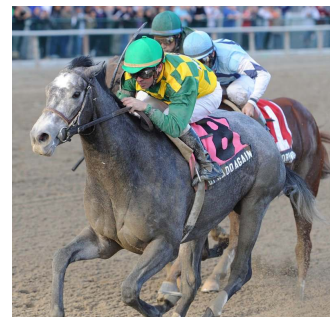
TWO-YEAR-OLD SPOTLIGHT

Juveniles took centerstage in graded stakes races at Churchill Downs and Aqueduct Saturday. Anita Cauley's **On Fire Baby** (Smoke Glacken) stole the show in Louisville, following her GII Pocahontas S. score with a dominating performance in the GII Golden Rod S.

Doing it well within himself, the handsome bay gained command in midstretch and was never seriously threatened by the late rally of Hymn Book. Hall of Fame trainer Bill Mott also campaigned the brilliant Cigar, who this race was renamed in honor of in 1997. "It's been a great month," said Mott, still basking in the glow of

Drosselmeyer (Distorted Humor)'s upset win in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic and Royal Delta (Empire Maker) in the GI Breeders' Cup Ladies' Classic. "We've got no complaints." Mott continued, "He's been really eating up good and it didn't look like we hurt his feelings too much in the Classic. I thought he ran well in there and he came back very sound and feeling good. I think [one mile] is an ideal distance for him; I think he's a very fast horse as the 1:33 and change would indicate. Actually, I think he's put on a little bit of flesh since the Classic, if you could imagine that."

Jose Lezcano has been in the irons during To Honor and Serve's last three races. "He broke well and I was able to make him relax," Lezcano said. "I had plenty of horse turning for home, I tapped him on the shoulder, and he changed leads and took off. I'm very happy with the way he finished." To Honor and Serve will be brought back for a 4-year-old campaign. "He's going to go home to Live Oak [in Florida] and rest for a little bit," Weber said.

Reigning juvenile filly champion Awesome Feather, sidelined by a suspensory injury for much of her sophomore campaign, was looking for the second Grade I victory of her career. Winner of last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies just two days before selling for \$2.3 million at the Fasig-Tipton November sale, the bay filly took the Oct. 5 Le Slew S. in her first outing for Stronach Stables. Awesome Feather, the obvious class of this eight-horse field, raced keenly as she chased pacesetter Love and Pride through fractions of :24.93 and :48.97. She forged past that rival after three-quarters in 1:12.41 and powered clear under a hand ride. "I was a little nervous there, but she's a pro," admitted trainer Chad Brown. "She's got the heart of a champion. We just try to stay out of her way in the morning training her and just try to take care of her, day-to-day. She does the rest every day. It was a pretty special win." As for what is next for the champion, Brown added, "We've just been taking it day-by-day with her. As long as she's 100% healthy, we'll probably see her in the Sunshine Millions at Gulfstream [Jan. 28]. That'd be the plan, but we're going to see how she is first, but if she's OK, that's where I'd go." Jockey Jeffrey Sanchez added, "She is unbelievable. She is little, but she is unbelievable. I didn't go to the lead, I sat there, took back. At the half-mile pole, I knew I was going to win the race. I had a lot of confidence in her."

O'Prado Again got it right in his fourth career attempt, going nine furlongs in an off-the-turfer over the Keeneland Polytrack Oct. 28, and earned a trip to the big leagues here. Settled in midpack through a quarter mile in :24.38, he crept up closer down the backstretch, tugging his way to race in third following a half mile in :49.97. With Kent Desormeaux aboard, O'Prado Again was under a ride while holding his position at the top of the stretch, and came with a sustained rally down the lane to nail the pacesetter late. "I think he's a special horse," trainer Dale Romans said. "The further he goes, the better he gets. He was training so well that we thought he

would run a big race, so we decided to run in the Remsen. Kent [Desormeaux] rode him with a lot of confidence." As for what's next Romans added, "We'll ship him to Florida and he probably won't race the rest of the year. There is a slim chance he could run at Hollywood [in the GI CashCall Futurity Dec. 17], but we will probably wait until next year. We think he is a Kentucky Derby horse, so we will treat him like that." O'Prado Again continues to improve with racing experience. A debut sixth in a five-furlong affair in the Churchill slop June 18, he reported home a closer seventh when stretched out and switched to grass at Saratoga Sept. 3, then rallied to finish third on the Keeneland lawn Oct. 9. Desormeaux added, "He's silky smooth, like [Fusaichi Pegasus] was. You can't tell his feet hit the ground. He's really, really smooth."

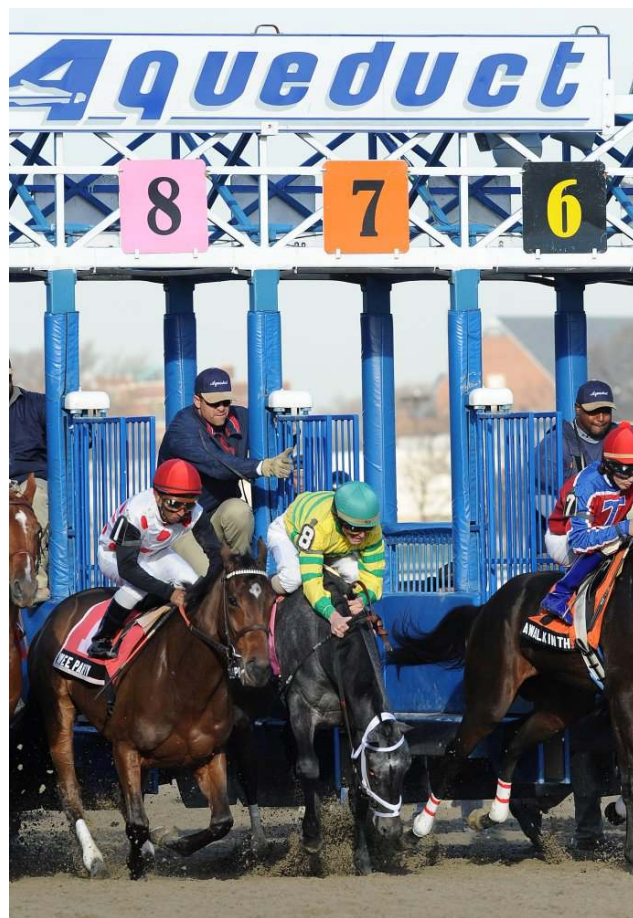

Disposablepleasure, a double-digit maiden winner going 1 1/16 miles at third asking at Belmont last time Oct. 6, ran a remarkable race to get the money here. The gray stumbled badly at the start, and caboosed the field of 10 through a half mile in :48.31. With Ramon Dominguez aboard, she began to make an eye-catching move approaching the far turn, but was forced to hit the brakes in traffic. Disposablepleasure quickly regained her composure once again, split horses to gain the lead in the stretch and was all heart to get the money.


Demoiselle S. cont.

“The only thing I thought [when she stumbled at the start] is maybe it’s Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy) again,” trainer Todd Pletcher recalled of the 2007 GI Belmont S. heroine, who also stumbled horribly when they sprung the latch. “That was bad to start with, but she really started her run on the turn, picked up some momentum, and had to stop again. It was a very courageous effort for any horse, but especially a 2-year-old filly. She’s got a lot of natural ability, but she showed she’s got some heart and desire to go along with it. For any horse to win and overcome all that first time going 1 1/8 miles was impressive, but you don’t see too many 2-year-old fillies do that.” Disposablepleasure debuted with a close fourth going two turns over the Saratoga lawn Aug. 14, then switched to dirt with a runner-up effort in a route at Monmouth Sept. 10.

On Fire Baby, heroine of the GII Pocahontas S. over this strip Oct. 30, remained perfect on dirt with a tour-de-force here. Away from the stalls first, the gray was under a tight hold through a half mile in an easy :50.01, and set the stretch ablaze en route to a flashy victory. She becomes the seventh filly to pull off the Pocahontas/Golden Rod double. "You saw today how good she is and I think she's got plenty left in her," trainer Gary Hartlage said. "When she got away with that kind of a half, I didn't think she would get beat if she was the horse I thought she was and she did her thing. They let us walk like a dog and she's just that good. I've trained a couple of Grade II winners, but she's the best one I've ever had. In my opinion, she's one of the top three 2-year-old fillies in the country." Just how confident is Hartlage in his charge? "We're nominated to the Kentucky Oaks now and we'll also nominate her to the Kentucky Derby. I'm telling you, she is that good." On Fire Baby, a four-length debut winner at Ellis Park Aug. 19, tired to finish fifth in the GI Darley Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Aug. 19 prior to her aforementioned score beneath the Twin Spires.

I'll leave everything else up to [WinStar President] Elliot [Walden] and the trainer [Todd Pletcher]." Walden added, "He'll get a little bit of a breather and then we'll regroup and see where we go. I don't know if he'll come back to WinStar Farm [for the winter]. We'll have to figure that out." Ever So Lucky was returning on short notice after posting an eye-catching debut win going 6 1/2 furlongs beneath the Twin Spires Nov. 11. "He's still just a little bit green," trainer Jonathan Sheppard said. "He put up a good fight when that horse came to him and we were quite proud of him."

The progressive bay rewarded their faith with an explosive win yesterday. Victor of the GII San Gabriel S. at Santa Anita in his 2010 finale, Jeranimo raced well in his first five 2011 efforts without actually finding the winner's circle, with his placings including a close-up third in the GI Frank Kilroe Mile in April and a second in the GI Eddie Read H. in July. Well-beaten when tried on the main track in the GI Pacific Classic at Del Mar Aug. 28, he bounced back with a win over Mr. Commons (Artie Schiller) in the GII Oak Tree Mile at Santa Anita Oct. 8. He was beaten 5 3/4 lengths by Court Vision (Gulch) in the BC Mile after pressing the pace, but jockey Garrett Gomez--aboard for the first time since the Eddie Read--opted to take him farther back here. The pair traveled along smoothly in a mid-pack position as Bob Black Jack (Stormy Jack) set relaxed :24.21 and :48.68 splits. The field began to bunch at the quarter pole, but Jeranimo, fanning widest, swept past them all at the furlong grounds and won going away.

Pacific Ocean, purchased by Gary and Mary West for \$300,000 as a 2008 Keeneland September yearling, opened his racing career with three straight victories before suffering his first loss with a runner-up effort in the May 21 GIII Hanshin H. He finished seventh in the July 20 Bold Venture S. at Woodbine in his final start for the Wests and trainer Wayne Catalano. Purchased privately this summer and donning the black and yellow silks of Dennis and Mike Narlinger's JMJ Racing Stables for the first time here for trainer Mike Mitchell, the chestnut gelding was hustled to the lead from his inside post position and cut out fractions of :21.52 and :43.78. DREAM HEADS THE DAMES

A strong local contingent braces for the onslaught of several top internationals in today's G1 Japan Cup at Tokyo Racecourse, and the country's most prestigious

race could well come down to a handful of accomplished fillies and mares. Heading the internationals is Germany's super filly **Danedream (Ger)** (Lomitas {Ger}), who shocked the betting public at Longchamp with a 26-1, track-record-setting upset of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Oct. 2. Trainer

Peter Schiergen is confident heading into Danedream's first start since. "Her condition is great, and I think she looks good," he said Saturday morning. "I'm not worried about anything. It looks like the weather is going to be fine, which means the turf will be in good condition, so we're all looking forward to the race. I'm aware that there will be an enormous crowd, but it won't affect our filly. She really hates to lose, so she'll probably show us a strong performance." Filling the place spot in the Arc filly trifecta was **Shareta (Ire)**, (Sinndar {Ire}), who has also made the trip to Japan. "She has lost a bit of weight since she was in France, but it doesn't surprise me at all since she's traveled a long way," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre said. "Anyway, her condition is improving. She prefers a fast track, and the long stretch here will suit her. She can handle any kind of pace, so I'm going to let our jockey ride her the way he thinks fit."

Japan's chances would be stronger had the connections of this year's Triple Crown winner Orfevre (Jpn) (Stay Gold {Jpn}) not opted to bypass the race--next month's G1 Arima Kinen could be the chestnut's next target--but **Buena Vista (Jpn)** (Special Week {Jpn}) gives the local bench a big chance. First across the line in this race last year before being DQ'd to second behind **Rose Kingdom (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), the 5-year-old Buena Vista hasn't found the winner's circle yet this year, but was running late when she returned from a four-month absence to be a close-up fourth to **Tosen Jordan (Jpn)** (Jungle Pocket {Jpn}) in the G1 Tenno Sho Autumn over this course Oct. 30. **Sarah Lynx (Ire)** (Montjeu {Ire}), yet another of the fairer sex with a chance despite long odds, comes in off a win over males in the GI Canadian International Oct. 16. **Victoire Pisa (Jpn)** (Neo Universe {Jpn}) ran third here last year before winning the Arima Kinen, but hasn't seen the starter since his emotional win in the G1 Dubai World Cup in March. **Win Variation (Jpn)** (Heart's Cry {Jpn}) played the role of Sham to Orfevre (Jpn)'s Secretariat this year, finishing second to him in each of his last three, including the G1 Japanese Derby in May and the G1 Japanese St. Leger at Kyoto Oct. 23, and will offer a clue to the strength of Japan's current 3-year-old crop. GI Manhattan H. upsetter **Mission Approved** (With Approval) represents the U.S. and should be an early pace factor. "He's relaxed and happy --maybe happier than in the U.S.," said jockey Jose Espinoza. "The course here is wide and beautiful. I have to study about the horses we're against before forming a strategy, but we'll probably be near the front."

TEOFILO FILLY TOPS FOAL FINALE

The 2011 December Foal Sale at Tattersalls in Newmarket showed major advances on last year by the time it finished in Newmarket last night. The sale's 23,860,100gns turnover rose by 36% from 2010, the 21,000gns median was up 5%, and the 35,880gns average increased by 15%.

"The figures for this week are up across the board, mirroring the October Yearling Sale with double-digit increases in average, median and turnover, as well as significantly more

100,000 and 200,000 guineas transactions and a higher clearance rate than last year," said Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony.

"While the figures are understandably still shy of the 2006/2007 peak, they are the third best this century, and an amazing tribute to the resilience and professionalism of the bloodstock industry," Mahony continued. "Breeders have responded to the challenges of the prevailing economic climate by reducing numbers and concentrating on quality. Matching supply with demand is the key for so many industries, and this week's competitive foal trade suggests that real progress has been made in this regard, which can only stand the industry in good stead going forward."

A duel between James Wigan and eventual buyer John Ferguson saw a Teofilo (Ire) colt out of a half-sister to G1 Irish Oaks heroine Shawanda (Ire) (Sinndar {Ire}) make a session-topping 220,000gns. Victor Stud offered the colt, who was produced by the 6-year-old Stairway to Glory (Ire) (Kalanisi {Ire}), as [lot 1094](#).

"Teofilo has made a great start, and we were delighted to see this colt, because he's such a good-looking, athletic individual," said Ferguson. "We were also particularly interested in this colt because Sheikh Mohammed owns

Shawanda, whose 2-year-old Encke (Kingmambo) is a really exciting prospect. He's a full-brother to Genius Beast, and both colts could be a really important part of the Godolphin barn next season." **Cont. p12**

Sheikh Hamdan's team was also shopping for prospects. Shadwell's Racing Manager Angus Gold paid 200,000gns for an Invincible Spirit (Ire) filly sold by her breeder Bernie Cooke's Bryanstown House Stud as [lot 1075](#). Sheikh Hamdan already owns the filly's 2-year-old full-brother Ektihaam (Ire), who is with Newmarket trainer Roger Varian. Both horses were produced by Liscune (Ire) (King's Best).

"We think her full-brother is very good and, although he was disappointing in the G1 Dewhurst S. [last of nine], he is a big horse and it just came too soon for him," said Gold. "This was an April-born filly, and I'm sure she'll improve."

James Wigan, shut out on the session topper, came back to nab a Dansili (GB) filly out of a full-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner Domedriver (Ire) (Indian Ridge {Ire}) for 180,000gns. The filly, [lot 1157](#), is another whose next public appearance is likely to be on the racecourse rather than a sales ring.

"She has been bought for a client to race, although I can't say who," Wigan said after outbidding Liam Norris. "That's a difficult family to get into." Bred by Dominic Burke's Whitley Stud in Gloucestershire, the filly is was out of Nitya (Fr), who was bought for €150,000 at the 2008 Arqana December Sale by James Delahooke.

Options remain open for a 165,000gns filly ([lot 1216](#)) from the first crop of Champs Elysees (GB) (Danehill) who is a sibling to G2 Prix Eugene Adam winner Shimraan (Fr) (Rainbow Quest). The filly, bred by Richard Kent and Allan Stennett's Allseasons Bloodstock and consigned by Mickley Stud, was bought by Cathy Grassick. Liam Norris was underbidder, while Damian Burns of Lodge Park Stud was another to bid into six figures.


"We were looking for fillies with pedigrees. She'll go back to Ireland, and all options are open," said Grassick, sitting with her client Yvonne Jacques.

Tattersalls's Edmond Mahony added, "Demand for yearlings drives the foal market, and the strength of our October Yearling Sale gave the British and Irish bloodstock industry a real lift and a sense of renewed confidence that has been evident throughout this week's Tattersalls December Foal Sale.

"Pinhookers from all over Europe and further afield, combined with many of the world's leading owners, have been active at all levels of the market and between them have contributed to a highly successful sale.

"Looking ahead to next week, we have a quality breeding stock catalogue that looks set to attract the usual cosmopolitan crowd of buyers, and should bring the 2011 Tattersalls sales season to a successful conclusion."



George's 'Destiny' Returns to Tattersalls...

There have been few more electric days in recent years at Tattersalls than the evening in October 2009 when a filly by the brilliant George Washington (Ire) (Danehill) became her ill-fated sire's lone foal to be offered at public auction. Subsequently named **Date With Destiny (Ire)**, the filly was bought by Buckinghamshire-based owner Julie Wood for 320,000gns and put into training with Richard Hannon. She has not let her connections down, winning a Newbury maiden on debut last year and getting black-type in May when finishing third in the Listed Oaks Trial. Tomorrow evening, she will move on to the next stage of her career when she is offered as [lot 1517](#) at the first session of the Tattersalls Mares Sale.

"You do sometimes think you will keep a filly, but we said when we bought her that we were not going to breed from her, so we stuck with what we always planned and will bring her to the sales," said Wood.

George Washington's story captured many racing fans. The 1.15-million guineas sale topper at the 2004 Tattersalls October Sale, he went on to win four Group 1s, including the 2000 Guineas, before proving sub-fertile at Coolmore Stud. He returned to training in 2007, and was tragically mortally injured in that year's GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Monmouth.

"Date With Destiny has had quite a following, and we've had huge interest through cards and e-mails and people have liked to know when she was running," added Wood. "The racecourses have been very good when she has run, and they made a big announcement at Yarmouth in September that here was a unique filly racing.

"A lot of people have stopped to ask me about her at the sale, and she's in good order and she is being sold as a filly in training, and could race on or be bred from. As well as being a one-off, she is a lovely specimen, and, if she is an example of what George Washington would produce, then he would have been a very popular sire."

Wood has no regrets about buying the filly and being part of the George Washington story over the past couple of seasons.

"We were going to enjoy her whatever her achievements, and she has been a pleasure to own," she said. "You could see that she enjoyed what she was doing. It is emotional to be selling her. Certain horses touch you, and she's one because of her uniqueness, and I hope she can find her next home for similar reasons. I've never seen the place so packed as when we bought her as a yearling--you could have heard a pin drop. I've just been thrilled we had her, and it's nice to be bringing her back to Tattersalls."

Wood and her husband Chris, a surgeon now involved in the pharmaceutical industry, have been supporting another equine great with his first foals over the past couple of weeks.

They tried for some of Sea the Stars (Ire)'s foals at Tattersalls, having previously-- buying as Woodstock-- bought a €300,000 filly by the six-time Group 1 winner at Goffs the week before.

"We got the Sea the Stars filly at Goffs last week to race, and she is another very exciting prospect," said Wood. "There was a similarly unique atmosphere in Ireland as when Date With Destiny was sold as a yearling at Newmarket."
