



MONTJEU COLT TOPS TATTS OPENER

A colt by Montjeu (Ire) provided the highlight of the Tattersalls December Yearling Sale in Newmarket Monday when selling for 150,000gns. The yearling was one of only two lots to pass the six-figure mark yesterday. Bred by Mogeely Stud and offered from the

Hillman family's Castledillon Stud, the colt--out of Group 3-placed Ghurra (War Chant)--had been returned when making €200,000 at the Arqana Yearling Sale at Deauville in August. David Redvers, acting for Sheikh Fahad Al Thani's Pearl Bloodstock, struck the successful bid yesterday after seeing off first trainer Gerard Butler, standing with owner Alan

Spence, and finally Anani Antoniadis, who often acts for Russian-based Stud 711.

"I believe he had a throat infection, which was why he was returned at Deauville, and he was a colt who just had a bit of quality about him," explained Redvers. "He's the 33rd yearling we've got for Pearl now, but we've still to finalise a trainer for him. We have bought a handful more horses privately this year and are struggling to keep under a total of 50 horses in training. We may have to sell a couple!"

M V Magnier of Coolmore was the day's other six-figure spender, going to 110,000gns for an Acclamation (GB) filly sold from the Cashman family's Rathbarry Stud who had missed the Goffs Orby Sale.

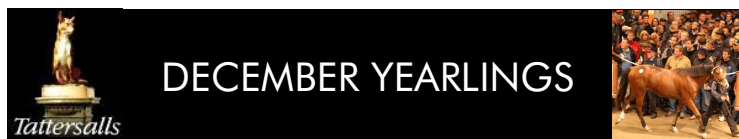
"She was recommended by the Cashmans and I believe she had to miss Goffs because she got a temperature," Magnier said. "It's still to be finalised where she is going into training, but we'll get her home and decide."

Dream Ahead's owner Khalifa Dasmal paid 80,000gns through his racing manager Mark Crossman for an Oasis Dream (GB) filly out of a granddaughter of champion Three Troikas (Fr) offered from Trickleddown Stud.

"The idea is that she will eventually go to Dream Ahead at Ballylinch Stud when he could need support in his third year," said Crossman. "She was a correct filly with a good page and is likely to go into training with [Dream Ahead's trainer] David Simcock." **Cont. p2**

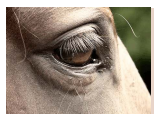

Juddmonte's nine-year foal share arrangement with Coolmore certainly has had its moments. After making a tremendous start in 2002, when Brian Boru, Powerscourt and Illustrator filled first, second and third places in the G1 Racing Post Trophy, this year has seen the mighty Frankel carry all before him and Await The Dawn develop into a leading middle-distance performer.

The partnership, which centered on Sadler's Wells, also produced some other notable horses. Soviet Moon never made it to the races, but that didn't stop her from producing the Derby and Arc winner Workforce for Juddmonte, and now Silk and Scarlet is also shaping up very well as a broodmare. American racegoers may know her as the dam of Master of Hounds, who ran on to finish a fine fifth in Animal Kingdom's Kentucky Derby, having earlier failed by only a nose to win the G2 UAE Derby. Silk and Scarlet's first foal, the Japanese-trained Eishin Apollon, has done even better. **Cont. p4**

This son of Giant's Causeway finally became a Group 1 winner two days ago when he defeated a strong field in the Mile Championship at Kyoto. However, he had already established himself among the leaders of his generation, as is shown by the Japanese Classification of 2-year-olds in 2009. Eishin Apollon ranked second, three pounds below Rose Kingdom.

Eishin Apollon in turn was rated three pounds superior to Apapane and Victoire Pisa.

For readers to fully appreciate the quality of this achievement, I need to point out that Rose Kingdom went on to be a close second in the Japanese Derby

before being awarded the 2010 Japan Cup; Apapane won both the Japanese 1,000 Guineas and Oaks in 2010 and recently finished a fine third to Snow Fairy in the Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup; and Victoire Pisa won the Japanese 2,000 Guineas and Arima Kinen in 2010, before his emotional victory in this year's Dubai World Cup.

Eishin Apollon slipped down the rankings at three, when he twice went close to victory at Group 2 level, but a lengthy absence from the track, plus a return to a mile from longer distances, has worked wonders. He won the G3 Fuji S. as a prelude to his Mile Championship win.

Silk and Scarlet was taken by Coolmore when the 2002 foals were divided up at the end of the year. As is Aiden O'Brien's habit, he didn't waste any time with the filly. He introduced her June 9 at Leopardstown, where she finished a promising second, and the filly quickly proceeded to win a six-furlong listed race in July and the G2 Debutante S. over seven furlongs in August, when she was followed home by the future Group 1 winners Luas Line and Chelsea Rose.

At this stage, a Group 1 win seemed likely to come Silk and Scarlet's way, but she could finish no closer than fourth in the French 1,000 Guineas and fifth in the Epsom Oaks.

I looked back at my notes from the end of 2000 to remind myself of the reasons why Silk and Scarlet's dam, the Lyphard mare Danilova, was included on the short list for Prince Khalid's approval. **Cont. p5**

Mating Danilova to Sadler's Wells produced 2x3 inbreeding to Northern Dancer, with such close inbreeding being something I am not normally eager to suggest. This time, though, there seemed to be strong grounds for making an exception. Back in 1995 another of Juddmonte's Lyphard mares, Skimble, had been sent to Sadler's Wells's three-parts brother Nureyev. This mating resulted in a colt, Skimming, who won the GI Pacific Classic in the summer of 2000 (and was to repeat that victory in 2001).

Also, there was a growing amount of evidence that pairing Sadler's Wells with the smaller, speedier and more muscular Lyphard was a rewarding means of inbreeding to the great Northern Dancer. The advertisements for this type of cross with Coolmore's champion sire included Stagecraft, a winner of Royal Ascot's G1 Prince of Wales's S. who was out of a mare by Lyphard's son Bellypha; the G1 Prix Lupin winner and GI Breeders' Cup Mile runner-up Johann Quatz, whose second dam was by Lyphard; and Beat Hollow, Juddmonte's G1 Grand Prix de Paris winner in 2000, who is out of a mare by Lyphard's brilliant son Dancing Brave.

Danilova was one of the preferred options among Juddmonte's Lyphard mares, as she was the right physical type and had already shown herself capable of producing a group winner. Her Warning colt Danger Over had shown surprising speed to win the 2000 edition of the G3 Prix de Seine-et-Oise over six furlongs. What's more, Danilova had the attraction of being out of a mare by Irish River, who already ranked as the broodmare sire of three Group 1 winners by Sadler's Wells. The effectiveness of the Sadler's Wells/Irish River cross is highlighted by its final total of five Group 1 winners and a pair of Group 3 winners. Fillies bred this way have also excelled as broodmares, notably producing the major winners Henrythenavigator and Conduit.

Danilova's credentials as a mate for Sadler's Wells also included being a half-sister to the Prix du Jockey-Club winner Sanglamore, their dam being Ballinderry, winner of the G2 Ribblesdale S. Ballinderry in turn was a half-sister to Lydian, a dual Group 1 winner by Lyphard.

Although Silk and Scarlet proved worthy of her bloodlines, the next few years provided a reminder of the uncertainties of bloodstock breeding. Danilova returned to Sadler's Wells on a further three occasions. Coolmore took all three of Silk and Scarlet's younger siblings, but only one of them managed to win.

It will be interesting to see whether Silk and Scarlet's sisters make amends as broodmares. The first, My Dark Rosaleen, was sold for 190,000gns after failing to find the winner's circle in 10 attempts. She has 2010 and 2011 colts by Dalakhani. Danilova's third Sadler's Wells filly, Quelle Vitesse, won only a small race in the French Provinces, but her pedigree was strong enough for her to fetch 220,000gns a few months later. She has a 2011 colt by Dansili which is scheduled to be sold at Tattersalls later this week, and the mare also comes under the hammer next week, in foal to Dalakhani. For her part, Silk and Scarlet has no reported produce for 2010, after foaling a Dansili colt in May 2009, and she has a Smart Strike weanling filly.

To get back to Eishin Apollon, his Kyoto victory means that Giant's Causeway's record with daughters of Sadler's Wells now stands at five stakes winners from 38 foals, which equates to 13%. One of the others is Giants Play, winner of the 1 1/4-mile GII New York S. on turf earlier this year.

The 4-year-old's win also makes him the 19th northern hemisphere Group 1/Grade I winner for the former champion sire.

Hollywood Derby to Feature European Flavor...

A pair of formidable European-based sophomores, plus another recent import, will add international appeal to Sunday's turf 10-furlong GI Hollywood Derby. Vinery Stables' **Western Aristocrat** (Mr. Greeley) shipped stateside to steal Belmont's GI Jamaica H. on the front end Oct. 8 ([video](#)) and, after returning to his

home base at Newmarket in the interim, the dark bay has ventured further from home, arriving in the California last Wednesday and clearing quarantine Friday. "He stayed at Belmont about a week, and it was decided to get him back

in his own environment," explained Wayne Tanner, assistant to conditioner Jeremy Nosedá. "Jeremy and [Vinery President Tom Ludt] sat down and talked and decided to come back here." Western Aristocrat will breeze at Hollywood on Wednesday, and will be piloted in the race by Corey Nakatani, who was aboard for the Jamaica.

Khalid Abdullah's MGSP **Slumber (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}) will also contest the Hollywood Derby. The Charles Hills pupil is a two-time winner at 1 1/4 miles, and most recently annexed the Oct. 29 James Seymour S. at Newmarket over that trip. Jockey Garret Gomez will be in the irons.

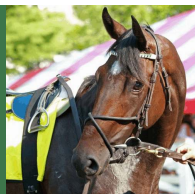
Magalen Bryant's **Venomous (GB)** (Red Ransom) came with a furious late rally while weaving through traffic to be a hard-luck second in the GII Oak Tree Derby at Santa Anita Oct. 15 in his first North American start. Trained by Tony Clout in France and in the Oak Tree Derby, the bay makes his first start for Leonard Powell Sunday. "The one question mark will be the distance," Powell told *Daily Racing Form*. "In Europe, he was racing in [mile races]. Last time, I don't think the extra furlong bothered him." The G1 Poule D'Essai Des Poulains third-place finisher drilled five furlongs in 1:01 flat over the Hollywood Cushion Track Saturday, getting his final furlong in ":23 and change," according to Powell. Joel Rosario gets the return call on Venomous.

West Virginia Supreme Court Limits Track Exclusions:

The West Virginia Supreme Court handed down a decision Friday which restricts the state's racetracks from ruling off license holders before a racing commission review. The case was brought by Charles Town Races and Slots and involved the track's 2009 efforts to exclude seven jockeys from its premises before the riders had received an appeal hearing from West Virginia's Racing Commission. The commission had imposed 30-day suspensions and fines for weighing-out violations and the riders were ejected from the track despite a circuit court injunction staying the sanctions. The circuit court initially ruled that Charles Town was not allowed to eject the riders because the track was working in concert with the commission. In its decision affirming the circuit court's ruling, the state's Supreme Court stated, "Any person ejected by the stewards or the association from the grounds of an association shall be denied admission to the grounds until permission for his or her reentry has been obtained from the association and the Racing Commission. However, all occupation permit holders who are ejected have the right of appeal to the Racing Commission."



Old Friends Recieves ASPCA Grant: Edited Press Release

Old Friends, the Thoroughbred Retirement Facility and 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization, has received a second \$50,000 grant from the American Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (ASPCA). In 2009, Old Friends was one of five organizations chosen to participate in the ASPCA's "Rescuing Racers Initiative," a \$1 million granting opportunity made possible by a generous donor designed to support horses impacted by the racing industry. Old Friends also received a \$50,000 grant in 2010. The majority of the funds will be used to construct four new paddocks on Old Friends's Dream Chase Farm in Georgetown, KY, allowing the organization to provide safe retirement for even more Thoroughbreds. Old Friends supports more than 100 retired racehorses, including a dozen on its satellite facility in New York, Old Friends at Cabin Creek: The Bobby Frankel Division. The farms are open to tourists daily by appointment. "We are so grateful for this funding," said Michael Blowen. "We appreciate the support and confidence the ASPCA has in Old Friends to continue its mission." In 2010 the ASPCA awarded more than \$1 million in the form of 93 grants to equine rescue groups and humane organizations in 32 states, nearly doubling the \$546,789 distributed in 2009. The ASPCA works to protect and aid horses through legislation, advocacy, education, targeted grants, and enforcement of the carriage horse and cruelty laws in New York City.
