Inauspicious Beginnings...

By Ron Winchell's own admission, Sabercat was a little slow on the uptake to start his career, with a debut fourth in the Churchill slop May 26 ahead of a much-improved third beneath the Twin Spires July 3. Neither did a switch to turf and two turns solve the problems, as the dark bay was a well-beaten eighth at Saratoga Aug. 6, but he broke through with a coast-to-coast defeat of **My Adonis** (Pleasantly Perfect) at Monmouth Sept. 5. He followed with an easy score in the Garden State Oct. 2, and the Juvenile was squarely in the crosshairs prior to the colic incident.

Bumped sideways at the start by **Dougs Buddy** (Badge of Silver) here, Sabercat was one of the race's two back markers as **My Adonis** and favored **Drill** (Lawyer Ron) engaged in a suicidal pace duel. **Basmati** (Borrego), who was one of the first into stride, eased back off the pace to save ground from fourth, while Sabercat was further back in the field, hoping the race would fall apart. And that it did. **My Adonis** was first to call it a day and **Drill** raised the white flag soon after, allowing **Basmati** to hit the front under a full head of steam. Sabercat, who was audaciously angled down towards the inside approaching the second turn, was steadied briefly in behind rivals on the bend, but powered up outside into the lane. He and **Basmati** dueled for a few strides, but Sabercat was doing the better work and went on to score handily. **Drill** completed a largely forgettable day for the Bob Baffert stable, finishing seventh.

Now I Know displayed excellent debut speed to wire a field of state-bred maidens on her Aug. 24 debut at Remington Park, then defeated a next-out winner and Yvette Sangalo in an open first-level allowance at the Oklahoma oval Sept. 14. A measured 3 1/2-length winner of a restricted allowance Oct. 12, she registered a career-best 85 Beyer Speed Figure in schooling her rivals by 9 1/4 lengths in the Oklahoma Classics Lassie Oct. 28. Making her fifth start in the span of 90 days, Now I Know took advantage of her low draw and set sail for the front, as **Delightful Magic** (Mineshaft) and favored **Candrea** (Trippi) positioned themselves to take advantage of any misstep up front. Now I Know continued to gallop along up front and began to put daylight on her rivals on the turn. She started to get a bit leg-weary in the final stages, but was actually going away from the competition and won clear. **Inny Minnie** just held for second over Yvette Sangalo for a 2-3 finish for their freshman sire, while **Candrea** tired badly to beat just one home. Now I Know is the first foal from her unraced dam, a \$20,000 yearling purchase out of the 2006 FTKOCT sale. She is the dam of a yearling colt by Storm Surge and was bred this year to Cowboy Cal.

When Graham Motion sends one out to California, you know he means business, and Sanagas racked up another Grade I win on the west coast for the Fair Hill-based operation. Victorious in four of his five starts in his native country, including a pair on the all-weather surface in Neuss, the 5-year-old wasn't able to translate his form in his stateside debut, finishing seventh in the Gill Arlington H. July 9. Blinkers went on for the 13-furlong John's Call S. at Saratoga Aug. 5, and that seemed to do the trick, as the dark bay drifted out late, but raced away from his rivals for a decisive 2

1/4-length victory. The 3-2 favorite for the Gill Bowling Green H. at Belmont Sept. 10, he got going a touch too late and was fourth, and he sat a three-wide trip in his latest, an off-turf renewal of the Gill Sycamore S. at Keeneland Oct. 20, but he overpowered his rivals on that occasion to score by a half-length. The mare Miss Match (Arg) (Indygo Shiner) took the early initiative and set the pace from Cal-bred Norvsky (Vronsky) as Sanagas could not get in and raced three wide past the stands for the first time. Positions were unchanged as they raced up the backstretch, but Rajiv Maragh decided to try to win the race at the half-mile pole and sent Sanagas to the front. He eased over to the fence and kept up that punishing gallop in the stretch to stamp himself as potentially one of this country's top stayers in 2012. "It was pretty straightforward. My horse got into a nice flow right away and was just pulling me around the track," Maragh commented. "It was a little earlier than I wanted initially, but he really wanted to go and I didn't want to dishearten him. He always runs big and we've always had high hopes for him." Motion also sent in Summer Soiree (War Front) to take this year's GI Del Mar Oaks.

Essence Hit Man began 2011 in style, capturing the Jacques Cartier S. in a track-record-setting performance Apr. 17 before finishing second in the seven-furlong GIII Vigil S. May 8. After fading to seventh in the grassy GIII Highlander S. June 26, the chestnut was fourth in the Bold Adventure S. July 20, and was given some time to regroup. He came back to set the pace in a salty local allowance Oct. 30, but was caught late and passed by Paso Doble (Bold N' Flashy). Away alertly, Essence Hit Man assumed his usual spot on the front end and had a clear lead through a :44.57 opening half. He shortened stride a bit yet, but had enough in the tank to secure his first graded trophy. Winning trainer Audre Cappuccitti credited a new bit for her charge's success. "I had [jockey] Jesse [Campbell] come back and breeze him after the last race, and I changed the equipment, and said, 'let's see if this will help'," said Cappuccitti. "He came back and said it really worked. He had a tiny bit more control. It's not that he's [Essence Hit Man] tough, he just wants to go and if you try to strangle him, it just doesn't work."

Blues Street won three of five 2010 starts for trainer Todd Pletcher, including the GIII Fair Grounds H. and GII Mervin Muniz Jr. Memorial H. Second by a nose in his 2011 opener, the GIII Ft. Lauderdale H. at Gulfstream, the veteran was out for six months before posting a win in a Belmont optional claimer June 16. He was fourth behind stablemate Sidney's Candy (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GII Fourstardave H. at Saratoga July 31, but faded to 11th in the GII Bernard Baruch H. Aug. 26 in what would be his final start in Pletcher's white bridle. In his first try for Eddie Kenneally, the dark bay missed by a neck in a one-mile allowance on Keeneland's sod Oct. 7. Unhurried early, Blues Street swept into contention with a bold, four-wide move on the far turn, and kept up the momentum to post a stylish victory. "He handled the turf," Kenneally said. "There was a little give in the ground, even though it was listed as firm. He relaxed nicely behind the pace and he's got a lot of class--he's got a lot of back class, this horse. He's good right now, and it worked out well."

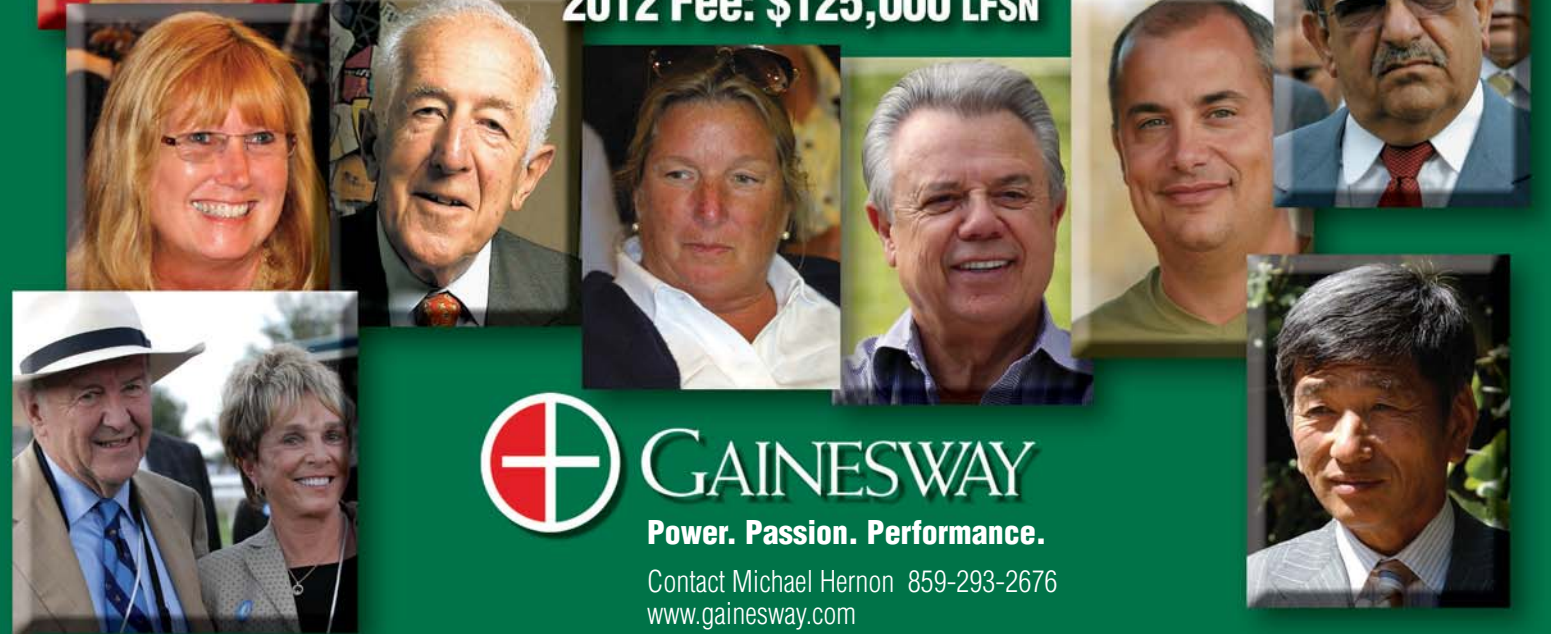

The Virginia-bred Redeemed used an Independence Day allowance success at Big Sandy as a springboard to stakes company and made the most of the chance, coming from second last to fill the exacta underneath Eclipse Award candidate Caleb's Posse (Posse) in Saratoga's Gil Amsterdam S. Aug. 1 and ran back to that effort when finishing runner-up to Wilburn (Bernardini) in the Smarty Jones S. at Parx on Labor Day. Instead of pressing on to that track's Gil Pennsylvania Derby, he made a circuitous trip to Remington Park for the Oklahoma Derby, and, with blinkers added for the first time, got up to defeat **☆ "TDN Rising Star" ☆** Alternation (Distorted Humor) by a nose. Redeemed jumped well, but was content to lay second as Ghost Gunner (Ghostzapper) established an even pace up front. Still traveling beautifully beneath Edgar Prado, Redeemed was poised to take command at the midpoint of the turn, but instead inherited the lead when Ghost Gunner took a bad step and was pulled up and out of the race. He cut the corner into the stretch and never looked in any serious danger as Socialsaul parlayed a ground-saving trip into a solid runner-up effort. "I have to tell you, he was very impressive to me today," said winning trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. "To me, every step around there, I knew he was going to win the race," added Dutrow. "When they came to him, he just spurred away again."

We've got a horse that we've met four times and lost to four times [Grand Prix Boss] and horses we haven't met before and horses from overseas, but he has developed steadily from spring. I think we can expect some good results." **Ridill**, seventh in the Yasuda Kinen, has won his last two starts, including the G2 Swan S. going seven furlongs over this course Oct. 29. Both **Immortal Verse** and **Sahpresa** have the credentials to take this race back to Europe. The G1 Prix Jacques le Marois heroine, **Immortal Verse** was no threat to Frankel when seventh to the Cartier Horse of the Year in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. at Ascot Oct. 15, but there is nothing like Frankel in this heat. **Sahpresa** is a three-time winner of the G1 Sun Chariot S. and makes her first start since completing the three-peat at Newmarket Sept. 24.

Defending G1 Hong Kong Mile hero **Beauty Flash** lines up here as well, but may be short of his best, as trainer Tony Cruz will aim to have the screws tightened for the title defense Dec. 11.

Banimpire's price of €2.3 million proved a massive point for Goffs, as we have always maintained that we will achieve the highest prices possible when we have the quality that appeals to a global audience. That her buyer travelled from Florida for this one mare speaks for itself, but also underlines the high respect in which Irish horses are held around the world.

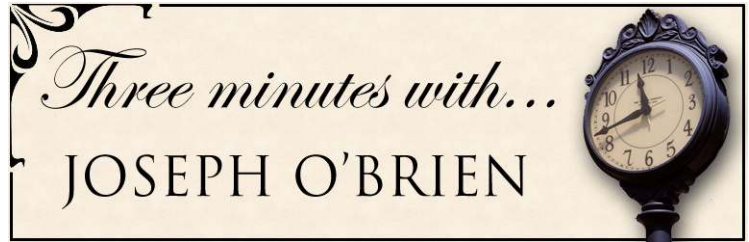

Again, a global audience converged on Goffs to get involved with buyers from all over the world competing at the top of the market.

“For both categories, the Goffs team continue to work alongside our friends at Irish Thoroughbred Marketing, and it bears repeating that no other country enjoys such a focused approach to international bloodstock marketing. These highlights have gained us some very enjoyable headlines and drive home the point we make with mares, foals and yearlings. That is that Goffs will get the best for the best; we just need more top Irish breeders to follow Jim’s example and we will not let them down.

“But the week has been about so much more than the headline lots, starting with a rejuvenated foal trade on Tuesday and finishing with a vibrant market for the lots on offer today. In between, there was sustained demand for quality Irish foals and breeding stock as well as a very successful first November Yearling section. Yes, this has been a very encouraging week, not just for Goffs, but for the industry in general. TRAINER ARMANDO RENZONI DIES

Leading Italian conditioner Armando Renzoni, 62, died early yesterday morning after a short illness. He is survived by his wife, Rita. Renzoni, the son of top post-war rider Roberto Renzoni, was a former amateur jockey himself before taking out his trainer's licence in Rome almost 30 years ago. He found success as the main trainer for Antonio Balzarini's Scuderia AJB and registered a Classic double for those silks with Atoll (Ire) (Caerleon) in the 1990 G2 Premio Regina Elena and G1 Oaks d'Italia. Atoll, purchased privately from breeder Robert Sangster, also registered a neck second in the G1 Irish Oaks. Other notable horses to emerge from Renzoni's Capanelle base include the crack sprinter Late Parade (Ire) (Astronef {Ire}) and the 2007 G3 Premio Parioli victor and dual Group 1-placed Golden Titus (Ire) (Titus Livius {Fr}). He also saddled the 2008 G2 Prix Robert Papin hero Lui Rei (Ity) (Reinaldo {Fr}) and Rosendhal (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}), who became the trainer's final group-race scorer when landing last year's G3 Premio Umbria at his local track. The last winner registered under Renzoni's name came by way of the 2-year-old filly La Ninfa Rossa (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), who annexed a five-furlong maiden heat at Naples two days ago. Armandino, as Renzoni was affectionately known, was not one to overface his horses and he never shirked the challenge of tackling top domestic and foreign races. Oft seen with cigar in mouth, he was a highly respected figure among Italian horsemen. His funeral service will be take place at Rome's Cimitero il Verano at 3:30 p.m. tomorrow.

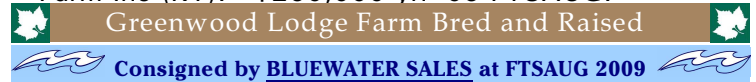
