PRINCE SAUD BIN KHALED'S STOCK DISPERSING AT KEENELAND

Keeneland announced Thursday that the bloodstock holdings of the late Prince Saud bin Khaled will be dispersed later this year. A native of Saudi Arabia who established Chanteclair Farm in Kentucky and Palides Investments N.V. Inc., Prince Saud passed away in February. The operation's 11 yearlings will be offered at

Keeneland September through Lane's End as agent, while the broodmares, weanlings and racing stock will go under the hammer in November under the Chanteclair Farm banner. Among the racehorses slated to sell is this year's GI Black-Eyed Susan S. heroine and **TDN Rising Star** **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker). Her dam **Delta Princess** (A.P. Indy), in foal to Distorted Humor, tops the 17 mares to be offered by the estate. The 12 weanlings include a Smart Strike filly out of Delta Princess. "Prince Saud achieved remarkable success from a very small but select broodmare band," said Keeneland President and CEO Nick Nicholson. "He was a passionate horseman, and took immense pride in planning the matings of his mares and campaigning his homebreds. We enjoyed his visits to Keeneland. He liked attending the races here." Chanteclair's President Ron Wallace added, "Mr. Khaled was one of the most sincere and most thoughtful people I have ever worked for. His mares have consistently produced, but this is the year they have really begun to peak as a group. It is bittersweet to know Mr. Khaled is not here to share in the continued success of his horses, but the finality of watching them go through the sale ring will be the hardest part for all of us at the farm." Among the horses bred by Prince Saud are Grade/Group 1 winners Biondetti (Bernardini) and Lear's Princess (Lear Fan).

MEANDRE GOES STRAIGHT TO THE TOP

Andre Fabre's actions often say more than words and when the master trainer rubber-stamped a €36,000 supplementary fee required to add **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}) to the field for yesterday's G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris, it was telling. That decision was justified when the grey homebred stepped up on a win in May's Listed Prix de l'Avre to defeat a stellar cast in this year's renewal at Longchamp. The victory improved Fabre's record tally in the contest to 11. "It was a truly run race, and Meandre quickened very well," Fabre said. **Cont. p2**

BREEDERS' CUP TO ELIMINATE RACE-DAY MEDICATIONS BY 2013 CHAMPIONSHIPS

The Breeders' Cup Limited has announced plans to develop protocols that will eliminate race-day medications in horses competing at the Breeders' Cup World Championships by 2013. The measure was adopted during Thursday's meeting of the group's Board of Directors. Procedures are expected to be developed that will prohibit the administration of race-day medication in 2-year-old races in the 2012 championships. The policy will then be expanded to all championship races in 2013. "Given the high level of international participation in our championships and the increasing support for our nominations programs throughout the global Thoroughbred breeding and racing community, Breeders' Cup feels strongly that the time has come to modify our medication policies to be consistent with international practices," Breeders' Cup Chairman Tom Lutd said in a statement. "Breeders' Cup has a longstanding reputation for setting high standards of safety, security and integrity for the participants in our championships, and this measure continues that tradition." The Breeders' Cup's new international nominations program has raised more than \$3.5 million so far this year, while the new international stallion nomination program has produced \$2.5 million since it began in January.

Meandre Goes Straight to the Top (cont. from p1)

Unsuccessful in four juvenile starts, Meandre emerged from winter quarters to run second at Saint-Cloud Mar. 15, and did so again in a conditions event next time Apr. 8. He broke through going 11 furlongs at Maisons-Laffitte in his seventh outing Apr. 28, and took a short break after triumphing in the Listed Prix de l'Avre over this course and distance last time May 22. The grey homebred was settled third off the clear leaders as Ballydoyle's G1 Irish Derby runner-up **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}) set searching fractions in advance of stablemate and Curragh conqueror **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}). The former set sail for home once into the stretch run and looked set for victory entering the final eighth as Meandre still tried to improve position, albeit much closer by now. The contest took on a different complexion inside the closing panel, as Meandre unleashed an impressive turn of foot to surge beyond Seville and Treasure Beach for victory, while G1 Prix du Jockey-Club victor **Reliable Man (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) ran on late to wrestle third from the latter. "We had not run him since the Prix de l'Avre on purpose, as he is a light-framed horse and we wanted to keep him fresh for this," explained Fabre. "He'll now have another break, and we'll bring him back here for the [Sept. 11 G2] Prix Niel before the [Oct. 2 G1] Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe." Offering a possible reason for Reliable Man's eclipse, trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "Reliable Man ran a good race, but he maybe lacked a little fitness. With the hot weather we have had, the ground has been very dry, and it's impossible to ask too much of the horses in such conditions. Also, I was unable to give him a serious workout at Chantilly racecourse, so maybe that explains it." Fellow conditioner Aidan O'Brien succinctly added, "Seville and Treasure Beach both ran well and there are no excuses, really."

Watar had been winless since garnering the 2008 G2 Prix Chaudenay, but took the whole of the following year off through injury, and has taken time to climb back up the ladder. Sixth when closing out last year in the Oct. 24 G1 Prix Royal-Oak at this track, he ran second in the Apr. 14 Listed Prix Lord Seymour back here on seasonal return, and hit the board in the G3 Prix d'Hedouville here once again last time May 5. Positioned in a handy third for most of this stamina test, he was hemmed in along the rail in the straight, but found a gap passing the furlong marker and quickened smartly in the closing stages to win with more in hand than the official margin would imply. "Watar is a horse who has a lot of class, and after winning the Chaudenay as a 3-year-old I thought he could be an Arc horse, but he had problems," said trainer Freddy Head. "He fractured a leg and was off for a year, and it has taken time for him to come back to his best. He really is talented, and we might come back at Deauville in a race such as the [G2] Prix Kergolay or the [G2] Grand Prix de Deauville [both Aug. 28]."

KHRC APPROVES KENTUCKY DOWNS' INSTANT RACING APPLICATION The Kentucky Horse Racing Commission yesterday approved Kentucky Downs' application to offer wagering on historic races. It is expected that Instant Racing machines will be available when the track opens for live racing Sept. 10. The Kentucky Equine Education Project has been lobbying for approval of the wagers. "As we have seen in Arkansas, historic racing has been able to contribute millions to purses at Oaklawn Park and to the Arkansas breeders program," the group's executive director Patrick Neely said in a statement after yesterday's vote. "Kentucky Downs is also preparing to hire up to 85 new employees at their facility to help install, maintain, and provide customer service to patrons who are enjoying historic racing. We have long argued that our signature racing and breeding industries need alternative revenue sources to allow our industry to compete on a level competitive playing field with our surrounding states. The successful application and installation of historic racing at Kentucky Downs will increase Kentucky purses, the Kentucky Thoroughbred Development Fund and the Kentucky Breeders Incentive Fund, and will help protect the 100,000 jobs that are reliant on the horse industry while at the same time creating new jobs. We are thankful that Governor Beshear and members of the Kentucky Horse Racing Commission have identified the crisis facing our industry, and are obviously determined to do something about it."

MIRAHMADI NAMED OAKLAWN ANNOUNCER Frank Mirahmadi has been named to replace Terry Wallace as track announcer at Oaklawn Park. Wallace announced his retirement last month after 37 years at the Oaklawn microphone. The 43-year-old Mirahmadi, a California native, currently calls races on the Northern California fair circuit. He also serves as a part-time analyst on TVG. "I am very grateful for this incredible opportunity," said Mirahmadi, who called his first race at Hollywood Park in 1992. "Oaklawn is one of the premier tracks in the country with an outstanding reputation for quality racing and large, enthusiastic crowds. It will truly be a privilege to call the stars that emerge from there year after year." Oaklawn opens for a 56-day meet Jan. 13.

British bookmaker Betfred's £265-million deal to purchase the state owned Tote has been officially ratified after John Penrose MP, the government minister responsible for betting and racing, informed Britain's Parliament the acquisition had been completed. "In my ministerial written statement to the House [of Commons] on June 7, I announced that the government had reached a legally binding agreement with Lightcatch Ltd, the parent company of Betfred, for the sale of the Tote," Penrose announced. "The government is now able to announce that the sale was completed Wednesday. The government would like to place on record its gratitude to the board and staff of the Tote, past and present, for their stewardship of the Tote, and to wish the combined businesses of Betfred and the Tote a successful future. The government will now enter into detailed discussions with representatives of the racing industry on the design of a scheme for disbursing its share of the net proceeds of sale in a manner which complies with European Union state aid rules."
