As 13-10 favorite **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) disappointed in seventh, it was left to the filly to upstage the colts with a devastating display. The

bay was settled in last early by a confident Thierry Jarnet, and moved up with menacing authority wide of the field as the action unwound in front. After swamping **Society Rock (Ire)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) inside the final furlong, she drew away to score by four lengths, with the former triple winner **Marchand d'Or (Fr)** (Marchand de Sable) finishing strongly up the stand's rail to be a further neck back in third. came from the clouds to deny the 7-4 favorite **Power (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) and cause a 33-1 shock in the G1 Keeneland Phoenix S. at The Curragh Sunday. With Power looking gone beyond recall inside the final furlong, only Declan McDonogh was making a move and once La Collina was extricated

from the pack she cut down the Ballydoyle hope in the final yards for a neck success. "She's a very good 2-year-old and today was a true test," McDonogh said. "The boss said to me that the fillies were better than the colts this year and he might be right." **Cont. p4**

**F-T SARATOGA SALE STARTS TODAY**

The Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings Sale begins its two-day run this evening in the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion, with the first of 160 catalogued yearlings scheduled to enter the sales ring at 7 p.m. Last year, 117 yearlings grossed \$32,415,000. The average of \$277,051 fell 15.6% from the 2009 figure, while the median held steady at \$250,000. Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning is looking for some improvement in the 2011 figures. "We hope that we have some potential upward movement in the average, and we also hope that we continue to have a high percentage of horses sold, which is another key indicator," Browning said. The buy-back rate a year ago was 28.6%. The Saratoga sale follows in the wake of a strong renewal of Fasig's July yearling sale. Browning is cautiously optimistic that trend will continue. "I thought our July sale was solid," he said. "There is certainly interest. People want to be rational on what they spend, but overall I thought there was an increase in interest in buying horses in July, as compared to 2010. It was a modest increase, but there seemed to be more enthusiasm." **Cont. p13**

Moonlight Cloud's natural ability was signposted with a facile 2 1/2-length debut win at Deauville, followed by a six-length verdict over Longchamp's seven panels in September. Rated better at that point than her esteemed stable companion Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) by Freddy Head, she took her chance in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on Arc day, but failed to fire as Wootton Bassett (GB) (Iffraaj {GB}) dominated, staying on into fourth. Back with a bang in the G3 Prix Imprudence over seven at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 7, the homebred was only seventh behind Blue Bunting (Dynaformer) in the May 1 Newmarket mile Classic, after which her trainer looked at dropping her in trip. Second to Sahpresa (Sahm) in Longchamp's G3 Prix du Palais-Royal back over seven furlongs June 4, she was more positively ridden over that course and distance in Longchamp's G3 Prix de la Porte Maillot over seven furlongs July 2, and held on by a diminishing head to set up a tilt at this prize.

Anchored early as the pace proved strong, she was out of trouble trailing the main pack. Dream Ahead, buried in the main pack by William Buick, started to flounder with a quarter mile remaining, but Strawbridge's white silks barely rippled as Thierry Jarnet and Moonlight Cloud cruised past him. Wootton Bassett began to tread water on the front end, and Society Rock ground his way into contention, but the filly was shaken up approaching the furlong pole, and her dramatic acceleration saw her surge into a decisive advantage. After receiving one slap with the whip, she was pushed out for a commanding success. In the process, she became the first 3-year-old filly to win this race since Dead Certain (GB) (Absalom {GB}) scored when it still had Group 2 status in 1990. "I was really disappointed that she ran a bad race in the Guineas, as I always said she was a top-class filly, and I never lost faith in her," Head offered, adding, "The obvious race is the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 2], but I hadn't made any plans before this so I'm not sure." Dream Ahead's trainer David Simcock said of the favorite, "I'm not making excuses, as when the gap came he didn't quicken, but he seems fine so the plan is still to run in the [Sept. 3] G1 Haydock Sprint Cup."

**Cloud Nine for Strawbridge...**

Moonlight Cloud was produced by SP Ventura (Ire), from the family of champion and Classic Derby winner Generous (Ire) (Caerleon) and G1 Epsom Oaks and G1 1000 Guineas winner Imagine (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), dam of G1SW Horatio Nelson (Ire) (Danehill). Ventura was a hot prospect at the 2001 Tattersalls December Sale, and owner/breeder George Strawbridge went to 500,000gns (\$748,177) to secure the then-3-year-old as a broodmare prospect. Ventura's first foal, Cedar Mountain (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), aired in the Round Table S. and was second in the GII Sunset H. at Hollywood for Strawbridge. Strawbridge sent Ventura back to TATDEC in 2009, where she sold for 58,000gns to Cormac McCormack Bloodstock. She produced a filly by Manduro (Ger) for breeder Paget Bloodstock in Ireland in 2010, was sold to David Redvers Bloodstock for 260,000gns at TATDEC 2010, and had a filly by Montjeu (Ire) in March.

Sean Avery earned a 112 Beyer when taking the June 5 Longfellow S. by 11 3/4 lengths at Monmouth Park, and he proved that performance was no fluke here. Two-for-four for trainer Mike Hushion during his abbreviated sophomore season, the bay was back at the track for a few months last term, posting a series of works between June 15 and Aug. 1. But he didn't get back on track until returning to take an optional claimer at Gulfstream Apr. 15 for Allen Iwinski after nearly 17 months on the shelf. The gelding made it two in a row in a Parx allowance test May 8, and added the Longfellow romp to make it three straight. Second as the 1-2 chalk in the Mr. Prospector S. at Monmouth July 4, he was the second-longest shot on the board stepping up to the Grade I ranks.

The Saratoga strip, listed as good after overnight rains, was speed-favoring, and jockey Joe Bravo took full advantage of that fact. Bravo sent Sean Avery to the front through rapid splits of :21.91 and :44.56. Odds-on Trappe Shot was inching ever closer as they drove down the lane, but Sean Avery held on to get the nod. It was the first Grade I win for Allen Iwinski, who gave up training for two years while battling hepatitis in the mid-2000s. "The race itself was just so exciting," Iwinski said. "Going right down to the wire, head-and-head. Are we going to get there? Are we beat? He just hung in." Sean Avery was in Iwinski's barn for his lone start at two, a third in maiden special weight company at Saratoga. "The owners called me up in Florida and asked if I wanted Sean back," Iwinski said. "Do you have to ask that question? So they sent him to me, and he was training fabulous. He was rehabilitated with Lynn Boutee in Ocala, Florida. When she sent the horse to me, he quickly came to hand. We worked him maybe four times off a 15-month layoff, so she really did most of the work and the preparation for his comeback." Black Swan is a partnership headed by John DeStefano that includes Sheryl Schwartz, the wife of Barry K. Schwartz. The Vanderbilt winner was named for the New York Rangers hockey player.

Supplemented for this valuable prize this week, Dancing Rain never looked in any danger of surrendering the early advantage crafted out by Kieren Fallon and led her rivals on a merry dance to become the Classic's first British-trained winner. Connections had learned much about the chestnut when she was second in the Listed Swettenham Stud Fillies' Trial S. at Newbury May 13 and more forcing tactics were employed in the G1 Epsom Oaks. That ploy led to Classic glory in the June 3 highlight, but when she was unable to get to the front in the July 18 Irish equivalent at The Curragh she could fare no better than fifth. In front before the first bend here, she was sent to sleep by Fallon and lobbed along before being asked to increase the tempo three furlongs from home. Turning the screw from there, she was clear up the straight as Djumama made her way into the silver medal spot. Her win capped a red-letter day for her dam Rain Flower (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), who is also the second dam of the G2 Debutante S. winner Maybe (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}). "Everything went according to plan," said Fallon. "I got to the front easily enough and in the end the German fillies weren't good enough to catch her." The runner-up's trainer Andreas Lowe commented, "Djumama ran a great race and had the winner not been supplemented, she could be a Classic winner now."

La Collina started out with a defeat of Mahaazen (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in an extended seven-furlong maiden at Limerick June 11 before finding only Maybe a neck too strong in the Silver Flash. Half an hour after that rival had advertised that form when extending her unbeaten record in style in the Debutante, the punters were still ignoring the Kevin Prendergast trainee who raced in rear early. The early pace was genuine as Seamus Heffernan ensured that Power gave Lilbourne Lad (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) no peace on the front end along with Parish Hall (Ire) (Teofilo {Ire}). With the gaps closing on the rail and the 10-3 second choice Frederick Engels (GB) (Iceman {GB}) running into a race-stopping dead-end there, Declan McDonogh switched La Collina out as Power set sail for home. That runner established a clear lead passing the furlong marker, but the filly was hitting top gear and dived up his inner with an impressive spell of acceleration. "She has certainly lifted us out of the doldrums and was unlucky at Leopardstown, as there wasn't a lot of pace on, but today they went hard and it suited her down to the ground," McDonogh explained. "I got outpaced early, so I just let her find her feet and although I met a bit of traffic at halfway I was lucky, as I never really got stopped. When I switched her out, I got a clear run and going down the inside at the end was the winning of it. She's all heart and if you don't have temperament, you have nothing and she has it in abundance."

Tar Heel Mom won optional claimers over the Spa surface in 2008 and 2009, but hadn't raced here since finishing fifth in the GI Ballerina S. two years ago. The dark bay captured the GII Distaff H. at Aqueduct and hit the board in all six starts last term, and had been first or second in five of her six appearances this term, with wins in the Jan. 15 GIII Sugar Swirl S. and Apr. 17 Harmony Lodge S. at Gulfstream Park, and the May 18 Nany S. at Belmont Park. **DEAUVILLE 2YOs TO THE FORE**



Two-year-olds bought from last year's **ARQANA** August yearling sale have been very prominent this spring. Several have even already showed Classic potential, notably the unbeaten filly **MAYBE**. The daughter of Galileo out of Sumora (Danehill) impressed on her debut at Naas, winning by four and a half lengths.

Michael Tabor's filly then faced the starter in the **L. 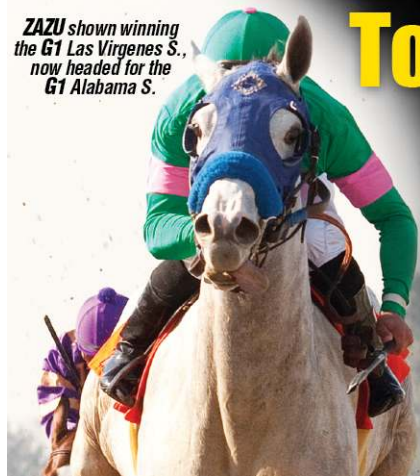

The chalk bided his time towards the front half of the body of the field as a pair of longshots opened up a double-digit lead through easy splits. The leaders ran out of gas before the quarter pole, and Pender Harbour waited for a seam behind a wall of challengers. Contreras tipped his mount out in the lane, and Pender Harbour made his bid on the outside. Celtic Conviction, who'd bumped with Crown's Path to his inside as they drove to the wire, straightened out and fought back, but couldn't hold off the winner, and lost another placing at the hands of the stewards .

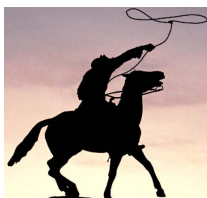

## Horse of the Year Campaign for Tizway...

Trainer Jim Bond, still basking in the glow of his win in the GI Whitney Invitational H. with **Tizway** (Tiznow), said he believed the 6-year-old has a solid shot at Horse

of the Year honors. "If he wins the [Oct. 1 GI Jockey Club] Gold Cup, I feel like he's 2-1 to be the leader," said Bond. "When you win the Met in the time that he did it and the way that he did it, and come back with a pretty crushing race [Saturday], if he can win the Gold Cup it's going to take a really good horse to

outshine him at the end of the year, as long as he stays together." Tizway stopped the timer in 1:32 4/5 when taking the GI Met Mile H. May 30. Criminal Type (Alydar) pulled off the Met Mile/Whitney double in 1990, and was named Horse of the Year. Only one horse, In Excess (Ire) (Siberian Express), has annexed both races since, but he lost out on the title to GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Black Tie Affair (Ire) (Miswaki). Explaining the dark bay's emergence as the top older horse on the East Coast at an age when most top runners have been retired, Bond said that the foot problems that have plagued Tizway are no longer an issue. The conditioner is so confident in his charge's soundness, he has mapped out his training regimen for the next two months. "Believe it or not, I've already booked his works through the Gold Cup," said Bond. "This morning, I was here at 3:30 [plotting out the morning schedule]. When you can do that with a horse, you've got a big edge. When you gotta say, 'Well, today, we've got to jog. We can't do this--things aren't good enough,' it makes a big difference, especially when you are running against Grade I-type fields."

## Bated Breath is Nunthorpe-bound...

Trainer Roger Charlton yesterday pointed at the G1 Coolmore Nunthorpe S. for Khalid Abdullah's **Bated Breath** (GB) (Dansili {GB}). Runner-up to Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 9, the four-year-old will drop to five furlongs for the first time in the Aug. 19 York contest. "We're aiming at the Nunthorpe," his trainer said. "Last time was definitely a step up, but he was beaten by a better horse on the day. I got the feeling that he could have gone a stride quicker, so dropping back to five and being able to bowl along and go his pace might well suit him at York."

## Morning Line to Undergo Tests...

GISW **Morning Line** (Tiznow), who trailed the field home after pressing the pace in the GI Whitney Invitational H., will be the subject of a complete veterinary examination this week, and then likely will head to owner Will Farish's Lane's End Farm in Kentucky. "That's the best farm in the world, and maybe they can further evaluate him, take him to Dr. [Larry] Bramlage and see what he says," said trainer Nick Zito. "He's obviously not right. We have to figure out what is it. I know they'll make a good decision." The 4-year-old captured the GI Carter H. in April, but was off the board in two subsequent outings. "Obviously, he's not the same horse," said Zito. "We're all disappointed, the stable's all disappointed." He added, "What's upsetting to me is, I know how good the horse is. He had five great races in a row, from the [win in the GII] Pennsylvania Derby on. And the Carter was spectacular." Morning Line was briefly sidelined by a foot problem that surfaced after a workout at Churchill following the Carter. "We X-rayed him, and we thought we were getting by that," Zito explained. "We went to Monmouth, and obviously he's not the same since that issue."

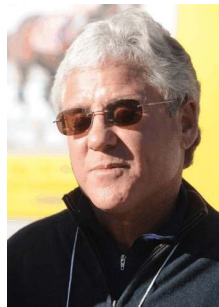

Craig Bendoroff, whose Denali Stud has consigned 10 yearlings to the Fasig-Tipton Saratoga Selected Yearlings Sale, shares the view that there are buyers for the right product.

“Good horses have been selling well and, as long as there is no change in people wanting good horses, than I’ve got to be optimistic because I really think that this is one of the strongest groups that I’ve ever brought here,” Bendoroff said.

With only 160 yearlings catalogued and selling spread over two nights, the Saratoga sale is all about quality over quantity, according to Boyd Browning.

“I think people are looking for quality horses,” he explained. “And I think they are going to find a high number of quality horses out of the catalogue in Saratoga. I think a large percentage of the horses in this catalogue will make a lot of short lists. There isn’t a huge catalogue, but there will be a huge percentage of horses that people will find attractive.”

This year’s catalogue is slimmer by 42 head from the 2010 version. Browning attributed the reduction to both a smaller foal crop and a stringent selection process.

“I think we all continue to try to be demanding and disciplined in the horses that we accept for the sales and I think our consignors try to be very disciplined in the horses that they send to the sales to try to minimize the mistakes,” Browning commented. “Because if you make a mistake in the world that we’re playing in right now, you pay a significant penalty, so

everyone is trying hard to get it right. The bull’s eye might continue to be shrinking, and maybe we’ll get a little reversal of that beginning in 2011, but thus far that bull’s eye has certainly not gotten any bigger and continues to be very hard to pinpoint.”

The two-day format with so few horses on offer, may be a deterrent to some people.

“Now, some people don’t want to pay the expenses and make the trip to Saratoga,” acknowledged Glencrest Farm’s David Greathouse. “It would be nice if they had more horses to draw more people.”

Still Browning, is satisfied with the sale’s format.

“We’ve got a format that we’re happy with and that has proven popular through the test of time,” he explained. “We’re comfortable with it.”

Browning is confident the strength of the sale will be borne out in time.

“We hope that people are picking up a catalogue in 2013 and saying, ‘Wow, look at all those good horses that were graduates of the 2011 Saratoga sale. They were right, they had a hell of a group of horses up there. I should have bid again. Wish I hadn’t quit,’” Browning said.

**BARRY HILLS RETIRES** Barry Hills, one of the top 10 trainers in England for four decades, has announced that he will retire after the York 'Ebor' meeting next week. The 74-year-old

horseman has saddled more than 3,000 winners over 42 seasons. He will hand the reins over to his son Charles, 31, at the end of racing Aug. 21. Barry Hills will continue to serve as an advisor at his Lambourn yard. Starting out as an apprentice rider in the 1950s, Hills went on to serve as head lad for 10 years before going out on his own in 1969. Just four years later, he sent out Rheingold (Ire) to take the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. His first Classic victory came with Enstone Spark (GB) in the 1978 G1 1000 Guineas. In total, he has captured 11 Classics, including the 1000 Guineas, G1 2000 Guineas, G1 Irish 1000 Guineas and G1 Irish Oaks twice, and the G1 Irish Derby once, and more than 25 Group 1 races. **More in Tuesday's TDN.**

**BUFFUM (c, 3, Bernardini--Storm Beauty {MSW, \$178,164}, by Storm Cat),** a \$1.2-million FTSAUG yearling, looked to have a bright future after digging in gamely to take his career bow for trainer Tom Albertrani at Belmont Oct. 30; he was awarded a 96 Beyer Speed Figure for that effort. Treated with Lasix for the GII Remsen S. at Aqueduct Nov. 27, the bay colt backed out of it early and wound up last, beaten 20 lengths in a five-horse field. He joined the Godolphin string in Dubai over the winter and made one appearance, finishing a close fifth in the G3 UAE 2000 Guineas on Meydan's Tapeta surface Feb. 10. Upon his repatriation, the Pennsylvania-bred was fourth in the GIII Bay Shore S. at Aqueduct Apr. 9, and had been working strongly in recent weeks. The 6-5 chalk traveled like a dream down the backstretch as second-choice Bulaga (Orientate) showed the way. He split horses to challenge for the lead entering the stretch, and the race was over in a flash. Jockey David Cohen confidently handled his mount through the lane for a popular 10-length success. Restricted to 3-year-olds who haven't won a stake over a mile on turf this year, the Gleaming features some lightly raced, up-and-coming types. #3 **Eternal Ruler** is very interesting considering that he only fell by a head two back to morning line favorite Seal Cove with a tougher trip--they're listed at 8-1 and 5-2 respectively. Eternal Ruler came to America with a win and a second against weak competition in Britain and debuted stateside for Bobby Ribaudo in race one (8.5fT 'NIX') on the June 11 Belmont Stakes undercard ([TDN Video](#)). Both he and Seal Cove were off slow, but while Seal Cove made a wide, sweeping move to challenge on the turn for home, Rajiv Maragh opted to keep Eternal Ruler inside. Seal Cove's bid was visually impressive, but as he was powering down the center of the course unimpeded, Eternal Ruler was stymied in behind a wall of horses, searching for a seam and tapping on the breaks repeatedly. By the time Eternal Ruler was clear, Seal Cove had already gotten the jump on him, but the import turned on the jets in the waning strides to make it a tight one. Seal Cove covered way more ground, but Eternal Ruler's loss of momentum made the difference in the order of finish. Eternal Ruler was admittedly disappointing last time in a 1 1/4-mile optional claimer back at Big Sandy 18 days after his first appearance--he finished fourth behind today's second-choice Sky Blazer with no trip excuse--but he figured to regress off of that first U.S. effort, as many European imports do. Add to that generalization a glance at Ribaudo's stats, and there's plenty of reason to toss out Eternal Ruler's last race. With a gap of eight to 30 days between starts, Ribaudo wins at a 9% clip with a \$1.42 ROI (all trainer stats courtesy off *DRF Formulator*). When he gives his runners 31-60 days to recover, however, as in this case, the conditioner scores at a 20% rate with a gaudy \$3.94 ROI. Her Storm Cat yearling filly was snapped up by Scott and Joe Ford's Westrock for \$675,000 at KEESEP that year, and they also picked up this filly as a weanling for \$250,000 at KEENOV. Winendynme has a yearling Medicean filly and produced a Street Cry (Ire) filly in May before being bred back to Harlan's Holiday. But there was fun, too. Look, I grew up doing this [in New Mexico]. I knew how to do it and it was fun."

Sutherland added, "Mike rode a really good race. All credit to him. To be honest, I'm glad it is over. There was a lot of pressure around this; a ton of media work leading up to it. But it was fun, too. All in all, I enjoyed it. And the cheers from the fans here today were special. The fans were awesome. That made it all worthwhile."

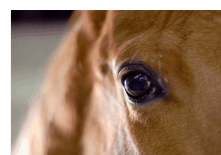
