### FRANKEL TOPS QEII TEN

Juddmonte's unbeaten **"TDN Rising Star"** **Frankel (GB)** (Galileo {Ire}) will be joined by stablemate and 3/4-brother **Bullet Train (GB)** (Sadler's Wells) in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Sir Henry Cecil confirmed yesterday that both will take part, with Bullet Train acting as pacemaker in Ascot's one-mile contest. "It looks like there are one or two good horses in the race, and no race is a formality," Cecil said. "There is no such thing as a 'good thing,' but I am very happy with Frankel. I also run Bullet Train--it could help me, and it could also help everyone

else, too. Frankel could take up the running at a certain time, but we haven't decided one, two or three things yet. I don't want it to be a crawl and then turn into a sprint, so it will depend on how the race is run as to whether it plays to Frankel's speed or stamina. Bullet Train should make it a true run race--he will not go off like hell in front, but is there if we need him." Frankel's eight remaining rivals at yesterday's confirmation stage include G1 Coronation S. and G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois victress **Immortal Verse (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) and **Excelebration (Ire)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}). Godolphin still have **Rio de La Plata (Rahy)** and the reigning titleholder **Poet's Voice (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) engaged, with the latter also entered in the G1 Champion S. later on the card. "Poet's Voice has been a little bit disappointing this year, as against the form he showed last season," admitted racing manager Simon Crisford. "With each race this season he seems to have improved, and he is doing well at the moment. Now we have got to weigh which is the best race for him. We will leave the decision as late as possible." Champion trainer-elect Richard Hannon will be represented by **Dick Turpin (Ire)** (Arakan) and **Dubawi Gold (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}), and the line up is completed by **Cityscape (GB)** (Selkirk) and **Side Glance (GB)** (Passing Glance {GB}).

### SURGERY FOR HERE COMES FRAZIER

**Here Comes Frazier** (Badge of Silver), who was leading Sunday's GIII Bourbon S. at Keeneland before bouncing off the rail and falling, has been taken to Rood and Riddle Equine Hospital and will require surgery to repair a fracture to his right hock. "He has not had surgery yet," trainer Ken McPeck reported yesterday. "They are going to do more X-rays to see if there is anything else up higher." Here Comes Frazier debuted with a seven-length victory at Arlington Park Sept. 5. The Bourbon was his second start. "He is one of the most talented horses I've ever had," McPeck said. "It is probably doubtful that he will ever race again, and he faces a long recovery time of six months to a year."

### THIRD MORVICH FOR CALIFORNIA FLAG

Veteran **California Flag** (Avenue of Flags) won the 2008 and 2009 renewals of the GIII Morvich S. and, after skipping the 2010 edition, came back to earn a third Morvich title with a half-length victory at Santa Anita yesterday. "He's a nice old horse," said winning trainer Brian Koriner. "It's just nice to see him back and people can quit criticizing [for running him at age seven]." California Flag has made three starts in the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, including a win in the 2009 renewal, but Koriner was non-committal about a fourth start. "We'll talk about it," he said. **Cont. p2**

California Flag, third in last year's G3 Al Quoz Sprint at Meydan, was making just his third start of the year. He was eighth in the July 3 Robert Kerlan Memorial H. and was coming off a rare main-track performance with a fifth-place effort in Del Mar's Sept. 7 Pirate's Bounty S. The gray millionaire broke well yesterday, but allowed the speed to go, settling into a stalking third. He pulled his way into contention after a quarter in :21.41 and engaged pacesetter Excessive Passion after a half in :43.42. The pair battled down the lane, with California Flag moving the better of the two late. "He ran a great race," said winning rider Patrick Valenzuela. "I had horse coming across the dirt and he just kicked on and fought it out hard. He's a fighter." Koriner agreed. "He grinds it out," the trainer said. "At the end, nobody was making any impact. They were just going even to the wire." California Flag races for his breeder Hi Card Ranch, owned by Barbara Card of Murrieta and her late husband Keith, who died in March at the age of 83.

**Ascot Irrigates...**

With drying conditions changing the official going to good-to-firm, Ascot has turned on the taps in an effort to prepare better ground for Saturday's inaugural QIPCO Champions Day. Further drying conditions, with the occasional shower, are expected and watering is underway on both the round and straight tracks. "The strong breeze has dried up the course in the last 24 hours, and this has prompted today's watering," explained Ascot's Clerk of the Course Chris Stickels. "I don't want to be putting on a lot of water on the course at this time of year, but we will monitor the situation through the week as the forecast is for mainly dry weather. I am looking to offer ground which is a combination of good and good-to-firm on Saturday."

**Hoof It Hops It...**

Andrew 'Chubby' Chandler and Lee Westwood's **Hoof It (GB)** (Monsieur Bond {Ire}) has failed to recover from the foot problem which forced his absence from the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp and will miss Saturday's G2 British Champion Sprint S. at Ascot. Veteran conditioner Mick Easterby's vastly improved 4-year-old franked the form of a runaway win in July's Stewards' Cup H. at Goodwood by finishing a close sixth in the G1 Nunthorpe S. on stakes debut at York the following month. He was denied by inches when an impeded third in the G1 Haydock Sprint Cup last time and, although late-season opportunities are available, connections are inclined to draw a line under this season. "Hoof It is still not 100% from having gravel, and we decided to pull up stumps," the trainer's son David Easterby told *Racing Post*. "He stood on the cleft of his shoe then it moved to the first nail hole on the right and then the second. It keeps bursting out and then re-infecting. It can either be sorted out very simply, or it can linger and grumble for ages, and we have got a lingerer and grumbler at the moment. It is not something that is going to cause permanent damage and the problem is solvable."

**So You Think Heads Champion 17...**

Ballydoyle representative **So You Think (NZ)** (High Chaparral {Ire}), a last-out fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, heads a cast of 17 for Saturday's G1 Champion S. in the race's first staging at Ascot. The Aidan O'Brien trainee may be joined by stablemates **Windsor Palace (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and **Await the Dawn** (Giant's Causeway) in the 10-furlong feature on Champions Day. Godolphin's sophomores **Casamento (Ire)** (Shamardal) and the unbeaten **Dubai Prince (Ire)** (Shamardal) have been confirmed as intended runners, while a third blue entry, Poet's Voice, will likely point to the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. "Dubai Prince is the one horse we have within Godolphin whom we have definitely not seen the best of yet," said racing manager Simon Crisford. "He is a quality colt, and he is not going to bounce from his victory at Newbury after a long layoff because that was an easy win for him. He is definitely progressing the way we want him to progress. It is impossible to judge his form so far, and we don't know how good he is. Whether he is good enough to win, we will find out. It has taken Casamento a few races to get back to his best, but he is a workmanlike colt who does not exude huge quality in terms of acceleration. He needs to be wound up a long way from the finish, but he comes into this race after a decent victory in France. Sheikh Mohammed will decide on the riding plans closer to the race." The race is deep in top-level performers, and notable entries standing their ground include reigning dual champion **Twice Over (GB)** (Observatory), his MG1SW stablemate **Middy (GB)** (Oasis Dream GB), the MG1SW globetrotter **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab), **Wigmore Hall (Ire)** (High Chaparral {Ire}) and French yardstick **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}). The Classic generation poses a serious threat. A five-strong team includes G1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. hero **Nathaniel (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), G1 Prix du Jockey Club victor **Reliable Man (GB)** (Dalakhani {Ire}) and Jim Bolger's admirably tough **Banimpire (Ire)** (Holy Roman Emperor {Ire}).

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### Caspar Targets Churchill...

Trainer Alan McCabe yesterday confirmed **Caspar Netscher (GB)** (Dutch Art {GB}) on course for a crack at the Breeders' Cup following his unlucky defeat in Saturday's G1 Middle Park S. at Newmarket. Only fifth in that six-furlong contest, having had a significant amount of ground to make up in the final furlong, the Aug. 19 G2 Gimcrack S. and Sept. 17 G2 Mill Reef S. scorer emerged unscathed and is being prepared for the GII Juvenile Turf. "He's fine, he's in good order and all seems well--all roads lead to America now," McCabe told *PA Sport*. "It was arguably his best effort, because it was his first run in a Group 1, and he was an unlucky loser. It's a tricky track and a unique course. He got shuffled back, but his run after that was amazing, and in a few more strides he'd have been in front. What's worse is the fact that we have already beaten, and beaten well, the horses who finished second and third, but that's racing. He's survived to go on to Kentucky. On that run, he's still progressing. [Jockey] Robert [Winston]'s initial reaction when he came in was that he should have won."

### RMTC BOARD HEARS DRUG RULES UPDATE

The Racing Medication and Testing Consortium received an update from its Race Day Medication, Drug Testing Initiatives and Research Committees during an Oct. 6 meeting in Scottsdale, Arizona. National Thoroughbred Racing Association President Alex Waldrop presented a model rule reflecting the RMTC's stance that furosemide be administered only on raceday by regulatory veterinarians. The board will present the rule at the Association of Racing Commissioners International Winter Meeting in Tucson in December.

**A #** will distinguish first-time stakes-winners, a **@** will indicate first-time graded stakes-winners, a **▲** will denote a first-time Grade/Group 1 winner, a **+** will indicate first-time starters, an **(S)** will be used for state-bred races.

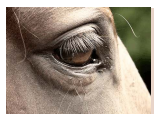

I doubt that even his greatest admirers would ever claim that Mr. Greeley was the most consistent of stallions, but there's no denying that when he was hot he was HOT, both in the sales ring and on the track.

This was perfectly demonstrated by his spectacular run of three Grade I victories last weekend, thanks to members of his 2007, 2008 and 2009 crops. This extraordinary sequence was all the more unexpected because Mr. Greeley hadn't enjoyed Group 1 success since his daughter Saoirse Abu took the Moyglare Stud S. just over four years ago.

There was every reason to have high expectations of Mr. Greeley's 2008 and 2009 crops. His 2007 coverings took place after he had been represented by six individual group/graded winners in 2006--a tally which helped boost his fee from \$35,000 to \$75,000. One of those group winners, Finsceal Beo, went very close to achieving a magnificent Classic treble in May 2007, with her victories in the English and Irish 1000 Guineas sandwiching a narrow defeat in the French version. Her handler Jim Bolger also trained Saoirse Abu, who became a dual Group 1 winner later in the year, to help boost Mr. Greeley's fee once again, this time to \$125,000.

The son of Gone West wasn't able to maintain this momentum in a falling market, with his fee for 2009 falling to \$75,000 (after originally being announced as \$100,000) and then to \$50,000 in 2010, the year he succumbed to laminitis at the age of 18.

His 2008 fee of \$125,000 was therefore a career high, and should theoretically produce his best crop. The 25-1 victory by Crusade in the G1 Middle Park S. is the first indication that this could come to fruition. Although he is one of only five juvenile winners so far, from a crop of 129, the others include the Vandal S. winner Buongiorno Johnny and the highly regarded English filly Firdaws. **Cont. p8**

It was also fair to have high expectations of Mr. Greeley's two \$75,000 crops, the second of which are his current yearlings. Unfortunately for the vendors of most of Mr. Greeley's 2011 yearlings, his stunning sequence of top winners came too late, with 38 selling for an average of just under \$90,000 and a median of \$75,000. His top price of \$280,000 is a far cry from the days when his yearlings achieved such prices as \$5,700,000, \$2,700,000 and \$2,200,000.

Western Aristocrat, Mr. Greeley's English-trained winner of Saturday's GI Jamaica H., is a member of the first \$75,000 crop. Most of the better performers from this crop have been based in Europe, other examples being the smart Irish filly Laughing Lashes, who reached the first four in this year's Irish 1000 Guineas and Irish Oaks, and High Ruler, fourth in the Irish 2000 Guineas.

Interestingly, Sunday's GI Spinster S. winner Aruna--a member of the 2007 crop--also started her career in Europe. However, her French efforts were markedly inferior to the form she has been showing on American turf and all-weather tracks, perhaps because she is out of a daughter of Unbridled and is inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector.

Two of Mr. Greeley's other Grade I winners--El Corredor and Whywhywhy--are also inbred 3x4 to Mr. Prospector, as are his fast daughter Miraculous Miss and his speedy son Sir Greeley. Aruna is one of several graded winners sired by Mr. Greeley from mares from the Fappiano branch of the Mr. Prospector line. Among the others are Whywhywhy (out of a Quiet American mare), this year's GII Distaff H. winner Nicole H. (out of a Victory Gallop mare inbred 3x3 to Fappiano) and Laughing Lashes (out of an Unbridled's Song mare).

Western Aristocrat also has a second line of Mr. Prospector, through Fappiano, as his second dam is another daughter of Quiet American. Crusade, for his part, is out of a mare inbred 4x4x5 to Mr. Prospector, with one line coming through Fappiano. Rebuttal, a Mr. Greeley colt who was a good second in the G1 Middle Park S. in 2004, is another out of a Fappiano line mare, having a dam by Rubiano.

Coincidentally, Crusade is out of a mare by Johannesburg, winner of the Middle Park S. as part of his sweep of four of the world's top juvenile events in 2001. But Crusade's dam, La Traviata, wasn't any old daughter of Johannesburg. Having sold for only \$75,000 as a weanling and \$112,000 as a yearling, she provided her vendors, Leprechaun Racing, with a spectacular profit when re-offered at Fasig-Tipton's Calder select sale of two-year-olds in 2006, where she was bought for \$1.1 million by Demi O'Byrne.

O'Byrne was the leading buyer at that sale, signing for six head for a total of \$21,450,000. A whopping \$16 million of that total was paid for a Forestry colt who became infamous as the non-winning The Green Monkey. O'Byrne enjoyed more luck with a \$2-million Mr. Greeley colt, who, as Belgravia, won the GIII Hollywood Prevue S., and with the \$1.1-million Johannesburg filly.

Named La Traviata, she didn't make it to the races until she was three, when she went unbeaten through her first three starts. After she had cruised home more than nine lengths clear in the GIII Victory Ride S. at Saratoga, winning trainer Patrick Biancone said: "There's nothing much to say: she's unbelievable." Unfortunately there wasn't a dream ending to La Traviata's story, as she managed only sixth place on a sloppy track when favorite for the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Sprint.

La Traviata has wasted no time in demonstrating her potential as a producer, Crusade being her first foal. She also has a 2010 colt by Henrythenavigator.

Crusade will apparently now attempt to follow in Johannesburg's footsteps even further, by challenging for the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. He will have to answer two serious questions: will he act well on dirt and will he stay?

The change of surface shouldn't bother him, as both his parents raced exclusively on dirt and his broodmare sire was also a Grade I winner on the surface. The

second and third generations of his pedigree also feature the likes of Gone West, Mr. Prospector, Reviewer, Hennessy and Unbridled, so dirt shouldn't be an insuperable obstacle.

A mile and a sixteenth might be more of a problem. Crusade's big win over six furlongs followed a less impressive display over seven furlongs, when he lost a couple of places

in the closing stages. Then there's the matter that both of Crusade's parents contested a Breeders' Cup Sprint of sorts, with Mr. Greeley finishing second to Desert Stormer.

Mr. Greeley has sired plenty of smart milers, though, and the presence of Unbridled in Crusade's pedigree should help. The colt's second dam, Piedras Negras, is a half-sister to Jack Sullivan, a smart all-weather and turf performer in Europe and Dubai who once tackled the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.

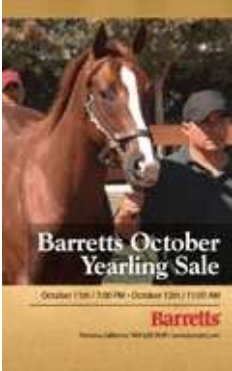

Elusive Pearl won on debut in the Laurel slop last December and, after a pair of sixth-place finishes in Maryland in January and May, the dark bay romped by 7 1/4 lengths on the Presque Isle Tapeta June 24. She was third behind subsequent Gill Ontario Colleen S. winner Anne's Beauty (Artie Schiller) in the Duchess S. at Woodbine July 30, and took to the turf in a big way last time with an upset front-running victory over Ruthenia (Pulpit) and Divalarious (Distorted Humor) in Saratoga's Riskaverse S. Sept. 2. Back on the engine and unopposed here through splits of :24.88, :50.44 and 1:13.64, Elusive Pearl was impossible to catch as she kicked home swiftly, getting her final quarter in :22.97. "It ended up setting up the way I was hoping," said pilot Ramon Dominguez. "There wasn't really much speed on paper and I was able to slow it down. Any time you let a good filly like her get away with a half like we did today...she came home very strong the last quarter of a mile." **How Sweet It Is...**

Saint Honore, the patron saint of bakers and pastry chefs, already had a cake named after him. And, yesterday afternoon at Belmont Park, the colt named for him started what turned out to be a very sweet day for breeder Christine Hansen. **Cont. p2**

"It is always a wonderful feeling to have bred a nice winner," Hansen said Monday. "And this day got even more amazing when another 2-year-old I bred, Galex (Flatter), placed second in a stakes race at Santa Anita, going off at 18-1--the longest shot in the field!"

Both juveniles were the product of very modest investments. Hansen bought She Ain't a Saint (Meadowlake), the dam of Saint Honore, for just \$3,500 at Keeneland November 2004.

"I've always had a weakness for Meadowlake, and when I saw big, beautiful She Ain't a Saint, I

immediately knew I wanted to buy her," Hansen recalled. "She hadn't produced much and was in foal to a stallion that was not very commercial, so I was

able to get her for a very affordable sum.

"The foal she carried, a filly by Peruvian who inherited her mother's size, was an impressive individual, but not easy to sell due to the lack of commercial appeal of the pedigree," she added.

That filly, stakes-placed I Lost My Halo, subsequently brought \$8,500 as a FTKFEB 2-year-old. She Ain't a Saint's foal of 2007, a colt by Sir Cherokee, was a \$6,000 KEEJAN yearling.

Saint Honore was hammered down to Tracy Farmer for \$29,000 as a KEENOV weanling, but he is listed as co-breeder. Hansen explained, "When it was time to decide on a mating for the 2008 breeding season, I thought that Sun King (Charismatic) was a great fit for her as soon as I saw him. I bred the mare on a foal share to Sun King, through Darby Dan Farm's office."

Farmer campaigned multi-millionaire Sun King, who won four graded races and was beaten a nose by Horse of the Year Invasor (Arg) in the GI Whitney H., and a head by Silver Train in the GI Met Mile H. in 2006. The dark bay was also third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Champagne S. in 2004. When it came time to send Saint Honore to the sale, he was on Farmer's radar, and the owner decided to hang on to him.

"His advisors loved the colt when they saw him at the Keeneland November sale in 2009, and he bought out my share," Hansen confirmed, adding, "I am in the business to breed, raise, and sell, and very rarely retain a horse to race. I was excited to see him go where I knew he would be truly appreciated and given every chance, as Mr. Farmer obviously would support his stallion as best he could."

Unfortunately, She Ain't a Saint died, and Saint Honore was her last foal. But the dam of Galex, Oh Caramel (Othello), is still going strong at Hansen's Montessori Farm in Jessamine County, Kentucky. She didn't break the bank either.

"I bred his dam on a \$600 stud fee, sold her privately as a weanling, then claimed her back for the same as I paid for She Ain't a Saint," Hansen said.

Oh Caramel changed hands via the claim box three times in her last five career starts, getting haltered for \$10,000 and \$12,500 before going to Hansen for \$3,500 after running third at Charles Town in June of 2002. Galex, her first foal to go through the ring, brought a healthy \$31,000 as a FTKOCT yearling last year. Racing for Olympia Star Inc. and trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, he broke his maiden by 3 1/2 lengths in his career opener at Golden Gate in June and was second in a stakes at Pleasanton in July. The chestnut was freshened after tiring to sixth in the Gil Best Pal S. at Del Mar Aug. 25. Near the back of the pack early in the Jack Goodman S. at Santa Anita yesterday, he angled outside for the stretch drive and came running late to be second.

Hansen was born in Germany, but packed her bags for the U.S. some 25 years ago.

"I moved to the Bluegrass region in order to attend [the University of Kentucky], and to find my place in the Thoroughbred industry," she said. "I currently operate a

small boarding/breeding operation. In 2009, the year Saint Honore was born, I was listed as breeder or co-breeder of five foals, which is a fairly typical number for me. Counting seasonal mares, we might breed about 20-25 mares each spring."

That year is etched in Hansen's memory, but not in a good way. Early in 2009, one of her barns burned down, and nine mares were lost.

"It is the worst thing that can happen," she said.

Left with her five bargain broodmares, Hansen could only pray that things would turn around, and she continued to work hard at what she loved.

"The hands-on involvement, being there every day to care for the horses, attend each foaling, prep each sale weanling or yearling, and occasionally break the yearlings myself, is my favorite aspect of the business," she said.

Well, that and celebrating the success of the babies she has raised.

"Having bred and raised a number of very useful racehorses out of inexpensive mares bred on modest stud fees, by industry standards, is always my biggest source of pride," Hansen said. "This was such a nice day for a breeder of five 2-year-olds...on a budget!"

### HUGHES FALLS FOUL OF NEW WHIP RULE

Richard Hughes was one of two jockeys to be punished under the revised whip rules introduced by the British Horseracing Authority yesterday. Judged to have hit his mount Swift Blade (Ire) six times during the final furlong of the 10-furlong handicap at Salisbury, he was handed the mandatory five-day suspension and duly lost his percentage of prize money and forfeited his riding fee. The new sanctions state that on the flat, a horse can be hit no more than five times inside the final furlong and seven times in total, a figure that was also exceeded by three-pound apprentice Kieren Fox, who picked up a 15-day ban for hitting the race's winner Orthodox Lad (GB) 11 times. Head of Stewards William Nunneley said, "It had to happen some day, and I'm afraid the penalties are there and they are severe. We've been trying to educate the rider and, at the end of the day, they are the people on top and they are the ones who got us where we are, if you like. I'm very disappointed we've had two breaches, and I'm certainly disappointed with Kieren Fox, as that's not just forgetting, that's way over the top. I was rather hoping that they would understand they have got to change the way they use the whip. It's a behavioral thing that has got to change."
