TATTS DECEMBER KICKS OFF

What promises to be an action-packed couple of weeks at the Tattersalls December Sale in Newmarket kicks off at 10 a.m. this morning with its one-day yearling section, featuring 241 entries. Few vendors

originally plan to offer their youngsters at the year's final major yearling sale, with many of those catalogued having either been withdrawn or unsold at earlier auctions this fall. Galileo (Ire) fillies have been all the rage at yearling sales this year and there is one opportunity to buy a daughter of the champion sire courtesy of [lot 204](#). She is a 3/4-sister to G1 Irish Derby

runner-up Golden Sword (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) offered from the Pocock family's Srington Farm. Montjeu (Ire)'s team includes a May 15-foaled sibling to G2 Lancashire Oaks winner Pongee (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) offered as [lot 190](#) from Newsells Park Stud, while [lot 166](#), a Montjeu (Ire) colt out of Ghurra (War Chant) offered from Castledillon Stud, realised €200,000 at the Arqana August Yearling Sale this year. [Lot 122](#), a son of Lemon Drop Kid offered by the same vendor, failed to sell at €110,000 at Deauville in August. Among several lots to have passed through this year's Keeneland September Yearling Sale is [lot 43](#), a Speightstown colt offered by Bumble Mitchell who was a \$47,000 RNA, while [lot 157](#), a Cherokee Run colt, was sold to Blue Blue Sky Thoroughbreds for \$33,000. Of those that sold as foals, none made more than [lot 84](#), a Fastnet Rock (Aus) half-brother to G1 Queensland Derby winner Dariana (Aus) (Redoute's Choice {Aus}) who realised 100,000gns at Tattersalls 12 months ago and is offered today from Biddestone Stud.

"This is a sale that constantly produces very high-class performers, not least the leading 2-year-old Harbour Watch (Ire) (Acclamation {GB}) this season," said Tattersalls marketing director Jimmy George. "We've got a real quality renewal this year, including a good number of yearlings who qualify for the 2012-13 Tattersalls Millions series."

The December Sale resumes Wednesday when the four-day foal section gets underway.

EISHIN APOLLON WINS MILE CHAMPIONSHIP

Eishin Apollon (Giant's Causeway), sent off the fifth betting choice, held on for a narrow victory over longshot **Fifth Petal (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}) in yesterday's G1 Mile Championship at Kyoto Racecourse. The 4-year-old broke well and was able to save ground while covered up in the early going. Swinging out four wide turning for home, he dug in to outstay Fifth Petal by a neck for his first win at the highest level.

Eishin Apollon, a half-brother to G1SP Master of Hounds (Kingmambo), was recording only his third run of the season yesterday, and was exiting a win in the G3 Fuji S. over soft Tokyo turf Oct. 22.

Sahpresa (Sahm), winner of the G1 Sun Chariot S., was another 1 1/4 lengths back in third after finishing willingly down the center of the track. "We were unlucky again with the draw for the third year running, but I am extremely proud with the mare, at age six, for maintaining her form to meet the high level of competition in this Japanese mile race," offered trainer Rodolphe Collet. "We may be headed to Hong Kong for our next target, but I will have to discuss this with the owners." **Cont. p2**

Immortal Verse (Ire) (Pivotal {GB}), victorious in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois earlier this season, could never really pick up over ground which was saturated by Saturday rains and checked in seventh, beaten a little more than three lengths as the 5-1 third choice. "I don't think she's run on such wet turf before--even in France--and the track condition today certainly didn't suit her," explained jockey Christophe Soumillon. "I'm sure she would have been able to display her great acceleration on a firmer track." According to trainer Robert Collet, the 3-year-old filly will be shelved for the remainder of the season and will return to competition in 2012.

Reigning G1 Hong Kong Mile hero Beauty Flash (NZ) (Golan {Ire}) was allowed to dictate terms up front, but Ambitious Dragon lay closer to the speed than is his custom, and with a crush of horses near the front, was trapped out three wide without cover and was going to

have to be very good to win. In the meantime, Destined for Glory was bidding his time down on the fence, setting the stage for a dramatic finish. Ambitious Dragon traveled well while four wide into the lane and hit the front with a furlong and a half to race, but Destined for Glory was now getting off the fence to launch

his bid. Though the chalk was able to put about a length on the field in the latter stages, Destined for Glory was switched to his outside and got his nose down first. Tony Millard, trainer of the reigning Hong Kong horse of the year, took the defeat in stride. "He was up very wide and quite close up and that's not his style," said the South African, "but he still went down by just a nostril. He hadn't run for seven weeks and, as things panned out, we didn't win, but the horse ran a great race. He was right on the day and of course we were hoping to win, but that was a great lead up to the [CXHK] Cup."

Runner-up to Flying Blue (Aus) (Piccolo {GB}) in the Chairman's Trophy last April, Thumbs Up was a non-threatening 10th to Xtension (Ire) (Xaar {GB}) in the G1 Champions Mile Apr. 25 and went away following an 11th to Real Impact (Jpn) (Deep Impact {Jpn}) in the G1 Yasuda Kinen June 5. He resumed in the Sha Tin Trophy H. Oct. 30, and, while California Memory (Highest Honor {Fr}) got the headlines for his brilliant

last-to-first score, Thumbs Up came from 12th to finish third, beaten just a neck. Drawn wide here, Thumbs Up dropped out to the tail of the field as they went at a good gallop up front. Still last as they raced down the side of the Sha Tin course, he was switched out widest of all and had clear sailing,

but running to do. Pure Champion, slightly better than midfield nearing the stretch, raced up to lead entering the final 300 meters, but the veteran Thumbs Up came with a stinging rally on the grandstand side to be up in the nick of time, with Irian closing well for third. Favored California Memory was boxed in by Irian in upper stretch and also lacked room inside the final half-furlong en route to a luckless fourth-place effort. "He never had a run in the straight," said his trainer Tony Cruz. "He was boxed in all the time and just never had a run."

Off a last-place effort to Ambitious Dragon (NZ) (Pins {Aus}) in last year's Hong Kong Derby, connections decided once and for all to keep Little Bridge at sprint trips, and he returned from a six-month vacation to finish runner-up to the classy Joy and Fun (NZ) (Cullen {Aus}) in a Class 1 handicap over track and trip Sept. 11. Only ninth to Entrapment in the Sha Tin Sprint Trophy H. Oct. 1, he finished ahead of that rival and just behind Rich Unicorn (Aus) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) in the Premier Bowl H. Oct. 30. Parked off the

pacesetting Dim Sum (GB) (Kyllachy {GB}) in fourth and always traveling comfortably, Little Bridge edged closer into the lane as odds-on Entrapment raced just off his heels. He was driven to the front at the furlong pole and stayed on well for the victory, as

Entrapment could do no better than second with no apparent alibi. Admiration, highly touted by trainer John Moore, rounded out a chalky trio. "We trained him for the (Mercedes-Benz Hong Kong) Derby last year," said a jubilant winning trainer Denny Shum. "But he wasn't able to get the trip, and after that he was exhausted. So we gave him a good long break, and he's come back so well. This year he looks fantastic, and he's just been improving race by race. Now I hope we can win the big one in December."

"I had a lot of faith in her today--she's probably better than she's been all year," said winning trainer Stuart Simon. "You're still leery, because you have to run the race and things can happen, but I'm so confident in her right now."

FOCUS ON DAVID REDVERS

By Tom Frary

David Redvers and his Tweenhill Stud are as upwardly mobile as it gets at the minute, thanks largely to the new connection with the Al Thani family of Qatar. From the early forays into the national hunt sphere, which saw his bargain buy Lady Rebecca (GB) launch him into the limelight with her hurdling prowess, Redvers now manages one of the hottest new sires around in Makfi (GB) as the Gloucestershire farm continues its rapid rise to prominence. Set up in 1995, Tweenhills Stud and David Redvers Bloodstock were the product of an upbringing in which horses were heavily influential. His mother and grandmother were show judges and father John is a renowned portrait painter. Redvers boasts years of experience in the racing, breeding and sales industry with trainer Mark Johnston, the firm which is now Brightwells sales company and at the likes of Shadwell Stud. Stallions were the main focus from the beginning, and the cheap national hunt sire Afzal (GB) got the ball rolling before Atraf (GB), Fraam (GB), Ishiguru and Sleeping Indian (GB) upped the ante.

"I always had a fascination with the stallion side of things and the intention was always to concentrate on that," Redvers explains. "I switched very quickly from the jumps to flat racing and, despite the fact that standing stallions is extremely difficult unless you have an awful lot of resources, we started off with cheaper commercial ones and from there it developed."

Despite gaining a considerable reputation for spotting talent in a Thoroughbred without a premium price, and for his pivotal role in creating the *Racing Post* Bonus Scheme, the entrepreneur who famously took part in the storming of the House of Commons in protest against the Hunting Bill, needed a bigger slice of fortune at the end of the last decade.

That came when he was head-hunted by Sheikh Fahad bin Abdulla Al Thani at the start of 2010. As a result, Redvers found himself at the centre of racing's new dynamic operation.

He describes the initial meeting of minds: "Sheikh Fahad phoned me with a view to dipping his toe into the water, as he had fallen in love with the game while at university here and took a fancy to the different angles into British racing," he says. "He appreciated it was the best in the world and wanted to invest a bit of money and luckily has enjoyed plenty of success. He is fascinated by it and extremely shrewd--he spends a lot of time studying the form and is top-notch at reading it and reading a race also--second to none." **Cont. p9**



Thanks mainly to the instant success courtesy of the Pattern-race winners Frederick Engels (GB) (Iceman {GB}), Lightning Pearl (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) and Melbourne Cup hero Dunaden (Fr) (Nicobar {GB}), Pearl Bloodstock is a new enterprise growing at speed.

“Sheikh Fahad very much likes the fact that we are punching above our weight and we now have 45 horses in training, with the results over and above what you would expect,” Redvers continues. “I am pretty certain that he is not going to turn around and say that he wants 150 horses in training to take on the other big operations, but he is intrigued by the business. I chose to take the route of having a good balance of horses, as I saw buying a load of yearlings as the quickest way to disaster. I took a view that the best way to guarantee success was to selectively buy horses in training and the results have been stunning. You have to buy a large percentage of yearlings to give yourself a chance of having another [G1 Cheveley Park S. winner] Lightning Pearl, for instance, as the opportunity of buying Group 1 winners is very slim. We have a broad spectrum of horses and I chose trainers I like and rate and who I get on well with. The list has extended to about 20 worldwide, as we have left horses with their original trainers, but that will grow and shrink in the future. At the moment, we have as many as we would want, but Sheikh Fahad likes his horses spread around so that all the eggs are not in one basket.”

While Pearl Bloodstock is Sheikh Fahad’s own racing operation, Qatar Bloodstock, which also involves his brothers, is the business-orientated commercial branch of the Thoroughbred interests. It boasts the acquisition of Makfi and more recently the exciting Strong Suit (Rahy). He was not seen to best effect from a terrible draw at the Breeders’ Cup, but the multiple group winner remains one of 2012’s potential stars. Also under this umbrella are a collection of top broodmares and the 2009 G1 Prix de l’Abbaye winner Total Gallery (Ire) (Namid {GB}). Most importantly, the Al Thanis’ Qipco investment company has made reality the British Champions Series, which so successfully culminated at Ascot last month.

None of this has come by accident to Redvers, who is famed for his “eye” for a horse (that comes from his father, he suggests). As Tattersalls December approaches, Tweenhills has a 20-strong representation in the foal catalogue, which includes a Sea the Stars (Ire) colt out of the dual-listed scorer Ripples Maid (GB) (Dansili {GB}). “The Sea the Stars is as smart a foal as in the whole catalogue,” Redvers boasts.

In the mares book there is the 13-year-old Ventura (Ire) (Spectrum {Ire}). Bought here 12 months ago for Qatar Bloodstock as a trading mare for 260,000gns, the dam of this year’s G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest heroine Moonlight Cloud (GB) (Invincible Spirit {Ire}) is just the latest example of the foresight which keeps him at the forefront of this tough industry. There is little time to reflect on the mileage covered so far.

“I constantly prefer to look forward rather than back and it all comes down to the stunning farm I am very lucky to have,” he concludes. “Since 1995, I have added two more farms and am looking to develop the whole time. At the moment, it is at 80% capacity, so there is still a great deal more to do. Other than the Stud, I am most proud of my involvement in the British Champions Series and the *Racing Post* Bonus Scheme, which are good for the industry. I am very lucky to be where I am.”
