



## 'CURRENCY' RISES IN HOPEFUL

**Currency Swap** (High Cotton) made the most of the sloppy conditions--and the absence of GII Sanford S. winner **Overdriven** (Tale of the Cat)--to give trainer Terry Pompay her first victory at the highest level in Monday's GI Three Chimneys Hopeful S. at Saratoga.

Settled in a stalking fourth behind 68-1 chance **Trinniberg** (Teuflesberg) who carved out a sharp opening quarter in :21.91, the Klaravich Stables representative advanced on the leader through a quarter mile in :45.14. Gaining the advantage at midstretch, the 9-5 favorite dug in late to overtake the game longshot by three-quarters of a length at the wire. Second choice

**J C's Pride** (Henny Hughes) broke awkwardly and was settled just behind the eventual winner in fifth in the early going, however, blew the final turn, was pulled up and vanned off the track. According to NYRA Chief Examining Veterinarian Dr. Anthony Verderosa, J C's Pride showed no apparent signs of injury or lameness. "I tried to put him in a spot that was pretty ideal for me on the outside in the clear where my horse was really happy," said winning rider Rajiv Maragh. "The other horse put up a really strong challenge. I wasn't sure I was going to win it until after I had passed the wire." The victory proved extra-special for the youngster's trainer, who grew up in Saratoga Springs and had many of her friends and relatives on hand to enjoy the landmark win. "I don't even know how to describe it," Pompay said. "I was so excited I thought I was going to pass out. This is my hometown and it's been exciting and fun, because I knew I was bringing a good horse." Currency Swap headed into this test with only one race under his belt, but he proved on that occasion that he deserved a chance at a Grade I when registering a six-length win in a 6 1/2-furlong maiden at the Spa Aug. 6. "This horse is so special," Pompay added. "I'm so proud of him that he came through. So far he's handled everything we've thrown at him. The sloppy track was an unknown factor. I wanted to showcase him on a dry track, but he handled it fine. I thought the other horse [Trinniberg] would stop, but he kept on going. I guess he really liked the slop. My horse showed guts because even when the other horse pushed him out a little bit, he kept digging in." **Cont. p2**

## PLETCHER, REPOLE & VELAZQUEZ TOP SPA

For the second consecutive year, the potent triumvirate--trainer Todd Pletcher, owner Mike Repole and jockey John Velazquez--finished atop the leader board at the conclusion of the 2011 Saratoga meet yesterday. Collecting his eighth Saratoga title and setting a new season record, Pletcher earned the H. Allen Jerkens training title with 38 winners, breaking his previous mark of 36 set in 2010. Winning at a 25% clip, Pletcher's horses made 149 starts, while amassing in excess of \$3 million in prize money. Repole, who recorded his biggest win of the meet with Stay Thirsty in the GI Traver S., ended the meet with 16 wins and \$1,485,280 in purses. Velazquez closed out the 2011 meet with 54 winners, placing him in second as the all-time leading rider at the Spa with 655 career wins.

## CITY TO CITY PROVES BEST IN PALOMAR

**City to City** (City Zip), winless since the GII Providencia S. in April 2010, regained the winning thread on Labor Day to collect the GII Palomar H. at Del Mar. Held in a stalking position early, the chestnut cut her way through traffic approaching the stretch and overhauled pacesetter **Medaglia d'Amour** (Medaglia d'Oro) late to win by three quarters of a length. "She was travelling well throughout," confirmed winning rider Garrett Gomez. "When we shifted out and went for our run in the stretch, her first response wasn't a good one for me. I said 'oh, oh.' But then she got it and fired. Then we were good." **Cont. p3**

The win also served as a welcome score for Klaravich Stables's Seth Klarman, who last enjoyed a win at the highest level with Subordination in the 1998 GI Eddie Reed H. at Del Mar. "We're ecstatic," said Klarman. "It's been a long time between Grade 1s for us. We were excited about this horse before he even ran. Nick de Meric picked him out. He runs[ Manuden Farm in Ocala] where our babies grow up."

While the closing day feature serves as an important stepping stone to many of the fall's important juvenile tests, it also holds the all important 'Win and Your In' ticket to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, which will be held at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. "This is just the start, because now we can go forward from here," said Pompay. "Obviously, we'd like to do the Breeders' Cup; we have to decide whether he'll have a race in between, or give him the time. I think this horse is going to get better as he gets older, and I think he'll like the added distance as well."

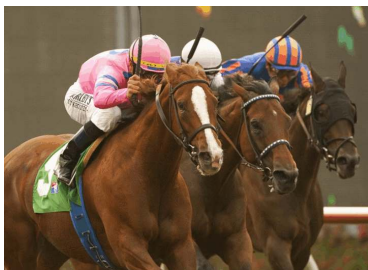

Fourth of July weekend. The filly was sidelined for the remainder of the year following a close-up second in the GII San Clemente H. She returned with a fourth in a Golden Gate allowance May 14 before just missing by a neck in the Alameda County F/M S. June 25. Most recently, she was

third--beaten a head after encountering some traffic--in the restricted Osunitas S. July 23. The 4-year-old is campaigned by William DeBurgh, Dr. Mark Dedomenico and her trainer, Jerry Hollendorfer. "I knew we would be [off the pace]," confirmed Hollendorfer. "I didn't want to get trapped on the rail, but unfortunately she got caught in there again. But this time she got out in time." As for her time away from the races, he added, "This filly came off a long layoff and to win a Grade II race like this--I'm very proud of her. We had to do surgery on her ankle. We laid her up at Pegasus Training Center [owned by Dedomenico] up near Seattle in Redmond, Washington. They did all the rehab on her and just did a fabulous job. We took our time with her and she has paid us back."

Allowed to linger in a comfortable sixth while Dynaslew carved out a dawdling opening quarter in :26.56 over the rain-soaked turf, Augustin Stables's Emerald Beech maintained the same position through a slightly-improved half in :51.80 and three quarters in 1:18.19. Moving into contention with three furlongs left to go, the bay made a big move to get within striking distance turning for home and mowed down the free-running Dynaslew at the eighth pole before drawing off under a hand ride. "She handled the softer turf very well here," said winning rider Alex Solis. A winner of one of five starts during her tenure with Woodbine-based trainer Macdonald Benson, the homebred failed to visit the winner's circle in as many starts last term, but managed a third over this course and trip last September. Runner-up over the yielding turf in her seasonal bow at Keeneland Apr. 28, she proceeded to win her next three, including her latest in the *Waya S.* Aug. 10. "This is only my second year having her," said winning trainer Jonathan Sheppard. "It takes me a while to figure them out. My training style is to have horses do well when they get older."

### GOLDIKOVA WAITS FOR THE FORET

Sunday's G1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp will be without its star turn after trainer Freddy Head announced that **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) would wait for the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de la Foret. Despite initially pointing to the mile contest as the next start for the Wertheimers' 6-year-old in the immediate aftermath of her defeat in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois, connections have had a change of plan. "I have decided not to run her in the Moulin de Longchamp and go instead for the Foret, as it is a better race to prepare her for her trip to Churchill Downs," Head told the *Racing Post*. "Everything is being geared for her to win a fourth GI Breeders' Cup Mile. Goldikova is in very good shape."



## RACETRACK Round-Up

### SEVILLE LONE BALLYDOYLE LEGER

Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}) looks set to be the sole Ballydoyle representative in Saturday's G1 St Leger, for which 11 stood their ground at yesterday's six-day stage. Runner-up in the G1 Irish Derby and G1 Grand Prix de Paris, he was third last time in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York Aug. 17 and is joined on the list for the Doncaster Classic by the G1 Epsom Oaks runner-up **Wonder of Wonders** (Kingmambo) and Saturday's G3 Kilternan S. third **Freedom (Ire)** (Hurricane Run {Ire}). "Seville is heading for the St Leger," trainer Aidan O'Brien told the *Racing Post*. "Wonder of Wonders is in the St Leger, but is unlikely to run. We're thinking of dropping her down in trip and she could go for the G1 Prix de l'Opera [at Longchamp Oct. 2]." Khalid Abdullah's impressive Great Voltigeur scorer **Sea Moon (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}) is likely to start a short-price favorite, while other notables include the Aug. 13 G3 Geoffrey Freer S. first and second **Census (Ire)** (Cacique {Ire}) and **Brown Panther (Ger)** (Shirocco {Ger}) and the July 7 G3 Bahrain Trophy winner **Masked Marvel (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}).

### CHINTA HAS MIDDLE PARK AIM

Trainer Kevin Ryan is targeting unbeaten 2-year-old **Bapak Chinta** (Speightstown) at the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket Oct. 8. Taken out of the G1 Nunthorpe S. due to a last-minute setback, the June 16 G2 Norfolk S. scorer is back on track now. "He's really, really well and is back cantering--he only missed three or four days," Ryan commented. "It was only a simple thing, but it was enough to rule him out of the race and as it turned out, it might have happened for a reason, as he probably wouldn't have liked the ground at York. We'll probably go for the Middle Park with him now. He's also in the [Oct. 2] G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, so we've got options."

## JONES HITS HIGH MARK IN QUARTER HORSE RACING, TAKES ALL AMERICAN FUTURITY

John T.L. Jones, Jr., former owner and general manager of Walmac International and father of its current GM Johnny Jones III, has long been an influential player in Thoroughbreds. But the 77-year-old got his start in racing with Quarter Horses back in the late 1950s.

Yesterday, roughly 60 years into it, Jones reached the pinnacle of the sport when a 2-year-old gelding he bred and co-owns, **Ochoa** (Tres Seis--Stolis Fortune, by Stoli), won the richest and

arguably most prestigious Quarter Horse race in the world, the \$2.4 million GI All American Futurity at Ruidoso. It was Jones's first win in the All American, which carried a \$1.2 million windfall for the winning connections. Having won two of three starts coming into the Futurity for trainer Dwayne "Sleepy" Gilbreath, Ochoa was made the 8-5 favorite after posting a :21.07 time when winning his 440-yard trial Aug. 18. It was the fastest of 26 trials run that afternoon. Leaving from post nine yesterday, Ochoa broke out and bumped a rival, but after straightening, raced in splendid isolation to the wire. The official winning margin of 1 1/2 lengths was generous to runner-up Jess Send Me (Feature Mr Jess), and Ochoa stopped the clock in :21.06 over a track rated fast. "It's been so hot and dry in Texas lately, and I needed this to buy some feed!" Jones said after the race. He added more seriously, "I've enjoyed the horse business, and I hope this isn't the finale--I don't intend to quit--but this real nice." Jones's achievements in racing are considerable. He has had ties to three Kentucky Derby starters--his best finish being Papelote's fifth-place try to Seattle Slew in 1977--and co-bred the 1998 G1 English 2000 Guineas winner King of Kings (Ire). And, of course, he stood watch during Nureyev's reign at Walmac. He has raced the Quarter Horse champions Noconi and Brenda Beautiful, and through the years, he had a handful of runners take aim at the All American. Eight years ago, bettors expected the highly regarded Planet Holland to give him his first win. And though the gelding went on to a stellar career, an All American trophy wasn't in the cards; he ran third as the 9-5 choice. "He was a nice horse and could have won it, but he stumbled and finished third," said Jones. The betting public was just as confident in Ochoa, and this time, Jones walked away with the big prize. "I knew we had the best horse," Jones said. "All I needed was for them to give him a place to run. He bumped a bit at the break, but he had a place to go."

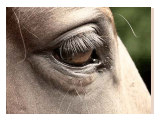

Jones bred Ochoa in Texas, and though he had modest bloodlines, Jones was confident he was a runner. "I had the mare, who was unraced," he said. "She hurt herself in training. I liked the horse I bred her to [Tres Seis], but he wasn't real popular. I had two out of her [previously] who weren't very stout, so I was trying to put some substance into [the foal]." Jones put Ochoa through the Ruidoso Select Yearling Sale, buying him back for \$25,000. "At the sales, he could compete with any of them physically, but he just didn't have the pedigree," said Jones. "But I wasn't going to sell him for less than \$25,000, and I didn't." Instead, Jones put together a partnership of friends that includes his J Bar 7, Monte and Katsy Cluck and Doug and Shavon Benson. The Clucks manage the Dean Cluck Feedyard near Gruver, Texas. "I always said one of the hardest things to do is buy a friend a horse, but I thought they'd have a lot of fun with this one," said Jones, who has returned to his homestate, where he owns six mares. Now with an All American in hand, Ochoa will get a well-deserved vacation. "He'll be rested now and come back for the big Derbies," he said. "He won't race again until next June." It was, incidentally, Jones's second big triumph at Ruidoso in recent months. In June, he was inducted into the Ruidoso Downs Racehorse Hall of Fame.

Thanks to the likes of Northern Dancer and Mr. Prospector--both of whom lived to 29--it is tempting to think that a very long life is the rule, rather than the exception, for today's stallions. Those expectations are bolstered by some of Northern Dancer's most prominent stallion sons, such as Sadler's Wells, Danzig, Lyphard, Vice Regent, Storm Bird, Be My Guest, Night Shift, Northern Taste and Dixieland Band all achieving veteran status, with Lyphard leading the way by living to 36.

Two other stallions who lived past their 30th birthdays were Hail To Reason's sons Halo and Mr. Leader. Halo, the champion sire of 1983 and 1989, lived to be 31 and Mr. Leader did even better, reaching the age of 33. Indeed Halo was fully 27 years old when the last of his graded winners, David Copperfield, was conceived. Several of Halo's stallion sons achieved highly respectable ages, with Southern Halo, Devil's Bag and Sunny's Halo living to be 26, 24 and 23. Unfortunately, Halo's most important sons in the Northern Hemisphere didn't share this longevity, with Sunday Silence dying at 16 and Saint Ballado at 13. Last weekend provided further reason for regretting that these two sons of Halo didn't enjoy the luxury of a longer life. The two group races for juveniles in Japan fell to youngsters by Sunday Silence's sons Daiwa Major and Admire Max. His champion miler Daiwa Major now heads the sires of 2-year-old table following the G3 success of his first-crop daughter Epice Arome.

Of course, Daiwa Major isn't the only son of Sunday Silence grabbing attention with his first runners, as Walmac Farm's Hat Trick--another champion miler--appears to have a possible future champion in the shape of his unbeaten G1 Prix Morny hero Dabirsim. Saint Ballado did even better, cropping up as the grandsire of two of Saturday's Grade I winners, thanks to Havre de Grace's win over males in the Woodward H. and Weemissfrankie's win in the Del Mar Debutante.

I have told Saint Ballado's story often enough in this column, but it bears repeating in these circumstances. Without a Grade I win on his resume, this brother to Devil's Bag and Glorious Song spent his first five seasons in Florida, at fees as low as \$2,500. However, those Florida crops yielded performers of the quality of Captain Bodgit, Yankee Victor, Sister Act, Flame Thrower and Straight Man. With his family's reputation being further enhanced by Glorious Song's sons Rahy and Singspiel, Saint Ballado was soon on his way to Kentucky, where his fee at Taylor Made rose as high as \$125,000. His final career figures were 70 stakes winners from around 700 foals, with his Kentucky crops producing Horse of the Year Saint Liam and top mare Ashado, who cost Sheikh Mohammed \$9 million at the end of a racing career which featured seven Grade I victories.

Of course Saint Liam is the sire of Havre de Grace, and it was Sunriver, a Grade I-winning brother to Ashado, who is responsible for Weemissfrankie. Unfortunately the tale of woe continues, as Saint Liam lived only long enough to stand one season at Lane's End. The 2005 GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner suffered a devastating hind-leg fracture in a fall in August 2006. In other words, he died at the age of six, four years after his sire.

Sunriver was similarly unlucky. He died from a suspected heart attack or aneurysm three years after Saint Liam, in August 2009, having spent just two seasons at Empire Stud at Hudson, New York. Sunriver had become the youngest of three graded-winning siblings when he won the GI Hollywood Turf Cup over 1 1/2 miles as a 4-year-old. He had scored at Grade II level on dirt the previous year, when he also filled third place behind Jazil and Bluegrass Cat in the GI Belmont S. Saint Liam's legacy was 98 foals, of which six have become stakes winners. His other graded winners are Buddy's Saint, who was officially ranked the fourth-best 2-year-old male of 2009, following his Grade II wins in the Nashua and Remsen S., and the Grade III winner Liam's Dream.

Sunriver covered 90 mares in his first season, for 63 foals, and 81 mares for 49 foals in his second. Weemissfrankie, now unbeaten in two starts, belongs to that first crop. Sunriver wasn't the likeliest candidate to sire a precocious Grade I-winning 2-year-old, as this 1 1/2-mile performer won only a maiden race from two juvenile starts, and Saint Ballado ran only once at two years. Remember, though, that Saint Ballado was a brother to a champion 2-year-old in Devil's Bag. Sunriver, for his part, was a brother to Ashado, who scored three times at Grade I or Grade II levels before finishing second in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.


There are also several other precocious types in the bottom half of Weemissfrankie's pedigree, not least her broodmare sire Meadowlake. Despite standing 17 hands in maturity, Meadowlake earned an Experimental Free Handicap rating of 122 after winning a maiden race by 22 lengths and the GI Arlington-Washington Futurity by nearly nine lengths. Meadowlake's small first crop produced Meadow Star, the champion juvenile filly of 1990, and he went on to sire winners of the Champagne S. (Greenwood Lake), Matron S. (Meadow Breeze) and Frizette S. (Sutra). More recently, Meadowlake has featured as the broodmare sire of Henny Hughes, another stallion who got into the weekend juvenile action, thanks to She Digs Me's success in the GIII Sapling S.

Weemissfrankie's dam--unraced Starinthemeadow--is a half-sister to dual 2-year-old stakes winner Program Pick, who also has a Grade I-winning 2-year-old filly to her credit. This was the Storm Creek filly Stormy Pick, winner of the Spinaway S. in 2000.

Our Michael, the sire of Weemissfrankie's second dam Lite a Star, was also at his most successful at two, when he gained five of his eight stakes successes.

**DEL MAR TO ADD OVER \$1M TO PURSES** As the 72nd meet at Del Mar draws to a close, the Del Mar Thoroughbred Club announced good news for local horsemen: a record under-payment amount in excess of \$1 million, meaning owners are set to receive at least an additional 8% on top of their overnight purse earnings from the meet. Track officials cited solid wagering numbers,

spurred by record purses and healthy field size, for the under-payment. Officials said they would go over the final numbers with the Thoroughbred Owners of California after the meet and said checks would likely be issued by November. Del Mar wraps up its 37-day race meet Wednesday. "This has been a delightful surprise for myself and others," said Del Mar's vice president of racing and racing secretary Tom Robbins. "We had real concerns coming into this meet--regarding both our horse inventory and the economics we all are facing these days--but the response by our horsemen and our fans has turned a difficult scenario into one of the most positive in Del Mar's history." While wagering numbers have been down slightly from a year ago, the 2011 meet can be considered a success for many different reasons, said officials, not least of which is that many expected steeper declines. Field size at Del Mar grew from 8.2 to 8.3 horses per race with virtually the same number of races from a year ago, while the track will realize daily average handle of \$11 million per day. Purses averaged over \$600,000 per day, a single-season record for the seaside oval and well ahead of last year's figure of \$556,324. Big purses were credited with brisk trade at the claim box, where 238 claims were made for a total of \$5,764,500. Last year, 141 claims were recorded for \$3,635,500. Innovative programs like the "Ship and Win" program--which offered \$1,000 stipends and a 20% bonus to money earned in a horse's initial start to runners shipping in from other states--helped to ensure full races drawing in more than 100 horses," according to officials. "Our horsemen have been fantastic at this meet," Robbins added. "They have responded well beyond our expectations to the Del Mar experience. This is a special place with a wonderful appreciation for our sport and the people who take part in it. It isn't hard to understand why those in our industry want to be part of it. Running your horse in front of large, cheering crowds; racing in one of the prettiest settings in the world; vying for the largest purses in the country. In the end, what's not to like about Del Mar?"
