ARUNA SHOWS POLY PROWESS IN SPINSTER

Flaxman Holding's **Aruna** (Mr. Greeley), rerouted to yesterday's GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland after the turf for last Saturday's GI Flower Bowl

Invitational S. at Belmont came up boggy, relished her first taste of Polytrack to best **Pachattack** (Pulpit) with ease that belied her official winning margin of a half-length. The homebred now presents her connections with the good kind of dilemma. A recipient of a "Win and You're In" bid to the Nov. 4

GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic over the Churchill Downs, Aruna would be making her first dirt start if she accepts the invitation. "I've got to think about it," trainer Graham Motion said when asked about the prospect of running on the main track. "I've had some luck running turf/synthetic horses at Churchill," he quipped, referring to this year's GI Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence's **Animal Spirits** (Arch) was the beneficiary of a startling spill in the GIII Bourbon S. at Keeneland, besting **Coalport** (Kitten's Joy) by a half-length to earn his diploma.

Magdalena Racing's **Here Comes Frazier** (Badge of Silver) appeared en route to an impressive front-running victory when he shied from pilot Julien Leparoux's whip, bouncing off the rail and catapulting Leparoux

into the infield. Both rider and horse walked off under their own power. "I caught it," winning rider Robby Albarado said when asked if he saw the spill. "At the time, I was about to run up to [Here Comes Frazier]. Animal Spirits—it didn't seem to bother him any. He's so mature. He seems like an older horse out there. Aruna Shines In Spinster...

Aruna began her career in France under the tutelage of Jonathan Pease, posting a 3-1-1-1 record at two before trying group competition the following term. She was fourth in the G3 Prix de la Grotte last April and sixth in the G1 Prix Saint-Alary a month later at Longchamp before crossing the Atlantic to join Motion's stable. She overcame a pronounced course bias to go last-to-first in a Saratoga allowance last September, and steadily moved up the class ladder to annex the Pebbles S. at Belmont last Columbus Day and Churchill's GII Mrs. Revere S. Nov. 20. The dark bay returned under the Twin Spires on Kentucky Derby Day May 7 to be second in the GII Distaff Turf Mile and bested a field she towered over on paper in the GIII All Along S. at Colonial Downs June 18. Compromised last time by a lack of pace and less-than-firm ground in the July 30 GI Diana S. back where she made her U.S. debut, Aruna came with her patented late run to be second behind Zagora (Fr) (Green Tune).

Confidently backed down to 2-1 compared to a morning line that was double that, Aruna traveled in the two path off the pace behind splits of :23.39, :46.41 and 1:10.76 set by **Embur's Song** (Unbridled's Song), holder of the 1 1/16-mile track record over the Keeneland all-weather. She eased her way closer as they went around the far turn, but was geared back down by pilot Ramon Dominguez to give back some of the ground she made up when a seam failed to open. Avoiding any future traffic trouble by tipping to the far outside at the head of the lane, Aruna struck the front under a confident ride and powerful move that Pachattack couldn't duplicate. GIII Kentucky Cup Distaff winner **La Gran Bailadora** (Afleet Alex) arrived on the scene late to spice up the exotics.

"I've got to be honest; I would have been disappointed if she hadn't been very close," said Graham Motion. "Obviously, I didn't know she was going to win, but I would have been disappointed if she hadn't run a big race today. She's a really nice filly." Of the prospects of trying dirt in the Ladies' Classic, he explained, "I love the mile and an eighth [of the Ladies' Classic] for her. I think we've got to take her over there and maybe work her, but I have to talk to Maria [Niarchos-Gouaze of Flaxman Holdings] about it."

Aruna is named for a character in Hindu mythology who is said to be the personification of the glow of the rising sun. Aruna is sometimes depicted as Surya's charioteer in Hindu stories. Surya, the Hindu God of the Sun, is Aruna's dam. Surya (Unbridled) was trained by the late Bobby Frankel for the Niarchos family's Flaxman Holdings. She took a pair of graded stakes on the lawn and an off-the-turf renewal of the GIII Ballston Spa Breeders' Cup H. in 2002. Surya has a maiden 3-year-old by Giant's Causeway, a 2-year-old by Giant's Causeway, a yearling by Harlan's Holiday and a weanling by Distorted Humor.

Aruna followed the lead of her paternal siblings Crusade and Western Aristocrat to become the weekend's third winner at the top level for the late Gainesway stallion Mr. Greeley (Gone West), who was euthanized last November after complications from laminitis. Crusade took the G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket, while Western Aristocrat upset the GI Jamaica H. at Belmont--both on Saturday.

While several would have chosen an easy-touch maiden for the illustriously bred Nayarra, trainer Mick Channon capitalized on a golden opportunity to further embellish the homebred's regal family in this prestigious affair, which was dominated by the fillies. Like yesterday's other blue-blooded black-type winner Homecoming Queen (Ire) (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}), the bay needed a few runs to get the hang of the racing game. After finishing second in four maidens and unplaced in the June 25 Listed Empress S. over a mix of five and six furlongs, she looked in need of an increased stamina test. Instantly improved going a seventh furlong, she was beaten in a flurry of heads when fourth in Goodwood's G3 Prestige S. Aug. 27, and her subsequent third placings in the Listed Stardom S. at Goodwood Sept. 10 and Newmarket's G3 Oh So Sharp S. 13 days later suggested she was more in the mold of her stouter family members than the speedy sires Invincible Spirit (Ire) and Kodiak (GB). Standing up to the typically aggressive campaigning for which her West Ilsley-based trainer is renowned, she proved with this game performance that her frequent trips to the races, and shipping to Italy, had taken no toll on her. Effectively left in front of the main bunch as Rosa Eglantera's rabbit Lo Zoccolo Duro (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) was sent more than 10 lengths clear in a pointless tactical maneuver, she was at the head of affairs from just before the furlong pole and fought bravely to ward off her other filly rival in the drive to the line. Nayarra was produced by the stakes-winning Massarra, a daughter of G1 Prix de Diane heroine Rafha and thus a half-sister to Invincible Spirit and Kodiak. In the same year this filly was born, 2009, Coolmore's M.V. Magnier went to 600,000gns (\$1,048,131) to secure Massara at Tattersalls December who was in foal to Galileo (Ire). The resulting produce was a colt, and, bred back to Galileo, Massara foaled a filly by him this March.

Trainer Mark Casse has already shattered Woodbine's record for wins at a meet, and continued his dominance north of the border by saddling the 1-2-3 finishers here, with the top two carrying major client John Oxley's silks. Prospective was second when unveiled in a grass sprint at Woodbine July 31, and earned his diploma in a dog fight going seven furlongs over the Polytrack Aug. 27. Well-held and wide while traveling in fourth behind a half in :48 2/5, the dark bay inched closer along the bend to vie for the lead three-wide as Lockout slipped through on the fence. That pair hit the top of the lane in sync with GIII Summer S. runner-up Escaper (Exchange Rate) sandwiched between them, but Prospective showed another gear when shown the whip by pilot Luis Contreras and powered home to a convincing success. Lockout battled back nicely after appearing out of gas to secure the runner-up slot, while Bluedacious arrived on the scene late to get up narrowly for third. Prospective's connections were handsomely rewarded for supplementing the colt to the Grey for \$4,500. "I wasn't really sure how good he was, but his last couple of works were really good, so we decided to supplement him," Casse told *Daily Racing Form*. "His pedigree is two turns, up and down, and Malibu Moon is one of my favorite sires."

Animal Spirits was making just his second career start in the Bourbon. He debuted at 8-1 odds going two turns over Saratoga's grass course Aug. 20 and ran with credit, rallying to get within a neck of winner and

subsequent GIII Pilgrim S. third Fantastic Song (Lemon Drop Kid) while settling for second. Keeneland's faithful gave the bay some respect, sending him off at 8-1 once again. The grandson of Personal Ensign (Private Account) carried at the back of the back as Here Comes Frazier set very sensible :23 4/5,

:49 and 1:14 splits. As they field turned the corner for home, it looked as if the pacesetter was only getting stronger, but in midstretch, feeling the right-handed whip of Julien Leparoux, Here Comes Frazier abruptly shied into the rail, upending himself and throwing Leparoux into the infield. Longshot Coalport (Kitten's Joy), looking to cap a huge weekend for Ken Ramsey, briefly took command, but failed to account for Animal Spirits, who was flying under Robby Albarado late. Al Stall, Jr. trains the winner for Seth Klarman's Klaravich Stables and William Lawrence, and said time would tell whether Animal Spirits would target the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

"I haven't dealt with Seth that much," he said. "I've enjoyed it so far. We'll talk about it and see what he wants. Obviously, the big question is whether you go over to Louisville and run in that race, but we'll see." Animal Spirits is the first stakes winner for Personal Ensign's 19-year-old daughter Pennant Champion (Mr. Prospector), whom Philip Steinberg and Ben Walden, Jr. purchased for \$130,000 with Animal Spirits in utero at KEENOV 2008. Pennant Champion had a War Pass colt this spring.

Here Comes Frazier's Trainer Ken McPeck commented, "He's a really good horse. We're just hopeful he's OK. It looked like he was walking fine. He's never been hit in his life. He's so fast, we've never even had to lay a stick on him. I think he was shocked. Julien rolled the stick over and hit him right-handed, and the horse was just shocked. That scared him over the rail. It's a tough game, it's hard. I told somebody the other day, 'Racing horses is like boxing. Somebody gets to hit you in the head about nine times, and then you get to him them back.' Today I got hit pretty hard." The 2-1 post-time choice Monastic (Rock Hard Ten) was bumped hard as he was gearing up his run and didn't recover, finishing 10th.

Gestut Etzean sold Thursday's sale topper--a 600,000gns Galileo (Ire) filly--at Tattersalls' October Book 1, and the Beerfelden nursery's stellar week continued with Monami, a half-sister to the 2003 G1 Oaks d'Italia and 2004 GII Orchid H. victress Meridiana (Ger) (Lomitas {GB}), who stayed perfect in Germany's most prestigious event for juvenile distaffers. The flashy chestnut, lining up off an impressive four-length debut score at Dresden Sept. 25, raced in a handy third for most of this stakes bow. Cruising to the fore at the top of the stretch, she kept on strongly under continued nudging inside the final furlong to comfortably claim a personal best. "Monami was a very easy winner at Dresden first time out," commented Christiane Weil-Dassbach, daughter of Gestut Etzean founder Heinz Weil. "Her dam already produced the Oaks d'Italia winner Meridiana, which made us quite hopeful for today, especially as she had worked very well beforehand. It's a bit of a surprise because she was the second choice [of stable jockey Eduardo Pedroza], but we are of course very happy to win such a race."

No Breeders' Cup for Never Retreat...

Never Retreat (Smart Strike), winner of Saturday's GI First Lady S. at Keeneland, will bypass next month's Breeders' Cup, confirmed trainer Neil Pessin, who saddled her for Chris Block, yesterday. "She doesn't want to go the mile and three-eighths [distance of the GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf], and she doesn't want to run against the boys [in the GI TVG Breeders' Cup Mile]," Pessin said of the 6-year-old mare.

Together to Remain Stateside for QE II...

Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), a solid second behind Never Retreat the First Lady, will remain at the Lexington oval to contest Saturday's nine-furlong GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup S., it was confirmed yesterday. "She is going to stay here for the Queen Elizabeth," said T.J. Comerford, head traveling lad for trainer Aidan O'Brien. "She ran very well yesterday, and we hope she runs better next week."

Trainer Steve Asmussen, whose four-win day on Saturday's card was capped by a decisive score by Stonestreet Stables and George Bolton's **My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike) in the Frizette, said My Miss Aurelia and Ron Winchell's GIII Sham S. hero **Tapizar** (Tapit), an impressive return allowance winner in the first race, would ship down to Churchill Downs this morning. "Obviously, My Miss Aurelia is a tremendous filly--Grade I win, homebred," he beamed. "Just a lot of warm fuzzies about that." Asmussen also reported that he will take over the training of Vinery's GI Jamaica H. winner **Western Aristocrat** (Mr. Greeley).

Trainer Kieran McLaughlin's trainees--Champagne runner-up **Alpha** (Bernardini) and troubled-trip Frizette show horse **Miss Netta** (Street Sense)--will also soldier on to Kentucky. "Everyone came back in good shape and, as of this morning, all systems are 'go' for the Breeders' Cup, but we still have to discuss it with all the parties and see for sure," said McLaughlin.

Todd Pletcher said yesterday that Mike Repole's **"TDN Rising Star"** **Stopshoppingmaria** (More Than Ready), runner-up to My Miss Aurelia, "looked very good this morning." He also boasts GIII Summer S. hero **Finale** (Scat Daddy) among his young guns. The Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith representative worked four furlongs Sunday morning in :47.64 over the Belmont training track as he prepares for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

Winter Memories Tunes Up for QE II...

GI Garden City S. heroine **Winter Memories** (El Prado {Ire}) turned in a five-furlong spin in 1:01.50 over the Belmont sod Sunday morning as her final work for next Saturday's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland. "We're all set to go," said conditioner Jimmy Toner. "She leaves [Monday]. It was a nice breeze and she finished up good, so we're right on target. Last week we couldn't breeze on the grass. We breezed on the dirt, which is okay, too. We got on the grass today and had a nice maintenance breeze." As to how her current condition compares to how she was before the Garden City, Toner said, "She's where she's supposed to be." He added, "We don't want her going over the top. She's happy, she's fresh. I don't think we can move forward off that last race. I think she went as forward as she could possibly go, so we're just maintaining her and keeping her fresh and happy."

Fellow Toner trainee **Bold Hawk** (Silver Hawk), most recently a close-up third in the GII Bowling Green H. over the Belmont turf Sept. 10, will also head to Keeneland after a 1:02.70 breeze over Big Sandy's grass course yesterday. "We're going to run him at Keeneland in the [Oct. 20 GIII Sycamore S.] and maybe try to keep him away some of the heavies he's been running against," Toner reported. "I'd just really like to win a race with him. He's just such a nice horse and gives you everything. It's been a long time between drinks for him, so we'd like to win a race with him. I think he deserves to win one after coming back off a three-year layoff. You have to like the guy."

The Factor Still BC Bound...

Trainer Bob Baffert confirmed yesterday that, despite his fourth-place finish in Saturday's GI Ancient Title S., **The Factor** (War Front) will continue on to the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. "He came back out of it really good," said the Hall of Famer of George Bolton and Fog City Stable's GI Pat O'Brien S. winner. "Euroears (Langfuhr) will go, too, but Coil (Point Given)'s not going. I'm going to freshen him up. Drill (Lawyer Ron) is going to go in the [GI Juvenile] and Game on Dude [will go in the GI Classic]." Baffert will also consider Kaleem Shah's **Irrefutable** (Unbridled's Song) for the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. He was second in the Ancient Title. Zayat Stables' GII Super Derby and GII West Virginia Derby hero **Prayer For Relief** (Jump Start) will run in next Sunday's \$400,000 Oklahoma Derby at Remington Park, Baffert reported.

Gio Ponti Returns to New York...

Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat), who collected his second consecutive victory in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile at Keeneland Saturday, was shipped back to trainer Christophe Clement's Belmont Park base. "He's a New Yorker like me," Clement said. "He wants to get back home." Shortly after recording his 12th career victory, the versatile champion was escorted back to Clement's barn amidst cheers from the crowd. "I don't think I've ever seen that," Clement said of the fans' reception. "A lot of the credit has to go to my owner, Shane Ryan, for keeping Gio Ponti in training. The fans get to know these horses." Gio Ponti, who is now a six-time Group 1 winner, surpassed the \$6-million mark with Saturday's score. With the victory, the Castleton-Lyons representative secured a berth in the Nov. 5 GI Breeders' Cup Mile at Churchill Downs, but the following afternoon's GI Breeders' Cup Classic also remains a possibility for the 6-year-old career finale. "He's been great to all of us--my owner, my staff, myself," said Clement. "It's very exciting. We go to the Breeders' Cup, and it's fun to play at that level. He'll be very difficult to replace. I have to enjoy him because I know it's going to be awhile before I get another one."

Also possible for next month's Breeders' Cup is Shadwell Turf Mile runner-up **Get Stormy** (Stormy Atlantic). "It is disappointing to run that great and lose," said trainer Tom Bush from his home base at Belmont Park. "I knew that [early leader] Sidney's Candy would be tough to get by, and when I saw that 1:22 2/5 for seven-eighths, I knew that he had to run hard. He just got beat by a very special horse." Bush said Get Stormy would remain at Keeneland until October 28. "We will probably go to the Breeders' Cup, but that's not etched in stone," he said.

Not likely to head to the Breeders' Cup is **Wise Dan** (Wiseman's Ferry), fourth in the Shadwell Turf Mile. "I am really happy with him," trainer Charles Lopresti said. "He ran hard and ran well." The 4-year-old gelding, who won his debut on the sod in the July 4 GII Firecracker H. at Churchill Downs, will likely make his next start at that venue, but not over the Breeders' Cup weekend. "I know the owner wants to see him run again this year," Lopresti said. "I don't think he'll run in the Breeders' Cup. Maybe something at Churchill Downs like the River City [H. Nov. 19], but that is a mile and an eighth. It just depends on if we find something."

Majestic City Returns to California to Prep for BC...

Jeff Bloom's **Majestic City** (City Zip), beaten 3/4 of a length by Dullahan (Even the Score) in Saturday's GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity, was scheduled to return to trainer Peter Miller's California base where he will train up to the Breeders' Cup at Churchill Downs. "I was very pleased with his effort," Miller said. "With a little better luck and a better trip, he wins the race. He closed into a fast pace, opened up and then hung on." A \$180,000 OBSMAR purchase, the chestnut may contest the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at a mile instead of the 8 1/2-furlong GI Grey Goose Breeders' Cup Juvenile. "We are going to nominate to both spots," Miller offered. "[Offspring by] City Zip move up on the grass and the flat mile is enticing. Plus without [leading 2-year-olds] Creative Cause or Union Rags, the Turf looks like it will be a softer spot." According to Miller, the winner of the GIII Hollywood Juvenile Championship S. will work two or three more times at Hollywood Park before returning to Kentucky a few days prior to the Breeders' Cup, scheduled for November 4-5.

Hannon Keen on Suit's Chance...

Trainer Richard Hannon was in a confident mood yesterday as he looks ahead to the GI Breeders' Cup Mile tilt of **Strong Suit** (Rahy). Impressive with a 4 1/2-length success in the G2 Challenge S. at Newmarket on Saturday, the recent acquisition of Sheikh Fahad Al Thani's Qatar Bloodstock operation is lined up for a crack at Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) at Churchill Downs. "He's proving a revelation after that wind operation that he had in the spring, and [jockey Richard] Hughesie reckons that he is made for America," Hannon said. "The ground at Newmarket was a bit loose on top, but in Kentucky it will probably be as hard as the local freeway, and that will suit him perfectly. Strong Suit has always been such a lovely horse to deal with and he has so much speed, which you need for America. He could win at five, six or seven furlongs, and we are confident that he'll get the mile there. He has always been inclined to lug slightly to his left when he comes off the steel, so the track out there will be right up his street. The faster the pace the better too and, while David Redvers, who bought him for Sheikh Fahad Al Thani's Qatar Bloodstock operation, will eventually stand him at his Tweenhills Stud in Gloucestershire, they are very sporting owners who like to see their horses race, and I would certainly not mind having Strong Suit back. He'll be even stronger then and we could campaign him at all the top races over a mile."

LILBOURNE LAD TO RATHBARRY

Rathbarry Stud Saturday's G1 Middle Park S. runner-up **Lilbourne Lad (Ire)** (Acclamation {GB}--Sogno Verde {Ire}, by Green Desert) will be retired in time to stand stud for the 2012 breeding season. In a move which replicates the recent securing of the services at stud of **Approve (Ire)** (Oasis Dream {GB}-Wyola, by Sadler's Wells), **Dark Angel (Ire)** (Acclamation {GB}--Midnight Angel {GB}, by Machiavellian) and **Zebedee (GB)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}--Cozy Maria, by Cozzene) at the end of their juvenile campaigns, Paul Cashman's County Cork-based operation has stepped in for the talented Richard Hannon trainee. Beaten 3/4-of-a-length by Crusade (Mr. Greeley) in Newmarket's six-furlong contest, the winner of the G2 Railway S. at The Curragh June 26 was also second in the Aug. 19 G2 Gimcrack S. at York and could have one more run in the Breeders' Cup. "The plan had been to take the Zebedee route, and retire Lilbourne Lad to Rathbarry Stud, who also stands his much-in-demand stallion Acclamation, are very keen to have him to help the other fellow with the covering of mares," Hannon explained yesterday. "However, there is now talk of Lilbourne Lad having one last tango in the States. He could have a shot at the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, or we might even have a look at the 2-year-old race on the turf, but we'll sit down and make a decision in the next week or so. He is such a tough horse and Hughesie [Richard Hughes] felt that things might have been different if Crusade, the eventual winner, had raced closer to him. But our fellow has done us proud again and showed again that he is right up there with the best of them." Rathbarry's Paul Cashman told *Racing Post*, "He has been tough and consistent all season, he's a real credit to his sire. He will probably have one more run. He likes fast ground, so it will probably be the Breeders' Cup. He is a very correct, deep-bodied horse with a fluent action." A fee for the colt, who has so far won three of his eight starts and over £162,000 in prize money, will be announced later.

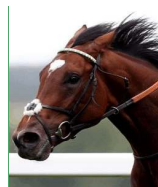
