WHAT DREAMS ARE MADE OF

It was a case of Deutsch and distaff delight at Longchamp yesterday after Gestut Berg Eberstein and Teruya Yoshida's **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {GB}) streaked to a five-length win in the G1 Qatar Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in record time. Sent off at 27-1, the 3-year-old led home a 1-2-3 for the fillies to register a second success for Germany--the first since 1975.

Having won the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden on testing ground last time Sept. 4, the bay--who was supplemented this week--showed her versatility on this fast surface. She was not for catching after streaking by fellow sophomore **Shareta (Ire)** (Sinndar {Ire}) approaching the furlong marker, and

stretched away to provide trainer Peter Schiergen and jockey Andrasch Starke with the fairytale outcome. It was left to **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) to complete the the female trifecta. "The Arc is a race I have dreamt of for a long time, first as a jockey and then during my career as a trainer," Schiergen said. "It is an unbelievable moment, and I have thought for a long time that she is the best I have trained. To win by five lengths here at this track with that great ambience is the greatest moment in my life." Earlier on the Longchamp card, **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) was denied victory in the G1 Prix de la Foret when **Dream Ahead (Diktat {GB})** came late to beat her by a head.

CAN'T MISS

Sharon Alesia, Bran Jam Stables, Ciaglia Racing LLC and Rob Dyrdek's **Weemissfrankie** (Sunriver) upped her career unbeaten record to three yesterday with a furious late rally to run down **Candrea** (Trippi) by a half-length in Santa Anita's GI Oak Leaf S. A much-talked about debut winner at Del Mar on opening day July 20, the \$175,000 OBSMAR 2-year-old ran to her favoritism to take the GI Del Mar Debutante Sept. 3. Backed down to 9-5 while getting her first taste of conventional dirt and a route of ground here, the chestnut bided her time in fifth as Candrea pressed Debutante runner-up **Self Preservation** (Lion Heart) through a half in :46.69 and six furlongs in 1:10.94. Candrea pulled clear a quarter mile out and repelled a bid from **Charm the Maker** (Empire Maker), but a looming presence was gobbling up ground down the center of the track. Weemissfrankie's rally was relentless, and she got up in the shadow of the wire. Charm the Maker ran on for third, another half-length back of Candrea. "When I got to the top of the stretch I put her clear, and like always, she showed me a big kick in the stretch," said rider Rafael Bejarano. He added, "My horse is going to improve a lot, and she is only getting better. She will be tough in the [Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies]." **Cont. p10**

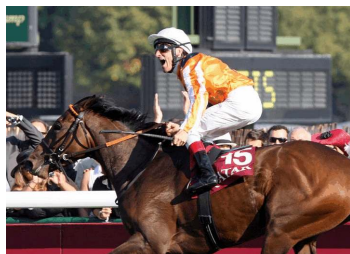

Danedream has been brought along the hard way by Peter Schiergen, but instead of backing off a busy campaign, improved with experience. As early as last August, she showed her class in this country when finishing first--before being DQ'd and placed third--in the Listed Criterium de FEE at Deauville. Sixth in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac on this card 12 months ago, she returned to her native land to run third in the prestigious G3 Preis der Winterkonigin over a mile at Baden-Baden later in October, before returning with a fourth in the Listed Premio Seregno over a mile at the San Siro Apr. 10. The bay was third in the G2 Derby Italiano May 7, and gave every indication of her prowess with a 6 1/2-length success in the G2 Oaks d'Italia May 29. Fifth when giving winner Testosterone (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) too much rope under a five-pound penalty in the G2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud June 26, she progressed again to beat the 2010 German champion Scalo (Ger) (Lando {Ger}) by five lengths in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Hoppegarten July 24. That form had been underestimated by many, as was the case after her six-length defeat of reigning heroine Night Magic (Ger) (Sholokhov {Ire}) in the Grosser Preis von Baden. But she had decent rivals strung out like jumpers that day, and the shrewd Teruya Yoshida was the prime beneficiary, purchasing a half share in the filly from Heiko Volz's Gestut Burg Eberstein this week. Danedream, advantageously drawn in stall two for the Arc, was settled in seventh against the rail as Treasure Beach (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) set off in isolation. Shareta, tracked by St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}), took control in the home straight and, with the favorites failing to pick up with any relish from the back of the pack, Danedream had dead aim on the leaders. Once she was given the command, the diminutive raider settled the result before she reached the furlong pole, and the bargain €9,000 BBAG Breeze-Up purchase cracked the track record set by Peintre Celebre in 1997. "It was a dream for me just to ride in the race," jockey Andrasch Starke said. "It was a great performance. In the last two furlongs, she gave me a great feel, and when she kicked I knew she would win and was just dreaming."

Peter Schiergen added, "I have trained some nice horses, but she is by far the best, and I had great confidence in her. There was no hesitation to supplement her, as she was coming into the race beautifully. I also had confidence in Andrasch, and he rode a great race, so we'll now savor the moment." Patrick Barbe, representing Teruya Yoshida, said, "Mr. Yoshida has watched the race from Japan and is absolutely delighted. We don't know yet what we will do with her now, but she stays in training and has already run quite a lot this year already. If she is well, she could run in the G1 Japan Cup [at Tokyo Nov. 27]." Co-owner Volz owns a furniture store in Germany. Introduced to racing by his father, who also owned horses, he started going to the races at age three.

Shareta a Surprise Package...

Shareta was supposed to be the second string behind the Alain de Royer-Dupre stable's leading contender and 7-2 favorite **Sarafina (Fr)** (Refuse To Bend {Ire}), but connections had stated that she was in the race on her own merits, and she proved that to be the case. Third in the G1 Prix Vermeille last time Sept. 11, the Aug. 12 G3 Prix Minerve scorer stepped out of the shadow of her stable companion and stayed on well after being up with the pace the whole way. Of third-placed Snow Fairy, Ed Dunlop said, "We're very proud of her. That was only her fourth run of the year, so, all being well, as long as she's okay, she'll go back to Japan for the race she won last year [the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 13], or maybe the Japan Cup instead, and then back to Hong Kong. She stays in training next year." **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) fared best of the males in fourth, and his trainer Aidan O'Brien told *PA Sport*, "He was coming home very well, and it was the first time he'd run over that trip for us. He's a big cruiser, and I think he would handle the dirt no problem, but the boys will have to discuss it before we decide what to do next." His jockey Seamie Heffernan added, "He had a very wide draw, so you had to make an early decision, and I wanted to make sure there was something left at the finish. I thought it was a good run." Last year's winner **Workforce (GB)** (King's Best) met with early interference and never got seriously involved before finishing 12th. Owner-breeder Khalid Abdullah's Racing Manager Teddy Grimthorpe said, "In the position he ended up in, he wasn't able to really threaten."

DREAM DENIED

Those assembled to witness a winning send-off for the soon-to-be-retired **Goldikova (Ire)** (Anabaa) yesterday were robbed of that opportunity as **Dream Ahead** (Diktat {GB}) swooped late to beat her by a head in the G1 Prix de la Foret. Sent off at nearly 5-1, Khalifa Dasmal's G1 July Cup and G1 Haydock Sprint Cup hero was delivered in the shade of the post to catch the 1-2 pick and complete a Group 1 double for jockey William Buick. Afterwards, it was revealed that Dasmal has sold a majority interest in the winner to Ballylinch Stud. The owner of that establishment, John O'Connor, said, "He will be retired at the end of the year and will stand at Ballylinch. He has always been a top-class horse, and has now reached another level by beating Goldikova. He is a relatively fresh horse, and it is possible he could run again this year. He has options in Hong Kong and the Breeders' Cup, but we will assess the situation in the next few days." **Cont. p4**

Dream Ahead's claims were obvious to all as he lined up here, but with Goldikova showing herself to be as good as ever so far in 2011, and breaking from the

advantageous stall two, his task looked uphill. As the Wertheimers' mare broke to follow her rabbit Flash Dance (Ire) (Zamindar) against the fence, he was forced to race wide without cover a length behind, and when she got the perfect split

with a quarter mile remaining, he had to swing wide to challenge. But, unlike 12 months ago, when she dealt with Paco Boy (Ire) (Desert Style {Ire}) with such ease, the 6-year-old failed to assert her superiority and was joined by Dream Ahead with a furlong remaining. Despite his customary wandering under William Buick, he was able to straighten enough to oust Goldikova in the final bobber and prevent her from completing a successful French finale. For Dream Ahead, this represented a fifth Group 1 win, having captured the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Middle Park S. to earn joint-champion juvenile status before going on to add the July Cup and Haydock Sprint Cup to his resume.

His tendency to veer off a true line in front had been in evidence in all bar the July Cup, when he enjoyed cover for most of the way before being delivered in the run to the line. At Haydock last time, he had rolled both right and left in front before inching out Bated Breath (GB) (Dansili {GB}) and Hoof It (GB) (Monsieur Bond {Ire}) in a dramatic conclusion, suggesting that there was plenty left in reserve, and his success here might have been a shade cosier than it looked as they flashed past the post. His rider was of that opinion afterwards. "I always said he'd be better in a good race, because when he gets to the front he does nothing," Buick explained. "Today, he went a head up and started hanging left. But everything panned out today. I just wish Goldikova wasn't second because she's the people's favorite, and I'm a big fan myself, but Dream Ahead was a worthy winner, and the best horse won the race." Dubai businessman Khalifa Dasmal added, "To beat a horse like Goldikova is unbelievable, and he's proved he is a good horse over different distances and different types of ground. It's a shame to retire him, but he would only be winning the same races next year." Dream Ahead was pinhooked by Rome-based agent Federico Barberini and Tally Ho Stud. Freddy Head said of Goldikova, "She ran a great race, but is perhaps maybe not as speedy as she used to be at six. The plan is still the GI Breeders' Cup Mile."

Dabirsim advertised his class at first asking, but most of the world was not watching, as his 10-length success came at La Teste de Buch June 8. Back there to win again July 5, he arrived at Deauville with his reputation preceding him and was only 17-10 when extending his unbeaten run in the six-furlong G3 Prix de Cabourg July 31.

Sent off the 7-5 favorite for the Prix Morny back over that track and trip three weeks later, he was partnered by Frankie Dettori for the first time, and that doyen of the international scene could not hide his excitement after his three-length verdict over the dual group scorer Family One (Fr) (Dubai Destination). Left alone in rear early as Salure proved headstrong in a clear lead Sunday, Dabirsim was hemmed in against the fence at the top of the straight, and the Italian raider showed no signs of stopping. But the winner was kept to the inner as those in front started to angle wide, and ultimately needed only hand riding to inhale the long-time leader and provide his rider with a 500th group success. "He is just amazing, and he is very relaxed and has a lovely temperament, which is his strength," trainer Christophe Ferland said. "He is finished for the season, but will be entered for both the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and G1 2000 Guineas. We will decide on which to go for next year, but he has run over a straight course at Deauville and proved here that he can handle a bend. The way he won this, I think he'll stay a mile."

after turning in at the top of Longchamp's wide straight, began to veer left. Taking a diagonal line to the finish, she was still three lengths clear of **Fire Lily (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}) there, with the 4-5 favorite **Zantenda (GB)** (Zamindar) 1 1/4 lengths back in third despite being the only one to run straight against the far rail. "I don't know why she did that, but I'd put it down to greenness, as this is an intimidating place for a 2-year-old filly," her rider said, but added, "It felt like she won very easily." **Cont. p7**

Elusive Kate made an encouraging debut when fourth behind **Falls of Lora (Ire)** (Street Cry {Ire}) in a Doncaster maiden June 4, and was off the mark next time at the expense of the subsequent listed-winning and group-placed **Kinetica (GB)** (Stormy Atlantic) over seven furlongs on Kempton's Polytrack 11 days later. After coming late to open her black-type account in the Listed Prix Six

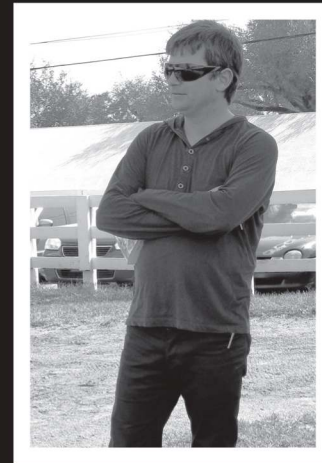

Perfections, she was ridden from the front to follow up in the G3 Prix du Calvados, and that tactic was employed again here. Leading the single-file field with Fire Lily in her slipstream, she was unhurried there as **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** Zantenda pulled too hard in rear. Turning for home, the race changed complexion, with Elusive Kate taking the eventual runner-up with her as she hung towards the stand's side, and Olivier Peslier dashing up the far rail on the favorite. Never headed despite her errant path, Elusive Kate was firmly in command at the line, and connections escaped the drama of an enquiry. "I was a bit worried before the race, as she was a bit buzzy, which isn't like her, and although the plan was to go to the front, I was worried she might do too much," William Buick explained. "Then she broke well and pricked her ears, but hung left from halfway, and I didn't really understand why. When I asked her to quicken in the straight, she was really decisive, and I didn't know where the others were, as I was trying to keep her straight. She was running downhill for the first time, but it's neither here nor there, because she won very easily. She's a very strong, forward little filly who should progress next year." Trainer John Gosden added, "She ran right-handed beautifully at Deauville, but she got confused in the downhill section here, and the ground is a little quicker. She changed lead and ended up on the wrong leg in the middle of the track. That should have cost her the race, as you shouldn't win from there, but she is an extremely talented filly with a big heart. She likes coming to France, so the plan is probably to come back here for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and then possibly to Churchill for the fillies' race." Fire Lily's trainer David Wachman told *PA Sport*, "The winner has won well, but [Fire Lily] has been second in two Group 1s now and is an exciting proposition for next year. She has been here, so might come back for the Pouliches." Elusive Kate is owned by Magnolia Racing, the stable name adopted by Robert and Janice McNair after they sold Stonerside, and Rachel Hood, a lawyer who is married to Gosden. She was produced by a winning half-sister to G1 Breeders' Cup Classic and G1 Dubai World Cup winner Pleasantly Perfect (Pleasant Colony).

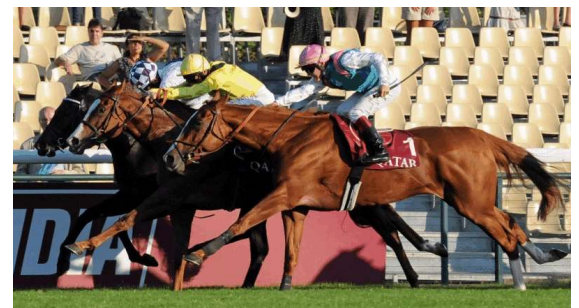

Roger Varian has inherited the patient approach of his mentor, the late Michael Jarvis, and it was fitting that his **Nahrain (GB)** (Selkirk), a shining example of that approach, provided the Newmarket conditioner with a first Group 1 triumph in the Prix de l'Opera. Unraced as a juvenile, Nahrain added to a May 16 Windsor maiden win in a June 9 Haydock handicap, and took the leap into Group 1

company off the back of a comfortable score in the July 2 Listed Sandown Distaff last time. The powerful chestnut was smartly away from her inside box and raced handily along the fence in third, but was shuffled back to fifth and caught in a pocket as the tempo increased with 350 meters remaining. Finding a clear passage once eased away from the rail approaching the final furlong, she was driven to the front with 100 meters to go and held on grimly as the renewed effort of **Announce (GB)** (Selkirk) reduced arrears to a sliver.

"That is my first Group 1 winner and I am really delighted," Roger Varian said. "She is a progressive filly who we have always held in the highest esteem, and she has won her three starts well. It was a bit ambitious to come here off the back of her last run in a listed race at the beginning of July. She had a setback, we were building her back up, and she has only just clicked in the last 10 days. I was worried the race might be a week or two too soon, but it's near the end of the season, so we had to have a go. She had a hard race today, which took a bit out of her, so we'll get her home and see how she is before deciding what to do with her. Hopefully, she'll stay in training next year." In an added twist, jockey Neil Callan, who partnered Nahrain in her previous start, gained compensation for missing the winning ride by landing the €500,000 G1 Qatar World Cup, a contest for purebred Arabian horses, in the preceding race.

FRUITFUL EQUIPMENT CHANGE

The drop back to five furlongs and the fitting of a visor gave **Tangerine Trees (GB)** (Mind Games {GB}) a new lease of life at the tail end of last semester, and he completed the progression to capture the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye Sunday. The gelding wired the Apr. 30 G3 Palace House S. at Newmarket on seasonal bow, but an attempt to repeat those front-running tactics led to a 10th-place finish in the May 21 G2 Temple S. at Haydock, and a last-of-19 effort in the June 14 G1 King's Stand S. at Royal Ascot. Rested until an all-the-way win in the Aug. 27 Listed Beverley Bullet Sprint S., he was quickly away once more at Longchamp, and blazed a trail up the middle while Captain Dunne (Ire) (Captain Rio {GB}) pressed the pace along the rail. Ridden to turn away the challenge of Mar Adentro (Fr) (Marju {Ire}) at the quarter pole, Tangerine Trees kept on well under a strong ride inside the final furlong as Secret Asset made a vain challenge on the inside. **Cont. p9**

"It's hard to describe the feeling, as we didn't expect to win the Abbaye--it's just a dream come true," said Mary Matthews, part of the 25-strong Tangerine Trees Partnership. "We knew he had a good chance on his form, and it was an unbelievable moment when he won." Registering his first Group 1 winner, jockey Tom Eaves added, "I can't quite believe it at the minute, but it's a brilliant feeling. He has progressed all the time, and to win is the icing on the cake. I knew he was very quick, but he got there very easily. I just tried to hang on to him for as long as I could and kick for home then." Jane Chapple-Hyam, trainer of runner-up Secret Asset, told *PA Sport*, "He's run a colossal race, and I'm absolutely thrilled. He might have been massive odds, but at least we've been competitive. I would think he will go to Dubai for the Carnival now."

KASBAH ROCKS AT LONGCHAMP

Kasbah Bliss (Fr) (Kahyasi {Ire}) has been admirably consistent in the G1 Prix du Cadran, running fourth in 2008, second in 2009 and third last year. He broke through with a win in the event at the tender age of nine. The gelding was held up at the back of the pack as **Tres Rock Danon (Fr)** (Rock of Gibraltar {Ire}) set ordinary early fractions. There was an injection of pace when **Elyaadi (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) took the baton seven furlongs out, and Kasbah Bliss was relegated to stone last, a place he maintained as they straightened for home. Jockey Gerald Mosse finally pressed the button at the quarter pole, and the winner flew home to trump a wall of challengers, allowing Mosse to take a pull in the final strides. **Cont. p10**

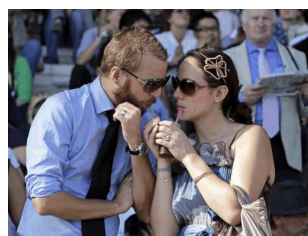

Filly Curren Chan kept with the theme of the day, beating the boys as favored Rocket Man (Aus) (Viscount {Aus}) disappointed. The start was delayed 10 minutes after B B Guldán (Jpn) (Chief Bearheart) got loose. When the race finally was off, Curren Chan settled in ninth. She followed the rally of fellow distaffer A Shin Virgo turning for home, and the pair drew even with designs on front-running Pas de Trois. The latter was able to save place honors from A Shin Virgo, but he was no match for the hard-charging Curren Chan. "I am overwhelmed by how strong she has become," said trainer Takayuki Yasuda. "She was on the weak side when I started training her, so I was careful not to push her too hard, and the patience has paid off. Now that she's a Group 1 winner, I will have to alter plans. I had a Group 2 race in mind, but I will pass it up and prepare her for the G1 Takamatsunomiya Kinen [next March]. I will discuss other plans, including any possible trips overseas, with the owner, but I don't want to ask too much, as she is just a filly." Rocket Man was stuck in traffic until it was too late and had to settle for fourth. Jockey Felix Coetzee said, "I could have taken him to the outside at the 600-meter [mark], but I wasn't too comfortable to do that because I thought it was a little bit early. So I held him in that position, hoping that I could get out, but that wasn't to happen."

City Wolf may not have lived up to his pedigree early on in his career, but the chestnut has now reeled off four straight victories since finding his niche on the Poly. He picked it up willingly at the head of the lane, and was quickly in front with a powerful move that no foe could rebut. When asked about what he knew of City Wolf before welcoming him into his barn, Baker said, "Obviously he's got a great pedigree. I saw the replays of his races and he tries to get out at the start, so I thought if we could cure that, we'd have a nice horse. But I didn't think he'd be this good... He still carries his head funny--I don't know what that is, but he runs good enough." Baker mentioned Woodbine's GII Autumn S. Nov. 12 as a possible target for City Wolf's next race.

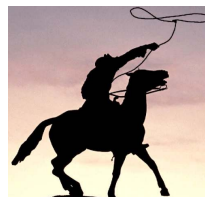

Blind Luck (Pollard's Vision) has been withdrawn from consideration for the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic in the wake of her last-place effort in Saturday's GI Lady's Secret S. at Santa Anita. "Right now, I would say she definitely will not run in the Breeders' Cup," trainer Jerry Hollendorfer reported yesterday. "But she came back fine. I don't know why she threw in a bad race. She never did that before." Blind Luck, last year's champion sophomore filly, had never finished worse than third in 21 previous starts.

Repole Pair on to Classic...

Repole Stable's sophomores **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) exited their Saturday engagements in fine shape and will likely line up against each other in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Classic. "At this time, that is what we are thinking for both of them," confirmed trainer Todd Pletcher. Of Uncle Mo's victory in the GII Kelso H., Pletcher said, "It was a sensational effort; Uncle Mo at his best." Stay Thirsty was third in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup. "Javier [Castellano] said Stay Thirsty didn't really like the surface, but at the same time I don't think he ran a bad race first time against older horses." The pair is expected to remain at Belmont Park until shipping to Kentucky 10 or 12 days before the Breeders' Cup. Pletcher added that **Life at Ten** (Malibu Moon) will likely be retired after her fifth-place effort in the GI Beldame.

Havre de Grace a 'Go' for Classic...

Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) exited her dominant performance in Saturday's GI Beldame S. in fine shape, according to trainer Larry Jones. "Everything looks good," Jones said. "She is still quite spry. All is well." Jones is looking forward to running Havre de Grace in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, with a possible Horse of the Year title on the line. "[Horse of the Year] could be determined in the Classic," Jones said. "That's where it should be determined, on the racetrack. It shouldn't just be bound to someone's opinion. If she wins the Classic, then definitely it's a no-brainer that she is Horse of the Year. But I don't think, for us to still be considered for Horse of the Year, we necessarily have to win the Classic. But we have to show up and run big." Also on target for the Classic is Saturday's GI Jockey Club Gold Cup winner **Flat Out** (Flatter). "Everything was great," trainer Scooter Dickey reported yesterday. "He came out of the race fine, and he was right on his feed."

Baffert Runners Eye Cup...

The majority of runners from the Bob Baffert barn who saw action Saturday will now be headed to the Breeders' Cup, the trainer confirmed yesterday. The group includes GI Goodwood S. winner **Game on Dude** (Awesome Again), GI Norfolk S. runner-up **Drill** (Lawyer Ron), GII Cotillion S. winner **Plum Pretty** (Medaglia d'Oro) and GI Vosburgh eighth-place finisher **Euroears** (Langfuhr). **Coil** (Point Given)'s status for the championship event is on hold after his third-place effort in the Goodwood. "I don't know yet about Coil," Baffert said. "I'll see how he trains the next couple of weeks." Of his other runners, Baffert added, "Euroears missed the break a little bit and then they just came over on him immediately. If he would have broke and been out there, he would have been done. Drill will be all right. We just found out a lot of things about him yesterday. Sometimes you learn more from defeat than you do in victory. You're trying to figure out their style. At least he got to handle some dirt in his face. He'll move way up off that."

FLEET INDIAN DIES Champion **Fleet Indian** (Indian Charlie--Hustleeta, by Alfeet) died Saturday night at Rood & Riddle Equine Hospital in Lexington, KY. "She had colic surgery Wednesday and she died of complications last night," explained Summer Wind Farm's Karen Bailey. Fleet Indian won the 2006 GI Beldame S., GI Personal Ensign S. and GII Delaware H. before being named that year's champion older mare. In foal to Storm Cat, the mare was acquired privately by Summer Wind after leaving the ring unsold at \$3.9 million at the 2007 Keeneland November sale. Her Storm Cat colt, Storm 'n Indian, sold to John Ferguson for \$2.05 million at the 2009 Keeneland September sale. Summer Wind retained Fleet Indian's A.P. Indy foal of 2009 and sold a Distorted Humor filly out of the mare for \$500,000 at this year's Keeneland September sale. Not in foal this year, Fleet Indian has a weanling filly by Medaglia d'Oro. Plans for the weanling are still up in the air. "It's hard to say [what we'll do with the weanling]," Bailey said. "We love the daughters out of our good mares."
