## STREET BACK TO BETTER GAME IN HOF

Flying Zee Stable's **Street Game** (Street Cry {Ire}) will likely go favored in this afternoon's GII National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame S. as he attempts to rebound from a seventh-place effort as the favorite in the GII Virginia Derby July 16. After running admirably against open company over the winter in Florida, he

defeated fellow New York-breds handily in his next two trips to the post before romping to a 7 1/4-length victory in the GIII Hill Prince S. over a yielding Belmont turf June 18. Although he was able to dictate a moderate

pace at Colonial, he found the final two panels too taxing and will appreciate this turnback in trip. **Benergy** (Tapit)'s Virginia Derby fate was thrust immediately into jeopardy when he was handed the 11 hole in a field of 12, and he sat a wide trip while never reaching serious contention. His draw is far better here, and a repeat of his performance in the GIII Jefferson Cup S., in which he was beaten two lengths by Virginia Derby runner-up and GI Secretariat S. hopeful Banned (Kitten's Joy) can land him a nice chunk of this pot. **Crimson China** (Giant's Causeway) lands here and will be scratched from tomorrow's Secretariat S. He was ridden too close to the pace in the Virginia Derby and was beaten over 10 lengths into seventh, but jockey Rajiv Maragh, who won an entry-level allowance on the colt back in the winter at Gulfstream, should ride him from a bit further back today and let him storm home late.

## HALL OPENS DOORS TO CLASS OF '11

Between morning workouts and the afternoon's live racing program across Union Avenue, the National Museum of Racing Hall of Fame will welcome its class of 2011 at ceremonies to be held at Fasig-Tipton's Humphrey S. Finney Sales Pavilion. The festivities are open to the public on a first come, first seated basis. Television commentator Randy Moss will serve as the master of ceremonies, while celebrity chef and Thoroughbred owner Bobby Flay will deliver the keynote address. The equine class of 2011 includes **Sky Beauty**, whose legend was secured on the New York circuit with nine Grade I wins; GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Safely Kept**; and **Open Mind**, who, like Sky Beauty was a Filly Triple Crown winner when the series consisted of the Acorn, Mother Goose and CCA Oaks. Jerry Hollendorfer, three-time winning trainer of the GI Kentucky Oaks, and within earshot of 6,000 career victories, will also be inducted. Three others were selected by a historic review committee--the horse Duke of Magenta, trainer Matthew Byrnes and jockey Shelby 'Pike' Barnes. Keeneland will produce live coverage of the event, which will be carried by HRTV and streamed online at [www.racingmuseum.org](http://www.racingmuseum.org).

Future Generation, who bagged a valuable distaffers-only handicap at The Curragh June 25, ran 10th in the G3 Brownstown S. at Fairyhouse four days later and was a last-out second in the July 16 G3 Minstrel S. back at The Curragh. Asserting for the lead after a furlong here, she came under ever-increasing pressure off the home turn to repel the persistent threat of Moran Gra and kept enough in reserve to safely hold the late bid of Emiyna for a career high. "She's all heart and is a lovely filly," trainer Ger Lyons told [irishracing.com](#). "She's been improving all summer, and the whole idea was to get black type with her. That was grand, but she wasn't 100% right last time. This looked a very hot race on paper, so I thought I'd declare her and see. When I saw the race I thought she had a chance of winning and I knew she wouldn't let us down. It's nice to win a Group 3 with her, and it's very important for [breeder] Ennistown Stud."

**Stately Victor to Ship in for Pacific Classic...**

**Stately Victor** (Ghostzapper), whose previous best career victory came in the G1 Toyota Blue Grass S. in 2010, has been confirmed a starter in the G1 TVG Pacific Classic, according to trainer Mike Maker. "We'd been thinking about it (Pacific Classic) for awhile and it was a mutual decision with the owners, made June 27, to go ahead," said Maker, who will be coming to Del Mar for the first time. "His last race was a good effort, but unfortunately he had to give a bit of weight." In that most recent appearance, Stately Victor rallied from midpack to be third--albeit a distant one--in the GIII Dominion Day S. over the Woodbine Polytrack, a surface over which he also won the 2010 Ontario Derby. He was giving the victorious Don Cavallo (El Prado {Ire}) some nine pounds on that occasion. Stately Victor is expected to arrive Sunday at Del Mar from Churchill Downs and will be stabled in the barn of Ron Ellis. Mike Smith has the call.

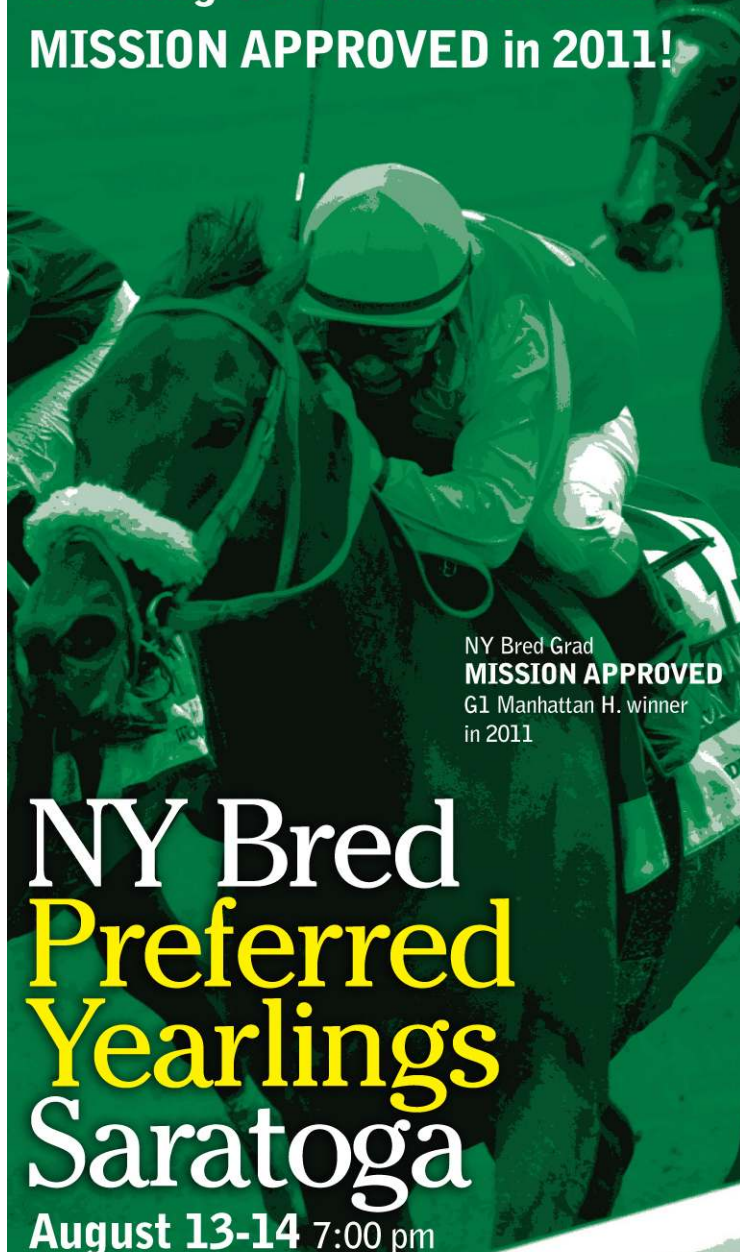

Hall of Famer will hope his next win doesn't take nearly as long and will tighten the girth around longshot **Newsdad** (Arch) in Saturday's \$400,000 event. A maiden winner and third in the GIII Palm Beach S. on turf over the winter, the James Karp homebred was a

deceptively good fourth in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. in April. Third two starts later in the Victoria Park S. over the Woodbine Poly June 12, he exits the July 16 GII Virginia Derby, where he rallied from last after a half-mile to be a respectable fourth, beaten just over six lengths. The blinkers go on for the Secretariat. "He put himself well back in the field and really weren't expecting him to be that far out of it," assistant trainer Rodolphe Brisset said Thursday morning. "That is why the blinkers are going on this time. The Virginia Derby winner made his move inside of us and we had to take the wide journey. We feel the 10 furlongs is the right distance for him." The Jim Bolger trainee turned quite a few heads at the Curragh, in a 6f maiden run on on Irish Guineas day. She

was slowly away from the stalls and looked trapped behind a wall of horses beyond halfway, so that Kevin Manning had to switch around the field to find daylight. When she did, she showed a very smart turn of foot to reel in the leader and win by a head. The daughter of young sire Lawman hasn't been seen out since, yet the form has worked out very well with the 4th placed **REMEMBER ALEXANDER** winning the Gr.3 Tyros Stakes and 5th placed **AFTER** filling the runner-up spot in the Gr.3 Anglesey Stakes. Janey Muddles was bred by Ballylinch Stud, who consigned her at Deauville where she was knocked down for €260,000 to Eamon Reilly from BBA Ireland. Lawman has 4 yearlings in the forthcoming Deauville yearling sale.

Hessonite was an easy winner of a state-bred allowance at Aqueduct in April to kick off the year, and put together a winning streak with a 3 3/4-length success in the New York Stallion Cupecoy's Joy S. June 5. She was a distant third behind Summer Soiree (War Front) when stepped up into graded company for the first time in Monmouth's GIII Boiling Springs S. June 25, and was bet down to favoritism on return here while facing the boys. Unhurried to be second to last in the early going behind splits of :24.63, :49.18 and 1:14.16, the chestnut steadily inched closer approaching the straight. **Soultown** (Vindication) is an intimidating presence coming off a speedy runner-up debut at Arlington July 10 in which he earned a 96 Beyer Speed Figure, but the bay may be susceptible to early pressure. He pressed a hot pace when unveiled, and a pair of very fast bullet drills over the Saratoga strip since changing barns from Donnie Von Hemel to Steve Margolis suggest he'll show early foot again. **Show Me the Way** (Rockport Harbor), **Perfect Slam (Brz)** (Grand Slam) and **Sea Song's Hammer** (Elusive Quality) have all earned quick early Moss Pace Figures in their prior efforts as well, so Soultown won't have an easy time of it. **Rothko** (Arch) is the logical alternative--he ran second on debut at Santa Anita at this distance to the very good Hoorayforhollywood (Storm Cat) with an 88 Beyer, but turned in a dull sixth-place effort as the chalk at Churchill Downs July 4. He might appreciate the turnback, even though his pedigree suggests he should like more ground, but only the winner from his debut has validated the apparent quality of his first race--the rest of that field regressed. Mostly by default, we're left with firster **Plymouth Square** (Graeme Hall). While conditioner Seth Benzel doesn't usually win first out, two of his three successful firsters over the past five season have come at the Spa. And despite winning at just 3% with fresh faces, he has a 28% in-the-money rate, so his runners might be a bit more primed out of the box than meets the eye. The Melnyk homebred is out of GISP Turner's Hall (Forest Wildcat), making him a full-brother to recent Gill Bed o' Roses H. winner Tamarind Hall, and he shows an upbeat recent four-furlong drill at Belmont. **Yesterday's Results:** Tale Untold's expected advantageous pace set-up was tempered by the scratch of two speed horses, and she was well out of it before being eased when an accident occurred in front of her. *For more Saratoga analysis, visit the [TDN Blog](#) or follow Brian on [Twitter](#).*

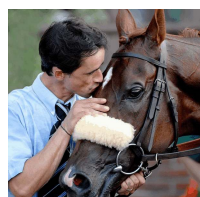

### EMPERORS NATIONAL 2YO SALE KICKS OFF

The 2011 Emperors Palace National 2YO Sale, South Africa's premier juvenile sale, begins its three-day stand today at the Thoroughbred Breeders Association (TBA) complex in Germiston. The sale runs through Sunday. The first two sessions start at 6:00 p.m. (local time), whilst Sunday's action kicks off at 11:00 a.m.

The National 2YO Sale has a long history of producing top-class racehorses. Recent graduates include multiple Group 1 winner The Apache (SAf) (Mogok), winner of the recent G1 Champions Cup and named champion 3-year-old colt at last night's Equus Awards ceremony. The Apache cost just R80 000 (\$11,168) at the National 2YO Sale, and, to date, has earned over R1.6 million in prize money.

The 2YO Sale has also seen a number of outstanding international performers go through the ring. Recent graduates to compete successfully at the highest level on the global stage include River Jetez (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}), Irridescence (SAf) (Caesour) and champion sprinter J J The Jet Plane (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}). The latter was one of the all-time great bargains. "JJ" cost just R70 000 at the 2006 renewal, and has earned over R12 million to date, with his victories include the Hong Kong Sprint and two triumphs in the Al Quoz Sprint.

Many of South Africa's leading breeders are represented here. There are 487 juveniles catalogued, with 29 withdrawals as of yesterday. Top stallions with progeny to go through the ring include Jet Master (SAf) (Rakeen), Captain Al (SAf) (Al Mufti), Dynasty (SAf) (Fort Wood), Jallad (Blushing Groom), Var (Forest Wildcat) and Silvano (Ger) (Lomitas{GB}). There are also 2-year-olds by such well-known international stallions as Elusive Quality and Commands (Aus), who have one horse apiece catalogued.

Trippi (End Sweep), whose 3-year-olds have done so well in the U.S. this year, will be represented by his first local crop of juveniles in South Africa, while last season's leading first-crop sire, Black Minnaloushe, has 15 youngsters on offer. There are siblings to Group 1 winners Seal (SAf), Rip Curl (SAf) and Zeeno Seal (SAf) on offer, as well as a three-parts sister to J J The Jet Plane.

Champion racefilly Bold Ellinor (SAf) (Kahal {GB}) will be represented by her first foal on sale, a bay colt by Tiger Ridge, who goes by the name of Nameri., while another of the sale's highlights could be a Trippi half-brother to Zanzamar (SAf) (Fort Wood), a smart 3-year-old in Dubai last year.

Jan Naude, CEO of the TBA, is quietly confident of a good sale. "There has been a lot of interest in the sale, with a fair number of people coming to look at horses," said Naude. 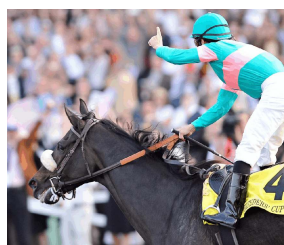
