FAST GROUND MAY FORCE WORKFORCE OUT

Sir Michael Stoute suggested yesterday that fast ground at Longchamp could mean that Khalid Abdullah's **Workforce** (GB) (King's Best) would be denied the opportunity of becoming the first back-to-back winner of the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe since Alleged in 1978. With well-above average temperatures across Europe and no rainfall expected ahead of Sunday's feature, the team behind the 4-year-old are looking closely at underfoot conditions, which have already led to the absence of his King George conqueror Nathaniel (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) and also threaten the participation of another leading candidate in **Reliable Man** (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}).

"I am concerned about the ground and would have reservations about running, but I'd have to speak to Teddy Grimthorpe and the Prince," Stoute said of the 2010 Epsom Derby hero, who was scratched from the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf last term due to ground fears. "I've been really happy with his preparation, but disappointed to hear about the weather forecast because he's a big, heavy horse and we do like good ground for

him. We're a long way from it at the moment and someone's going to have a look at the track today and give us an update." Workforce, who was reportedly struck into by the ill-fated Rewilding (GB) (Tiger Hill {Ire}) during his last start when second in the July 23 Ascot feature, has otherwise pleased connections as he builds toward his second Arc. "It's difficult to win one, let alone two," Stoute added. "He's had a nice break after the King George, having been stiff behind for a week or 10 days afterward and his racecourse gallop at Sandown was a satisfactory workout which brought him on a little bit more. I've been very happy with his performances this year and, while we campaigned him over a mile and a quarter earlier on, we know this is his best distance. We're very happy with his condition and it looks a particularly strong renewal this year, so it's disappointing we're having this Indian summer in Paris."

FIRE ON ICE DONE FOR YEAR

★ **"TDN Rising Star"** ★ Fire On Ice (Unbridled's Song--Lost in the Storm, by Storm Cat), one of the likely favorites for Belmont's G1 Champagne S. Oct. 8, has suffered a non-displaced condylar fracture in his left hind leg and will miss the remainder of his 2-year-old season, trainer/co-owner John Kimmel revealed Thursday. The gray, out of an unraced half-sister to champion sprinter Squirtle Squirt (Marquetry), fired a best-of-12 five-furlong bullet in :59.94 at Belmont Park Wednesday. "He worked beautifully yesterday," Kimmel commented. "He wouldn't have blown a match

out when he came back. We took the bandages off this morning and [discovered the fracture]." Frank Stronach purchased a controlling interest in the \$160,000 FTKJUL graduate following an eye-catching 10 3/4-length debut win for owner Eli Gindi and Kimmel at Saratoga Aug. 27 ([video](#)). Dr. John Madison will perform surgery on Fire On Ice at the Ocala Equine Hospital Monday. "It's straightforward medicine and surgery, and we'll bring him back as a 3-year-old," Kimmel added.

Also on the Arc's doubtful list with the ground riding unusually quick is the June 5 G1 Prix du Jockey Club and Sept. 11 G2 Prix Niel hero Reliable Man. Trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said, "Fast ground is a problem, as it was too firm [when third] in the G1 Grand Prix de Paris [at Longchamp July 14] and he doesn't like it. Good-to-firm is not best for him and I am afraid of that. If we have no rain, it could be that he won't run as he is entered in the G1 Champion S. [at Ascot Oct. 15]. He looks very well and only the ground worries me." As expected, there were three supplementary entries at yesterday's stage at €100,000 apiece and they were Bjorn Nielsen's Sept. 10 G1 St Leger hero **Masked Marvel (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}), the Rothschild family's Grand Prix de Paris winner **Meandre (Fr)** (Slickly {Fr}) and Gestut Burg Eberstein's July 24 G1 Deutschland-Preis and Sept. 4 G1 Grosser Preis von Baden heroine **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}). There was only one withdrawal and that was Michael Tabor's **Seville (Ger)** (Galileo {Ire}), leaving a maximum of 16 set to go to post.



MEDIAN UP AT ORBY'S END

Goffs' Orby Sale wrapped up yesterday, with an increase in the median of 3% offsetting the fall by the same percentage of the average. Commenting on a renewal that was more or less about maintaining the status quo, Goffs Chief Executive Henry Beeby said, "Steady without being spectacular is probably the most apt phrase to describe the last three days' trade, although so many buyers have also commented that the good ones are as hard as ever to buy. Some significant buyers felt they were the most level collection of quality yearlings we have presented at Goffs for many years and they are testament to the faith placed in the Goffs service by our vendors."

Beeby continued, "We have welcomed increased numbers to Kildare Paddocks, with buyers from 20 countries following the focused work of the Goffs team alongside our partners at Irish Thoroughbred Marketing. Our global work to promote the catalogue is clear evidence that Goffs is, indeed, the gateway to the world for Irish horses and it is heartening that more and more breeders heed our call for the best each year. That so many British trainers converged on Goffs also demonstrates the quality of the catalogue and the enduring appeal of the Irish horse together with recognition of the value and customer service for which we are renowned."

A filly by New Approach (Ire) topped this year's sale when selling for €350,000 to Shadwell Estate during Wednesday's second session of the auction. Beeby acknowledged that top figure was a far cry from last year's €950,000 topper.

"To some, a top price of €350,000 may seem a disappointment after a high of €950,000 last year, and it is clear that the average has slipped marginally for that reason. But it is noteworthy that the three-day median price has risen by 3.4%, illustrating the solidity of the market, whilst a clearance rate of 79% (up two points) is a real triumph in the current climate. The middle market between €50,000 and €200,000 was generally accepted to be the most competitive and that is borne out by the increased number surpassing the €150,000 barrier (25 as opposed to 20 last year)."

Considering the current economic climate, Beeby professed himself satisfied with the sale's results. "To trade over €22.5 million of horses against the backdrop of the headlines we have all endured in the eurozone countries in recent months is a definite positive and we continue to defy the gloom and doom that seems to dominate so much of our lives at the moment," he commented. "It is probably also noteworthy that we catalogued more fillies than last year and a greater number of yearlings following a huge demand for places. Those factors may have had some consequences for some of the statistics, but Goffs exists to serve the Irish breeder where possible and tinkering with the format of the sale unnecessarily is not going to help those that support us each year."

Acclamation Filly Tops Orby Part 2...

Yesterday's more low-key session, which has been known in previous year's as the "Open" and "Sportsman's" Sale, was topped by hip 625, a daughter of Acclamation (GB). She sold to Paddy Twomey for €53,000. Her half-brother Ceremonial Jade (UAE) (Jade Robbery) is a listed-winning mainstay of the Marco Botti stable and was used as a pacemaker this term for Excelebration (Ire) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}). The dam is a full-sister to the 2002 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up and 2004 GII San Geronio S. third Firth of Lorne (Ire) (Danehill), who is now the dam of this year's listed performer Etive (Elusive Quality). Twomey said, "She's a good-looking filly from a very nice family and the sire has had a terrific year. Let's hope she's lucky when we go breezing with her next spring." *Cont. p4*

Jeremy's Taken...

The Irish National Stud incumbent Jeremy has enjoyed a solid start, thanks to Yellow Rosebud (Ire) running second in last month's G2 Debutante S. and fellow maiden-winning filly Princess Sinead (Ire) hitting the board in Sunday's G3 C L Weld Park S. Those timely achievements spilled over to Kildare yesterday and his hip [522](#) from Glenspring Farm is bound for a date with next spring's breeze-up calendar after selling to pinhooker Willie Browne. Following a technical delay at the rostrum, the April foal--whose dam is a half-sister to the dual listed winner Khaytada (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire})--was eventually sold for €50,000. "It's a family I've been lucky with before, so I guess I had to buy him," Browne stated. "His 2-year-old half-brother is with Henry Cecil and I'm hoping he can do me a favour, while Jeremy has done well with his runners to date." That Cecil trainee, who also sold here last year for €58,000, has been named Carthaginian (Ire) (Azamour {Ire}), but has yet to race.

Also sold for €50,000 was Ballylinch Stud's hip [562](#), a daughter of Haras d'Etreham's sire Elusive City knocked down to agent Robin O'Ryan on behalf of owner Norman Steel. Out of the dual-Listed winner My Funny Valentine (Ire) (Mukaddamah), she is a sibling of five previous winners. The bay is set to make the short hop across the Irish Sea and on to Richard Fahey's Yorkshire base.

"For us, she was the standout yearling of the day and we're looking forward to her going into training with Richard Fahey," Steel, owner of this term's G1 Coronation S. third Barefoot Lady (Ire) (Footstepsinthesand {GB}), said of the filly, who RNA'd at €6,000 at last November's Foal Sale here.

More Marju...

Marju (Ire) has had an Orby that reflects his lasting influence as well as the recent fortunes of his runners, and the now-pensioned Derrinstown resident was responsible for another highlight during yesterday's trading. Lumville Farm's hip [585](#), a grandson of the 1987 G2 Ribblesdale S. runner-up Queen Midas (GB) (Glint of Gold {GB}), was knocked down to Jim McCartan for €43,000. "He's from one of the last crops of Marju and he's just a good colt who I hope will make a nice breezer," McCartan commented.

Another who has enjoyed a profitable sale is Duke of Marmalade (Ire)--Coolmore's first-crop sire who hit the heights in the elite section of the catalogue was also responsible for one of yesterday's best. Consigned as hip [473](#), Triermore Stud's April-foaled filly is out of a dual listed-placed daughter of the MG1SP State Crystal (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}) from the family of the 2000 G1 Fillies' Mile victress and 2001 Irish 1000 Guineas runner-up Crystal Music (Nureyev). She sold privately to Frank Barry for €40,000. He said, "She's a good-looking filly with a good step to her and she's by an exciting stallion for next year. I've bought her for a client."

Also making his mark among the first-crop sires was the 2007 G1 July Cup hero Sakhee's Secret (GB). His hip [531](#) also sold for €40,000. Knocked down to Mags O'Toole for €10,000 at last November's Foal Sale here, Lynn Lodge Stud's filly yielded a major profit on that valuation when selling to Curragh-based trainer Paul Deegan. "She's a lovely, strong, racy filly from a good family and I hope she's going to be a lovely 2-year-old type. I've bought her for a client," said Deegan. Another success story for Eddie O'Leary's nursery, the bay--from the family of MGISW Brocco (Kris S.)--is out of an unraced daughter of the 1993 GI Starlet S. third Viz (Kris S.). Her dam is therefore a full-sister to the 2003 Listed Radley S. victress Secret Charm (Ire) (Green Desert) and a half-sister to the 2001 G1 Epsom Oaks third Relish the Thought (Ire) (Sadler's Wells).

Portanova Bloodstock later paid €36,000 for Rathbarry Stud's hip [597](#), a son of Aussie Rules whose dam is a sister to the group-placed Zayn Zen (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}) from the dynasty of Oh So Sharp (Ire) and Roussalka (GB). Full results can be found on www.goffs.com.

the dam of the couple's 2008 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile winner Albertus Maximus, who later annexed the GI Donn H. for Shadwell Stable. Here Comes Ben, trained by Charles Lopresti, retires at the age of five with a record of 17-7-1-3 and earnings of \$410,764.

3,919 FOR KEENELAND NOVEMBER A total of 3,919 horses have been catalogued for the Keeneland November sale, which will run from Nov. 7 through 17. The catalogue will be available at keeneland.com starting Oct. 4 and print catalogues will be mailed out the week of Oct. 17. The 11-day auction features the continuing dispersals of the estates of Edward Evans's Spring Hill Farm and Prince Saud bin Khaled's Palides Investments N.V. Inc. "We have a quality November catalog with strong global appeal," said Keeneland Vice President of Sales Walt Robertson. "As always, we will offer a number of top-class race mares and a number of prized broodmares, as well as weanlings by some of the most sought-after sires in the world." The catalogue includes 1,991 broodmares or broodmare prospects, 1,518 weanlings, 398 horses of racing of age, five stallions and seven stallion shares. "The catalog has been reduced in number this year, which is a positive development," Robertson said. "Breeders have done an excellent job of decreasing the number of non-commercial mares being bred, which concentrates the overall quality of the sale and strengthens the Thoroughbred industry as a whole."

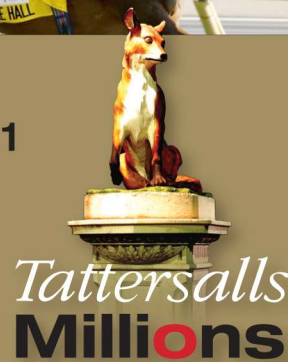

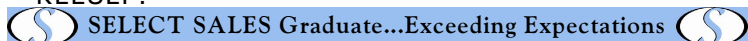
