An extremely competitive group of five sophomore fillies will line up for today's nine-furlong GI Coaching Club American Oaks at Saratoga. **It's Tricky**

GEORGIE'S ANGEL FLIES IN SCHUYLERVILLE

Sheffer Racing Stable, et al.'s 4-5 choice **Georgie's Angel** (Bellamy Road) remained unbeaten yesterday in Saratoga's traditional opening day feature, the GIII Schuylerville S., besting **True Feelings** (Latent Heat) by 1 1/2 lengths. **Force de La Nature** (Scat Daddy) was 5 3/4 lengths back in third. Georgie's Angel looked like she might go to the lead after an alert break, like she had when graduating by 6 1/2 lengths at Churchill Downs July 4, but John Velazquez wisely reined his mount in when longshot **Vukovar** (Forest Wildcat) and **Gypsy Robin** (Daaher) were quarter-horsed from the gate. Vukovar won the early race, opening up as many as 3 1/2 lengths on Gypsy Robin through a quarter in a blistering :21.38, while Georgie's Angel rated comfortably in third. The chalk picked off Gypsy Robin, who had taken over from the already fading Vukovar, in mid-stretch, and the race was won. ABBEY ON ROAD TO GLORY?

Ascot's G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. has attracted just five combatants, but what is short on quantity is long on quality as one record or another is certain to tumble in the aftermath of today's £1-million contest. Ballydoyle conditioner Aidan O'Brien has won on three previous occasions, most recently with Duke of Marmalade (Ire) (Danehill) in 2008, but part-owner Michael Tabor will become the race's winningest owner if **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) prevails. Triumphant in the 2009 G1 Racing Post Trophy, he slammed inferior opposition by more than nine lengths in the May 6 G3 Ormonde S. at Chester, and his abundant stamina was in evidence once again when he reeled in Midday (GB) to land the June 3 G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom in his most recent outing. O'Brien's son Joseph, who won this semester's G1 Irish 2000 Guineas aboard the stable's Roderic O'Connor (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), has been put in place to become St Nicholas Abbey's fourth different rider. "I haven't ridden him in a race before, but I ride him in a lot of his work at home," said the younger O'Brien. "I'm looking forward to the race--it's a very, very good race--and all I can do is ride my horse to the best of his ability. I have to say a big thanks to the owners for giving me the opportunity to ride the horse." **Cont. p3**

"The race set up kind of like we thought it might on paper, and she ran a very professional race," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "She broke well, but we anticipated a little bit of speed inside us, and the best thing is that when you have an outside post like that it gives you some options. Johnny rode a perfect race. [The Sep. 4 GI Spinaway S.] is the logical [next step]. We'll see how she bounces out of it, but it's good spacing. We ran her back a little quick off her win at Churchill, so now we have a little extra time." Pilot John Velazquez added, "It went my way today. I knew those two horses had the speed and I told Todd we had a good post position on the outside, so if those two horses go, I can sit right off of them and try to save a little for the end, and she did." Sir Michael Stoute currently shares the title of leading trainer of this race with Dick Hern and Saeed bin Suroor, but will be in splendid isolation with six wins if **Workforce** can add to his victories in last term's G1 Epsom Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Runner-up to So You Think (NZ) in a thrilling G1 Eclipse S. last time July 2, Juddmonte's bay will seek redemption in this contest having finished 17 lengths adrift of stablemate Harbinger (GB) when odds-on favorite last term. "It was the only bad race he's ever run and, on reflection, I think I gave him the wrong preparation last year. But we'll see if we can put it right this time," Stoute said. "His preparation has gone well, and we think we've got him in good shape. His two runs this year have been very promising, particularly his performance in the Eclipse at Sandown."

Like Michael Tabor, Godolphin also sits on five prior wins, and a victory for either **Rewilding** or **Debussy** will give Mahmood Al Zarooni a first success. Frankie Dettori continues his partnership with Rewilding, who is unbeaten this term with victories in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic and the G1 Prince of Wales's S.--beating So You Think (NZ) at Royal Ascot last time.

"Everything has gone well with Rewilding since Royal Ascot," commented Al Zarooni. "We haven't changed anything with him, we have freshened him up, given him one easy piece of work, and he's ready to run. He did very well to win the Prince of Wales's S., and I think that he has changed from a 3-year-old to a 4-year-old. He is physically stronger, and the last race hasn't taken as much out of him compared to last season...A mile and a half is his best trip, and we are confident heading back to Ascot. We are running **Debussy** again to ensure a good pace." Cont. p4

Dettori added, "It took us a while to figure out how to deal with Rewilding, but Mahmood has done a great job, and he spaces the horse's races. The form of Rewilding's win at Royal Ascot has stood up well, with So You Think winning the Eclipse, and we are going back to Ascot ready to go. I think that the ground will be on the slow side of good, which will be good racing ground for everyone. Debussy will make sure that the race does not turn into a 'sit and sprint' and we go a nice even gallop. It is not a big field, I foresee a very straightforward race, and may the best horse win."

Nathaniel, a £75,000 supplementary entry and the sole representative of the Classic generation, is the only non-Group 1 winner in the line-up and receives the annual 12-pound lump conceded by older horses. Impressive when plundering the June 17 G2 King Edward VII S. by five lengths over course and distance at the Royal meet, he will provide John Gosden with a first renewal if successful. "We decided not to supplement him for the [July 14 G1] Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp], because the ground was drying up and it actually ended up on the fast side of good," explained Gosden. "The forecast for here was favourable and suggested we would get some ease in the ground, so we decided to supplement him. He's a course-and-distance winner, and he's a 3-year-old with improvement ahead of him, but obviously Workforce sets a very high standard."

Predicted overnight showers failed to materialize at Ascot yesterday, and the official going description on the track's round course remains soft going into Europe's midsummer showpiece. "There was no rain overnight [Friday], and the ground remains soft, good-to-soft in places, on the round course," Clerk of the Course Chris Stickels told *Racing Post*. "The forecast is for scattered showers, which could amount to a couple millimeters, possibly up to four [millimeters]."

Buster's Ready (More Than Ready), second to It's Tricky in that January allowance, blossomed into a star in her own right. Runner-up to **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) after attending a fast pace three-wide in the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 20, the Evans homebred annexed the GI Mother Goose S. at Big Sandy June 25 by 4 1/4 lengths over **Joyful Victory** (Tapit) after both Royal Delta and **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) failed to make the race as expected. Royal Delta's excuse was a foot bruise that forced her to miss prep time coming into the Mother Goose, but conditioner Bill Mott doesn't see a relative lack of race conditioning as an issue. "I don't think it will be that much of a disadvantage," said the Hall of Famer. "This distance wasn't an issue last time [in the Black-Eyed Susan], and I think being fresh could be an advantage not for this one, but maybe for the [Aug. 20 GI TVG] Alabama S." Peachtree Stable's GI Kentucky Oaks heroine Plum Pretty ships east to a venue where Bob Baffert has won at a 29% clip over the past five years with four graded wins, according to *DRF Formulator*. The bay didn't ship from her California base for the Mother Goose due to a slight fever, and instead contested the GII Hollywood Oaks on the same day. She was second to GISW Zazu (Tapit) in that synthetic track contest.

Augustin Stable's East Coast invader **Smart Bid** looks to get his first Grade I tally after coming up just a nose short to recent GI United Nations S. winner Teaks North (Northern Afleet) in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. in February. He finished one slot in front of subsequent MGISW Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) in that event. George Strawbridge's homebred then took the GII Mervin Muniz, Jr. H. by the same narrow margin at Fair Grounds in March, and was runner-up to Get Stormy in the GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. on Kentucky Derby Day May 7. Smart Bid is coming off a runner-up effort in the well-funded June 18 Colonial Turf Cup. The dark bay has posted a 5-2-1-0 record in previous California outings, highlighted by a win in the Damascus S. and a second in the GII San Fernando S.--both on the Santa Anita synthetic.

Two-time GI Charles Whittingham Memorial H. winner **Acclamation** turns back off a successful title defense in that 1 1/4-mile event at Hollywood June 11. Despite his early speed, the 5-year-old has had all of his major success at 10 and 12 furlongs. He won the 1 1/2-mile GII Jim Murray H. by seven lengths in Inglewood May 14. "The shorter distance is a little worrisome," trainer Donald Warren acknowledged to *Daily Racing Form*. "We won't be on the lead by three or four lengths, breezing like he did going a mile and a half. In the Jim Murray, he rated. If he has to rate, he can do it." If the pace gets hot, **Caracortado** is a dangerous late-running threat. Twice missing Grade I glory by narrow margins at a mile--in last March's GI Frank Kilroe Mile S. and in the GI Shoemaker Mile S. last time July 2--the chestnut took the Sunshine Millions Turf in his only try at this distance Jan. 29. He and Acclamation will be the first contestants in Del Mar's new head-to-head bet, which will be offered on every Saturday feature at the meet.

The presence of Juddmonte's dual G1 Champion S. hero **Twice Over** bolsters the profile of this fledgling event, inaugurated in 2006. Successful in the Mar. 3 G2 Al Maktoum Challenge (Round 3) at Meydan on seasonal return, he has been off the board in three subsequent starts, including when a 17-length fifth to Rewilding (GB) in the June 15 G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot last time. "We were a little disappointed at Ascot, and we thought Twice Over would run a lot better than he did," said racing manager Teddy Grimthorpe. "He has come out of the race fine, and he has been training really well and enthusiastically, so we thought a little drop down in grade would be a confidence booster. There are never any gimmes in this game, and there are some good horses in there, but we hope that the race will set up nicely for him. He was second to Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the [G1] Juddmonte International over the course and distance last year, so he knows the place.

Following a pair of handicap defeats, **Dominant** regained the winning habit in his most recent outing when surging to a five-length score in the £150,000 Tattersalls Millions 3-y-o Cup at Newmarket June 25. "He seems to have taken his last run at Newmarket in his stride, and I've been pleased with his work," said trainer Roger Varian. "He's on a high official rating now, and we want to keep him at 10 furlongs for the time being. There are limited options, but at some point you've got to dip your toe in the water at this level. I'm quite happy with his condition, and we'll see how we get on. York is a good fair track and there are not too many runners. On paper the opposition looks a little bit daunting, but he's a 3-year-old who I think is on the upgrade."

As his odds would suggest, three-time Grade I winner **Winchester** towers over this bunch if ready, or close to ready, off the break. The Firestone homebred, who dropped jaws with a 7 1/2-length triumph in the 2008 GI Secretariat S. over this turf course in his U.S. debut for Dermot Weld, recaptured that promising form last season with scores in the GI Manhattan H. in June over stablemate Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) and in the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Invitational S. in October. The bay was fourth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Nov. 6, and last raced in Hong Kong, finishing 11th in the G1 Hong Kong Vase Dec. 12. "He's not ready to give his best yet," trainer Christophe Clement admitted to *Daily Racing Form*. "The race will set him up perfectly for him to give his best next time."

RACETRACK Round-Up

'Mo' Heads Back to Track...

Mike Repole's champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) returned to the track yesterday morning for his first breeze since May. The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero was forced out of the GI Kentucky Derby with a subsequently diagnosed case of cholangiohepatitis. After recovering from the liver condition at WinStar Farm's state-of-the-art facility in Kentucky, he arrived in Saratoga July 11 having gained 100 pounds. Uncle Mo covered three furlongs yesterday in :38.40 under exercise rider Patti Krotenko on Saratoga's main track shortly after 6 a.m., galloping out four panels in :51.62. "It was perfect," said conditioner Todd Pletcher. "I told Patti to go between :37 and :39, and he went in :38 2/5 and galloped out in :51, so it was exactly what we were hoping for today." Repole added, "He's a different horse. He's the horse he was when he was a 2-year-old. He's been here for over a week now and gained five more pounds with heavy training. His blood work keeps improving every single day, which is great. It's nice to see him out there." Last year's leading owner for the Saratoga meet continued, "It's kind of déjà vu," he added. "Last time I saw him running down the stretch at Saratoga he was winning by 14 1/2 lengths in his maiden, and today it looked like there was a horse 15 lengths behind him. It's a good day. It feels like I won a big race today and it was only a three-furlong work." Repole and Pletcher hope to have their star back for the seven-furlong GI Foxwoods King's Bishop S. Aug. 27. Uncle Mo was last seen finishing third as a heavy favorite in the Apr. 9 GI Resorts World New York Casino Wood Memorial at Aqueduct. It was the colt's first loss in five starts.

Overdriven Has Big Shoes to Fill...

Mike Repole's **Overdriven** (Tale of the Cat) will have big shoes to fill at what should be a very short price when he contests Sunday's GII Sanford S. at Saratoga. The Repole Stable colorbearer earned a 100 Beyer Speed Figure for his Belmont debut July 1, besting well-regarded J C's Pride (Henny Hughes) by 3 1/2 lengths with another 13 lengths back to the show horse. He will now look to become just the third horse since 2000 to capture this trophy in his second lifetime start. Of the two juveniles previously successful in that endeavor, one was Scat Daddy (Johannesburg). Also trained by Pletcher, Scat Daddy took the 2007 Sanford by a neck at 30 cents on the dollar, and went on to win Grade I races at two and three. As if the shadow cast by that accomplished runner wasn't enough, Pletcher has already been asked to compare Overdriven to Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie), who earned champion juvenile colt honors last year during a season that began with a smashing debut win at the Spa. Uncle Mo had plenty of success in his own second start--he took the GI Champagne S. at Belmont with devastating ease. "I'm not going to make any Uncle Mo comparisons with anybody," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. Of Overdriven's debut, however, he said, "The fractions were very fast. He rated kindly, sat off a hot pace and finished up strongly. It seemed like he had a lot of energy left--pricked his ears when he got to the wire, and galloped out well. He kind of did everything you hoped one would do in his first start. He was professional, he was fast, and he came out of it well."

Hellenic, Dam of BC Winner Islington, Euthanized...

Ballymacoll Stud's blue hen mare **Hellenic (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}--Grecian Sea {Fr}, by Homeric {GB}), whose progeny includes GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf heroine Islington (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), was euthanized July 15 after suffering from severe chronic arthritis, according to the nursery's website. She was 24. Unplaced as a 2-year-old in 1989, Hellenic flourished at three, winning the G1 Yorkshire Oaks and G2 Ribblesdale S., and finishing second against the boys in the G1 St. Leger for trainer Sir Michael Stoute. Hellenic was equally effective in the broodmare shed. Her first three foals earned black-type and included Group 1 winner and German highweight Greek Dance (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and stakes winner Election Day (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Put to Sadler's Wells again, she produced Islington in 1999. That filly collected four Group 1s in total, including two renewals of the Yorkshire Oaks and the G1 Nassau S. Hellenic also produced G1 Prix de Saint-Cloud winner Mountain High (Ire) (Danehill) and the Group 3 winner New Morning (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Hellenic's last reported foal is the unraced 3-year-old Justlookdontouch (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). Ballymacoll has retained four of Hellenic's daughters, including Islington, Desert Beauty (Ire) (Green Desert), Olympienne (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and La Divina (Ire) (Sadler's Wells).

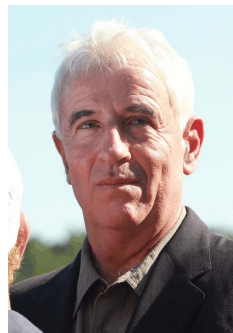

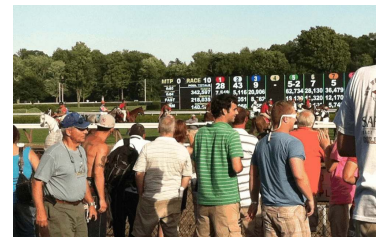

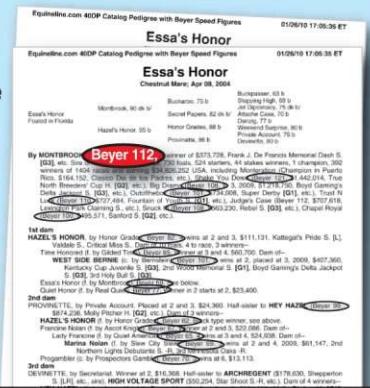

Cali To Void Claims for On-Track Fatalities:

Traditionally, if a horse is claimed, the new connections take ownership regardless of whether the horse finishes the race or not. In a new rule passed by the California Horse Racing Board, that is about to change. On Thursday, the board ruled that claims on horses who die during a race or require euthanization before returning to be unsaddled will be voided. The measure will be enacted in the coming months, reports *Daily Racing Form*. Statistics presented at Thursday's meeting show the issue isn't raised often. From the beginning of 2007 through Sept. 1, 2010, only six claims were registered on horses who suffered mortal injuries. Thoroughbred races at Los Alamitos were not included in the statistics. The *Form* points out, however, that official track veterinarians often prefer to load injured horses onto a track ambulance and take them back to the trainer's barn, if possible, so a thorough diagnosis can be made. The measure passed by a 5-2 margin.
