PAULS MILL STALLIONS HEAD TO WINSTAR

The four stallions currently standing at Pauls Mill, headed by top sophomore sire **Bellamy Road** (Concerto), will stand at Kenny Troutt's WinStar Farm in 2012, it was announced Friday. Rounding out the group are sophomore **Artie Schiller** (El Prado {Ire}); MGISW **Summer Bird** (Birdstone), with first foals of 2012; and European champion **US Ranger** (Danzig), whose first crop was foaled this year. WinStar has acquired interests in the quartet, and Ben Walden, owner of the Pauls Mill operation, will continue to hold shares in the stallions. "We are extremely excited about these four

young stallion prospects, which Ben Walden has already done a fabulous job developing," said Troutt. "Ben has a God-given talent to see the potential in a young stallion prospect, and Bellamy Road is his latest success story. Ben will stay involved and continue to have a significant interest in all of these stallions' futures." Bellamy Road is the sire of GI Wood Memorial S. winner Toby's Corner, GII Schuylerville S. winner Georgie's Angel and GIII Eight Belles S. heroine Victoria's Wildcat this year. "It will be rewarding to see the work we have begun with these four stallions meld into the exciting future of WinStar," said Walden. "I look forward to serving them going

forward as WinStar seeks future opportunities in the stallion business." He added, "Bellamy Road is a sensational young stallion. What more could he have done to now? Artie Schiller was truly a top miler and we're seeing his first crop of 3-year-olds flourish like we expected them to. When I think of Summer Bird, I think of his extraordinary physique, which most top stallions possess, and his exceptional female family includes Tapit.

DANDY GROUP OF SEVEN AT THE SPA

Sophomores take centerstage in today's GII Jim Dandy S. at Saratoga. Mike Repole's **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) returns to action following a game runner-up finish at 16-1 in the GI Belmont S. June 11. "He's been taking a backseat to Uncle Mo," trainer Todd Pletcher said of the GIII Gotham S. hero. "But he can do a lot for himself by stepping up in the Jim Dandy, and the Travers." Pin Oak Stable's **Alternation** (Distorted Humor), a game winner of the GII Peter Pan S. May 14, bypassed the final leg of the Triple Crown in favor of the Jim Dandy. "We backed off after the Peter Pan and let him relax for a couple of weeks," trainer Donnie Von Hemel commented. "We then got back in business and put some in company works and some longer distances just to make sure we had everything ready to go." Live Oak Plantation homebred **Brilliant Speed** (Dynaformer), winner of the GI Blue Grass S. Apr. 16, emerges from a good third in the Belmont. "When I see my horses training as well as he has, I'm confident they're going to run well," Tom Albertrani revealed. "He's come back with three works since the Belmont, and we're pretty pleased with him. Hopefully, the Jim Dandy will be a steppingstone to the Travers." *Field, p3*

Midday (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) bids to become the first to win three renewals of the G1 Nassau S., having easily dealt with the high-class Rainbow View (Dynaformer) in 2009 and Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger})

last year. Five times a top-level winner and not out of the first two on her last nine starts, the brilliant Juddmonte stalwart had been under consideration for last Saturday's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. before Workforce (GB) (King's Best) was committed to that test. She was second to St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the June 3

G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom and, despite being put firmly in her place by Misty For Me when six-lengths second in the G1 Pretty Polly S. at The Curragh last time June 25, connections are expecting her to rebound from that disappointing reversal. "Misty For Me ran a super race and is a very talented filly, but we were slightly scratching our heads as we thought we could have done better," Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said. "We're in the same mindset as we were going to Ireland, because we're very confident. She has come out of it brilliantly and is in really good form and is moving great. She obviously loves and thrives at Goodwood. Last year she quickened twice, which is quite rare in a Group 1 race, so we are hopeful." Misty For Me was a late scratching yesterday due to the drying-out track conditions. Ed Dunlop puts forward **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab), who completes a fascinating trio of star distaffers as she bids to add to her similarly impressive tally of four Group 1 wins. Last year's G1 English and Irish Oaks, G1 QEII Cup and G1 Hong Kong Cup heroine was fourth in the G1 Eclipse S. on her belated return at Sandown July 2, and her conditioner is certain that she will have improved off that effort.

"Snow Fairy has come on a lot for her run in the Eclipse at Sandown, where she just got tired after such a long absence," he commented. "She blew for 45 minutes afterwards, but she worked fantastic on Tuesday morning under Ryan Moore and, though it is disappointing that he cannot ride, we are lucky to have Frankie. He has not ridden the filly before, but she is straightforward and, while it is a very hot race, we are going there to win, and the ground will be perfect." Patrick Cooper, racing manager to owner Cristina Patino, added, "Snow Fairy worked very well the other day, and [trainer] Ed [Dunlop] has been very pleased with her. We were delighted with her run at Sandown, and it was just nice to see her on the racecourse after seven months off. She started last season at Goodwood, so the course holds no fears." Sir Michael Stoute currently ties with Sir Henry Cecil with a record seven winners of this race and relies on **Crystal Capella (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), who took apart her rivals in the G2 Princess of Wales's S. over 12 furlongs on rain-softened ground at Newmarket last time July 7.

"She can be quite tricky to train and she has a mind of her own. She has done everything with relative ease, but it is a huge step into Grade I competition." The aforementioned Aviate enters off a disappointing sixth as the 3-2 chalk in Belmont's GI Just a Game S. over a "good" course June 11. "We feel that firm turf is a little better for her," trainer Bill Mott offered. "The ground [in the Just a Game] might have bothered her. It was a little softer than I thought it would be."

EVENLY-MATCHED GROUP IN SAN DIEGO

In a race lacking a standout, the streaking **Kevlar Kid** merits a long look in Del Mar's GII San Diego H. The Warren Williamson colorbearer makes his stakes debut following a pair of optional claiming tallies since the addition of blinkers at Hollywood May 7 and June 17. "He's a free-running horse and I think Chantal [Sutherland] fits him well," trainer Carla Gaines told *Daily Racing Form*. "He always runs big races." Gaines decided to add the hood to Kevlar Kid following a second-place finish to First Dude (Stephen Got Even) in a Santa Anita allowance Apr. 9. "When First Dude ran by him at Santa Anita, he watched the horse go by him and then took off again," Gaines continued. Triple AAA Ranch **Uh Oh Bango**, winner of Golden Gate's GIII Berkeley S. May 30, stretches back out following a fourth-place finish in the GI Triple Bend H. July 2. **Golden Itiz** got back on track in his latest with a sharp seven-furlong allowance score at Hollywood July 10. The 2010 GIII Affirmed H. hero is owned by Jay Em Ess Stable.

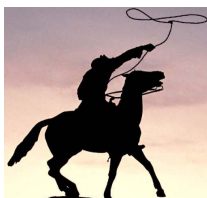

Tizway Had Final Whitney Prep...

William Clifton Jr.'s GI Met Mile H. hero **Tizway** (Tiznow) had his final tune-up for the Aug. 6 GI Whitney Invitational H. Friday morning, going five furlongs in 1:00.23 on the Oklahoma training track at the Spa at first light. Trainer Jim Bond was pleased with the move. "It was just perfect," Bond said. "Everything went according to what we wanted. He went five-eighths in a minute and galloped out in 1:13 and a couple. I had another horse just to press him the last quarter mile, just like I did before the Met Mile, and [Tizway] came home in :23 flat. Everything looks great, and he'll train lightly into the race." Fourth in the 2009 edition of the Whitney, 6-year-old Tizway captured the GII Kelso H. and was third in the Met Mile last year. He opened this term with third-place efforts in the GII Gulfstream Park H. Mar. 12 and the GIII Charles Town Classic Apr. 16 before reeling off the mile in 1:32 4/5 in the May 30 Met Mile last time out. A win or a second in the \$750,000 Whitney would put the dark bay's earnings over \$1 million.

De Francis Dash Back on Maryland Calendar...

Following a one-year hiatus, the Frank J. De Francis Dash S. is officially back on the books after the Maryland Jockey Club unveiled Laurel Park's fall stakes schedule yesterday. A Grade I race when won by Vineyard Haven (Lido Palace {Chi}) in 2009, the six-furlong event lost its graded status when it wasn't contested in 2010, but will still be one of the highlights of the 27 scheduled stakes races worth nearly \$2.3 million at Laurel.

Four of the previous 19 winners of the De Francis Dash--Housebuster (1991), Cherokee Run (1994), Smoke Glacken (1997) and Thor's Echo (2006)--earned an Eclipse Award as champion sprinter. The race is set for Saturday, Oct. 22. "It is important to have open stakes races to bolster our daily average purse distribution, which will be \$185,000," said Maryland Jockey Club president Tom Chuckas. "Last year, all 19 stakes races were for Maryland-bred or Maryland-sired runners. To build the business from a handle standpoint, our races have to be more attractive to the simulcast players. Adding the De Francis Dash to the schedule gives us instant credibility, while five of the other seven are scheduled for the turf and that almost guarantees large fields." Laurel's 68-day fall meeting begins Friday, Sept. 9 and runs through Saturday, Dec. 17. Also featured during the meeting is the Jim McKay Maryland Million on Saturday, Oct. 1. The Maryland Jockey Club made the announcement after reaching an agreement with both the Maryland Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association and Maryland Horse Breeders Association. The schedule was approved by the Maryland Racing Commission early Friday afternoon at its monthly meeting.

Always traveling easily while stalking the fast early fractions, all was going to plan until the bay was carried wide by the errant Bogart (GB) (Bahamian Bounty {GB}) inside the final quarter. Once rid of that rival, he swooped on Bannock passing the eighth pole en route to an authoritative success, justifying the yard's hype. Jockey Richard Hughes was impressed afterwards. "It was a very good performance and he has a lot of class," he said. "I was losing ground at a vital stage when I was carried wide, so I had to quicken to get by him, and when he did, he changed gear and went again. I don't like to compare horses, but his piece of work in Herridge the other morning was as good as Canford Cliffs did as a two-year-old. He's a nice, big tall horse, so he's going to do a lot better physically." Trainer Richard Hannon added, "We've always thought he was a very good horse and when he goes further, he'll be even better. He's definitely one of the best we've got and he'll stay seven very easily--he's a big, strong fine horse and there is no reason why he won't be going a mile next year. He's a very hard horse to get in front of. Richard [Hughes] said he would have won by four or five lengths if he hadn't been inconvenienced. I suspect we'll be heading for a Group 1 next and stay at a trip that suits him this year."

Drunken Sailor went from racing around the Irish circuits for Paul Flynn to the sunshine of Dubai after joining Luca Cumani at the start of last year and showed immediate improvement to capture two handicaps at Meydan. Maintaining that progression back in Britain, his best effort came when scooping the Listed March S. over 14 furlongs here in August before backtracking with unplaced efforts in the G3 Geelong Cup in October and G3 Queen's Cup at Flemington the following month. After another spell back at Meydan, the bay returned to spreadeagle the field in Newbury's Listed Aston Park S. May 14 before running third behind Await the Dawn (Giant's Causeway) in the G2 Hardwicke S. at Royal Ascot last time June 18. Held up in last initially, he crept up the rail to deny the warring Harris Tweed and Jukebox Jury in the final strides. "This is one of my favourite horses," Kieren Fallon said. "He's got so much ability and has done nothing but improve since coming to Luca's yard--I've never ridden a horse who has improved so much in such a short space of time. You just have to time it right with him, because when he gets to the front he thinks he has done enough and idles. He's getting better and better and loves this fast ground. At Newbury, I got there too soon but he was much better than the rest and was able to maintain it and at Ascot last time, the ground was too soft for him and he couldn't quicken on it, but he still ran a great race. He did nothing wrong today and we got a lucky run up the inside and it all unfolded for him." Trainer Luca Cumani is looking at a tilt at the G1 Melbourne Cup at Flemington Nov. 1.

AMERICAN GRADED STAKES COMMITTEE RULING

STARS AND STRIPES S.: In accord with American Graded Stakes Committee policy, the July 23, 2011, renewal of the GIII Stars and Stripes S., scheduled for the Arlington Park turf course, but switched to the main track, was automatically downgraded to ungraded status. 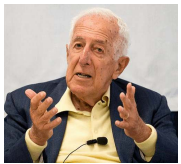

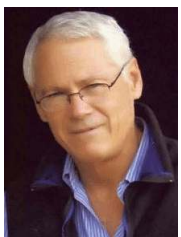
Chicago native purchased the former Greentree Stud property in Ocala, FL in 1966, and had his first stakes win at Hawthorne the following year. Top runners campaigned by Glen Hill include MGSW & MGISP Relaunch (In Reality), GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner and homebred One Dreamer (Relaunch) and, more recently, MGSW Banned (Kitten's Joy)--also bred by Glen Hill. Lavin's grandson Craig Bernick took over as president and CEO of Glen Hill in 2008, and has set out to revitalize the farm. The operation owns about 25 mares and has a total horse population of around 120. Tom Proctor trains all Glen Hill colorbearers.



Lori & George Hall

K & G STABLES - Pants on Fire K & G Stables is the original nom de course of George and Lori Hall, who now race under their own names. The initials "K" and "G" are for the Hall's first two children, Kathryn and George, Jr. George Hall is the president, founder and majority shareholder of Clinton Group Inc., an investment company. The Halls, who live in

Rumson, NJ, got involved in racing in 2004 with the purchase of four yearlings. With their private trainer Kelly Breen, they have campaigned GI Kentucky Derby starters West Side Bernie (Bernstein), Atomic Rain (Smart Strike) and Pants On Fire (Jump Start), ninth in this year's Derby. The Halls own the 385-acre Annetes Farm in Versailles, KY, where they keep seven broodmares. Their racing string consists of 24 horses.



Rob Whiteley

LIBERATION FARM & BRANDYWINE FARM - Ruler On Ice Liberation Farm is the commercial breeding operation of Rob Whiteley. Whiteley, who grew up in Chula Vista, CA, earned a master's degree from Harvard and a Ph. D in psychology from UC Berkeley. It was while looking for a break from the daily stress of the doctorate program that he became a racing fan. He moved to NJ to

join the graduate department at Rutgers University, and established the first Liberation Farm in NJ, beginning a modest breeding operation. After more than a dozen years in academia, Whiteley was hired by Fasig-Tipton to head up the appraisals division, then was tabbed by Carl Icahn to develop and manage Icahn's commercial breeding venture Foxfield. During his 18-year run at Foxfield, he planned the matings of horses like Better Than Honour (Deputy Minister) and Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy). He went out on his own after Icahn got out of the breeding business in 2005.

Haskell Breeders cont.

Through Liberation, he has bred or co-bred GISWs El Corredor (Mr. Greeley), Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus) (Ruler On Ice's sire) and Henny Hughes (Hennessy). Pam and Jim Robinson breed and sell under the banner Brandywine Farm. They typically co-breed over 100 mares with Liberation annually. The Robinsons bought their first horses when they married in 1971. Pam taught at the University of North Carolina before they moved to Kentucky in 1999. Jim was an electrical engineer at GTE.



Dr. Gary Knapp

MONTICULE - Joe Vann Monticule is a 550-acre farm located in Lexington, KY. Founder Dr. Gary Knapp became interested in racing while attending the University of Kentucky during Secretariat's Triple Crown run in 1973 and, after teaching at the University of Houston and founding a mortgage-backed securities firm, he returned to Kentucky and purchased the original 200-acre Monticule property in 1989. Knapp purchased part of the consulting firm Equix, a company that specializes in Thoroughbred biomechanics, in 2003. He is also associated with www.casetherace.com, a site that applies biomechanical data to handicapping. Monticule's broodmare band consists of about 20 mares, most notably Mien (Nureyev), the dam of champion Big Brown (Boundary).



Jess Jackson & Barbara Banke

STONESTREET STABLES - Astrology Stonestreet is the stable name of Jess Jackson, who passed away in April at age 81, and his wife, Barbara Banke. After a successful career as an attorney, Jackson bought the 80-acre Santa Rosa, CA, property that would become the Kendall-Jackson vineyard in 1974, and began selling under the Kendall-Jackson label in 1982. A longtime fan of racing, he became heavily involved in 2003, campaigning Horses of the Year Curlin and Rachel Alexandra. Jackson purchased the former Buckram Oak Farm near Lexington in 2005, and also acquired properties from Adena Springs in Versailles, KY, and Ocala, FL. Stonestreet, named after his father, was the leading breeder of sales yearlings by total sales dollars in North America in 2010. Jackson bought Quiet Eclipse (Quiet American) for \$1.6-million at Keeneland November in 2007 while she was carrying Astrology.

Highclere's Managing Director Harry Herbert told *PA Sport*, "We have no idea why it happens. She doesn't worry, she doesn't fret, she doesn't sweat, she came out at Salisbury in a test during racing at Salisbury the other day. She flew out at home yesterday. It's bizarre. She seems to know when it's a proper race day. That's enough of that. She will come back to Highclere. She is a very talented filly and a lovely-looking filly. Her half-sister [Remember Alexander] looks like being one of the best 2-year-old fillies in Ireland. As a December Sales filly, hopefully she will be in great demand, but for the syndicate it's such a disappointment knowing how good she is and not seeing that potential fulfilled. You can't take away last year at Royal Ascot and Newmarket. She was a brilliant filly, but has her own mind." In all, Memory was the winner of three of her seven starts and over £85,000 in prize money.
