**REPOLE THIRSTING FOR TRAVERS SUCCESS**

While the Midlantic and Northeast prepare for a near direct hit from Hurricane Irene during the latter half of this weekend, owner Mike Repole is bracing for a whirlwind day of his own today with morning-line favorite **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) in the GI Travers S. in addition to the much-anticipated return to action of champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) in the GI Foxwoods

King's Bishop S. (see p8). "You know I think it's anybody's dream," Repole commented. "I mean the Travers has been around for 100 years and the King's Bishop has been around for about 30. And when you look at that top five to 10 races I want to win in my life, these races are definitely in the top 10. [The] Travers is probably in the top five. I'm really going to savor the moment and enjoy the moment and definitely try to

soak it in and have a lot of fun." Much has always been expected of Stay Thirsty, even if he was more than a little bit in the shadow of Uncle Mo until the champ was sidelined and forced to miss the GI Kentucky Derby. Stay Thirsty didn't run much of a race in the Run for the Roses, finishing well back in 11th, but he put that effort behind him with a solid runner-up effort to **Ruler On Ice** (Roman Ruler) in the GI Belmont S. June 11. Some questioned the quality of that event and may have downgraded the effort due to the sloppy surface, but the dark bay answered those critics with a career-best performance in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 30, coming from midpack for a four-length tally from **Moonshine Mullin** (Albert the Great). "He came out of the race great and is training unbelievable," Repole commented. "We always thought he'd be a late developing 3-year-old, 4-year-old type horse. I think we're starting to see that." **Cont. p2**

**A TALE OF TWO MOS**

Today's GI Foxwoods King's Bishop S. comes down to one very important, and very puzzling, question-- which **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) will show up? The colt who romped on this card a year ago by 14 1/4 lengths on debut garnering the

seemingly unbeatable Repole Stable colorbearer proved less than invincible at three. He cruised along on an uncontested lead to win the Timely Writer S. at Gulfstream in March, but earned a career low 89 Beyer Figure in the process. Still 1-9 for the GI Wood Memorial S. at the Big A Apr. 9, Uncle Mo came up empty to be third--quite an achievement for many, but a disappointment for the champ. Forced to scratch on the eve of the GI Kentucky Derby and subsequently diagnosed with cholangiohepatitis, a rare liver disorder, Uncle Mo now seeks redemption at the venue where his meteoric rise first began.

*Coil Out to Spoil...*

For all they have accomplished in their careers, both trainers Todd Pletcher (Flower Alley, 2005) and Bob Baffert (Point Given, 2001) have celebrated just one victory in the 'Midsummer Derby.' It is a son of the 2001 hero--Coil--who seems most likely to prove the fly in the Stay Thirsty ointment this afternoon. The GIII Affirmed H. winner when making his black-type debut June 11 at Hollywood, he was without an apparent alibi when beaten a head in the GII Swaps S. July 9. After missing the break in the GI Haskell Invitational S. July 31 and last for the opening six furlongs, Coil came with a bold anti-bias rally to defeat GI Preakness S. victor **Shackleford** (Forestry) by a head. His Travers status remained in the balance, as Baffert wasn't convinced the Florida-bred was getting over the track to his satisfaction. But a bullet half-mile in a sharp :46 over the main track Aug. 23 sealed the deal. Coil will not race with a protective cup over his right eye which is healing from a scratched cornea. Shackleford has much to play for and is trying to win for the first time since scoring on the third Saturday in May at Old Hilltop. A pacesetter fourth in the Kentucky Derby before seeing out the Preakness trip, he did not stay the 12 furlongs of the GI Belmont S. and was fifth. He sat a good trip off a decent pace in the Haskell and was in front entering the final furlong before yielding to Coil. The chestnut has every right to improve off that, but still has some questions to answer at today's distance. **Raison d'Etat** (A.P. Indy) looms an interesting outsider. A 7 3/4-length maiden winner at Belmont June 18, he may have needed the two-turn experience when a green runner-up in a highly rated renewal of this track's Curlin S. July 29.

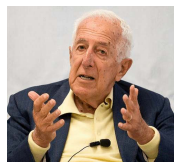
## TRAVERS S. BREEDERS



**Frank Stronach**

**ADENA SPRINGS - Bowman's Causeway** Frank Stronach's Adena Springs was the Eclipse Award-winning breeder for five straight years, from 2004-2008, and earned the honor again in 2010. Stronach himself was the champion breeder of 2000, and the Eclipse-winning owner from 1998-2000 and again in 2008. A native of Austria, Stronach immigrated to Canada in 1954. He started out in the tool and die industry, expanding to automotive parts

and finally founded Magna International. He bought his first racehorse, a \$700 claimer, in the early '60s, and acquired his first farm in Kentucky in 1989. He moved to his current location, a 2,000-acre property in Paris, Ky, in 2005. Among the top horses bred and/or raced by Stronach are Horse of the Year Ghostzapper (Awesome Again), champions Glorious Song (Halo), Perfect Sting (Red Ransom), Macho Uno (Holy Bull) and Ginger Punch (Awesome Again); GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero Awesome Again (Deputy Minister); and Classic winners Red Bullet (Unbridled) and Touch Gold (Deputy Minister).



**Leonard Lavin**

**GLEN HILL FARM - Coil** Glen Hill Farm was founded by Leonard Lavin, who developed the Alberto-Culver Company, a major producer of well-known consumer brands, into a Fortune 1000 company in the late 1950s. He is also the author of "Winners Make It Happen: Reflections of a Self-Made Man." The

Chicago native purchased the former Greentree Stud property in Ocala, FL in 1966, and had his first stakes win at Hawthorne the following year. Top runners campaigned by Glen Hill include MGSW & MGISP Relaunch (In Reality), GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner and homebred One Dreamer (Relaunch) and, more recently, MGSW Banned (Kitten's Joy)--also bred by Glen Hill. Lavin's grandson Craig Bernick took over as president and CEO of Glen Hill in 2008, and has set out to revitalize the farm. The operation owns about 25 mares and has a total horse population of around 120. Tom Proctor trains all Glen Hill colorbearers.

**G Watts Humphrey**

**G WATTS HUMPHREY JR - Malibu Glow** Humphrey, 67, a native of Ohio, earned a BA from Yale and an MBA from Harvard Business School. He lives in Sewickely, Pa. The grandson of George M. Humphrey, a prominent horse owner in the 1940s who was U.S. Secretary of the Treasury under Dwight Eisenhower from 1953-57, he is the president of a private investment company and chairman of I.P.E.G and Conair, both in the plastics industry. Humphrey owns the 1,000-acre

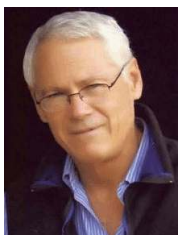
Shawnee Farm near Harrodsburg, Ky, and has approximately 60 broodmares. He bred 1985 GI Belmont S. winner Creme Fraiche (Rich Cream), in partnership with his aunt, Pamela Firman, as well as 1987 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Sacahuista (Raja Baba), in partnership with W.S. Farish. He also races a string of about 25 horses, typically selling the colts and keeping the fillies to add to his broodmare band. His daughter, Vicki Oliver, is a trainer. His wife Sally bred 1981 GI Kentucky Derby winner Genuine Risk (Exclusive Native).

**DR RUSS BERAN & DICK JOHNSON - Moonshine Mullin** Dick Johnson of Omaha, Nebraska, races Moonshine Mullin under his nom du course, Viking Farms. The owner of CoxJohnson Corporation, which produces boat, sports, and travel consumer shows in Nebraska and Iowa, he was in charge of publicity and advertising at South Dakota's Park Jefferson racetrack in the early '60s. Johnson went on to breed Lord Avie (Lord Gaylord), the champion 2-year-old colt of 1980. Dr. Beran is a physician in Omaha who has been in family medicine for more than four decades.



**Bill Graves**

**WILLIAM GRAVES & DENNIS LYNCH - Rattlesnake Bridge** Graves was named Fasig-Tipton's vice president of recruiting and selection in 2010. He had previously served as an account executives and as director of yearling sales for Fasig-Tipton. Lynch operates Lynch Bloodstock in Lexington, and is also part of Fasig-Tipton's yearling selection crew.



**Rob Whiteley**

**LIBERATION FARM & BRANDYWINE FARM - Ruler On Ice** Liberation Farm is the commercial breeding operation of Rob Whiteley. Whiteley, who grew up in Chula Vista, CA, earned a master's degree from Harvard and a Ph. D in psychology from UC Berkeley. It was while looking for a break from the daily stress of the doctorate program that he became a racing fan. He moved to NJ to

join the graduate department at Rutgers University, and established the first Liberation Farm in NJ, beginning a modest breeding operation. After more than a dozen years in academia, Whiteley was hired by Fasig-Tipton to head up the appraisals division, then was tabbed by Carl Icahn to develop and manage Icahn's commercial breeding venture Foxfield.

During his 18-year run at Foxfield, he planned the matings of horses like Better Than Honour (Deputy Minister) and Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy). He went out on his own after Icahn got out of the breeding business in 2005. Through Liberation, he has bred or co-bred GISW's El Corredor (Mr. Greeley), Roman Ruler (Fusaichi Pegasus) (Ruler On Ice's sire) and Henny Hughes (Hennessy). Pam and Jim Robinson breed and sell under the banner Brandywine Farm. They typically co-breed over 100 mares with Liberation annually. The Robinsons bought their first horses when they married in 1971. Pam taught at the University of North Carolina before they moved to Kentucky in 1999. Jim was an electrical engineer at GTE.



**John Gunther**

**JOHN D. GUNTHER & JOHN DARREN GUNTHER JR. - Stay Thirsty** The 65-year-old John D. Gunther grew up in Alberta, Canada. He moved to Vancouver, where he worked as a longshoreman. Gunther attended the races at nearby Hastings Park on the weekends. He later became a stockbroker and is now a senior partner at Jones, Gable & Company Ltd, a Vancouver-based brokerage and investment banking firm. Gunther owns Glennwood Farm, a 340-acre full-service farm. He has bred or co-bred the likes of First Samurai (Giant's Causeway), Stevie Wonderboy (Stephen Got Even), Bending Strings (American Chance) and Eye of the Tiger (American Chance). John Jr., John's son, is also a stockbroker based in Vancouver. Stay Thirsty is one of the first horses the father-son team have bred.

Martin Schwartz

**MARTIN SCHWARTZ - Bowman's Causeway** Born in Connecticut, Schwartz, 66, received an MBA from Columbia University, and went on to great success as a Wall Street trader. He wrote "Pit Bull: Lessons from Wall Street's Champion Trader" in 1998. A racing fan while growing up in the 1960s, Schwartz didn't become involved in the sport until 2000, but his first horse was millionaire Bowman's Band (Dixieland Band). He decided to start

buying and campaigning horses in France in 2007 to take advantage of the lucrative bonus program for the owners of French-breds. Schwartz has also campaigned GISWs Asi Siempre (El Prado {Ire}), Gorella (Fr) (Grape Tree Road {GB}), Lady of Venice (Fr) (Loup Solitaire) and Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}), and annexed the 2009 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches with Elusive Wave (Ire) (Elusive City).



**PEGRAM, WATSON & WEITMAN - Coil** Michael Pegram, Karl Watson and Paul Weitman also campaigned 2009 champion juvenile colt and 2010 champion 3-year-old Lookin At Lucky (Smart Strike), and two-time champion sprinter Midnight Lute (Real Quiet). Pegram, who owns 22 McDonald's franchises in Arizona and Bodine's Casino in Carson City, NV, owned GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Thirty Slews (Slewpy), Hall of Famer Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) and almost-Triple Crown winner Real Quiet (Quiet American). Watson and Weitman each own car dealerships in Arizona.

A # will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a @ will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a ▲ will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a + will indicate first-time starters, an (S) will be used for state-bred races, a (C) will be used for maiden-claiming races and an (R) will be used for other restricted races.

**STUART GRANT - J W Blue** Grant, a 51-year-old Delaware-based attorney, owns the Camden Training Center in Camden, SC, a facility that features one-mile and five-furlong dirt tracks, a seven-furlong turf course and turn-out paddocks. The Brooklyn native followed the sport in his youth, and bought his first racehorse 10 years ago. Involved in the breeding end of the business as well, he also acquired the 350-acre Windham Hill Farms in Paris, Ky. Grant bought J W Blue's dam, Kentucky Storm (Dynaformer), privately with the Travers starter in utero.

**R A HILL STABLE - Malibu Glow** Raymond Hill III, a graduate of Rutgers, founded Institutional Research Services in 1982, and established the NYC-based brokerage firm PCS Securities in 1989. He also co-founded HRC Portfolio Solutions LLC, which raises assets for select investment managers, in 2000. Hill has been a racehorse owner since 2005. He resides in Carmel, NY.



**VIKING FARMS - Moonshine** Mullin Viking Farms is owned by Richard Johnson of Omaha, Nebraska. The owner of CoxJohnson Corporation, which produces boat, sports, and travel consumer shows in Nebraska and Iowa, he was in charge of publicity and advertising at South Dakota's Park Jefferson racetrack in the early '60s. Johnson went on to breed Lord Avie (Lord Gaylord), the champion 2-year-old colt of 1980.

**Prince Khalid Abdullah**

**JUDDMONTE FARMS - Raison d'Etat**  
 Prince Khalid Abdullah of Saudi Arabia founded Juddmonte in 1977, and the breeding and racing operation has become one of the world's most prominent and successful. Juddmonte's famed pink and turquoise silks have crossed the wire on top in 22 Classic races in England, Ireland, France and the U.S. and they have won Grade I or Group 1 races with 40 homebreds. Juddmonte's breeding operation is spread out across eight farms--three in England, two in Ireland and three in Kentucky. They boast a broodmare band of over 300 mares, and have won Broodmare of the Year awards for Hasili (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}), Toussaud (El Gran Senor) and Slightly Dangerous (Roberto). Juddmonte currently stands eight stallions in Europe and two in the U.S., including champion sires Dansili (GB) and Zamindar.



**Nicholas Brady**

**MILL HOUSE - Rattlesnake Bridge Mill House** is the racing and breeding operation of Nicholas F. Brady, 81, who grew up in Far Hills, New Jersey. Brady earned a BA from Yale and an MBA from Harvard before working in the banking and investment industries in New York. He was appointed the U.S. Senator from New Jersey in 1982, then served on various presidential committees for Ronald Reagan before becoming the U.S. Secretary of the Treasury from 1988-1993, when he served under presidents Ronald Reagan and George H.W. Bush. Brady was introduced to racing by his father, James Cox Brady Jr., and is a former chairman of The Jockey Club.

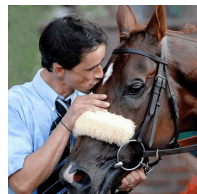

Looking to defend his title in this event, Get Stormy had to work hard on the front end, and his early efforts took a toll late, allowing Turallure to capitalize in the final half-furlong. Despite needing five starts and a trip to the Peapatch to graduate, Turallure followed up with a victory over Brass Hat (Prized) in the Sept. 6 Cliff Williams S. at Ellis Park Sept. 6 and a Keeneland allowance score Oct. 10. Third to the in-form Yankee Fourtune (Yankee Gentleman) in the GIII Commonwealth Turf S. to close his season, he could do no better than eighth to Get Stormy in the GI Maker's Mark Mile S. Apr. 15 in Lexington. Runner-up in Churchill allowance company May 6, he defeated Tajaaweed (Dynaformer) in the Opening Verse S. under the lights in Louisville June 17, but was a non-threatening fifth to many of these rivals in the GII Fourstardave H. July 31. Get Stormy, drawn widest in this field, was ridden for speed and had cleared the field by the time they reached the wire the first time. Turallure, in the meantime, had just two behind him before being asked a bit leaving the far turn. The favorite still held the call and appeared to be going well in the stretch, but Turallure, switched out about five wide by Julien Leparoux, collared him inside the final furlong and was under only hand encouragement late.

**Uncle Mo Returns in King's Bishop cont. from p1**

"We've been pointing for King's Bishop since we started [bringing him back]," said conditioner Todd Pletcher of Uncle Mo. "We envisioned it'd be a tough spot. We're somewhat limited in options. When you have a horse like that, who has accomplished a lot and doesn't have any allowance conditions left, you have to start somewhere. We think he's the kind that's talented enough to do something off the bench like that." The bay has five upbeat works at Saratoga since shipping up from WinStar Farm in Kentucky.

Top-class sprints always feature an abundance of early speed, and the King's Bishop is no exception. **Caleb's Posse**, winner of the GIII Ohio Derby June 4 and fourth in the GIII Iowa Derby June 25, was let go at 12-1 when turning back for the GII Amsterdam S. here Aug. 1. There was no missing him in the lane, however, as the bay swept from last to first with a powerful rally to score by four lengths. Jim Bakke and Gerry Ibister's **Cool Blue Red Hot** makes the same move Caleb's Posse did for the Amsterdam. He was stuck behind a glacial pace in the 1 1/16-mile GII Dwyer S. last time July 2, but rallied to be third. He has been working up a storm at the Spa in the interim, firing bullets Aug. 9 and Aug. 18.

Alex Rankin's **Tar Heel Mom** enters the GI Ballerina S. off a 5 3/4-length waltz in the GII Honorable Miss H. going a furlong shorter here Aug. 7. The 6-year-old Stan Hough trainee has an excellent record at the Spa with three wins from four attempts, and she's also a graded-stakes winner at this trip having annexed the GII Distaff H. at Aqueduct last April. Jerry Romans' **Sassy Image** rose from obscurity to upset **Hilda's Passion** by three lengths at 16-1 in the GI Humana Distaff on the Kentucky Derby undercard May 7 and she hasn't looked back since. The chestnut returned to annex the GIII Winning Colors S. under the Twin

Spire May 30 over a pair of next-out winners, and came from very far out of it to get up in the GI Princess Rooney H. July 9. "She's training phenomenal," said conditioner Dale Romans, who trains Sassy Image for his brother. "She had a super breeze the other day and when she works like that, she usually runs well. I couldn't be happier with her." The "super breeze" was a five-furlong spin in :58.66 Aug. 20--none of the other 36 workers to record a drill at the same distance that day broke the minute mark. Hilda's Passion enters this race off her first off-the-board finish since last July. The bay's highlight reel includes successes in the GII Raven Run S. at Keeneland last October; the GII Inside Information S. at Gulfstream in March; and the GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont in June, but she was sixth of seven with no apparent excuse in the GIII Bed o' Roses H. last time at 35 cents on the dollar behind 15-1 **Tamarind Hall**, who romped by 5 1/4 lengths. "There's no real explanation for her last start," Todd Pletcher, Hilda's Passion's conditioner, admitted. "We thought that the surface was a little peculiar that day. She never really fired, never got going, very unlike her normal performances. So we decided to freshen her up a touch and point for the Ballerina, and she has trained exceptionally well."

A more patient ride from Jose Lezcano, especially given a more favorable pace scenario, could do the trick here. **Romacaca** will try to take her winning streak to six, but faces much tougher rivals than she has of late. Victorious in a pair of black-type events in Florida in April and May, the dark bay added the July 3 Miss Liberty S. at Monmouth prior to a victory in the GIII Taylor Made Matchmaker S. July 31.

**A BOY AMONG MEN**

**Mr. Commons**, unbeaten in two starts on the turf, faces a compact, but talented group in today's G1 Del Mar Mile H. Highly impressive in graduating by better than five lengths down the hill at Santa Anita in January, the bay took a two-turn allowance on the main track the next month and was a decent third in the G1 Santa Anita Derby. He was excluded from the Kentucky Derby with a lack of graded stakes earnings, and an eighth in the G1 Preakness S. earned him a break and a return to the grass. The bay found a good return spot in the restricted Oceanside S. July 20, and he proved too classy for his rivals, scoring by 1 1/2 lengths and giving Mike Smith one of his two wins at the meet. At 114 pounds, he'll get a significant weight concession from his rivals and that could help bridge the gap. **Caracortado** returns to his optimal distance. Very unlucky in finishing second in two of the premier mile events on the Southern California circuit--the G1 F. E. Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita in March and the G1 Shoemaker Mile S. in early July at Hollywood, he tried the nine furlongs of the G1 Eddie Read S. and was an even third to loose-on-the-lead Acclamation (Unusual Heat). **Champ Pegasus** holds a class advantage over the field, but this comes at a distance short of his best and figures as a prep for the 1 1/4-mile G1 Clement Hirsch Turf Championship at Santa Anita next month.

**IN FINE VOICE**

**Poet's Voice**, on the road back, preps for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. in today's G2 Celebration S., the race he used as a springboard to QE II success 12 months ago. Restricted to three outings after his defeat of Rip Van Winkle (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in Ascot's feature last September, he split Wigmore Hall (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) and Presvis (GB) (Sakhee) when second in the G2 Jebel Hatta at Meydan Mar. 3. Either side of that effort, his exuberance got the better of him when down the field in Newmarket's G1 Champion S. in October and in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai World Cup. Saeed bin Suroor, who also saddles last year's G3 Prix Daphnis and G2 Oettingen-Rennen winner **Emerald Commander**, is hoping that it will be a fifth edition for the royal blue silks here. "Poet's Voice is pleasing us after his break following the Dubai World Cup," bin Suroor commented. "He had his last piece of work yesterday and worked very well--he is back in good condition. He will improve a lot from this race. He will benefit from a strong pace in the race and Emerald Commander will be there to ensure they go a good gallop. Emerald Commander has plenty of ability himself and he is also working well at present." Heading the opposition is the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas runner-up **Dubawi Gold**, who was a latest fourth in the G2 Hungerford S. over seven furlongs at Newbury Aug. 13. "Dubawi Gold is the only 3-year-old in the field, but the Classic generation came out on top the last three years and he goes there with a decent chance," trainer Richard Hannon said. "Dubawi Gold did not settle in the Hungerford at Newbury last time and he is best judged on his two excellent runs in the Guineas, at Newmarket and The Curragh. Granted, both were on fastish ground and Goodwood looks like riding slow at best, but it was soft when he won the Hyperion at Ascot last year for Michael Dods, so we'd be hopeful that he will cope with the conditions." Four-time pattern-race scorer **Premio Loco** was third in the G1 Lockinge S. at Newbury May 14 and ran better than his sixth placing suggests in the G3 Sovereign S. at Salisbury last time Aug. 11. "When he ran at Salisbury, he saw less daylight than the Chilean miners down a hole, so you can't take that as a true form guide--he just never got the chance to get out and get racing," trainer Chris Wall told *PA Sport*. "He is very well and has come out of the Salisbury race in good nick."

Twice a winner at this distance against maidens and allowance company at two, the dark bay returned in the one-turn mile GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Feb. 26, setting the pace and fading to fifth. She improved drastically second off the bench, stalking and driving up the rail to score in Aqueduct's GIII Comely S. Apr. 9. Runner-up Her Smile (Include) became a Grade I winner two starts later in the Prioress S. at Belmont, and two other Comely also-rans took stakes in subsequent efforts. The Black-Eyed Susan has also proven a key race. 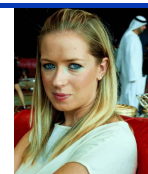

with Darley Flying Start's Sophie Ignarski



The Darley Flying Start Program, established in 2003 to develop potential leaders in the Thoroughbred industry, will celebrate its 10th anniversary in 2013. The *TDN* has asked one of the trainees for 2011-2013, Sophie Ignarski, to blog about her experience, from packing up to join her class at Ireland's Kildangan Stud Aug. 15, until her graduation July 6, 2013.

On Monday the 15th of August, the 12 new Darley Flying Start trainees arrived at Kildangan Stud in Ireland, the first of five different locations where we will be based over the next two years. Although some had endured long journeys from their home countries, everyone seemed in good spirits and eager to 'hit the ground running.'

I was pleased to see that I was not the only member of the group for whom the firm instructions to pack light had fallen by the wayside; one of the other trainees had taken it to an unprecedented level by vacuum-packing the entire contents of his suitcase!

After brief introductions, we were shown to our respective houses on the Stud--'Crimplene,' 'Street Cry' and, somewhat worryingly, for the boys, 'Isolation Yard House.' Once we'd settled into our new homes, the group was invited to lunch, held in the beautiful surroundings of Kildangan House. This was the first occasion for us to meet as a group, and an opportunity to be introduced to several key members of Darley's staff, many of whom will be giving our forthcoming lectures here at Kildangan.

The first week of the program was devoted mainly to logistical tasks, including setting up bank accounts, medicals and IT training. The allocation of the (in)famous Kildangan bicycles was a welcome event, and just one member of the group succumbed to a tumble in one of the Stud's immaculate hedges.

One of the main highlights of the week was a fascinating introduction to Kildangan's resident stallions from nominations manager Mick Buckley. We were fortunate to have the chance to ask plenty of questions, and some interesting discussions followed. We also had the opportunity to visit some of the other Darley Studs in Ireland, where we were able to view several blue-blooded youngsters and top mares, including dual-Classical winning Kazzia.

As in previous years, the two Irish representatives on the course were appointed as team leaders for this leg of the program, and both gave interesting talks introducing the rest of the group to the Irish breeding and racing industries. Jack Davison, 24 grew up on a stud farm in Co. Meath, Ireland, and recently graduated from University College Dublin with a degree in Animal Science (Equine).

Jack worked at both Dromoland Farm and Lane's End in Kentucky, and he tells me his main interest lies in the racing side of the industry.

Reflecting on his first week on the programme, Jack said, "I'm very much interested in the racing side of the industry. So far, my first week on the Darley Flying has been most memorable, as I have been very busy taking everything in--from meeting my new colleagues, who will also be my new friends (with a bit of luck!), to becoming familiar with my beautiful new surroundings here in Kildangan. I can't help but be excited at what lies ahead for us in the upcoming weeks --from stud visits and racing to pedigrees and bloodstock."

Our other Irish representative is Stephen O'Connor, 23, from Co. Kilkenny. Stephen graduated from the University of Limerick with a degree in Equine Science, and has most recently been working with breeding stock at Dromoland Farm in Kentucky.

Giving his first impressions of the programme, Stephen remarked, "After so much anticipation, time is racing along already. The Darley team have made us feel most welcome and at home here in Kildare. One of the highlights for me this week was seeing the Darley stallions, including the imposing Cape Cross and Shamardal. Everything is well organised, and we seem to be a good mix of nationalities and backgrounds,. The next two years look very exciting indeed."

Our first week was rounded off by a fantastic day's racing at The Curragh, which gave many of the trainees their first taste of Irish racing.

"We needed to see this before we stepped up," trainer Bill Mott revealed. "He was coming off races that probably were not good enough for a race like the Travers. He stood in there like a gentlemen, broke well, and he relaxed well down the backside. As for what's next Mott added, "Hopefully there is a 3-year-old race somewhere, [like the GII Pennsylvania Derby], and we were even nominated for the [GII] Super Derby, but it was nice to walk him out of our barn and see him perform on a track that we know he has run well on before. **The SARATOGA Spotlight Race of the Day**

**Race 12 - GI Travers S., 3yo, 1 1/4m**

Stay Thirsty (Bernardini)'s last race was a big step forward, and he deserves to be favored off that effort. His previous races make him only one of a number of contenders, though, and to take too short a price on him would be a mistake. **Raison d'Etat** (A.P. Indy) was all the rage following a 7 3/4-length maiden-breaking romp at Belmont June 18 in his third career start, but appears to have fallen out of favor a bit after finishing a well-beaten second at 9-5 in the Curlin S. here July 29. That effort was much better than what he has been given credit for, however. Unhurried behind a pacesetter who had everything his own way, the Juddmonte representative rallied up wide and easily swept by everyone but the leader ([TDN Video](#)). Winner Turbo Compressor (Halo's Image) just had to keep going--he had done nothing early to tire himself out--and he and Raison d'Etat both finished up well to earn 101 and 97 Beyer Speed Figures, respectively, and late Moss Pace Figures that fall into the "very fast late" category. Raison d'Etat was very green in the stretch of the Curlin--he reacted sharply to Eddie Castro's reminders as if he were on a slalom course--and, with only four starts under his belt, he has plenty of room still for improvement and maturity. The 10-furlong distance of the Travers adds to Bill Mott's charge's upside, and the son of A.P. Indy out of seven-time GISW Sightseek has been working a hole in the wind since his last race. To Honor and Serve (Bernardini)'s performance yesterday for Mott was a positive sign, and Raison d'Etat is similar to GI Alabama S. winner Royal Delta (Empire Maker) in many ways. The Hall of Famer just might find himself in the winner's circle for the second consecutive Saturday following a Grade I for 3-year-olds at 1 1/4 miles. **Yesterday's Results:** Paris Vegas was completely stymied and stopped when attempting to make his run, and finished seventh with a chart comment that fails to mention his trouble. His form is significantly darkened, and he's a bet back depending on where he returns. *For more Saratoga analysis, visit the [TDN Blog](#).*

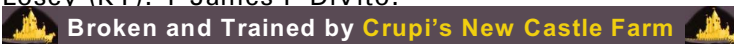

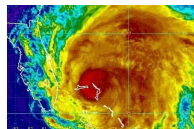
