BUCKEYE HITS THE BULLSEYE AT KEESEP

An Ohio-bred daughter of Sky Mesa topped Monday's eighth session of Keeneland September after trainer Mark Casse, sitting just under the press box, saw off a challenger from across the pavilion to land the flashy chestnut for \$230,000. Selling from the draft of Judy



Klosterman, agent for Langsem Farm Inc., [hip 2242](#) was produced by the winning Floral Park (Forest Wildcat), a granddaughter of GISW Chelsey Flower (His Majesty). "I just thought she was beautiful," said Casse, buying on behalf of an

undisclosed client. "I thought she was one of the nicest fillies I'd seen all week. It's funny, I was actually out yesterday looking at horses and wasn't even looking at this filly, but she walked past and I said to my wife, 'Find out who *that* is.' I was excited to get her--I really wanted her."

The filly received a timely update since the catalog was printed, as her year-old half-brother Dougs Buddy (Badge of Silver), listed as unraced on the page, has now won all three of his starts. A modest \$7,500 yearling here a year ago, Dougs Buddy broke his maiden by seven lengths at Northlands Park at first asking July 20, romped by six in the Edmonton Juvenile S. 10 days later and, more recently, annexed the Birdcatcher S. Aug. 27. He has \$72,119 in earnings.

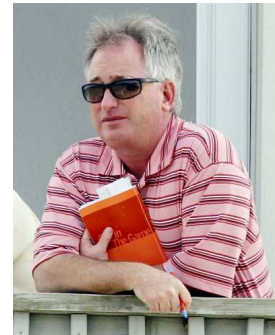


...and heading back home

Both horses were bred by Langsem Farm, the Loveland, Ohio-based operation owned by Ken and Judy Klosterman. Judy grew up in a racing family, so much so that when she and Ken married, they were given five Thoroughbreds as a wedding gift from her father. The Klosterman family's Klosterman Baking Co., founded over a century ago and headquartered in Cincinnati, is one of the largest family-owned bakeries in the Midwest. **Cont. p2**

FASIG-TIPTON PUSHES BACK FLORIDA SALE

Fasig-Tipton has announced the 2012 dates for its Florida Sale of Selected Two-year-olds in Training at Palm Meadows. The sale will take place approximately three weeks later than it did in 2011. The under-tack show is scheduled for Mar. 23, while the actual sale will be Mar. 26. Last year's sale took place Mar. 3. "There has been a steady shift over the last few years in most 2-year-old racing programs, with the tracks pushing back juvenile races to later dates in their calendars," explained Fasig-Tipton President Boyd Browning. "Finding a window for our sale in late March is a logical move to reflect these circumstances. We will also move the sale from a Thursday spot to a Monday, which allows us to avoid any conflicts with live racing at Gulfstream Park." Browning also noted the positive response Fasig-Tipton received regarding last year's change in facilities from Calder Race Course to Palm Meadows Training Center. "After our inaugural sale there last year, our buyers and consignors alike gave very high marks to the facilities and location of Palm Meadows, and we loved the enthusiasm for the project from the entire team there," Browning said.

Langsem Farm itself was founded in 1987, and isn't a stranger to success in the Keeneland ring. At the 1999 September Sale, it sold the Ohio-bred Unbridled Time (Unbridled's Song--Haveaheavenlytime, by Halo) to Bob and Beverly Lewis for \$1.15 million. The D. Wayne Lukas-trained gray won the WHAS S. at Churchill in his second career start on Derby Day in 2000 and became a MSW of over \$340,000. Other big scores at Keeneland for the Klostermans include Tempt Fortune (Forest Wildcat), who brought \$340,000 at the 2004 renewal.

"We've been there before, but it's always really exciting," said farm manager Leslie Stone, who was heading up the Klosterman draft along with grooms Jennifer Scarborough and Mary Corwin. "The sales have been so tough the last few years, it's nice to be on the other end of it."

The transaction was especially sweet given the Klostermans' investment in the mare. They acquired Floral Park, an Overbrook Farm-bred, Churchill Downs allowance winner of nearly \$100,000, as a broodmare prospect for \$45,000 at the 2007 Keeneland November Sale.

Despite the nice update and a sterling physical, Stone admitted to being pleasantly surprised by the price. "I thought maybe she'd bring \$100,000, so obviously I'm really happy with the result," she said from the rear walking ring. "But she was a really nice filly. She's always been sound. It's only the second foal out that mare, and the first had that big update."

Asked if she was surprised the Ohio-bred went to a horseman who wasn't based in the Midwest, Stone offered, "I don't think it really matters much where they're foaled--a good horse is a good horse."

A pair of colts shared the second-highest price of the day at Keeneland. [Hip 2029](#), a Charlton-consigned chestnut by Lion Heart--Silent Academy went to the Hong Kong Jockey Club (*see story below*) for \$220,000. Cash Asmussen signed the ticket for the HKJC, which has rung up eight yearling buys at Keeneland for a total of \$987,000. "He was a wonderful horse," said Asmussen, who went on explain the group of yearlings will be resold as horses-in-training in Hong Kong. "We were looking for horses that have a little more speed than in the past, because we're concentrating on sprint or mile races," Asmussen explained. "He fit the bill. We've had to have a lot of patience. There's a certain type of horse we are looking for, and within a certain price range, that makes sense for us to be able to resell in Hong Kong. The horses will be trained here and then sent over."

The colt's \$220,000 price tag was later matched by a colt from the same sire line. [Hip 2197](#), by Tale of the Cat--Darling Temper, went to Bob Feld, agent for Sagamore Farm. The chestnut was produced by a winning Point Given half-sister to GISW Early Pioneer (Rahy) and two other stakes horses. He was consigned by Eaton Sales.

Two others made \$210,000 on Monday. [Hip 2241](#), the Lawyer Ron full-brother to recent GI Del Mar Futurity winner Drill, realized that amount on the strength of Nick Sallusto and Hanzly Albina's bid for Black Rock Stables. The bay, from the winning Cat Dancer (Storm Cat), was a nifty pinhook for the partnership group that had purchased him as Fir Grove Farm for \$60,000 at the 2010 Keeneland November Sale. Gainesway Farm consigned.

Also realizing \$210,000 was the Lane's End-consigned [hip 2357](#), a filly from the first crop of Horse of the Year Curlin (Smart Strike) out of Montera (Easy Goer). The May 4-foaled chestnut is a half-sister to GSW Sue's Good News (Woodman) and MSW & MGSP Easyfromthegitgo (Dehere).

Small Breeder Sells Lion Heart Colt...

A fractured arm kept Anne Thorington from attending the Keeneland September Sale, but the head of Maple Leaf Farm was able to watch on the internet as [hip 2197](#), a Lion Heart half-brother to Sweet August Moon (Malibu Moon) she bred in Pennsylvania, brought a near-top price of \$220,000 during yesterday's eighth session. Cash Asmussen, acting on behalf of the Hong Kong Jockey Club, made the winning bid for the colt, who was consigned by Rick and Dixie Abbott's Charlton. "They got a nice fella," Thorington said by phone.

The fella the Hong Kong Jockey Club got is a son of the winning 12-year-old mare Silent Academy (Royal Academy), whose first foal, the now 6-year-old Sweet August Moon, sold for \$50,000 here back in 2006. Bought as a yearling by Tony Bowling and Bobby Dodd, Sweet August Moon was resold to trainer Brian Koriner for \$400,000 at the 2007 OBSMAR sale. She went on to win a trio of graded races, including last year's GI A Gleam H. at Hollywood, for Legacy Ranch and Shirley MacPherson and is now retired to the broodmare shed.

"She was a big, tough mare," Thorington said of Sweet August Moon. "This colt is really a nice guy--I don't mean gentle--but he's much more mannered. I had to take her to swim one time and it was worth your life just trying to get her into the pool. She was just a 2-year-old then. She was tough. But the mother and the dam are very quiet, so they vary how they are. I just hope this guy gets a good home. You get very fond of them when you raise them and they're on your farm." **Cont. p4**

Why Go Anywhere Else?



Maple Leaf cont.

Maple Leaf Farm is based on 90 acres in Coatesville, Pennsylvania, about 30 miles from Philadelphia. "We're a very small farm," said Thorington, who is retired. "We had six foals this year, and we're only having four next year. We live a half an hour from Rick [Abbott], Michael Matz lives on the end of the road I'm on, and one of my neighbors is Betty Moran, so you can understand why I have an inferiority complex."

Thorington has owned Thoroughbreds herself for the past 20 or 25 years, but has been around horses all her life. "My father raced and bred horses, and I did a lot of foxhunting in my younger years," she said. She currently has a few horses in training with trainer Tim Woolley at Fair Hill Training Center.

Yesterday's Lion Heart colt is actually the grandson of one of the first mares Thorington bought for Maple Leaf, the MGSW Silent Turn (Silent Cal), acquired in foal to Spend a Buck for \$190,000 at the 1990 Keeneland November Sale. Maple Leaf did okay selling out of Silent Turn, selling not one, but three separate colts to the Maktoum brothers for \$180,000 each. "She's still alive--she's 29," said Thorington. "Once you get here, you stay."

One Thorington didn't sell out of Silent Turn was the Lion Heart colt's dam. Silent Academy was bought back for \$65,000 as a KEESEP yearling in 2000 before going on to be an allowance winner of over \$40,000 on the track. "Unfortunately, she lost the Malibu Moon she was carrying for next year, so that's disappointing," Thorington reported. "But she has a nice Broken Vow weanling filly right now who might sell as a yearling next year. Though I get very reluctant to sell fillies."

Yesterday wasn't Maple Leaf's best day at auction. Back in the mid-1990s, it sold eventual stakes winner All the Moves (A.P. Indy) and GSP Sequence (Dixieland Band) for \$430,000 and \$320,000, respectively, as FTSAUG yearlings.

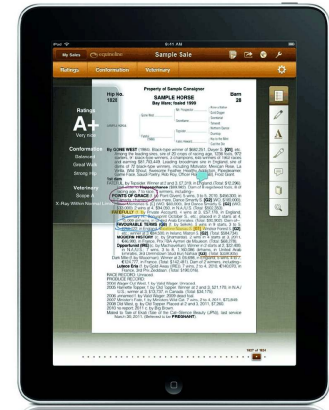

iPad App Popular on the Grounds...

Equineline recently released a free Sales Catalog iPad App, and an increasing number of buyers are taking advantage of the new technology to keep better organized at the marathon Keeneland September Sale.



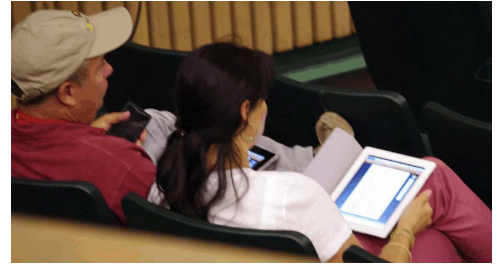
"I tell you what, after you use it, you feel foolish for not using it sooner," said leading Canadian trainer Mark Casse. "You don't have to carry around a bunch of catalogs, it's easy to make short lists, if it's windy you don't have to deal with pages flying around--you just type what page you want and it's right there." Casse added with a laugh, "Some of the horses have shied away from it, but we bought one today who didn't mind it at all. I told the guy he was iPad broke."

The app allows users to download any number of catalogues into their iPads, where they'll be arranged on a digital "bookshelf." Buyers then have a wide array of tools at their disposal. Using a stylus, or just the tip of a finger, catalog pages can be written on just like a traditional paper catalog. There's also a highlighter tool. Several different color palates are offered.

Three menu items with pre-entered indicators can speed up the process. Letter grades (A+, A, B, etc.) can be quickly assigned, as can veterinary grades for scopes and x-rays. There are also a number of conformation fields ("strong hip," "back at knees," "long pasterns," etc.) that can be checked off. More menu items can be added and are customizable.

The "sticky note" tool inserts an icon at a determined place on the page that, when selected, brings up a yellow pad, on which longer, more detailed notes can be taken.

There are also “index” and “search” features that make it easy to find just what a buyer’s looking for. New York-bred Malibu Moon fillies out of stakes-producing mares? Check.

Short lists can be generated by selecting whichever criteria one chooses, and buyers shopping for numerous clients can make several different short lists. There are six, color-coded default short lists.

Once buyers are done shopping, catalog pages, including any notes made to them, can easily be emailed to clients or associates.

Bloodstock agent Pete Bradley was another giving the app positive reviews. “There are still a few bugs, but ‘few’ being the key word,” said Bradley. “Compared to pen and paper, it takes just a little longer to enter information, but with a little effort you get used to it quickly. On the positive side, you don’t have to carry two or three catalogs; if someone tells you something about a horse in Book 1, you can access the page right away. The best feature is that, once you customize the system, you can do short lists in about 7 seconds, instead of taking an hour and a half of going through your book, and reconfirming your notes on each one.”

Alanza Added to Sun Chariot...

His Highness The Aga Khan yesterday paid the £16,000 fee to supplement his rapidly improving 3-year-old filly **Alanza (Ire)** (Dubai Destination) to Saturday's G1 Kingdom of Bahrain Sun Chariot S. at Newmarket. Successful twice at listed level in Ireland before shipping over to Britain to add the G3 Sceptre S. to her tally at Doncaster last time Sept. 8, the John Oxx trainee will bid to provide her owner-breeder with a second renewal having captured the 1990 version with Kartajana (Ire) (Shernazar {Ire}). "The weather looks like it will be dry enough for Alanza, but she goes well enough on good-to-firm, which the ground seems likely to be," Oxx commented. "She came out of her Doncaster run very well--she came home in good form--and it was probably a case of going for this race or doing nothing with her for the rest of the year. It is a bit of a chance supplementing her, but she looks so well in herself that we are letting her run at Newmarket. She doesn't have a Group 1 rating at the moment and she has a good bit to go, but we felt that she would make a nice 4-year-old and she has a lot of things going for her--she is very tough, consistent and reliable. Running her at Newmarket will point us in one direction or another with regards to whether she can make the grade next season." Among her 13 opponents for the £174,400 prize is **Sahpresa** (Sahm), who will attempt to become the first triple winner of the race. Successful in the last two editions for Douglas McIntyre, the Rodolphe Collet-trained 6-year-old will be racing in the Teruya Yoshida silks this time. Sahpresa is set to renew her rivalry with her July 8 G1 Falmouth S. conqueror **Timepiece (GB)** (Zamindar), who finished behind her when the pair were second and third respectively in the G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville July 31. The Sir Henry Cecil-trained Timepiece is one of two Juddmonte possibles alongside the impressive Sept. 3 G1 Matron S. heroine **Emulous (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) from the Dermot Weld stable, while Aidan O'Brien has a duo engaged including Derrick Smith's **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). She was filling the runner's-up spot for the fourth time at this level in the Matron last time. Sheikh Ahmed bin Rashid Al Maktoum's unbeaten July 2 Listed Distaff S. winner **Nahrain (GB)** (Selkirk); the July 29 G3 Oak Tree S. scorer **Chachamaidee (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) and last year's runner-up **Strawberrydaiquiri (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) are other notables.

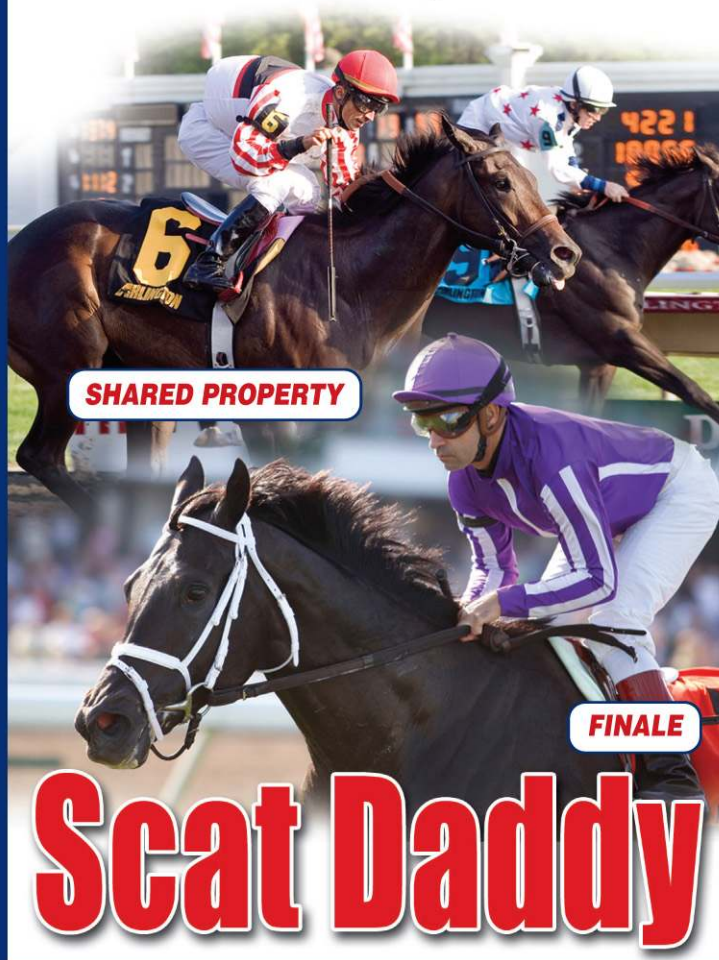

Trainer Ger Lyons yesterday paid £15,000 to add the G3 Round Tower S. winner **Lightening Pearl (Ire)** (Marju {Ire}) to Saturday's G1 Jaguar Cars Cheveley Park S. at Newmarket. Successful by five lengths in that Aug. 28 Curragh contest, Pearl Bloodstock's filly is one of 15 in the list for the £163,500 six-furlong highlight at yesterday's six-day stage. Lightening Pearl had previously finished third behind Maybe (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G2 Debutante S. also at the Curragh Aug. 7. Her conditioner said, "Lightening Pearl is grand at the moment and we are going to have a go at a Group 1 with her. As far as I am concerned, the best juvenile that we have seen this season is Maybe and we were unlucky not to be second behind her in the Debutante Stakes. Our filly stepped up on that with a good performance in the Round Tower S. and I didn't want to take on Maybe again. She gets seven furlongs and a mile, but she has shown enough speed for six furlongs, so the [Cheveley Park] seemed the obvious race for her. I wouldn't want the going too quick, but she goes on most ground--she's only a small, light filly. Good ground would be lovely but she will be fine as long as it is not heavy or firm."

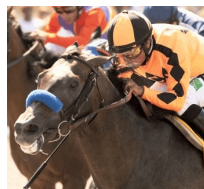

That section of the honor roll hails from the Class of 2008; the latest edition has yielded a remarkable 90 individual winners of 116 races. They include recent G2 Champagne S. hero Trumpet Major (Ire) (Arakan), who sold to Peter and Ross Doyle on Day 1 of last year's installment for €20,000. Three lots are offspring of Classic-placed dams: Fortbarrington Stud's [Hip 46](#), a Pivotal (GB) colt out of the 1997 G1 1000 Guineas third Dazzle (GB) (Gone West); Castlebridge Consignment's [Hip 267](#), a Refuse to Bend (Ire) colt out of the 1997 G1 1000 Guineas runner-up Oh Nellie (Tilt the Stars); and the same operation's [Hip 398](#), a Rock of Gibraltar (Ire) colt out of the 1999 G1 Kentucky Oaks third Sweeping Story (End Sweep).

GINGER MCCAIN DIES

National Hunt legend Ginger McCain, trainer of the triple Grand National hero Red Rum (GB), died yesterday at age 80. Famed for his handling of the winner of that iconic race in 1973, 1974 and 1977, as well as the 2004 scorer Amberleigh House (Ire), the veteran had suffered from a short illness. A statement from wife Beryl McCain read, "Donald--Ginger as we all knew him--passed away peacefully in his sleep after a short illness this morning. He would have been 81 on Wednesday. There will be a private family funeral followed by a later memorial service, for which there will be more information in the coming weeks. Joanne, Donald Jr and I appreciate all the kindness we are being shown and, at this difficult time, would appreciate it if we were afforded some privacy." Having begun training in Merseyside in 1953, McCain took out a full licence in 1969. He handed over the reins to his son, Donald Jr, in 2006.
