

DEAUVILLE'S DREAM

If the ground stays in her favor, **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) has an opportunity to garner a 15th success at the highest level in today's G1 Prix Jacques le Marois at her beloved Deauville. Only once in six outings at

this seaside venue has she been beaten, with Makfi (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) lowering her colors in the testing conditions in which he thrived and she abhors in this event 12 months ago. Remarkably consistent, the Wertheimers' queen went to the line with all her customary zeal when registering a cozy defeat of **Sahpresa** (Sahm)--she won by a short neck, but was eased down in the closing stages to flatter the runner-up--for a fourth consecutive G1 Prix Rothschild over this track and trip last time July 31.

"We just hope that the ground stays good enough and doesn't get too heavy, as we have had some rain," Pierre-Yves Bureau, the Wertheimers' racing manager, told *PA Sport*. "It's a very nice race, there are lots of Group 1 winners in there, so it is exciting. Last time in the Prix Rothschild they went very fast which suits her well. The time of the race was one of the fastest in 20 years. I think she's as good as ever--she's had no problems--so we'll see what happens." **Cont. p7**

DIVERSE PATHS CONVERGE IN 'SPECIAL'

The field for today's GII Three Chimneys Saratoga Special S. may be short with just six entrants, but they have come from all over. **Banner Bill** and **Indian Evening** represent the Canadian contingent. The former boasts a three-for-three record, including a 5 3/4-length success in the Victoria S. at Woodbine and a one-length tally in the Colin S. a month later in which the bay re-rallied after being passed by two horses in the lane. "That, to me, was the most impressive [of his races] because everything that could have gone wrong in the race, did, and he still won," said trainer Ralph Biamonte of the Colin. "I had him way too sharp, and when he found himself on the lead he thought the race was over. Two horses passed him, but he came back and won." Banner Bill trains on dirt in Canada, and Biamonte does not expect the switch from Polytrack to the conventional stuff to be an issue. Indian Evening turned in a professional winning debut in Toronto July 10 after being backed down to favoritism, and the runner he defeated by 1 1/2 lengths returned to earn his diploma in the Vandal S. **Cont. p8**

CAN'T MISS

George Bolton and Stonestreet Stables' **My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike), backed down to 1-2 favoritism, dug in gamely to hold off GII Matron S. winner **Millionreasonswhy** (Grand Slam) by a neck in the 95th running of Saratoga's GII Adirondack S. yesterday. The chalk nearly beat the gate, but allowed **Bellacourt** (Lion Heart) to take a narrow early advantage as she stayed glued to that one's right flank through an opening quarter in :22.20 with just three lengths from leader to last. The pacesetter dropped out of top-spot contention around the bend, but My Miss Aurelia was soon confronted by Millionsreasonswhy, who appeared to be going better of the two as they spun into the lane side by side. My Miss Aurelia responded enthusiastically to the challenge, however, and always kept a short edge on her foe during a stretch-long battle. Bellacourt was 14 3/4 lengths back in third. "She ran a really tough race," said winning trainer Steve Asmussen. "We're very proud of her. She definitely earned it." **Cont. p4**

This race confirmed the impression across Europe that the Classic generation are ahead of their elders, and it was Earl of Tinsdal who led home a one-two-three for the sophomores here. Having beaten Saltas in Frankfurt's G3 Albert von Metzler-Rennen May 1, the bay dropped to fourth in the May 22 G3 Bavarian Classic over 10 furlongs at Munich before running second to his barnmate Waldpark (Ger) (Dubawi {Ire}) in the G1 Deutsches Derby at Hamburg last time July 3. Sent to the front after the initial jostling, he had all rivals at work at the top of the stretch, and even had the energy to spook at the quarter pole before powering clear for an emphatic win.

"He is still a bit dumb and green at times," commented trainer Andreas Wohler, who is looking at sending Earl of Tinsdal to the Sept. 25 G1 Preis von Europa back in Cologne before bringing him back at four. "Eddie [Pedroza] took the lead, which was okay if nobody else was willing to do so, and halfway down the straight I was sure he was going to win. His next race could be back here in the Preis von Europa, as he is a horse that needs a bit of a break between races." Earl of Tinsdale is the first Group 1 winner for his 12-year-old sire, a full-brother to Galileo (Ire) and a half to Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}), et al.

The homebred was favored in her last three tries, but ran second in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 16, third in the GI Gamely S. May 30 and second in the GIII Beverly Hills H. June 26 with a disastrous beginning. She broke slowly in the Beverly Hills before clipping heels with a rival and nearly going down, but Cozi Rosie recovered nicely to make up all but 1 3/4 lengths on Malibu Pier. The hard-luck chestnut donned the hood and was piloted by red-hot Garret Gomez for the first time here. Cozi Rosie hugged the rail in fifth as Wasted Tears

cruised through six furlongs in 1:12.69, narrowing the gap between herself and the pacesetter along the far turn. She fought her way through on the inside of Wasted Tears in mid-stretch, and out-kicked familiar foe Malibu Pier to win with room to spare. "This horse has been very unlucky her last few starts," said winning conditioner John Sadler. "She's a really good filly, in good form and we're really excited. And we were happy to see Dubawi Heights (GB) (Dubawi {Ire}) run well in Chicago yesterday [when second in the GI Beverly D. S.]. These California fillies are pretty close and that's good for the division."

Sarah Lynx stepped up from a fifth in last term's G1 Prix Vermeille to hit the board--albeit promoted from fourth--in the Oct. 2 G2 Prix de Royallieu at Longchamp, and closed her sophomore campaign with a seventh in the Nov. 23 Listed Prix Solitude at Saint-Cloud. Fifth on seasonal return in the June 4 Listed Preis der Badener Hotellerie at Baden-Baden, she improved one spot in the July 24 Listed Prix de la Pepiniere at Maisons-Laffitte last time and proved best in a tactical affair here to deservedly register a career high. The eventual winner was positioned in a stalking role just behind a sedate early crawl. Challenging full of run off the home turn, she seized control with 300 meters remaining and was ridden out to score in comfortable fashion. "Sarah Lynx is an easy filly to ride--she doesn't pull and has a very good late kick," explained winning conditioner John Hammond. "It certainly helped being close to the pace in a slowly run race, and the soft ground probably helped, too. It looks like we have no other choice, but to go for the [Sept. 11] G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp]. That looks like a very tough race this year, so we might also have a look at the [GI] Flower Bowl Invitational [at Belmont Park] in New York." Sarah Lynx hails from the family of G1 Epsom Oaks runner-up Meeznah (Dynaformer).

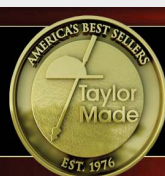

"I would have loved for it to have been easy for her so she can come back," Asmussen said. "We have big plans for her, and we want enough horse left to do it. She's a very special filly, with her being a Stonestreet homebred and George [Bolton] being in on her. Barbara [Banke], she's just a tremendous individual and it speaks volumes of the horses they are breeding and raising to win a race of this caliber, especially in that style. She earned it--it definitely wasn't given to her today." The conditioner acknowledged that the G1 Spinaway S. at the Spa Sept. 4 would be a logical return for the bay if all goes well.

Of the fillies name, George Bolton explained, "Jess [Jackson] and Barbara [Banke] named her after my mother shortly before Jess passed away. It's a very sentimental thing. My mother is a lucky person, and it was apropos to have a horse named after her." Banke, Jess Jackson's widow, added, "Aurelia is one of the luckiest people I know, and was our lucky charm during the entire Curlin campaign."

Jackson purchased My Miss Aurelia's very quick stakes-winning and graded stakes-placed dam for \$925,000 at Keeneland November in 2007. Her first foal was the stakes-placed 3-year-old Albergatti (Unbridled's Song). She has a yearling by Mr. Greeley and a weanling by Distorted Humor.

Cirrus des Aigles, who hit the board in the Apr. 30 G1 Prix Ganay, gave Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) cause for concern when second in the May 22 G1 Prix d'Isphahan, then bagged the G3 La Coupe in his third straight start at Longchamp. Finding just Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse to Bend {Ire}) too good when second in the June 26 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud, he garnered a seventh black-type success with an easy win in the July 20 G3 Grand Prix de Vichy last time and impressed again in the mud here. Restrained in third until challenging on the bridle in early stretch, he was pushed clear approaching the final furlong and increased his buffer under coaxing in the closing stages to win by daylight. "What can I say which hasn't already been said about this lovely horse?" asked trainer Corine Barande-Barbe. "He loves his racing and thrives on it. Winning three group races so easily this year has helped build his confidence and, in turn, that builds a horse's career. Because he's a gelding, he's not allowed to run in all French Group 1 races, but if he was he'd be running in tomorrow's Prix Jacques Le Marois instead of here today. If he bounces back well from this race, he will come back here in two weeks for the [Aug. 28 G2] Grand Prix de Deauville."

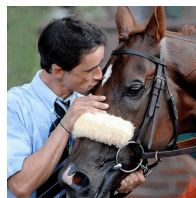

For the legions of Goldikova fans, a major concern must be the current high success rate for the 3-year-olds taking on their elders at this level and she has a host of talented sophomores to face here. Chief among them is Khalid Abdullah's unbeaten **Mutual Trust (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}), who followed a first black-type win in Chantilly's G3 Prix Paul de Moussac June 12 with a defeat of Zoffany (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) and Strong Suit (Rahy) in a three-way go for the G1 Prix Jean Prat back there July 3. That form has a solid look, with the runner-up having previously threatened Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) at Royal Ascot and the third registering impressive successes in the G3 Jersey S. and G2 Lennox S. either side. Another from the Classic generation who has already flaunted her wares at this level is Richard Strauss's **Immortal Verse (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}), who followed a visually impressive score in Chantilly's G2 Prix de Sandringham June 5 with an even more striking display when garnering the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot last time June 17.

The recent rain will help her cause, as it will **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan), who takes on Goldikova again after finishing third behind her in the G1 Prix de la Foret over seven furlongs at Longchamp in October and in last place when she was making her successful return in that track's G1 Prix d'Ispahan May 22. Connections retain the faith in the 4-year-old, who warmed up for this with a smooth win in Ascot's G2 Summer Mile July 9. "We all have a lot of respect for Goldikova, but Canford Cliffs beat her at Royal Ascot, and now we hope Dick Turpin can do likewise," Richard Hannon Jr. commented. "They had 7mm of rain at Deauville on Saturday night and, while the forecast is for conditions to improve, hopefully there will be enough cut in the ground for our fellow to do himself justice. It was great to see Dick's confidence come flooding back at Ascot when he won the Summer Mile very comfortably, and Hughesie was really impressed when he rode him in a gallop on Thursday. Dick Turpin ran Goldikova to a length in last year's Prix de la Foret, and while we were a long way behind her in the Prix d'Ispahan earlier this season, the ground had dried up and we should not have run him, especially so soon after the Lockinge. He is flying again now and we are very hopeful." Ecurie Wildenstein's **Planteur (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) reverts to a mile after a below-par fourth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 15, having upstaged Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) in Longchamp's G1 Prix Ganay over 1 5/16 miles Apr. 30. Add to the mix the Marquesa de Moratalla's May 15 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains hero **Tin Horse (Ire)** (Sakhee), the Juddmonte stalwart and G1 Queen Anne S. third **Cityscape (GB)** (Selkirk) and Scuderia Incolinx's Italian champion **Worthadd (Ire)** (Dubawi {Ire}), and this is as strong a renewal as has been seen for some time.

TRIPLE INTRIGUE

Three of Europe's best line up in today's G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano, with the G1 Prix de Diane one-two **Golden Lilac** and **Galikova** renewing rivalry, and are taken on by the G1 Deutsches Derby hero **Waldpark**. Golden Lilac, who had Galikova a length behind in that June 12 Chantilly Classic, was adding to her impressive success in the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp May 15. Connections of her arch-rival were disappointed that she had not provided more of a fight in the Diane after her striking display when annexing Saint-Cloud's G3 Prix Cleopatre previously May 7. "Whether she can turn the tables on Golden Lilac is the big question," Pierre-Yves Bureau, racing manager to Galikova's owner-breeders the Wertheimer brothers, told *PA Sport*. "Golden Lilac is a very good filly, she's won the Guineas and the French Oaks very easy, but Galikova keeps improving, so we hope she can win. Everybody is talking about the fillies, but it is the first time either of them have run against the colts. The German horse looks very good, so it's going to be very interesting. If she runs well, we would maybe try to go to the G1 Prix Vermeille [at Longchamp Sept. 11], but we need to see how she runs first." Waldpark is still unbeaten and could be anything at this stage, with the form of his July 3 Hamburg Classic victory working out in his favor. The second and third--Earl of Tinsdal (Ger) (Black Sam Bellamy {Ire}) and Saltas (Ger) (Lomitas {GB})-- filled the first two places in yesterday's G1 Rheinland-Pokal, while the fifth Brown Panther (GB) (Shirocco {Ger}) was runner-up in Saturday's G3 Geoffrey Freer S.

Trinniberg comes from the opposite direction of Banner Bill and Indian Evening--he romped by 5 3/4 lengths when unveiled by Bisnath Parboo at Calder July 8, besting two next-out graduates and two runner-ups. Todd Pletcher trainee **Stat** is the only juvenile to have previously raced in New York. He bided his time before taking over with ease at Belmont July 9, earning the field's top Beyer Speed Figure of 79 as well as morning-line favoritism here. "We were very pleased with his first start and are hopeful he can get us this elusive race," said Pletcher, who has never won the Special despite his recent dominance with 2-year-olds. **Union Rags**, who had first-out success at Delaware last month, was sold by breeder Phyllis Wyeth for \$145,000 last August at Saratoga, but she bought him back for \$390,000 at FTFFEB. **Italo** was part of Wesley Ward's charge in Europe, scoring first out at Longchamp in May. He was a well-beaten last in the G2 Coventry S. at Ascot June 14, but appears to be working well since returning to the States.



Uncle Mo Fires Another Bullet at the Spa...

Mike Repole's **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) remains on target to return in the Aug. 27 GI King's Bishop S. following his second straight bullet workout at Saratoga Sunday. Breezing in company with Curlin S. hero Turbo Compressor (Halo's Image) over the main track, last year's champion juvenile colt covered the distance in 1:00.34, finishing about two lengths ahead of his workmate. Jockey John Velazquez was aboard for the move. "He's back in race mode," trainer Todd Pletcher of Uncle Mo, sidelined since placing third in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 9 with a rare liver disorder. "You can see a change in his disposition leading into these works the last couple of times. At the same time, he's been settled. It was another bullet work and he did it well within himself. He galloped out strongly and came back well. We're excited about where he is at the moment."

Uncle Mo previously worked a bullet five furlongs in 1:00.22 over the Oklahoma training track Aug. 9. "When you are looking at a horse who has accomplished as much as he has, you're not going to find an easy race to come back in," Pletcher continued. "The first start of his life he ran an enormous race here at Saratoga and we would expect him to run a big race first time back. Right now, he's Uncle Mo and he's perfectly healthy. As long as that continues to be the case, then we're confident he'll go over and run his 'A' race."

Stablemate **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini), headed to the Aug. 27 GI Travers S. following a sharp win in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 30, worked four furlongs in :51.98 at the Spa yesterday. "He went a tick slower than we set out to do, but I felt better after seeing a group of horses work," Pletcher said of the Repole colorbearer. "The track was definitely on the slow side. We were looking for a maintenance half, and we'll come back and do something a little more serious with him next week."

Pletcher also sent out the versatile **Sidney's Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) for a four-furlong breeze in :48.89. The WinStar Farm and Rubio B. Stable runner was last seen annexing the GII Fourstardave H. July 31. "As we've talked about before, he's a horse who does a lot of things well," Pletcher commented. "His work this morning on the dirt opens up more possibilities. I'll talk to his connections more, but we're keeping a close eye on the [GI] Forego [Sept. 3]. A race like that--a Grade I sprint on the dirt at Saratoga--would add to what's already a very big resume."

Royal Delta Alabama Bound...

Palides Investments' **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker), heroine of the GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 20, punched her ticket to the GI TVG Alabama S. Aug. 20 with a five-furlong move in 1:00.88 at Saratoga Sunday. The dark bay, a well-beaten third in the GI TVG Coaching Club American Oaks July 23, was also being considered for the grassy GII Lake Placid S. Aug. 21. She missed a start in the GI Mother Goose S. with a bruised foot. "I was laying on my pillow, and I had this dream," trainer Bill Mott said with a smile when asked about Royal Delta's next start. "The Alabama is a very important race. It's very prestigious,

The Juddmonte homebred, out of the brilliant Distant View mare Sightseek, turned in a five-furlong workout in 1:01.23 at Saratoga Sunday.

Winter Memories Tunes Up for Lake Placid...

Winter Memories (El Prado {Ire}), perfect in three starts this term, including an eye-catching tally in Saratoga's GII Lake George S. July 27, tuned up for next Sunday's GII Lake Placid S. with a four-furlong move in :49.78 over the Oklahoma turf course yesterday. Regular pilot Jose Lezcano was aboard. "She went off in :13 and a tick, :25 and change, :38, and :49 4/5," trainer Jimmy Toner offered. "So she went the last eighth in :11 4/5. We wanted her to relax early, and everything she did was perfect. It was exactly what we wanted. She had a pretty serious breeze last week [five furlongs on the turf in :59.29]. We didn't want any :47s. We wanted her nice and relaxed and comfortable." The gray daughter of millionaire Memories of Silver (Silver Hawk) has also posted victories in this term's GIII Appalachian S. at Keeneland and the GII Sands Point S. at Belmont Park. "She's pretty sharp," Toner said. "She knows what's coming. We schooled her the other day, and she's pretty good in the paddock, but going home she was a little ticked off because she didn't get to run."

Get Stormy Pointing for Bernard Baruch...

Sullimar Stable's **Get Stormy** (Stormy Atlantic), forced to miss the July 31 GII Fourstardave S. with a minor tendon issue, is scheduled to return to action in the GII Bernard Baruch S. at Saratoga Aug. 26. The GI Maker's Mark Mile S. and GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic S. hero, third in the GIII Monmouth S. last time June 12, worked five furlongs over the Oklahoma turf course in 1:02 Aug. 12. "We didn't go too, too strong," trainer Tom Bush commented. "We're feeling our way a little bit. He finished real nice and Ramon [Dominguez] was tickled to death. I wouldn't have minded him going a little bit faster, but we have time to come back next week and do something a little stronger. He'll come back next Friday, so hopefully we'll have a good few days here and stay on schedule."

MCKINSEY REPORT HIGHLIGHTS ROUND TABLE *by Mike Kane*

The 58th Round Table Conference on Matters Pertaining to Racing, held Sunday in Saratoga Springs, was highlighted by the presentation of a major industry study entitled, "Driving Sustainable Growth for Thoroughbred Racing and Breeding." After Dan Singer and Michael Lamb, of the management consulting firm McKinsey & Company, concluded their presentation, which was commissioned by The Jockey Club, the organization's President and Chief Operating Officer James L. Gagliano announced that many of the strategies unveiled, including a series of televised races, will be put into place. The plan is believed to involve a multi-million dollar commitment from The Jockey Club.

The McKinsey & Company report found that, in the past decade, handle had declined 37%, attendance was off 30%, starts per horse were off 14% and race days declined 14%. The report said the major issues facing racing include competition from other forms of gambling, brand perception, the fan experience and fragmented distribution of the product.

"The Jockey Club went into this exercise knowing full well that merely compiling a set of recommendations without a strategic plan of action, and the commitment to build on that, would be a gigantic waste of time and money," Gagliano said. "So the 2011 industry study doesn't really conclude today; rather, it begins.

"The Jockey Club Board of Stewards has authorized funding over the next five years to help implement these recommendations, in some cases with industry partners," he continued. "We will devote considerable financial, technological and human resources to this effort."

Gagliano's announcement is a major step in the direction that The Jockey Club has moved in this year through its support of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association's communications and marking programs.

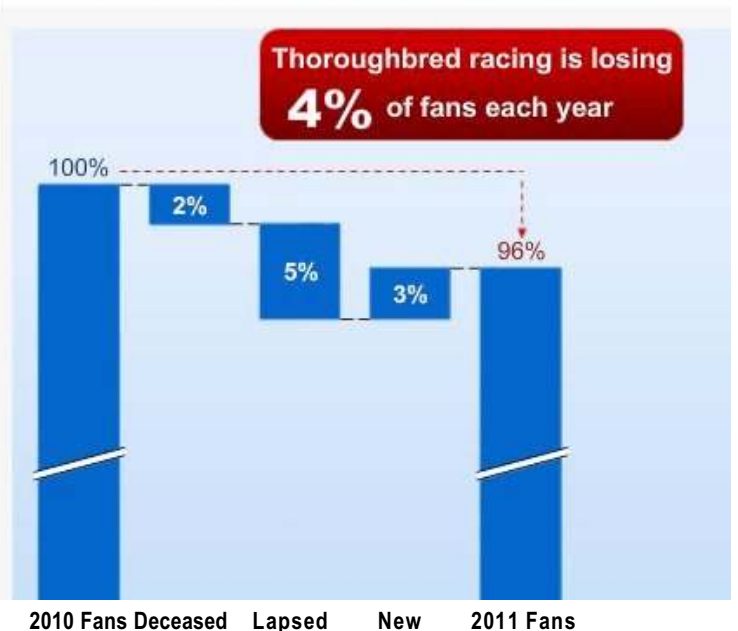

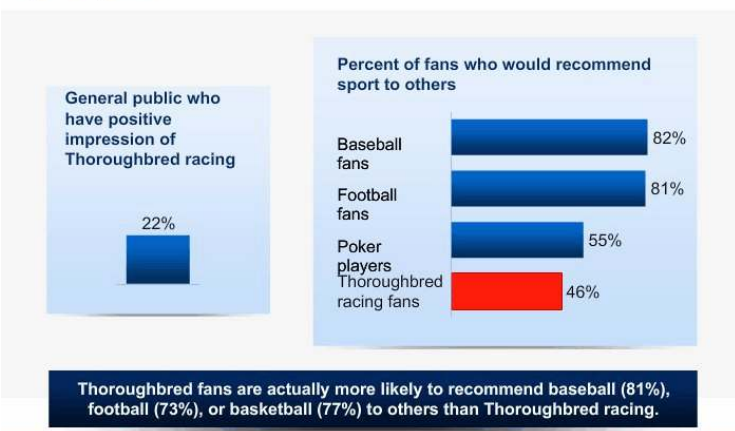
During their nearly 40 minutes on the stage at the Gideon Putnam Resort, Singer and Lamb provided a series of statistics illustrating the significant declines in the industry during the past decade. Among the findings of their study is that racing is losing 4% of its fan base a year, and that its absence from national television severely hurts its ability to attract new fans.

It also concluded that a reduction in the number of racing programs and a coordination of the timing of important races would help improve handle. At the conclusion of their analysis of the state of racing, Singer and Lamb made nine recommendations that they said could have a positive impact on the industry.

The nine recommendations from the study, "Driving Sustainable Growth for Thoroughbred Racing and Breeding"

- Increased television coverage
- A free-to-play website
- Fewer, better races and better scheduling to increase field size and showcase the best product
- Creation of a social game
- Innovative wagering platforms
- Track-integrated ADW
- Racing integrity reforms
- Encouragement of ownership through greater transparency
- Dissemination of best practices from tracks around the country

Gagliano said The Jockey Club has extended its relationship with McKinsey & Company, and added, "We are determined to create a televised racing series, and are presently in discussions with several networks, television producers, racetrack representatives and sports marketing agencies. We will build a social game to reach and attract a new audience. We will create a free-to-play site, and have retained an experienced developer of sports fantasy games to guide design, development and promotion."

In addition, Gagliano said The Jockey Club, with the help of McKinsey & Company staff, will use its InCompass subsidiary to develop a tool that will help tracks select the best dates and times for its races.

In his concluding remarks, Ogden Mills Phipps, The Jockey Club chairman, said, "The Jockey Club is doing what it can to effect positive change in the industry. Undertaking this study and making a firm commitment to implement its recommendations is evidence of that."

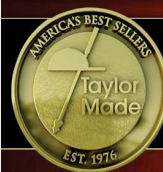

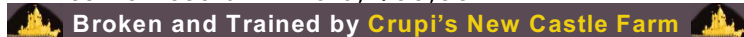

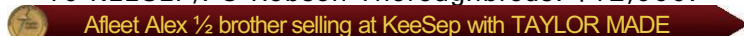

NATIONAL 2YO SALE ENDS

The 2011 Emperors Palace National 2YO sale ended Sunday with figures down across the board. Continuing economic woes were reflected in considerable declines in aggregate and average from last year. The aggregate fell from R25,045,000 (R1 = \$0.14) in 2010 to R19,385,000, a drop of 19%. The average fell from R74,985 to R58,039, a 22.3% hit. However, the clearance rate was more favorable, dropping from just 64% to 76%.

The top-priced yearling Sunday--and of the sale--was [lot 455](#), who went to Alec Laird for R350,000. Named **Queen of the Sky (SAf)**, the filly was by **Dynasty (SAf)**, who also sired the top-priced colt. **Queen of the Sky**, out of the mare **Fly High (SAf) (Habub {Ire})**, was consigned by Bosworth Farm.

Top priced colt on sale was [lot 64](#) and came during Friday's opening session. Named **Dynamic (SAf)**, the son of the Fort Wood stallion **Dynasty** was consigned by Highlands Farm, home of **Dynasty**, and purchased by leading Cape-based owner Hassan Adams for R325,000. He is out of the **Theatrical (Ire)** mare **Lanquid Lady**.

Klipdrif, as agent, was the leading vendor by aggregate, selling 27 of its 32 lots for a gross total of R2.41 million--an average of R89,259.

The leading vendor by average (3 or more sold) was Danika Stud. Danika sold four juveniles for a total of R580,000 and an average of R145,000. Danika's highest-priced yearling was [lot 305](#), a Trippi half-brother to the smart Dubai performer Zanzamar (SAf) (Fort Wood). The colt was purchased by D. Chinsammy for R300,000. The ill-fated Victory Moon (SAf) was the leading sire by aggregate. His 13 youngsters made R1.47 million and averaged R113,077. The leading sire by average was champion sire Jet Master (SAf). All nine of his offspring on offer sold, averaging R151,111. D'Aquino was leading buyer, purchasing nine lots for an aggregate of R800,000.

Visiting Irish auctioneer Alistair Pim was understanding of the market, saying, "The better horses inevitably fetch better prices, and a nice horse will always get buyers interested, no matter the market." TBA's CEO Jan Naude was resigned after the sale, commenting that, "The downtrend continues as a result of the economy.
