



### LIVINGSTON, I PRESUME

Fresh from saddling the 1-2-3 finishers in Saturday's G2 Royal Lodge S., trainer Aidan O'Brien was back in Kildare yesterday with a 1-3-4 finish in the G2 Juddmonte Beresford S., with **David Livingston (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) coming out on top thanks to a positive ride from Seamie Heffernan. After being left alone in front early, the bay carved out a clear lead at the top of the straight. Favored **Akeed Mofeed (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) struggled and momentarily became unbalanced in the heavy going as they turned for home. Johnny Murtagh managed to conjure a closing effort from that rival, but, despite plugging on through the testing conditions, he was always facing a thankless task attempting to reel in the ultra-game leader. At the line, the front two had put a sizeable distance between themselves and the winner's stable companions **Athens (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}) and **Furner's Green (Ire)** (Dylan Thomas {Ire}). "I was happy enough to bowl along, and he got the mile well," Heffernan said. "Although it's never ideal to make all the running in any race, he fought hard for me. I thought the extra furlong would play into my strengths. I thought Johnny [Murtagh]'s was the one with the form, and I'm just happy I was in front at the line."

Uncle Mo, coming off a runner-up effort in the G1 Foxwoods King's Bishop S. at Saratoga, went four furlongs in a bullet :46.57 on the training track in preparation for the GII Kelso H. "That was faster than I wanted to go; it's not what we set out to do, but I think it's

an indication of how well he's doing at the moment," reported Pletcher. "We were looking for a final breeze before the race, a standard :48, :49, and I think he's just doing so well now that he went a little quicker than that. It seems like he's moving great and everything he's been doing since the King's Bishop has been exceptional, so we're pleased with that."

### DICK TURPIN SETS SIGHTS ON FRANKEL

Saturday's G1 Premio Vittorio di Capua winner **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) could clash with **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S., connections revealed yesterday. The 4-year-old scored his second Group 1 success in the San Siro mile contest, and trainer Richard Hannon now has an eye on the Oct. 15 Ascot prize. "[Owner] John [Manley] is quite keen to take on Frankel in the QEII at Ascot on Champions' Day, so he could well go there," Hannon said. "There is plenty of good place prize money on offer and, who knows? If we get our ground, we might even beat him." Of the recent Qatar Bloodstock acquisition **Strong Suit** (Rahy), who has not been seen since winning the G2 Lennox S. at Goodwood July 26, he added, "We have Dick Turpin in other top races at the back-end, but Strong Suit will probably be our horse for the G2 Challenge S. [at Newmarket Oct. 8]. The seven furlongs will suit him perfectly." Strong Suit could also have a trip to the States in his future. "We'd be hopeful that he would get the extra distance in the [Nov. 5] GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Downs, which is a sharp track," his conditioner said.

Campanologist chased home So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 22, but his form slipped downhill after that with fifth place finishes in the G2 Harwicke S. at Royal Ascot June 18 and in the G2 Princess of Wales's at Newmarket July 7. Last of 10 in the G3 Glorious S. at Goodwood July 29, the 6-year-old rebounded quickly with a latest second in the Sept. 4 G2 Bosphorus Cup at Veliefendi in Turkey. He was held up with one rival behind in the opening exchanges here. The pacesetter Earl of Tinsdal was asked for his effort straightening for home, but he failed to stretch his rivals, and Campanologist was able to cruise upsides at the quarter pole. Pushed to the front soon after, the Newmarket raider was punched out by jockey Frankie Dettori for his third win at the top level in Germany, following his 2010 successes in the G1 Rheinland-Pokal here and G1 Deutschland Preis at Hamburg.

Trainer Saeed bin Suroor, who was celebrating a third renewal of this prize, commented, "Campanologist won well, and I was delighted with his performance. He had a good position all the way in the race, and Frankie gave him a great ride. There are no firm plans, but we could send him next to Italy for a Group 1 over the same trip [the

David Livingston had looked all stamina when winning his maiden over seven furlongs here June 25, and when fourth in the Aug. 20 G2 Futurity S. and third in the Sept. 10 G1 National S. "He had a good run in the National S. and kept going very well, and you'd imagine he's a horse who will get a mile and a quarter next year," Aidan O'Brien said. "We'll look at the G1 Racing Post Trophy [at Doncaster Oct. 22] and one of the races in France [Oct. 30 G1 Criterium International and Nov. 12 G1 Criterium de

Saint-Cloud], but he's done plenty and it's also possible he won't go." Akeed Mofeed's owner Jaber Abdullah's Racing Manager Bruce Raymond told *PA Sport*, "The ground was a bit too heavy for him and he just couldn't get a blow in at the leader. The leader looked as though he got away from him two [furlongs] out, and he just couldn't make up the ground in those conditions. He was making it up steadily, but he ran a good race. He's potentially a good horse and he won't run again this year. Next year is a long way off, but hopefully he might be aimed at one of the trials. I'd be surprised if it was one of the Guineas trials, it's more likely to be a Derby trial, but it's a long way away."

This race was billed as the spot for Queen's Plate heroine Inglorious to bounce back from her disappointing last-place non-effort in the GI Alabama S. at Saratoga Aug. 20, but it was instead the site of a breakthrough performance by another promising filly. Smart Sting began her career with a score over the turf here last October, and remained undefeated in a Gulfstream allowance the following March. She had failed to add another tally in four subsequent efforts, but only finished off the board once--in the July 16 GIII Virginia Oaks at Colonial Downs two back when fourth, beaten just 1 3/4 lengths. The homebred came with a late rally last time to get second money in the grassy GIII Ontario Colleen S. here Aug. 27, and was trying a surface other than turf for the first time. Finding herself on the lead at the start, Smart Sting guided her four foes through an opening quarter in :24.98, briefly conceding the pole position to Anne's Beauty before regaining control through six furlongs in 1:14.60. The bay took a clear advantage turning for home, and was quickly building up an insurmountable lead. Inglorious tried to mount a bid, but Patrick Husbands on Anne's Beauty refused to move off of Inglorious' right flank, keeping her in with a textbook display of race riding. Smart Sting won off unchallenged, while the order of finish behind her remained unchanged after a stewards' inquiry. "She'd been working great on the Polytrack," winning trainer Roger Attfield remarked. "She's very, very well right now. I told Eurico in the paddock to just let her run her race, and he gave her a great ride. The filly has a big future."

Racing close up in second from the outset, the bay was shaken up at the quarter pole and kept on under pressure to collar Ovambo Queen close home. "Kapitale has improved further, and missed out on going to Baden-Baden due to the going," trainer Andreas Wohler commented. "I don't know at the moment whether she might run again this year, but I expect further improvement of her as a 4-year-old."

Coral Wave garnered minor prizes in a pair of maidens at this track in August, and was a late scratch from the Aug. 28 G1 Moyglare Stud S. here due to unsuitably quick ground conditions. Justifying that decision, the bay was an impressive winner of the course-and-distance Listed Flame of Tara S. last time Sept. 11, and made the grade with this tenacious victory to record a career high--for herself and trainer alike. Settled second in the wake of Homecoming Queen until joining that rival at the two pole, she was coaxed to the fore approaching the final eighth, but required forceful urging thereafter to hold the rallying pacesetter in the drive. "I've come close before, but that's my first group winner, and to do it at The Curragh, my home track, makes it a very special day," explained winning conditioner Patrick Prendergast. "I really, really wanted to run her in the Moyglare, but we had to miss it as I felt the ground was too quick and she was still a little bit weak." Prendergast added, "She handles the [heavy] ground and I knew it'd be a hard slog, but I was a little concerned because she is still a little immature. She was working better then than she is now, so maybe it's time for a break. [Owner] Rick Barnes and myself decided beforehand--win, lose or draw--that she was going home to the stud to rest after today. I'm not going to write off the [G1] Irish 1000 Guineas, but I think she might be a [G1] Irish Oaks filly."
