One year ago, **Miss Keller (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}) found herself one-length short of taking home the lion's share of the purse in Woodbine's GI E.P. Taylor S., but she reversed that form yesterday afternoon when she came from far back to nab the 2011 renewal of the 1 1/4 mile event.

The 5-year-old mare is campaigned by Lordship Stud, Clodagh McStay and Three Chimneys Racing. Three Chimneys Farm--who campaign the Irish-bred in partnership with Anthony

Ramsden--was also responsible for yesterday's GIII Harold C. Ramser Sr. S. winner **Up In Time (Ire)** (Noverre) at Santa Anita. Taken to her customary place at the back in the early going by jockey Johnny Velazquez, Miss Keller was unhurried through **Mahbooba's (Aus)** (Galileo {Ire}) opening pace of :25.34, :51.06 and 1:16.07. Closing on the front rank through a mile in 1:41.00, the 5-year-old swung to the outside for the stretch drive and was up in time to hand **I'm A Dreamer (Ire)** (Noverre) a narrow defeat. **Cont. 10**

Big Day for the Ladies...Again

The sole filly in yesterday's Canadian International lineup, Sarah Lynx settled near the back of the pack in 10th as **Kara's Orientation** (Orientate) went immediately to the front, taking the field through early fractions of :25.41, 52.06, 1:17.7 and 1:42.96. The pacesetter started to weaken over the heavy footing on the far turn, while new challengers **Treasure Beach** (GB) (Galileo {Ire}), **Joshua Tree** (Ire) (Monjeu {Ire}), and **Arctic Cosmos** (North Light {Ire}) began to close on the outside. However, it was Sarah Lynx moving fastest of all along the inside late, inhaling her rivals in the straight and powering clear to win by four lengths.

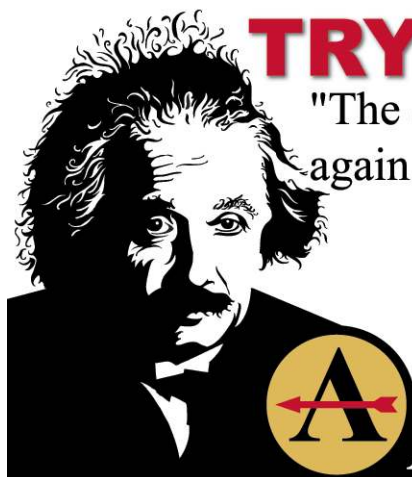
Her winning margin was the largest since Relaxed Gesture (Ire)'s 4 1/2-length tally in 2005, while Secretariat holds the race record--6 1/2 lengths--in 1973. "She likes to be inside of horses," said winning rider Christophe Soumillon. "The great thing is that she has a good turn of foot. This is the third time she's had blinkers on, because before she was a bit lazy. So with those on, I saw she was not pulling at all in the race. She was really relaxed. I was quite confident."

Catlike Moves...

Sarah Lynx enjoyed modest success in France last season, finishing a close-up fourth behind Middy (GB) (Oasis Dream {GB}), Plumania (GB) (Anabaa) and Sarafina (Fr) (Refuse to Bend {Ire}) in the 12-furlong G1 Prix Vermeille and the 1 9/16-mile G2 Prix de Royallieu at Longchamp. Fifth in her 2011 unveiling in the 11-panel Preis der Baden-Badener June 4, the bay was a credible fourth in the Prix de la Pepiniere at Maison-Laffitte July 24 before breaking her year-long losing streak in the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville Aug. 14. Taking another stab at the Vermeille Sept. 11, the Irish-bred encountered some traffic late, but closed to be a good fourth behind winner Galikova (Fr) (Galileo {Ire}). Trained by John Hammond, the Irish-bred, who went postward a 22-1 outsider, became just the sixth filly or mare--and first since Infamy in 1988--to win the mile Canada's richest horse race. Sarah Lynx was the first mount in the International for Soumillon, who won the GI E.P. Taylor S. aboard longshot Reggane (GB) (Red Ransom). The French rider started off the weekend with a bang, taking Saturday's GI Champion S. at Ascot aboard Cirrus Des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}). In a reversal of fortune, literally, the leading jockey was handed a whopping £52,000 fine for the excessive use of the whip, handed down in accordance with the new British whip rules.

BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

Repole Duo Struts Their Stuff at Belmont...

Mike Repole's **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) worked Sunday morning over Belmont's training track in preparation for the Breeders' Cup Nov. 4 and 5. Uncle Mo covered five furlongs in a a bullet :58.64--fastest of 32 at the distance--and Stay Thirsty negotiated a half-mile in :48.62. It was the first work for both horses since Belmont's Oct. 1 Super Saturday card, when Uncle Mo took the

GI Kelso H. and Stay Thirsty was third in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Invitational. "Mo's work was similar to his last work before the Kelso," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "It was a little quicker than we set out to do, but it's just an indication of how well he's doing right now." Uncle Mo was accompanied by jockey John Velazquez, while Stay Thirsty was partnered by Patty Krotenko. "That was a good maintenance breeze for him," said Pletcher. "He was moving well and seemed happy."

Repole added, "Stay Thirsty--Steady Thirsty," quipped Repole. "You tell Stay Thirsty to go :48 and three, he goes :48 and three, and then he comes back and he asks 'Did I go :48 and three?' And I say 'Yes, you did.' He does everything right. I spoke to and she said she had plenty, plenty of horse underneath her. Caixa Eletronica was on the inside, but at any time she could have just went by him. He's Stay Thirsty. Mo decides what he wants to do. It's the Mo show."

Pletcher confirmed that both horses would work at Belmont next weekend before shipping to Churchill Downs Oct. 24. "We'll probably do something a little further with Stay Thirsty, and I'm not sure what we'll do with Mo next week," confirmed Pletcher. "We're going into a 1 1/4-mile race off a seven-furlong and a mile race under our belt [with Uncle Mo], so we want to make sure that we're fit enough and I think we made a big step in that direction today. [Leaving] Monday [Oct. 24] is the schedule at the moment, with one work at Churchill Downs."

Mott Team Readies at Churchill...

A trio of contenders from the barn of Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott--**To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini) (Classic), **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) (Ladies' Classic) and **Courageous Cat** (Storm Cat) (Mile)--worked Sunday at Churchill Downs in preparation for the Breeders' Cup Nov. 4 and Nov. 5. Live Oak Plantation's To Honor and Serve, recent winner of the GI Pennsylvania Derby, covered four furlongs in :50. Internal splits for the exercise were :13.60, :25.60 and :37.60, with a five-panel gallop out in 1:03. The sophomore was accompanied by Rudolph Brisset. "[Assistant] Kenny [McCarthy] had him from the three-eighth [pole] to the seven-eighths in :48-and-three [fifths]," said Mott. "He galloped out strong over there and my guess is he went a little better than :50. It was his first work here and we weren't asking for too much."

Palides Investments' GI Alabama S. heroine Royal Delta also worked over Churchill main track Sunday, covering four furlongs in :48.40. Brisset, who was back in the irons, guided the filly through splits of :13, :25 and :36.80, with a five-furlong gallop-out of 1:02.60. Royal Delta's work tied as the eighth-fastest of 52 moves at the distance. "She's doing well," Mott said. "It was her first work here and she did it very easily. She came back good."

Pam and Martin Wygod and William S. Farish's GI Shoemaker Mile winner Courageous Cat was the fastest of Mott's Sunday workers as he breezed four furlongs over the main track in :48.40, which tied as second-fastest of 52 works at the distance. The 5-year-old worked in company with stablemate Clear Attempt. Also on the worktab for Mott Sunday were WinStar Farm's **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) (GI BC Classic), winner of the 2010 GI Belmont S. and runner-up to Flat Out in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, and Preston Stables' GI Brooklyn H. winner **Birdrun** (Birdstone) (GI BC Marathon), who worked four furlongs in company. Drosselmeyer completed the task in :47.60, the fastest of Saturday's 54 half-mile works, while Birdrun negotiated the distance in :48.40--the sixth-best of the day at the distance.

Brown Outlines Plans...

Trainer Chad Brown's three contenders for the Breeders' Cup tuned up for their future engagements by breezing on turf Sunday at Belmont Park. Martin Schwartz's **Stacelita (Fr)** (Monsun {Ger}), who is being primed for the Nov. 4 GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf, breezed four furlongs in :48.55 seconds. "She breezed a half-mile on the turf course, and she is doing very well," confirmed Brown.

Dayatthespa (City Zip) and **Fantastic Song** (Lemon Drop Kid), under consideration for the GI Breeders' Cup Fillies Turf and the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf, respectively, worked in tandem, completing five panels in 1:04.01. "They breezed a little slow," said Brown. "It was OK, though. I have plenty of time to do some more work with them. They just started off a little slow--a little bit of rider error, to be honest with you. I thought they finished up well and galloped out good." Dell Ridge Farm's **Fantastic Song** was third most recently in the GIII Pilgrim S. while **Dayatthespa** was runner-up in the GIII Natalma S. "Dayatthespa, we're definitely pointing towards the Breeders' Cup," said Brown. "Fantastic Song most likely will go. I would say he would be on the bubble to get into the race. I think he'll get in with his third-place finish in the Pilgrim, but I'm not positive about it."

Not slated to run during this year's championship weekend is Schwartz's GI Diana S. heroine **Zagora (Fr)** (Green Tune), who finished seventh in the Sept. 18 GII Canadian S. "I want to shut her down and give her a little bit of a break," confirmed Brown. "She came out of the race in Canada sound, but her energy level is not where it was in the summer when she was in form. Her coat has changed a little bit. I think she is a little out of season right now. I'll map out a campaign in the spring and get her to Florida early."

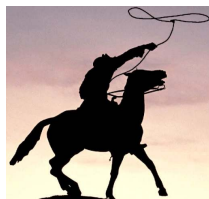

McLaughlin Maps BC Schedule...

Trainer Kieran McLaughlin indicated yesterday that his Breeders' Cup hopefuls will complete major preparations for their respective races at Belmont and ship to Churchill the week of the event. Godolphin Racing's dual Grade I winner **It's Tricky** (Mineshaft), runner-up in the Oct. 1 GII Cotillion at Parx Racing, will be prepared for a tilt at the GI Ladies' Classic, while Mill House's GII True North H. hero **Trappe Shot** (Tapit)--fourth in the GI Vosburgh Invitational--will contest either the GI BC Dirt Mile or the GI BC Sprint. Additionally, Godolphin's Oct. 8 GI Champagne S. runner-up **Alpha** (Bernardini) will target the GI BC Juvenile and Cheyenne Stables' Oct. 8 GI Frizette S. third **Miss Netta** (Street Sense) will focus on the GI Juvenile Fillies. "Next weekend we will work It's Tricky and Trappe Shot," McLaughlin said. "Miss Netta and Alpha are only going to have one work, so that's in two weeks. We think we're going to stay here as long as we can and ship Sunday or Monday of Breeders' Cup week. We have to see exactly what time the fillies have to be on the grounds, but we will do all of our works here." Mill House's **Rattlesnake Bridge** (Tapit), whom McLaughlin named an outside possibility to go to the Breeders' Cup Classic, breezed a half-mile over the Belmont training track in :48.70. Runner-up to Stay Thirsty in the GI Travers S., Rattlesnake Bridge was most recently third in the Sept. 24 GII Pennsylvania Derby. "He looked good and worked well," McLaughlin said. "Probably not [for the Breeders' Cup], but still he's a possibility."



RACETRACK Round-Up

Together Heads Home; QEII Wrap Up...

Mrs. John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Together (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}), who wheeled back off a week's rest to win Saturday's GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland, was slated to fly home to Ireland yesterday as connections mull over a return to the U.S. for the Breeders' Cup. "She came out of the race well and now we'll take her back home," said Kieran Murphy, assistant to Aidan O'Brien. "She didn't have to run very hard, and she was pulling away at the end. She had a great trip and Colm [O'Donoghue] rode her perfectly. I think she can run even better." Of a possible tilt in the GI Breeders' Cup F&M Turf, Murphy added, "We'll see how she came out of the race back home, and they'll have 10 days or so to make a decision."

A week earlier, Together ran on gamely to finish second against her elders in the GI First Lady S. "We were happy with her the whole time she was here," Murphy said. "We were happy with everything here. The treatment and hospitality we received couldn't have been better."

Tom Proctor, trainer of QEII runner-up **Marketing Mix** (Medaglia d'Oro), had opinions on the winner's prolonged stay. "I wish they hadn't run her back in a week," he said. "My filly was 3 1/2 lengths clear of the rest of them. I would have looked like a superstar." Proctor added of Marketing Mix, "She is good this morning. She will probably go to the farm for a while and then probably start her back at Tampa [Bay Downs]. They have races for her there."

Trainer Jimmy Toner, whose charge **Winter Memories** (El Prado {Ire}) finished a disappointing fourth as the 7-5 pick, confirmed the gray would be shelved for the remainder of the year. "She's good. She's just tired," he said. Graham Motion, who conditions Team Valor International's **Summer Soiree** (War Front), fifth in the QEII, said Hollywood's GI Matriarch S. Nov. 25 could be the filly's next target. "She's fine this morning and will go back to Fair Hill," said Motion. "She might possibly run next in the Matriarch and get back to a mile."

Miss Keller hit the board in seven of eighth starts at four, including a score in the nine-furlong GII Canadian S. over the E.P. Taylor turf course in September and a runner-up finish in last year's running of this race. Not enjoying the same kind of consistency early this season, the bay was sixth on the soggy turf in the Apr. 16 GII Jenny Wiley S. and the GII Nassau S. here June 4. A respectable fourth in the GII Dance Smartly S. over the Toronto-area oval July 10, she failed to close into a pedestrian pace in the restricted De La Rose S. at the Spa Aug. 6. Most recently, the Irish-bred was fifth--beaten three lengths--in this season's Canadian Sept. 18.

"The main thing with him is to get him relaxed," said winning rider Corey Nakatani. Shortly after the wire, Regally Ready ducked towards the rail before being straightened out by Nakatani. "That kind of surprised me. His tendency is to drift to the right, but when he saw the cones, I thought he was going to go to the right. So I shifted to the right and he went left. It's one of those things. I was just thankful he got to the wire first and he didn't get hurt and I didn't get hurt." Looking ahead, Nakatani added, "His first comeback race [at Monmouth Park], he got a little late, but [trainer] Steve [Asmussen] said, 'Don't worry about it. We'll be on track for the Breeders' Cup.' I think this was a great spot for him, and he did what he was supposed to do, going into the [GI] Breeders' Cup [Turf Sprint]."

Having been in the long shadows of the very best in Europe for most of the last year, Campanologist found a new lease on life when bossing inferiors in the G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne last time Sept. 25 and repeated the dose here. Rattling up a brace of successes when diverted to Germany in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Hamburg last August and G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne the following month, the bay had appeared to go off the boil since a notable effort when second to So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 22. Rejuvenated by a trip to Istanbul when runner-up in the Sept. 4 G2 International Bosphorus Cup at Veliefendi, he had looked to have regained his old swagger when toying with the opposition in the Preis von Europa. A confident bet for the San Siro locals as a result of that last impression, the homebred was settled in fourth initially patiently ridden off the pace set by Lord Chaparral. Traveling easily the best in early stretch, he was allowed to stride to the front by Frankie Dettori approaching the furlong marker. As Arrigo started to wind up in behind, Campanologist needed to be ridden out to make it count but was beyond recall by the time that rival hit full stride.

Brought back gently in the G2 Prix Niel over this track and trip last time Sept. 11, he finished off with purpose to be third behind stable companion Reliable Man (GB) (Dalakhani {Ire}) in that Arc prep, but took this easier option instead of the autumn highlight. Allowed to stride past Solemia and into the lead after a furlong, he was able to race well within himself until the final 100 yards, when Christophe Lemaire had to get a shade more serious to hold off that rival. "After we made the wise decision not to run Vadamar in the Arc, this race has always been the target," explained conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre. "We were afraid of a lack of pace, which is why I instructed [jockey] Christophe [Patrice Lemaire] not to hesitate in making the running. It turned out very well as my other horse, Ivory Land, also finished third. We might stop here for the season and wait for next year with Vadamar. Ivory Land might go to Asia if we get invited."

BRITISH CHAMPIONS DAY ASCOT • OCTOBER 15

Upgrades Sought for Champions' Day Races...

Next year's British Champions' Day may boast another two Group 1 races if the organizers are granted the upgrade by the European Pattern Committee. With the G2 British Champions Fillies' and Mares' S.--formerly the Pride S. when run at Newmarket--and G2 British Champions Sprint--which was formerly staged as the Diadem S.--having exceeded the benchmark average rating of 110 for three consecutive years, applications have been submitted for the pair of events to share top status with the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. and G1 Champion S. "Yesterday exceeded our wildest expectations for the inaugural Qipco British Champions' Day with such high-class fields, absolute top-class winners and a record autumn Flat crowd for the modern era," British Champions' Series Chief Executive Rod Street commented. "There is a great deal for us to review over the coming weeks, but one obvious thing we would like to improve is the official status of the two Group 2 races and one Group 3 on the card. Clearly, we would like to have five Group 1s, and after yesterday, I don't think anyone could say that the day does not merit that. Whilst it may be difficult to achieve, yesterday's ratings will have ensured that we made some great strides towards our goal and, as well as applying to upgrade the Fillies and Mares, we also hope that the Sprint might qualify for fast-track elevation given that it does not conflict with the five furlong Prix de l'Abbaye on Arc weekend. Different horses tend to run over five and six furlongs, and there is considerable logic in having a late-season Group 1 sprint over six furlongs as well as five. The G3 Qipco British Champions Long Distance Cup is much more difficult, given the presence of the G1 Prix Royal Oak at Longchamp next weekend, but we would be delighted if it could achieve Group 2 status in the near future. Having had what are arguably the top two stayers in the world finish first and second yesterday, the same one-two from the G1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot, we will have comfortably achieved the requisite rating for the race this year. We are very grateful to the European Pattern Committee to have supported the vision that made yesterday possible, and we look forward to working with them to strengthen further the overall autumn European Pattern."

Barbe Eyes Ascot Return for Cirrus...

Corine Barande-Barbe suggested that Saturday's G1 Champion S. hero **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}) could stage a comeback at Ascot in next year's G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth S. Confirming that the 5-year-old had traveled back with no problems following his career-best win in the 10-furlong feature, the trainer is first looking at the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 11 in a bid to improve on his seventh in that 10-furlong contest last year. "He was perfect after the race, and I don't believe there are any problems," she told *PA Sport*. "He felt very proud of himself after the race, and so are we. We are invited to go to Japan, but I think we will wait and go only to Hong Kong this year. Last season he did both, but he has had a busier year this time, and I think to go to Japan this time would be too much. Hopefully, he can go to Hong Kong, get a better draw than last year and get revenge. Next year he could go back to Ascot for the King George. He has already won by 10 lengths over a mile and a half, so the distance will be no problem."

Immortal Verse Has Far East Target...

Richard Strauss's **Immortal Verse (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) could run again this year following her defeat in Saturday's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. Third behind Frankel (GB) (Galileo {Ire}) at Ascot, the G1 Coronation S. and G1 Prix Jacques le Marois winner will skip the Breeders' Cup, but could travel to Hong Kong or Japan. "Immortal Verse did not finish her race off like we know," trainer Robert Collet told *PA Sport*. "She had a small problem in her preparation and was not 100%. She still ran okay, and even if she was 100%, I don't think we would have beaten Frankel, but I think she can do better than that. Our first option was not to run her again this year, but now her condition is improving, there is a possibility she could go to Hong Kong and Japan. She won't go to the Breeders' Cup."

No Luck for Snow Fairy; On to Japan...

Trainer Ed Dunlop was yesterday ruing the luck of Cristina Patino's **Snow Fairy (Ire)** (Intikhab) following her third placing in Saturday's G1 Qipco Champion S., while confirming her on course for the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup. Meeting traffic in the straight en route to finishing third behind Cirrus des Aigles (Fr) (Even Top {Ire}) in the 10-furlong Ascot highlight, the 4-year-old will be geared towards a defense of her crown in the Nov. 13 Kyoto feature. "She did not enjoy the rub of the green, as she was boxed in and Olivier Peslier had to wait for Christophe Soumillon to make his move on Cirrus des Aigles until he could find an escape route," Dunlop explained. "Our filly was gaining on the first two hand over fist at the end, and just ran out of ground, but considering it was only 13 days since she ran in the Arc it was another Herculean effort. We will see how she comes out of the race, but the plan has always been to try to defend her crown in the QEII Cup and, all being well, that is where she will be heading," Dunlop said.

SAEZ SORE, BUT APPARENTLY OK Taken to the hospital after a spill in Saturday's finale at Keeneland, jockey Gabriel Saez appears to have escaped the incident without serious injury, but is scheduled to be reevaluated today. Saez was admitted to the University of Kentucky Medical Center Saturday night complaining of hip and shoulder pain, but initial examinations came back negative. "He was released [Saturday] night and we went out and got something to eat," said Ruben Munoz, Saez's agent. "He's sore, but his spirits are good. He's a warrior and if it was up to him, he [would have ridden Sunday], but that [did] not happen. We are going to get it checked out again [Monday]. He's got a hoofprint right in the middle of his back." Saez was aboard the 2-year-old filly Irish Exchange (Exchange Rate) when the filly clipped heels with first-timer Coup (Empire Maker) and went down, throwing Saez to the track. Larry Jones, trainer of Irish Exchange, said the filly was fine. "All she is worried about this morning is eating," Jones said. "When we were running down to get to her, we didn't know what to expect, but when we got there, she got up. I had them take her around the screen they had put up to show everybody she was OK. Gabe is going to be fine, too, but he's going to be sore. When we went to get the silks, there was a big horseshoe print right [on the silks]."
