with a facile success under an almost motionless Joseph O'Brien. Off since taking a July 14 Leopardstown maiden in his only previous start, Camelot was held up in last early on. He cruised to **Zip Top (Ire)** (Smart Strike) passing the furlong pole and on to a 2 1/4-length success

without being extended. "I thought I was on the best horse and he never really came off the bridle," O'Brien said. "He's very smart. He was a little bit keen in the first furlong, but he hadn't been out for a while and was fresh. He traveled and did it all very easily."

The Crowning of a Champion...

The 51st renewal of this contest lost a fascinating contender when Godolphin's **Encke** (Kingmambo) was found to be lame yesterday morning, but by the time Camelot had passed the line all the focus was firmly on Ballydoyle's new leading man. Despite creating a striking impression at 1-3 on debut over a mile at Leopardstown, this was a real test of his merit against proven rivals off a subsequent lengthy absence. While the common sense view was that he had something to prove at cramped odds, the significant early gamble suggested that he ranks at the top of the pecking order of a talented crop of 2-year-olds at Rosegreen. Ridden with maximum faith as stable companion St Nicholas Abbey (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) had been in this two years ago, the Joseph O'Brien-piloted bay allowed his barnmate Learn (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) five lengths head start and was only asked to move closer as Kevin Manning tackled the pacesetter with Zip Top. In a matter of strides, Camelot was upon that rival, as **Fencing** (Street Cry {Ire}) tried to make a fist of it out wide, but the winner was barely out of a canter in an impressive show of dominance throughout the closing stages.

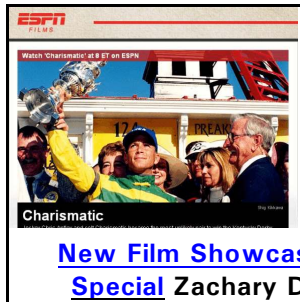
Aidan O'Brien revealed afterwards that Camelot had been hitting the bullseye on the Ballydoyle starometer. "The data we were getting from him at home was showing up as something out of the ordinary," O'Brien told *PA Sport*. "Although you are only reading that stuff, he still had to come here today and prove it. He's a super-quick thinker with a lovely temperament, and he's a joy to have anything to do with. He can do probably whatever you want. The boys will make the decision, but you saw the speed." Zip Top's trainer Jim Bolger added, "The winner is obviously a very smart horse. Our horse has run a good race, and I think he's entitled to improve. I think he'll find improvement into next year. I'd imagine he'll be going to Dubai and [next year] will be up to the people at Darley."

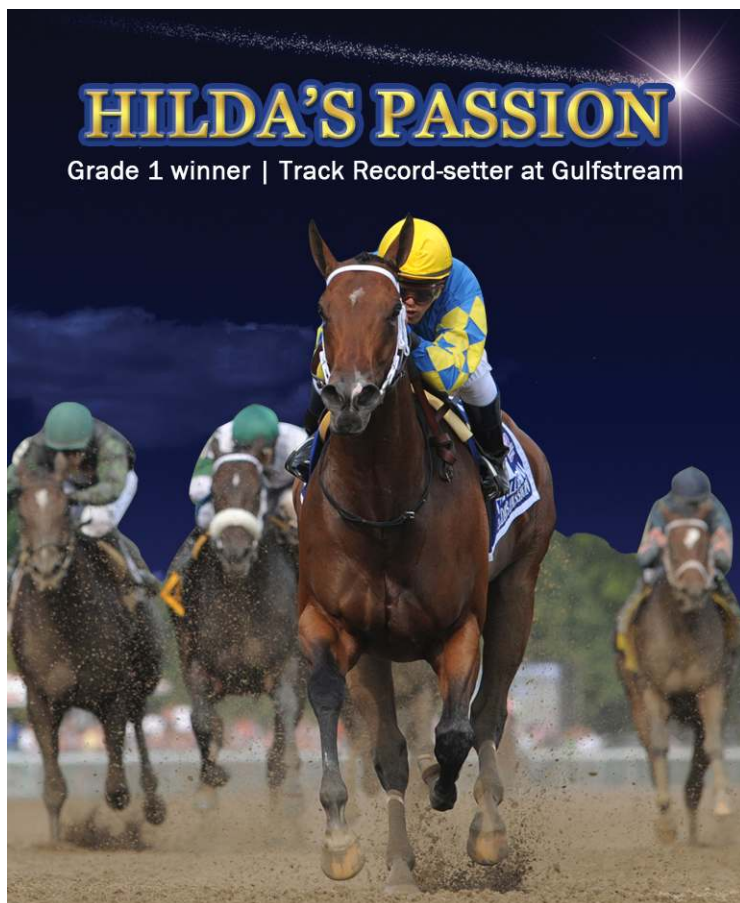

Fifth in the grassy Gil San Clemente H. at Del Mar July 24, Great Hot was a decent third to Mizdirection in that track's Sandy Blue H. Aug. 19 before switching to the Polytrack to take the Sept. 4 Torrey Pines S. She tried older rivals for the first time in a seemingly tough spot, but gave an outstanding account of herself in the GI Lady's Secret S. at Santa Anita Oct. 1, finishing third and just two lengths behind Zazu (Tapit). She tuned up for this return to her own age group with a sizzling three-furlong breeze in :33 4/5 Oct. 13 and was the narrow second choice in the wagering to Roman Treasure (Roman Ruler). Settled in midfield early on, though always in touch with pacesetter Dr. Diamonds Prize (Pure Prize), Great Hot edged forward to be just off the heels of the leaders approaching the stretch. Chantal Sutherland went for an inside run and still had a couple of lengths to make up one furlong down, but Great Hot closed determinedly at the fence and held a last-gasp lunge from Groupie Doll for the victory. Roman Treasure dropped out to last. The winner was purchased in utero for \$75,000 at Keeneland November in 2007. Her second dam is a full sister to Hennessy.

Beaten Up, who garnered an Apr. 16 Ripon maiden by daylight, registered a similarly easy success in a Sept. 9 Doncaster conditions heat last time, and kept his unbeaten record intact with another clear margin success here. He was under hard restraint in rear behind a sedate pace and still raced keenly into the straight. Making smooth headway to challenge passing the two pole, he was cajoled clear to easily take this pattern-race bow. "It was a huge step up for him having won a conditions race, but on his homework, we thought he had a chance, and I'm thrilled to bits with him," said conditioner William Haggas. "God knows what the handicapper will rate us after that, but I guess handicaps are out of the equation. I've no idea what we'll do with him now, but he won't run in England again this year, and I doubt he'll run anywhere. He might go to Dubai [in the spring], but we'll regroup and see. We'll enjoy this victory first."

Consistent throughout a busy first campaign, Tell Dad bagged the £200,000 Tattersalls Millions Median Auction Trophy at Newmarket Sept. 17, but ran second when trying to double up in the Oct. 1 £500,000 Tattersall Millions 2yo Trophy back at headquarters last time. He broke sharpest to seize an immediate lead in this first stakes start since running a below-par 12th in the June 16 G2 Norfolk S. at Royal Ascot. Stoked up to maintain control approaching the final quarter mile, he kept on well under forceful urging in the latter stages to claim a first black-type badge in decisive fashion. "He was always quite tricky and temperamental, but once we gelded him halfway through the season, he's never looked back," revealed assistant trainer Richard Hannon Jr. "He ran very well in two sales races, and now he has won a Group 3. He's been a joy for his owner Andrew Tinkler, who bought his full-brother [for 115,000gns at Tattersalls October Book 2] last week. He's in the [Tattersalls] Sales next week, but I hope that doesn't happen. He can't go for the [G1 2000] Guineas because he's a gelding, so we'll have to find something else...or sell him on a high note."

Runner-up in last month's G2 Stocks S. and in this month's G1 Epsom H., Pinker Pinker took a vital step forward and caused a 25-1 shock with an impressive victory in Saturday's G1 Tatts W S Cox Plate at Moonee Valley. The bay distaffer settled off the pace in a midfield eighth as favored Helmet (Aus) (Exceed and Excel {Aus}) crossed over from his wide alley and led, but she was shuffled back through the pack as the tempo increased inside the final half-mile. Finding a dream rail on the home turn, she angled outside in early stretch and took off once given a couple of flicks of the persuader inside the closing panel to win by a hard-held 1 1/4 lengths from Jimmy Choux, with Rekindled Interest a further half-neck back in third. "[Trainer] Greg [Eurell] didn't give me any tied down instructions and we both had the same game plan from that [outside] draw [in 12]," revealed winning rider Craig Williams, who also lifted last week's G1 Caulfield Cup. "I trusted her, we took the runs when they came and she was great. When we got out, I thought we had to chase down a superhorse in Jimmy Choux, but when I gave her a smack, she just lifted. She is so tough and honest, and to win a race like this in the style that she did is just fantastic." Eurell, who represented Australia at Los Angeles' 1984 Olympic Games, added, "My ultimate goal was to get to an Olympic Games and I didn't think anything would surpass that, but today has."

Beaten under two lengths when fifth defending his crown in the G1 Prix du Cadran here on Arc day, he may have taken longer than connections bargained to recover from a failed attempt at the G1 Tenno Sho at Kyoto May 1. Fifth in the 1 5/16-mile Listed Prix de Reux at Deauville Aug. 2, he flopped in the G2 Prix Kergorlay back there 19 days later before his Cadran effort. His Highness The Aga Khan is represented by two fillies, with Christophe- Patrice Lemaire opting to ride the 3-year-old **Shankardeh**. She showed tenacity to deny **Miss Lago** and gain a first pattern-race score in the G2 Prix Chaudenay at this venue Oct. 1 and has a more progressive profile than the Alain de Royer-Dupre runner **Shamanova**. She was runner-up over 10 furlongs to the subsequent G1 Prix Jean Romanet winner Announce (GB) (Selkirk) in the G3 Prix Allez France at Chantilly May 2, but showed abundant stamina when third in the Sept. 11 G3 Prix Gladiateur over this track and trip. Given too much to do last time when a close-up last of four in the G2 Prix de Royallieu over a shorter trip back here Oct. 1, the homebred continues to give the impression she has more to offer. **Cavalryman** has to prove he retains ability after two dismal displays when failing to beat a rival in the G1 Deutschland-Preis at Hoppegarten July 24 and G1 Rheinland-Pokal at Cologne Aug. 14, but on past form is more than worthy of respect. Third in the Arc two years ago, he forms part of a two-pronged attack from Godolphin, alongside the progressive **Be Fabulous**. She comes here on the back of a win in Saint-Cloud's Listed Prix Scaramouche over 14 furlongs Oct. 6 and hails from the Andre Fabre stable successful six times. Cavalryman's trainer Saeed bin Suroor commented, "Cavalryman has been working well all season, but he never seems to show the same form on the racecourse. We are giving him a chance over a longer trip and I hope that he can run a better race this time."

Orfevre looks to become the seventh horse to sweep Japan's Triple Crown. The last was the great Deep Impact (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), who accomplished the feat in 2005. Orfevre, third in the G3 Kisaragi Sho at Kyoto in February, has been unbeatable since. He won the G2 Spring S. in March, then defied his 10-1 odds taking the 2000-meter G1 Satsuki Sho (Japanese 2000 Guineas) by three lengths at Tokyo Apr. 24. Soft ground didn't derail the train in the 2400-meter G1 Tokyo Yushun (Japanese Derby), a 1 3/4-length victory that came at the expense of runner-up **Win Variation** May 29. After a break, Orfevre once again had that foe in second in the 2400-meter G2 Kobe Shimbun Hai S. at Hanshin Sept. 25. Orfevre now returns to the site of his last defeat trying to etch his name in the record books. Course specialist **Frere Jacques** broke his maiden at Kyoto in May and added an allowance here a few weeks later before shipping to win the G3 Radio Nikkei Sho at Nakayama July 3. He finished third to Orfevre in the Shimbun Hai, and connections hope the move back to Kyoto can help the lightly raced colt turn the tables. **Click for the TVG.com PPs.**

The colt could start in either the GI Grey Goose Breeders' Cup Juvenile or the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. "The track was slow and he put in a workmanlike five-eighths," Romans said. "He was very responsive and energetic. He's a serious horse and he made a move for me in the Dixiana that I haven't had a horse do for me in 10 years." Romans said a decision on which race Dullahan would start in will be made after his work next week.

Fawkes Duo Work With Sprint in Mind...

The David Fawkes-trained duo of defending GI Breeders' Cup Sprint champ and Eclipse Award winner **Big Drama** (Montbrook) and **Apriority** (Grand Slam) each registered five-furlong works Saturday morning at Calder and are on target to square off in this year's short-track event at Churchill. Owned by Harold Queen, Big Drama covered the distance in a bullet 1:00.40 beneath jockey Daniel Centeno while working in company with the Don Disney-owned Apriority, who was given the second-fastest clocking of 1:00.80. "I spoke to my assistant this morning and he told me they both worked excellent," said Fawkes, who was at Keeneland saddle Hot Summer in the GII Raven Run S. "Apriority had to go a little wide and they both had to avoid a pair working in front of them coming down the stretch, but they worked excellent. Pre-entries for the Breeders' Cup are taken on Monday, and we'll make a decision about Apriority then."

Cambina Works for F/M Turf...

Cambina (Ire) (Hawk Wing), dead-heat winner of this year's GI American Oaks, tuned up for the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf with a five-furlong drill over the Santa Anita lawn yesterday. The sophomore filly completed the work in 1:00.20, third fastest of seven at the distance. "It was absolutely perfect," racing manager Mersad Metanovic said of the work. "She broke off cleanly under the exercise rider and she finished up like a train. It was exactly what we were looking for." Trained by Jeff Bonde, Cambina won the GIII La Habra S. in February and the GII Providencia S. in April. She was fourth in the GI Del Mar Oaks and is coming off a fifth-place effort in the Oct. 1 GI Yellow Ribbon S. Metanovic also reported that all systems are go for **Blacky the Bull** (Flashy Bull)'s tilt at the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint after the colt's five-furlong move at Santa Anita last Thursday. Coming off a maiden win in Arcadia Oct. 8, the juvenile worked in 1:00.40 last Thursday. "He came home in :23 flat," Metanovic said. "It was perfect and we're ready to go."

Drosselmeyer Preps for Classic...

WinStar Farm's GI Breeders' Cup Classic hopeful **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) turned in a five-furlong work in company with GII Breeders' Cup Marathon candidate **Birdrun** (Birdstone). The pair, moving in tandem, put up fractions of :25, :36.80 and out six furlongs in 1:14.40. "I liked both of their works," said trainer Bill Mott. Explaining the decision to run last year's GI Belmont S. winner in the Classic rather than in the Marathon, WinStar President Elliott Walden said, "He's a Belmont winner and the Marathon does not matter for him. He has had two good works here and is coming out of a good race. He deserves a chance at the Classic and the mile and a quarter suits him fine." Drosselmeyer is coming off a runner-up effort behind Flat Out (Flatter) in the Oct. 1 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup.

Juveniles on the Work Tab...

Heart of Destiny (Lion Heart), second in the GI Darley Alcibiades S., worked five furlongs in 1:02.60 at Churchill Downs yesterday. The chestnut filly, third over the dirt at Saratoga in her debut, broke her maiden over the turf before her runner-up effort over the Polytrack Oct. 7. She is being considered for either the GI Grey Goose Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies or GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf. "It is hard to say [which surface she is best on]," said trainer Jim Baker. "She has run well on all three surfaces. Lion Heart was mostly sprinters, but the mare [Doc's Destiny] is turf. We'll decide by Monday."

JCM Racing's **Putthebabiesdown** (Closing Argument), third in the Alcibiades, went four furlongs Saturday at Churchill in :48.60 in preparation for the Juvenile Fillies. "She went really well and we're really happy with the time," said Philip Bauer, assistant to trainer Ken McPeck. "The track seems to be playing a little slow, but she handled it well."

Jeranimo Drills for Mile...

Jeranimo (Congaree), who is set to become the first Breeders' Cup starter for trainer Mike Pender, went a half-mile in :47 flat over the Santa Anita main track Saturday morning as he prepares for a start in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile Nov. 5. The 45-year-old Pender is looking forward to the challenge. "The Mile has the best horses in the world," he commented. "I might be a little bit biased of course, but of all the races at the Breeders' Cup, pound for pound I think the majority of people are looking forward to that race. It does have the three-time defending champ Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa)." A Florida-bred owned by B. J. Wright, Jeranimo earned his way into Mile consideration with a 3/4-length victory over Mr. Commons (Artie Schiller) in the GII Oak Tree Mile Oct. 8.

Options Remain Open for Caleb's Posse...

With co-owner Everett Dobson looking on, GI King's Bishop S. hero **Caleb's Posse** (Posse) drilled three-quarters of a mile in 1:13.20 ([video](#)) ahead of his intended appearance in either the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint or the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile at Churchill Nov. 5. Caleb's Posse has been stabled in the Donnie Von Hemel barn at Keeneland since his third-place effort in the GII Indiana Derby Oct. 1. "We were pleased with his work," Von Hemel said. "He finished up the last quarter right around :23 and galloped out well. I'm glad to have that work out of the way and look forward to a couple of weeks." Though both races remain under consideration, Von Hemel said they have a first preference for the Dirt Mile. Caleb's Posse, who is co-owned by Don McNeil, will travel across Interstate 64 to Churchill Downs Oct. 28 and will have his final pre-race breeze Oct. 30 or 31.

Dettori to Miss Breeders' Cup Saturday...

Frankie Dettori will miss Breeders' Cup Saturday after being handed a seven-day suspension at Newbury yesterday. Judged guilty of careless riding after his actions led to the unseating of Harry Bentley in the feature handicap on the card, his ban covers the main part of the action at Churchill Downs, but he will be able to partner G1 Prix de l'Opera victress Nahrain (GB) (Selkirk) in the GI Filly & Mare Turf, one of the featured events on the Friday program.

TWIRLING CANDY INJURED, RETIRED

The Craig Family Trust, Marty Wygod and Will Farish's **Twirling Candy** (Candy Ride {Arg}--House Of Danzing, by Chester House) has suffered a minor injury that precludes his participation in the Breeders' Cup and will be retired to stand alongside his sire at Farish's Lane's End Farm in Kentucky. "It's a slight injury," trainer John Sadler told *Daily Racing Form*, describing it as a strain. "It's not a big thing. He'll go off to Lane's End for his new career. The timing is such that we could bring him back, but he'd need 60 to 90 days off." The 4-year-old was being pointed toward a probable tilt at the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile. Bred by the Sid and Jenny Craig Trust and from the second crop of their Grade I-winning Candy Ride, Twirling Candy was a first-out winner at Hollywood in November of his 2-year-old year.

He didn't return to the races until May of his sophomore year, when he was tabbed a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ after airing by 7 3/4 lengths in an allowance race at the same track. Twirling Candy was odds-on winning both the grassy Oceanside S. at Del Mar and GII Del Mar Derby, and was a 3-5 choice in last October's GI Goodwood S. before losing his unbeaten record in a fourth-place try. He rebounded in a big way, however, scaling back to seven furlongs and nosing out Smiling Tiger (Hold That Tiger) in the GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita. The final time for the race, a dazzling 1:19 3/5, established a new track record. At four, he added the GII Strub S. and GII Californian S. and concluded his career with a head runner-up finish to Acclamation (Unusual Heat) in the 10-furlong GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar. Farish and Wygod bought into the colt in February. In all, he compiled a record of 11-7-1-1 and earnings of \$944,900. Twirling Candy hails from the extended family of Triple Crown winner Affirmed. It's been a tough week for Sadler. On Wednesday, it was announced that Zazu (Tapit), the standout 3-year-old filly he trains for Jerry and Ann Moss, would miss the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic with an inflammation in her shoulder.

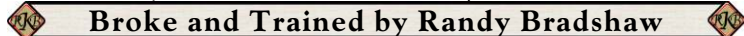
