May 1 and G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh July 17, the Godolphin filly looks likely to stay this far on the evidence of her latest effort when outlasting Vita Nova (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Aug. 18 G1 Yorkshire Oaks. She may have been unlucky not to have an Epsom Oaks under her belt, too, as she got left behind when the sprint began in that falsely run affair

June 3, and it will take a talented colt to stop her emulating the likes of User Friendly (GB) (Slip Anchor {GB}) and the last Triple Crown heroine Oh So Sharp (Ire) (Kris {GB}). Frankie Dettori, who already has five editions to his name, has a soft spot for the grey. "All the signs are good," he said. "She is a tough filly, she goes on any ground and likes a fight. **Sea Moon (GB)** (Beat Hollow {GB}) sets a good standard, but she has done me no harm this year, and I love her dearly." Racing Manager Simon Crisford was also full of enthusiasm earlier this week. "She is super tough and very resolute--she gives everything she has, though she wins her races by a narrow margin," Crisford commented. "She has been such a revelation, because she is quite an odd filly to look at--she is not a supermodel on the catwalk, but very correct. Blue Bunting has held on to her condition throughout a tough and busy campaign. Looking at her now, she is as robust and healthy as she was back in May, which is why she is going for the St Leger. Obviously, her sex allowance will be incredibly important and, hopefully, will give her every chance of beating the colts."

season, including tallies in the GIII Iowa Derby at Prairie Meadows June 25 and the GII West Virginia Derby at Mountaineer Aug. 6. He worked a sharp four furlongs in :47 1/5 at Del Mar Sept. 4. "He's really come around," trainer Bob Baffert told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's changed so

much from what he was as a 2-year-old. He worked really well the other day, so I thought, 'You know what, I'd better take a shot here.'" Pin Oak homebred **Alternation** (Distorted Humor), hero of Belmont's GII Peter Pan S. May 14, looks to get back on track following a well-beaten fourth in the GII Jim Dandy S. July 30. "I think most of the races he's won, they've had probably just pretty average fractions in them," trainer Donnie Von Hemel told *DRF*. "In the Peter Pan, he wasn't that far back, either. So, hopefully, he'll leave there good enough [for Ramon Dominguez] to be able to place him where he needs to be, depending on pace." **Field p5**

Count In Census...

Richard Hannon is not accustomed to having a runner in this kind of test, but, in Highclere Thoroughbred Racing's **Census (Ire)** (Cacique {Ire}), he has a colt who has taken himself in this direction. Arguably the most improved performer in the line-up, he followed a six-length second to **Brown Panther (GB)** (Shirocco {Ger}) in Royal Ascot's 12-furlong King George V H. June 16 with a strong-finishing head second to **Masked Marvel (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G3 Bahrain Trophy at Newmarket July 7. After that, he showed he was still progressing fast when reversing the Royal form and beating Brown Panther in Newbury's G3 Geoffrey Freer S. over an extended 13 furlongs Aug. 13. "He's a pretty good horse, he's worked his way through the ranks and deserves to take his chance," Hannon commented. "He came to hand at the backend of last season, and has just got better and better and has not been out of the first two on his last six starts. We've had a few stayers over the years, and the last horse we had for the Leger was Assessor (Ire) [who was sixth in 1992]. Census would be the same type of horse, but with a little more speed." Highclere's MD Harry Herbert added, "Physically, he's a horse that improves every time you look at him--he looks fantastic and has progressed again since Newbury. He will relish the trip and his profile coming into the race is really good. We've got huge respect for Sea Moon, and Blue Bunting's form speaks for itself, but our advantage lies in the fact that we know he'll stay this trip, and we are going places." One of England's biggest soccer names, Michael Owen, could be celebrating a fairytale outcome if his homebred Brown Panther prevails, and trainer Tom Dascombe feels the best is yet to come from the bay. "In April, he got beat in a handicap off a mark of 73 and he's gone up after every run so you've got to say he's still improving," Dascombe commented. John Gosden, who has saddled three winners from his last four runners in this Classic, puts forward a duo headed by Bjorn Nielsen's Masked Marvel. Only eighth in the June 4 G1 Epsom Derby following his win in the Listed Cocked Hat S. at Goodwood May 18, the bay rebounded to best Census at Newmarket, and has been deliberately rested subsequently. "He's in the form of his life and I'm confident he'll stay," said his jockey William Buick. "He's an uncomplicated, straightforward ride, and John [Gosden] is an expert on winning the St Leger." Gosden also saddles Princess Haya of Jordan's **Buthelezi** (Dynaformer), who needs to improve on his latest fourth in the Geoffrey Freer, but sports a hood for the first time in a bid to eke out more of his ability. "Masked Marvel probably didn't quite handle Epsom, and Census has confirmed the form of the Bahrain Trophy, so he comes into the race as a solid prospect and should definitely stay as he is related to a German St Leger winner," Gosden said. "The trip takes a bit of getting and you've got to see it out with class. Buthelezi could have just been a pacemaker, but he's there to run on his merits. He is quite a quirky character, but he gallops and will stay."

THE FAME GAME

Already successful in the G1 Gold Cup this term, **Fame and Glory** bids to join Ballydoyle's recent staying stars Yeats (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) and Septimus (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) in adding this prize to his impressive resume. His versatility has been his strong point up to now, showing top-class form over 10 furlongs when runner-up in the 2009 G1 Irish Champion S., over a mile and a half when winning that year's G1 Irish Derby and over the 2 1/2-mile marathon trip of the Royal meeting's feature June 16. His surprise defeat by **Fictional Account** on his first run after a subsequent break in the Listed Irish St Leger Trial over this track and trip last time Aug. 20 was met with a distinct lack of panic from Aidan O'Brien, and the third Saddler's Rock (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) also boosted the form when winning yesterday's G2 Doncaster Cup. **Duncan**, who scored in the May 13 G2 Yorkshire Cup over this trip, was sixth in the Gold Cup and runner-up in the G2 Lonsdale Cup over an extended two-mile trip at York last time Aug. 20 and will be suited by a drop in distance; ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Jukebox Jury** looks as if stamina tests play to his strengths. The 2009 G1 Preis von Europa hero has won on both occasions that he has tackled further than 12 furlongs, in the 2009 Grand Prix de Deauville and in that track's G2 Prix Kergorlay on his latest outing Aug. 21. "I was very impressed with him the last time in Deauville," Jockey Johnny Murtagh said. "The ground at the Curragh is going to be on the soft side, but he's by Montjeu, so I don't think he'll mind it. He likes to run up there with the pace and is a typical Mark Johnston horse--there are no quirks with him. If there is pace, he can sit second, and if there is none he can go on himself. I think he'll enjoy the Curragh with it's big, open spaces."

A NATIONAL CAUSE

Supplemented this week to the G1 National S., **Talwar** has all the ingredients in place to shake up the home team and become one of only two overseas raiders to succeed since 1996. Successful on rain-softened ground in the Listed Winkfield S. at Ascot July 23, he followed that with an impressive five-length win in the G3 Solario S. at Sandown Aug. 20. "My personal hunch is that the Irish 2-year-olds are possibly a little bit below what you would expect for this time of year, so I felt it was worth supplementing--especially with softish ground looking likely," trainer Jeremy Nosedo explained. "We can go there and feel we have a solid each-way chance and a decent chance of winning a Group 1, which would move the horse to another level as to his value--possibly even giving him some stallion potential for the future. I felt it was a gamble well worth taking, paying the supplementary. Talwar is in good shape. He is quite a lazy worker at home, but he is a tough and honest performer who has progressed with every race." Heading the domestic squad is **Power**, who represents the Ballydoyle stable successful on seven of the last 15 occasions. He beat the re-opposing **Tough As Nails** in the Listed Marble Hill S. over five furlongs here May 21 and followed that with a neck defeat of Talwar's stable companion Roman Soldier (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}) in the June 14 G2 Coventry S. at Royal Ascot. Grabbed late by La Collina (Ire) (Strategic Prince {GB}) in the G1 Phoenix S. over six at this venue last time Aug. 7, he has to prove that he can handle more testing conditions. "Everyone is very happy with him, and I think he was a bit unlucky in the Phoenix," jockey Seamie Heffernan told *PA Sport*. "He got caught right on the line and was probably in front a bit too long. He's a fine, big colt and I'm looking forward to riding him over seven furlongs. He hasn't run on soft ground before, but, hopefully, he'll handle it."

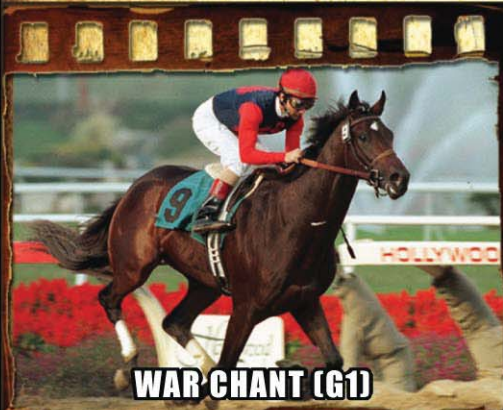

CHAMPAGNE FOR THE DUKE?

Penalties are always hard to defy in the better juvenile contests such as this afternoon's G2 Park S., and it is the turn of **Red Duke** to be saddled with the antiquated anomaly here. However, connections are hopeful he has the class to overcome adversity. Having picked up the extra burden with a defeat of Chandlery (Ire) (Choisir {Aus}) in the G2 Superlative S. over this trip at Newmarket July 9, he was denied a clear run when subsequently third behind that rival in the G2 Vintage S. at Goodwood July 27. "I've been very happy with all of his work, he seems in fine form and we're hoping for a good performance," trainer John Quinn told *PA Sport*. "He has plenty of experience, so I'm not worried about the small field, but we have got to carry a three-pound penalty against some good colts." One of those is the unbeaten **Entifaadha**, who put up just as impressive a performance as Red Duke when winning York's G3 Acomb S. over this distance when last seen Aug. 17, but, due to the vagaries of the rules, escapes a penalty. This year's Acomb looked a smart renewal on paper, and it is already starting to work out, with the fourth Caledonian Spring (Ire) (Amadeus Wolf {GB}) winning at listed level and also-rans Balty Boys (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}) and East Meets West (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) putting in improved subsequent efforts. **Al Khan** finished fifth on that occasion, but Peter Chapple-Hyam was convinced that the rain-softened ground affected the performance of the highly regarded colt. Aidan O'Brien sends across **Daddy Long Legs**, who put up a taking effort on his winning debut over this trip at Gowran Park Aug. 10.

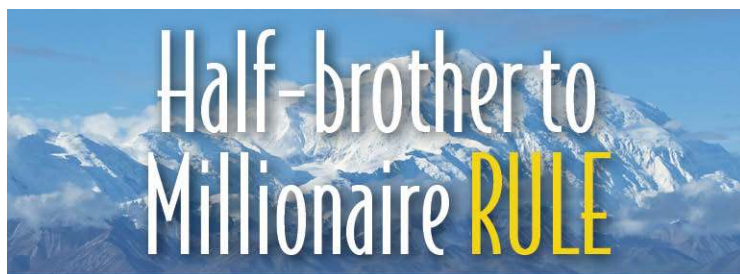

TILTING AT THE WINDMILL

Just nine line up in tomorrow's G1 Qatar Prix du Moulin de Longchamp, which has traditionally drawn small fields since its inauguration in 1957. It has been moved again this year to add extra spice to Longchamp's much-analysed Arc trial card, having initially taken place on the undercard of that autumnal highlight before being shifted to the last Sunday in September in 1974 and to the first Sunday of that month in 1980. Aidan O'Brien scratched **Roderic O'Connor (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) yesterday, leaving a select bunch in a renewal that has cut up due to the missing star distaffers Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa)--successful three years ago--and Immortal Verse (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}). O'Brien saddled Ballydoyle's only winner Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) back in 2002 and will be represented by **Zoffany (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}). That colt will be ridden by Gerald Mosse since the stable's go-to jockey Christophe Soumillon claimed for **Planteur (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}). Zoffany will be bidding to better the third-placing of his sire behind Sendawar (Ire) (Priolo) in the 1999 edition.

Successful in the G1 Phoenix S. over six furlongs at The Curragh last term, Michael Tabor, Derrick Smith and Susan Magnier's colt got closest to Frankel (GB) (Dansili {GB}) than any other rival this season when beaten only 3/4 of a length by the monster in the G1 St James's Palace S. at Royal Ascot June 14. Subsequently a head runner-up to Mutual Trust (GB) (Cacique {Ire}) in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly July 3, he never looked at home on in soft ground when dropped back to the 6 1/2-furlong trip of the Aug. 7 G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville. Also representing Coolmore interests is the newly acquired stallion prospect **Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), who continues to sport the silks of Giuliano Manfredini here. His latest six-length success in the seven-furlong G2 Hungerford S. at Newbury Aug. 13 sets a clear standard here, and suggests he had progressed for his break after finishing third in the St James's Palace. Despite having won on soft ground in Cologne's G2 Mehl-Muhens-Rennen May 22, trainer Marco Botti is concerned that conditions do not deteriorate too much ahead of tomorrow's contest.

Saddler's Rock, who was unraced as a juvenile, graduated at third asking in a June 23 Tipperary maiden before bagging a 14-furlong Leopardstown handicap in his penultimate start July 7. Third behind the G1 Irish St Leger-bound Fictional Account (Stravinsky) and Fame and Glory (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the Aug. 20 Listed Irish St Leger Trial at The Curragh last time, he reaped the reward of connections' decision to bypass that Classic and made the most of a substantial weight-for-age allowance to deny G2 Goodwood Cup and G2 Yorkshire Cup hero Opinion Poll in game fashion. Jockey Niall McCullagh employed patient tactics for most of the contest and guided his mount into contention once into the long straight. Stoked up approaching the final quarter mile, Saddler's Rock was ridden to challenge at the eighth pole, and he drew off late as his featherweight impost and closing surge proved decisive. "Saddler's Rock is a very economical little horse and only comes alive when you need him to," explained McCullagh. "They went a good pace, he was very good at the business end of the race and stayed on very well. His work last week was very, very good, and the boss [John Oxx] was quietly confident of his chance today." The runner-up's jockey, Frankie Dettori, rued the concession of 17 pounds to the winner. "Opinion Poll ran a great race, but giving one stone and three pounds to the winner was just a step too far," commented Dettori.

Following the group-winning exploits of Gamilati (GB) (Bernardini) and Discourse (Street Cry {Ire}), Lyric of Light proved another Mahmood Al Zarooni-trained 2-year-old filly whose future looks bright with a comfortable success in this competitive renewal. Green on debut but firmly on top at the end of a seven-furlong maiden at Newmarket Aug. 26, the homebred was largely ignored in the betting, which concentrated mainly on the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Fallen For You. Racing with only Samitar behind off the generous early pace here, the bay cruised on to the front end as the pace collapsed with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining and immediately veered right to join the market leader. Continuing to drift towards the stands' rail and take that rival with her, she always seemed to be holding her safely at bay, and the stewards had little option but to let her keep the prize. "She had only run once and so, when she hit the front, she went right, and I tried to steer her as much as I could so as not to interfere with William [Buick, on Fallen For You]," winning rider Frankie Dettori said. "She has a lot of class and won with her ears pricked, so she had a little bit left in the tank. We have some great fillies this year and they are bringing each other on." John Gosden was not downhearted by the effort of the runner-up. "The races have all changed," Gosden told *PA Sport*. "There are three in 27 days with the Prestige, May Hill and Fillies' Mile. We didn't want to be engaged in all three, so came here and it was a real hot race. We're thrilled with the run. She's a lovely big filly and has the scope for next year. William felt he was intimidated and squeezed across, but that happens in racing. If you consider it's a strong cross-headwind, it's no surprise."

Exhibiting dash to claim the July 26 G3 Molecomb S. at Goodwood, he was unable to display that trademark zip against elders on softened turf in York's G1 Nunthorpe S. last time Aug. 19, but rebounded in style to once again deny old foe Burwaaz here. Requinto was swiftly into stride and accepted a tow from Vocational (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) through fast early fractions. Urged to the front approaching the final furlong, he gained a decisive buffer soon after and held on well under a drive as Burwaaz flashed home late. 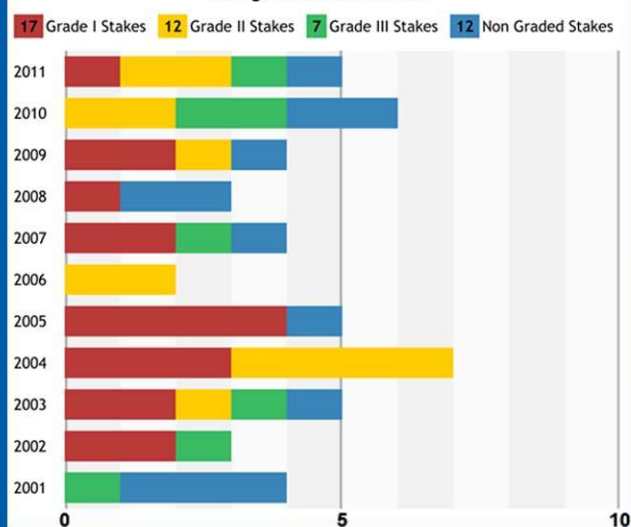

SEPTEMBER BEGINS EVANS DISPERSAL

The Keeneland September Sale marks the beginning of the dispersal of the late Ned Evans' Spring Hill Farm, with 51 yearlings scheduled to sell without reserve.

Evans, who passed away last December, ruled Spring Hill Farm for 40 years. During that time, the Pennsylvania native bred more than 100 stakes winners, including 2005 Horse of the Year Saint Liam (Saint Ballado) and multiple Grade I winner Quality Road (Elusive Quality). Siblings to both will go through the Keeneland sales ring next week.

Spring Hill's longtime farm manger Chris Baker has spent the past several months organizing the dispersal of bloodstock he helped develop over the past 11 years. While it has been a difficult time, Baker said the experience offered him the chance to appreciate anew all that Evans accomplished.

"With what we had to do, you try not to dwell on the emotional side of it," Baker said. "It's the hand we were dealt, with Mr. Evans's death. We've got a job to do, and we have to get that part of it done. We just do as best we can every day and position these horses to sell well, as we expect they will. The other side of it, getting used to not having Mr. Evans himself and losing the opportunity for all of us to be associated with his operation, that's the part of it that is really difficult and hard to get your head around. It was just such a rare

opportunity. We were aware of it when we were here doing it, but you are even more aware of it after it's gone, when you reflect on how great it was. That's the part that is going to take some time to get used to."

Evans was known for his passion for racing and breeding top-quality racehorses, and for his attention to detail.

"Competing at the highest level of the game, that's what drove him," Baker recalled. "He didn't say, 'I want to breed a Derby winner,' or, 'I want to breed a Triple Crown winner,' or 'breed a colt that goes on to be a Classic winner and influential sire.'"

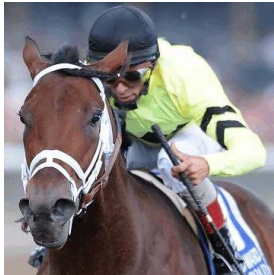

Baker continued, "The standard was always excellence. Whatever we did, we did it at the highest level and we sought to play at the highest level. And if we did that, then those other pieces of the puzzle would fall into place. People say, 'Breed the best to the best and hope for the best.' With him, it was breed the best to the best, do your best by them and good things will happen. He wanted to have the best breeding, the right facility and highest standard of care, from planning the mating, the mare's gestation, the raising of the foal, the breaking of that yearling, to the trainer selection and the trainer doing his job. He wanted to control all the variables, starting with the right mare and breeding her to the right stallion, then control all those variables along the way to give yourself the chance to succeed."

And succeed they did. Evans raced Irish juvenile filly champion Minstrella, as well as Grade I winners Raging Fever, Summer Colony, Cat Moves, Malibu Prayer, Christmas Kid, Misty Gallore and Gygistar. He also was represented by graded winners Withallprobability, Gold Mover, Cat's at Home, Dixie City, Possible Mate and With Ability.

Quality Road was likely the best runner to carry Evans' yellow and black silks. Evans purchased his dam

Kobla (Strawberry Road {Aus}), a full-sister to champion Ajina, for \$1.05 million at the 1999 Keeneland November Sale. She foaled Quality Road in 2006. The bay colt went on to win the GI Florida Derby and GI Fountain of Youth S. before a hoof injury knocked him off the Triple Crown trail. He returned the following season to win the 2010 GI Donn H., GI Metropolitan H. and GI Woodward S. before retiring

with earnings over \$2.2 million.

Evans was the leading breeder in Virginia for nine of the past 11 years and, in 2009, was named TOBA's breeder of the year. He was leading owner at the 2000 Belmont spring/summer meet and Saratoga meet, the 2001, 2002 and 2004 Aqueduct spring meets and the 2010 Saratoga meet. Last year, he was ranked seventh on the North American owner's list with earnings of \$3.6 million.

His single-minded pursuit of excellence made him a demanding boss, but Baker said Evans inspired his team to be better.

"I would describe Mr. Evans as being tough but fair," Baker said. "He had no tolerance for incompetence, no tolerance for fools. If you could get the results for him and you could produce, he had respect for you. If you weren't cutting it in any way, shape or form, there was hell to pay. But if you knew that and were comfortable with that and you could take the heat in the kitchen, so to speak, you were in a position to work with some great horses and do some great things. At times, he certainly was difficult, but I always found him to be fair and extremely honest and with great integrity.

"He was somebody who could push people to be better than they thought they could be, but it wasn't in a Vince Lombardi way," Baker continued. "It was more in a 'What is the price I am going to have to pay if I don't get this right?' Even though there was that gruff and tough exterior, when you got to know him and got to see how he was, he was the kind of guy that was very endearing and the kind of guy you wanted to do your best for. He definitely brought that out in people. It wasn't all hammer and tongs, but there wasn't any Dr. Phil in there, either."

Baker said Evans' attention to detail and his ability to pare things down to their basic components are two lessons he'll take away from his time at Spring Hill.

"What I saw as Mr. Evans' greatest source of genius was his ability to distill what appeared to be complex issues or problems down to one or two simple questions that needed to be answered or acted on appropriately to get the desired outcome," he explained. "There were a number of times I would come to him and say, 'I've got this and I've got that and the other thing.' And he would say, 'Chris, it is not that complicated. This is the core issue you're talking about. Get the information to answer this question, and then go on with confidence. If there was one life lesson that I can take from him and apply to my personal and professional life, it would be that.'

The Evans dispersal, which is being handled by Lane's End, has four horses selling in Book 1 of the September sale.

The first scheduled to go through the ring is [hip 68](#), a colt by Medaglia d'Oro out of Grand Prayer (Grand Slam). The yearling is a half-brother to Grade I winner Malibu Prayer (Malibu Moon).

"He's a very nice, very big, strong forward colt," Baker said of the dark bay. "All of the good parts of that cross, he has, and he is out of a Grade I producer, so there is a lot of upside to him."

[Hip 158](#), a colt by Lemon Drop Kid out of Christmas Gift (Green Desert), is a full-brother to Christmas Kid. Baker described him as a, “bigger, stronger, masculine version,” of that GI Ashland S. winner. “He’s a very forward colt, a big, strong colt. We have high expectations for him.”

A colt by Indian Charlie out of multiple graded stakes winner Gold Mover (Gold Fever) sells as [hip 174](#). A half to stakes winner Giant Mover (Giant’s Causeway), Baker said he is a “very fast-looking colt, very powerful, a well-balanced, well-made colt.”

[Hip 183](#) is a full-brother to Quality Road, and Baker thinks the colt is more impressive than his older brother was at this stage. “He’s better made, he’s a little typier, a little more heavily muscled than Quality Road was as a yearling,” Baker commented. “There are a lot of similarities between them; similar head set and neck set and similar personality, and the exact same coloring. But this is a colt that maybe will come to hand a little quicker. He is a very nice, big, handsome colt.”

Evans’ Spring Hill Farm property in Casanova, Virginia, is slated to sell, with proceeds, like the sale of the farm’s horses, going to the Edward P. Evans Charitable Foundation. But Baker said the farm has yet to be appraised or listed with a real estate agent.

After September, Baker will be focusing on the second phase of the dispersal at the Keeneland November sale. But he is already considering his options for life after Spring Hill.

“I think over the next 30-60 days, I’ll probably be narrowing down my options, but I’d like to do something similar to what I do here,” Baker said. “I’d like to be part of a team of upper management at an owner-breeder-type operation that is trying to do great things in racing. I’d like to contribute to the next great thing and help somebody reach their goals. Time will tell where I end up finding that.” -*Jessica Martini*

FORGING AHEAD AT KEENELAND

Forging Oaks Farm has spent much of the last decade adding quality to its broodmare band via its ever-improving racing string. However, Jim Peyton--owner of the Midway-based nursery--has decided to call time on

his Thoroughbred venture. Through agent Eaton Sales, the farm is slated to offer 10 yearlings over the next two weeks at Keeneland before offering 16 mares during Book 1 and 2 at this venue in November. The operation’s weanlings will be made available

for viewing at the farm, and will be offered as yearlings in 2012.

“They have the best yearling crop I think they’ve ever had,” conceded Reiley McDonald of Eaton Sales. “But they’re here to sell. It’s unfortunate to see people get out of the business, but Mr. Peyton made a business decision.”

Among notable horses campaigned by Forging Oaks Farms are GII San Clemente H. winner Passified (GB) (Compton Place {GB}) and Ticker Tape (GB) (Royal Applause), victorious in the GI American Oaks Invitational and the GI Queen Elizabeth II Cup. Ticker Tape was purchased privately by trainer Jim Cassidy in 2005. Both mares are slated to be among those offered in November.

“I have had a ball racing mares that we brought over from Europe, but I just haven’t had the kind of success, commercially, selling yearlings that I need to in order to continue the operation,” said Peyton, explaining the decision to disperse.

During Sunday's opening session at Keeneland, Forging Oaks has a single yearling on offer in Book 1--[hip 20](#)--a colt by Giant's Causeway.

"He is a really good physical horse," said McDonald. "Particularly in the amount of quality he possesses. He has a really great walk to go with it. We thought he would be a very good horse for Book 1, based on his physical more than anything."

The Feb. 4 foal is out of SW and MGSP Victory Lap (Touch Gold), a half-sister to MGSW and GISP Zanjero (Cherokee Run). Futher expanding on the colt's catalogue page, McDonald offered, "Victory Lap could run and she is still a young mare, and there isn't a more durable sire than Giant's Causeway."

In Book 2, the farm has an additional four yearlings--a filly by Henrythenavigator out of Ticker Tape ([hip 411](#)); a colt by Harlan's Holiday out of Better Now ([hip 595](#)); a filly by Speightstown out of Floating Island ([hip 799](#)) and another daughter of Henrythenavigator out of Passified ([hip 1098](#)).

"The Speightstown filly really looks like a Speightstown, but has more size and leg," confirmed McDonald. "She has the typical big shoulder and hip. She has a really beautiful neck, but she also has some of the features that Speightstown doesn't always get. Given the pedigree and her physical attributes, this filly will really light people up."

Forging Oaks thought enough of the young Coolmore stallion Henrythenavigator to send two of its top mares to him in his first season at stud, and McDonald feels the fillies will be well received at Keeneland.

"The offspring of Henrythenavigator are generally very balanced and have beautiful, long sweeping walks," said McDonald. "I think the Europeans will like them in particular."

Fortunes Rising...

Jim Peyton purchased a closed-down International Harvester forging plant in Louisville in 1985, and after re-christening the dilapidated structure Louisville Forge and Gearworks, he became the sole U.S. supplier of crankshafts for Toyota. Out of the ruins, Peyton developed the company--which was relocated to Georgetown in 1992--into a business that grew to 350 employees, generating \$100-million a year in sales revenue. In 1999, Peyton sold the company to Aishi Steel for an undisclosed sum and turned his focus to the Thoroughbred industry. Since his purchase of Forging Oaks in 1998, Peyton divides his time between his Newtown Pike residence and his home in Naples, Florida. And despite his blazing success in the automotive world, Peyton wasn't able to translate that form to the Thoroughbred business world. Regardless, the septuagenarian doesn't regret his run in the racing game.

"Mr. Peyton has enjoyed horse business and the people he has met, but it's just time to take a break from it," McDonald concluded.--*Christina Bossinakis*

Uncle Mo Likely for Kelso...

Champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie), a game second in his highly anticipated return in Saratoga's GI King's Bishop S. Aug. 27, will likely make his next start versus older horses in Belmont's one-turn mile GII Kelso H. Oct. 1, *Daily Racing Form* reports. Owner Mike Repole and trainer Todd Pletcher were also considering the Sept. 24 GII Pennsylvania Derby, run at 1 1/8 miles, for last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero. **Jackson Bend** (Hear No Evil) and **Jersey Town** (Speightstown), one-two across the line in the GI Forego S. at the Spa Sept. 3, are also pointing toward the Kelso. "After coming back in such spectacular fashion in the King's Bishop, it gives him an extra week, and that is a big factor for us," Repole told *DRF*. "It's five weeks from the King's Bishop and five weeks before the Breeders' Cup; the spacing of the race is perfect." Repole continued, "The second factor is Belmont is his home. He'll be able to work over the track two or three times, we're keeping him on a surface that we know he likes, and that he'll be on for the next four weeks." Uncle Mo was sidelined with a rare liver disorder following a third-place finish in the GI Wood Memorial S. Apr. 9.

Big Drama Headed to Vosburgh...

Harold L. Queen's **Big Drama** (Montbrook), last year's champion sprinter, will make his next start in Belmont Park's GI Vosburgh S. Oct. 8, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Sidelined following a track-record setting performance in Gulfstream's GIII Mr. Prospector S. Jan. 15, the 2010 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint winner resurfaced with an easy win in Calder's Whippleton S. Sept. 4. "I'm real happy with his race, he's doing excellent, and all the ducks are in order to run in the Vosburgh," trainer David Fawkes told *DRF*.

After a session marred by withdrawals and a low turnout, DBS MD Henry Beeby said, "There were positives and negatives to take away from tonight's sale. There was good trade for horses at a level, and we received a fantastic response to the publication of the catalogue, but we were disappointed by the number of withdrawals, especially some of the higher-profile horses, which meant that some of the international buyers decided not to travel.
