SAYING GRACE AT THE SPA

On paper, **True Feelings** (Latent Heat) might have looked the stronger half of the Michael Dubb, et al, entry in the GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga Sunday. But on the track it was **Grace Hall** (Empire Maker) who gave her owners a reason to be thankful. The bay broke sharply, but took back to track the leaders from fourth through early fractions of :22.71 and :45.96. Fanned four wide at the top of the lane, she collared **Judy the Beauty** (Ghostzapper) in deep stretch and was drawing away late. "I was on her a couple of times just breezing her, and she was very sensible in the morning," jockey Ramon Dominguez said. "[Trainer] Tony [Dutrow] told me how much he liked her, and, coming from him, I knew she had to be special. Sure enough, today she showed how good she is." Co-owner Michael Dubb is founder and president of The Beechwood Organization, the largest residential home building and development company on Long Island. The New York native became involved in racing first as a consultant on the building of Anna House, the childcare center at Belmont Park, in 1998. He ventured into horse ownership as part of a partnership group in 2000. Dubb was the leading owner at the 2010 Belmont Park sprint/summer meet. **Cont. p2**

With divisional leader Overdriven (Tale of the Cat) sidelined, can **J C's Pride** (Henny Hughes) take over the title of best juvenile on the East Coast? He has that chance in today's GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga. The Joseph Bucci colorbearer was runner-up to Overdriven in his debut at Belmont July 1, but came back to post the easiest kind of maiden win, scoring by a handy 3 1/4 lengths at the Spa July 27

([video](#)). He earned **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** status for the effort. "He's very, very rapid," said trainer Bobby Barbara. "But, he's very easy to handle. I'm hoping he gets out of the gate like he did in his first two starts, stays in front, and relaxes on the lead." But Barbara isn't afraid the chestnut will get caught up in a speed duel. "If someone runs at him down the backside, he's not a horse who's going to grab the bridle and run off," he added. J C's Pride stretches out off his five-furlong graduation performance, but the added distance is not a worry for his connections. "If he runs as fluidly and smoothly as he did when he broke his maiden, he'll handle it," said Barbara. "Plus, he's got a wonderful mind. That's what's going to keep him sound and good, because he's not aggressive and running off." **Cont. p10**

Grace Hall broke her maiden as a 4-1 shot at first asking, going gate to wire to win by three lengths at Delaware Park July 30. The Darley-bred filly changed tactics as she stepped up to the Grade I ranks at second asking, but the result was much the same. "I'm overwhelmed," trainer Tony Dutrow said. "We don't get to do that much. I am so happy. For the second race of her life, she answered a lot of questions today." Sheikh Maktoum Al Maktoum's Gainsborough Stud purchased second dam Dream Season (Mr. Prospector) for \$900,000 as a KEEJUL yearling in 1990. Unraced, she produced three stakes horses, including first dam Season's Greetings (Ire), a listed winner and three times group placed.

Danedream had the clear-best credentials entering this prestigious prize, which her sire Lomitas (GB) had captured 20 years ago, and Germany's emerging force did not let the Baden-Baden faithful down. Smart at two, the bay finished first past the post in the Listed Criterium de FEE at Deauville in August, only to be disqualified and placed third, before staying on to be sixth in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on Arc day. She was a rallying third in the G3 Preis der Winterkonigin over a mile here in late October. The middle-distance Classics were on her agenda at three, and she was just warming up when fourth in the Listed Premio Seregno over a mile of the San Siro circuit Apr. 10. Third behind Crackerjack King (Ire) (Shamardal) in the G2 Derby Italiano at the Capannelle May 7, she built on that effort to register a commanding 6 1/2-length success in the G2 Oaks d'Italia back in Milan 22 days later. Danedream was not seen in her best light when fifth under a five-pound penalty in the G2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud June 26, but showed her true ability with a five-length defeat of Scalp (Ger) (Lando {Ger}) in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Hoppegarten last time July 24.

The bay was unaffected yesterday by a false start involving Silvaner (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}), Waldpark (Ger) (Dubawi {Ire}) and last year's winner Night Magic, and allowed the latter to stride on in the early stages, with jockey Andrasch Starke content to confer a two-length advantage to that rival. With Night Magic's rider Karoly Kerekes keeping a

hold on the leader in the deep ground caused by the persistent downpour, Danedream was able to easily keep tabs on the grey and, when the button was pressed on the turn for home, she swooped on the front end in a matter of strides. Grabbing the stand's rail and sprinting clear, she needed only to be kept up to her work to secure the win, and probably domestic champion status in the process. "Before the race, the going was really the big worry, as Danedream had never encountered such heavy going. But she and Night Magic had a great trip," Starke said of the winner, who was providing the Peter Schiergen barn with a fifth renewal. "When I asked for more in the straight, she responded immediately and took off. She is absolutely amazing. She keeps improving, and I don't know where she finds the strength." Connections are considering supplementing for either the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 2 or GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Nov. 4.

Since his impressive success in this 12 months ago, Indian Days had been tried at the top level on four occasions. He was not a factor in those events, but still managed to add Newbury's G3 John Porter S. to his tally Apr. 16. Only ninth last time in the G3 Glorious S. at Goodwood July 29, the veteran overcame some late trouble to rebound in this valuable prize. The chestnut, settled towards the rear early, was making steady progress before being hampered approaching the final furlong, where Campanologist was sent on. Finding a gap in time, he made up over two lengths on Godolphin's raider to snatch the victory in the shade of the post. "He made a lot of ground up in the last 100 meters, and I'm very proud of him," trainer James Given commented. "Alan thought the line might come too soon." Indian Days was no better than ninth in the G1 Hong Kong Vase last December, but Given added, "If we get an invitation, we'd like to go back."

Musir was the undoubted class act of this line-up, and was ultimately not hard-pressed to get back to winning ways following an intense period of top competition. Having booked a trip to Dubai when flaunting his ability in the 2009 G1 Golden Horseshoe at Greyville, the bay

was unbeaten during the 2010 Carnival at Meydan, and scooped the G3 UAE 2000 Guineas and G2 UAE Derby before spending 11 months on the sidelines. Returning at that venue to be second in the Listed

Firebreak S. Feb. 10, he was in the same spot behind Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) in the Mar. 3 G2 Al Maktoum Challenge Round Three before finishing seventh after pulling too hard and meeting traffic in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai World Cup. Third in the G1 Champions Mile at Sha Tin Apr. 25, he was unable to land a blow on Excelebration (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) in Newbury's G2 Hungerford S. over seven furlongs last time Aug. 13, but still had the subsequent G2 Celebration Mile scorer Dubawi Gold (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}) behind, along with some proven pattern performers. Settled with two behind early by Christophe Soumillon, he crept close on the turn and, after hitting the front passing the quarter pole, hammered home his superiority.

He was sent off at 4-5, and Banned came through for the crowd, but just barely. Poised off the leaders in the early going, the Glen Hill colorbearer angled outside at the top of the lane and hit the gas, and it looked as if he would gallop away with an easy win. But Midnight Interlude, down on the inside, dug in gamely when he saw Banned coming, and the two fought it out to the line before Banned got the bob. Extensive, claimed by Holly and David Wilson and trainer Vladimir Cerin from Glen Hill for \$80,000 from his last start, was between horses in the run to the line and just missed. The winner of the May 6 GII American Turf S. and June 18 GIII Jefferson Cup at Churchill, Banned ran second by a neck in the July 16 GII Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs. He was coming off a third in the GI Secretariat S. at Arlington Aug. 13. The bay ran fifth in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf last year, but trainer Tom Proctor indicated he would skip the World Thoroughbred Championships this season. "We'll probably just go for the [Oct. 15 GII] Oak Tree Derby," Proctor said. "We'll go to the Breeders' Cup next year, maybe, if he's still around." Ken and Sarah Ramsey purchased dam Cardinalli, then a 4-year-old, for \$125,000 as a broodmare prospect at FTKNOV 2005. Her first foal, a full to Banned, died as a yearling. She has a yearling colt by Catienus. There was no foal reported this year, and she was bred to Kitten's Joy for 2012.

Live Oak homebred Brilliant Speed added this decisive win to his nose victory in the GI Blue Grass S. on the Keeneland Poly in April. The dark bay was not disgraced when finishing seventh in the GI Kentucky Derby May 7, beaten just 5 1/2 lengths, and he came back to be third over a sloppy strip in the GI Belmont S. June 11. Solidly backed at 7-2 in the July 30 GII Jim Dandy S. over the Saratoga main track, he could do no better than fifth, more than 10 lengths behind winner Stay Thirsty (Bernardini), and the decision was made to return him to the turf, where he had posted a record of 1-2-2 in five tries. It proved a wise move. In mid-pack early behind splits of :24.33, :49.89 and :1:14.27, the dark bay inched closer turning for home. It took a bit of encouragement from jockey John Velazquez for Brilliant Speed to reach top speed in midstretch, but when he hit top gear, it was all over. He blew by his foes to secure a popular score. The winner will be pointed for the Oct. 8 GI Jamaica S. on the Belmont turf. "He's a better horse on the grass--no doubt," Velazquez said.

He responded quickly when put to a drive, opening up to win handily.

OBITUARIES

THOMPSON MARCUS ROACH II (1948-2011)

Prominent breeder Thompson Marcus Roach II passed away Sept. 3 after a long illness. He was 63. Tom Roach was born May 26, 1948, and lived in his hometown of Midway, Kentucky, for the majority of his life. A graduate of Duke University, he was studying law at the University of Kentucky in 1974 when he decided leave school to run his family's Parrish Hill Farm in Midway. The farm, originally called Village View, was established in 1908 by Roach's great-great uncle James Ware Parrish. Tom Roach and his father, the late Dr. Ben F. Roach, chairman of the Markey Cancer Foundation, were co-breeders, along with friend Will Farrish, of 1999 Horse of the Year and GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness winner Charismatic (Summer Squall). Charismatic was out of Roach's mare, Bali Babe (Drone). Roach also bred GI Breeders' Cup Distaff winner and champion older mare Princess Rooney (Verbatim). Other graded-stakes winners to emerge from the Parrish Hill breeding program include Millennium Wind, Storm Tower, Tossofthecoin, Queen of Song, Lawyer Talk, Inca King and Cormorant, sire of Go for Gin. The breeding of current millionaire and Grade I-winning turf specialist Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) was planned by Roach for his longtime client and dear friend, Mrs. Mary Sullivan. The 5-year-old was born and raised at Parrish Hill until he left to be broken for racing. The 2002 GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner Volponi (Cryptoclearance) was also foaled at Parrish Hill Farm. After the sale of the original Parrish Hill Farm in 2008 to Mike Moreno of Southern Equine Stables, Roach and his wife Robyn continued their breeding, sales and racing operation on their farm in Versailles, Kentucky, also called Parrish Hill, where Roach resided at the time of his passing. He is survived by his wife, Robyn Pulley Roach; daughters Amanda Roach and Hallie Lewis; son-in-law Drew Lewis; grandson Parrish Lewis; sisters Julia Roach and Helen Rentch; and brother James Roach;, along with many nieces, nephews, brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law.

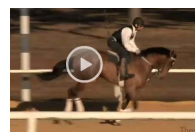

HORSE FOR THE COURSE?

The ultra-consistent **Andina (Ire)**, who has been worse than fourth just once in her 15 career starts, looks to run her record on the Del Mar lawn to a perfect two-for-two in the GII Palomar H. today. The 4-year-old tried out the local turf for the first time in the July 23 Osunitas S. at the Palomar distance of 1 1/16 miles and came from just off the pace to win by a head. Trainer Ben Cecil believes it's the perfect trip for his filly. "I think she's been better going shorter," Cecil told *Daily Racing Form*. "We tried her a couple of times going a mile and a quarter and she didn't stay." Interestingly, jockey Garrett Gomez, who was aboard Andina in the Osunitas, switches to **City to City**, who ran third in a three-way photo that afternoon. Del Mar's meet-leading rider, Rafael Bejarano, rode City to City last time, but gets the call on Andina here. City to City bids for her first win since annexing the GII Providencia S. at Santa Anita in April of 2010.

RACETRACK Round-Up

Jackson Bend to Target Kelso...

Jackson Bend (Hear No Evil), who earned the first graded win of his career in the GI Forego S. at Saratoga Saturday, will stretch to a mile for his next appearance, the GII Kelso S. at Belmont Oct. 1. "If I'm thinking of the [GI] Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile [at Churchill Nov. 5], I want to run in the [one-mile] Kelso," said trainer Nick Zito. "The [GI] Vosburgh [at Belmont Oct. 1] is six furlongs; he'd be at a disadvantage going three-quarters, and then what? The [GI] Breeders' Cup Sprint? He's not a big horse. What is he going to do, weave through the field? We're going to stick with the original plan."

Ask the Moon Westward Bound?

Ask the Moon (Malibu Moon), who made it two straight in Grade I company in Saturday's Personal Ensign S. at the Spa, is likely to head to California for her next outing. Trainer Marty Wolfson indicated he would point the \$75,000 claim for the two-turn Oct. 1 GI Lady's Secret S. at Santa Anita against Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision), rather than the one-turn GI Beldame S. at Belmont against Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) the same afternoon. The 6-year-old captured the GI Ruffian S. at Saratoga at the start of the meet. She will end the season in the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic at Churchill, then go through the ring at Keeneland November. "That's been the plan all along," Wolfson said.

Dream Plan Pays Off...

Trainer David Simcock yesterday reflected on the change of tactics which led to the success of **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) in Saturday's G1 Haydock Sprint Cup. Held up and never a factor in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville Aug. 7, Khalifa Dasmal's 3-year-old was always in the front line in the six-furlong contest, and his conditioner believes that was the key to avoiding a repeat of his previous flop. "We opted for a change of tactics at Haydock--we were far more aggressive with him," Simcock said. "With what happened in France, we wanted him to be more competitive earlier, and we got away with it. We are just delighted and relieved to have got him back on track after France. That's the most pleasing thing for us, as his run in Deauville left us scratching our heads a bit. He seems fine this morning. He went out for a pick of grass and seems very pleased with himself. We'll consider two options for him--the G1 Prix de la Foret [at Longchamp Oct. 2] and the G2 British Champions Series Sprint [at Ascot Oct. 15]."

Hoof it Team Consider Appeal...

Connections of Saturday's luckless G1 Haydock Sprint Cup third **Hoof It (GB)** (Monsieur Bond {Ire}) were yesterday pondering a possible appeal against the stewards' decision to let the race stand. Beaten a nose and a head by Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}) and Bated Breath (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the six-furlong highlight, the 4-year-old was forced to challenge around the wandering winner inside the final furlong. "I thought he was very unlucky, and we are considering appealing," trainer Mick Easterby told PA Sport. "There was definitely interference, and the stewards said they couldn't be certain the interference affected the result. But when you are talking in terms of a head and a nose, it is very, very harsh."

Arc Bid for Fairy?

Ed Dunlop yesterday suggested a crack at the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe is in the cards for his star filly **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) following her second in Saturday's G1 Irish Champion S. Denied a half-length by So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in Leopardstown's 10-furlong contest, Cristina Patino's 4-year-old could head to Longchamp in search of a fifth success at the top level. "I was as proud as anybody could possibly be of a horse without winning," Dunlop commented. "Snow Fairy produced a very good performance, arguably a career-best, and she never stopped trying all the way to the line. She will be back in the yard this afternoon, and we will see how quickly she recovers from her Leopardstown exertions, but the plan is to have one more race in Europe, either the G1 Prix de l'Opera or the Arc at Longchamp or the [Oct. 15] G1 Champion S. at Ascot, and it will be ground-dependent. If conditions were suitable, we would be very tempted by the Arc, but we will keep our options open and monitor the weather charts, and then she will head back to Japan and Hong Kong for the races that she won last year. You can't get off the chair for every dance, and we have decided to sit out the Breeders' Cup."

Bunting Pleases Ahead of Leger...

Godolphin's **Blue Bunting** (Dynaformer) pleased connections in her latest exercise ahead of Saturday's G1 St Leger at Doncaster, where she is set to be joined by stable companions **Genius Beast** (Kingmambo) and **Rumh (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}), who will be supplemented today. Speaking on Saturday, Racing Manager Simon Crisford said of the G1 1000 Guineas, G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Yorkshire Oaks winner, "Blue Bunting pleased in her workout this morning, and His Highness Sheikh Mohammed gave her the green light to run in the Ladbrokes St Leger." Trainer Mahmood Al Zarooni added, "Blue Bunting looks to be in the same form as she was before the Darley Yorkshire Oaks. I have been pleased with her preparation for the St Leger, and it is now a question of waiting until next Saturday."

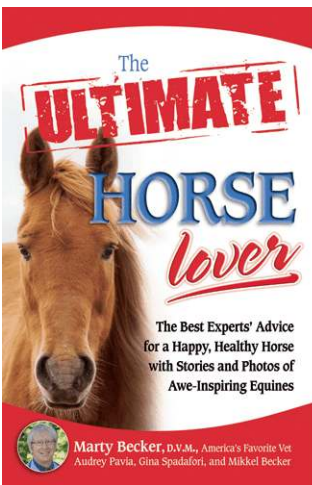
