Hurricane Foils Havre de Grace Work Schedule...

Fox Hill Farms' **Havre de Grace** (Saint Liam) was forced to miss her final workout yesterday as she prepares to face the boys in Saturday's GI Woodward S. at Saratoga. "We'll just gallop into it," trainer Larry Jones said Monday. "We normally would have breezed today and, of course, there was no training today at Delaware Park [due to the effects of Hurricane Irene]."

When asked if he would try to work Havre de Grace a day later than expected,

Jones replied, "I doubt it. Hopefully, we'll get on the track tomorrow. If we don't get it going, we may ship up tomorrow to Saratoga. I really don't know." Havre de Grace, winner of the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn in April and recently second, beaten a nose, by familiar foe Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) in the July 16 GII Delaware H., is expected to face six males: **Convocation** (Pulpit), **Flat Out** (Flatter), **Giant Oak** (Giant's Causeway), **Ice Box** (Pulpit), **Mission Impazible** (Unbridled's Song) and **Rule** (Roman Ruler). "It is what it is," Jones said of the formidable line-up. "We've got to go out and see what we've got. It's too early [to discuss strategy]. We'll fly by the seat of our pants."

So You Think Opposition Cuts Up...

Aidan O'Brien was responsible for three of the six entries remaining in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. at Leopardstown, with **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) set to start at long odds-on for the prestigious 10-furlong contest. The seven-time Group 1-winning 5-year-old has been enjoying a summer rest since beating Workforce (GB) (King's Best) in the July 2 G1 Eclipse at Sandown. He could be joined by stable companions **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Recital (Fr)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who have also been on the shelf for the last few weeks. Ed Dunlop is set to saddle Cristina Patino's four-time top-level scorer **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab), while Dermot Weld has declared Khalid Abdullah's **Famous Name (GB)** (Dansili {GB}), and Kevin Prendergast has left in John Connaughton's **Dunboyne Express (Ire)** (Shamardal).

Sidney's Candy Confirmed for Forego...

Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}), who annexed the GII Fourstardave H. over the turf at Saratoga July 31 in his first start for trainer Todd Pletcher and co-owners WinStar Farm and Rubio B Stable, will turn back and switch surfaces for Saturday's GI Forego S. at seven furlongs. "The Woodward and the Forego are very attractive races, and Sidney's Candy is a horse who is so good at all these things," said Pletcher. "But we felt the seven-eighths was a little more comfortable distance than the 1 1/8 miles." Pletcher will also send out Dogwood Stable's GII Churchill Downs S. winner **Aikenite** (Yes It's True) in the Forego. He was fifth last out in the track-and-trip James Marvin S. "Aikenite's last race was good--it was just such a tough race," Pletcher said. "He probably ended up a little closer to the pace than he ideally wanted. He still ran a very credible race."

Future for Uncle Mo, Stay Thirsty in Flux...

Todd Pletcher said Monday that future plans had not been finalized for Mike Repole's GI Travers S. winner **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) or GI King's Bishop S. runner-up **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie). "I've had approximately 12 conversations with Mike, but nothing is formed up," joked Pletcher. "The most likely scenario for Stay Thirsty is the [GI] Jockey Club Gold Cup [at Belmont Oct. 1]. I suppose there's some wiggle room there; the [GII] Pennsylvania Derby [at Parx] is a week sooner against straight 3-year-olds." He continued, "The Pennsylvania Derby is also an option for Uncle Mo. I suppose if we felt like he needed another week, a race like the [GII] Kelso [H. at Belmont] could be in the mix. The Breeders' Cup Classic is 1 1/4 miles and we still have aspirations to making that race with Uncle Mo. Between now and then, if we need to stretch him out and want to go 1 1/4 miles, I don't know if the Kelso at a mile would be long enough for us to get there. So we'll have to play it by ear."

Big Drama Nears Comeback...

Reigning sprint champion **Big Drama** (Montbrook), sidelined since a track-record setting victory in the GIII Mr. Prospector S. in January, could return to the races this weekend. The 5-year-old worked a bullet five furlongs at Calder Sunday in 1:01.00 and may start next Sunday in the Florida track's Whippleton S. "I'm running out of time with him if I want to get him back to the Breeders' Cup," trainer David Fawkes told *Daily Racing Form*. "I'd love to start him back over his home track, but if the race at Calder doesn't go, I'll probably send him to the Icecade S. at Monmouth Park on Monday."

Bewitched Targets Cup...

Trainer Charles O'Brien yesterday confirmed triple group scorer **Bewitched (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) is on course for Saturday's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup, for which 17 were in the mix yesterday after **Hoof It (GB)** (Monsieur Bond {Ire}) was the sole supplementary at the six-day stage. Sent off the 3-1 favorite for the June 18 G1 Golden Jubilee S. at Royal Ascot, the Susan Magnier and Jacqueline O'Brien-owned 4-year-old filly flopped when beating only two home there, but her trainer reports her back on track. "She's an intended runner at Haydock, all going well, and I'm very happy with her," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "She was in quite a bad way after Ascot and very sore. It has taken a while to get her right, but I think she's back on song now." Hoof It's connections revealed yesterday that the 4-year-old Stewards Cup winner will be reunited with Graham Gibbons in the six-furlong contest after recent partner Kieren Fallon was claimed to ride for Luca Cumani at Ascot. David Easterby, assistant to trainer Mick Easterby, told the *Racing Post*, "We've booked Graham for the ride; he's ridden him before, and he was actually jockeyed off him before Kieren took over. I think he's the best jockey in the north--nothing fazes him." Other notables include Khalifa Dasmal's July 9 G1 July Cup hero **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}), Jan and Peter Hopper and Michelle Morris' impressive Aug. 7 G3 Phoenix Sprint S. winner **Deacon Blues (GB)** (Compton Place {GB}) and Khalid Abdullah's July Cup runner-up **Bated Breath (GB)** (Dansili {GB}).

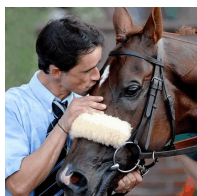

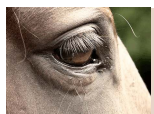

With memories of Secretariat remaining vivid to this day, it is easy to understand why breeders were always keen to inbreed to this legendary performer. As the 1973 Triple Crown winner was responsible for the dams of the champion sires A.P. Indy and Storm Cat, it was inevitable that breeders would jump at the chance of combining the two. To the end of last year, Storm Cat mares had 73 foals by A.P. Indy, with another 128 by sons of A.P. Indy, including 10 from the first crop by the dazzling Bernardini.

So far this type of cross has produced just two Grade I winners in Sky Mesa and Dialed In, both of whom were sired by stallions representing the potent A.P. Indy/Mr. Prospector nick. As for Bernardini, the best of his 3-year-olds out of Storm Cat mares appears to be Buffum, but there have also been recent maiden victories by Refugio and Achieving at Woodbine, to take his total of winners among his 10 3-year-olds to five. He has also recently been represented by Spare Change, a maiden winner at Saratoga, who is one of nine members of Bernardini's second crop with a Storm Cat dam.

Summer Squall, a stallion bred on the same Storm Bird/Secretariat cross as Storm Cat, has also come into the picture thanks to his daughter Heat Lightning. Mated to A.P. Indy's sons Stephen Got Even and Bernardini, she has produced the champion 2-year-old Stevie Wonderboy and the three-time English stakes winner Theyskens' Theory, respectively. These two are inbred 3x3 to Secretariat's daughter Weekend Surprise, which means that they are also inbred 4x4 to that highly influential mare Lassie Dear. **Cont. p5**

The question that has to be asked is how much is inbreeding to Secretariat contributing to the success of this type of cross. I suspect the answer is not a lot. Mating A.P. Indy or his sons to mares by Storm Bird, the sire of Storm Cat and Summer Squall, doesn't produce any inbreeding to Secretariat. Yet there are two stakes winners among A.P. Indy's 14 foals out of Storm Bird mares, and now there are two graded winners among the first 46 foals by sons of A.P. Indy. The latest is Stay Thirsty, who followed in Bernardini's footsteps to triumph in the GI Travers S., having earlier emulated his sire's success in the GI Jim Dandy S. The only inbreeding in Stay Thirsty's first five generations is 5x3 to Northern Dancer.

Darley must have been delighted to see Bernardini come up with his third Grade I winner following last year's victories by Biondetti (another out of a grand-daughter of Northern Dancer) and A Z Warrior. Coincidentally, Darley also bred Stay Thirsty's dam, Marozia. This daughter of Storm Bird was distinctly ordinary as a racemare and it wasn't until she was four that she gained her only victory in nine starts, in a 1 1/2-mile handicap for horses rated zero to 70 on Lingfield's all-weather surface.

Darley promptly dispatched her to the 1998 December Sales, where Eaton Sales paid 210,000gns for her, in recognition of her excellent American bloodlines. It is easy to see why Marozia would be considered surplus to Darley's requirements. Time Changes, her year-younger three-parts sister by Danzig, had won the Listed Prix Isola Bella over a mile nine days before Marozia was sold.

As often happens, the less talented racemare has proven the superior producer. Not that Time Changes failed to make her mark. Although her Halling gelding Age of Reason had a Timeform rating of 116 at his best, this pales in comparison with Marozia's feat of producing three sons with Grade I form. **Cont. p6**

The first, her Fusaichi Pegasus colt Andromeda's Hero, was second to Afleet Alex in the 2005 GI Belmont S. and later finished third behind Invasor in the GI Suburban H. and behind Bernardini in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup.

Andromeda's Hero's younger full-brother Superfly showed he was also above average at two when third in First Samurai's GI Champagne S. But Stay Thirsty is undoubtedly Marozia's best effort. She can now be mentioned in the same breath as Storm Bird's other good broodmare daughters, which include Dear Birdie (dam of Birdstone and Bird Town), Weekend Storm (dam of Court Vision), Line of Thunder (dam of Thunder Gulch), Classy Mirage (dam of Dublin), Mystic Goddess (dam of the good English sire Medicean) and Starlet Storm (dam of Flanders). Commentator, Sand Springs, Thorn Song and Avanzado are other Grade I winners with dams by Storm Bird.

Stay Thirsty showed plenty of determination in winning the Travers. He had previously shown plenty of stamina in finishing a close second to Ruler On Ice in the Belmont S., a race which in the past fell to Bernardini's sire and grandsire. His dam, as previously mentioned, also won over a mile and a half, showing more stamina than many daughters of Storm Bird. For this she could thank her dam Make Change. Although Make Change won only a minor stakes race, she was good enough--and unfortunate enough--to finish second in four Grade I events, including two over a mile and a quarter.

With Roberto as her sire and a granddaughter of Ribot as her dam, Make Change was bred similarly to Dynaformer, Sunshine Forever and Brian's Time. The granddaughter of Ribot was the CCA Oaks runner-up Equal Change, a daughter of yet another Belmont S. winner in Arts and Letters. Equal Change was herself a half-sister to Solford, the Nijinsky II colt who landed the G1 Eclipse S. in 1983.

Older readers may recognize that this is a first-rate female line. Stay Thirsty's fifth dam, Equal Venture, was best known as the dam of Prove Out, who became one of the few horses to defeat Secretariat, in the 1 1/2-mile Woodward S. This grandson of Ribot also won the Jockey Club Gold Cup in its days over two miles. Equal Venture was herself a sister to the 1946 Triple Crown winner Assault, so no one could accuse Stay Thirsty of having a pedigree unworthy of a potential leader of his generation.

GULFSTREAM ADDS TRAKUS Gulfstream Park will undergo a \$3-million capital improvement project in advance of its upcoming 2011-2012 race season, which runs from Dec. 3 through Apr. 8. The project includes the addition of the Trakus system, which uses wireless technology to monitor every horse at every moment in a race and to provide trip distance, peak and average speeds and margins and rail distance. Gulfstream will also install six new Daktronics boards throughout the facility, providing fans with a higher resolution image. Some 250 covered stadium seats will be added to the track's popular Tiki Hut area. "The capital improvement projects underway are just another sign of Mr. Frank Stronach and The Stronach Entertainment Group's commitment to Thoroughbred racing and to our fans, both locally and globally," said Gulfstream's President and General Manager Timothy Ritvo. "While the new Gulfstream was constructed only six years ago, Mr. Stronach is committed to giving Gulfstream a facelift and keeping up with the latest in video technology."

F-T TEXAS SUMMER YEARLINGS TODAY The Fasig-Tipton Texas Summer Yearlings sale will be held at 10:00 a.m. today on the grounds of Lone Star Park in Grand Prairie, Texas. A total of 372 yearlings have been catalogued, and the sale will also feature Phase III of the Heiligbrodt Racing Stable Dispersal. Fifty three horses of racing age make up that portion of the sale. "Talk about critical mass," said local director of sales Tim Boyce. "This year's catalogue includes 49 Texas-breds, 214 Louisiana-breds and 52 Oklahoma-breds. Our sire power is exciting with about 20% of the sires being first year sires such as Brother Derek, Divine Park, Into Mischieff, Midnight Lute, Red Giant, and Tiz Wonderful. All had horses sell for \$100,000 or more at the recently concluded Fasig-Tipton Summer Select Sale in Kentucky." Boyce continued, "With the sale being on Tuesday, it will give buyers an extra day of looking. 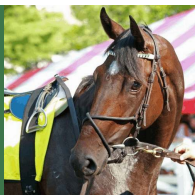
