FIRST STATE CLASSIC

They first met a year ago in the GII Delaware Oaks, when **Blind Luck** (Pollard's Vision) nipped **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam) by a desperate nose in a sloppy renewal. Twelve months and four split decisions later, the California-based **Blind Luck** got the better of her determined rival once more with a stretch battle that should make many a highlight reel. Having been beaten soundly by

Havre de Grace at Oaklawn in March, **Blind Luck** carried two pounds less than the odds-on local lass. "I'd rather have the two pounds than not," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer told *Daily Racing Form*. "Havre de Grace is the number-one rated filly in the country and we were coming to her home track, so I would expect to get a couple of pounds." **Blind Luck's** rider Garrett Gomez added, "We came up to [Havre de Grace] and she fought back--I thought I might be in a little trouble. But with this filly, as soon as you pull her out and she pins her ears back, she accelerates in two jumps." **Cont. p5**

HOLLYWOOD ENDING

Nereid (Rock Hard Ten) was doing her best to hang on after making all of the running the GI Hollywood Oaks, but **Cambina (Ire)** (Hawk Wing) made her way determinedly through traffic, and the two fillies were deemed inseparable at the wire by the camera. WONDERFUL TODAY?

Johnny Murtagh received a barrowload of plaudits for an enterprising ride that aided **Dancing Rain (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) to success in the June 3 G1 Epsom Oaks, but it is the runner-up from that contest, **Wonder of Wonders** (Kingmambo), who is expected to reverse Classic placings in today's G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh, according to bookmakers' forecasts. Ryan Moore renews his acquaintance with the May 4 Listed Cheshire Oaks victress, who bids to provide Aidan O'Brien with a fourth triumph in the €425,000 event and continue the trainer's sweep of domestic Classics. However, a reversal of fortune is not a formality, and **Dancing Rain's** trainer William Haggas is looking forward to the rematch. "We'll see whether it was just a fantastic ride by Johnny [Murtagh] at Epsom, or if she was good enough to win," he said. "She's a long-striding filly and is a lengthener, rather than a quickener, and just needs a good gallop. If there is no pace, she'll have to make the running again. She seems to have come on since Epsom, and we feel she is in good shape at the moment. She ran well as a 2-year-old on soft [going], and she obviously goes well on fast. I think that she is such a fluent mover that fast ground will be ideal, but we can't do anything about the weather." **Cont. p2-4**

Godolphin's **Blue Bunting** was chinned on the line for third at Epsom, with Frankie Dettori incurring the wrath of the local stewards for dropping his hands late, and trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni considers the G1 1000 Guineas heroine to have progressed from her latest effort. "We thought Blue Bunting was a mile-and-a-half filly before she won the Guineas," Al Zarooni told *Racing Post*. "The pace really helped her at Newmarket, and she stayed on. I wouldn't say she was unlucky at Epsom, but the pace was too slow. Mile-and-a-half fillies always come from behind, and they prefer a fast pace. She has ability, has already proved she's a class filly, and I think she can do it again. I think she likes fast ground, but it was soft ground when she won her maiden, so she won't mind the ground. She did very well after the Oaks, she's stronger, better and more relaxed now. We just need the luck. If you are not in it you cannot win it." It seems an annual occurrence that Jim Bolger mines a prime example of his training ethic, and this year **Banimpire (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) fits that bill, carrying the torch with elan. She has won five black-type events from seven starts this term, and lines up with a stamina guarantee, having annexed Royal Ascot's G2 Ribblesdale S. last time June 16. "I hope we have her in form, as good as we've had her in all year," Bolger said. "If that is so, we expect her to give a good account of herself. She is a filly that we like and she is entirely reliable. We felt she was in good form for Royal Ascot and was up for it on the day. We were a bit concerned about the going, but she seemed to cope with that fairly well. She is gutsy and has a fair level of talent. Those two together combine to make her a useful racehorse." The home defense is further

bolstered by **Laughing Lashes** (Mr. Greeley), who will seek to improve on a third in the May 22 G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, and makes her first start beyond one mile here. "Laughing Lashes ran really well and was staying on in the Irish 1000," said trainer Jessica Harrington. "The plan was always to go straight for the Oaks after that. She's a very big filly, and that's why she hasn't had much racing this year, with a view

of her hopefully staying well and having a nice autumn campaign. She's in great form." **Irish Oaks cont. p3-4**

IRISH OAKS BREEDERS

AIRLIE STUD - Gemstone (Ire) Airlie was founded by the late Capt. A.D.D. Rogers after WWII, and is now headquartered in Co. Kildare, Ireland. Still run by the Rogers family, the operation combines commercial breeding with boarding of mares and foals at Grangewilliam Stud and sales prep for yearlings at Kilmacredock Stud. Classic winners produced by the farm include Bachelor Duke, Fair Question (Ire), Margarula (Ire) and Petrushka (Ire).

BRAD KELLEY - Blue Bunting A resident of Nashville, Tennessee, Brad Kelley founded the Commonwealth Brands tobacco company in 1990, which manufactured discounted cigarettes and undersold the top brands by offering low advertising costs. He sold the company in 2001 for a reported \$1 billion and subsequently held a majority ownership position in Kentucky Downs near the Tennessee border and a small stake in Churchill Downs. He also served on that track's board for a short time. Kelley was one of four original partners in Hurricane Hall, and later purchased the 403 acres of land after the farm's stallions were relocated to Pauls Mill. Kelley also owns Lane's End stallion English Channel in partnership, maintains a small racing stable and has real estate investments across the United States.



KILCARN STUD - Banimpire (Ire) Kilcarn, owned by Pat O'Kelley, is a 200-acre stud in Co. Meath, Ireland. The operation was started by O'Kelley's father, Major Ned O'Kelley, in 1943, and taken over by the daughter about 40 years ago. The farm was the leading breeder in Britain and Ireland in 1966, and produced champion and Classic winner Salsabil (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), who beat the boys in the 1990 G1 Irish Derby, and also took the G1 1000 Guineas and three other Group 1 events.

LIBERTY BLOODSTOCK - Wonder of Wonders Liberty Bloodstock is a U.S. arm of the Coolmore conglomerate. All Too Beautiful (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), the dam of Wonder of Wonders, is out of the great Urban Sea (Miswaki), and was acquired by Coolmore for 1,100,000gns as a TATDEC weanling. She went on to win the G3 Middleton S. and run second behind Ouija Board (GB) in the G1 Epsom Oaks while carrying Michael Tabor's colors. Wonder of Wonders is the second foal out of the half to champions Urban Ocean (Fr) (Bering {GB}) and Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}), and full to champions Galileo (Ire) and Black Sam Bellamy (Ire). The mare has an unraced 2-year-old filly, Along (Ire) (Smart Strike), and a yearling colt by Dansili (GB).

He started out as a stone mason and, it has been reported, sold his house and the cars of both he and his wife to fund his first real estate project. His racing interests are represented by Herve Barjot, who was a pedigree researcher, consultant, buyer and stud manager while working in Australia, France, Ireland and the U.S. The wide-ranging Pegasus operation

offers everything from sales prep and racing partnerships to racehorse management and boarding.

RUNNYMEDE FARM & ROBERT P LEVY - Laughing Lashes Established in 1867 in Paris, Kentucky, by patriarch Col. Ezekiel Clay, Runnymede is the oldest continuously run Thoroughbred farm in the state. It is now headed by Catesby Clay, the grandson of the founder, and great grandson Brutus Clay III serves as president. The 365-acre farm was named after the spot where the Magna Carta was signed. Runnymede has produced Hall of Famers Ben Brush, Hanover, Miss Woodford and Roamer. Philadelphia native Robert Levy, 80, is chairman of DRT Industries, a conglomerate of industrial holdings in the Delaware Valley. He became involved in racing through his father and his uncle, who owned horses in the 1940s, and went on to breed and/or

race top horses such as champions Housebuster and North Sider. Other ventures included forming racing partnerships, and owning the full-service boarding, breaking and sales prep operation Muirfield East in Maryland. Levy is a director of Penn National Gaming. He established the Robert P. Levy Community Service Award, presented to the individual, business or organization that has done the most to contribute to the quality of life in Philadelphia through sports, in 1996.

STIFTUNG GESTUT FAHRHOF - Rumh (Ger) Founded



in 1960 on 170 acres by German business magnate Walther Jacobs and originally intended only for the family's own warmblood stock, Fahrhof readily established itself as one of the leading German racing and breeding operations. They celebrated German Derby

victories with Surumu, Lagunas and Acatenango and also campaigned the likes of GI Arlington Million hero Silvano, his full brother Sabiango and the globetrotting Quijano in their yellow and black silks. Rumh was a 300,000gns purchase out of the 2009 Tattersalls October Sale from the consignment of Newsells Park Stud. Klaus Jacobs, son of Walther, ran the operation until the time of his death in 2009. His widow Renata is now at the helm.

SWETTENHAM STUD - Dancing Rain (Ire) Swettenham is owned by the estate of the late Robert Sangster, who died of pancreatic cancer in 2004. His three sons--Adam, Guy and Ben--have carried on the prestigious operation, though on a smaller, restructured scale. Ben manages Swettenham's Northern Hemisphere operation from the family's Manton estate in Wiltshire, while Adam owns and manages the farm's Australian division. Robert was the son of Vernon Sangster, founder of the Vernon Soccer Pools. Robert inherited the business and sold it in 1987 for a reported \$151.2 million. In the '70s, Sangster joined forces with trainer Vincent O'Brien and Coolmore's John Magnier to develop commercially profitable sires from the horses they raced. The men revolutionized the breeding industry, pioneering the shuttling of stallions to the Southern Hemisphere and building Coolmore into an international powerhouse. Horses carrying Sangster's famed green, blue and white silks included Sadler's Wells, Alleged, The Minstrel and El Gran Senor.

Zain Al Boldan (GB) Tweenhills Farm and Stud is the operation of David Redvers, who converted the 350-acre family farm in Gloucestershire into a breeding operation in 1995. The son of one of Britain's leading show judges and an esteemed portrait painter, Redvers learned the ropes working for top horsemen such as Luca Cumani, Mark Johnston and Amanda Skiffington, and also spent time with Tattersalls and Keeneland sales companies. He is also active as a bloodstock agent.

When the gates flew open, Havre de Grace took a stutter step to her left before being straightened out by rider Ramon Dominguez and going up to race in third. The typically unhurried Blind Luck, meanwhile, needed the length of the run to the first turn to drop closer to the rail from her outside post. Havre de Grace settled in third while racing three wide as Life at Ten set honest fractions of :47.74 and 1:12.53. The crowd's choice inhaled the pacesetter on the far turn, but Blind Luck wasn't too far behind. The chestnut angled off the fence entering the stretch and was under a full head of steam, and for a stride or two it appeared that she might go right by her old foe. Havre de Grace had other ideas, though. Digging in gamely on the inside, the bay still had her nose in front with the wire rapidly approaching, but Blind Luck stretched her stubborn nose out just in time.

Havre de Grace's trainer Larry Jones wasn't pleased that his solidly built charge carried two pounds more than the 2010 champion. "Tell me two pounds does not make a difference," Jones told *Daily Racing Form*. "She won six Grade 1s versus our one, and we are the highweight. That makes a lot of sense. I probably should not have run."

Like last year, Blind Luck will head next to Saratoga for a 10-furlong contest, but this time it will be the GI Personal Ensign S. Aug. 28.

Luck's Got Nothing to Do With It...

Blind Luck followed up her Delaware Oaks triumph over Havre de Grace with a neck victory at level weights in the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga, but couldn't reel in her bay rival while giving her 10 pounds in the GII Fitz Dixon Cotillion S. at Parx Racing Oct. 2 and wound up second by a head. She was second to Havre de Grace's third in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Churchill Nov. 5, and earned the Eclipse Award for a season that also included wins in the GI Kentucky Oaks, GII Fantasy S. and GI Las Virgenes S.

With barely a break, the wiry filly resumed this winter at Santa Anita, but looked like she was past her prime, finishing second twice to Always a Princess (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). Trainer Jerry Hollendorfer sent her back to Oaklawn for the GIII Azeri S. Mar. 19, but she was unable to challenge Havre de Grace in that rematch, and wound up second by 3 1/4 lengths.

Things have gone differently since. After toppling her Breeders' Cup conqueror Unrivaled Belle (Unbridled's Song) in the GII La Troienne S. at Churchill May 6, the 4-year-old rallied six wide to prevail in the GI Vanity H. at Hollywood June 18, and round six with Havre de Grace was on.

The winner's dam produced a Successful Appeal filly in 2010 before being sold to Shadai Farm for \$1.85 million at KEENOV. She was bred to Deep Impact (Jpn) this spring.

A year ago, trainer John Shirreffs sent out Harmonious (Dynaformer) to take the GI American Oaks in just her fourth career start. This time around, her lightly raced stablemate Nereid had to share the honors, but a Grade I win is a Grade I win, even if you have to split the check. Second to subsequent top-level winner Zazu (Tapit) in her career debut on the Hollywood Cushion Track Oct. 15, the dark bay donned cap and gown when she resurfaced on this course May 7, and added an allowance win going a mile June 2. She was more than up to this stretch-out. Cambina, twice a winner in Ireland when trained by Tommy Stack, was unplaced in her U.S. bow for conditioner Jeff Bonde, but rebounded to take her next three, including the Feb. 21 GIII La Habra S. and GII Providencia S. Apr. 9, both at Santa Anita. Third at 4-5 to Star Billing in the GIII Senorita S. in her first Hollywood appearance May 7, the chestnut was beaten a half-length when third--and a head behind Star Billing--in the GII Honeymoon H. going nine panels on this sod June 11. Nereid took charge when the gates opened, tracked intently by Kentucky shipper Bizzy Caroline (Afleet Alex), while Cambina caboosed the field.

After six furlongs in 1:12.76, Nereid opened up a bit of daylight on her rivals, and Cambina commenced her rally. The closer was forced to steady a bit between horses in midstretch, and that may have been enough to get them to the wire together. Star Billing, also trained by Shirreffs, was fanned very wide turning for home and finished third by a head. "Having two horses

in the race, I thought that Star Billing would have the lead and Nereid could go to a stalking position," Shirreffs offered. "So,

when the gate opened and Star Billing stumbled, everything changed. You always worry late in the race, the last two or three strides is where a horse is susceptible. You wonder where the turf course wire is." He added, "This was a Grade I, so there was an opportunity for both of them to have Grade I status. That was the reason they both ran. I would hope in the future we could separate them."

Nereid is owned by Eric Kronfeld, whose breeding operation Maverick Productions has produced the likes of Horse of the Year Zenyatta (Street Cry {Ire}). Her dam has a 2-year-old Proud Citizen filly and a yearling full-sister to the American Oaks heroine, and has a Lemon Drop Kid filly at her side.

The French-bred Right One compiled a modest two-for-16 record in his home country, but has found new life on American shores. A winner in his 4-year-old finale in a Deauville conditions event in December, the gelding appeared four months later in South Florida and duly captured his U.S. bow, a 7 1/2-furlong optional claimer on the grass Apr. 1. He set a new course record that day--speeding the distance in 1:26.91--and was favored in his next, the one-mile Island Sun S. at Belmont, which he won by a two-length margin in a fast 1:33 2/5. There was a bit of give in the ground in the one-mile GIII Poker S. June 10 and, after tracking slow fractions, he had to settle for third under Rajiv Maragh. Partnered with Javier Castellano for the first time in this test and back on firm ground, Right One was settled at the back of the seven-horse field as Yield Bogey raced out to lead by daylight through :23.74 and :46.66 splits. Right One began to take closer order turning for home while still second last, but gobbled up ground with every stride and just got up to deny a game Yield Bogey. "Nice win, no?" trainer Christophe Clement offered. "He came to me this winter; he was trained by a very good friend of mine, Crique Head, and belongs to her mother, Ghislane Head. I worked for the Heads; I am very close with them and I am delighted to be able to win a Grade III for them. He's never run a bad race since he came to the States. I told Javier, 'Don't worry about the pace.' He was moving very well on the turn and Javier waited until the stretch and gave him a great ride. The pace was against us, but you cannot change a horse's style. Perhaps we'll put him away and wait for the fall."

Settled in midfield initially here, he moved up easily to stalk the pacesetting Markab outside the furlong marker and was ridden clear to win readily and continue his climb up the sprinting ladder. 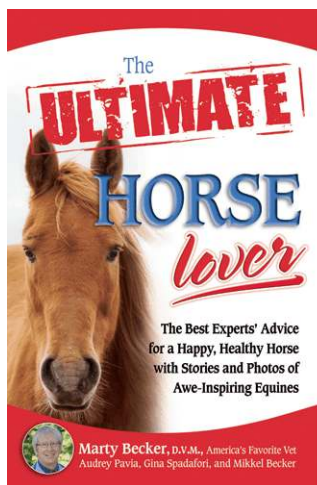

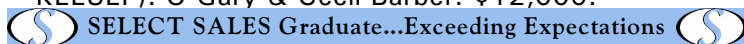
