## 'CANDY' DRAWS 10 HOLE IN PACIFIC CLASSIC

**Twirling Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}) was handed post position 10 for Sunday's Pacific Classic at Del Mar during a draw party held Wednesday night at the Rancho Valencia Resort in Rancho Santa Fe. Owned by Jenny Craig, Marty Wygod and William S. Farish, the winner of the GI Malibu S., GI Californian and GI Strub S. was made the 5-2 morning-line favorite by track oddsmaker Russ Hudak over GI Santa Anita H. winner **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again). Trained by Bob Baffert, the latter--owned by Diamond Pride LLC, the Lanni Family Trust and Mercedes

Stable--was listed at 3-1 in the morning line. In their most recent start in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup, Game On Dude was nosed out by recently retired First Dude (Stephen Got Even) for the win, with Twirling Candy a neck back in third. "We were very happy," trainer John Sadler confirmed Thursday morning. "If you go back and look he was No. 1 in The Californian and the Hollywood Gold Cup, and toward the inside [No. 5] in the Big 'Cap. So he hasn't had a good draw in quite awhile. We wanted to get an outside post, so he can pick wherever he wants to be and not get in trouble. You have a long run to the first turn and you can get a good position from the outside post." **Bourbon Bay** (Sligo Bay {Ire}) was automatically scratched from the 10-furlong feature when he was entered in Sunday's GI Del Mar H. Rules prohibit entry in both races, since they are scheduled on the same day.

## AUGUST SALE ENDS ON A HIGH

Arqana's August Yearling Sale came to a close yesterday when a solid second half of the "Select Session 2" completed the auction's recovery from a shaky start to proceedings on Monday. The latest renewal of this prestigious affair ended with a cumulative average of €95,924 which edged ahead of last year's figure of €94,500 by 1.5%, with the median of €65,000 down by only 7%. Arqana's President Eric Hoyer said, "In the current environment, and with the major investments we undertook--both through the new sales pavilion and to attract new buyers--the result of this four-day sale is highly satisfactory. The increase in the number of horses sold is very significant and reflects a strong, healthy market. The great diversity of buyers, both from France and abroad, is a positive sign of the French racing system's performance and international appeal. Finally, the new sales complex received the thumbs up from all involved and allowed for a warm, welcoming atmosphere as well as optimum comfort, even though a bit of fine-tuning still needs to be done." Topping the final day's proceedings was hip [392](#), the half-sister to Sunday's G1 Prix Morny hero Dabirsim (Fr) (Hat Trick {Jpn}) who was sold to Patricia Boutin's Suprina Bloodstock for €240,000. The Feb. 28 foal is by Slickly (Fr).

**Team Shackleford Unscathed After Scare**

It was all systems 'go' for GI Preakness S. hero **Shackleford** (Forestry) Thursday morning as he received his final preparations in advance of Saturday's GI Travers S. at Saratoga.

However, the camp had a momentary scare Wednesday afternoon when the handsome chestnut's jockey, Jesus Castanon, went down in a spill on the grass in the day's second race. Neither horse nor the jockey was injured, and Castanon was back at work Thursday morning, galloping Shackleford a mile and a half. Castanon gave the thumbs up when asked how he felt. "He said the track felt soft yesterday," joked Romans. "He can literally tell you how it feels." Castanon chimed in, "I've still got a little grass on me."

Shackleford finished second behind **Coil** (Point Given) in the July 31 GI Haskell Invitational S. Asked about tactics for Saturday's 10-furlong test, trainer Dale Romans offered, "If someone wants to go [to the lead], we'll just sit off of them. I think he likes that, anyway, having a target, so he can keep clocking them. Going a mile and a quarter, there will be very few of them that will be out fast there early."

**Blinkers Off for J W Blue**

Stuart Grant's **J W Blue** (Sky Mesa) will race with blinkers off in Saturday's GI Travers S., according to trainer Tony Dutrow yesterday. The dark bay finished sixth when fitted with the hood for the first time in the Apr. 16 GI Arkansas Derby, the Elkstone Group runner was third in the May 7 Federico Tesio S. before finishing runner-up in his two latest--the June 13 Floor Show S. and the Barbaro S. July 9. "I'm not seeing the blinkers help him," Dutrow revealed. "I've always thought, and I'm still thinking, that J W Blue is capable of more than we have seen. I tried blinkers to see if that would bring out the best in him. I don't feel blinkers accomplished that. In his last two races, he made the lead, pulled himself up [and] got beat. I just don't see the need for the blinkers. I think he's better off without the blinkers than with them."

**Coil Ready to Spring in Travers**

Despite his inspiring victory in his dirt debut in the GI Haskell Invitational at Monmouth July 31, trainer Bob Baffert hopes **Coil** (Point Given) will be closer to the early pace come Saturday. Never worse than third at any call of his previous five races, all on synthetic surfaces, the colt broke very slowly last time, and Baffert confirmed he does not want to see a repeat of that. "I don't want him dead last like he was in the Haskell," Baffert said. "I told [jockey] Martin [Garcia], 'When you were last going down the backside, I had already given up and was so upset,' and he said, 'Senor, it's not where you are on the backside, it's where you are right here [in the winner's circle].' So he will just put him in a spot where he feels comfortable. He needs a target, though." Coil, also winner of the GIII Affirmed S. at Hollywood June 11, was a head short of the win in the nine-panel GII Swaps S. July 9.

Consigned by Haras de Grandcamp, the daughter of Slickly commanded plenty of interest given her half-brother's victory in last Sunday's G1 Prix Morny. At this venue last year, Dabirism sold for a mere €30,000. Also kin to the stakes-placed Preferred Yield (High Yield), the filly will race in the colors of France Galop's President Edouard de Rothschild. "The horse will be trained by Andre Fabre," Patricia Boutin revealed. "Andre and his wife Elisabeth had a close look at her beforehand and backed up my choice to Edouard, so it was an easy decision to make. The page has received a serious boost with Dabirsim winning so nicely on Sunday, and Edouard loves Slickly, who is the sire of his G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner Meandre (Fr). Personally, I feel that the catalogue was very good and there were a lot of good-looking horses." Haras de Grandcamp's Eric Lhermite added, "We are delighted with the sale, and the breeder Michel Montfort is over the moon. She is a good-looking filly and we wish them all the luck. Overall, we have been very happy with the consignment and some have made more than we expected and some less, but that is the name of the game." Suprina also paid €105,000 for Haras des Capucines' hip 417, a Zamindar half-sister to 2003 G2 Prix Noailles winner and G1 Prix Lupin and G1 Prix du Jockey Club runner-up Super Celebre (Fr) (Peintre Celebre), who now stands at Haras du Camp Bernard.

**Sultan's Growing Influence...**

Blandford Bloodstock paid €240,000 for a daughter of Raven's Pass on Monday on behalf of Sheikh Sultan bin Khalifa Al Nahyan and added another to that owner's roster yesterday. Hip [385](#) is a Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) son of the smart ex-Aga Khan racemare Rosamixa (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), a full sister to this year's G2 Prix du Muguet winner and G1 Prix d'Ispahan third Rajsaman (Fr) from the family of the 2009 G1 Prix Marcel Boussac heroine Rosanara (Fr) (Sinndar {Ire}). Rosamixa's first foal is Pearl Mix (Ire) (Oratorio {Ire}), a €120,000 graduate of this auction last year and fourth in last month's G2 Superlative S. at Newmarket. Again, it was Haras de Grandcamp celebrating a high-profile sale after the March foal fetched €155,000. "He is a very good-looking colt, and Sheikh Sultan now owns the dam, so [he] wants to upgrade the family and make sure everything goes well," Blandford's Richard Brown said. "That's why we were keen to have him." Japan's Big Red Farm later paid €100,000 for Haras du Quesnay's hip [444](#), an April-foaled son of Gold Away (Ire) out of a half to 2003 G3 Prix des Reservoirs and 2005 GIII Azeri Breeders' Cup S. runner-up Colony Band (Dixieland Band), while Nicolas Clement snapped up one of the last Anabaas from the draft of Haras de Colleville. Hip [363](#), already named Style Vendome (Fr), is a son of the Listed-placed Place Vendome (Fr) (Dr Fong) and was knocked down to the trainer for €92,000. "He has been bought for a French client who lives in Argentina and is a very nice colt," Clement commented. "He seems very precocious, and the dam was a good horse with a lot of speed. He is from the last crop of Anabaa and has everything that it takes to make a good horse, so I'm very happy." Clement also signed for Haras du Cadran's hip [453](#), a son of Verglas (Ire) out of the stakes-placed Afra Tsitsi (Fr) (Belong To Me) after a final bid of €80,000. Anabaa's last hurrah was completed by the sale of Colleville's hip [394](#), a colt named Shanaba (Fr) out of the Listed-winning and Group-placed Sabasha (Fr) (Xaar {GB}) who sold to Alain Decrion for €75,000.

Bertrand le Metayer was the successful bidder at €75,000 for hip [355](#), a son of the Listed-placed October Winds (Irish River {Fr}) from the extended family of the sire Nepal, who was offered by Haras des Capucines. **'STORMY' WEEKEND AHEAD AT THE SPA**

Attempting to defend his title in this test, **Get Stormy** is four for five over this turf course, including a win in last summer's GII Fourstardave H. Off the board in his first start this term in the Jan. 9 GIII Ft Lauderdale S., the 5-year-old was an improved third in the GI Gulfstream Park Turf H. Back in the winner's circle following the Apr. 15 Maker's Mark S. at Keeneland, the Sullimar Stable performer added a victory in the GI Turf Classic May 7. Most recently, the bay weakened in the final stages to be third in the GIII Monmouth S. **Moryba (Brz)**, a Group 1 winner in his native Brazil, marked his debut for trainer Bill Mott with an allowance win at Gulfstream earlier this winter. Runner-up in the GII Mervin Muniz Jr. H. at Fair Grounds Mar. 26, he failed to hit the board in two subsequent starts, including the Turf Classic, but was only beaten 3 1/2 lengths by winner Get Stormy that day. Giving reason for consideration in his latest, the dark bay was a close-up second behind the talented Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the Fourstardave.

**MIGHTY CAROLINE**

Juvenile **Mighty Caroline** (Stormy Atlantic), who provided trainer Melody Conlon with her first stakes victory in the Aug. 5 GIII Sorrento S., has been retired due to a suspensory ligament injury to her right front leg. "It most likely happened in the race, but it didn't show up until a few days afterward," Conlon said Thursday morning. "We took X-rays that didn't show anything, but an ultrasound showed a slight tear. Horses usually don't come back to being 100% after a ligament injury, so we felt it best to retire her." The John Liviakis homebred is going back to Hill 'N' Dale Farm in Kentucky where she may be bred to Tapit next year. "She'll have a good life and we're looking forward to her babies," Conlon said.

**PERU TO BAN MEDS IN BLACK-TYPE EVENTS**

The Board of the Jockey Club of Peru has decided to eliminate all forms of medicine 2013 in all its black-type races. The ban would include furosemide and phenylbutazone. A few weeks ago, officials in Argentina announced a similar policy, and it is expected that other South American racing jurisdictions will proceed down the same path in the coming weeks.



**WILDCAT HEIR COLT TOPS OPEN FINALE**

A colt by Wildcat Heir--offered as [Hip 537](#)--went to Vision Racing and Sales for \$85,000 to top the second and final Open session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's August Yearling Sale. Consigned by Summerfield (Francis & Barbara Vanlangendonck), agent, the bay colt is out of Tiz What It Waz (Tiznow), a daughter of stakes-placed Ualoaa Lani (Rare Performer). Heading the ladies was [Hip 596](#), a filly by Chapel Royal consigned by Greystone Manor Farm. The dark bay filly, who is out of Aggressive Broad (Broad Brush) and a half-sister to stakes winner Awesomewithbroads (Awesome Again), sold to Steve Dwoskin for \$48,000. At the conclusion of Thursday's session, 195 horses sold for a total of \$1,929,400, compared with 229 horses grossing \$1,793,850 at the corresponding session last year. The average price was \$9,894, up 26.3% from \$7,833 in 2010, while the median price of \$7,000 rose 40% from \$5,000 a year ago. The buyback percentage was 25.6%, identical to last year's session. **Race 9 - GII Bernard Baruch H., 3yo/up, 1 1/8mT**

This race is one to be played with conflicting race shapes in mind and accounted for. Favored Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) is a must-use in vertical wagers (Pk3s/4s), but one should also include other runners whose chances of winning depend on a drastically different pace scenario than what will benefit the favorite. The chalk will prove too good if allowed to waltz on the front end, but with a number of potential pressers and a target on his back, things could heat up early. Under the pace collapse scenario, **Paris Vegas** (Maria's Mon), the longest shot on the morning line at 30-1, has a live look. A minor stakes winner in France last winter, Paris Vegas showed flashes of ability at varying distances and surfaces upon his arrival in the U.S., but only tried the grass once while under the care of Fabrice Chappet. That one turf attempt came when he was sixth of six in last year's GII Hall of Fame S. here while rank and unrate-able. The grey was privately purchased and turned over to astute horseman Tom Voss this spring, and after a very poor effort on the dirt at Pimlico in May, he has shown new life returning to the sod. The 4-year-old was a late-running second with trouble in a 7 1/2-furlong allowance at Delaware in June, and was the horse most victimized by a laughably run, merry-go-round renewal of the GII Fourstardave H. July 31 ([TDN Video](#)). Paris Vegas was in last place early behind a half in :50.49, and was pinned inside when trying to rally. He never found a seam, ducking in at one point and brushing with another rival before finishing sixth of seven. His finish was deceptively strong, however, and he covered the final five sixteenths in :28.39--a fifth of a second faster than anyone else in the field. Paris Vegas still might not be good enough, and he might not get the set-up he needs, but he'll offer exceptional value on top and underneath. **Yesterday's Results:** Krissy Kat didn't appear comfortable attempting to keep up with the pacesetters after breaking well, and she dropped back to last midway through the race. She re-rallied very wide in the lane to be in a photo for third, however, and could be better going long. *For more Saratoga analysis, visit the [TDN Blog](#).*

### Illinois Tracks Rewarded After Long Battle:

The Illinois racing industry benefitted from a positive development earlier this week when \$141 million was released to horse tracks and owners, according to [pantagraph.com](http://pantagraph.com). After five years of litigation, the U.S. Supreme Court finally ruled to release the funds that had been held in escrow. "We have new life," said Tony Somone, executive director of the Illinois Harness Horseman's Association. "It's going to stimulate the local horse racing community." According to Executive Director of the Illinois Racing Board, Marc Laino, the windfall could affect purses soon. "It's all going to take shape this week," he said. Somone added that the tracks would likely take a conservative approach in boosting purses. In 2006, a law which diverted 3% of the earnings of the state's four biggest casinos to the horse tracks was implemented to stop the deterioration of the racing industry. Aside from the development, the casinos have a separate lawsuit pending in federal court, and as of Tuesday, it remained unclear whether the case would be pursued.
