



'MEMORIES' TRIES TO FORGET

Last seen checking in a hard-luck fourth at 40 cents on the dollar in Saratoga's GII Lake Placid S. Aug. 21, **Winter Memories** (El Prado {Ire}) seeks redemption and her first Grade I tally in today's Garden City S. at Belmont. She's faced with no easy task yet again,

however, as Lake Placid heroine **Hungry Island** (More Than Ready); GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **More Than Real** (More Than Ready) and formidable European invader **Theysken's Theory** (Bernardini) top a list of worthy opponents. Previously unbeaten in 2011 with breathtaking wins in the GIII Appalachian S., GII Sands Point S. and GII Lake George S., Winter Memories came into the Lake Placid with a lofty reputation and a very large target on her back. She appeared less than fond of Saratoga's yielding sod--despite a romp over a similar bog in last term's GIII Miss Grillo S.--and endured significant traffic trouble, partially due to Ramon Dominguez's successful race riding on eventual third-place finisher Dynamic Holiday (Harlan's Holiday) ([TDN video](#)). Trainer Jimmy Toner enlists the services of Javier Castellano for the first time. Jose Lezcano piloted Winter Memories in each of her seven previous starts. "I would like for her to make amends for her last race," admitted the veteran conditioner. "I certainly don't want to take anything away from Hungry Island, who ran a great race. I just hope [Winter Memories] can run her race, is all." Hungry Island's Lake Placid performance was very impressive--Winter Memories-esque, one might say--and she may very well have made it to the winner's circle regardless of what her favored foe did. Seeking the fourth-straight victory of her own last time, the Emory Hamilton homebred swept from last to first in the blink of an eye, getting her final furlong in a very quick :11.79 considering the conditions, to win going away by 2 1/2 lengths over **Kathmanblu** (Bluegrass Cat). "I think that last race was obviously her best race," said Buzz Tenney, assistant to Shug McGaughey, trainer of Hungry Island. "All summer long we've seen improvement and I think there's room for more improvement, too." If that's the case, Hungry Island will be a handful. **Cont. p2**

THE RETURN OF MIDGE

Last year's GI Breeders' Cup Turf hero **Dangerous Midge** (Lion Heart) bids to book a return visit to Churchill Downs as he comes back off a lengthy break in today's G3 Arc Trial S. at Newbury. Having run below par when left trailing in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Meydan Mar. 26, he will need to be near his best to emulate his four-length success in this race 12 months ago. "He is in good heart, but could be a little ring-rusty," trainer Brian Meehan said yesterday. **Sri Putra (GB)** (Oasis Dream {GB}) was third in both the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 15 and G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 2, but seems to reserve his best for that type of race, and **Green Destiny (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) may be of more interest in this affair. Off the mark in pattern company in York's G3 Strensall S. over nearly nine furlongs last time Aug. 19, he is held in high regard by his astute trainer. **Field p6**

More Than Real has also gotten the best of the expected Garden City favorite. Celebrity chef Bobby Flay's runner took the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf at 13-1 over 11-10 Winter Memories last November, but is in search of her first victory since then. The chestnut began her sophomore campaign with an off-the-board finish in the G1 Coronation S. at Ascot June 17, and was third with a wide, bumpy trip in the Lake George last time. With more time to recover from her overseas voyage, the Todd Pletcher trainee could turn it around and return to her juvenile form. Andrew Rosen's **Theysken's Theory**, winner of the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood and third in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot last term, is coming off a victory in the Aug. 20 Atalanta S. at Sandown. The 112 *Racing Post* Rating she received for that effort compares very favorably with what it will take to win here.

CALLING CASPAR

Traditionally used as a springboard to the Middle Park, today's G2 Mill Reef S. features **Caspar Netscher**, who bids to defy a penalty for his winning exploits in the G2 Gimcrack S. over this trip at York last time Aug. 19. Previously third behind the leading juvenile Harbour Watch (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) in Goodwood's G2 Richmond S. July 29, he looks to be progressing with each outing. "He's in rude health and all being well, I think he goes there with an excellent chance," conditioner Alan McCabe told *PA Sport*. "He showed at York he handles cut in the ground--if anything, he was more effective on it. We'll wait and see which way the race is run tomorrow and how we get on before we make any future plans." **Saigon** beat that rival in the Listed Rose Bowl S. over course and distance July 15, but was only fifth in the Richmond and third in the G3 Sirenia S. on Kempton's Polytrack Sept. 3. Trainer James Toller is hoping he can revive his fortunes here. "His Newbury form with Caspar Netscher obviously gives him a very good chance, so we're hoping for the best," Toller told *PA Sport*. "Caspar Netscher finished in front of us at Goodwood, but I don't think the track suited our horse and the watered ground also left it quite loose, which didn't help. I'm slightly concerned about the ground on Saturday, as I think he'd be a better horse on a faster surface. I'm very happy with the horse and, while he might be ready for a step up to seven furlongs, a straight, galloping track like Newbury should be all right for him over six." **B Fifty Two** was second to the subsequent G1 Prix Morny winner Dabirsim (Fr) (Hat Trick {Jpn}) in the July 31 G3 Prix de Cabourg at Deauville, but was only fifth in the Gimcrack, and needs to show more this time.

FINALE FACES TOUGHER TEST IN SUMMER

While expected heavy favorite **Finale** looms an imposing presence in the GIII Summer S., he must deal with a much more talented field than he drubbed by 10 1/2 lengths in the Continental Mile S. last time at Monmouth Aug. 20. The Todd Pletcher trainee first caught the eye with an out-of-the clouds third-place finish on debut at Belmont May 5, and donned cap and gown by an emphatic 5 3/4 lengths two starts later while switching surfaces. He was 1-5 in the Continental Mile, which was a testament to the impressive nature of his previous effort, but also an indictment of the group he was facing. Trainer Sid Attard saddles two of Finale's tougher opponents. Noresman Racing Stable's **Maritimer** has shown flashes of talent, but still appears to have some growing up to do. He has a tendency to cut it close and take his time reaching top speed, which cost him in the main-track Vandal S. when he lost by a head July 31. He was runner-up to GIII Natalma S. morning-line choice Hard Not to Like (Hard Spun) (*see below*) in an Aug. 26 allowance prep for this over course and distance last time, again failing to get uncorked until it was too late. "He's like a big kid," Attard told *Daily Racing Form*. "He likes to play around. When he puts it together, he's going to be a really nice horse." Jim Lawson's **Jomelo**, third in the July 3 Clarendon S., put it into overdrive in the late stages of his turf debut to earn his diploma going six furlongs last out Aug. 4. He covered his final eighth in :11.34 and, as a son of Giacomo out of an unraced daughter of MGISW router Magical Maiden (Lord Avie), he figures to appreciate more ground. "I don't think [the surface] matters for him, but he ran so good on the grass," Attard told *DRF*. "I think he'll relax in behind and come running."

PLENTY OF POSSIBILITIES IN NATALMA

Any one of the 13 entered for Saturday's GIII Natalma S. appear in with a shot, but one trainer has things stacked very much in his favor. Mark Casse has four representatives--Ontario Debutante S. runner-up **Northern Passion** and recent maiden winners **Sky Dreamer** and **Spirited Miss** for John Oxley, as well as seven-length Polytrack romper **Quality Lass** for West Point Thoroughbreds. Northern Passion, the shortest price of the Casse contingent at 4-1 on the morning line, has never tried the turf and has never gone long, but her well-armed conditioner doesn't see many limitations for her. "She's like a dream," Casse told *Daily Racing Form*. "She does everything right. I think she could be any kind. I don't think that she'll have any problem with the grass." Hillsbrook Farms' **Hard Not to Like** is the only filly in the group to take multiple trips to the winner's circle. After opening her account with a nice late rally sprinting over this course on debut July 30, the grey beat the boys in an allowance over this trip Aug. 26. Runner-up Maritimer (Stormy Atlantic) is 4-1 on the line in the Summer S. (see above). Hall of Famer Bill Mott should fly under the radar with **Anna Sophia**, but she has license to improve dramatically in her grass debut.

By top European stallion Oasis Dream (GB) out of an Australian female family, the Siena Farms homebred was a surprising debut winner on the main track at Belmont June 30. She was a well-beaten last of five in the GII Adirondack S. at Saratoga Aug. 14, and now gets on the surface that she's best bred for following a snappy five-furlong spin in 1:00 1/5 over the Belmont spinach Sept. 11. Anna Sophia shares connections with Alaura Michele (Arch), an impressive winner of the P.G. Johnson S. within this same division Aug. 31.

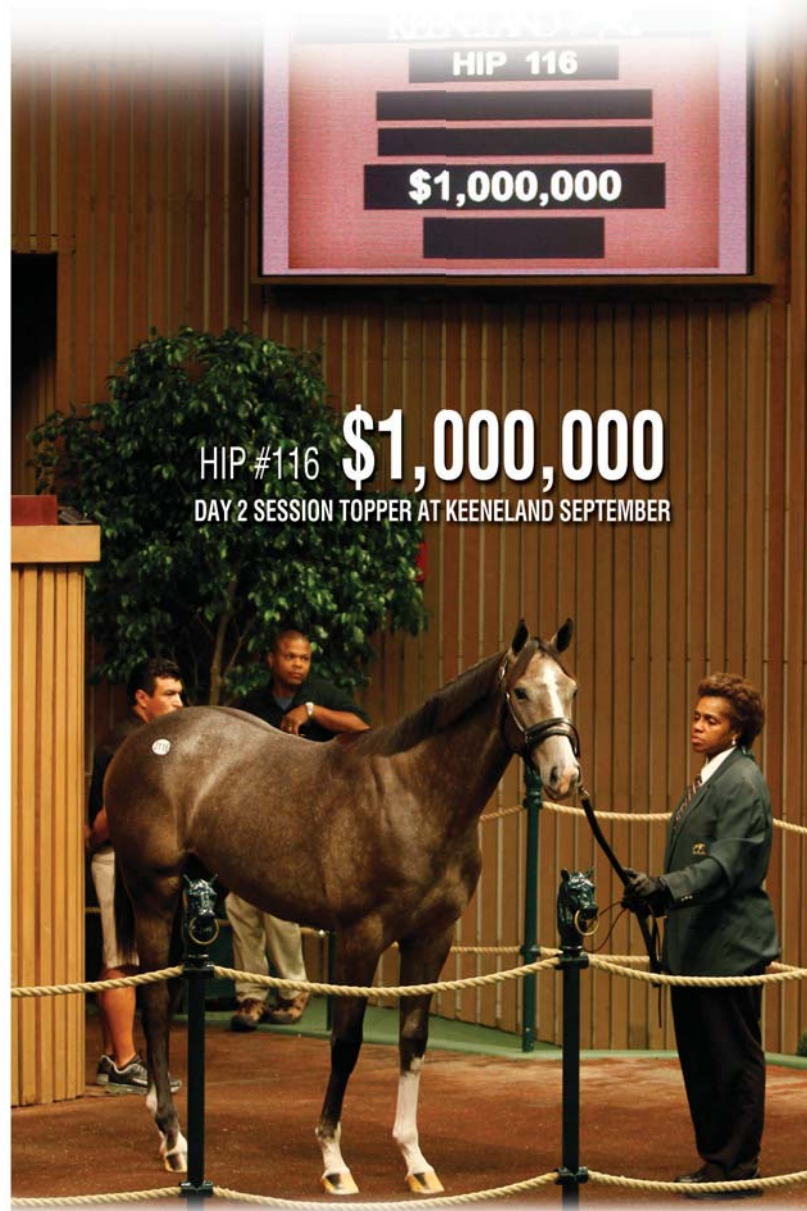
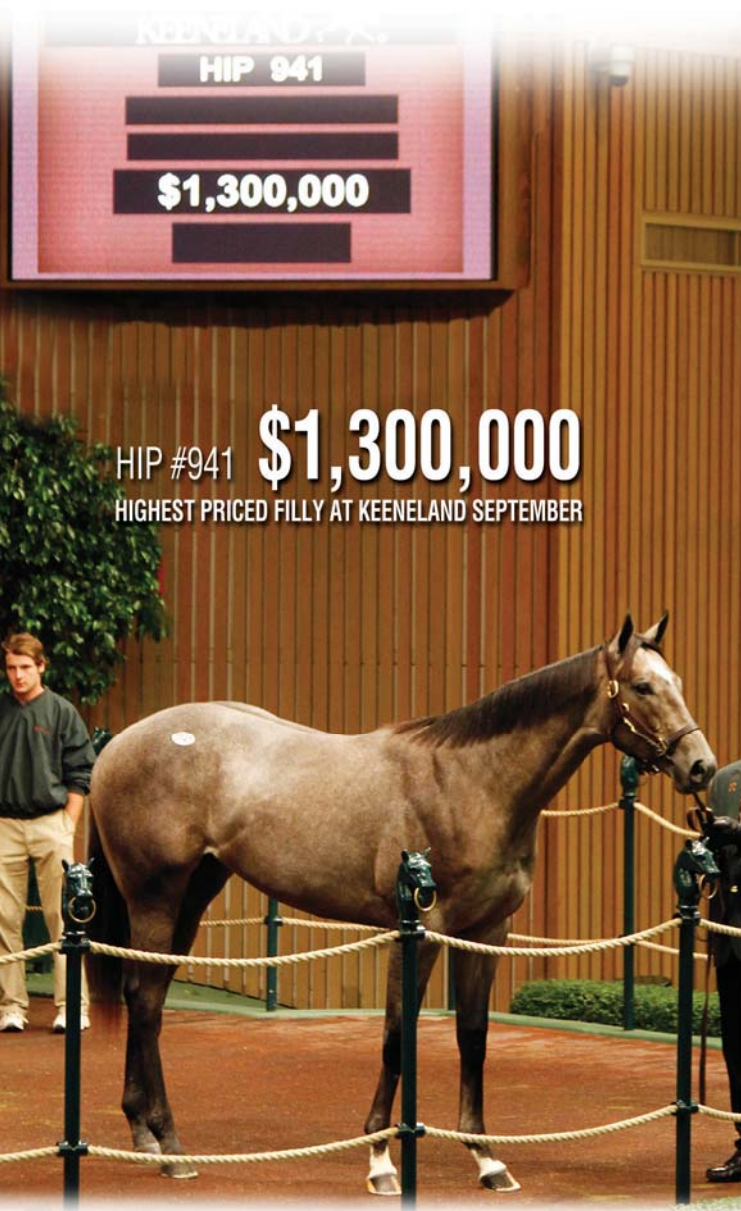

'MARKET' CERTAINLY IN THE MIX

Glen Hill Farm's **Marketing Mix** has a bright future on the lawn if her smashing 4 3/4-length romp in the 10-furlong Wonder Where S. for Canadian-bred fillies was any indication. She seeks her first graded blacktype in the GIII Pucker Up S. at Arlington this afternoon, and bids to remain perfect on the green stuff. Millenium Farms' **Summer Savory** is two-for-two over this course, and was held up in traffic in the July 16 GIII Virginia Oaks at Colonial before making a late surge to get second, beaten a half-length while probably best. She had no apparent excuse last time for her sixth-place finish as the chalk in the GIII Ontario Colleen S. Aug. 27, but her connections show signs of confidence running right back in this tough spot. A more unsung member of this full field is \$1,000 KEESEP bargain buy **Don't Tell Sophia**, a turf graduate at Indiana Downs July 1 and an 8 3/4-length victress on the dirt at Hoosier Aug. 12. She earned a solid 87 Beyer Speed Figure for the romp last time, and trainer and co-owner Phil Sims is high on her. "The Pucker Up will test her, but I feel like she's good enough," he told *Daily Racing Form*. "I always have liked her. She's still just kind of learning. When she gets going, she can really move."

BIG PURSE LURES THEM TO CHUCK TOWN

Charles Town has done well in recent years using slots-fueled purses to attract top out-of-state talent, and a very accomplished field has gathered to chop up the \$400,000 purse attached to tonight's Charles Town Oaks. Bobby Flay ships in **Her Smile**, third in the one-turn mile GI Acorn S. June 4 and winner of the six-furlong GI Prioress S. July 4, both at Belmont. She's coming off a fourth-place run in the GI Test S. at the Spa Aug. 6. **Hot Summer**, who bested Her Smile in the GIII Comely S. at Aqueduct in April before finishing third in the nine-furlong GII Black-Eyed Susan S. at Pimlico May 20, returned Aug. 27 to grab the GIII Victory Ride S. at Saratoga with a furious late finish. Trainer David Fawkes sent Duke of Mischief (Graeme Hall) here for an impressive score in the GIII Charles Town Classic in April, and took the Red Legend S. with Big Drama (Montbrook) in 2009. Lightly raced **Groupie Doll** invades from Kentucky for trainer Buff Bradley, who co-bred and owns the chestnut with his father, Fred. Groupie Doll graduated impressively by 3 1/2 lengths Churchill Downs in her second start June 17 before cruising by 8 1/2 lengths at this distance in the slop at Ellis July 4. She handled older foes with ease in her stakes debut last time, annexing the GIII Gardenia S. Aug. 13 by three lengths with a 94 Beyer Speed Figure, the highest last-out number in the field.

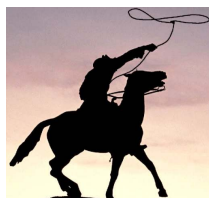

RACETRACK Round-Up

'Blanco' Coming Back for Joe Hirsch...

Cape Blanco (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}), who has already crossed the Atlantic twice this summer to collect the GI Man o' War S. and GI Arlington Million, is expected to add more frequent flyer miles for the GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic at Belmont Oct. 1. Winner of the G1 Irish Derby and G1 Irish Champion S. last season, the chestnut is campaigned by the partnership of Fitri Hay, Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Michael Smith, and is trained by Aidan O'Brien. "He appears to be in great form, so we're hopeful he'll run somewhere close to best again in the Joe Hirsch," said O'Brien. "He's an extremely laid-back horse, so the traveling doesn't seem to take too much out of him." With a pair of Grade I wins, Cape Blanco is among the frontrunners for divisional honors on these shores. "He's beaten 2009 and 2010 champion turf horse Gio Ponti in both the Man o' War and the Arlington Million, so we'd like to think he's in with a good shot at getting an Eclipse Award," said O'Brien. "However, there are plenty of races yet to be run, so let's see what happens. There was no great 'master plan' to win an Eclipse Award, but we're delighted that he is now in contention for one."

Air Support Grounded for the Year...

Stuart Janney III's **Air Support** (Smart Strike), unraced since his win in the GII Virginia Derby July 16, will be freshened up for a 4-year-old campaign, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "He just never seemed to bounce back out of his race in Virginia, so I piddled with him and piddled with him and I could never get him the way I wanted him, so I pulled the plug," trainer Shug McGaughey told *DRF*. Air Support, who also captured Keeneland's GIII Transylvania S. and Belmont's GIII Pilgrim S., will be turned out at Niall Brennan's farm in Ocala, Florida before joining McGaughey's string at Payson Park this winter.

Keeneland Boosts Purses for Woodford, Bourbon...

Keeneland has announced purse increases for a pair of Grade III events during its opening weekend, the Oct. 8 Woodford S. and Oct. 9 Bourbon S. Previously listed at \$100,000, both turf races will now be worth \$150,000. "Keeneland is committed to providing the highest purses possible, especially for our Breeders' Cup prep races," said Vice President of Racing Rogers Beasley. "These two races are emerging as top prep races, so we're glad to be able to augment them." Last year's Woodford winner Chamberlain Bridge (War Chant) went on to capture the GII Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint.

THREE-DAY EXTRAVAGANZA

Toward the end of Thursday's session--even better than Tuesday's and Wednesday's super-strong sessions--Keeneland president Nick Nicholson commented, "of course, we are thrilled, not just for ourselves, but for the industry. It's without any doubt the first time since 2007 people have had a spring in their step, and smiles on their faces--and the buyers as much as the consignors. It's great to see." I threatened to report Nick as 'deliriously' happy, but as he reminded me, he doesn't really do 'delirious.' So as close as Nick Nicholson gets to delirious, that was his take on the proceedings.

The first real evidence we had that the market was actually taking off was when we saw the \$32-million gross figure for Tuesday's opening session of Book 2; if that continued, the 2011 three-day gross would actually approach the 2010 four-day gross. In 2010, the four-day Book 2 had 1,302 yearlings catalogued, of which 814 sold (62.5%), grossing \$97,682,500, and averaging \$120,003. I thought, after Book 1, a gross of \$80-million for this year's three-day Book 2 would be a big win. In fact, with 935 yearlings catalogued (28% fewer than 2010), the gross actually exceeded that of 2010: this year, 624 yearlings sold (67% of those catalogued), grossing \$99,616,500, and averaging \$159,642. To actually exceed the 2010 four-day gross in a three-day sale which had 28% fewer horses catalogued, that pretty much sums it up.

Here are a couple of measurements which indicate the market's strength: take a look at the table below showing the number of horses in Book 2 which achieved three key price levels:

This year, three horses in Book 2 brought \$1m+; last year, there was one. This year, 13 yearlings brought final bids of \$500,000 or more; last year (four days instead of three, remember), 10. Most telling, this year there were 73 yearlings in Book 2 that sold for final bids of \$300,000 or more; last year, there were 58. There were 26% more yearlings which sold for \$300,000 plus, but as a percentage of those sold, it was even much higher: 73 at \$300,000+ of the 624 sold in Book 2 is 11.7%. In 2010, 58 which brought \$300,000+ were 7.2% of the 814 yearlings sold. The percentage of Book 2 yearlings which brought \$300,000 or more from those sold increased by 62.5%! Mind you, in a way it does highlight the gap between the rich and the poor in this context: 88.3% of yearlings sold did not make \$300,000+, and considering stud fees and other production costs, there were still an awfully lot of yearlings that lost people money. But that doesn't obviate the tremendous results for those which did clear the bar.

Perhaps the best actual measurement of where the market stands is to compare this year's Books 1-2 not to 2010, but to 2009, which was the clear September market bottom, and which had also had a similar number of yearlings catalogued (though in four days, the last year of the old format) as in 2011 (see the bottom table in the Weekly Sales Ticker, the lines for 2011 and 2009). In 2009--and this was the market bottom--1,212 yearlings were catalogued in Books 1-2, of which 703 sold (58% of those catalogued), grossing a rock-bottom \$117,659,500, and averaging \$167,368--this is for the whole first week, remember, Book 1 plus Book 2. This year, there were 1,146 yearlings in Books 1-2, of which 753 sold (66% of those catalogued), grossing \$145,216,500, and averaging \$192,851. The number sold in 2011 Week 1, compared to 2009 Week 1, was 7% higher; and the clearance rate from the catalogues improved by 14% (66% divided by 58%). The gross was up 23%, and the average up by 15%. If we average out the 23% increase in gross and the 15% in average, that comes out to 19%--let's call it 20%. Using these calculations, we can say with some confidence that the Keeneland September market is up 20% from its 2009 bottom. It's the first seriously good news we've seen in the Thoroughbred market since the crash three years ago.

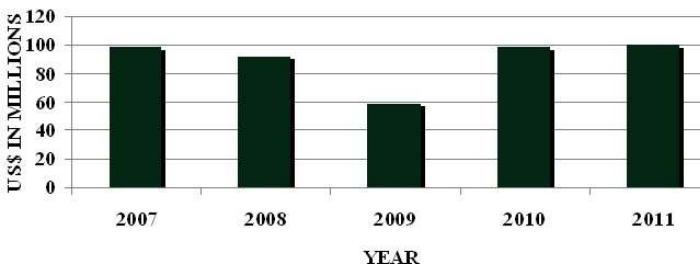

“An increase in average wouldn't be entirely unexpected with Book 2 shrinking to three days from four, but for this year's three-day Book 2 gross to top last year's four-day gross by nearly \$2-million WAS entirely unexpected. As detailed in the column, the most logical comparison of Week 1 is to compare this year's 5-session Week 1 (1,146 catalogued in Books 1-2) with the four-day Week 1 in 2009 (1,212 catalogued). Using that comparison, Week 1 was up 23% in gross from the 2009 bottom, and 15% in average. Happy Days aren't here again, but the Week 1 market was 20% above the bottom.”

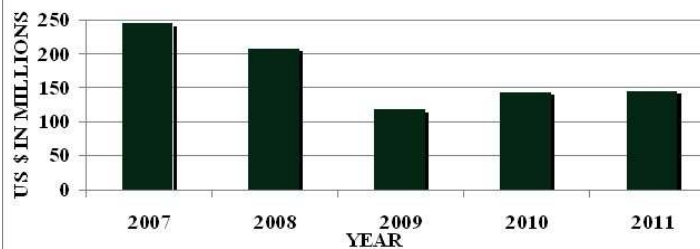

Awesome Again has been on the underrated list for some time now, but his name was back in lights Thursday night as the leading sire by average in Keeneland Books 1-2, thanks to his \$1.35-million session topper, for which Frank Stronach, at whose Adena Springs Farm Awesome Again stands, outbid Ghostzapper partner Stonestreet, and their sometimes-partner George Bolton. With seven sold in the first two books, Awesome Again averaged \$452,143, besting A.P. Indy, whose eight sold averaged \$411,875. However, Awesome Again has 15 catalogued in Week 2, whereas A.P. Indy has none, so it doesn't need much working out that A.P. Indy will finish the sale as the top sire on average. It's good to see Awesome Again back on the leader board where he belongs, though.

Claiborne's War Front has been one of the revelations of the sale, as his eight yearlings have averaged \$356,250 (all averages from *keeneland.com*). He has nine more catalogued in the second week, however, so Darley's Street Cry, who achieved 'July Sale sire' status, with 16 averaging \$351,888 and has just one catalogued in the second week, will almost certainly end up with a higher average at the end of the entire proceedings. The accompanying table shows the top 20 sires by average, just in Keeneland Books 1-2, with the number catalogued for each in the second week. Of course, beginning today is when we'll begin to see the bigger representations of sires like Tiz Wonderful (59), Henny Hughes (50), Lion Heart (50), Street Boss (47), etc. **Bill Oppenheim may be contacted at bopp@erb.com (please cc TDN management at suefinley@thoroughbreddailynews.com). 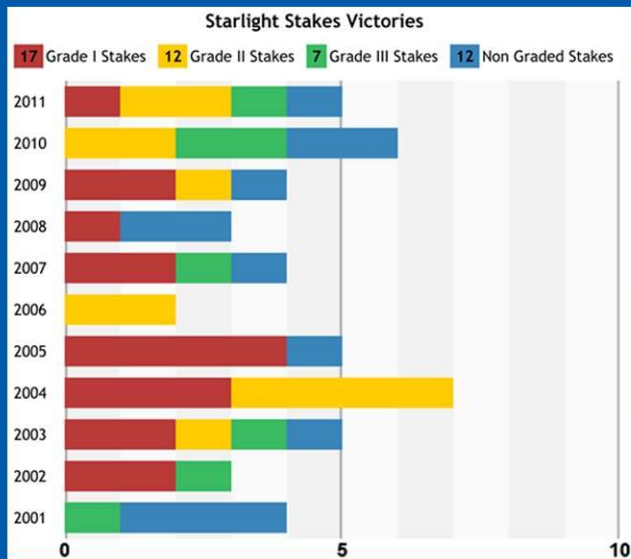

Jockey Club's Wilson to Discuss McKinsey Study at Simulcast Conference:

Edited Press Release

Jason Wilson, Vice President of Business Development for The Jockey Club, will review the recent study conducted by McKinsey & Co. on the Thoroughbred racing industry Monday afternoon, Oct. 3, at the 19th annual International Simulcast Conference in Scottsdale, AZ. Wilson, who joined The Jockey Club a year ago after serving as a vice president in the real estate, gaming and lodging investment banking group Banc of America Securities, will elaborate on McKinsey's study, including its analysis of the causes of the decline of racing, where the industry is headed over the next 10 years if it follows its current course, and recommendations for not only stemming the decline, but also sparking vital growth. Following Wilson, Brad Kimbrell, Executive Vice President of InCompass Solutions, will describe the toolset being developed as part of the "Fewer, Better Races through Rational Scheduling" initiative. This toolset will address scheduling of race dates and post times, suggest which races are most likely to fill based on horse inventory and which of those races should result in the best pari-mutuel race card. Metrics gained from the McKinsey Study will be applied to racing data along with historical information available to the InCompass RTO System to optimize race cards. The McKinsey study's recommendations regarding the need to raise awareness of racing through television will be addressed in the conference's closing session on Wednesday morning.

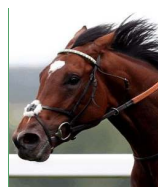

REFUSE TO BEND TO LOGIS

Refuse To Bend (Ire) (Sadler's Wells--Market Slide, by Gulch) has been transferred from Whitsbury Manor Stud to Haras du Logis, the *Racing Post* revealed yesterday. The sire of Sarafina (Fr) and this year's G1 Prix Saint-Alary scorer Wavering (Ire) has moved to the Normandy-based operation ahead of the former's Arc bid and Darley's Director of Stallions Sam Bullard told the trade daily, "Refuse To Bend has proved himself more than capable of siring classy, durable racehorses and, in Sarafina, he has a truly top-class daughter. His stock have performed extremely well in France, and we think he has the potential to be a future champion sire there. A fee for Refuse To Bend will be set in the autumn."

Agence FIPS paid €38,000 for the day's top-priced filly by Poliglote (GB) from Jedburgh Stud. Hip **121** is a half-sister to this year's G2 Prix Robert Papin runner-up Louve Rouge (Fr) (Gold Away {Ire}). Trainer Jean-Claude Rouget, who trains at nearby Pau, bought a total of eight yearlings headed by a Green Tune colt from the draft of Elevage de Tourgeville. From the immediate family of one of the sire's black-type performers in Love Green (Fr), hip **7** was secured for €34,000.
