### UNCLE MO FEE SET AT \$35,000

Champion **Uncle Mo** (Indian Charlie--Playa Maya, by Arch) will stand his first season for \$35,000, stands and nurses, at Ashford Stud in 2012. Winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and GI Champagne S. last season, the bay is one of two new stallions at the Versailles, Kentucky, nursery, alongside **Cape Blanco (Ire)** (Galileo {Ire}--Laurel Delight {GB}, by Presidium {GB}). That chestnut is a leading candidate for championship honors following his victories this season in the GI Arlington Million, GI Joe Hirsch Turf Classic and GI Man o'War S.

### Pour Moi to Debut for €20K...

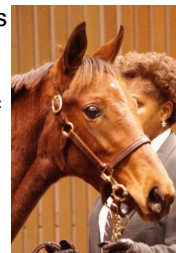
Coolmore Ireland will introduce three new stallions in 2012, headed by G1 Investec Derby hero **Pour Moi (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}--Gwynn {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}), who will command a fee of €20,000 for his first year at stud. The bay, trained by Andre Fabre, was also the winner of the G2 Prix Greffuhle at Saint-Cloud prior to besting fellow Coolmore runner Treasure Beach (Ire) (Galileo {Ire}) in the Derby. Also new to the Coolmore roster are top milers **Canford Cliffs (Ire)** (Tagula {Ire}--Mrs Marsh {GB}, by Marju {Ire}) and **Zoffany (Ire)** (Dansili {GB}--Tyranny {GB}, by Machiavellian). "Even though we see an upturn in the market, in setting the Coolmore fees for 2012," said Coolmore Director of Sales David O'Loughlin. "We recognize the difficulties that breeders are facing. Stud fees for 11 of our stallions have been reduced with only Holy Roman Emperor and Strategic Prince's fees increasing slightly. Our three new Group 1 winners reflect our commitment to quality, choice and value for breeders."

### TAPIT RAISED TO \$125K

Gainesway stallion **Tapit** (Pulpit--Tap Your Heels, by Unbridled) joined the six-figure club when it was announced he would stand for \$125,000. The 10-year-old stallion's fee was \$80,000 last spring. Tapit was represented by his third Breeders' Cup winner last weekend when Hansen stretched his unbeaten streak to three in the GI BC Juvenile and stamped himself as a leading Eclipse Award candidate. "I think Tapit is the most exciting young stallion at stud in the U.S. and I think he warrants this kind of stud fee," said Michael Heron, Gainesway's director of sales. "He's a marquee horse. Everybody has won with Tapit; he's had 13 stakes winners this year. His progeny, male or female, run on all surfaces. Now Hansen is champion elect 2-year-old after winning the Breeders' Cup. Tapit has bred very high-class mares in 2010 and 2011, so the expectation of his future progeny can only be top class." **Cont. p2**

### ALL QUIET AT KEENELAND FRIDAY

A Quiet American filly from the dispersal of Ned Evans's Spring Hill Farm topped yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland November sale with a final bid of \$510,000 from Eddie Kane of Bluegrass Hall. Kane had to see off challenges from Arthur Hancock and Hill 'n' Dale's John Sikura. Sikura was sitting in a back row of the sales pavilion alongside Donato Lanni, who was speaking animatedly on the phone as bidding began to stall. Lanni began shaking his head before Sikura took over the phone and, after a brief conversation, definitively shook his head negative and the hammer fell. "I loved the family," Kane said. "And she was beautiful; a good walker, a good mover." The weanling ([hip 1575](#)) is out of Misty Dancer (Lyphard) and is a full-sister to Quiet Dance--dam of Horse of the Year Saint Liam (Saint Ballado)--whose family has produced fireworks all week at Keeneland. Brad Kelley's Bluegrass Hall has been an active buyer at the November sale, purchasing 25 lots for \$5.775 million and an average of \$231,000. The Quiet American weanling was the farm's most expensive acquisition. Also from the Evans dispersal, Bluegrass Hall purchased a weanling colt by Tale of the Cat out of Quiet Now (Tiznow) for \$425,000 and Misty American (Quiet American), a 2-year-old full-sister to yesterday's session topper for \$420,000. **KEENOV cont. p2**

**Tapit Fee Upped to \$125,000 cont.**

Hansen joined fellow Tapit offspring Stardom Bound and Tapitsfly as Breeders' Cup winners. "The market sets the price, and the market and the demand for his seasons are intense," Hernon offered. Tapit's book will also be tightened up. "Following consultation with breeders and shareholders alike, we are going to reduce his book and have a ceiling on the book of 130 mares," Hernon added. "Consequently, with the internal support which will be strong from the syndicate, Ron Winchell being primary, as well as Antony Beck, who is also a very large shareholder in the horse, that will give us a limited number of seasons to sell."

**Street Boss Colt to Walnut Hill..**

A colt by multiple Grade I winner Street Boss is destined for a return trip to the sales ring after selling yesterday to the \$175,000 bid of pinhooker Peter O'Callaghan's Walnut Hill Stables. The weanling ([hip 1523](#)), consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, is out of Kinsale Lass (Royal Academy), a half-sister to recent GI First Lady S. winner Never Retreat (Smart Strike).

"We thought he was a lovely colt and we were keen to buy him," O'Callaghan reported. "Like all the good foals here, he was probably expensive, but the nice horses are expensive."

Street Boss, who won the 2008 GI Bing Crosby H. and GI Triple Bend Invitational H., has his first yearlings this year.

"There is always concern about a young stallion," admitted O'Callaghan. "But Street Boss is a horse with a chance; we've bought a few of them now. But [the weanling] is a very good individual. He looks like a racehorse, regardless of what stallion he is by. I hope the stallion does well, but I think even if he doesn't, a horse like this will always sell."

O'Callaghan agreed that end users have dominated the early days of the November sale. "There was an awful lot of end-user money here for the first several days of the sales and that's trickled down and us pinhookers are feeling the effects of it," the Irishman explained. "But it's what we do. If you're not in, you can't win."

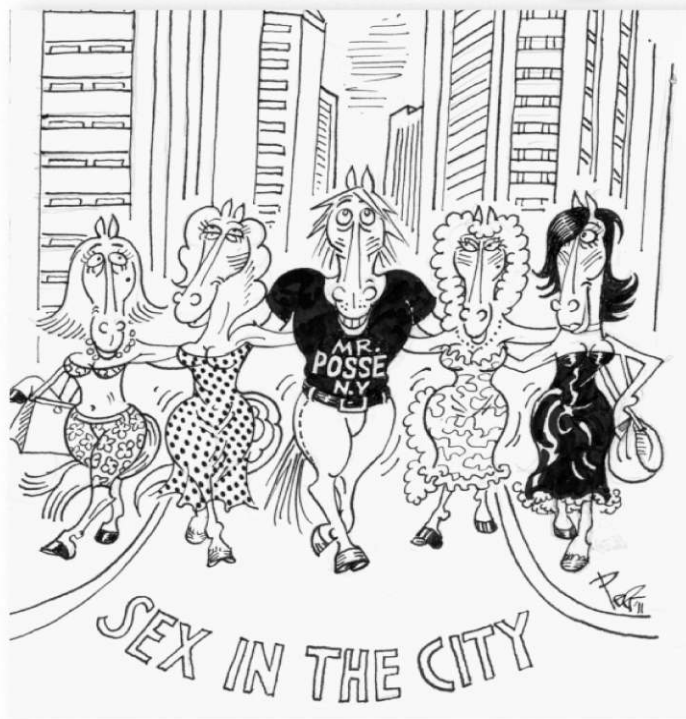

### St George Stables Has Elusive Moment

Dr. Oscar Benavides, bidding on behalf of St. George Stables, secured **Elusive Moment (Ire)** (Elusive Quality--I'll Get Along, by Smile) ([hip 1446](#)) for \$170,000 during yesterday's fifth session of the Keeneland November sale. The 6-year-old mare, in foal to City Zip, is a full-sister to Kentucky Derby winner Smarty Jones.

"She had a lot of class," Benavides commented after signing the ticket. "She is a big mare and very correct." Benavides has signed for no fewer than seven November mares for St. George, including Bambera (Ven) (Water Poet {Ire}) for \$325,000; Towering Palace (GB) (Unbridled's Song) for \$260,000; and May Day Vow (Broken Vow) for \$240,000.

**Team Valor Goes Back to War Front Well...**

The young Danzig sire War Front has been good to Barry Irwin's Team Valor International this season. The 3-year-old filly **Summer Soiree** made all in the GI Del Mar Oaks a start after romping in the GIII Boiling Springs S. at Monmouth, while the 2-year-old colt **State**

**of Play** won Saratoga's GII With Anticipation S. for Team Valor. So it was no surprise when Irwin proved gamest for [hip 1259](#) yesterday, a filly by the Claiborne sire from Meg Levy's Bluewater Sales. The Apr. 14-foaled miss, purchased for \$90,000, was produced by Smooth Brandy (Awesome Again), a half-sister to Grade I winner Dr. Zic (Milwaukee Brew).

"I just think [War Front's] a fantastic sire," said Irwin during a break in the action in the Keeneland dining room yesterday. "He's one of the few horses where his foals seem to have the ability to stay close [to the pace during a race], and then explode. It's pretty impressive; I like that."

Irwin said the filly is typical of what he's seen in many of the War Fronts. "Most of them are on the smaller, lighter side," he said. "This wasn't a real big filly, but she's a mid-April foal. I went out to the Levys' farm last week and saw this one out in the field running around, and I was pretty impressed. At that price, I was happy to get her."

Irwin has made a fine career for himself buying horses in training privately, and of course earlier this year registered his biggest-ever score as the owner/breeder of GI Kentucky Derby winner Animal Kingdom (Leroidesanimaux {Brz}). But he's also enjoyed success buying unraced horses, either as yearlings or, to a lesser extent, as weanlings.

"I don't ever have a game plan," Irwin said. "We show up at all these sales, and if I see something that tickles me, we'll take a shot."

"I probably have bought only five weanlings over the years. One of them was in South Africa, a horse called Ebony Flyer (SAf) (Jet Master {SAf}). She's one of the best horses I ever had down there. She beat last year's South African Horse of the Year Igugu (Aus) (Galileo {Ire}) in the G1 [Cape Fillies] 1000 Guineas S. and ran third in the G1 Queen's Plate this year, which is kind of like a 3-year-old filly running in the G1 Met Mile. It was the 150th running of the race, and she's only the second filly to ever place. In my opinion, she's more talented than Ipi Tombe (Zim)."

Ipi Tombe, by Manshood (GB), also won the 1000 Guineas in South Africa, as well as the G1 Dubai Duty Free for Team Valor.

Irwin has now both bought and sold at November. On Tuesday, Team Valor sold three racemares: **Gypsy's Warning (SAf)** (Mogok) to Flaxman Holdings Ltd. for \$1.05 million; **Daveron (Ger)** (Black Sam Bellamy {Ire}) to Live Oak for \$750,000; and **Miss Singhsix (Ire)** (Singspiel {Ire}) to Vinery Stables for \$485,000. Denali Stud consigned all three mares. On Thursday, Irwin bought out his Team Valor partners on a fourth mare, signing for GSW & G1SP Sweet Theresa (SAf) (Strike Smartly), in foal to Leroidesanimaux, for \$80,000.

"I think it's a good sale for selling," said Irwin. "If you have the right stuff, you'll do fine. Everybody's saying it's a buyer's market. I don't believe that. It's a seller's market--it's very healthy. Everything we had exceeded our expectations, and the only one that didn't, I bought myself." -LM

**\$15K Claim Turns to \$260,000...**

A half-sister to the up-and-coming 3-year-old **Rothko** (Arch), haltered out of an Aqueduct claiming race for \$15,000 just 11 months ago, brought some claim-to-fame glory for her connections yesterday after re-selling for \$260,000. That was the top priced paid for a mare

during Keeneland November's fifth session.

The miss in question was the 4-year-old **Kinsey** (Delaware Township--Raspberry Eggcream, by Time for a Change), offered by John Mayer's Nursery

Place and hammered down to JMC Bloodstock, agent for Redmon Farm. Claiborne Farm was reportedly the underbidder. The well-made chestnut, [hip 1524](#), sold in foal on an Apr. 16 cover to Arch, and is thus carrying a close relative to Rothko. That Padua homebred recently rattled off his third straight race by daylight, posting a 108 BRIS figure when winning a Churchill optional claimer by 6 1/2 lengths on the Breeders' Cup Friday undercard ([video](#)). Kinsey is also a full-sister to GSW Electrify and a half to SW Cream Only (Exchange Rate).

Mayer is part of a longstanding group that includes his brother-in-law Happy Broadbent that purchases young mares off the track--either through the claim box or privately--and resells them at auction.

Rothko was unraced when the group claimed Kinsey, though the word was that the colt had some ability. Rothko ran second on debut at Santa Anita a month later, finished a disappointing sixth as the chalk at Churchill returning in July, then figured it all out in Saratoga maiden special Aug. 12, winning off by 2 1/4 lengths. He added a 6 1/4-length trouncing of Monmouth allowance foes Sept. 18 and looked like the real deal under the Twin Spires. "We had heard he had some talent," said Mayer.

In addition to the obvious reason to breed Kinsey to Rothko's sire, Mayer said there were other pluses. "We like to take our young, unproven mares to proven stallions if we can," he explained. "We also spend a lot of time trying to evaluate the physicals, and what will match up."

Kinsey herself showed plenty of early promise during her racing days, capturing a 5 1/2-furlong maiden special weight at Saratoga in snappy 1:03 2/5 in her second career start as a juvenile in 2009. Behind her that day? Eventual Grade I winner Awesome Maria (Maria's Mon) finished second, while MGSW Ailalea (Pulpit) ran third. Third in the Sorority S. at Monmouth next out, Kinsey didn't continue to improve at three, and found herself in claiming company.

Both Mayer and Broadbent were reluctant to take much credit for yesterday's score, insisting it was a team effort. "It's very easy for me to stand in front of the barn when we have these kind of mares," said Mayer. "We've got a great team at the farm, we've got a great team in the office, and it's why I might feel awkward standing out here [accepting congratulations]. It takes a lot of work from a lot of people. The group's been together almost 20 years. We've had a really good 20 years, and it's been successful, but it's also a group that works very hard."

He added that, when it came to Kinsey, nature had done much of the heavy lifting. "God made they mare what she was; she's special," he said. "Physically, she could have been anywhere in the catalogue. She's got a great hip and shoulder, and the grace to go with it. It's a rare combination. Hey, she's a beautiful mare with a live horse under the first dam." -LM

**Into the Sunset for Hill 'n' Dale...**

Hill 'n' Dale's John Sikura picked up the mare Indian Sunset (Storm Bird), then 15 years old, for \$38,000 at the 2009 Keeneland January Sale. Following a sterling result yesterday, Sikura can now boast of selling \$360,000 worth of stock from the relative of Storm Cat in the last two months.

Hill 'n' Dale offered Indian Sunset's latest foal, a colt from the first crop of the farm's MGISW Zensational (Unbridled's Song), as [hip 1508](#), and watched as Clearsky Farms went to \$160,000 for the handsome chestnut. At Keeneland September, Hill 'n' Dale sold a Candy Ride (Arg) colt it bred out of Indian Sunset to Bluegrass Hall for \$200,000.

The colts are a half-brothers to GSW Palanka City (Carson City) and SW & GSP Quick Action (Carson City), and were produced by a granddaughter of Crimson Saint (Crimson Satan), also the second dam of the great Storm Cat (Storm Bird).

"I love that family," said Sikura. "[Indian Sunset] was a middle-aged mare [when I bought her], but she had two outstanding foals for us--the Candy Ride we sold earlier this year, and this colt, who was a great specimen."

Zensational, a rocketship of a horse who won three straight Grade 1s in Southern California, stood the 2011 season for a fee of \$22,500. "We've got a lot of great Zensational foals at the farm, and we wanted the public to see some of them," Sikura said when asked why he chose to bring this colt to the marketplace.

"He's a third-year stallion now, and you want people to see how good his foals are to help promote him," Sikura added. "We've got some real superstars at the farm out of some of our very best mares."

He added, "This colt was probably a little more compact than a lot of the Zensationals, but they all have very good bodies. One sold one earlier today for \$100,000 [[hip 1303](#), to T. Hyde], and they've been very well-received."

Paragon Farm's Brandon Perry handled the bidding for Eamon Cleary's Clearsky, which will resell the Zensational colt as a yearling. Perry said there plenty to recommend the April Fool's Day baby.

"He's by a very fast horse, and he looked very fast," said Perry. "And he's got some pedigree. We actually tried to buy his half-sister, Palanka City, as a mare last year at the Fasig-Tipton November Sale. We liked her, and she sold for quite a bit of money [\$520,000, to My Meadowview]. She was extremely fast, too. This just looked like a smart horse."

The colt was Clearsky's second weanling purchase at November. On Thursday, it acquired a filly by Malibu Moon--High Heeled Hope (Salt Lake) for \$195,000. Selling as [hip 1070](#), the half-sister to GSW Sweet Hope (Lemon Drop Kid) and SP Highgate Park (A.P. Indy) was consigned by Paramount Sales.

Mandaeen's facile debut success over nine furlongs at Longchamp Oct. 16 stamped him as an exciting prospect and it is worth noting that Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) was opening his account for Andre Fabre in a similar contest 12 months earlier. Of those with proven pattern-race form, **Tai Chi** sets the standard and enters this on the back of wins in a valuable sales race at Baden-Baden Oct. 9 and the G3 Preis des Winterfavoriten at Cologne a week later. In the latter contest, the traditional championship race for Germany's juvenile colts, he swept aside the country's finest prospects with real authority and has the world at his feet. Charlie Hills is still seeking a first top-level success since taking over from his father Barry in August, and **Letsgoroundagain** improved for the step up from sprint trips to a mile last time when annexing Pontefract's Listed Silver Tankard S. Oct. 17.

Another unknown quantity is the unbeaten filly **Brocottes**, who scored at Fontainebleau Oct. 5 and at Longchamp 18 days later while the supplemented **Mirandola** bolsters the female presence after her success in a nine-furlong conditions race at Maisons-Laffitte 11 days ago.

A better-timed ride could make the difference, and she appears to be working slowly, but steadily in the interim at Big Sandy. "The \$175,000 [purse] had a lot to do with it," said Proctor. "She's also doing really well and we wanted to give her one more shot to run against her age group... It's always a tough race. Everyone wants to run against 3-year-olds one more time before the end of the year. This is one competitive race."

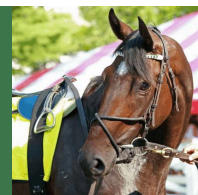

"We couldn't be more proud of the WinStar stallions and the success enjoyed across the board in 2011," said Elliott Walden, WinStar president & CEO. "We set out with the goal of growing our 2012 roster with promising young stallions that give breeders a range of quality options. And, despite the popularity of many of our stallions, we will continue to be sensitive to the economics of the game, and to our breeders who depend on our product to make a profit. "Like Gulfstream, we also had the Sunshine Millions on our stakes schedule for 2012, but during recent purse negotiations, the Thoroughbred Owners of California informed us they did not wish to participate this year," Rick Hammerle, Santa Anita's racing secretary, told *Daily Racing Form*.

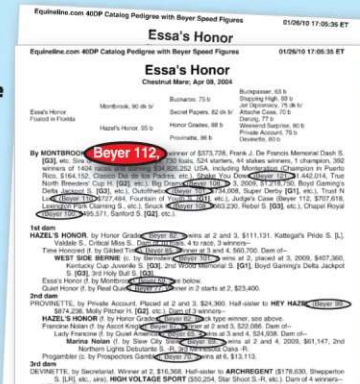

## Feeling Lucky...

Ever So Lucky first turned heads earlier this spring at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic 2-Year-Old Sale, breezing an eighth in a sharp :10 1/5. The EQB team of Jeff Seder and Patti Miller secured the promising juvenile for a sale-topping \$600,000 on behalf of long-time client George Strawbridge Jr. The bay proved to be a homerun for pinhooker Becky Thomas, who went to \$95,000 the previous fall at the Keeneland September Sale.

“We thought he was an exceptional horse,” Miller revealed. “It was a dreadful racetrack when that horse breezed. He was well-touted going into the sale. I had seen him at the farm beforehand and he was a beautiful mover. He dictated to the track. Jeff has this theory that he says, ‘Great horses dictate to the surface, the surface doesn’t dictate to them.’ He had a tremendous cardio too, and he was a very good physical, although a little bit leggy.”

Seder and Miller have done quite well selecting horses for Strawbridge at the juvenile sales. In fact, the duo landed on subsequent Augustin champions Informed Decision (Monarchos) for \$320,000 at the 2007 FTMMAY sale and Forever Together (Belong to Me) for \$240,000 at the 2006 OBSMAR sale.

“Mr. Strawbridge wants to play and he wanted a really good horse or two,” Miller continued. “We just thought that this was a ‘wow horse.’ He looked like a really good one to us.”

Adding with a laugh shortly after watching the replay of Churchill’s eighth race yesterday, she said, “Guess what? He just looked like a really good horse again!”

Miller wasn’t surprised how sought after Ever So Lucky was in Timonium.

“I was hoping we’d get him for about what we paid for Informed Decision,” she admitted. “George said that if we liked him as much as we did that he has faith in us. Mr. Strawbridge was our first client at EQB and we really appreciate him. [Trainer] Jonathan [Sheppard] came to the sale to look at the horse and he really liked him, too.”

Ever So Lucky didn’t miss a beat once joining Sheppard’s shedrow, posting a slew of bullet workouts going four furlongs, including a :47 3/5 breeze at Delaware Sept. 28, a :46 move at Keeneland Oct. 9, and most recently in :46 1/5 beneath the Twin Spires Nov. 8. **In Sharper Focus cont.**

"We were hoping that he would be," Miller said when asked if she was surprised that he was ready to graduate at first asking. "Jonathan lives about a mile or so from us here [at the EQB base in West Grove, Pennsylvania]. I keep in touch with him and you could tell that the horse was doing everything right. It's not like Sheppard--he doesn't like to push a horse unless the horse tells him that he wants the pressure. He doesn't look at a horse as *having* to run at two or three. He'll start a horse first time out at four if he has to. He's got patience and he's a terrific horsemen."

Under pressure in the early stages after breaking a beat slow, Ever So Lucky impressively drew clear with a quick shake of the reins in the stretch and received a premature congratulatory tap on the shoulder from jockey Julien Leproux well before hitting the wire.

"He was a very efficient-moving horse at the sale," Miller said. "He looked like he was totally within himself yesterday, even when Julien pushed him up in there early. I think he knew that he had to get him into the fight."

"Once he got him into the fight, then Ever So Lucky got Julien out of the fight," she added with a laugh.

Ever So Lucky will winter in Florida with Sheppard's first string. An immediate target has yet to be determined. -SS

**AMERICAIN RETURNS IN ZIPPING CLASSIC**

Fresh off a close fourth-place effort in defense of his title in the G1 Emirates Melbourne Cup Nov. 1, **Americain** (Dynaformer) is the marquee attraction on the final day of the Spring Carnival in today's G2 Zipping Classic at Sandown. A winner two starts back in the G2 Moonee Valley Cup, he did not disgrace himself in the 'race that stops a nation,' rallying from unusually far back before staying on well after traveling wide into the stretch. Level weights will only help his cause in this 2400-meter affair, and should all go well here, Americain has been penciled in for a start in the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup in which he was third last season. **Manighar (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}), a respectable sixth in the Cup, and **Saptapadi (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}), further back in, 16th, will do their best to stand in Americain's way, **Mourayan (Ire)** (Alhaarth {Ire}), a late Cup withdrawal, will try to improve off his runner-up effort to Glass Harmonium (Ire) (Verglas {Ire}) in the G1 Mackinnon S. Oct. 29.

**ROCKET MAN OVERCOMES SCARE TO SCORE**

It wasn't the easiest or most stylish of his 18 career victories, but G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen winner **Rocket Man (Aus)** (Viscount {Aus}) remains on track--for the time being, at least--for a return trip for the G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 11 after taking a 1200-meter event over the Kranji all-weather track Friday evening ([video](#)). But there were some anxious moments for his connections and his legions of fans, when the 6-year-old hurdled a shadow while making the pace with just under a half-mile to race. Rocket Man never lost his action and continued to bowl along up front, while being angled a bit off the inside by jockey Barend Vorster in upper stretch to prevent any further incidents. **Merchant (Aus)** (Fubu {Aus}), the 80-1 second choice, tried to make a race of it in the late stages, but the chalk held sway to score by two lengths in a performance more workmanlike than it was brilliant. Rocket Man returned S\$5.30 (1-16 odds), the lowest dividend allowed by the Singapore Turf Club for a S\$5 stake. Trainer Patrick Shaw will go over his charge with a fine-tooth comb before committing to Hong Kong. "I've already spoken to his vets to have his legs checked after he jumped a shadow at the 700-meter [mark]," said Shaw. "He's done this before, but never at this stage of the race, and that is a bit of a concern. Barend had to ease him to the middle in the home straight to stay clear of any other shadow just in case." He continued, "Obviously he had to ride him a little more carefully tonight. I think the Japan trip and the quarantine there has taken something away from him, and he definitely needed the run tonight. We'll see how he pulls up. If he pulls up good, Hong Kong is still on target." Rocket Man dead-heated for the win in last year's G2 Cathay Pacific Jockey Club Sprint before just missing in the main event three weeks later.
