THE SCHUY'S THE LIMIT AT SARATOGA 2011

The 143rd season at Saratoga Race Course starts today. John Velazquez will be going for a second straight riding title, but he acknowledged the difficulty of accomplishing the feat. "It's a tough meet for everyone," said Velazquez. "At Saratoga, everyone wants to win. When you have New York jockeys like Cornelio Velasquez and Ramon Dominguez, it's

tough. Plus, you have the top riders coming in from Kentucky, so it's even harder." Eight of the top 11 riders from Churchill Downs, including leader Julian Leparoux, will join the colony. Todd Pletcher, who led all trainers with 36 victories last year, will be loaded for bear once again. He sends out favored **Georgie's Angel** (Bellamy Road) in the first graded race of the meeting, today's GIII Schuylerville S. The dark bay opened her career with a 6 1/4-length score in a Churchill Downs maiden test July 4. She steps into the graded ranks for her second start. "She's settled in well here and had a nice breeze the other day," said Pletcher, referencing the filly's half-mile workout in :49.07 over the Spa's main track July 16. "It's a graded stakes at Saratoga, and obviously it's a tough race to win. This will be a test of her quality." Pletcher has, in fact, won the Schuylerville three times in the last eight years. Standing in his way of a fourth victory in the event could be **Force De La Nature** (Scat Daddy), a rallying 1 1/4-length debut winner at Churchill June 19. Her sire won the GII Sanford S. and was second in the GI Hopeful S. at the Spa in '06. *(more on the Spa, p2-4)*

AWESOME MARIA DONE FOR YEAR

Mrs. E. Paul Robsham's homebred **Awesome Maria** (Maria's Mon--Discreetly Awesome, by Awesome Again), perfect in four tries this season, including the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont last time June 18 ([video](#)), is done for the year with a condylar fracture. The 4-year-old had two screws inserted by Dr. Larry Bramlage to stabilize the non-displaced fracture in her left foreleg at Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital in Kentucky Wednesday. Trained by Todd Pletcher, Awesome Maria was gearing up for the GI Ruffian Invitational H. with a five-furlong move in 1:02 at the Spa before the injury was detected. "It compressed really well, she was sound following the surgery, which is always a good indication that they'll return to full capability if Mrs. Robsham decides to race her again next year," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "It will be an option." Awesome Maria also posted wins in this season's GIII Sabin S. Feb. 19, GIII Rampart S. Apr. 2 and GII Shuvee H. May 21. "It's really disappointing--she seemed like she was in career form," Pletcher added. "She was four-for-four on the year, coming off a Grade I win; we were looking forward to the Ruffian."

Workforce has usurped **St Nicholas Abbey** as ante-post favorite after a select field of five stood their ground at yesterday's declaration stage. Juddmonte's G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner, drawn in four, is currently rated a 6-4 chance with Britain's bookmakers, as punters see the last week's rainfall--which has changed the Berkshire track's official going to soft--as a positive factor for the 4-year-old bay. Further rain is forecast, both today and tomorrow, and Ascot's clerk of the course Chris Stickels expects little change to the current description. "I'm afraid we may get occasional showers Friday and Saturday, and it's likely to be on the soft side of good on the round course for Saturday's race," he said. Derrick Smith's G1 Coronation Cup winner St Nicholas Abbey has drifted in the betting over recent days, and the 5-2 chance will have the guidance of Joseph O'Brien in the saddle. He will exit from the two hole. Alongside in one will be **Rewilding**, who has yet to taste defeat this term and is offered at 3-1 to provide Godolphin with a fifth renewal of the £1-million contest. Lady Rothschild's impressive Royal Ascot winner **Nathaniel**, a 7-1 chance, is the sole representative of the Classic generation and has been allocated stall three. Godolphin's number two **Debussy**, who won last year's GI Arlington Million in Princess Haya's silks, completes the line-up. The 100-1 outsider will depart from gate five.

RCI COMMITTEE ADDS THREE CLASS 1 SUBSTANCES *(Edited press release)* The Drug Testing Standards and Practices Committee committee of Racing Commissions International voted Wednesday to specifically add Methylenedioxypropylone and related analogues (bath salts); Dermorphin; and synthetic cannabinoids as Class 1 prohibited substances in horse racing, and called for any violators to be sanctioned with the highest recommended penalties contained in the RCI Model Rules. Delaware Racing Commission Member Duncan Patterson, the chair of the DTSP Committee, said, "These substances have no place in racing, and those using them will result in significant fines and suspensions. I encourage stewards and judges to not only consider the recommended penalties contained in the Model Rules, but to consider referrals to their commission for even tougher penalties as provided for in the Model Rules." Methylenedioxypropylone and related analogues have recently been found in post-race tests conducted in several racing jurisdictions. These "designer drugs" are psychoactive with stimulant properties, and have been marketed in North America as "bath salts." Dermorphin is a natural opiate more potent than morphine, but less likely to produce addiction. Racing investigators have discovered vials of this substance, and testing labs have been put on notice. Synthetic cannabis is a psychoactive herbal and chemical product that mimics the effects of cannabis. The committee voted that use of any of these substances warrant the most severe penalties currently recommended in the RCI Model Rules. Those penalties provide for a minimum one-year suspension, a fine of \$10,000 and exclusion of the horse from competition for at least three months, and the ability of the stewards to refer the matter to the Racing Commission to consider more severe penalties. RCI President Ed Martin noted that the RCI, as well as the Racing Medication and Testing Consortium, are working on increasing recommended sanctions for those with Class 1 and 2 substance violations. "The tougher the penalty, the greater the deterrent," Martin said. "There is a growing belief that repeat offenses should trigger a review of the underlying racing license with an eye toward denial, revocation or the imposition of conditions that, if violated, would result in a loss of license." The committee also voted to make a specific notation in the Classification document instructing stewards and judges, if they find a substance that is not specifically noted, should treat it as a Class 1 substance, warranting the most severe penalty, unless consultation with the RCI or RMTC advises otherwise pending formal inclusion on the list. The RCI Board of Directors will take final action next Wednesday.

CHRB Reduces Bute Threshold:

Beginning Jan. 1, 2012, the permissible threshold for the anti-inflammatory butazolidin will be lowered from five nanograms to two nanograms per milliliter of blood, the *Daily Racing Form* reports. The California Horse Racing Board voted 4-3 to lower the bute level during its meeting Thursday. Approximately 85-90% of horses tested at CHRB tracks already fall at or below the two-nanogram level. The American Graded Stakes Committee has already implemented a policy that, as of Jan. 1, 2012, will require all graded events to observe the lower threshold.

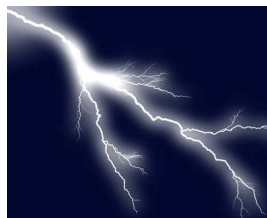

"I trained the mother [Kiswahili] for Miss [Kirsten] Rausing and she was an out-and-out stayer. This is her second foal, and Miss Rausing has used the sire [Stormy Atlantic] to introduce a bit of speed before with great success. 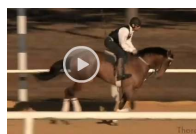
