TWO DOZEN ENTERED FOR MELBOURNE CUP

A field of 24 of the world's top stayers, headed by defending champion **Americain** (Dynaformer) was drawn late Friday evening for Tuesday's G1 Emirates Melbourne Cup H. at Flemington Racecourse. After struggling a bit in France this spring and summer, the 6-year-old made a victorious return to Australia in his latest, a 2 1/4-length defeat of **Tullamore (NZ)** (Savabeel {Aus}) in the G2 Moonee Valley Cup over 2500 meters

Oct. 22. Americain will have to overcome a wide alley in 15, but connections are not unduly concerned. "The barrier doesn't matter," part-owner Gerry Ryan told *AAP*. "The girls

looking after him say he's perfect, in the best condition he's ever been in. If that's the case, we can't ask for any more." Americain remains a 3-1 favorite following the draw. His owners also own a 50% stake in **Jukebox Jury (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), another of nine foreign-based horses in the field. He comes into the Cup on the heels of three wins from his last four starts, including the G2 Prix Kergorlay at Deauville Aug. 21 and the G1 Irish St Leger at The Curragh Sept. 10.

Exactly 12 months ago, owner Morton Fink and trainer Charlie Lopresti made their way onto the Keeneland turf course to accept the trophy for Successful Dan (Successful Appeal)'s win in the GII Fayette S., and they were back again Saturday with that one's half-brother Wise Dan. Fourth in a stakes-quality allowance racing seven furlongs over the Churchill main track June 10, Wise Dan switched to the infield and struck from close range in the GII Firecracker H. on Independence Day. He made it two in a row with a half-length success in the valuable Presque Isle Mile over that track's Tapeta surface Sept. 9 and gave a very good account of himself last time out, finishing fourth, but beaten under two lengths, by Gio Ponti (Tale of the Cat) in the GI Shadwell Turf Mile here Oct. 8. Settled four wide while just off the pace set by Decisive Moment (With Distinction) and Future Prospect (Freud), Wise Dan advanced deep on the track to lead at the quarter pole and pulled clear to a handy success. loya Bigtime got a too-patient ride and came home with good energy for the place spot. The victory in Australia's oldest Classic was worth A\$900,000 to his connections. Sabrage was third. Sangster was coming off a head loss to Sabrage in the G3 Norman Robinson S. at Caulfield Oct. 15. Prior to that, he was third in Randwick's G1 Spring Champion S. Oct. 1. "We set this day up six months ago and for it to pay off, it's a dream result," said winning trainer Trent Busuttin. "It's fantastic, I can't describe it. Since we set the horse for the Derby,

everything has gone a dream, and it's just unbelievable that we've got there and done the job." Busuttin added that he had his doubts during the running.

I didn't want to yell until the 100 meters, and as soon as I did Induna came out after us, and I thought, 'Here we go again.'" Busuttin added, "I just want to thank all the people that have helped us along the way, the guys up in Sydney, blokes like Reg Elliot that have given us galloping mates, all the vets and all the farriers. All my team back home."

Glass Harmonium's jockey Damien Oliver tipped his hat to the gelding's connections for wheeling him back. "It was good faith by [trainer] Mike Moroney and owners to persevere and give him another crack," said Oliver. "Nothing much went right for us Cox Plate day, but it all worked out lovely today." Moroney added that, although he has his doubts Glass Harmonium will be at his best over the 3200 meters of the Melbourne Cup, there were six million reasons to take the risk. "I've always had a little bit of a question mark with him over the two miles, but if we're ever going to have a go at it it's the right race, for \$6 million, to do it in and he is nicely weighted," he said. "We'll discuss it between all the owners and make a decision."

Sheikh Mohammed's Sepoy, prominent from the start, took the lead approaching the clock tower and held sway late by a head from fast-finishing Foxwedge. Satin Shoes took the photo for third. Sepoy, last season's G1 Golden Slipper hero, was coming off wins in the G1 Manikato S. Sept. 30 and G2 Caulfield Sprint Oct. 15. "It was a really satisfying win," said trainer Peter Snowden. "He's

had five hard runs, five top runs at the highest level you can get, and he's only still a young horse, so to stay up for as long as what he has it's full credit to the horse.

It's a narrow margin, but believe me it was a really good effort." Added jockey Kerrin McEvoy, "He probably had a little bit of a look when he hit the front--I might have hit the front a little bit too soon--but we wanted to ride him positively like we have been and run those nice sectionals that breaks the hearts of his opposition. It's probably fair to say that he switches on better around a corner when he's got a rail to follow, but it was just well done to the horse getting the job done."

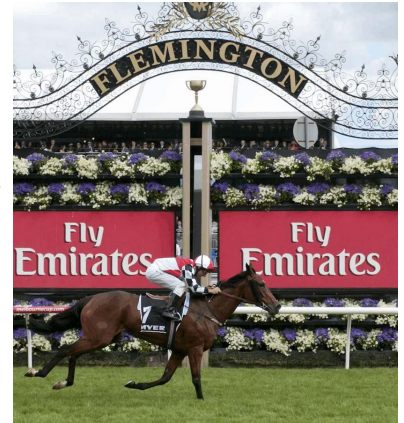

Myer Classic cont.

Hurtle Myrtle, winner of the G2 Dane Ripper S. and G2 Sapphire S. already this season, registered a well-deserved first Group 1 success here. The 5-year-old mare was runner-up in the G2 Premiere S. at Randwick Oct. 1 and ran fifth in the G3 Betair S. at Caulfield Oct. 15 and was a 15-1 chance making her third start of the month. Under jockey Damien Oliver, Hurtle Myrtle put in a big run in the stretch and flashed under the wire a length clear of Sacred Choice.

Heavy Favorite More Joyous (NZ) (More Than Ready) could do no better than seventh. "[It was] a super ride by Damien," said trainer Matthew Smith. "He was confident before the race that even with a bad gate he would get a good run. He rode her beautifully and produced her at the right time. We are a bit more mature now and back up to the mile, we were confident she would run well today, but I can't believe we've won. It's a dream come true. This is what you aim for as a trainer. On this day, to win a Group 1, it's such a thrill. We've got a great crew of owners in this horse and many of them have been with me since I started training, so it's a great thrill to have the success today."

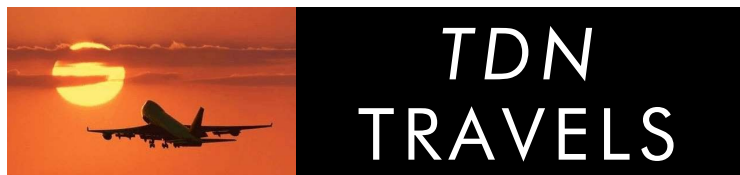

The unbeaten Atlantic Jewel improved to five-for-five with an eye-catching win here. The bay debuted a winner in August, took a pair of handicaps two weeks apart in September, then aired by three lengths as the odds-on choice in the G1 Schweppes 1000 Guineas Oct. 12. Jockey Michael Rodd called her "freakish" after the race, and she doubtfully did anything here to change his opinion, airing by seven lengths while becoming the first filly to complete the Schweppes 1000 Guineas-Wakeful double since Arborea (Aus) in 1993. "My number one aim is to keep her out of trouble," said Rodd this time around. "You don't have to ride a pretty race with a horse like that. She is quite a big filly with a massive stride on her. She just destroys them."



Live From Melbourne, It Is/Was Saturday Morning...

It rained steadily Friday night, and Derby Day dawned grey and cool. But, by the time the races got underway, the ever-changing Melbourne weather morphed into glorious sunshine with a light breeze. The mounting yard is conveniently situated just downstairs from the members' stand, and the horses make their way around the parade ring with the connections watching from behind a rail. The ladies were stylish and the gentlemen dapper under the fair skies--perfect for soaking up the scene. All told, 92,336 went through the turnstiles, about half of them having arrived via train.

The official colors of Derby Day are black and white, and many racegoers duly maintained the color code, but with varying degrees of success. Crown Jewel...

So many thrilling races, including a hugely exciting finish in the main event, the G1 AAMI Victoria Derby, but hands down the most impressive performance came early on the card in a Group 2. Unbeaten **Atlantic Jewel (Aus)** (Fastnet Rock {Aus}), stretching out to 2000 meters following her win in the G1 Caulfield 1000 Guineas over 1600 meters Oct. 12, strode home in imperious fashion. I'm not sure who was behind her, but she quite literally could not have been more impressive while carrying Coolmore's navy blue colors.

"That was a bit arrogant, the way she did that," trainer Mark Kavanagh said about the seven-length success. "I must admit, it was pretty good." The big bay filly was set to have a break after this contest, but is now expected to come back in Thursday's feature at Flemington, the A\$1-million G1 Crown Oaks over 2500 meters. And why not? The sky just might be the limit.

Atlantic Jewel, an A\$320,000 purchase by Demi O'Byrne from the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale, descends from Pass the Peace (Ire) (Alzao), heroine of the 1988 G1 Cheveley Park S. Pass the Peace's Nashwan daughter Nanshan (Ire) was sold from Darley for 110,000gns as a 4-year-old in 1997, and is now the second dam of Atlantic Jewel. Also in the immediate family are Group 1 winners Embassy (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) and King's Apostle (Ire) (King's Best).

Pandemonium broke out in the mounting yard as the owners of front-running Glass Harmonium (Ire) (Verglas {Ire}) realized their big grey would hang on to win the A\$1-million G1 Longines Mackinnon S. "C'mon Glass, c'mon Glass," they chanted. Well done at 7-1! "You should know how much they had on him," a bystander quipped about the relative longshot. Bred by Ballymacoll in Ireland, Glass Harmonium captured the G3 Gordon Richards S. for trainer Sir Michael Stoute in April 2010 before being sold to Australian interests. He hails from the Ballymacoll family of Group 1 winners Spectrum (Ire) (Rainbow Quest) and Petrushka (Ire) (Unfuwain), and his dam is a 3/4-sister to champion Conduit (Ire) (Dalakhani {Ire}).

Main Draw...

The racing wrapped up in the late afternoon and the attention turned upstairs to the Committee Room for the G1 Emirates Melbourne Cup barrier draw. The gathered crowd was a vocal one, with cheers greeting favorable draws, and groans when fancied runners were parked outside. The loudest shouts came when Lucas Cranach (Ger) (Mamool {Ire}) was granted the 11 hole. Luca Cumani saw both sides. His Drunken Sailor (Ire) (Tendulkar {Ire}) got a sweet spot in eight, but Manighar (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}) received 21. "Well, it's not great," Cumani confirmed. "The eight is much better. It will be difficult, but I'll leave it up to Damien [Oliver]--he's in excellent form, and won three races today."

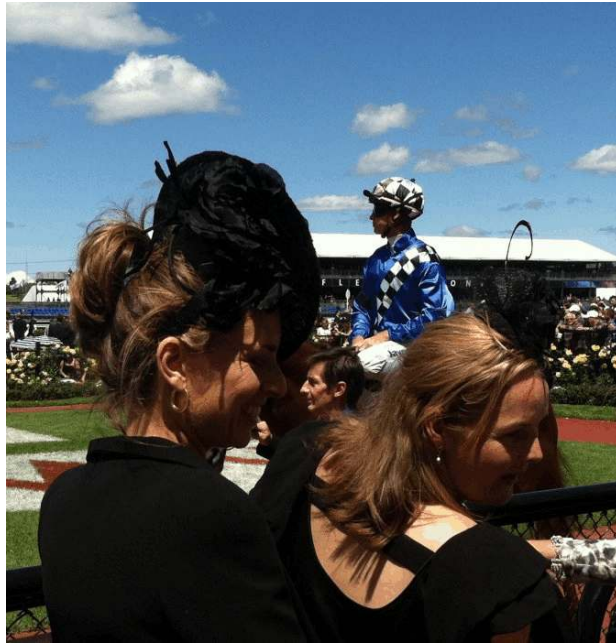

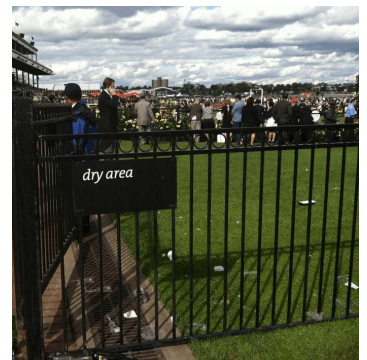

THE LEARNING CURVE

Europe's 2011 2-year-old season is nearing its end, but there are still a few important staging posts left as the Classic picture is steadily put together for next year. Today's G1 Criterium International provides more vital clues. Since its introduction in 2001, the Saint-Cloud feature has been garnered on three occasions by Aidan O'Brien, and he is represented by a sole representative this time in the progressive **Learn**. Returning from a 2 1/2-month break after his Leopardstown maiden win to be fourth after setting the pace in last Saturday's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster, he will provide an early indication as to the true merit of that contest, and of the impressive winner Camelot (GB) (Montjeu {Ire}). He faces a selection of smart home-trained colts without there being an obvious star in the line-up in the mold of the top-class domestic winners Act One (GB), Dalakhani (Ire) and Bago (Fr). **Veneto** boats the best single piece of form, having been fourth in Longchamp's G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere when last seen Oct. 2. Beaten a length by France's leading juvenile Dabirsim (Fr) (Hat Trick {Jpn}) in that seven-furlong contest, he had previously been third after meeting traffic problems behind the subsequent G3 Preis der Winterfavoriten scorer Tai Chi (Ger) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in a conditions event over that track and trip Sept. 8. **Kendam** brings the form of the G3 Prix Eclipse into the equation, but needs to prove she stays this far after winning that six-furlong affair at Maisons-Laffitte Oct. 12, while **Saint Pellerin** is already proven at this distance. Runner-up in the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp Sept. 17, he warrants respect as the chosen representative of the Jean-Claude Rouget stable.

A NEW STAR?

There is little that **TDN Rising Star** **Born To Sea** can do to escape the formidable shadow of his sibling Sea the Stars (Ire) (Cape Cross {Ire}), but the last progeny of the great Urban Sea (Miswaki) bids to wrap up his truncated 2-year-old campaign with a performance to keep dreams of a re-run of recent history alive in an intriguing edition of the G3 Killavullan S. Off the mark in fluent fashion in The Curragh's Listed Blenheim S. over six furlongs Sept. 10, the much-vaunted Tsui homebred has done everything right since that occasion according to trainer John Oxx. "He didn't have too much experience on the grass before the Blenheim, but he was very professional on the day, and he did well to give them a headstart and quicken up past them," Oxx said. "He's bounced out of the race and things have gone well in the meantime. There was always going to be a bit of attention on him, but it's early days, and there is a tendency to over-hype, so we are playing it quietly race-to-race. He has a certain degree of his brother's ability, but we'll see how much." Jockey Johnny Murtagh added, "It's a very competitive Group 3 and a big step up, but everyone wants to see him, and I'm looking forward to riding him again. He has big hoofprints to follow, but he started well and we're all happy with him, and I'm hoping he brings the crowds like his brother did." Aidan O'Brien saddled the subsequent 2000 Guineas hero Footstepsinthesand (GB) to win this in 2004, and he puts forward a fascinating contender in **Nephrite**. The colt took a six-furlong Curragh maiden by four lengths Sept. 25, and that form has been working out well since. **Seanie** impressed when breaking his maiden at 40-1 in the Tattersalls Ireland Super Auction Sale S. over seven furlongs at Fairyhouse Sept. 18 and was too keen when subsequently fourth in the Listed Star Appeal S. over that trip on Dundalk's Polytrack Oct. 7.

Sept. 10. He made some progress from last to finish a well-beaten eighth in Keeneland's GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity S. Oct. 8 and should appreciate the slight cutback to the one-turn mile for this.

Also from the Romans barn, GI Preakness S. hero **Shackleford** (Forestry), preparing for a start in the GI Dirt Mile, drilled five-eighths of a mile in :58.20, the best of 49 moves at the distance. "He worked really well and I'm happy with him," Romans said. "We're ready for Saturday."

Aruna Breezes on Dirt, Plans Still Uncertain...

Flaxman Holdings' **Aruna** (Mr. Greeley), who thrust herself into Breeders' Cup consideration with an impressive victory in the GI Juddmonte Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 9, went five furlongs over the fast Churchill main track in 1:03.80 Saturday morning, with jockey Sheldon Russell in the irons. "Sheldon was very happy with her and he said she handled the track fine," trainer Graham Motion said. "She was not going to have a flashy work this morning regardless of which race she goes in." The work leaves Motion with something of a tricky decision to make between now and Monday's

draw. Aruna is cross-entered in both the GI Ladies' Classic and GI Filly and Mare Turf, with a first preference in the former. "The [11-furlong] distance of the [Filly & Mare] Turf is a concern because she has never done it," Motion said. "I wanted to have her go a mile and a quarter [in the Flower Bowl], but we didn't do it [because of soft turf]. The [Ladies' Classic] was not even on our radar until the race began to fall apart [with the likelihood of Havre de Grace going in the Classic and the withdrawal of Blind Luck]. I would hate to make the wrong decision and run on dirt and have her not handle it." Should she race on dirt Friday afternoon, Aruna will be ridden by Ramon Dominguez. That rider is already booked on Stacelita (Fr) (Monsun {Ger}) for the Filly/Mare Turf, and Aruna would be ridden by Julien Leparoux in that event.

Drosselmeyer, Birdrun Work in Company...

Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor), who will enter the GI Breeders' Cup Classic off a runner-up effort to top contender Flat Out (Flatter) in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 1, and stable companion **Birdrun** (Birdstone), bound for the GII Marathon, went five furlongs in company Saturday morning beneath the Twin Spires, with Drosselmeyer going in 1:01 flat and Birdrun one tick slower. It was the third consecutive Saturday that the duo have breezed together. "I asked the boys to just go a tick slower than they did last week and last week they went in 1:01," Mott said. "It was a very similar work today and they galloped out very good. Maybe they didn't gallop out as fast [as last week], but they were both moving well and they were both doing it on the bridle. Drosselmeyer was up in the bit when he got to the hip of Birdrun. He grabbed onto the bit and looked like he was energetic and willing to go, and the rider was very happy with him." Three other Mott trainees are scheduled for their final workouts this morning at Churchill: **To Honor and Serve** (Bernardini, Classic) and **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker, Ladies' Classic) on the main track, while **Courageous Cat** (Storm Cat, Mile) will work either today or tomorrow on the turf.

Pletcher Fillies Tune Up...

Four fillies from the Todd Pletcher barn got in their final preparations for various Friday races yesterday morning in Louisville. Working prior to the renovation break, Bobby Flay's **Her Smile** (Include) went a strong half-mile in :48.20, the sixth fastest of 62 workers at the distance. She goes in the GI Filly/Mare Sprint. "She worked really well," Pletcher said. "She got over the ground well, finished strongly and galloped out great. I was really happy." Her Smile, the GI Prioress S. winner this past summer, was out five furlongs in 1:00.60 and three-quarters in 1:14.40. **Super Espresso** (Medaglia d'Oro), also owned by the celebrity chef, knuckled down for Friday's GI Ladies' Classic by working five panels in 1:01.80. "I thought she worked well for her," Pletcher said. "She's never been an overachiever in the morning and she sort of lost interest when her workmate fell behind her, but overall it was solid." Pletcher's two hopefuls for the Juvenile Fillies Turf got a feel for the Matt Winn turf course in a company work. Mike Repole's **Stopshoppingmaria** (More Than Ready) and Eclipse Thoroughbred Partners' **Sweet Cat** (Kitten's Joy) went five-eighths of a mile, with Stopshoppingmaria finishing a length in front of her barnmate in 1:04.20. "Stopshoppingmaria went over the turf really well," Pletcher said. "We'll see how she comes back from the work and I'll talk with Mike and we'll make a decision tomorrow [about which race to enter]."

Defending Turf Sprint Champ in Fine Fettle...

Chamberlain Bridge (War Chant), who came from well back to register a mild upset in last year's Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, then a Grade III event, seems to be rounding into his best form approaching this year's renewal, which will be staged as a Grade II. Working around the dogs, he went a half-mile in :50.40 under the watchful eye of trainer Bret Calhoun. "Physically he's as good as he's ever been, but he's not as mentally tough so we wanted to give him plenty of space between races," Calhoun said. "All of his races this year have been pretty average besides his last one. His run [a close third] in the [GI] Turf Monster [Sept. 5] reminded me of his best races, so he seems like he's coming up to another big one. We're looking for the repeat for sure."

Dubawi Heights Breezes An Easy Four Panels...

The 4-year-old filly **Dubawi Heights (GB)** (Dubawi {Ire}) worked four panels in :50 3/5 over Santa Anita's main track yesterday morning as she readies for next Friday's GI Emirates Airline Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf. "It was an easy move," trainer Simon Callaghan said. "She runs in six days and she's got to ship [Saturday], so we were conscious to do it on the easy side. It was just what she needed. It's just a matter of keeping her going. We didn't need to get anything out of her today fitness-wise so I was very happy with her. It was just what she needed." Since coming to the States last year, Dubawi Heights' form is hard to fault. She has been first or second in every start but her U.S. debut. In her last three, she has wins in the GI Gamely S. in May and GI Yellow Ribbon S. at Santa Anita Oct. 1 bookending a strong second to Stacelita (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) in the GI Beverly D. S. over yielding turf at Arlington Aug. 13.

"Larry and I talked over our options with both the Ladies' Classic and the Classic and decided that we will only enter Grace in the Classic," Porter wrote. "We considered entering both so that we could have another option should we draw the one hole or if weather conditions looked better for Friday. We decided that she's earned her way into the Classic and we'd ultimately be dissatisfied if she ran in the Ladies Classic, regardless of the draw or weather conditions. She deserves her shot at writing racing history." Porter said Havre de Grace is bedded down in barn 43 at Churchill Downs after vanning in from Keeneland Saturday. She is scheduled to breeze five furlongs Monday morning around 8 a.m.

Kiaran Quartet Tunes Up...

Before the rains hit in earnest in New York yesterday, trainer Kiaran McLaughlin sent out a quartet of Breeders' Cup contenders over Belmont Park's training track. **Rattlesnake Bridge** (Tapit), prepping for the GI Classic, worked five furlongs from the gate in company with GI Juvenile-bound **Alpha** (Bernardini). The pair, worked in 1:00.83 and 1:00.84, respectively. Calvin Borel was up on the former. "It was nice to get Calvin here to get a feel for the gray horse, because he will ride him Saturday," said McLaughlin. "He's a bit keen, and we want Calvin to take him back like he can do. We hope that he settles toward the rear. Calvin didn't think that would be a problem, so we're glad he worked him." **Trappe Shot** (Tapit), pre-entered in the GI Dirt Mile and the GI Sprint, went a half in :49.83, which prompted McLaughlin to say, "We were looking for just what we got." And **Miss Netta** (Street Sense), who rates an upset chance in the GI Juvenile Fillies, worked a bullet four furlongs from the gate in :46.87 under Rajiv Maragh. How quick was the work? The next fastest of 107 horses to work the distance came in :48.06.

"Miss Netta worked a bit quick out of the gate, but sometimes the gate gets them a bit eager," said McLaughlin. "We wanted to kick her out of the gate after her nightmare day at the Frizette. She came out of it great--we had a good morning." Miss Netta blew the break in the GI Frizette S. at Belmont Oct. 8, but came running to fill the show spot. All five are scheduled to depart Belmont Park Monday by van, arriving at Churchill Downs early Tuesday morning.

Winchester Likely to Miss Turf...

Trainer Christophe Clement said yesterday that Mr. and Mrs. Bertram Firestone's **Winchester** (Theatrical {Ire}), winner of the GI Sword Dancer Invitational at Saratoga over the summer, was unlikely for the GI Breeders' Cup Turf after a bad scope yesterday. The 6-year-old had breezed four furlongs over the turf in :50.62 in company with stablemate Grassy (El Prado {Ire}). "Winchester had a dirty scope after the breeze," said Clement. "I do not like the fact the horse did not have a good, clean scope after the breeze, and I do not like to put pressure on the horse. So most probably we will regroup. Mr. Firestone is leaning against running, and passing on the race, because he is not comfortable running the horse after a dirty scope." Clement said that GI Mile contender **Gio Ponti** (Tale of the Cat) will fly to Kentucky Tuesday.

Sharp Final Work for Amazombie...

GI Breeders' Cup Sprint hopeful **Amazombie** (Northern Afleet) was out early yesterday at Santa Anita, breezing five furlongs in 1:00 2/5 in the pre-dawn darkness at 5:30 a.m. "He went in 1:00 2/5, the last quarter in :23 3/5 and the last eighth in :11 1/5," trainer Bill Spawr said of the 5-year-old, winner of the GI Ancient Title S. at Santa Anita Oct. 8. "He galloped out [six furlongs] in 1:13 3/5. He'll ship Tuesday." Asked about concerns for a possible off track, Spawr said, "We're hoping for a good, safe fast track."

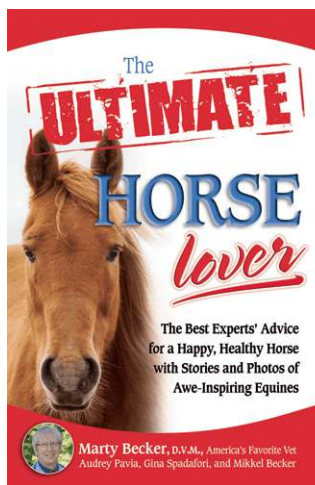
