A LEGEND IN THE MAKING?

By just after 3 p.m. today, the hype surrounding **Camelot (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}) will give way to reality as Derrick Smith's exciting prospect is tested in the G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. Whatever the outcome, the build-up to today's renewal was certainly sparked to life by a major gamble earlier in the week that forced the July 14 Leopardstown maiden winner into 11-8 from 5-2. "He did it nicely first time out, he was very professional," jockey Joseph O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "He's had a nice break since then. He's been brought along gently and he seems in good form. I ride him in all his work at home. You'd like to think that he has matured mentally as well as physically since his first run. The ground should be fine. As long as it's not too soft, nobody can have a complaint--it should be beautiful." Aidan O'Brien brought the Sadler's Wells pair Aristotle (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire) here off maiden wins, and it is interesting that the two sons of Montjeu to succeed here, Motivator (GB) and Authorized (Ire), were also having their first runs in pattern company. **Cont. p2**

FLASHPOINT RETIRED

Flashpoint (Pomeroy--Two Punch Lil, by Two Punch), a runaway winner of this term's GII Hutcheson S. at Gulfstream Park ([video](#)) and GIII Jersey Shore S. at Monmouth Park ([video](#)), has been retired with a suspensory tear, Peachtree Stable's founder John Fort revealed. He was under consideration for the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint before the injury was detected. "It's the type of injury that he could come back from, but it would require a good deal of time off," Fort told *TDN*. "The horse is sound and happy. He's certainly the fastest horse that Peachtree's ever owned or

campaigned." Fort continued, "He's a big, beautiful horse, and up to this injury, he had been extremely sound. We're pretty devastated to lose him out of our racing stable." Flashpoint, a son of the multiple stakes-winning mare Two Punch Lil, is a half-brother to Uncle Lee Sam (Exploit), SW-Jpn, \$1,158,866; and Yuwa Hurricane (Mt. Livermore), SP-Jpn, \$471,091. Bred in Florida by Silverleaf Farms, Flashpoint went through the ring twice as a yearling, bringing \$115,000 at Keeneland January and \$100,000 at Keeneland September. The sophomore won three of seven career starts and bankrolled \$271,450 in earnings. THE PLAY AT THE PLATE

A total of 11 Group 1 winners will enter the starting gate for today's G1 Tatts Cox Plate at Moonee Valley, and the market is headed by Sheikh Mohammed's 3-year-old **Helmet (Aus)** (Exceed and Excel {Aus}), who gets a hefty pull in the weights as he tries his elders for the first time. The attractive chestnut completed a sweep of Australia's juvenile events last season for his owner, with wins in the

G1 Sires' Produce S. and G1 Champagne S. to complement Sepoy (Aus) (Elusive Quality)'s victory in the G1 Golden Slipper S. Helmet comes into this off back-to-back scores in the G3 Caulfield Guineas Prelude Sept. 24 and the G1 Caulfield Guineas Oct. 8. Both of those successes came from on or near the pace, and the withdrawal of Descarado (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) should make his life a little easier at the head of affairs this afternoon. Just seven sophomores have succeeded in the Cox Plate since 1970, with an additional 19 running second or third. **Cont. p7**

George Strawbridge's **Fencing** was the subject of a significant punt himself when breaking his maiden in Newbury's Listed Washington Singer S. over seven furlongs last time Aug. 13, and brings proven black-type form to the contest. "He's a nice horse who was going to go to the Royal Lodge, but he got a nasty spot on his back," trainer John Gosden explained. "He's a progressive horse. It's a fascinating race, and we'll know a lot more after. Fencing is very much an unfurnished horse who needs to strengthen and so may not be quite as advanced as a couple of his rivals, but time will tell." Jim Bolger has supplemented **Zip Top (Ire)**, who carries the same silks of Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum as last year's winner Casamento (Ire) (Shamardal). After winning over seven furlongs on debut at Leopardstown June 9, he was sixth in soft ground when dropped back in trip for The Curragh's G3 Anglesey S. July 17. Back with a late-closing third in the seven-furlong G3 Somerville Tattersall S. at Newmarket Sept. 22, he was in front of subsequent G1 Middle Park S. winner Crusade (Mr. Greeley) and Listed Silver Tankard S. scorer Letsgoroundagain (Ire) (Redback {GB}) on that occasion. "We liked his run at Newmarket and he was coming home very well," Bolger told *PA Sport*. "We think he's come on since then. He was finishing off very strongly at Newmarket and the step up to a mile should suit him. The form looks good. They are telling us the ground will be on the good side, so I'd be happy with that."

Godolphin's **Encke** earned his spot with an easy 4 1/2-length success in a mile maiden at Newmarket Oct. 1. "Encke has done well since he won at Newmarket, and his last piece of work went very pleasingly--you could see the improvement," trainer Mahmood al Zarooni said. "He is a [full-brother] to Genius Beast, who won the Classic Trial at Sandown earlier this year, and I think that Encke is going to want a similar distance next season. He is bred to be a mile-and-a-half horse, so a mile is not a problem for him as a 2-year-old. He is taking on some progressive colts, and it looks like a very open contest. Most of them have similar profiles, and I am hopeful that he can run well."

BHA BACK DOWN OVER WHIP; HUGHES BACK

The British Horseracing Authority yesterday announced major changes to the new whip regulations, highlighted by the scrapping of the five-hit rule inside the final furlong on the flat. With several high-profile bans since its introduction last Monday and the move by Richard Hughes to give up all rides after falling afoul of the final-furlong rule on two occasions, British racing's leading authority has relented on some of the most controversial issues. While riders are still only allowed seven hits in the course of a race, these can be administered in the final furlong. Other changes mean that jockeys will not lose their riding fee, just the percentage of prize money if their offence results in a ban of seven days or more. A BHA statement read, "The board is committed to the highest standards of regulation in the sport and ensuring that British Horseracing continues to lead the way in matters of equine welfare. This is a sport not without its challenges, but they will always be outweighed by the sport's strengths. These challenges will best be met--and are being met--by finding a common purpose amongst the sport's participants, and by putting the sport first." BHA Director of Raceday Operations Jamie Stier later added, "We haven't so much come to a compromise, we've acted as a responsible regulator should. We've listened and heard further from our stakeholders during this week, we've then acted quickly in a measured, decisive way and we've gone about implementing the changes as quickly as we were able to. I believe there is a lot of misinformation out there and I would say the rules were properly explained to people. People are entitled to form their opinion and change their opinion as matters progress, but the explanation was full." The Professional Jockeys Association issued their own statement. It read, "The PJA is pleased that the BHA has recognized that the new rules over the use of the whip did require amendments, especially in regard to the limitations on the use the whip in the final furlong and after the last fence in flat and jump racing, respectively, as well as in regard to the forfeiting of riding fees. We are pleased that the impact and the effectiveness of the rules will be constantly monitored, and jockeys will wish to be fully consulted. There are still serious concerns about the level of penalties for minor infringements of the rules. A jockey could still be in breach of the rules and face a heavy penalty for using the whip in the best interests of safety and horsemanship. There are also concerns among Jockeys about the way that the rules may impact differently on flat and jump racing. Discussions among jockeys about the amendments will continue today and over the weekend."

All penalties from last week which would not have resulted under the new rules have been rescinded, which means that Christophe Soumillon now gets his share of the purse from Saturday's G1 Champion S. and that Richard Hughes will be able to ride Strong Suit (Rahy) at the Breeders' Cup. Hughes, who took the Friday opener at Newbury, was duly pleased. "It's great to be back. I'm happy with the change and applaud the BHA for realising the rule that was in place didn't work," he commented. "You don't know if something works until you test it out and they realized very quickly it wasn't going the right way and they've changed it. The penalties are still very severe. It's not as much prize money, as prize money in Britain is deplorable and we get about £80 for riding a winner, but five days off can lead you missing £2,500 in riding fees with someone getting five rides a day. This is a move forward, but the penalties are still very harsh for a very minor infringement."

THE "DIRECT" APPROACH

Never worse than second in her first five career starts, California invader **Mizdirection** takes her show on the road for today's GII Lexus Raven Run S. at Keeneland. The grey filly was second on the dirt at Santa Anita in her debut back in March, then romped by 11 1/2 lengths when switched to the sod at Hollywood in May. The runner-up in the June 18 Manhattan Beach S. in Inglewood and the July 24 GII San Clemente H. at Del Mar, she was freshened after going gate to wire in the Aug. 19 Sandy Blue H. last time out. **Honey Chile** has shown an affinity for the Keeneland strip in the past, taking an allowance by 6 1/2 lengths last fall and running second to Turbulent Descent (Congrats) in the GII Beaumont S. this spring. Third in a black-type affair going five-eighths on the Penn National turf last out Aug. 27, she underlined her preference for the Lexington oval with a bullet five-furlong move in :58 flat Oct. 16.

Undefeated State of Play Preps at Keeneland

State of Play (War Front), who missed the GIII Bourbon S. at Keeneland after spiking a fever, was back in action yesterday morning, working five furlongs in 1:01.60 over the Polytrack. Perfect in two starts, the dark bay was last seen taking the GII With Anticipation S. at Saratoga Sept. 1. The Team Valor International colorbearer clicked off fractions of :13.40, :25.60, :38 and :49.40, and galloped out three-quarters in 1:15.60. "I thought he worked super," said trainer Graham Motion. "He's been sick; he missed a work or two, so there was a fine line between him doing enough and overdoing it, since he's only got one more work before the Breeders' Cup. I was very pleased with how it worked out. I thought it was about as close to perfect as it could have been." State of Play is scheduled to ship to Churchill Oct. 26.

Juveniles Breeze at Churchill Downs

A pair of 2-year-old Breeders' Cup hopefuls stretched their legs at Churchill Friday morning. **Take Charge Indy** (A.P. Indy) drew owners Chuck and Maribeth Sanford from their home in Chicago to Louisville, where he went five-eighths in 1:00.60, a bullet for the distance. His fractions were :12.20, :24, :35.60 and :47.60. The dark bay has made all three starts on the synthetic, most recently running second in the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity Oct. 8, but after witnessing the move, Chuck Sanford said, "I want to see him run on dirt." Adding that the breeze made it worth the trip, he remarked, "You want to make sure he can handle the surface he is going to run on. I had never seen him on an off track and, for the kind of money you are putting up [\$20,000 to pre-enter and \$40,000 to pass the entry box], you'd better make sure he can handle the surface he is running on." Take Charge Indy's connections did have an anxious moment when, just as their colt crossed the finish line, another horse unshipped his exercise rider and veered toward him, but there was no contact, and Take Charge Indy galloped out unharmed. "We dodged a bullet there," trainer Pat Byrne said. "My heart is still pounding. He probably would have gone even faster without that loose horse. It was scary."

Also breezing under the Twin Spires, undefeated **Rocket Twentyone** (Indian Charlie) went six panels in 1:15.60, galloping out seven-eighths in 1:29.80. Regular rider Eddie Razo Jr. was aboard. The winner of the Sept. 10 GIII Arlington-Washington Lassie last time out, she goes next in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.

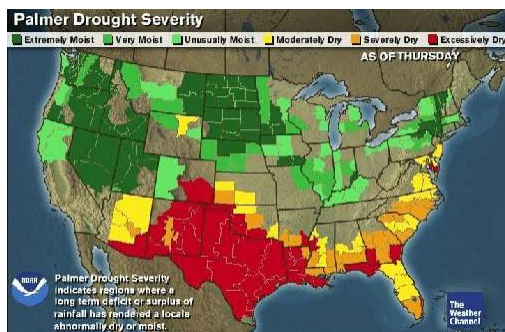

Hay Now: Bad Weather Drives Up Costs for Farms...

From Hurricane Irene's impact on the East Coast to Texas's worst-ever drought, drastic weather conditions this year have presented unique challenges to farms across the country. Many operations are feeling the

pinch in the form of rising hay prices.

"Our hay prices have at least doubled," said Danny Shifflett, manager of Lane's End Texas in Hempstead, about an hour away from Houston in the southeast corner of the state. "I can tell you an

\$8 bale of alfalfa last year is now costing us \$16 to \$23. And that's if you can find it. We're fortunate that we've been dealing with the same supplier for 20 years, so we're first on his list when it comes to availability."

Farms in the Southwest have been affected on two fronts. Hay supply is down, and with demand steady, prices are up. Meanwhile, the hot, dry weather has turned typically fecund pastures to arid grassland, reducing the amount of forage horses can take from their paddocks.

"We've been feeding hay since the end of May," said Shifflett. "In prior years, we never fed hay during the summer. We used to have to cut down on grain feeding because our pastures were in such good shape and the horses would pack on so much weight. Now we're feeding hay and grain just to maintain them. We're feeding roughly 60 resident mares--which is down about 50% from a few years ago--and, with our pastures depleted the way they are, we're feeding anywhere from \$600 to \$800 a day in hay alone."

In Kentucky, an exceptionally wet spring delayed the first hay cutting, while some areas in the upper mid-western portion of the country that supply hay for local farms suffered record flooding.

"It's a problem--and it's always a problem finding good quality hay," said Jim Robinson, who with his wife Pam owns and operates Brandywine Farm in Paris, Kentucky. "In the past four months, prices have gone up about 30-40%, and they're saying they might go up a lot more."

He added, "We've always fed 100% alfalfa, and I don't know if we'd do this or not, but we might have to go to a different type of hay and increase the protein in our feed. And feed prices have got up a bit, too, because corn prices have risen some."

In the Northeast, from New York and into Ontario, bouts of extreme rain in the spring and summer--including a deluge from Hurricane Irene in August--have affected the harvest.

"We're anticipating prices rising through the winter," said Dan Hayden, general manger of Vinery New York. "It's not too bad right now, we're probably about \$20 a ton more expensive than last year." That's still about an 8% jump, and Hayden said even modest increases like that can wreak havoc on a farm's budget.

"The bottom line on a farm is hay, straw, feed and payroll, so any time any of them go up, it's going to affect the farm in a negative way," said Hayden. "People think that when you're charging \$30-\$35 a day that you're making money, but you're not. You're just paying the bills."

The men agree that the hardest part of the rising hay prices is trying to avoid passing on the increased costs to horse owners, who are already struggling in tough financial times.

“It’s a dilemma, believe me,” said Shifflett, who added that Lane’s End has chosen to not raise the day rate for its 60 or so resident mares. “But we’re going to have to deal with those decisions. When we get from 200 to 250 mares to breed in the winter, you have to try to absorb the loss or transfer for the costs. You obviously have to do right by the horses and keep them in the best shape as possible.”



The extreme weather has been especially hard on equine sanctuaries, which rely not on customers paying a day rate, but on donations from supporters. The Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation

(TRF) provides funding for and helps run a number of equine retirement facilities, and is in the unique position of having satellite farms across the eastern half of the U.S.--from Vermont to Oklahoma. Because of its scope, the TRF is perhaps feeling the impact more acutely than others. In a typical year, TRF farms in one region might struggle with weather-related issues while those in another region fare better.

“But this year, there really hasn’t been one place in the country that hasn’t been affected in some way,” said TRF Executive Director of External Affairs Diana Pikulski. “For us, it’s a big-budget increase going into the winter.”

An increase of some 40%, Pikulski reckoned. “A large square bale of timothy alfalfa went from \$7 a bale to close to \$10,” she said.

The TRF, whose fund-raising efforts have already been hampered in recent years by the economy, has been asking donors for help, but with mixed results.

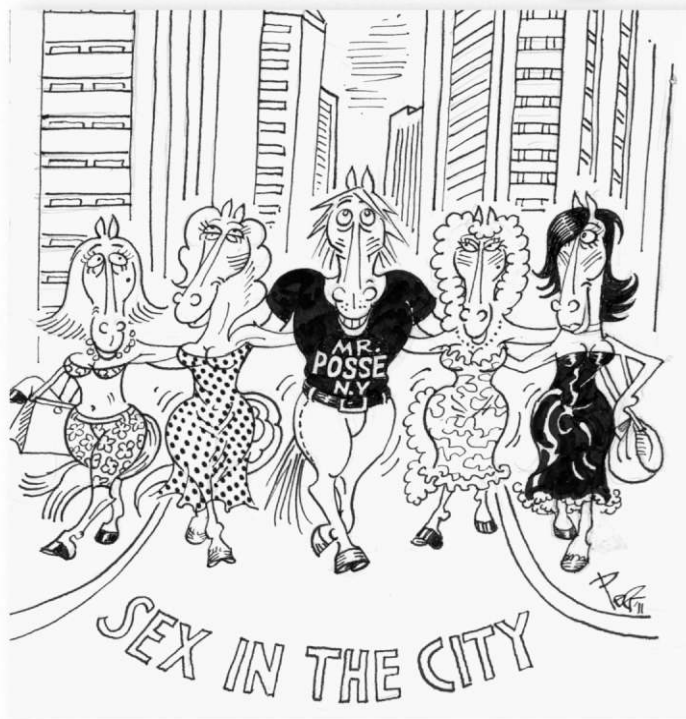
“Out in Oklahoma, especially, where the majority of our permanent retirees are, we’ve launched a special campaign,” said TRF Annual Fund Director Lisa Craig. “There’s been a little help that’s come in, but one thing that we’re hearing from a lot of foundations that typically support us is that their money for the year is already committed. That’s one of the big challenges this late in

the year. The money’s just not there to donate. So we’re between a rock and hard place now.”

Oct. 14. On Oct. 19, allowance winner Newsdad (Arch) set a new standard for 1 1/4 miles, going in 2:00.61. 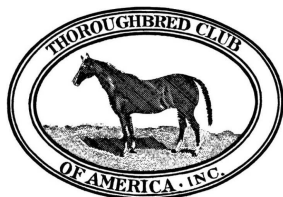

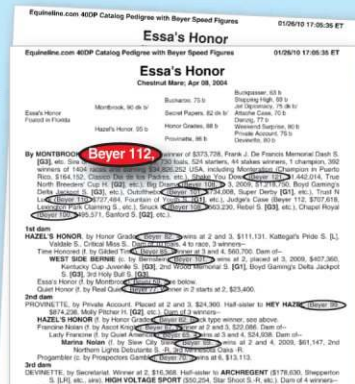

SLOW DAY AT IFFEZHEIM

Trade was subdued during the first session of BBAG's two-day October Mixed Sale which saw returns fall short of last year's main indicators at Baden-Baden's Iffezheim venue yesterday. It didn't bode well for the "Premium Auktion" section, a select draft of 75 lots to open proceedings, when just seven of the first 26 catalogued were knocked down as sold within the first hour. Gestut Karlshof's **Hip 20**, a yearling filly by Soldier Hollow (GB), was the most notable RNA--led out unsold at €40,000--during the early exchanges. However, the mood remained positive and trade picked up soon after. It was not long before Gestut Schlenderhan's **Hip 32**, the 4-year-old gelding **Solidaro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}), headed the way when selling to BBAG's very own Italian representative Peter Franceschini for €38,000. The Jens Hirschberger trainee, who ran fourth in this term's Listed Silbernes Band der Ruhr, is a full brother to G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club e Coppa d'Oro runner-up Salutino (Ger). He is bound for a career over obstacles, and his price was not bettered throughout the day.
