**MONMOUTH LEASE IN JEOPARDY?**

The Newark *Star-Ledger* reported Monday that New York real estate developer Morris Bailey has informed the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority that the memorandum of understanding he has to lease Monmouth Park for five years, formalized in June, is "null and void." Bailey has expressed his unhappiness with the delays and the costs that have stymied the

finalization of the lease. John Samerjan, the vice president of public affairs for the NJSEA, confirmed Tuesday that a letter from an attorney representing Bailey had been received Friday. Samerjan added, "We can assure there has been no breach on the

Authority's part. We think this is some kind of misplaced negotiating ploy." No meeting between NJSEA officials and Bailey has been scheduled. "There had been meetings on a regular basis, but I don't know [what will happen] going forward," Samerjan said. The *Star-Ledger* speculated that the bidding process to lease Monmouth could be reopened if Bailey withdraws as operator. The daily, citing an anonymous source, also reported that an area of contention is a \$4-million loan floated by the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association to keep purses at an average of \$400,000 a day. The money has already been utilized by the purse account, but, according to the source, Bailey is now declining to accept responsibility for the loan. John Forbes, the president of the NJTHA, said Tuesday, "We're like everyone else--we know what we've been reading in the paper. It appears that Morris has some material differences with the state, and we have to wait until they sit down and work it out before we can make any comment."

**STRONG SPA SEASON CONCLUDES**

The 143rd season of racing at Saratoga concluded Sunday with on-track wagering up 5.6% from a year ago. Daily average attendance was also up, while all-sources handle fell slightly. Total attendance for the 39-day meet was 871,772. Daily attendance of 22,353 was up 1.8% from the 2010 figure of 21,957. On-track handle was \$121,101,664, compared to \$114,693,168 a year ago. Daily on-track handle was up 8.3% to \$3,105,171. All-sources handle totalled \$526,251,818, down 4.6% from \$551,660,726 in 2010. Daily average all-sources handle was \$13,493,636, down 2.2% from \$13,791,518 last year. Average betting interests per race were 8.2, compared to 8.4 in 2010.

**FUTURITY CONCLUDES DEL MAR MEET**

Summer unofficially comes to an end today when the GI Del Mar Futurity brings down the curtain on the 2011 racing season at the seaside oval. A field of eight juveniles goes postward in the seven-furlong event, including 9-5 morning-line favorite **Creative Cause** (Giant's Causeway). Unbeaten in two lifetime starts, Heinz

after a 4 3/4-length debut victory at Hollywood Park July 16. He followed that effort with a 1 3/4-length triumph in the GII Best Pal S. at Del Mar Aug. 7. He prepped for today's start with a bullet six-furlong move in 1:12 1/5 at Del Mar Sept. 2. Bloom Racing Stable's **Majestic City** (City Zip) puts his perfect three-for-three record on the line in the Futurity. The chestnut colt, the 5-2 second choice on the morning line, has been off since winning the July 17 GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship. He will be stretching out an extra furlong this afternoon, but trainer Peter Miller is not concerned about the extra distance. "The way he won the Hollywood Juvenile, really finished up strong the last sixteenth of a mile and galloped out and the way he's training, I think the seven-eighths is definitely within his scope," Miller said. "But, as is the question with all these young horses, you never know until they actually do it." **Full field p2**

**EXCELEBRATION TO HAVE NEW PARTNER?**

**Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), the impressive winner of the May 22 G2 German 2000 Guineas and the Aug. 13 G2 Hungerford S., may be partnered by a different jockey in Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix du Moulin, according to trainer Marco Botti. The bay sophomore--a recent acquisition of the Coolmore operation--was partnered by Adam Kirby in all four starts this term, including a third to Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) in the June 14 G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot, but the association may be broken in the one-mile event at Longchamp. "It will be down to Coolmore to make a decision and, at the moment, I am not sure if Adam will ride Excelebration," Botti told *PA Sport*. Botti added, "He's been working well and we're happy with him. For me, a mile is his best trip, and, hopefully, the ground won't be too soft in France. He has won on good-to-soft [going], but it was very soft at Longchamp last Sunday. Thankfully, the forecast is good from midweek onwards, so the ground should be fine for him, and he is travelling over [to France] on Friday."


Of the 4,319 yearlings catalogued to sell (down one day and 536 yearlings, or 11%, from 2010) in the two weeks beginning this Sunday at Keeneland's September sale, nearly half (2,101) are by no more than 38 stallions which have 40 or more yearlings each catalogued throughout the 13 sessions. **(See tables, p7-11).**

There's no doubt that sire power has become more concentrated in recent years, since the advent of the 'Big-Book Era' around 1996. On the whole, that's been a plus for buyers; if prices remain stable or drop--as they have the past few years--they are likely to get more sire power, at least, for their money than may have been the case in the past.

That's not to say there isn't still plenty of diversity in the ranks of sires of Keeneland September yearlings. A total of 253 stallions have yearlings catalogued to the sale, and, besides the 38 with 40 or more catalogued, another 82 have between 10 and 39 in the sale. Since that includes the likes of Distorted Humor (38) and A.P. Indy (12), it's not as though there isn't life beyond the 38 sires with 40+ catalogued. They represent many different sire lines and branches and have many different aptitudes. Still it's striking that no more than 120 stallions have 10 or more catalogued throughout the two weeks.

In last week's column, we published some details of the 93 sires represented in Books 1-2. Today, we list similar details for all 253 stallions represented in the sale (including the 93 from last week). Notably, the four sires with the highest number catalogued in the first week all have double-digit representation in the second week, and remain the top four by number catalogued for the whole sale; **Medaglia d'Oro**, who has 73 catalogued in the first week, has another 22 in Week 2, taking his total number of yearlings catalogued in one sale to 95, which must be a world record. It's a good thing he's a popular sire. Next is **Unbridled's Song**, with 17 in the second week to go with his 66 in Week 1, for a total of 83. **Tapit** has 56 plus 22, for a total of 78, and **Giant's Causeway** has 53 plus 15, for a total of 68. It will be fascinating to see how prices hold up for these sires given such staggering numbers.

Fifteen sires have 40 or more catalogued in the second week, Books 3-6, of which five have enough in the first week to rank them among the 11 stallions with 60 or more catalogued for the entire sale. So more of the sires with big representation in the second week have only a handful in the first week. The top second-week sire by number catalogued is Spendthrift's first-year sire, **Tiz Wonderful** (Tiznow), with 59 catalogued in Books 3-6; he has just one in the first week, making his overall total 60. **Cont. p6**

Tied for second are Darley's **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy), whose second crop of 2-year-olds have put him in the top three on the North American juvenile sire list, and **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat), second on the juvenile sire list (his sire Tale of the Cat is first!), but exported to Turkey last year, when of course he had GI Breeders' Cup Turf winner Dangerous Midge. They have 50 second-week yearlings each. Next is Gainesway's **Corinthian** (Pulpit), whose first foals are racing at two this year. He has 49 in Books 3-6, giving him 61 overall.

Three sires (besides Tiz Wonderful) with their first yearlings of 2011 have 40 or more catalogued in the second week, along with two others (besides Corinthian) with their first 2-year-olds. The other rookie yearling sires are: Darley's **Street Boss** (Street Cry, 47 in the second week); Ashford's **Majestic Warrior** (A.P. Indy, 41); and Hill 'n' Dale's dual GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Midnight Lute** (Real Quiet, 40). The other sires with their first 2-year-olds are the Darley pair of **Any Given Saturday** (Distorted Humor, 45) and **Discreet Cat** (Forestry, 40), though it should be pointed out that two other of Darley's impressive corps of freshman sires, **Hard Spun** (Danzig, 29 plus 32) and **Street Sense** (Street Cry, 37 plus 24), have 61 each catalogued throughout the whole sale. Others with 40 or more catalogued in the second week include: **Forestry**, **Rock Hard Ten** (first 4-year-olds), and **Tale of the Cat** (44 each); and **Bernstein**, **Dixie Union**, and **Harlan's Holiday** (40 each). As usual, it's all going to be mighty interesting; like the man says, Let the games begin!

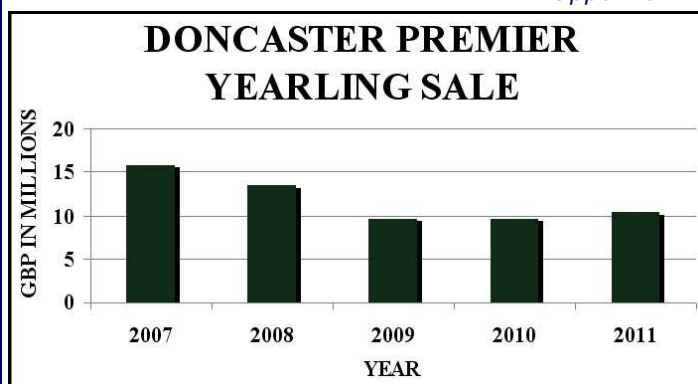

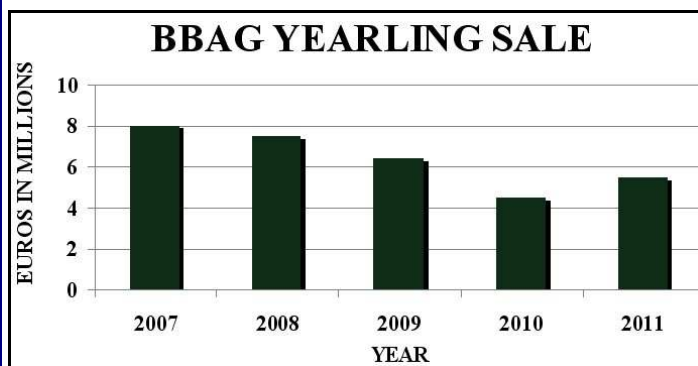



A colt by War Front topped the two-day select portion of the CTHS Canadian-bred Yearling Sale at the Woodbine Sales Pavilion yesterday in Toronto, selling for C\$140,000 to the bid of William and Anne Scott. During yesterday's session, 95 yearlings grossed C\$3,271,500. The average was C\$34,437 and the median was C\$25,000. There were 50 horses reported not sold. During Monday night's opening session of the sale, 48 yearlings sold for a total of C\$1,322,000 and an average of C\$27,542. Cumulatively, 143 yearlings grossed C\$4,593,500. The average was C\$32,122, up 11.5% from last year's one-day select sale when 128 horses sold for C\$3,686,700 and an average of C\$28,802. Monday's top-priced yearling was [hip 37](#), a son of Bold Executive, who sold for C\$100,000 to Danny Dion's Bear Stables. Out of the stakes-winning Alwuhush mare Honolulu Gold, the colt was also consigned by Hogan, who owned and co-bred the yearling in partnership with Winston Penny.
