## BUNTING UP AGAIN

Godolphin's G1 1000 Guineas victress **Blue Bunting** (Dynaformer) was nabbed on the line for third in last month's G1 Epsom Oaks, earning Frankie Dettori a hefty ban for dropping his hands, but the jockey made no mistake in the G1 Darley Irish Oaks at The Curragh yesterday, and the filly emulated her Newmarket swoop to bag a second Classic win. In rear for most of the contest, the well-backed 5-2 second favorite surged wide and late to oust **Banimpire (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) by a short head on the line, with G1 Epsom Oaks second

**Wonder of Wonders** (Kingmambo) a further half-length back in third. Epsom victress **Dancing Rain (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) held every chance at the two pole and kept on resolutely to finish a close-up fifth. "It was a bit of a mess at Epsom, but I came here with every chance and genuinely thought we could win," insisted Dettori. "I think the natural step would be the [Aug. 18 G1] Yorkshire Oaks, but Sheikh Mohammed will decide, as he may well have other plans." **Cont. p2**

## MAJESTIC CITY STILL UNTESTED, UNBEATEN

Jeffrey Bloom and partners' **Majestic City** (City Zip) remained undefeated yesterday with a decisive 2 1/4-length win in the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship. Leading trainer Bob Baffert swept the consolation prizes with **Brigand** (Flatter) second and **Night Tide** (Malibu Moon) third. The speedy 9-10 choice Majestic City opened his account in Inglewood May 21 and then turned the June 12 Willard L. Proctor Memorial S. into a virtual walkover with an easier-than-it-looked 3 1/2-length tally. He displayed a new dimension this time, rating in a joint second outside of Brigand off of splits of :22.44 and :45.54 set by Night Tide, but the result was the same--a win in hand and by daylight. It was a better race for second, as Brigand fought through on the rail to best his front-running stablemate. "He wasn't even trying all the way around the turn," said wining rider David Flores. "I'm driving and he's not moving. I got worried a little bit. But then when he changed leads, I got after him harder and whipped him a few times and I could feel the difference. 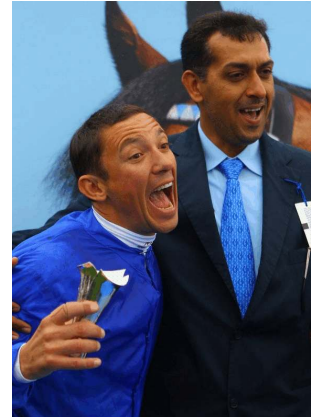

Blue Bunting opened her career with a second to subsequent G3 Prestige S. victress Theyskens' Theory (Bernardini) going seven furlongs in a July-course maiden at Newmarket July 31, and went one better going an extra panel at Doncaster two weeks later. Juvenile stamina was presented as evidence again with success in the Oct. 30 Listed Montrose Fillies' S. at Newmarket's other track in her campaign closer Oct. 30, and she tasted Classic glory with a late surge along the rail in the G1 1000 Guineas back at headquarters on seasonal return May 1. Frankie Dettori was guilty of complacency in the June 3 G1 Epsom Oaks next time, having eased Blue Bunting prematurely and losing third on the line behind Dancing Rain (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and Wonder of Wonders. That transgression earned the jockey a 10-day holiday, but he made no mistake this time and gained some measure of redemption with a last-gasp triumph. The eventual winner was settled double-digit lengths off the clear leaders Amazing Beauty (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and Hurricane Havoc (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}), who combined to carve out testing fractions. Godolphin second choice Rumh (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) provided a bridge to the remainder in third. Easing his mount closer with a half-mile remaining, Dettori crouched lower on the home turn as the tempo neared maximum. However, Blue Bunting looked held when fifth inside the final quarter mile, just as the new leader Banimpire came under the full force of Kevin Manning's persuasion to contain Wonder of Wonders.

But Blue Bunting was angled outside at the furlong marker and powered home wide and late--with Dettori at the limit--to wrest victory from Banimpire on the line. "The pace was solid, the five good ones were all together turning for home, and the best filly won," the rider said. "I got myself a bit stuck two [furlongs] out as she wasn't going forward for me. As a last resort, I decided to switch her to the outside, and that won me the race. I was really struggling when I was stuck behind the other horses, but once she saw a bit of daylight, she went forward." Celebrating a second European Classic, trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni told *irishracing.com*, "Frankie gave her a brilliant ride, the nice pace helped and the pacemaker did a good job. I'm delighted for my team which did so well to prepare her for today. I wasn't that confident before the race as I thought every horse had a chance. We have no certain plans for her now, but she may go for the Yorkshire Oaks next."

Blue Bunting was bred in Kentucky by Brad Kelley, a former partner in the now-defunct Hurricane Hall. Ben Walden, another partner, purchased her dam, Miarixa, in foal to Gulch, for Kelley for \$220,000 at the 2006 Keeneland November Sale. Kelley acquired the mare to breed to English Channel, one of Hurricane Hall's original stallions and now on Lane's End's roster. Kelley is a shareholder in English Channel, and Blue Bunting has a year-younger half-sister by the son of Smart Strike who sold to Fleetwood Bloodstock for \$110,000 at September last year. Miarixa has a yearling filly by English Channel and foaled a colt by him this spring.

**Banimpire So Close...**

Jim Bolger trainee **Banimpire (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), Gaelic for empress, has made relentless progress towards the top during a busy sophomore campaign, but failed by a whisker to justify her name-tag and reach the pinnacle of her generation. Looking set fair for victory after gamely fighting off Wonder of Wonders, she succumbed to another of Blue Bunting's late surges and was usurped on the line. Banimpire has proved tenacious throughout a seven-race season before this Classic, garnering five wins in black-type company, including the G3 Ballysax S., the G3 Blue Wind S., the G3 Noblesse S. and the G2 Ribblesdale S. at Royal Ascot last month. "It was very close at the finish," stated Bolger. "The ground maybe didn't help her, but she has run a good race nonetheless."

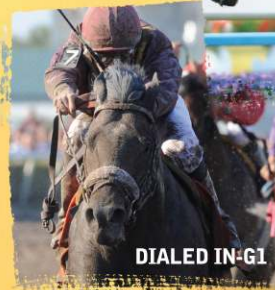
Alianthus has been in tremendous form this season, rattling off a hat trick of easy wins in the Apr. 10 G3 Fruhjahrs Meile over course and distance, the June 2 G3 Badener-Meile and the June 25 G3 Hamburger Meile last time. Sent off as the odds-on favorite to continue his unbeaten season, he was allowed to set moderate early fractions. Alianthus traveled best of all as the field straightened for home, was ridden along soon after and kept on strongly under a drive to keep the British challengers at bay inside the final furlong.

The only tense moments for the favorite came before the race--he reared up in the paddock and went down. "He got startled by the crowd in the paddock and he sucked back and lost his footing," explained trainer Peter Miller. "He didn't flip over, but he kind of fell sideways. The rule is that if a horse flips, they scratch him. But he didn't actually flip, he kind of fell more sideways. I want to thank the state vet (Dr. Dana Stead), who allowed the horse to warm up to see how he was and for allowing the horse to run. He looked perfect." Miller continued, "Those were two nice colts that he beat. I was a little worried at the quarter pole because he wasn't really moving, and then at the eighth pole he really leveled off and continued on. The [Aug. 7 GIII] Best Pal S. [at Del Mar] is probably next."

Majestic City is owned by an eight-person partnership led by Jeffrey Bloom, who left his position as vice president of West Point Thoroughbreds' West Coast operations earlier this year. Bloom then started Majestic Racing Stable with Mike Shustek and Majestic City was one of the first horses the duo purchased together at OBS March. Bloom bought out Shustek's stake in Majestic City following the Proctor, according to *Daily Racing Form*.

Imponente Purse, a minor stakes winner and Group 1-placed in his native Brazil in 2009, was seeking his second win from 14 U.S. starts. The bay scored by a neck in an optional claimer here last December, but hadn't been able to recapture that success since. He did, however, fall just a head short when second in the 1 3/4-mile GII San Juan Capistrano H. at Santa Anita Apr. 17. Imponente Purse was coming off a rough-trip sixth in a one-mile optional claimer 15 days ago, and garnered second-choice status on the stretch back out to a more suitable distance for him. Relaxed along the rail and towards the rear behind splits of :48.53, 1:12.57 and 1:36.70, rider Chantal Sutherland tipped her mount out along the home bend and coaxed him enthusiastically to pick it up. He did, and strode out nicely in the stretch to earn the top prize with something in reserve.

Stepping up in trip with another fourth in the Apr. 17 Listed Salsabil S. at Navan, she finished fifth in the June 9 Listed Nijinsky S. back at Leopardstown last time. Forcing a strong pace in a clear lead by the first call, the bay homebred was still several lengths in front when kicking on the home turn and stuck on gamely as her strong-travelling stablemate flew from the rear to snatch second close home. **Cont. p6**

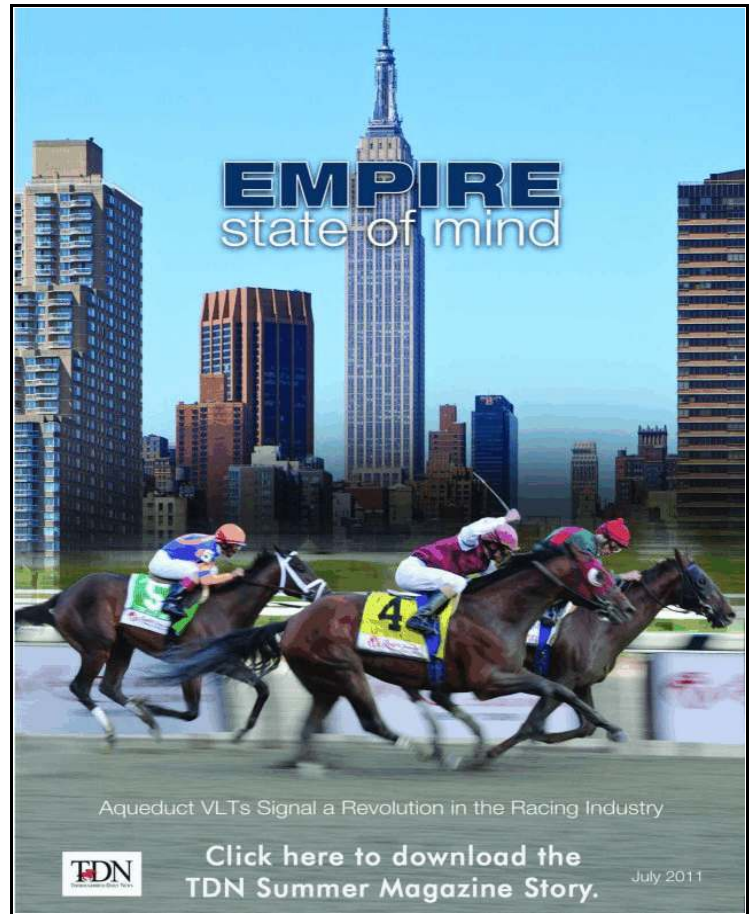
