**ONE IN A MILLION**

This afternoon, Arlington Park hosts its marquee event of the season, the Arlington Festival of Racing, which features four stakes, including three Grade I events. Heading the quartet is the Hatoof S. followed by the GI Secretariat S., GI Beverly D. S. and the

festival's centerpiece, the GI Arlington Million. Attempting to add another Million title to his resume is three-time champion **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat), who will try and improve on a close-up second-place finish in last year's renewal of the 10-furlong test. Named champion turf horse and older male in

2009 after collecting four Grade I victories--including a score in this race--the handsome bay collected wins in last season's GI Man O' War S. and GI Shadwell Turf Mile, but had to settle for second best behind Debussy (Ire) (Diesis {GB}) here. The Castleton Lyons runner, who repeated as champion male turf horse in 2010, was fifth in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai World Cup, third over the yielding turf in the GI Manhattan H. June 11 and runner-up behind European import **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the July 9 GI Man O' War S.

Cape Blanco heads a two-pronged attack by trainer Aidan O'Brien. Campaigned by Mrs. Fitri Hay, Derrick Smith, Mrs. John Magnier and Michael Tabor, the chestnut triumphed in last June's G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. in September, but failed to hit the board in four starts since, including a sixth in the June 11 G1 Queen Anne S. O'Brien's other representative is this season's G1 Irish Derby hero **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}), who will lineup in the Secretariat. Both colts cleared quarantine 6:30 yesterday morning, before taking to the track by 7 a.m. "The lads were happy with them and said they are both 100%," said Pat Keating, O'Brien's head traveling lad. "They moved well on the track, and I couldn't be happier with them."

**CLASS OF 2011 JOINS HALL OF FAME**

The 57th annual induction ceremony for Thoroughbred racing's Hall of Fame took place on a picture-perfect morning and before a packed house in the Humphrey S. Finney Pavilion in Saratoga Springs Friday. With Randy Moss handling emcee duties, four from the contemporary world of racing and three historical figures joined the ranks in the Hall. The latest inductees are: jockey Shelby "Pike" Barnes, trainers Matthew Byrnes and Jerry Hollendorfer, and the horses Duke of Magenta, Open Mind, Safely Kept and Sky Beauty. Celebrity chef and owner/breeder Bobby Flay gave the keynote speech. "The Hall of Fame...it's a phrase that has so much power behind it," Flay said. "It's something so distant, you don't even think about achieving it in your dreams." To Hollendorfer, he added, "Hall of Famer--it has a pretty nice ring to it, doesn't it, Jerry?" Trainer D. Wayne Lukas, a fellow member of the Hall, also paid tribute to the newest member of the contemporary class of conditioners. "We recognize you for your work ethic, your professionalism, the way you've conducted yourself," Lukas said. "You're a role model for the Hall of Fame, and we welcome you."

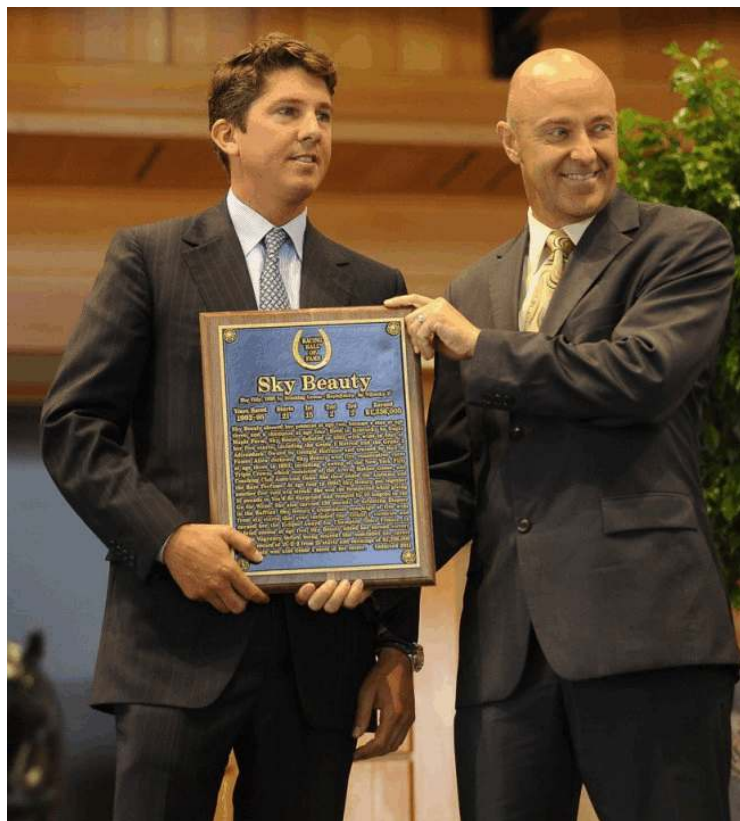

Lukas remarked that owner Eugene Klein had "the Midas touch," adding, "If he bought a burro, it would be the fastest burro in the world." As for how Klein came to own Open Mind, Lukas said that, after the yearling sales were over, he would meet with his owners, and the details of each purchase would be on 3x5 cards. The cards would go in the center of a table, and the owners would trade back and forth until satisfied with their new acquisitions. In 1987, there were two cards left when the dealing was done--including Open Mind's, a \$150,000 FTSAUG yearling. Lukas, with the blessing of his owners, was going to keep them, but it wasn't to be. "As I reached out to sweep those cards in front of me, Gene said, 'Ah hell, they didn't cost that much. I'll take 'em.'"

**WILL IRISH EYES BE SMILING**

Derrick Smith, Michael Tabor and Sue Magnier's **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) is easily the most accomplished sophomore to invade Chicago for the GI Secretariat S., the opening leg of a Festival Pick 3, off his near-miss second in the G1 Investec Derby June 4 and his 3/4-length victory in the G1 Irish Derby a little more than three weeks later. Despite a last-out fourth in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris July 14, his overwhelming European form could see him come down from his morning line of 2-1, and if the Secretariat were contested over 12 furlongs, it could well be game, set and match. But Treasure Beach has not seen a distance this 'short' since finishing a distant third to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G2 Royal Lodge S. over a mile last September.

He is more of a grinder/stayer than he is blessed of a powerful turn of foot. That being said, he can win this on class alone and take the Secretariat trophy back to Europe for just the third time [Aidan O'Brien conditioned **Ciro** to a win in the 2000 Secretariat for Jayeff B Stables]. Jockey Colm O'Donoghue is in town and watched as the colt sweated up a bit as he went through his paces after clearing quarantine Friday morning. "He's been in great form since his run in the Grand Prix de Paris, and he's going there with a good chance," O'Donoghue told *Racing Post*. "He's a horse that isn't short of speed, and he's done very well this year, and winning the Irish Derby on him after just missing out at Epsom was huge for me." **Willcox Inn** (Harlan's Holiday) is looking to become the fourth horse to sweep all three legs of the Mid-America Triple and the first since Honor Glide accomplished the feat back in 1997. He enters off convincing wins in the Arlington Classic May 28 and the GII American Derby July 9, easily accounting for **Suntracer** (Kitten's Joy) on both occasions. **Newsdad** (Arch) has drawn the rail and adds blinkers off a solid fourth-place effort in the GII Virginia Derby, in which **Banned** (Kitten's Joy) and **Casino Host** (Dynaformer) finished immediately ahead. Newsdad should be able to lay a little closer to what appears to be a slow pace and will try to pounce on them late.

She was again second, beaten just a half-length by Gitano Hernando, in the May 22 G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup and is coming off a fifth-place finish in the July 8 G1

Falmouth S. at Newmarket. Trainer Mike de Kock is pleased with how his charge is adapting to her new conditions. "Everything is good with her," de Kock said. "She's improved day by day since she's been here."

**Dubawi Heights** takes a four-race win streak into this event, most recently securing a head success in the May 30 GI Gamely S. "She just keeps improving," said exercise rider Max Chaussee, who traveled with Dubawi Heights from trainer Simon Callaghan's Southern California barn. "She had a tough race last time, so we gave her a bit of a break. If she ends up making the pace, everyone else better prepare to go slow." **Fantasia** is coming off a course-and-distance win in the July 9 GIII Modesty H.

## St. John's River Breezes for Alabama...

Dede McGehee's **St. John's River** (Include), last-out winner of the GII Delaware Oaks July 9, breezed an easy five-eighths of a mile in 1:02.24 over a fast

Saratoga main track Friday morning. She is scheduled to make her next appearance in the GI TVG Alabama S. Aug. 20. Both McGehee and trainer Andy Leggio Jr. watched from the grandstand. "That's good," the conditioner said after watching the full sister to MGISW

Panty Raid gallop out strongly. "Nice easy move. I like what I saw. She did it very easy the first part and picked it up nicely." Given the likelihood of a compact field for the 10-furlong Alabama next Saturday, Leggio expressed concern about the pace scenario, but let the filly do her thing Friday morning. "I didn't want to take too much out of her. I'd rather save her for the race," he commented. Also runner-up to possible Alabama competitor Plum Pretty (Medaglia d'Oro) in the GI Kentucky Oaks, St. John's River has a record of 6-2-3-1 and earnings of \$500,070.

## Mucho Macho Man Back to Work...

**Mucho Macho Man** (Macho Uno) returned to the worktab for the first time since finishing seventh in the GI Belmont S. June 11, going three furlongs in :35.35, the fastest of six moves at the distance over the Oklahoma training track. "We wanted him to work easily," trainer Kathy Ritvo explained. "He went quickly, but he went well. We let him do it on his own. We're putting a foundation under him, getting him ready for the races again." Victorious in this year's GII Risen Star S., Mucho Macho Man was a close third in the GII Louisiana Derby and followed with a trifecta finish behind Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}) in the GI Kentucky Derby May 7. He failed to factor in the final two legs of the Triple Crown, checking in sixth in the GI Preakness S. ahead of his Belmont effort. Still eligible for a second-level allowance, Mucho Macho Man has two wins from 11 starts and earnings of \$610,643.

Grassy was also unlucky in his latest, leading deep into the final furlong of the GIII Singspiel S. June 26 at Woodbine before dropping a neck decision to the classy Muskettier (Ger) (Acatenango {Ger}). He should be closer to the pace this afternoon and will try to hold them off late. **Teaks North** goes in search of a third Grade I victory in 2011, having taken the Gulfstream Park Turf H. over the winter and the GI United Nations S. last time out July 2. Connections could have opted for this afternoon's Arlington Million, but instead remain on the East Coast for a first go at 12 panels. "The extra distance will be a benefit," stated trainer Justin Sallusto. "The farther he goes, the better he goes." Clement's other runner is **Winchester**, who has just one run under his belt this term, a one-paced third in the GIII Stars and Stripes S., rained onto the Polytrack at Arlington July 23.

**HOWARD JOHNSON RETIRES AFTER BAN**

Leading jumps trainer Howard Johnson has announced his retirement after learning that he has been banned for four years by the British Horseracing Authority yesterday. The 58-year-old County Durham-based conditioner, who has enjoyed some success on the flat as a result of his connection with owner Graham Wylie, was found in breach of charges relating to horse welfare and the administering of steroids to horses in his care. It was discovered that he had sent out one of his string on eight occasions after a palmar neurectomy, or de-nerving, had been performed and his sentence was set at three years for that offence. His ban was stretched to four years due to the finding of laurabolin, an anabolic steroid containing nandrolone, in three other of his horses. Paul Struthers, Head of Communications for the BHA, said, "The Authority is satisfied that the Disciplinary Panel has imposed a significant and appropriate sanction for what were two different but very serious offences. A four-year disqualification means that Howard Johnson is unable to work in or have any involvement with racing, including a prohibition on entering licensed premises such as training yards or racecourses, not just in Britain but the rest of the world. The Panel stated in its reasons that Mr. Johnson had shown a 'reckless disregard' for the rules, that his behavior 'fell seriously short of the standard to be expected of a licensed trainer' and that 'any lesser penalty would undermine the confidence stakeholders in racing are entitled to hold that, reckless disregard of equine welfare, will not be tolerated.' This decision, and the action of the authority in investigating this case and bringing charges, demonstrates once more that British Racing will take decisive and firm action when confronted with issues relating to welfare or integrity."

**DAY ONE OF NATIONAL 2YO SALE ENDS ON A HIGH**

The first day of the 2011 Emperors Palace National 2YO Sale ended with increases in average and aggregate. The 86 lots that sold grossed R5,085,000 (\$708,167)--up from last year's R4,505,000--whilst the average price rose from R54,277 to R59,128 (\$8,234). The RNA percentage rose, however. Twenty-nine horses failed to make their reserves--an RNA rate of 25.2%--compared to 20% in 2010.

The top-priced juvenile on day one was [lot 64](#). The bay colt, named Dynamic (SAf), is a son of leading sire Dynasty (SAf), and is out of a six-time winning daughter of international champion Theatrical (Ire) in Lanquid Lady. Consigned by Highlands Farm, home of the Fort Wood stallion Dynasty, the colt was snapped up by Hassan Adams for R325 000 (\$45,261).

Second top lot on day one was [lot 124](#). The unnamed Goldkeeper colt was snapped up by S. D'Aquino for R220 000 (\$30,638). The colt, consigned by Sandown Stud, is out of the unraced Centenary mare Newsday (SAf)--a half-sister to the stakes winner Tub Thumper (SAf) (Badger Land).

The top-priced filly on day one was [lot 86](#). A flashy daughter of champion sire Jet Master (SAf), the filly was sold for R170 000 (\$23,675) to Star Point Electrical. Consigned by Klipdrif Stud, as agent, the filly is a three-parts sister to J J the Jet Plane (SAf), being out of a half-sister to the international champion.

Leading Cape trainers Dean Kannemeyer and Brett Crawford were both realistic about the sales results. Kannemeyer stated, "It's a buyers' market. If you work hard, you will find a nice horse or two. I do believe that the market is flooded, and it is made worse by the economic situation. We need to stop people from breeding bad stallions to bad mares."

Crawford echoed those sentiments, saying, "It's purely a buyers' market, [thought] I have yet to buy a horse."
