### POPE FINDS STYLE TO SPARE AT KEENELAND

For the fourth time in four sessions, yesterday's Keeneland November sale was topped by a dispersal offering. This time it was the dispersal of Hilbert/Menard Thoroughbreds, handled by Lane's End, that went to the top of the list when Mandy Pope's Whisper Hill Farm paid \$575,000 for **Miles of Style** (Storm Cat-Tomisue's Delight, by A.P. Indy). The unraced 4-year-old mare ([hip 1153](#)), in foal to Quality Road, is out of Stephen Hilbert's multiple Grade I winner Tomisue's Delight (A.P. Indy).

"I loved her size and bone," Pope said shortly after signing the ticket on the dark bay mare. "She had a lot more substance than a lot of the Storm Cat mares have."

Miles of Style is a full-sister to GI Maker's Mark Mile winner Mr. Sidney, as well as to multiple stakes-placed Save Big Money.

She was followed into the sales ring by her weanling filly by GI Kentucky Derby winner Street Sense, who sold for \$295,000 to Longitude Farm, agent.

"I liked the baby, so that helped to sell [the mare]," Pope added.

The Whisper Hill broodmare band numbers approximately 25 head and Pope says her focus is increasingly on breeding to race.

"I've mainly been breeding to sell, but more and more I'm becoming involved in the racing," she said. "I've been doing the selling for quite a bit of time and now I want to enjoy the racing and have some homebreds to run. I'm looking forward to that now."

Pope admitted that she has looked at plenty of horses this week, but has found the waters deep.

"I've been doing a lot of shopping, but not too much hand raising and then some unsuccessful hand raising," she said. "It's very competitive for these mares. The first couple of days, we were just blown out of the water. It's totally amazing. There is obviously no recession for the people who bought these mares."

Miles of Style's weanling filly by Street Sense ([hip 1154](#)) was yesterday's top-priced foal. Alec Head made the winning bid of \$295,000 on behalf of daughter Martine Head's Longitude Farm.

"They asked me to come and look at her," Head explained after signing the ticket. "She's a good-looking filly, and it's a very nice family."

Head said the filly would remain in the States to race, but that a trainer had not yet been decided on.

### CARTIER NOMINATIONS ANNOUNCED

G1 Champion S. winner **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire});

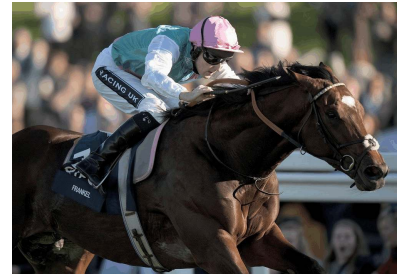
G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine

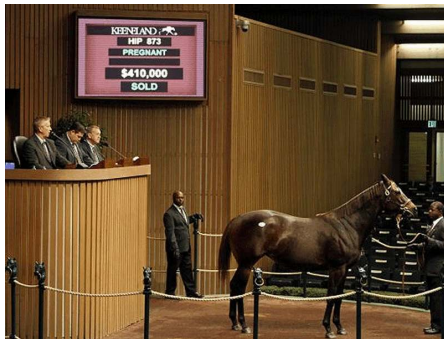


**Something Sumptuous for Stonestreet...**

**Sumptuous** (Hennessy-Belle of Perintown, by Dehere) led early returns at yesterday's fourth session of the Keeneland November sale when selling for \$410,000 to the bid of Stonestreet Thoroughbred Holdings' John Moynihan. The dark bay mare ([hip 873](#)) was part of the dispersal of Ned Evans's Spring Hill Farm.

It was a homecoming for the 6-year-old mare, who was bred by Stonestreet and sold by the farm to Evans for \$400,000 at the 2006 Keeneland September sale.

"She is a beautiful, beautiful Hennessy mare," reported Moynihan. "We actually sold her to Mr. Evans, maybe the first year we started selling yearlings. We always loved her at the farm and Hennessy is a great broodmare sire. [Stonestreet owner] Barbara [Banke] had a little affection for her. She's beautiful and she fits what we're trying to do."

Stonestreet still owns Sumptuous's dam, Belle of Perintown, who has also produced graded stakes winner Strike It Rich (Unbridled's Song).

"Her mother is one of our most favorite mares at the farm," Moynihan continued. "She always has pretty babies, so we're hoping that the daughter has pretty babies for us, too."

Sumptuous, multiple stakes-placed on the racetrack, sold yesterday in foal to Quality Road.

Moynihan admitted the market at Keeneland November is a competitive one.

"It's very difficult to buy," he said. "But we've gotten a few and we love the ones we got."

**Sienna Not Just Looking...**

Representatives from the Florida-based Sienna Farm, standing together out back by the left lead-in chute, landed the day's fifth-highest-priced mare, the well-related **Looking** (Seeking the Gold--Listen Well, by Secretariat), for \$340,000. Craig and Holly Bandoroff's Denali Stud consigned the 4-year-old, in foal on an Apr. 24 cover to Artie Schiller, as [hip 1121](#).

Looking is a half-sister to MGSW Listening (Night Shift), GSW & GISP Beautiful Noise (Sunny's Halo) and MGSW Solar Echo (Spinning World), as well as to the dam of MGSW Listen Here (Gulch).

"We loved the pedigree," said Sal Simeone who, with his wife Colleen, owns Sienna. "We love [damsire] Secretariat,

and the dam's been real solid. She's not the biggest mare in the world, but she's very well-balanced and very elegant. She's exactly what we're looking for, and thought she

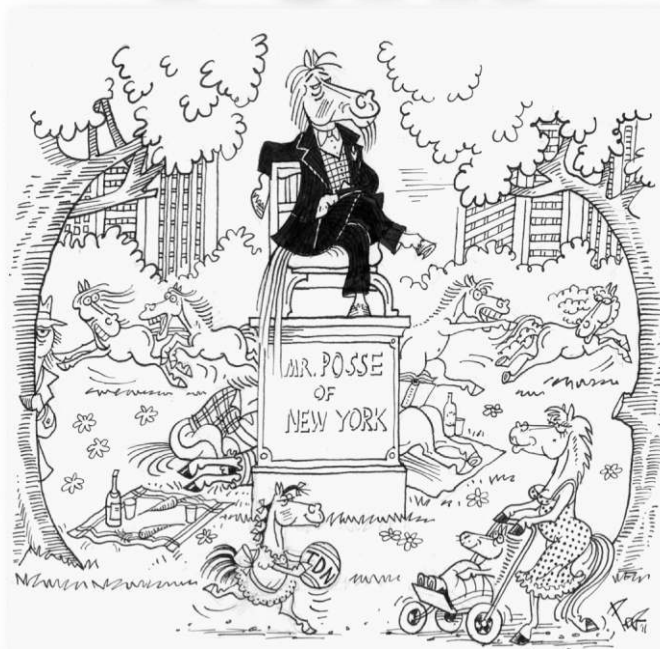

was priced fairly. We expected to pay a little more, to be honest. She was just a little below our ceiling; we thought she'd go from between \$250,000 and \$400,000. I think her size maybe slowed her down."

Sienna Farm is located in Belleview, Florida, not far from Ocala, and is an up-and-coming breeding and racing operation established seven years ago. The Simeones were quick off the mark when they purchased Kimchi (Langfuhr) for \$70,000 as a yearling in 2004, and watched as that one captured two legs of Canada's Filly Triple Crown--the Woodbine Oaks and Bison City--en route to championship honors in 2006. The Sovereign Award winner is one of about 25 mares at Sienna.

"We've been trying to upgrade the quality of our broodmares, and slowly but surely we've been doing that," said Simeone. "We're looking to buy maybe one here."

The Simeones, along with farm manager Tom Drier, had already purchased a pair of mares at Keeneland before nabbing Looking. On Monday, they bought **Erin's Song** (Unbridled's Song--Scapegoat, by Forty Niner) for \$75,000. Taylor Made Sales consigned the 5-year-old, in foal to the farm's Eskendereya (Giant's Causeway), as [hip 107](#). Then on Tuesday, Sienna secured Hard Spun (Danzig)'s half-sister **Bethan** (Giant's Causeway--Turkish Tryst, by Turkoman) for \$250,000. The unraced 3-year-old, selling as [hip 288](#) as the property of Lakland Sales, was in foal to Smart Strike.

Simeone said it's been awfully competitive for the choice lots at November. "Good lord," he smiled. "Today calmed down a little bit, but those dispersals..." He added, "I don't know if it's just the dispersals invigorating the market, but hopefully it's the market coming back. It's a shame it's coming back on us at this moment, but overall it's a good thing."

The Sienna group will be turning their attention even further northward this weekend. On Saturday, the 3-year-old Unbridled Kimanchi, the first foal from Kimchi and coming off a maiden win at Woodbine Sept. 25, goes in the GII Autumn S. at Woodbine. -LM

**Update Gives Walden, Madden \$325,000 Exact...**

A weanling colt from the first crop of the Danzig sire U S Ranger elicited a bid of \$190,000 from Blandford Bloodstock to key a successful mother-son exacta yesterday for Ben Walden and partner Pat Madden. The colt, offered as [hip 925](#), was preceded into the ring by his stakes-winning, graded-placed dam **Affirmed Dancer** (Affirmed--Woolloomooloo, by Regal Intention) ([hip 924](#)), who brought \$135,000 from Robert B. Trussell, Jr. John Stuart's Bluegrass Thoroughbred Services, Inc., consigned both horses, who grossed \$325,000.

The dual transactions took on a particular sheen considering how much Walden had paid to acquire Affirmed Dancer: \$22,000, when selling in foal to Sun King at the 2009 Keeneland November Sale. The difference in price had much to do with the success of Affirmed Dancer's now 4-year-old daughter La Gran Bailadora (Afleet Dancer), a hard-knocking sort who won the Likely Exchange S. at Turfway earlier this season and registered her first graded win in the GIII Kentucky Cup Distaff S. at the same track Sept. 24. The Tracy Farmer homebred also ran a fast-closing third in the GI Spinster S. here at Keeneland Oct. 9.

Walden said that even without the update, the weanling colt would have been a standout. "He was just a special horse--special physicality," he said. "A lot of horses can be muscular and have athletic prowess, but they don't have the movement. A lot of horses can have movement, but they don't have that structure. This horse had both, and that's when they really reach down and pay the money for them. Those are the race horses."

Walden, of course, has a special place in place in his heart for U S Ranger, a stakes winner and Group 1-placed runner who was produced by a three-parts sister to Dynaformer. Walden put together the deal to stand U S Ranger in America at his Pauls Mill Farm in 2009. This summer, it was announced that WinStar Farm, managed by Walden's brother Elliott, had acquired an interest in all four of the stallions standing at Pauls Mills, including U S Ranger, and was relocating the stallions to its Versailles base. Walden, along with breeder Joe Allen and co-owners John Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith, has retained an interest in U S Ranger, and is enthusiastic about the 7-year-old's chances at stud. "His foals are unbelievable," said Walden. "I can feel the momentum building as people start seeing his foals." -LM

**'Long Legs' Kin Brings \$270,000...**

For a Texas couple whose operation is now based in Kentucky, Europe has been very good for Philip and Brenda Robertson. They bred the talented filly Sander Camillo (Dixie Union), a dual group-winning juvenile across the pond, while this year, Daddy Long Legs (Scat Daddy), a half-brother to a mare they owned, enhanced the value of the family with a break-out win over subsequent GII BC Juvenile Turf winner Wrote (Ire) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Newmarket Sept. 24.

With the family riding a hot streak, the Robertsons offered that half-sister yesterday at Keeneland November, and recorded a smart success when the 7-year-old **Tres Dream** (Chester House--Dreamy Maiden, by Meadowlake) made \$270,000. Barry and Judith Becker purchased the mare, in foal on a Mar. 10 cover to Sky Mesa, from the draft of Vinery Sales. Tres Dream sold as [hip 889](#).

"We figured it was the right time to move some horses around and make something happen to generate cash flow," said Philip Robertson. "We thought, with the way [Daddy Long Legs] ran, it might be time to cash in."

Tres Dream's price tag was considerably higher than the first time she sold at Keeneland. Back in 2005, Robertson himself picked her out as a yearling and purchased her for \$30,000 at the September Sale. "I liked her scope and the way she traveled," said Robertson. "At that time, the family wasn't as strong as it is now, but we liked the way she moved and looked."

Put into training with Steve Asmussen and racing for Savorthetime Stables LP and Robertson, Tres Dream recorded her first two wins at Churchill Downs, then aired by over five lengths in the Ponca City S. in August of her 3-year-old year in 2007. She added the Esplanade S. at Fair Grounds later in the season, and after two more black-type efforts at four, was retired with five wins from 16 starts and \$261,970 in earnings.

The Robertsons sent Tres Dream to Stormy Atlantic, and came up with a handsome colt who two months ago sold to Barry and Joni Butzow for \$190,000 at September.

"He was a great-moving horse, just like his mother," said Robertson.

While the Robertsons still live in Texas, the struggling regional market there prompted them to move their commercial breeding operation to Kentucky about a year ago. They rent 80 acres at Overbrook Farm. They have about 15 broodmares, and buy yearling fillies with an eye on eventually adding them to the broodmare band.

"I've had better luck with that than trying to buy colts and turning them into stallions," laughed Robertson. The Robertsons currently have four horses in training with trainers Donnie Von Hemel, Bret Calhoun and the Louisiana-based Brett Brinkman.

The Robertsons bred Sander Camillo and sold her for \$160,000 at the 2005 FTKJUL sale. She won the G2 Cherry Hinton S. and G3 Albany S. a year later, and at the end of her 3-year-old year sold to John Ferguson Bloodstock for 3,200,000gns (\$6,939,408). -LM

**Tapit Colt Goes West...**

A weanling colt by Tapit will be joining the racing stable of Gary and Mary West after bloodstock agent Ben Glass secured the youngster for \$240,000 yesterday at Keeneland. The gray colt is out of multiple graded stakes winner French Park (Ecton Park).

"He's athletic and racy looking and that's what we look to buy," Glass said of [hip 1050](#). "I liked the way that he walked and the rhythm that he had and the way he handled himself. And I love Tapit. So everything came together."

Of the price, Glass added, "I didn't think I'd have to give that much for him. But I actually only bid once."

Glass said the weanling market at the November sale has proven competitive.

"If you lead a good one in there, there is money for them," he explained. "The ones with physical problems, x-ray problems, scope problems, people will say, 'Well, that one didn't bring much,' but it had problems. The ones that are good and go through all the hoops, they are bringing real good money."

The Tapit weanling was bred and consigned to yesterday's sale by Gainesway.

"He is a good colt and was highly popular at the barn," commented Gainesway's Michael Hernon. "He did bear strong resemblance to undefeated GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Hansen (Tapit)."

Tapit was also represented by Wednesday's top-priced weanling, a \$700,000 filly out of Piedras Negras (Unbridled). The Gainesway stallion has attracted a broad spectrum of buyers, according to Hernon.

"Tapit is just a marquee stallion now, he's got international demand and the weanlings here have been bought by top buyers," Hernon said. "Tapit has had 13 stakes winners, two Grade I winners, this year. He's just a remarkable stallion. There is intense demand for his seasons next year and we plan to reduce the size of his book from 150 to right around 125-130, and that is going to be good for the customer base because we are going to tighten up the supply of the product and Tapit's average, as a consequence, will be driven higher."

French Park won the 2005 renewals of the GII Golden Rod S. and GIII Pocahontas S. as a juvenile. Gainesway purchased the mare, in foal to Giant's Causeway, for \$300,000 out of the 2009 Keeneland November sale. Her Giant's Causeway filly sold for \$260,000 at Keeneland September this year.

"[Gainesway President] Antony Beck bought French Park himself," Hernon explained. "She is a young, attractive mare who was a dual graded stakes winner at two—that is significant because we wanted speed. We got a nice Giant's Causeway filly and now she's produced this Tapit colt for us."

French Park is currently in foal to Bernardini.

**Stormy Atlantic Colt to Shahinian...**

Bloodstock agent Steve Shahinian, bidding on behalf of an undisclosed client, paid \$225,000 for a son of Stormy Atlantic out of Forest Lady (Woodman). Asked what he liked about the youngster, who is out of a full-sister to Grade I winner *Ciro*, Shahinian said succinctly, "Everything." He added, "He will likely be pinhooked for an undisclosed client."

Shahinian has found plenty of competition in bidding at Keeneland this week.

"I got outbid on eight horses before I got one," he explained. "It was especially competitive early and especially out of the Spring Hill and Chanteclair consignments."

The Stormy Atlantic weanling ([hip 1046](#)) is a New York-bred and Pat Castello of Paramount Sales, which consigned the colt, thinks that helped his popularity in the ring yesterday.

"It just goes to show you what the New York program is doing," Castello said. "If that horse had been Kentucky-bred, I'm not sure he would have brought that kind of money. But he was a lovely horse. He was a standout. He had every buyer on the grounds on him. It was a great price and we're delighted."

Forest Lady was purchased, with this foal in utero, for \$50,000 by James Moloney at last year's Keeneland November sale.



**Down But Still Up...**

The dispersal-fueled surges in average and median abated some Thursday, but Keeneland November nonetheless enjoyed a strong day of selling with broad participation from international buyers. Average for the session was \$78,855, up 23.4% from 2010 figures, while the median of \$50,000 was up 11.1%. That left the cumulative average of \$209,379 still up some 62.8%, and the cumulative median of \$100,000 up 29.9%. The RNA rate has crept up a bit in each session since Monday's outstanding 83% clearance rate, but Thursday's not-sold rate of 23.7% still indicated that most buyers and sellers were finding common ground. "The sale has continued on well through Book 2, which we anticipated after a strong Book 1," said Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell. "It's very competitive, and a lot of the people who were here for Book 1 are still here. And there's some new faces. Today, there was a strong international presence, with South Americans popping up--Saudis, Turks--as well as a strong domestic bench." Russell said he was optimistic the momentum would carry on into Book 3, which begins today. "Talking to consignors who were showing yesterday and today for Book 3, they said they were very busy," he said. 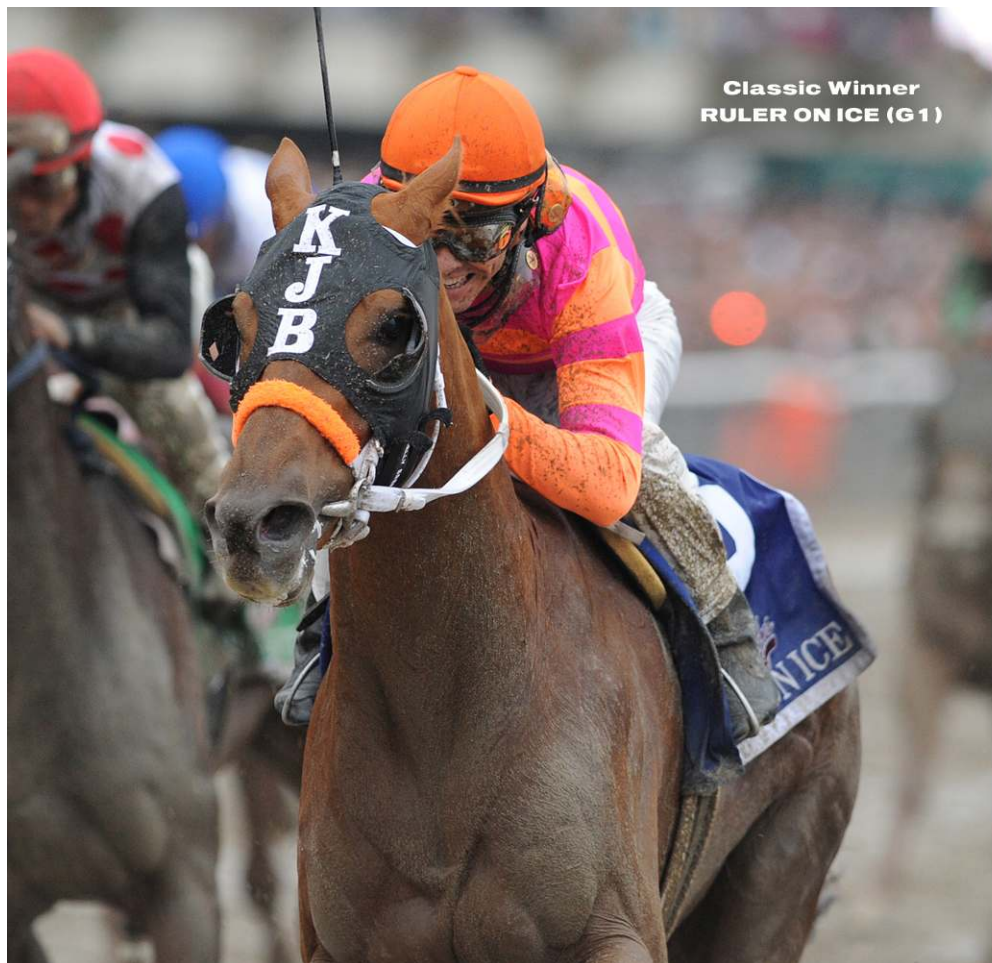

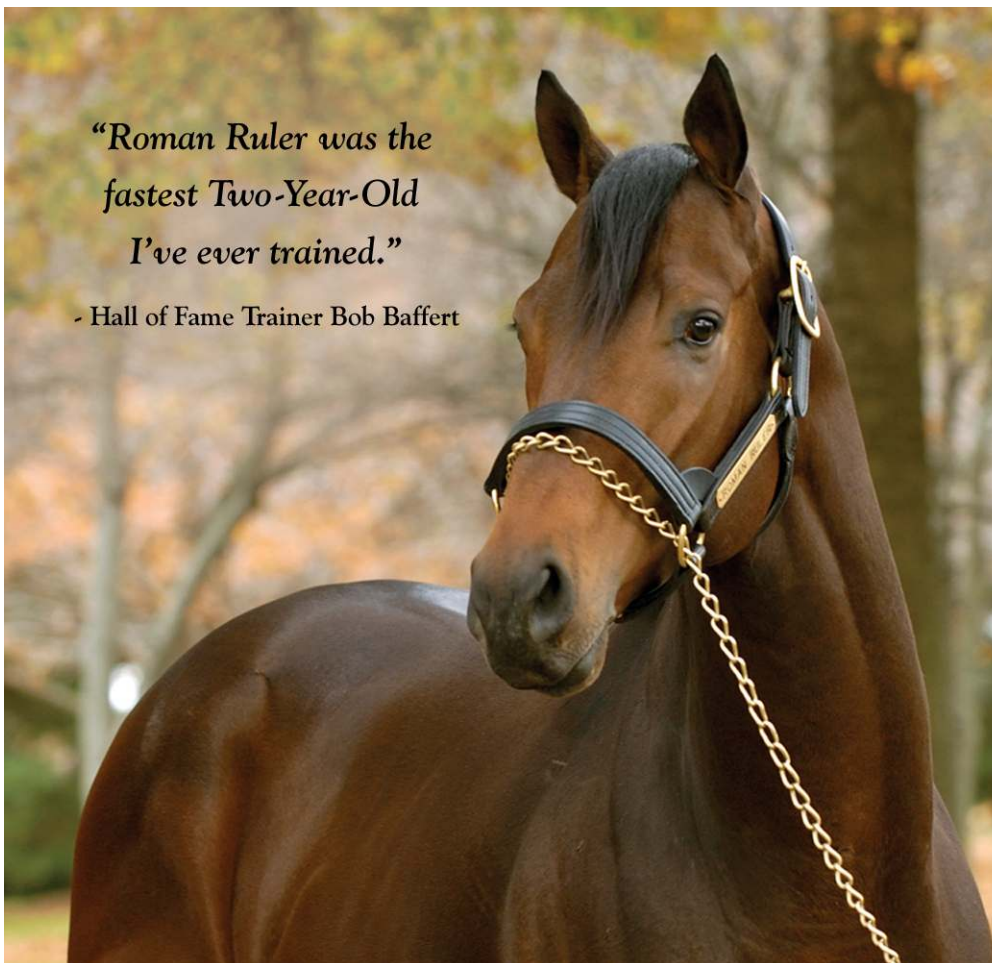

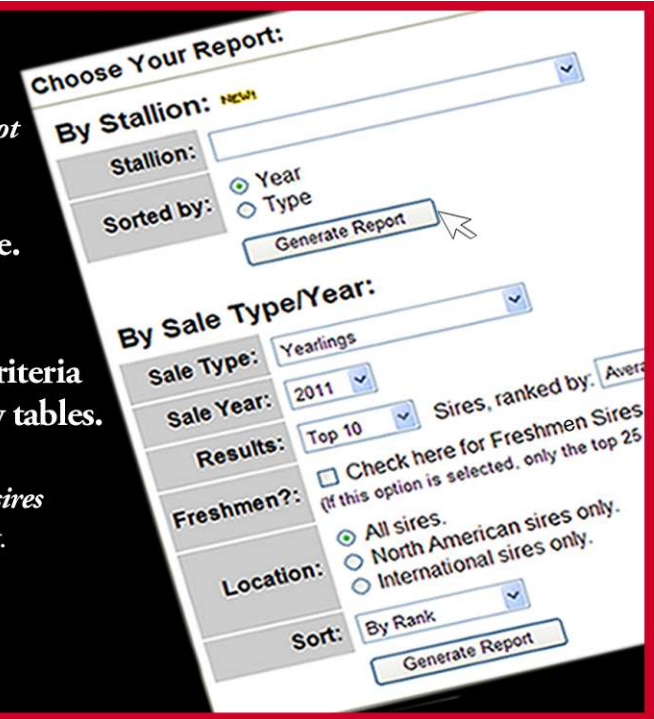

"Both are very talented racehorses and grand-looking individuals by two of the hottest sires in the world." From the first crop of champion Bernardini and the first of his sons to retire to stud, Wilburn was a \$75,000 yearling purchase who matured into a Keeneland April sales-topper when selling to Stonestreet Stables for \$625,000 last spring. The half-brother to GSW Beethoven (Sky Mesa) was also victorious in the Smarty Jones S. and retired with five wins from nine starts and earnings of \$586,515. Victor's Cry had his best season in 2010, adding the GI Citation H. to his Shoemaker success. He retires with a half-dozen wins and earnings of \$762,021. Both stallions, along with the recently retired Tizway (Tiznow) and Court Vision, are available for inspection at Spendthrift.

## ILLINOIS SLOTS BILL FAILS IN STATE HOUSE

A few weeks ago, Illinois Governor Patrick Quinn threatened to veto a bill which would have expanded casino-style slot machines to a handful of satellite facilities, including Chicago airports and the state's racetrack. But the bill never made it to Quinn's desk, as the Illinois State House, which approved the bill with 65 votes this past spring, defeated the legislation this time around with just 58 representatives voting in favor, reports the CBS St. Louis website. An additional two votes were required for passage, though, even with the 65 favorable votes the first time around, there were not enough to override a potential veto from the governor. Democratic Senator Lou Lang, who reserves the right to call the bill again for a vote, was forced to include the slots language in the bill in order to drum up enough support for it, but it did not garner the necessary support.

**On-Track Numbers Up, All-Source Handle Down at Belmont Fall: Edited Press Release**

On-track handle and NYRA Rewards account wagering posted huge gains during the 2011 Belmont Park fall meet and attendance also increased, while all-sources handle declined from last year. On-track wagering on NYRA races during the Belmont fall meet totaled \$41,656,097, up 45.4% over last year's total of \$28,656,204, while attendance increased 4.6% to 133,369 compared with 127,540 during last year's meet, which was 35 days. The 2011 Belmont fall meet was scheduled for 37 days, but only had 35 full days of racing, one day that was canceled after three races due to weather, and another that was canceled prior to the start of racing due to weather. NYRA Rewards account wagering, including wagers made on simulcast races, also demonstrated tremendous growth, with Telebet phone wagering up 216% (\$8,280,728 vs. \$2,620,682) and internet wagering up 234% (\$12,786,902 vs. \$3,825,633). All-sources handle, comprising all wagers made on NYRA races, fell 10.3% from last year's meet, with \$263,037,788 wagered this year as compared to \$293,163,373 in 2010. Simulcast wagering during the Belmont fall meet, comprising wagers made on non-NYRA races, increased 209% to \$37,587,023, up from the \$12,165,718 bet on simulcast races during last year's meet. There were 123 turf races run during the 2011 Belmont fall meet, down 8.2% from the 134 turf races run last year, with 35 races being taken off the turf both years. Total betting interests during the meet numbered 2,756, a 2% drop from last year's 2,812, and average betting interests per race dropped 2.6%, with an average of 8.25 this year compared to 8.47 last year. This year, 334 races were run during the Belmont fall meet compared with 332 last year. **New York Report cont. p4**

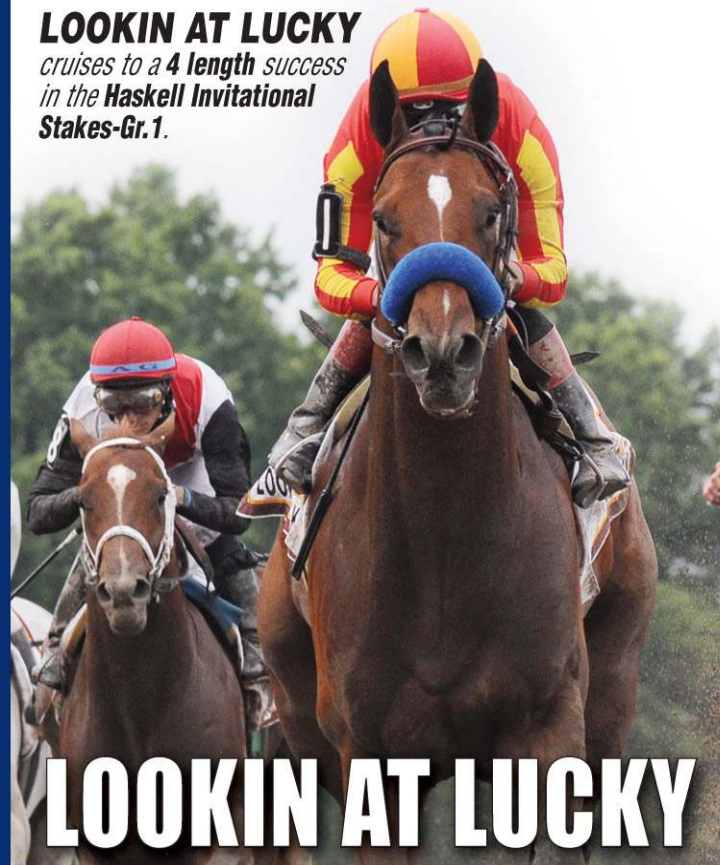

## NTRA REPORT FROM CAPITOL HILL



### MAJOR INVESTMENT INCENTIVES SET TO EXPIRE

Two major investment incentives are set to expire in 2011. These incentives offer tremendous opportunities for those in the market for horses, equipment or other farm additions.

**100% Bonus Depreciation** - allows purchasers to write off the entire cost of new qualified depreciable property if the property is put in service before 1/1/2012. Property is new if its original use commences with the purchaser. Examples of new property include yearlings, barns, and new tractors.

There are no investment limits as long as the property qualifies.

**\$500,000 Expense Allowance** - allows purchasers to write off the cost of new or used qualified depreciable property, up to \$500,000, if the property is put in service before 1/1/2012. The expense allowance applies more to used property this year since 100% bonus depreciation covers new property. An example of used property is a broodmare (pregnant or barren) because her original use was for racing. The purchaser of a pregnant mare simply puts her in service upon purchase; the purchaser of a barren mare must prepare her in 2011 to be bred in 2012.

There is a \$2 million investment threshold for the expense allowance.

**TRF Offers New Foster Care Option:**

Due to growing demand for a retired racehorse foster program for those who do not own a farm, the Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation has introduced a "Full Sponsorship" option. For \$5 a day, one can be the sole sponsor of a retired racehorse. "I wanted to help because I love the horses, but our farm is full," said Johnathan Miller, who came up with idea for the program along with his wife Lisa. "And, I thought there must be many people out there who live in cities or suburbs and who want to help as well. So, I suggested I pay the daily cost of caring for a horse, and the TRF calls the horse mine." He continued, "This helps the TRF and saves the horse having to be moved away from his pasture mates... It's a win-win situation." There are currently 60 horses placed at foster farms thanks to the TRF's Foster A Horse program, with a goal of 300 horses fostered or fully sponsored in the coming year. Rob Hinkle, President and CEO of the TRF, said, "The Full Sponsorship program could help TRF reach its goal and also provide a more meaningful way for current and potential supporters to donate to the TRF." ## BHA MAKE NEW WHIP RULE CHANGES

The British Horseracing Authority yesterday announced further amendments to the new whip rules in a bid to placate the Professional Jockeys Association. While the frequency of strikes will remain at seven for the Flat and eight for national hunt jockeys, moves have been made to lesser the penalties which are incurred as a result of breaches of the regulations. From today, one strike over the limit will now incur a two-day rather than five-day ban and a second offence will see that doubled to four and not 10 as it had been when the new rules were introduced a month ago. BHA Chairman Paul Roy issued the following statement, "These developments represent a carefully considered and measured response to both our monitoring procedures and constant dialogue with the PJA and other relevant parties. A key purpose of the Review was to achieve behavioural change. This absolutely remains the case, and the same high standards of good horsemanship and equine welfare remain at the heart of our approach to the whip. We are encouraged that we have seen a great deal of behavioural change in a short time period since the implementation of the recommendations of the Review. However, in terms of the specific rules and penalties themselves, it has always been our position that we will constantly monitor how jockeys are adapting. If by making adjustments we can achieve behavioural change more effectively, then as a responsible regulator we should do that. There were fundamental reasons for the changes we introduced last month. They were for the good of the sport and its long-term health, including all its participants, and all groups consulted agreed that new rules were needed. The sport as a whole now needs to cooperate to make the new rules work, and move forward to achieve what we all want to see--a firm but fair set of rules that promote competitive racing, and safeguard welfare and the reputation of British Racing."
