## QUIET NOW MAKES NOISE AT KEENELAND

Seth Hancock of Claiborne Farm had to wait until nearly the end of Wednesday's third session of the Keeneland November sale, but he was finally able to purchase a mare from the sought-after offerings of Ned Evans's Spring Hill Farm dispersal. Hancock, sitting in the second row of the sales pavilion, outlasted a determined Greg Goodman from Mt. Brilliant Farm, sitting just across the aisle, with a final bid of \$1.85 million to acquire **Quiet Now** (Tiznow-*Quiet Dance*, by *Quiet American*) on behalf of Claiborne and Adele Dilschneider.

It was the session's only seven-figure sale and the 12th offering from the Evans dispersal to break the million-dollar plateau at the November sale.

"I've wanted something from that family for a long time," Hancock admitted. "And I tried, but Mr. [Ben] Leon got the ones on Monday, so I tried on [hip] 746 [Minishaft] and Ned's brother Shel got me on that one. So this was the last gasp. Our backs were to the wall if we wanted something from the family."

Quiet Now ([hip 805](#)) is a half-sister to Horse of the Year Saint Liam (Saint Ballado), as well as to graded stakes winners Congressionalhonor (Forestry) and Quiet Giant (Giant's Causeway) and stakes winner Dance Quietly (A.P. Indy).

Ben Leon's Besilu Stables had a virtual monopoly on the family during Monday's opening session of the sale; he acquired Quiet Dance for \$800,000; Quiet Giant for \$3 million, Quiet Dance's weanling half-sister by Medaglia d'Oro for \$2.6 million and her stakes-winning half-sister Dance Quietly (A.P. Indy) for \$2 million.

The 6-year-old Quiet Now sold yesterday in foal to City Zip. Her first foal, a colt by More Than Ready, sold to Shadwell for \$325,000 at this year's Keeneland September Yearling sale. Her weanling filly by Tale of the Cat followed her into the ring yesterday and attracted a final bid of \$425,000 from Bluegrass Hall. **KEENOV coverage cont. p2**

## DROSSELMEYER DECISION DUE NEXT WEEK

Officials at WinStar Farm will make a decision on the future of GI Breeders' Cup Classic hero **Drosselmeyer** (Distorted Humor) sometime next week, according to a release from the farm. The 4-year-old was originally set to retire to stud in New York in 2012, but those plans have been rescinded, owing to a clause in the contract which allowed for flexibility were the colt to win the Classic. "All options are open for Drosselmeyer, and we expect to make a decision by some time next week," said Elliott Walden, WinStar President & CEO. "Our phone has been ringing off the hook since Saturday's big win, including Mike Smith lobbying to keep the horse in training. So we're weighing all of our options and will do what we feel is best for Drosselmeyer and WinStar." With his victory at Churchill Downs, Drosselmeyer became his sire's all-time leading money winner and took his earnings to \$3,728,170. He joins A.P. Indy as the only horses to win a Belmont and the Classic and is one of just seven horses to win a Triple Crown and Breeders' Cup event, joining the likes of Unbridled, Sunday Silence and Curlin.

"I just loved the family, and she is a nice big mare and I loved the weanling," Hancock continued. "Her first foal was a More Than Ready that Shadwell bought that is going to have a good chance to do something."

Of the final price, Hancock said, "It was way too much money, but we wanted her."

Hancock acknowledged he admired the breeding operation that Ned Evans had assembled.

"Ned Evans would do it like I would like to try to do it," Hancock said. "He kept his broodmare band culled down and he bred his mares to the right kind of stallions. He raced them and he loved them. I thought he was a lot like us and I am happy to have something from his best family."

The Ned Evans dispersal has now become the highest grossing dispersal in Keeneland history. Through the first three days of the November sale, 101 lots have sold for \$49,669,500 and an average

of \$491,777. Adding in the 50 yearlings which were sold at Keeneland in September, the dispersal has sold 151 lots for a gross of \$56,196,500 and an average of \$372,162. -*Jessica Martini*

**Tapit Weanling Ignites Bidding War...**

Ireland's Team Coolmore outbid American bloodstock agent John Moynihan for the rights to a chestnut weanling filly by Tapit ([hip 783](#)) at Keeneland on Wednesday. The \$700,000 price was the highest for a weanling on the day.

Bred in Kentucky by John Antonelli, the Tapit filly is out of Piedras Negras (Unbridled). Piedras Negras' first foal was the brilliant Johannesburg filly La Traviata, whom Coolmore bought for \$1.1 million at the 2006 Fasig-Tipton Calder sale.

La Traviata won her first three starts, including the Gill Victory Ride S., and was the favorite in the 2007 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint. She finished sixth in the Breeders' Cup and never raced again because of injury.

"La Traviata was a very fast filly, and she was just unlucky with what happened to her," said Coolmore's M. V. Magnier. "Demi [O'Byrne] and Paul [Shanahan] loved this Tapit filly, and we bought her to race."

Magnier added, "La Traviata has a Henrythenavigator that's going to Ballydoyle, and it's one of the finest around."

The Tapit filly was consigned by Three Chimneys Sales, agent for John and Marsha Antonelli. -Pete Denk

**Piedras Negras Rewards Antonelli Again...**

John Antonelli and his wife Marsha, California-based commercial breeders, picked up the mare Piedras Negras (Unbridled), in foal to Johannesburg, for \$95,000 out of the 2003 Keeneland November sale. The mare's in utero foal was La Traviata.

Though Marsha Antonelli passed away in September, her husband was able to enjoy the mare's success yesterday.

"I spoke with John and he is thrilled with the sale," said Three Chimneys' Case Clay. "And Coolmore has had tremendous success from La Traviata, so we wish them the best of luck."

Of the price, Clay said, "We weren't expecting that, but when it comes down to two people who love a horse and want it, they are going to bid."

Clay added, "She was all class and a lovely mover. She stood in the sales ring a long time and didn't bat an eye."

**Evans Carries on the Family Tradition...**

Shel Evans was finally able to secure a broodmare from the dispersal of his brother's Spring Hill Farm, bidding \$620,000 for **Minishaft** (Mineshaft--Minidar, by Alydar).

"That's the first full-sized one I've been able to afford," Evans said shortly after signing the ticket on the 5-year-old mare, ([hip 746](#)), in foal to Tale of the Cat. "I've bought some of the weanlings, but those full-sized ones are expensive."

Minishaft is a half-sister to graded stakes winner A Little Warm (Stormin Fever), and to the dam of graded stakes winner Mini Sermon (Pulpit).

Asked what attracted him to the gray mare, Evans admitted, "I actually got on her because I thought she'd be relatively cheap. That turned out to not be

the case, but I was kind of tired of finishing second. Compared to some of them, she was relatively cheap."

While Minishaft is the first broodmare from the dispersal of his late brother's breeding stock that Evans has acquired, he has purchased four weanlings, including a filly by Lemon Drop Kid out of Christmas Gift (Green Desert) ([hip 75](#)) for \$700,000. That weanling's full-sister, Christmas Kid, sold for \$4.2 million Monday.

Shel Evans, chairman of the board of the industrial manufacturing Crane Company, owns Courtland Farm in Easton, Maryland. He has campaigned Grade I winners Sewickley and Shared Interest, as well as graded stakes winners Marsh Side and New Normal.

Evans admitted it was hard to watch his brother's Thoroughbred empire go through the Keeneland sales ring.

"It's very, very hard," he said. "We first came to Keeneland in 1965 to the summer sale and we bought some mares in partnership. We were kids. We've both been in it a long time. It is hard to lose him. He was an inspiration to me in an awful lot of ways."

Still the dispersal of Spring Hill Farm has proven a fitting tribute to Ned Evans, with 12 lots attracting seven figures already at Keeneland November.

"My brother was magic," Evans said. "You can see that at the sale here. It's amazing what he accomplished. That's been verified in the last few days and there is still a lot more to go."

"He was probably one of the smartest people I knew and people who went to school with him and knew him knew that," he continued. "He did an incredible job running Macmillan [publishing group]. And when he stopped doing that, he put most of his efforts into the Thoroughbred business. You take a guy with some money and some brains like he had and put them in the Thoroughbred business, they can make it successful. It was a lifelong work for him." -JM

**Hit Me: Tiznow Mare Brings Session-Topping \$410k...**

The 4-year-old mare **Tizahit** (Tiznow--Never a No Hitter, by Kris S.), selling on a Feb. 20 cover to Indian Charlie, was hammered down to Blue Devil Racing for \$410,000 to star during the early stages of

Wednesday's session. Margaux Farm LLC sold Tizahit as [hip 491](#) on behalf of the husband-and-wife team that campaigned her, Jim and Susan Hill.

The Hills, based in Alberta, Canada, purchased Tizahit

for \$185,000 at the 2008 Keeneland September Sale. Put into training with George Weaver, the filly registered her biggest win in the following year's GII Demoiselle S. at Aqueduct. She was retired at the end of last season with a record of 10-2-2-1 and earnings of \$195,307.

"We first got her last fall, and thought she was very attractive," said Margaux General Manager Jon Carpenter. "She's a big, tall mare with a real nice body."

Tizahit had some family, too. Her second dam is MGSW Jeano (Fappiano), also the second dam of champion and Grade I winner Folklore, another daughter of Tiznow.

The Hills didn't make the trip down from Canada to watch Tizahit sell, but were reportedly pleased with the results. "We didn't quite expect her to go as high as she did; we were pleasantly surprised," said Carpenter, who corrected himself, "Well, going into the sale, we weren't expecting that. But after all the action she got, we were pretty confident we could reach what we reached." -LM

**It's Elementary for Holmes...**

In just over an hour, Tony Holmes was represented by five horses to pass through the Keeneland sales ring and the results had the New Zealander smiling. **Autumn Ash** (Tapit--Crafty Ember, by Crafty Prospector) ([hip 562](#)) got things started when she sold for \$280,000 to the bid of Carolyn Vogel. Holmes and Tim Thornton purchased the mare for \$35,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale.

"I just thought she was priced right," Holmes recalled. "The intention was just to pinhook her. She had just come off the track. Give her some time, I thought, and she'd be a beautiful mare."

The 5-year-old Autumn Ash, a two-time winner on the track, is a half-sister to Grade I winner Pampered Princess (Indian Charlie), prompting Holmes to breed the mare to Indian Charlie before her return trip to the Keeneland November sales ring yesterday.

It wasn't long before Holmes was celebrating again. [Hip 604](#) was a weanling colt from the first crop of multiple Grade I winner Colonel John. Holmes purchased Crystal Shard (Mr. Prospector), with this foal in utero, for just \$23,000 at Keeneland last November. The weanling proved popular yesterday, ultimately selling for \$170,000 to Peter O'Callaghan's Walnut Hill Stables.

"The best one was the Colonel John," Holmes said. "I bought the mother last year carrying him. We've got a gentleman that's been working on the farm forever and I think the world of him. I financed him into a quarter of the mare, so he owned a quarter of that baby." Holmes paused before laughing, "He'll probably retire now. I'll probably lose him."

Completing Holmes's trifecta yesterday was [hip 615](#), a weanling colt by Indian Charlie, who also sold to Walnut Hill, this time for \$210,000. The foal is out of Diamondsareforesta (High Yield), a mare who was purchased by Holmes' Marula Park Stud for \$65,000 out of the 2007 Keeneland November Sale. The weanling was co-bred by Holmes and Tom VanMeter and consigned by VanMeter Sales.

"Diamondsareforesta had a beautiful Indian Charlie foal that died, so I just bred her back to him, because of that," Holmes explained. **Cont. p7**

The foal's final price wasn't a big surprise to Holmes. "Actually, I thought he could bring that, just because he was so nice," Holmes admitted. "He has always just been really nice. And he is actually going through a growth stage now, getting leggy."

Holmes first came to the U.S. in 1984, working for Airdrie Stud manager Tim Thornton. He started Marula Park Stud in 1992. Holmes purchased Heat Lightning (Summer Squall) in 2002, while the mare was in foal to Stephen Got Even. The resulting foal was juvenile champion Stevie Wonderboy. The mare resold for \$1.1 million at the 2005 Keeneland November sale.

The Marula Park commercial broodmare band currently numbers some 25 head and Holmes is always looking for the right opportunity to acquire more mares.

"It's tough to buy," Holmes said of the November market. "And it probably won't settle down. I wouldn't care if I didn't get anything, unless I can find something that I think is real good value. That's when I get excited. You just have to keep a close eye on them."

Despite his success with yesterday's weanlings, Holmes's focus isn't usually on selling foals.

"We never used to sell a lot of weanlings, but we've had a bit of luck with them," he explained. "You've got to sell the ones that are ready to sell, otherwise we'll just keep them over."

For now, Holmes is content to enjoy Wednesday's successes.

"You've got to enjoy it while you can," he said. "They say the tide comes in and the tide goes out. I guess the tide was coming in today." -*Jessica Martini*

***Girolamo Gets With the Program ..***

When Darley made the decision to retire the impeccably bred Grade I winner **Girolamo** (A.P. Indy--Get Lucky, by Mr. Prospector) to the newly reopened Sequel Stallions New York last week, the 5-year-old became arguably one of the best prospects--

by race record and pedigree--to retire to the Empire State in memory. At least, that's the opinion of Chester Broman, who has made a pair of pricey purchases at Keeneland November to support the son of blue hen Get Lucky, dam of graded winners Daydreaming (A.P. Indy) and Accelerator (A.P. Indy), and granddam of Super Saver (Maria's Mon) and Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat).

Broman, who bid unsuccessfully on several mares Sunday night at Fasig-Tipton, bounced back Monday to land [hip 11](#), the MSW & GISP **Spritely** (Touch Gold--Wood Sprite, by Woodman), for \$850,000. The 6-year-old mare sold in foal to Bernardini from the Edward P. Evans draft, which is being handled by Lane's End. Spritely is a half-sister to GSP Sea of Trees (Belong to Me) and to MGSW Ailalea (Pulpit), and earlier this year produced a filly by the latter's sire.

Another who was in foal to Darley's Bernardini, Arradoul is a half-sister to MSW & MGSP Ender's Sister (A.P. Indy) and SW & MGSP Ender's Shadow (A.P. Indy).

Sequel's Becky Thomas, who advises the Long Island-based contractor, said it's exciting to have a breeder like Broman behind her newest stallion. "Chester's has a broodmare band that is absolutely top-shelf, and he is excited about a horse like Girolamo coming to New York--the state has never really had a horse like him," said Thomas, who last week announced that she was re-opening Sequel New York with Dennis Narlinger after a two-year hiatus. Thomas said the impetus behind the reopening was the expected infusion of cash into the New York-bred program from recently installed VLTs at Aqueduct.

Sequel is standing Girolamo on behalf of Sheikh Mohammed's Darley. Wearing the royal blue of Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin, Girolamo won the six-furlong GI Vosburgh S. and one-mile GII Jerome H., and Thomas said his sprinter speed is a huge plus when it comes to standing in New York.

"As a blue-collar horsewoman who relies on the breeders' awards, I really need these horses to run at two," she said. "With Girolamo, you have a stallion who will probably be able to get you a 2-year-old who later will be able to run a mile and an eighth. That's really important in the New York program."

Thomas said that a number of Darley clients are planning to support Girolamo with their "Kentucky" mares, and several other prominent Kentucky breeders have expressed interest. Sequel New York has brought on Mark Toothaker, formerly of Legacy Bloodstock, to assist with bloodstock sales and client relations.

"We're all just really excited and focused on making this a success," said Toothaker.

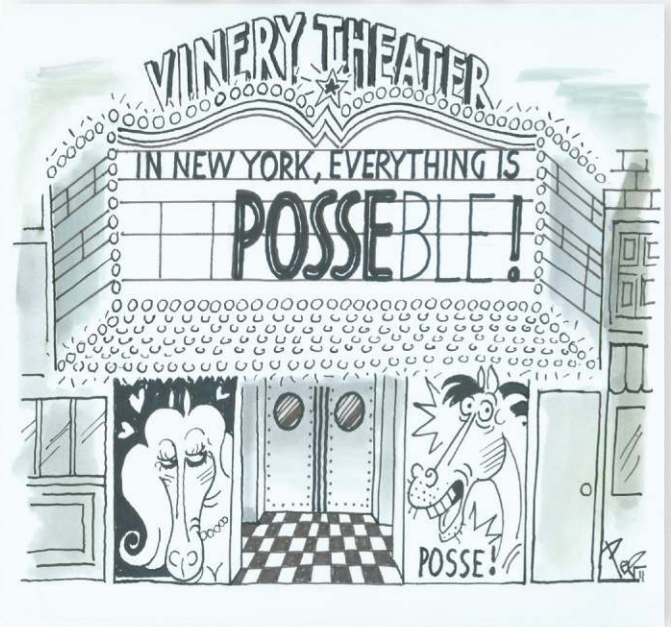
Sequel also stands perennial leading New York sire Freud, the Storm Cat full-brother to Giant's Causeway, as well as the young Noonmark, by Unbridled's Song.

"I wouldn't have sunk so much money into reopening the farm if I didn't think we were positioned for really big things," said Thomas. "I really think we have the best stallion roster New York has ever seen. Freud just couldn't be a better sire. There was a stretch last month where he had a 7-year-old [Future Prospect] win the GII [WinStar] Kentucky Cup S. going a mile and a sixteenth; he had Giant Ryan, who's a 5-year-old, win the GI Vosburgh S.; and he had a 2-year-old filly [The Funky Express] win a 5 1/2-furlong open stakes [Small Wonder S.] at Delaware. And Noonmark was a fast, sound horse who was still around to win a graded stakes at five." -LM

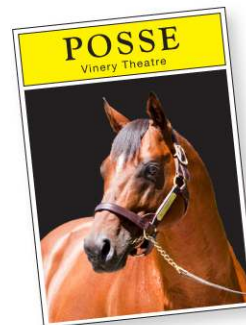

***Bernardini Weanlings Continue to Sell Well...***

Colts by Bernardini accounted for two of the top prices for weanlings yesterday at Keeneland, led by a \$350,000 colt out of Come Together (Dixie Union) ([hip 783](#)).

Brian Graves of Gainesway signed for the Come Together colt under the moniker BG Stables. The price was the third highest for a weanling on the day. Graves said the bay colt likely will be re-offered at a yearling sale in 2012.

"We'll take him home, hope he goes good, and maybe resell him next year," Graves said. "He's a great-looking horse--an athletic horse with a nice pedigree. The stallion averages \$320,000, so I thought it made sense."

The third foal out of Come Together, the Bernardini colt was bred by Fred W. Hertrich III and consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, agent.

Earlier on Wednesday, Everett Dobson's Cheyenne Stables LLC paid \$280,000 for a Bernardini colt out of Sweet Arizona (Gone West) ([hip 476](#)). Cheyenne Stables owns 2011 GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile winner Caleb's Posse (Posse) with Don McNeill.

Brandon and Diannah Perry's Paragon Farms consigned the Bernardini colt out of Sweet Arizona, whom Paragon bought with this foal in utero for \$110,000 at last year's Keeneland November sale.

"The mare had a very good pedigree, and she is a very attractive mare," said Brandon Perry. "I guess she slipped through the cracks. We were surprised when we got [Sweet Arizona] for \$110,000, because she was in foal to Bernardini. Bernardini is a horse we try to breed to every year. Sometimes we can get to him, sometimes we can't. All three of her first foals are winners, but she hasn't produced a great horse yet. Hopefully this is the one."

Paragon, located in Lexington, was founded in 2002.

"Our broodmare band is down to about five. We're trying to focus on quality, not quantity," Perry added.

The Perrys also partner with John and Jill Stephens in Vision Racing and Vision Sales. -*Pete Denk*

**Keeneland November Continues Strong Returns...**

The Keeneland November sale continued to produce strong results during its third session yesterday. Through three sessions, the sale has grossed \$147,028,500 and the average is up a whopping 71.78% to \$271,270, while the median is up 40% to \$140,000. The intense competition for horses from the dispersals of Spring Hill Farm and Palides Investment has only made for stronger demand in Book 2, according to Keeneland officials.

“From the comments that we received after Book 1, a lot of people said that they couldn’t buy anything,” Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell said yesterday. “So they have just been moved back into Book 2, where the top lots have just gotten more competitive. And with competition comes higher prices, inside and outside of the dispersals.”

Demand for weanlings was strong during yesterday’s session, with foals representing three of the top 10 lots. The day’s second-highest priced lot was the \$700,000 paid for a weanling filly by Tapit.

“The weanling market is very strong,” confirmed Russell. “The sentiment is that pinhookers had been outbid by end users for the first two days, so they were very strong today. It was a little frustrating for the first two days, but they hit stride today.”

The November sale continues today at 10 a.m.

The connectivity is not always consistent. In different barns it varies. Cellphones don’t always work here, and the WiFi doesn’t always work, and I just want it to work. Millions are at stake, so let’s get it done. Or we should just go back to [print catalogs].”

“The foal market seems to be quite strong. The good weanlings are making plenty, plenty of money. The mare market seems to be ok as well. To me it looks very healthy.”

**DISPERSALS SPUR 50% INCREASES**

Everybody pretty much knows by now that assessing mixed sales from year to year is difficult because the composition of the catalogues--what's actually for sale--can vary so dramatically. After a yearling sales season which featured the Keeneland September Sale notching up a 26% gain in average versus the 2009 bottom, and the Tatteralls' October 1 sale registering a 32% gain in average over 2010, the first three days of the November sales, Fasig-Tipton's Sunday sale plus Keeneland Book 1 Monday and Tuesday, were up 50% in gross (over \$49-million up) and 71% in average. The three days this year grossed \$147,426,500 (last year: \$98,341,500) and averaged \$405,018 (last year: \$236,967), both huge increases. The joints were jumpin', absolutely no doubt about that, with an amazing total of 35 seven-figure (\$1-million plus) sales--13 at Fasig, and 22 at Keeneland--highlighted by Tuesday's sale of pro-tem 3-year-old filly champion Royal Delta to Benjamin Leon's Besilu Stables (outbidding the sale's second-leading buyer, Frank Stronach's Adena Springs Farm) for \$8.5-million. Besilu took no prisoners during the two Keeneland sessions, buying nine horses--six from the Evans dispersal Monday, three (including Royal Delta) from the Palides dispersal Tuesday--for a total of \$22.4 million. Adena Springs went home with seven purchases totaling \$10.68 million. In all, the two 2011 Keeneland November Book 1 dispersals saw 83 horses sold, for a total of \$80,089,500 and registering an astonishing average of \$969,934. That \$80-million plus represented 70% of Keeneland's entire Book 1 receipts, and 54% of the three-day total of \$147-million, with Fasig added in. Including Fasig, the 281 horses not in the two dispersals which sold over the November Sales' first three days averaged \$239,633. So here's the summary: 83 horses in the two dispersals averaged \$969,934; the other 281 horses not in the two dispersals averaged \$239,633. That statistic becomes even more interesting if we go back and compare non-dispersal prices in 2009 and 2010--again, given the caveat that differences in the catalogues can account for significant variations. In 2010, there were no major dispersals; in 2009, 38 horses from the Overbrook dispersal sold in Keeneland Book 1, grossing \$20,957,000, and averaging \$551,500. If we subtract those from the 2009 three-day total (again including Fasig), this, interestingly, is what the non-dispersal figures look like:

I would call this a pretty interesting discovery. I wouldn't be entirely sure what it means, but it could suggest that there is a specific price level which has been established for non-dispersal mixed sale 'Book 1' (including Fasig November) horses. It may not mean that, but if it doesn't, it's sure an interesting coincidence. Having said that, it may be only a Book 1 phenomenon. The two dispersals, 83 horses, were roughly 20% of the Book 1 catalogue. That means 83 horses, probably of comparable pedigree to last year's Book 1 horses, got kicked back into Book 2; sure enough, halfway through yesterday's opening session of Book 2, the average was up 35% versus last year's third day. Whether that really means comparable pedigrees are up 35%, or if it's a reflection of better horses being kicked back into Book 2, or both, we won't be able to tell for a few days. But one thing is absolutely certain this week: the news from the Lexington sales is good. The higher end of the yearling sales market finished up with 30% gains, and, however we are able to measure it, the momentum is continuing. 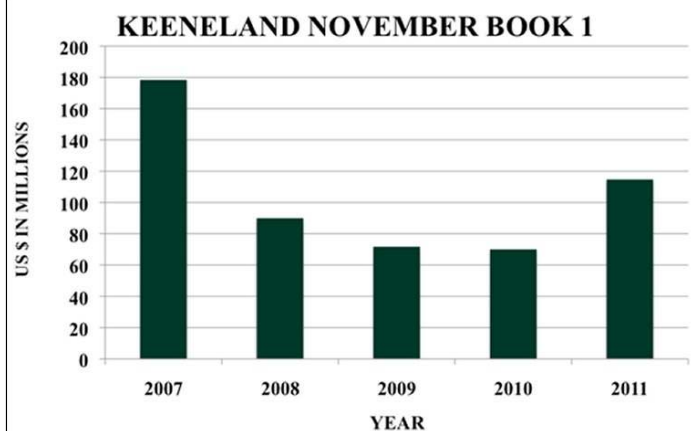

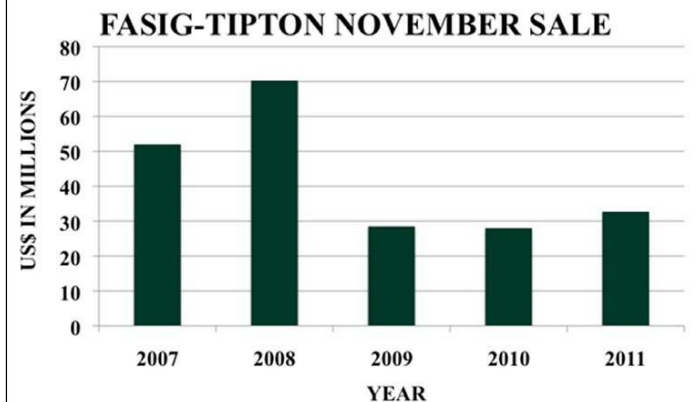

"The pictures tell the story here: yes, the Keeneland Book 1 gross was up 63%, and the average up 86%, from last year; while Fasig, with a more comparable catalogue to last year, was up 17% in gross and 32% in average. Combined, the two sales were up exactly 50% in gross from 2010, and 71% in average. The most important news (aside from 35 seven-figure horses) is that the 2011 bars on the graphs – which are gross – are significantly higher than they've been the last two years. But the two big dispersals had a huge impact, as discussed in the column." -Bill Oppenheim

**DOGWOOD'S COT CAMPBELL TO RETIRE** After forming racing partnerships for Dogwood Stable for 40 years, W. Cothran (Cot) Campbell has announced that he will no longer form partnerships as of Jan. 1, 2012,

but will continue to manage those already in existence. "I suppose my new status could be regarded as 'semi-retirement,'" Campbell said in a statement.

"However, it may well be that Dogwood--in a newly structured form--will continue the formation of new racing partnerships, but my only responsibility will be to see to the servicing of the partners and partnerships that are on the books now." He

continued, "I adore racing horses, and will always keep at it, being involved in a

variety of ways. What a wonderful life I have. However, though I am plenty fit and healthy, I am ready to ease off after doing this since 1971. This move will be no great shock, so it follows that we will be talking with several outfits and individuals that could be part of a restructured Dogwood, hopefully including a couple of key people currently with us." Campbell said that he had contacted the roughly 90 partners (in 43 partnerships), and that they understood his rationale and supported the decision. "We have a wonderful client roster, some partners who have been with us as long as 35 years," he explained. "Many have become close friends. Since we started we estimate that we have brought into racing around 1200 people, and we have certainly bought that many horses." Campbell began to develop the partnership idea in the late 1960s in Atlanta, but, in 1971, bought and raced Mrs. Cornwallis, one of the best fillies of her generation, and was able to give up his advertising business and founded Dogwood Stable in middle Georgia. In 1986, Campbell relocated the entire operation to Aiken, South Carolina. Dogwood has campaigned 76 stakes winners to date, including Classic winner Summer Squall and champion Storm Song. Campbell and his wife Anne were presented with a gold tray from Keeneland Oct. 21 in recognition of their eight graded stakes winners at the historic track.
