## ORFEVRE SWEEPS JAPANESE TRIPLE CROWN

Sunday Racing's **Orfevre (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}) was heavily favored to become just the seventh horse to win Japan's Triple Crown, and in front of a thrilled

Kyoto crowd, the exciting chestnut flew home a much-the-best winner over rival **Win Variation (Jpn)** (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) in yesterday's G1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St. Leger). A bit unsettled in a mid-pack position in the early stages yesterday, Orfevre progressed into contention under his own resolve. Four or five wide as they made the right-hand turn into the stretch, he unleashed a devastating turn of foot, sprinting away from the others and racing in splendid isolation to the wire as

jockey Kenichi Ikezoe geared him down in the dying strides. Win Variation closed gamely for place honors as a hail of paper and programs was sent up by an ebullient crowd of 68,289. Orfevre becomes the first horse to win Japan's Triple Crown since Deep Impact (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) in 2005. Orfevre is the first Classic winner for his trainer Yasutoshi Ikee, who also trained his dual champion full-brother Dream Journey (Jpn). Ikee is the son of Yasuo Ikee, who trained Deep Impact, and so the pair become the first father-son duo in Japan to train Triple Crown winners. The younger Ikee was an assistant for his father when he trained Orfevre's sire Stay Gold. "I am both delighted and relieved to have won after all that pressure that we've been through," said Yasutoshi Ikee. "I will have to see how he recovers from this race, but if all goes well, challenges in the G1 Japan Cup or the G1 Arima Kinen are definitely an option. As a long-term goal, I hope to try him for the Arc." *cont. p2*

## BENTLEY SMITH DIES

Bentley Smith, longtime racing manager for Frances Genter, died Saturday in Palm Beach, Florida. He was 88. The highlight of Smith's 30-year tenure as his mother-in-law's racing manager was Unbridled's victory in the 1990 GI Kentucky Derby. In 1987, Smith purchased the future Derby winner for \$70,000 on behalf of the Genter stable out of the Tartan dispersal. The Minnesota native also purchased the colt's dam, Gana Facil, at the same auction for \$275,000. Gana Facil produced Cahill Road the following year and the Genter homebred went on to win the 1991 GI Wood Memorial. The Genter stable also won the 1986 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint with its homebred Smile. Smith continued to run the stable after Genter's death in 1992 until it was disbanded at the end of 2000. Smith bred and campaigned Unbridled's daughter Oatsee, who went on to produce this year's GI Preakness S. winner Shackleford (Forestry), as well as multiple graded stakes winner Baghdadia (Royal Academy). Oatsee's daughter Lady Joanne (Orientate) carried Smith's yellow colors to victory in the 2007 GI Alabama S. Funeral arrangements are pending.

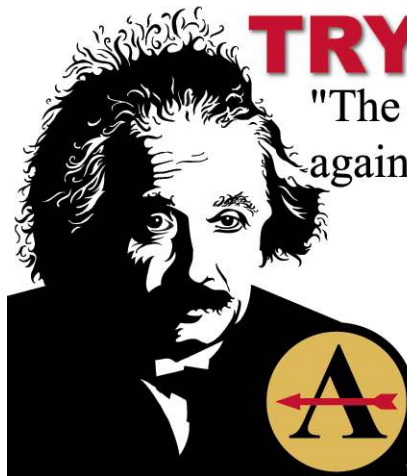

Having opened her black-type account in the  
 14-furlong Listed Prix Scaramouche at Saint-Cloud last

Tested at listed level as a result in the Prix Scaramouche, Be Fabulous dealt with a trio of black-type performers in Pouvoir Absolu (GB) (Sadler's Wells), Balaythous (Fr) (Bahhare) and Tac de Boistron (Fr) (Take Risks {Fr}) in a manner that suggested she was ready for this elevation. Settled in mid-pack early by Maxime Guyon, the well-backed crowd's choice traveled comfortably with the free-running pacesetter Cavalryman (GB) (Halling) in her sights and led the chase after that long-time leader at the top of the stretch. After gaining control approaching the furlong pole, she was driven out to assert and was beyond reach by the time fellow fillies Miss Lago and Shankardeh arrived with their flourishes. For Andre Fabre, this was a seventh success in the race known as the "French St Leger."

Third in the 2009 G2 Oaks d'Italia, Quiza Quiza Quiza was not tried at this level until the 2010 renewal of this race in which she was fifth. After showing consistency in listed contests and conditions events this spring, the bay was a strong-finishing third in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica May 15. Only seventh over an inadequate mile in the Listed Premio Royal Mares June 19, the homebred was handed two confidence boosts in conditions events Sept. 10 and Oct. 1. Held up towards rear early by a patient Fabio Branca, she was guided towards the stand's side in the straight as Kapitale was committed at the head of affairs. Beatrice Aurore struck the front with a furlong remaining on the other side and looked to have the race in safe keeping, but Quiza Quiza Quiza found a late flourish to overwhelm them in the final yards for a career-best.

**BERNSTEIN DIES** Bernstein (Storm Cat--La Affirmed, by Affirmed) was euthanized yesterday after suffering complications from colic. The 14-year-old stallion had been standing at Castleton Lyons. "Today is a very sad day for all of us on the farm as Bernstein was a very special stallion that in an all-too brief career at stud has sired top-class horses throughout the world," Castleton Lyons President Shane Ryan said in a statement. "I would like to thank Doctors Nathan Slovis, Laura Werner and Dwayne Rodgerson of Hagyard Equine Medical Institute and the management and staff of Castleton Lyons for their great efforts to try and save Bernstein today. I would also like to thank all of our clients that supported this stallion and I would hope that Bernstein's influence in the bloodstock world will be felt for many years to come." A two-time group winner in Ireland, Bernstein retired to stud in 2001. He is the sire of U.S. Grade I winners Dream Empress and Miss World, as well as Argentinian champions Storm Military (Arg), Storm Marcopolo (Arg) and Storm Mayor (Arg) and Japanese champion Goshawk Ken. From eight crops to race, Bernstein has sired the earners of over \$23 million.

## Pletcher Cup Hopefuls Work

Repole Stable's GI Breeders' Cup Classic hopefuls **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie) and **Stay Thirsty** (Bernardini) were on the track yesterday at Belmont Park for trainer Todd Pletcher. Uncle Mo went six furlongs in 1:13.22 under jockey John Velazquez ([video](#)). "We broke him off at [6 1/2 furlongs] just to get him off in a relaxed fashion," explained Pletcher. "It worked out well. Last week, there was another horse that he had as a target. Today he had a nice open track with no distractions. I liked the way he did it. We were looking for a kind of longer, steadier, more relaxed first part. I thought he broke off really kindly. Johnny had a nice hold of him. He was relaxed and doing it settled. It was a good, rhythmic breeze where he settled into a nice stride. He kind of kept clicking them off exactly the way we'd be looking to do in the Classic, so I thought it was perfect."

The GI Travers S. winner Stay Thirsty covered five furlongs in 1:01.01 with Javier Castellano up ([video](#)). He worked in company with GIII Bold Ruler contender Caixa Eletronica (Arromanches). "I thought Stay Thirsty worked really, really well," Pletcher added. "Historically, he's not as eye-catching a work horse as Uncle Mo. It was a very, very good solid aggressive work. He finished up well and galloped out great. It seemed like he was very willing throughout. It was set up to be a more serious work [than last week], and it was."

Pletcher was less satisfied with the five-furlong drill of Repole's **Stopshoppingmaria** (More Than Ready). The filly, who is under consideration for the GI Juvenile Fillies or Juvenile Sprint, worked in company in 1:01.41. "I thought it was a little lackluster," Pletcher admitted. "Mike [Repole] and I talked about it a little after the work and it might open up the option of the Juvenile Sprint. We might pre-enter her in both races and take a look. We won't make a decision until she breezes at Churchill." Stopshoppingmaria was tabbed a **★ "TDN Rising Star" ★** after a 9 3/4-length maiden win at Saratoga Aug. 14 and was most recently second as the even-money favorite in the Oct. 8 GI Frizette S. "I thought in the Frizette, she ran well, but it was not as good as we expected her to run," Pletcher explained. "I'm not sure if that had anything to do with the distance, or maybe she was a little flat. We'll maybe rethink it."

### Mile Work for Flat Out


Trainer Scooter Dickey sent Preston Stables' GI Breeders' Cup Classic contender **Flat Out** (Flatter) out for "a strong gallop to put air in his lungs," at Churchill Downs yesterday morning. The 5-year-old, with jockey Greta Kuntzweiler in the irons, was credited with a mile work in 1:43.60 after covering fractions of :13.80, :27, :39.60, :52.20, 1:04.80, 1:18, 1:31.20 and out a mile and an eighth in 1:58.40. "I got him in 1:43 and it was just what we wanted," Dickey said afterwards. "Greta handled it perfectly. If it had been a real work, no telling what he would have done, maybe 1:39 or 1:40, by himself." Flat Out won the July 2 GII Suburban H. and is coming off a 2 1/4-length victory in the Oct. 1 GI Jockey Club Gold Cup.

The filly, aiming for the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic, covered the distance in fractions of :14, :27, :38.60, :50.40 and out six furlongs in 1:15.20 and seven furlongs in 1:29.80. "Royal Delta finished up well and galloped out good," Mott said. "She progressed as the work went on and her last three-eighths was in :35 and change. She moves well over the track."

The Hall of Fame conditioner also sent out Breeders' Cup Classic contender **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini) to work the same distance in 1:02. The GII Pennsylvania Derby winner completed the work in fractions of :13.40, :25.40, :37.80 and :49.60 with out times of 1:15.60 and 1:31. "To Honor and Serve worked very well," Mott added. "He has had two nice works here and it looks like he moves well over the track."

Mott has five horses pointed towards the Breeders' Cup. In addition to his two Sunday workers, he also has **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) (Classic), **Birdrun** (Birdstone) (Marathon) and **Courageous Cat** (Storm Cat) (Mile). "This is where I want to be," Mott confirmed. "All the horses are doing well, but then they have to do it in the afternoon. I have a good feeling. They are all eating well and moving well over the track."

### TATTS AUTUMN OFFERS SOLID FARE

Tattersalls' Autumn Horses In Training, the world's largest auction of horses of racing age, begins this morning in Newmarket at 9:30 a.m. Following an impressive success at Newbury on Saturday, the star lot could come an hour into Tuesday's second session. That's when the 2-year-old **Tell Dad (GB)** (Intikhab) goes through the ring as [lot 444](#). The colt took the 14-runner G3 Horris Hill S. by two lengths Saturday and, after a busy season, boasts prize money earning of over £247,000, helped by a victory in a Tattersalls sales race in September.

The gelded son of Intikhab, owned by Andrew Tinkler, is consigned by Richard Hannon's stable, which offers a large draft also including this season's G1 Golden Jubilee S. second and Goodwood listed winner **Monsieur Chevalier (Ire)** (Chevalier {Ire}), who is catalogued as [lot 427](#).

Other talented sprinters on offer include [lot 88](#), **Humidor (Ire)** (Camacho {GB}), winner of a listed event at Doncaster last month for trainer George Baker. Two-year-olds are always popular at this event, and among those with a high rating is [lot 165](#), **Hestian (Ire)** (Kodiac {GB}), who was trained by Tommy Stack to win a Dundalk nursery in September. The colt was subsequently beaten in Group 3 company.

Meanwhile, the John Oxx-trained **Buffalo Billy (Ire)** (Invincible Spirit {Ire}), [lot 616](#), picked up black-type earlier this month when third in a Dundalk listed contest while racing in the colours of his breeder, Sir Edmund Loder. *Cont. p8*

**F-T KENTUCKY FALL YEARLING SALE BEGINS**

Fasig-Tipton's Kentucky Fall Yearlings Sale kicks off its three-day stand today at the sale company's Newtown Paddocks near Lexington. The sale runs through Wednesday with sessions beginning daily at 10 a.m. A total of 1,007 horses have been catalogued, down 13% from a year ago, when the sale saw modest declines. Last year's average of \$13,616 was down 2.4%, while the median of \$5,000 dipped a more substantial 16.7%. But sale officials see evidence of a possible rebound in 2011.

"The action over the weekend was steady, and there are the faces you want to see, in terms of buyers from all over the U.S.," Fasig-Tipton President and CEO Boyd Browning Jr. said. "I've seen several very nice horses, and we're very encouraged by the strength of the catalogue and the pre-sale interest we've had. I think we're going to have a nice, good sale this week."

There is further optimism that the success of other sales, including last month's marathon Keeneland September auction, will carry over to an event that has seen several high-profile graduates boost its profile in recent years, led by a pair of GI Kentucky Derby winners. Highclere Sales sold Mine That Bird (Birdstone) to Dominion Bloodstock for \$9,500 at the 2007 renewal, a year after Eddie Woods plucked Big Brown (Boundary) from the Monticule consignment for \$60,000. The 2006 sale also saw Dubai Majesty (Essence of Dubai) go through the ring. She RNA'd for \$7,000 from the Kaizen Sales consignment. But last year, after winning the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint en route to end-of-year Eclipse honors, she realized a bit more than that when selling to Katsumi Yoshida for \$1.1 million at Fasig's November Sale.

Browning said those notable successes have made the October sale a viable destination for quality horses.

"There's no question [sellers] are more comfortable and confident bringing a nice horse here, be it one who maybe lacked maturity and needed a little time, or one who had a minor issue along the way," said Browning. "They know there's a really solid marketplace to sell that horse in. The buyers, likewise, are just as confident, because they've seen the success of graduates from the sale. They feed off each other, and one plus one equals three on both sides."

Last year's sale saw nine horses bring six figures. They were led by a Hard Spun filly out of champion Hollywood Wildcat (Kris S.), who was bought by Lakland Farm for \$310,000. Taylor Made Sales consigned the half-sister to War Chant (Danzig) as part of the dispersal of Irving Cowan. Mark Casse, agent, bought the top-priced colt, by Tapit--Classic Woman from Dapple Stud

who went for \$280,000. Last year's top five also included Gun Boat (Congrats), a \$130,000 purchase by Sunset Stables from the Hill 'n' Dale consignment. Gun Boat resold to Fog City Stable and George Bolton for \$150,000 at Barretts May and won at first asking at Del Mar Aug. 6 before running a close-up fourth in the GI Del Mar Futurity Sept. 7. Other FTKOCT grads include the ill-fated but very talented Banned (Kitten's Joy), purchased by Glen Hill Farm for \$130,000 in 2009.

Asked to comment on the current state of the yearling market, Browning added, "I think it's slightly better overall from last year. It continues to be selective, but there seems to be an increase in the overall level of interest, probably helped by the decline in the number of horses that are being presented for sale. It's similar, but slightly improved."

Over the years, he also campaigned Eclipse champion Wayward Lass (Hail the Pirates), as well as Grade I winners Noble Nashua (Nashua) and Key Contender (Fit to Fight), and graded winners like Cosmonaut (Lemon Drop Kid), I Lost My Choo (Western Expression) and Screen King (Silent Screen). 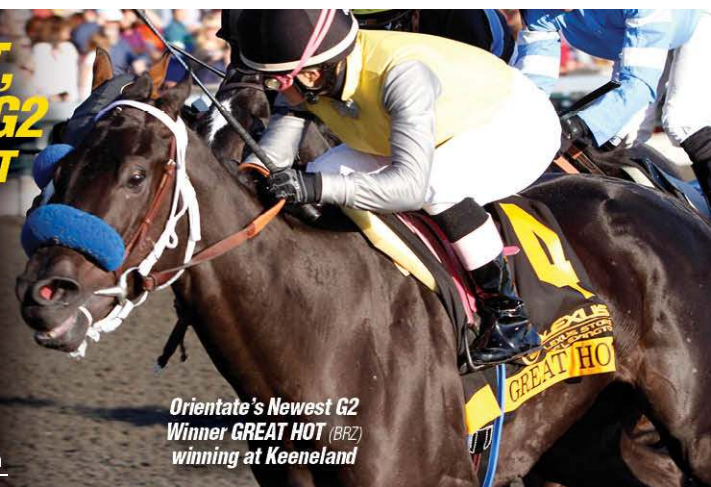

The couple race as Bantry Farms. "I was just overwhelmed; I must have gotten 700 texts immediately," Ewing, a former assistant to trainer Bob Hess, said. "I don't think it's sunk in yet." A lifelong horse lover, Ewing didn't become a racing fan until she and her husband visited Santa Anita about 10 years ago and met Hess. "Within a year, I was in the barn every day--I'm sure Bob was totally annoyed," Ewing told the Keeneland publicity department. I was working in the barn--anything I could to learn racing. I groomed and hot-walked and did anything I could." In partnership with trainer Paula Capestro and Martin Racing Stable LLC, Bantry Farms campaigned River's Prayer (Devon Lane), winner of the 2007 GI Princess Rooney H. When Hess decided to send a division of horses to Keeneland five years ago, he sent Ewing as his assistant. Last year, the California native decided it was time to take out her trainer's license. She currently trains 13 horses. "I'm living my dream," she said. "I love getting up and working with horses. I love the babies. What I really love is to see the progression, because I think you buy hope. I love training them, knowing them inside and out, trying to figure them out, what's going to work and what's not."
