Following wins in a Windsor maiden Apr. 18 and Newbury conditions event May 13 with a battling defeat of **Shumoos** (Distorted Humor) in the June 15 G2 Queen Mary S. at Royal Ascot, the diminutive bay defied a penalty in York's G2 Lowther S. over this trip last time Aug. 18. Jockey Richard Hughes is one of her biggest fans. "She is a little angel and is so quiet and nearly lethargic before her races, but when the gates open she takes off," Hughes explained. "She is a real pro. She definitely grew from Ascot to the Queen Mary and, although she is still quite petite, I thought she had done well when I rode her the other morning."

**Fillies' Mile cont.**

By July, Godolphin's 2-year-old filly department looked to be holding above-average weight, with Gamilati (GB) (Bernardini) annexing the G2 Cherry Hinton S. and Discourse (Street Cry {Ire}) wildly impressive in the G3 Sweet Solera S. on the July Course. Add to those names the likes of Desert Gazelle (Smart Strike), Rakasa (GB) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), Falls of Lora (Ire) (Street Cry {Ire}), Kunooz (Ire) (Hard Spun), Minidress (GB) (Street Cry {Ire}), Pimpernel (Ire) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) and Ihsas (Rahy), and it is clear that the boys in blue have considerable depth in 2011. Partnered by Mickael Barzalona on debut over seven furlongs on the other Course at this venue, Lyric of Light started at 6-1 and overcame greenness to become the latest fledgling luminary in her category. Still stargazing in the May Hill, she nevertheless comfortably beat ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ Fallen For You (GB) (Dansili {GB}) despite carrying that rival across the track in that Doncaster event customarily used as a stepping stone to this feature. There were some who suggested a reversal of form could be on the cards here, but Fallen For You was already paying for her early keenness as the royal blue moved upsides her and glided by passing the quarter pole. Samitar, who was benefitting from a dramatic change of tactics from Jamie Spencer, was the sole target remaining with Dettori still sitting pretty entering the final furlong, and she put up a brave fight before succumbing in the final stride. "During the first furlong, she was a bit uncomfortable on the ground, but then I got her into a nice rhythm and the pace was honest," Dettori commented. "I was using Willie [Buick on Fallen For You] as my target, as she was green at Doncaster and I didn't want to get there too early, but at the top of the hill I could see he was beaten, so I crept into the race nicely. When Jamie [Spencer] kicked then, he took a length out of the field and, although I had no doubt I would catch him, when I asked her to quicken, she got unbalanced and took a lot longer to quicken than I expected." He continued, "She started to idle again when she got past him and did really well to produce that turn of foot. I thought Discourse was the best we had, but, when this one came on the scene, it took me by surprise. The whole group of fillies we have are nice, and we are lucky to have two like her and Discourse in the same year. A mile and a quarter is within her reach and beyond that, we don't know, but all the signs are good." Racing Manager Simon Crisford added, "She's got a great future and that will probably be it for this year, although Sheikh Mohammed will decide. There are other races to look at, such as the Breeders' Cup, but whether she wants to be traveling at this time of her career is open to question. I definitely see her as a Guineas filly, as a mile suits her well, but a mile and a half is unknown territory at the moment, as she has a lot of speed in her pedigree."

Ransom Note first gave notice that he was a potential pattern-race performer when winning Royal Ascot's Britannia H. last June, and fared even better when

beating the older brigade in a competitive handicap at York's Ebor meeting. He proved up to that grade when returning with a win under positive tactics in the G3 Earl of Sefton S. over nine furlongs here Apr. 14 before coming up short in both the G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp May 22 and

G1 Queen Anne S. back at the Royal meeting June 14. Second to subsequent G1 Juddmonte International hero Twice Over (GB) (Observatory) in the G2 York S. over 10 furlongs July 23, the bay was then fifth in the G3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville on heavy ground when last seen Aug. 14. Back on a fast surface and under enterprising tactics from Michael Hills, he simply dominated this contest from pillar-to-post with the latecomers Premio Loco and Poet's Voice facing a thankless task in pursuit.

"He's a lovely horse, but in the middle part of the season he went missing and he's come back now," Hills said. "It was very soft ground in Deauville and he didn't like it. He's a good horse on his day and I knew something would have to be quite good to get me, as he was picking up and picking up the whole way." Trainer Charles Hills added, "Michael gave him a lovely ride out in front and he loves it here. He's got such a lovely stride, we thought we'd let him use it. He's had a long year and had been taking on the best, so we thought we'd give him a break and bring him back for this. He's not blessed with bags of speed, but stays well. We'll have a good look and, as he's Breeders' Cup eligible, we'll consider that, and something like the Hong Kong Mile [at Sha Tin Dec. 11] could be a race for him. He is in the G1 Champion S. [at Ascot Oct. 15], but whether he's quite up to that I don't know--we'll see how he comes out of this. It's always been the plan to go to Dubai."

Alsindi showed a sharp turn of acceleration to record an impressive 3 1/4-length success on her debut over six furlongs at Yarmouth Aug. 28, and that was on display again here as she registered a last-gasp success in this competitive renewal. Held up in rear early by Tom Queally, the bay traveled sweetly as joint-favorite Questing cut out the running. Challenging wide, she had her neck stretched fully when swooping on that long-time leader in the shade of the post to land a significant gamble. "I was impressed--she's a nice filly," her rider commented. "Clive [Brittain] was keen on her beforehand and he told me to take my time and ride her for a turn of foot, and she won quite comfortably at the end. She'd only had one run, so can certainly build on this." Her trainer added, "I think she's a filly with a future, and the only worry I had coming here was that she won on soft ground at Yarmouth and it is lively today." Brittain added, "I'll talk plans over with Saeed Manana, but she's in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac [at Longchamp Oct. 2], and that's a possibility. I think she's ready to step up to a Group 1, and at least I know she can go on soft ground if she needs to. She'll be back here next year for the 1000 Guineas and I think she'll get a mile, as 50 yards past the line she hadn't shut down, which is a good sign." Godolphin's Rakasa (GB) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}), under Frankie Dettori, broke awkwardly and pulled up lame after halfway.

her belt and her favored fast ground underfoot, but if there is a danger lurking it could be the sophomore **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}). Having gained a reputation as the perennial bridesmaid with four second-place efforts from six efforts at this level, Derrick Smith's colorbearer has given

the impression she is still a work in progress for Aidan O'Brien. Her 2-year-old career was marred by a tendency to run off a true line, but she also showed determination when a strong-finishing runner-up in the G1 Fillies' Mile at Ascot 12 months ago. Undone by Blue Bunting (Dynaformer) in the latter stages of the G1 1000 Guineas over this track and trip May 1, she found only Misty For Me (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) 3/4 of a length too strong in the Irish equivalent at The Curragh three weeks later. A disappointing fifth in the G1 Coronation S. on unseasonal soft ground at Royal Ascot in June, she was returning from a subsequent break when second to Emulous (GB) (Dansili {GB}) in the G1 Matron S. at Leopardstown last time Sept. 3. "We've been very happy with her since her last run," jockey Colm O'Donoghue told *PA Sport*. "The last day she ran in Ireland, it was her first start for a long time. She's come out of the race very well."

Sir Henry Cecil last won this race with the great Indian Skimmer in 1988, and while his duo **Timepiece (GB)** (Zamindar) and **Chachamaidee (Ire)** (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) stand no comparison with that grey, their form entitles them to be in with a shout. Timepiece finally justified her **TDN Rising Star** status when taking advantage of a slow early pace to get first run on Sahpresa in the July 8 G1 Falmouth S., but has since been put in her place by Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) and that rival when third in Deauville's G1 Prix Rothschild July 31; and by Announce (GB) (Selkirk) back there in the Aug. 21 G1 Prix Jean Romanet. Chachamaidee looks to be more a seven-furlong specialist than miler at this stage, judged on her decisive success in the G3 Oak Tree S. at Goodwood July 29 and latest third under a penalty in the G3 Sceptre S. at Doncaster Sept. 8, but she was second in the G2 Windsor Forest S. over this trip at Royal Ascot June 15.

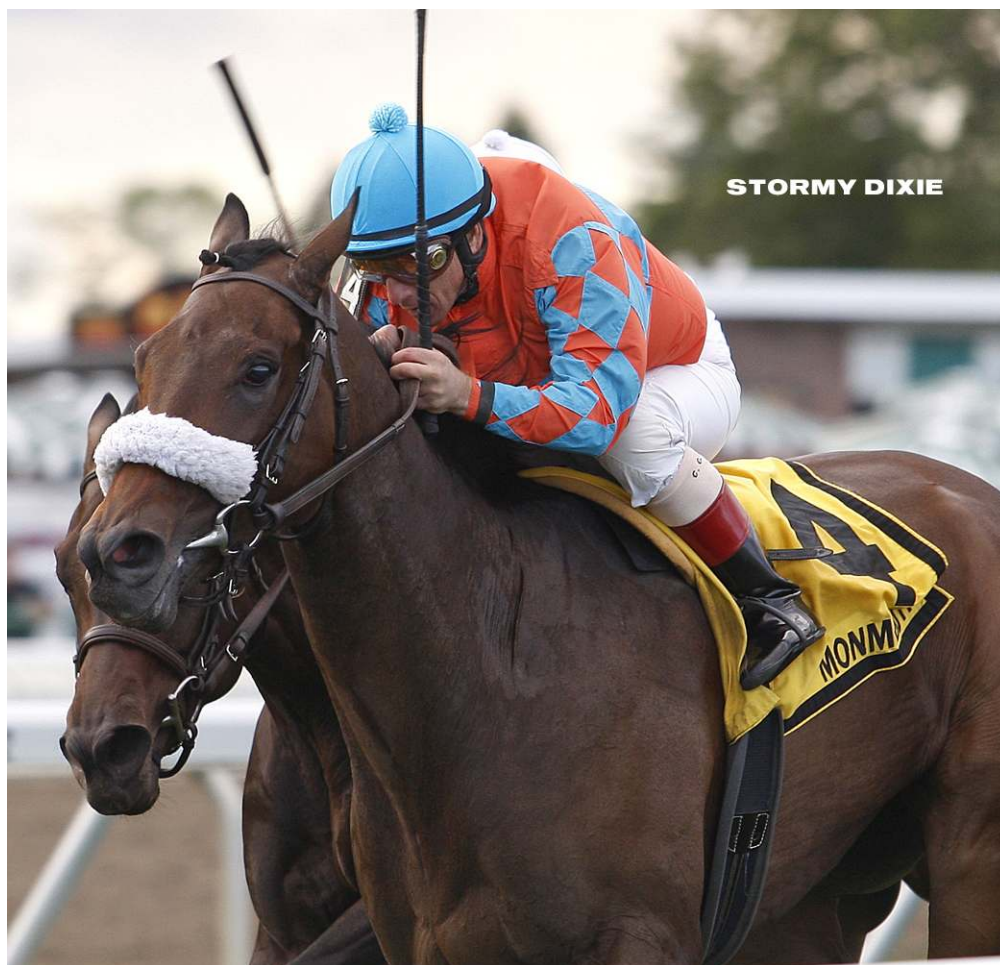

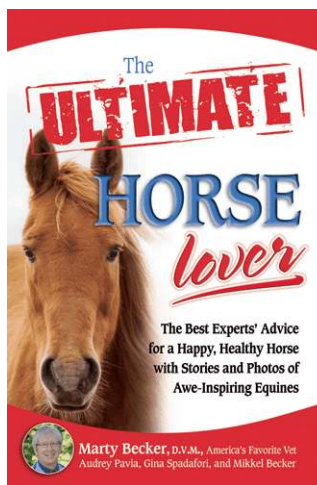

The consistent **Workin for Hops** rates the nod in a competitive renewal of the GII WinStar Kentucky Cup, which returns to Turfway after a year's hiatus. A graded winner on turf last year, the chestnut gelding bounced back from a runner-up effort to Get Stormy (Stormy Atlantic) in the GI Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland in April to annex the GIII Hanshin H. on Arlington's Polytrack May 21. He was subsequently unplaced in a pair of grassy graded events when shipped out of town, but most recently finished a neck behind Mister Marti Gras in the GIII Washington Park H. on the Arlington main track Sept. 3 before being disqualified to third. "He's always right there," said trainer Michael Stidham. "He tries hard and gives you a big effort, and you can't ask for more than that." California-based **Shediak (Fr)**, Group 1-placed in France at two, endured a 19-race drought since arriving on these shores, mostly in turf allowance company. The bay snapped that streak with a brave effort in a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer on Del Mar's Polytrack Aug. 20, and added the one-mile Windy Sands H. on the same surface Sept. 3. "Based on his European form, he had been a bit of a disappointment until his last two races," explained trainer Ben Cecil. "I think the turf and dirt surfaces he's run over here in California have been too firm for his liking. He really seemed to like the softer Polytrack at Del Mar in his last two. We thought he would be [assigned] 114 pounds for his last race [the Windy Sands], but he was highweighted [at 120] and still won. So we're hoping the Turfway Polytrack is a softer Polytrack like Del Mar."

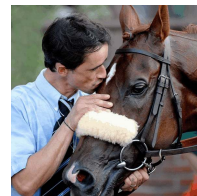

# RACETRACK Round-Up

## Tizway out of Gold Cup...

**Tizway** (Tiznow), a leading Horse of the Year candidate off his victories in the GI Met Mile and GI Whitney H. this year, will be forced to miss his intended start in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 1 due to a missed workout caused by a fever. "He spiked a fever Thursday and was lethargic," his trainer H. James Bond explained. "We treated him, but to work him at 70%, run in a tough race like the [Jockey Club] Gold Cup and then run in the [GI] Breeders' Cup Classic would be unfair to the horse." Bond indicated that the hiccup would not alter plans for championship weekend. "He's been training brilliantly and will be ready to go a mile and a quarter Nov. 5," Bond said, adding that the horse could shift his training to Belmont Park if the weather in Saratoga becomes an issue. Tizway will breeze next Thursday or Friday and remain on a seven- or eight-day workout schedule between now and the Breeders' Cup.

## Banned Fighting for His Life...

Multiple graded stakes winner **Banned** (Kitten's Joy), last seen getting up for a nose decision in the GII Del Mar Derby Sept. 4, fractured both sesamoids in his right ankle during a four-furlong turf workout in :52 at Santa Anita Thursday, owner Craig Bernick of Glen Hill Farm revealed on Twitter. "Banned injured himself pulling up after an easy half mile work," Bernick tweeted Thursday.

"Trying to save him. He seems to be a relatively good patient. Fingers crossed, but vets say 20% chance he makes it. Very touch and go." Surgery is likely for the GII American Turf S. and GIII Jefferson Cup S. hero, Bernick tweeted Friday. "There is a slight pulse in the broken ankle, so it is worth taking a shot at putting it together and trying to save him," he reported. Banned, bred in Kentucky by Ken and Sarah Ramsey, brought \$130,000 as a FTKOCT yearling. The GI Secretariat S. third-place finisher has posted a record of 10-5-1-2 and earnings of \$599,476.

### **Alpha Male...**

**Alpha** (Bernardini), who sported the Darley silks when he broke his maiden by six lengths in his career opener at Saratoga Sept. 3 ([video](#)), will be carrying the Godolphin blue when he goes to the post for the Oct. 8 GI Champagen S., trainer Kiaran McLaughlin reported Friday. The homebred breezed a half in :49.53 Wednesday. "He'll work one more time for the Champagne," said McLaughlin, adding, "He's going to change jerseys. He'll run under my name, but a different jersey." As for plans after the Champagne, the conditioner remarked, "We'll take it one race at a time. If he graduates from McLaughlin High School and goes on to college, we'll be proud and hopeful."

### **Frankel Firing Ahead of QE II Bid...**

Sir Henry Cecil yesterday expressed himself satisfied with the progress of **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) as he bids to round off his season in the G1 the Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot. After overseeing the work of Khalid Abdullah's unbeaten World Rankings heavyweight in Newmarket, his trainer held court to a press assembly and was in confident mood ahead of the Oct. 15 Champions' Day test. "Frankel is coming on very, very nicely," Cecil said. "So far, everything is going very well. I would rather be ahead of time than trying to catch a train, as there is nothing worse than to mistime it and find that you are a gallop short and have to put pressure on them before a race. I would rather be ahead, so I can pull back and keep him fresh and well. Physically, he has done very well--he looks a stronger horse and is growing up mentally a lot. Now he is far more relaxed and far easier to train than in the early days. This morning I put Tom Queally on, because I wanted Tom to have plenty of confidence in the horse and find out that he is actually an easier horse to ride now than he was earlier in the year. At this stage, I am really happy with him--I am looking forward to going for the race, a very good race for him."

### **Dunboyne Express Sold to Hong Kong...**

**Dunboyne Express (Ire)** (Shamardal) has become the latest European export to Hong Kong after Tiranga Bloodstock brokered the deal to purchase the 3-year-old. Successful in last year's G3 Anglesey S. and the G3 Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial this term, the former Kevin Prendergast-trained colt was also fifth in the G1 Irish Derby and is set to be trained by John Moore. His sale follows that of the stakes-winning 2-year-olds Frederick Engels (GB) (Iceman {GB}) and Caledonian Spring (Ire) (Amadeus Wolf {GB}) in recent weeks. "He is a very nice horse who has won group races at two and three and we have finally managed to acquire him, having tracked him for almost a year," Tiranga's Peter Hickey told *Racing Post*. "With the poor prize-money in Britain, it is no surprise to see horses heading to Hong Kong, America and Australia to further their career."

### **Bearpath Euthanized...**

**Bearpath** (g, 5, Dynaformer--Song 'n Silk, by Unbridled's Song), a game winner of the 2010 GIII Pan American S. at Gulfstream ([video](#)) and second-place finisher in that term's GI Sword Dancer Invitational S. at Saratoga, was euthanized Friday. The Lothenbach Stables colorbearer fractured his shoulder when stumbling and unseating jockey Frederic Lenclud in the early stages of Saratoga's John's Call S. Aug. 5. "Over the past couple of weeks, Bearpath had started to go the wrong way, and while we remained hopeful he would turn the corner, he did not," trainer Ian Wilkes commented. "We regretfully had to put him down today." Bearpath, a \$170,000 KEESSEP yearling purchase, posted a record of 25-4-4-3 and earnings of \$380,969. He was bred in Kentucky by Whisper Hill Farm.

### **Golden Slipper Winner Crystal Lily Dies...**

**Crystal Lily (Aus)** (Stratum {Aus}), the 2010 G1 Golden Slipper S. winner, collapsed and died during a barrier trial for an intended start in the G1 Manikato S. next Friday night. "She was probably halfway through the trial and started to drop out suddenly and then collapsed to the ground," assistant trainer Simon Zahra, who was watching from the grandstand, told ABC Radio, surmising the 3-year-old filly suffered a heart attack. Jockey Glen Boss was thrown to the turf and suffered a fractured left humerus. He was scheduled to undergo surgery Friday, but could return to the saddle in as little as two weeks. Winner of four starts at two, highlighted by the Golden Slipper, she most recently returned from a four-month absence to be narrowly defeated into second in the G3 McEwen S. at Moonee Valley Sept. 10.



### **Trappe Shot Preps for Vosburgh...**

**Trappe Shot** (Tapit), who came back after an 8 1/2-month layoff to take back-to-back wins in the May 11 Waldoboro S. and June 11 GII True North H. at Belmont, worked a half in :48.45 on the Belmont main track Friday. He goes next in the Oct. 1 GI Vosburgh S. The 4-year-old had been scheduled to breeze Saturday, but trainer Kiaran McLaughlin explained, "We called an audible with the weather." He added, "He worked well, and we're ready for the Vosburgh." The Florida-bred has won six of his 10 career starts, earning \$626,384.

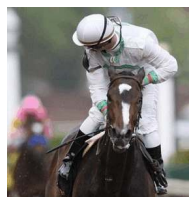

Nothing is of more interest than new information on how to make a living breeding Thoroughbred horses, which has proven a daunting prospect for me during the last 20 years.

Since taking it up as serious endeavor in 1992 after a decade of breeding Quarter horses, I have tried to read every word written by Porter, Oppenheim, Sparkman et al and anyone else who offered an idea on how best to do it. One of the most stunning revelations of my early experience was how many matings are arranged purely from looking at paper and how many people make money without ever laying eyes on the two participants.

Less surprising but equally as amazing was the industry's preoccupation with the male gender over the female, a consistent perspective matched perhaps in literature nowhere else except maybe the Bible, probably for the same reasons. Males have generally sired more offspring and produce more data to consider--and the authors of both histories are, of course, males who generally rate their contributions considerably higher than those who actually bear the fruit, truth not withstanding.

Fortunately--or unfortunately as the case may ultimately prove--my horse breeding education was not confined to literature. One of the blessings in my life has been the opportunity to meet, converse and read the recollections of successful horse breeders, not only of Thoroughbreds but Arabians, Quarters, Paints, Lippizaners, and many who specialize in producing animals for specific performance such as cutting, reining, jumping and dressage. Not one of these breeders ever admitted arranging a cross without looking at the two animals involved. And just as important, nearly all credited their success to a mare they bought or a proven female family on which they decided to build their program. And today I do not know a single person who would base a breeding decision solely on the hocus pocus being sold by the nicks people.

Unfortunately I do know many buyers who do mainly because each day in *TDN* and other publications, there are major stakes winners credited with being A nicks, A + nicks and so on, all ratings based on the cross of one stallion line with another, many of them so far removed from the actual cross or on so little actual data as to be a joke. Right next them, however, seldom noticed, is often a major stakes winner with a D or an F nick or no rating at all.

Among these, if I am not mistaken, was the incumbent Horse of the Year Zenyatta, who had a D+ from one of the Nick hucksters.

Only recently have the nicks people begun to acknowledge the weakness, and at least Goldmine has done something about it by attempting to assess the females in some I fashion other than just a small and meaningless number in the equation. And to his credit, John Sparkman, in his frequent contributions to the *Thoroughbred Times* and a welcome recent history of the great broodmares, makes an attempt to identify and glorify the female contributions that has generally been ignored by the so-called experts, who cannot figure out to make a dollar doing it.

Believe me, there is no resistance here to scientific discovery or change. The ability to measure the efficiency of a horse's heart, respiratory system and gait has all occurred in the last decade or so. In 2001, when Two Bucks-bred Monarchos ran the second fastest Kentucky Derby in history, not everyone was surprised. Jeff Seder's now prominent bloodstock agency EQB had already told me that Monarchos possessed the best combination of heart and gait efficiency their assessment process, then in its infancy, had ever measured. And not everyone was shocked by the instant prowess at stud of Tapit and Bellamy Road. Both horses had begun their conditioning under trainer Michael Dickinson, in those days a devotee of the heart assessments of Dr. David Lamber, one of the gene research pioneers. A lot of Dickinson's clients, me among them, had mares in the early books of both stallions.

But hearts, gaits and ultimately genetic maps are--as Bill Oppenheim suggested in his speech--simply new tools to be added to the box. For all the success EQB has had selecting eventual stakes winners from yearling and 2-year-old sales, none of its assets is more important than the practiced eye and experience of Patti Miller. She looks at every one of those horses that end up in the winner's circle. That several of mine, including a Kentucky Derby winner, have been among them may well be due to nothing more than Patti's ability or my good luck.

Yet I am convinced that the foundation principle of a lot of successful breeders around the horse world has had something to do with it. This principle might possibly be best illustrated by the success of the three of America's most prominent stallions in last 20 years--Storm Cat, Gone West and A.P. Indy. Each represented one of the three stallion lines on which this nicks business is based--Northern Dancer, Mr. Prospector and Seattle Slew. And I would be willing to bet what is left of my breeding business, if it survives this economic debacle, that eventually the genetics experts will find that the magic gene came from Secretariat's dam Somethingroyal.

Without a doubt, genome mapping and rapid following research is clearly in the best interest of horse. Eventually it will tell us the cause of colic, founder and why our horses are more fragile than they have ever been. It will produce therapeutic meds to cure maladies and keep horses healthy. And it will affect breeding decisions beyond any tool or service previously offered for sale. Already we are learning how to mate horses to produce a certain color. And maybe we will even be able to find out what makes them run. About that, however, I am more skeptical. And I hope we never do. I believe there is a magic something in a great racehorse that cannot be determined until it is headed in the stretch.

Meanwhile, as we search for the speed gene, the slow gene, the grass gene, the dirt or synthetic gene, buyer beware ought to be our watchword. Before genes tell us anything of consequence, it will likely become just another tool for the box and unfortunately one that can be used by bloodstock agents and veterinarians to disqualify and discount horses in the sale ring. We need another one of those like we need a hole in the head.

**NORTH AMERICAN LISTED STAKES RACES TO UNDERGO FURTHER REVIEW ANNUALLY**

*(Edited press release)* The North American International Catalogue Standards Committee (NAICSC) announced Friday that all listed stakes races in the United States and Canada will undergo further review of their listed status annually by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association's American Graded Stakes Committee and the Canadian Graded Stakes Committee, respectively, beginning in 2012. Currently, North American stakes races with a minimum purse value of \$75,000 available to all starters that close 72 hours in advance and have no restrictions receive listed status in catalogues for sales organized by Society of International Thoroughbred Auctioneers members. Restrictions that prevent a race from receiving listed status include any conditions that tend to exclude runners of greater quality for considerations other than sex or age. Listed races are reviewed annually for possible upgrade to Grade III status. Under the new procedures, listed stakes will also be reviewed for possible downgrade by removal of their listed status. Races that lose their listed status would still qualify for non-listed black-type in SITA catalogues. Listed races for 2012 in the United States and Canada will be initially reviewed at the 2012 meetings of the AGSC and the CGSC. The committees will apply the same technique and information, including fact-based statistical analysis, that is used during their annual evaluation of graded stakes races. Races not deemed to be of listed quality using this process will lose their listed status beginning in 2013. In addition, during 2012, the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has been charged by the NAICSC with investigating options for further quality control measures for non-listed black-type races.

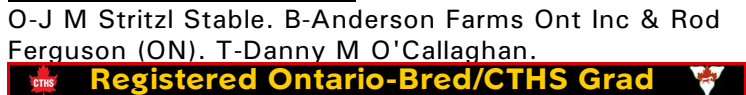

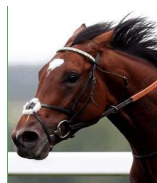
