Mike Repole and trainer Todd Pletcher have **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) taking on his elders in the GII Kelso H. during Belmont's "Super Saturday" card, and will also have a serious contender in the day's marquee event when **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) struts his stuff in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. The bay colt enhanced his Eclipse Award credentials by sweeping Saratoga's GII Jim Dandy S. and GI Travers S., and a victory here could see him follow in the footsteps of

champions Summer Bird (2009) and Curlin (2007), as well as his own sire in 2006. All three of those colts beat older horses in the Jockey Club Gold Cup on their way to Eclipse Award honors. "The one thing he's done is he's made his own resume now," said Pletcher. "The Jim Dandy was certainly a big step in that direction, but when you come back and you put the Travers on top of that, I don't think he has to be compared to anyone now." NEW APPROACH FILLY LIGHTS UP GOFFS

New Approach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) remains one of the Goffs Orby Sale's finest graduates, with Jim Bolger's €430,000 purchase five years ago now the stuff of history. It was therefore fitting that the Darley resident should end up topping the latest renewal with a member of his first crop after his daughter from The Castlebridge Consignment sold for €350,000. Having made a notable first foray into the 2011 European yearling market on Tuesday, Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum's Shadwell Estate Co. was responsible for the purchase of this prized chestnut on a day when the fillies dominated. Hip 234 is a half-sister to last month's G3 Desmond S. winner Future Generation (Ire) (Hurricane Run {Ire}), and hails from the family of MG1SW Halfway to Heaven (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}). That ex-Ballydoyle star and her high-class dam Cassandra Go (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) featured prominently on day one of Goffs, and it was no different as soon as the bidding started on the second session. "She was one of the highlights of the day for us," Shadwell's Stephen Collins explained. "She's an outstanding yearling with a good update and by a very exciting stallion. We were delighted to get her." **Cont. p2-7**

Shadwell Stocking Up...

A few frenetic minutes after securing what would be the session topper, Sheikh Hamdan's Shadwell paid €340,000 for Airlie Stud's hip [237](#), a daughter of Arch. That sire's success with his runners this term, including the GI Arkansas Derby hero Archarcharch, was reflected in Kildare, and Angus Gold swooped again to deny trainer Brian Meehan for the Claiborne Farm resident's only offering during the session. A full-sister to the 2005 GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. winner Prince Arch, she is also a half to the 2009 G1 National S. hero Kingsfort (War Chant), who cost a bargain €36,000 here three years ago. "Her pedigree speaks for itself, with the dam having produced two Group 1 winners already," Collins added. "She's going to make a fantastic broodmare prospect in time, and she's an excellent, well-balanced individual from a good farm."

High Altitude...

After a lull in proceedings during mid-afternoon, a daughter of Galileo (Ire) with all the right connections cranked up the pressure. Staffordstown Stud's hip [404](#) is out of Kirsten Rausing's Altitude (GB) (Green Desert), who managed only to win a lowly maiden on Southwell's fibresand, but who more importantly is a half-sister to that owner-breeder's Group 1-winning Alzao duo of Alborada (GB) and Albanova (GB). Opportunities to acquire female descendants from this famed Alruccaba (Ire) dynasty are few and far between, and Henry Beeby took his usual positive stance as he instigated the bidding. Proclaiming the page to feature "the pedigree of the book" and to have "everything you want," he mustered a €100,000 starting bid. In the end, it was Sir Robert Ogden, who had taken home the day one topper by Montjeu (Ire), who won the bidding with €300,000 offer. As during Tuesday's opening session, Racing Manager Barry Simpson took instructions by phone. "She's a really good filly from an outstanding pedigree," Simpson said. "Hopefully, she can run as well as her pedigree suggests. She was a filly we liked a lot from the moment we saw her, although we were probably at our limit there."

Deja Vu For Montjeu...

Montjeu (Ire), responsible for Tuesday's topper, provided the joint top-priced colt yesterday in Oaklawn Stud's hip [318](#). The March foal is a full-brother to this term's well-regarded maiden winner Rougemont (Ire) from the family of 2004 G1 Irish Derby hero and MG1SW Grey Swallow (Ire) (Daylami {Ire}). Demi O'Byrne saw off David Redvers with a bid of €200,000 and was on top again soon after when going to €170,000 for hip [320](#), a son of Galileo (Ire) consigned by Roundhill Stud. That February foal is out of a winning full-sister to 1997 G2 Flying Childers S. heroine Land of Dreams (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), who is herself the dam of this term's G1 July Cup and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup victor Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB}). The renowned vet went on to complete a quick-fire treble when usurping trainer Ger Lyons at €190,000 for a daughter of Duke of Marmalade (Ire) from Mountain View Stud. Presented as hip [331](#), the April foal is out of a winning daughter of Born Gold (Blushing Groom {Fr}), herself a full-sister to 1992 G1 Prix Marcel Boussac and 1993 G1 Coronation S. heroine Gold Splash and the dam of 14-time Group/Grade 1 champion Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) and recent G1 Prix Vermeille victress Galikova (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}). "She's a fantastic filly," O'Byrne said of the latter. "She is an outstanding individual from the immediate family of Goldikova, and you couldn't ask for any more. She's by a very exciting stallion who was a top-class racehorse and must have every chance of making it when his runners hit the track next year."

Pinhooking Success For Knockenduff..

After the early fireworks, Shadwell's name was absent from the returns until later in the afternoon when Angus Gold fired a €170,000 winning salvo to deny Ed Sackville, alongside trainer Jeremy Nosedo, for a filly from the second crop of Hard Spun. That son of Danzig has done well in Europe this season, with his highlight being his G2 Superlative S.-winning and Breeders' Cup-bound son Red Duke. Knockenduff Stud's hip [344](#) is an Ontario-bred half-sister to last term's Listed Prix Policeman winner Paris Vegas (Maria's Mon). She was the only lot by her sire in the catalogue. She is also from the family of the 2006 G1 Prix de Diane victress Confidential Lady (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) and three-time U.S. champion Affirmed. The transaction marked a significant pinhooking return for the vendors on an outlay of \$70,000 at last year's Keeneland November Sale.

Significant First Approaches..

Those involved with the first-crop sires Tamayuz (GB), Duke of Marmalade (Ire) and New Approach (Ire) enjoyed a jamboree over the two days, with the latter making a particular mark on yesterday's action. He was also responsible for the sale of hip [336](#), a Croom House-consigned filly whose siblings include the 2004 champion Damson (Ire) (Entrepreneur {GB})--now the dam of this year's top-class 2-year-old Requito (Ire) (Dansili {GB})--to Peter and Ross Doyle Bloodstock for €150,000. "She's a good-looking filly by a sire who is getting good-looking stock," Peter Doyle said. "Considering her pedigree, I thought that she was good value. She's been bought for a client, and a trainer for her will be decided later on."

Another first-crop sire with a high-profile purchase against his name yesterday was Henrythenavigator, who had only three catalogued. His daughter of the Group 1 winner Valery Lady (Arg) (Roy) consigned by Airlie Stud as hip [365](#) was bought by William Johnstone for €115,000.

Merry Gets Danehill Dancer Colt for Hay...

Agent Hugo Merry bagged a Rock of Gibraltar filly--hip [52](#)--for just €20,000 on day one when acting on behalf of Dr. Jim and Fitri Hay. He had to go further for the rising force among the European owner ranks yesterday when paying €170,000 for a Grove Stud-consigned Danehill Dancer (Ire) colt. The sire of this term's Group 1 winners Planteur (Ire) and Dancing Rain (Ire) is usually prominent at this auction, and his hip [243](#) is a son of 2001 G3 Prix d'Aumale victress Quad's Melody (Ire) (Spinning World), herself a half-sister to the MGISP Bonapartiste (Fr) (Kendor {Fr}). "He was a good colt," Merry commented. "I thought that there was plenty to like about him, and he's out of a precocious, Group 3-winning mare. I've bought him for Dr. Jim Hay, and a trainer for him will be decided on later on." Merry later fended off Ross Doyle to acquire Lynn Lodge Stud's Teofilo filly for €180,000. Offered as hip [283](#), the chestnut is a half-sister to last year's G2 Railway S. winner Formosina (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}) from the family of the MGSW Tumbleweed Ridge (GB) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) and 2006 G2 Queen Mary S. victress Gilded (Ire) (Redback {GB}). The deal represented a threefold return for Eddie O'Leary's nursery, which paid €60,000 for her at last year's November Foal Sale here. Merry had been alongside trainer Brian Meehan earlier when a €320,000 bid failed to get the aforementioned Arch filly (hip [237](#)). "She's been bought for Andrew Rosen, who has been a longstanding client of Brian Meehan's yard and that is where she will be going into training," Merry said of the Teofilo miss. "Andrew has had some very good fillies over the last few years and, hopefully, she will follow suit."

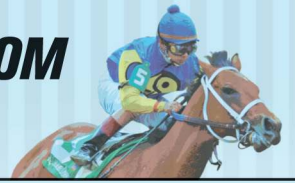
Bobby On the Beat...

Agent Bobby O'Ryan snapped up a pair of fillies who were in demand. After paying €165,000 for Castlemartin Stud's hip [382](#), a daughter of Acclamation (GB) who is the first foal out of listed winner Yarastar (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) from an O'Reilly family on the rise, he went to €150,000 for another sought-after Marju (Ire) representative. From the draft of Joerg and Diana Vasicek's Kenilworth House Stud, hip [420](#) is a full-sister to 2008 G3 Park Express S. winner Marjalina (Ire) and half to the recent listed winner What a Charm (Ire) (Key of Luck).

One of the sale's finest pinhooking successes was witnessed after Peter Doyle went to €145,000 for Yeomanstown Stud's hip [436](#), a son of Gay O'Callaghan's leading first-season sire Dark Angel (Ire). Bought for just €18,000 at the November Foal Sale here, he is out of a half-sister to GSWs Budai (Ger) (Dai Jin {GB}) and Bernardon (Ger) (Suave Dancer).

That sale came moments after David Redvers secured another of the Danehill Dancers, this time from the Camas Park Stud consignment. Hip [431](#) is a 3/4-sister to 2006 G2 Champagne S. winner and 2007 G1 2000

NEW WAGE RULE DELAYED 60 DAYS

The [Department of Labor](#) (DOL) has postponed for 60 days the effective date of the new wage rule for the H-2B Visa program from September 30, 2011 to November 30, 2011. This delay allows the DOL to ensure that it is properly administering the H-2B program under potentially conflicting court orders.

Many lawsuits have been filed that are related to the new wage rule. Horsemen's groups joined employers and trade associations from other affected industries in a lawsuit against the DOL and were successful in gaining a Temporary Restraining Order on implementation of the changes.

The new DOL rule would change the methodology used to calculate hourly wage rates for current and future H-2B workers and is expected to raise rates by as much as 100 percent in some cases. Today, employers are required to pay such workers the highest rate of the prevailing wage, the federal minimum wage, the state minimum wage or the local minimum wage. The new rule adjusts how the prevailing wage is determined.

Guineas runner-up and sire Vital Equine (Ire) (Danetime {Ire}) and she was sold for €140,000. That price was matched on three other occasions, with the first being Camas Park's hip [278](#), a Proud Citizen filly from the same Dream Ahead family as the aforementioned hip [320](#). SF Bloodstock was the name on the docket.

"She's from a high-class and very current pedigree, and Dream Ahead has already proved himself a champion at both two and three," said SF's Tom Ryan. "I had three or four fillies picked out here, and she was the one I liked best of all. She's a filly who could work both in Europe and America, and we'll just have to see where she starts off. We were delighted to get her."

The second to fetch that price was another from the Yeomanstown draft in hip [412](#), a Verglas (Ire) full-brother to Sheikh Hamdan's 2008 G2 Railway S. runner-up Alhaban (Ire) from the family of the operation's stalwart Group 1 performer Maraahel (Ire) (Alzao) who predictably was a further purchase for Shadwell.

Johnny McKeever was responsible for the final member of the €140,000 club when snapping up another of Camas Park's offerings. Hip [445](#) is a Holy Roman Emperor (Ire) half-brother to the MSW & GSP (Indian Ridge {GB}), who is also the dam of black-type getters Swiss Diva (GB) (Pivotal {GB}), Swiss Franc (GB) (Mr. Greeley) and Swiss Dream (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}).



Fireworks At the Finale...

As the session drew to a close, a trio of yearlings made sure that proceedings did not end with a whimper. Kicking off the late flourish, BBA Ireland went to €200,000 for hip [454](#), a son of the popular Duke of Marmalade who capped a successful session for Camas Park Stud and who shared the top-priced colt honors with the aforementioned Montjeu. Out of the Listed-placed Bowstring (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), the February foal descends from the Classic-winning matriarch Sarah Siddons (Fr). Hot on the heels of that was the sale of hip [456](#) to the Hong Kong Jockey Club for €180,000. Consigned by Denis Brosnan's Croom House Stud, he is a son of Cape Cross (Ire) from the excellent family of Henrythenavigator and Listen (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) et al. Completing the trinity of last-gasp highlights was hip [458](#), a daughter of Dalakhani (Ire) from the Nagles' Barronstown Stud. Out of GSP Briquette (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), she is therefore a granddaughter of the prolific top-class producer Cocotte (GB) of Pilsudski (Ire) fame. Hugo Merry, who stepped in for the blueblood, prevailed with a bid of €160,000.

Just Missed...

This year's renewal has so far failed to match last year's vital figures, with no eye-popping top lot to live up to the €950,000 benchmark of 12 months ago. While the clearance rate has inched up to just over 80%, the average of €61,544 is down by 6% and median of €42,000 has fallen by nearly 7%. NATHANIEL OUT, MARVEL IN?

The final line-up for Sunday's G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe was still in flux yesterday, with the countdown to today's supplementary stage prompting some potentially important changes of direction. Chief of those was the suggestion from the John Gosden stable that the recent G1 St Leger winner **Masked Marvel (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) could be added to the Longchamp feature after **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}) was finally ruled out due to the dry forecast. Bjorn Nielsen's Sept. 10 Doncaster Classic hero would swell the final field beyond its current total of 14 runners if connections take the plunge and pay the €100,000 fee.

"We have had someone walk the ground for us at Longchamp and, as it is, Nathaniel is not going to run and he will be rerouted to the G1 Champion S. [at Ascot Oct. 15]," Gosden, who also scratched **Arctic Cosmos** (North Light {Ire}) yesterday, told the *Racing Post*. "In the past couple of days, given the likely surface, we have been considering supplementing Masked Marvel instead, but we will make a final decision on Thursday morning."

Two who are almost certain to be supplemented today are the Rothschild Family's July 14 G1 Grand Prix de Paris hero and Sept. 11 G2 Prix Niel runner-up **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}) and Gestut Burg Eberstein's impressive July 24 G1 Deutschland-Preis and Sept. 4 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden heroine **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}). All the main contenders stood their ground yesterday, with Aidan O'Brien cutting his team to four and leaving in the June 26 G1 Irish Derby one-two **Treasure Beach (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) and **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}) as intriguing potential back-up to **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) and **St Nicholas Abbey (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}). As expected, Godolphin also withdrew **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal), leaving the outfit with no Arc representative for only the sixth time since Lammtarra's watershed triumph in 1995.

The hard-knocking In Summation (Put It Back) took Thomas Moore and Judy Livingston's Waterford Stable to new heights when he won the GI Bing Crosby H. in dramatic fashion in 2007 and carried the couple's colors to a respectable fourth-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint in 2008.

With his smart debut victory at Belmont Park yesterday, Summer Front (War Front) has a ways to go to displace In Summation as the stable's best and most productive runner, but the sky is the limit, according to bloodstock agent Steve Young, who signed the ticket on the colt at this year's Keeneland April Sale of Two-Year-Olds in Training. At \$475,000, he was his successful young sire's second most expensive juvenile of 2011, and was third-highest-priced youngster at the sale, just behind another son of War Front bred on the exact same cross at Summer Front that was purchased for \$485,000 by Stonestreet Stables.

Bred in Kentucky by Graceville Breeding, Summer Front came to Keeneland with large shoes to fill from a pedigree standpoint. His older half-sister Laragh, from the first crop of Tapit, was one of the outstanding juvenile fillies of her generation, winning the GI Hollywood Starlet S. in addition to her third-place finish in the inaugural Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. Young credits Summer Front's sire for improving an already-strong family.

"This was probably one of the best mares he'd been bred to at that time, and if he can move something up like Rose of Summer, then he must something really special."

Consigned to the April sale by Niall Brennan, the horse that would come to be known as Summer Front breezed a quarter-mile in a snappy :21 1/5 ([video](#)). That he had to go so deep for the colt came as little surprise to Young.

"He's a horse that shipped into Keeneland with a huge reputation," Young said yesterday by phone. "He trained well in Florida and then he went to Keeneland and trained great over the Polytrack, We just thought he was a graded-stake horse, and that's what we wanted. He was just a really athletic and well-balanced horse that has *tremendous* mechanics and moves like a horse of quality."

Young expected that Summer Front would deliver a performance worthy of 2-1 favoritism at first asking.

"Anyone that's ever been around the horse has thought he was special, but it's always nice to go out there and prove it," Young said.

And, despite a debut at six furlongs on turf, the colt could prove versatile, Young offered. In addition to his under-tack work ahead of the sale at Keeneland, Summer Front worked a half-mile from the gate in :48 4/5 over the Belmont training track in late August.

"I think he can run on anything," Young said. "I was at Belmont when he was [training] at Saratoga and at Saratoga when he was at Belmont, so this is the first time I've seen him since the sale," Young stated. "Christophe felt he wanted to start him off on the grass, so that's what was decided."

And although Summer Frost showed he was equal to the task in his debut, Young thinks that patience will rule the day.

"It's up to Mr. Moore and Christophe, but I don't think anyone is going to get in a hurry with him. He's a really good horse." --AC

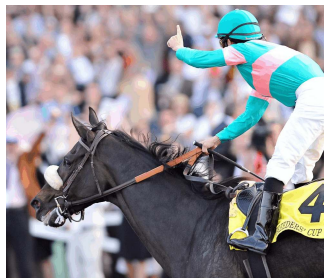
