Trainer Bob Baffert bids for his third straight edition of the \$1-million GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar this afternoon. The snow-capped conditioner saddled Richard's Kid (Lemon Drop Kid) to victory in 2009 and 2010, and also sent out General Challenge (General Meeting) for the win in 1999. This year's candidate is **Game On Dude** (Awesome Again), who exits a nose runner-up finish behind First Dude (Stephen Got Even) in the GI Hollywood Gold Cup at the Pac Classic trip of 10 panels. Baffert still has work to do to tie the mark for success in the race, however. The late Bobby Frankel holds the record, with six victories, including four in a row from 1992-95. **Cont. p9**

**A Dry Spell...**

Stay Thirsty showed promise early on the Triple Crown trail, taking the GIII Gotham S. in March, but he was well-beaten in the GI Florida Derby in April and GI Kentucky Derby in May, and it was time to regroup. The dark bay skipped the GI Preakness S., and rebounded with a solid second-place effort in the June 11 GI Belmont S. He powered home a four-length winner in the Jim Dandy, and went to the head of the class with his gutsy Travers score. In front through an opening quarter in :23.45, he settled as they came around the first turn and let Shackleford have the lead. That rival faded before they'd gone a mile, and Stay Thirsty turned back all comers for the victory.

"He's really gotten so much better since the Kentucky Derby," trainer Todd Pletcher said. "He was so courageous today--he ran hard the whole way." As for what's next, Pletcher offered, "We'll look at the [GI] Jockey Club Gold Cup [at Belmont, Oct. 1]. We need a bridge between here and the [Nov. 5] Breeders' Cup, and that's the most likely one." Mike Repole, who less than an hour earlier watched his Uncle Mo go down to defeat in the GI King's Bishop, remarked, "It's a roller-coaster game--it's bi-polar. What we just saw in the last half hour for Todd Pletcher and Mike Repole? The highest, the lowest, in 30 minutes. It's a tough loss with Uncle Mo and probably the best win of my life with the Travers. It would've been a monster double."

**Family Affair...**

Stay Thirsty is one of the first horses bred by the father and son Vancouver-based stock-broking team of John D. and John Darren Gunther. The mare, in foal to Kingmambo, was picked up for just \$50,000 at KEENOV 2003. The three foals they have sold out of the mare have grossed \$710,000. Barren in 2010, she produced a Smart Strike filly this year.

Uncle Mo turned in a remarkable performance off a four-month layoff in the King's Bishop and, though he was upstaged in the final jump by an in-form Caleb's Posse, last year's Eclipse Award-winning juvenile lost very little in defeat. Three-for-four at two going one turn, Caleb's Posse focused on routes early this year, taking the Smarty Jones S. in January at Oaklawn and finishing second to The Factor (War Front) in that track's GII Rebel S. before a 12th in the GI Arkansas Derby Apr. 16. He bounced back to land the GIII Ohio Derby June 4, but was only fourth in the GIII Iowa Derby three weeks later. Connections decided to return him to sprints, and he came with a powerful late run for a 12-1 upset of the GII Amsterdam S. here Aug. 1. Last or second-last for the opening half-mile, Caleb's Posse got underway approaching the stretch and set sail for Uncle Mo, who sat closer to the speed and bid four wide into the lane. The Repole runner went after a tiring Flashpoint (Pomeroy) while drifting in leaving the eighth pole and drove for the wire, but Caleb's Posse was able to get his nose down first. "My horse is a closer," said winning jockey Rajiv Maragh. "He broke well, but he wanted to settle back a little bit. I tried to time my run right, and I was fortunate to get up in time." Despite the narrow loss, Mike Repole was thrilled with the comeback effort of Uncle Mo. "I think the horse ran great," he commented, but added, "We don't know how much that race took out of him." Repole hinted that the champ might be retired.

It was a race filled with drama--Tar Heel Mom stumbled at the start, and Sassy Image (Broken Vow) bolted on the far turn, but Hilda's Passion was in the clear all the way, leading gate to wire to take her first Grade I. Tar Heel Mom recovered to chase the pace, but was left in the dust down the lane. Hilda's Passion was first or second in her first five tries this term, including 5 1/4-length tallies in the Mar. 19 GII Inside Information S. at Gulfstream and the June 4 GII Vagrancy S. at Belmont, but beat just

one home at 3-10 in her latest, the GIII Bed o'Roses S. at Big Sandy July 3. She was let go at 5-2 in the Ballerina. Sent right to the front by jockey Javier Castellano, the bay cut out fractions of :45.13 and 1:09.19, then simply exploded down the lane to leave her rivals gasping. "I don't know what happened to her last time," Castellano said. "I'm glad it's over and we've turned the page. Today, it was a great day. I knew she was going to give me a good performance." Added trainer Todd Pletcher, "We were wanting to be where we were, and it looked like she was doing it the right way." Robby Albarado, aboard 7-5 Sassy Image, said, "I don't know what happened, she just wanted to bolt. She was just unmanageable. She felt sound under me and she's never shown anything like that."

Bidding for her fourth win from her last five starts, and her third in a row, Daveron collared pacesetter Tapitsfly in the waning yards and drew clear. The chestnut mare started her career in her native land, where she took a listed event in May of 2009. Team Valor acquired the mare as a yearling for €100,000 at the 2006 BBAG sale, and sent her to the U.S. for a solid 2010 campaign, with wins in an optional claimer in May and the Scoot S. in October, both at Belmont Park. But the mare proved a late bloomer, capturing the May 7 Gill Beaugay S. at Belmont and July 4 Dr. Jack Penny Memorial S. at Parx in two well-spaced prior outings this term. Stepping up as she attempted to add to her streak, Daveron rated in fourth as the grey Tapitsfly cut out the pace on a clear lead. She emerged from the pack when they straightened for home and ran down the frontrunner in deep stretch before edging clear. "When things go right for her, she's pretty impressive," trainer Graham Motion said. "I don't think she could have won any easier today." Motion did not outline future plans, but added, "She's very highly strung--that's why we pace her races out."

She left it to the last moment, but Hot Summer, from the team who brought you champion Big Drama (Montbrook), slipped up inside pacesetter Maple Forest to score at the Spa Saturday. The dark bay capped off 2010 with a maiden win at Monmouth in October and an impressive allowance tally at Parx in November. Fifth in the Gill Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Feb. 26, she rebounded to capture the Gill Comely S. at Aqueduct Apr. 9, and most recently ran third in the May 20 Gill Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico. Caught in traffic in the early going, the Virginia-bred was well back as Maple Forest blazed through a half in :44.23. She saved ground on the bend and was gifted a clear path on the rail down the lane, running down the pacesetter to get up in the shadow of the wire. Trainer David Fawkes indicated Hot Summer could be trained up to the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint at Churchill Nov. 4. "It's possible," Fawkes said. "I have to talk to [owner Harold Queen]." He added, "I wouldn't mind seeing her go seven-eighths."

Dubawi Gold enjoyed a lofty reputation at two when under the care of Michael Dods, but he managed only a runner-up placing in the Listed Woodcate S. on Epsom Derby day and a seven-furlong conditions win at Ascot in October. Revitalised by a switch to Richard Hannon, he rattled up a brace of listed wins on Lingfield's Polytrack in the Mar. 26 Spring Cup and Apr. 9 International Trial S., but was no match for Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire})--though best of the rest--in the Apr. 30 G1 2000 Guineas. The bay's run was left late by Richard Hughes in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later, and he was second again, but could do no better than sixth in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 14 and was given a bit of a breather. Too free for his own good on his comeback when fourth in the G2 Hungerford S. over a panel shorter at Newbury Aug. 13, he switched off for Hughes this time in a detached last, but found himself temporarily short of room traveling best of all nearing the final furlong. As soon as daylight appeared on the outside, he darted through and coasted alongside Set the Trend in the final yards for a snug success. "I always said that, when he gets cut in the ground, he'll be better, and although I got a bit of stick after the Irish Guineas, he changed his legs two or three times," Hughes said. Connections are now looking at the Sept. 11 G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp and the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Oct. 15.

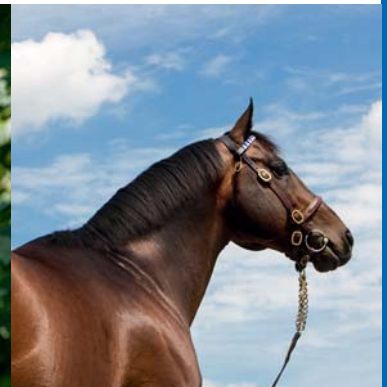

The bay, winner of the May 14 GII Jim Murray H., June 11 GI Charlie Whittingham H. and July 23 GI Eddie Read S., zipped six panels in 1:12 3/5 on the Del Mar main Aug. 22, prompting his connections to go for his fourth in a row over the track. "He worked the last quarter in :23 and looked great doing it, so we're going to take a shot," trainer Don Warren said. "I thought for weeks we should leave him on turf. But you have to reserve your opinion until you see him work [on Polytrack] and, after that, we thought we might as well go for the million." In his last all-weather attempt, Acclamation ran third in the GII Strub S. at Santa Anita in February of 2010.

## THE X FACTOR

Aug. 20. His three efforts prior to the Arkansas debacle were also impressive, as he reeled off consecutive victories in a Santa Anita maiden test Dec. 26, the GII San Vicente S. Feb. 20 and the GIII Rebel S. at Oaklawn Mar. 19. One thing is for sure, however--The Factor will be in front early. "There's no rate in him," trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's one of those horses that takes them as far as he can." The ultra-consistent **Smiling Tiger** could contest the pace, or sit back and make a run at The Factor down the lane. The 4-year-old rallied to take the GII San Carlos H. at Santa Anita in February and the GIII Count Fleet H. at Oaklawn in April, but wired the field in the GI Triple Bend H. at Hollywood July 2. Off a step slowly in the July 31 GI Bing Crosby S. at Del Mar, he came on late to be second to Euroears (Langfuhr). **Crown of Thorns**, runner-up in this event last year, shortens up after taking the 1 1/16-mile GII Mervyn LeRoy H. May 7 and running seventh in the 1 1/8-mile GI Stephen Foster H. June 18.

Since her neck defeat in the Silver Flash, **La Collina** has upstaged Maybe's stable companion Power (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}) in the G1 Phoenix S. over six furlongs three weeks ago, and trainer Kevin Prendergast is hopeful she has improved enough to make a race of it with Maybe again. "The last time she met Maybe, that filly had been to Ascot and had plenty of experience," he told *PA Sport*. "Maybe is a February foal and La Collina is an April foal, so she had a couple of months on us, so we might make it up this time. We think she has a fighting chance." Another who has gone to defeat behind the favorite, **Rubina** was soundly beaten in fourth behind Ballydoyle's **Maybe** in the Aug. 7 G2 Debutante S. over this track and trip. Rubina's trainer John Oxx is also hoping that experience will help his filly as she bids to make up ground on the favorite. "She ran well in the Debutante," Oxx told *PA Sport*. "Obviously, she's up against it with Maybe, who beat her easily the last day, and La Collina as well. She will have come on for the run and we're running, like a lot of other people, for a chance of sneaking into the money."

Back on track with a victory in the Jan. 17 GII San Marcos S. and second by a nose in the Feb. 19 GII San Luis Obispo S., he faded to 11th when shipped to the Middle East for the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. The bay picked up minor awards in the June 11 GI Charlie Whittingham H. at Hollywood and the July 2 GI United Nations S. at Monmouth before switching to the all-weather to annex the July 29 GIII Cougar II H. at Del Mar. He withdrew from the GI Pacific Classic in favor of this spot.

Runner-up to Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the May 22 G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp, the five-year-old beat a pair of subsequent top-level scorers in Announce (GB) (Selkirk) and Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) in that venue's G3 La Coupe June 13 before running second to another star distaffer in Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse To Bend {Ire}) in the June 26 G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. His last two outings have resulted in successes by three lengths and eight lengths, respectively, in the July 20 G3 Grand Prix de Vichy and G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron over 10 furlongs here Aug. 14. If he stays this far in testing ground he is the one to beat. Last year's winner **Marinous** comes here with only one placed effort in eight subsequent starts. **Silver Pond** rates a bigger threat to the favorite off his win in the June 5 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly and latest third in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud.

### WAGING WAR

Undiminished at the age of eight, **War Artist** returns to the scene of his defeat of **Smooth Operator** two years ago in the the G2 Goldene Peitsche S. Holding his form admirably this term, the veteran was a head second to J J the Jet Plane (SAf) (Jet Master (SAf) in the G2 Al Quoz Sprint at Meydan Mar. 26 and was far from disgraced when subsequently fifth in the G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot June 14 and seventh in the G1 July Cup at Newmarket July 9. Last year's winner **Amico Fritz** warrants respect despite his no-show in the July Cup, while it is significant that **Rose Blossom** has been supplemented by Highclere Thoroughbred Racing. Last year's G3 Summer S. winner and G1 Nunthorpe S. fifth-place finisher returned to winning ways last time in Pontefract's Listed Flying Fillies' S. Aug. 14. "We took a decision to supplement her for this race and, apart from running her in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye, it's the last chance to have a crack at a Group event which, on her best form, she can be competitive in," Highclere's Harry Herbert told PA Sport, "She's in very good form. We did have her in a couple of Listed races this weekend, but we have finished in front of War Artist before, so it must make sense to try to win a Group 2 and a well-known sprint race for the pedigree book."

# RACETRACK ROUND-UP

**Pour Moi Retired...**

Andre Fabre yesterday announced that the G1 Epsom Derby hero **Pour Moi (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}--Gwynn {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}) has been retired through injury. Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's colt was being trained for the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp when the misfortune struck. He will stand at Coolmore Stud. Speaking to *PA Sport*, Fabre said, "He badly over-reached himself on his off-fore and I'm afraid he won't run again. It's difficult to mend. What he did at Epsom was amazing, to go from last to first. For a horse to get there so easily, the turn of foot he showed was a sign of great ability. When a horse comes from behind, they are sometimes difficult to rate, but the way he accelerated in the Greffulhe was good and in the Derby it was amazing. I have never trained a middle-distance horse that had such acceleration." Speaking of the injury, his trainer added, "It happened two days ago, and when it was scanned you could see what the damage was. It was deeper than we thought. I'm sure he will be a super sire. He's a beautiful, well-bred colt with a fantastic action and a change of pace." In total, Pour Moi won three of his five starts, including the aforementioned May 7 G2 Prix Greffulhe at Saint-Cloud, when his dramatic acceleration was first witnessed and earned almost €900,000 in prizemoney. His last-to-first surge in the June 4 Epsom Classic remains the highlight of a brief career and the form of the blue riband has since been boosted by the G1 Irish Derby and G1 Secretariat S. success of the runner-up Treasure Beach (GB) (Galileo {Ire}).

The 2-year-old maiden races on the Travers undercard always offer a first glance at future stars--champion Uncle Mo (Indian Charlie) garnered the **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** distinction for his romp here last year--and the trend continued in 2011. Fire On Ice, whose dam is a half to champion sprinter Squirtle Squirt (Marquetry), didn't secure a winning bid at KEEAPR after working in :21 3/5 over the Polytrack ([Video](#)), but co-owner John Kimmel had the grey ready to roll at first asking here off an upbeat series of works. Taking significant action to be as low as 2-1 into the teeth of a heavily touted Pletcher/Repole entry, Fire On Ice was 5-2 at the offing. He was pumped from the bell by David Cohen to secure the lead, and set splits of :22.29 and :45.07 with Casual Trick (Bernardini) at his right hip. Fire On Ice shook clear at the top of the lane, and the hulking colt poured it on to cruise by 10 3/4 lengths. 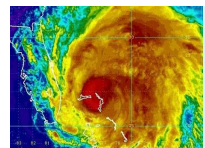
