ARQANA **DECEMBER BREEDING STOCK SALE**

BRISTLING ARQANA TRADE YIELDS RECORD AVERAGE

The fireworks evident at Goffs' and Tattersalls' recent breeding stock sales did not relent once Arqana's December Sale began at Deauville yesterday, and by the end of trade, a new record average had been set. There were 37 six-figure transactions all told--nine more than a year ago--and the action started as early as the second lot through the ring when His Highness The Aga Khan's [hip 3](#), the listed-placed sophomore **Celenza (Fr)** (Dansili {GB}), went the way of France Turf for €120,000.

As is customary, it was not the only high-profile selection offered from the Aga Khan draft. That source

also provided the nearly white **Artistique (Ire)** (Linamix {Fr}), the day's highlight once darkness had descended, at €520,000 (approximately US\$697,044). Offered in foal to Cape Cross (Ire) as [hip 213](#), she ultimately fell to Robert Nataf of

Horse France, standing alongside Paul Shanahan and M.V. Magnier, who outlasted Blandford Bloodstock's Tom Goff. The 15-year-old, winner of the 1999 G3 Prix Berteux, is out of the G1 Oaks d'Italia runner-up Armarama (GB) (Persian Bold {Ire}). She is the dam of five winners, the most notable of which is the 2008 G1 Juddmonte Grand Prix de Paris hero Montmartre (Fr) (Montjeu {Ire}).

"She was, in my opinion, the standout in the catalogue," commented Nataf. "It was a rare opportunity to purchase a mare capable of breeding a Group 1 winner, so I was keen to get her." Cont. p2

Second-highest price of the day was the €450,000 paid early by Nicolas de Watrigant of Mandore International Agency for Haras du Quesnay's [hip 24](#), the 4-year-old **Jumoooh (GB)** (Monsun {Ger}). Offered in foal to Invincible Spirit (Ire), the Shadwell-bred is a half-sister to last year's G2 Queen Mary S. winner and MG1SP Maqaasid (GB) (Green Desert), who hit the board in this term's G1 1000 Guineas. Blue-hen Height of Fashion (Fr) (Bustino {GB}) is her third dam, and she is out of a half-sister to the 2009 G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Coronation S. victress Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway), and the Group 1 placegetters Mawathee (Danzig) and Rumoush (Rahy).

"Jumoooh was just about the best-looking mare in the book and possesses an exceptional pedigree," opined de Watrigant. "She's by a top-class sire [Monsun], is carrying her first foal by an exciting stallion, and is from a developing pedigree."

It was later revealed the purchase was made on behalf of Ling and Christophe Tsui, as was de Watrigant's winning bid of €400,000 for the Haras des Sablonnets-offered **Hidden Silver (GB)** (Anabaa). Led in as [hip 176](#), the 11-year-old is the dam of the 2009 G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains victor Silver Frost (Ire) (Verglas {Ire}) and was offered with a Dubawi (Ire) covering. Her yearling colt (by Galileo {Ire}) realised a sale-topping price when selling for €310,000 at this venue's October Yearling Sale.

"She's an attractive mare by a good damsire [Anabaa] and, as the dam of a Classic winner, she was an enticing proposition," added de Watrigant.

The agent completed a trio of purchases for the Tsuis when landing Haras des Capucines [hip 194](#), the winning 3-year-old **Scarlet and Gold (Ire)** Peintre Celebre), for €240,000. She is a half-sister to the 2009 G1 Prix du Jockey Club hero Le Havre (Ire) (Noverre) and, like Jumoooh and Hidden Silver, is ultimately bound for a covering by Sea the Stars (Ire).

Hidden Silver's €400,000 tag matched the price achieved four lots earlier when Haras d'Etreham's [hip 172](#), **May Kiersey (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), went the way of Shadai Farm, who denied Paul Makin after a tense struggle. The 7-year-old is a full-sister to the MG1SP Gagnoa (Ire) and a 3/4-sister to this year's G1 Epsom Derby hero Pour Moi (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}). She sold with the added enticement of a covering to Fastnet Rock (Aus), who was responsible for four Classic winners in Australia and New Zealand this year.

Tetsuya Yoshida, accompanied by Patrick Barbe, struck again on behalf of Shadai Farm when going to €360,000 for the 4-year-old Classic winner **Evading Tempete (GB)** (Dubai Destination). Consigned by Haras des Capucines as [hip 185](#), the globetrotting distaffer registered her career high in last term's G3 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas) and will increase her air-mile tally with a one-way ticket to Japan.

“May Kiersey and Evading Tempete are good-looking mares with nice pedigrees,” commented Yoshida. “They will ship to Japan, but a decision regarding which stallion they will visit has yet to be made.”

Paul Fudge’s Waratah Thoroughbreds made a mighty impression when shelling out €1.7 million for a Galileo (Ire) filly at the August Yearling Sale here, and the spree continued at Tattersalls’ Park Paddocks earlier this week. There was no let up yesterday when Alain and Gerard Wertheimer’s [hip 161 Insoumise \(Ire\)](#) (Galileo {Ire}) was knocked down for €350,000. The bay sophomore is a half-sister to the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud victress Plumania (GB) (Anabaa), and the G2 Prix de Royallieu winner Balladeuse (Fr) (Singspiel {Ire}).

“She’s from a good family and is a half-sister to good horses,” said Fudge. “She’s a lovely looking sort who will suit our breeding programme.”

Close-of-trade returns revealed a 5% increase on turnover, despite a downturn in clearance rate. The average surged almost 19% to €74,044, a new sale record. The median leapt forward by a third to €40,000. Selling continues at 11 a.m. today. The catalogue and full returns can be viewed at www.arqana.com.

Freddy Head paid €110,000 for the then-2-year-old Jumoooh at this sale in 2009, the same year Ghanaati (Giant’s Causeway), produced by a sister of her dam, won the G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Coronation S. Jumoooh’s half-sister gave even more luster to an already brilliant pedigree, as Maqaasid (GB) (Green Desert), younger by a year, won the 2010 G2 Queen Mary S. and was third in the G1 Cheveley Park S., then came back to be third in this year’s 1000 Guineas. Jumoooh placed in January of this year for trainer Head, who also owned the filly, but after being put in foal to Invincible Spirit (Ire) this spring, her real value was realized in a return trip to Deauville.

Blandford Bloodstock reached in and secured Main Spring for 20,000gns at last year’s Tattersalls December Sale, which looked like a bargain after her half-brother My Kingdom of Fife (GB) (Kingmambo)--knocked down to Kern/Lillingston a few months earlier at TATAUT for 60,000gns--went on to win Australia’s G1 AJC Queen Elizabeth S., G2 A.D. Hollindale S. and two other Group 3s this term. A maiden at the time of her purchase last December, Main Spring was put in foal to second-season sire Tamayuz (GB) (Nayef)--who stands at Derrinstown Stud for a fee of €15,000--and elicited much more attention 12 months later.

Rocatella was hammered down to BBA Germany for a bargain €7,000 (\$9,678) at the Goffs September Yearling Sale in 2008. The filly debuted for Stall H20 and trainer Werner Hefter a year later, and while she took a few races to come around, went on to place in a trio of Group 3 events and secure a career high in the Listed Royal Mares S. at San Siro this past June. To date, Rocatella has earned in excess of \$160,000. Add that to yesterday’s sale price, and she realized a huge return on her connections’ initial investment. Rocatella was consigned by her trainer.

Hidden Silver was knocked down to Broadhurst Agency for €55,000 at this event in 2006 while in foal to Verglas (Ire). She had already produced a colt by that stallion who in 2009 won the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains as Silver Frost (Ire). The foal Hidden Silver was carrying at the 2006 DEADEC sale--the Haras des Sablonnets-bred Blazon (Fr)--subsequently was hammered down to John Ferguson for €360,000 (\$529,020) at the 2008 Arqana August Yearling Sale. That transaction occurred after Silver Frost had won the G3 Prix de Cabourg, but before his Classic win. Hidden Silver's next two foals were bought at auction, but Haras des Sablonnets returned Hidden Silver to Deauville yesterday, and realized the day's co-third-highest price. The Normandy-based Haras des Sablonnets is owned by Antoine de Talouet-Roy.

STRONG HAND FOR HOLLENDORFER IN BAYAKOA Hall of Fame conditioner Jerry Hollendorfer boasts two strong chances in today's GII Bayakoa H. at Hollywood. **City to City**, winner of the GII Palomar H. at Del Mar Sept. 5, will return to a synthetic surface for the first time since 2009. She was most recently second in the GII Las Palmas S. at Santa Anita Nov. 6. Fellow Hollendorfer pupil **Washington Bridge** was a 5-1 winner of this event last year, but the bay hasn't returned to the winner's circle in eight efforts this season. She's been knocking on the door, however, and was beaten just 1 1/2 lengths last time when third in the turfy Swingtime S. at Santa Anita Oct. 8. Winner All Star Heart (Arch) came back to beat City to City by two lengths with an impressive late kick in the Las Palmas. Lightly raced 3-year-old **Bauble Queen** could have the most upside of this bunch. The dark bay was a 5 1/2-length graduate in her third try sprinting here in June before annexing an optional claimer on the Del Mar grass in July.

She was a close second in the Aug. 19 Sandy Blue H. back in Oceanside, and was most recently third in the GIII Harold C. Ramser Sr. S. at Santa Anita Oct. 16. Conditioner Eric Kruljac gives his charge a good chance to return to her winning ways as she gets back to the site of her first victory. "She seems to have a little trouble with the tight turns on the grass at Del Mar and Santa Anita," he told *Daily Racing Form*. "We've got a lot bigger turns, and it's not as sharp [here]. Hopefully, she won't lose her chance."



Hall of Famer Bayakoa (Arg) bankrolled over \$2.8 million while winning 21 of 39 career starts. She won 12 Grade I events in the U.S., including the 1989-90 renewals of the Breeders' Cup Distaff, and captured two Eclipse Awards.

CUP CHANCE FOR U.S. BREDS?

It's been eight years since the Doug O'Neill-trained, Jon Court-partnered Fleetstreet Dancer (Smart Strike) won the G1 Japan Cup Dirt, and, notably, that long since a foreign-trained horse even hit the board. With that dismal record on display, it's no surprise, then, that the Cup will go without an international runner for the second straight year. But there are a pair of horses with strong American ties--the Kentucky-breds **La Verita** and **Testa Matta**--representing the red, white and blue. A 4-year-old filly, La Verita probably holds the better hand when it comes to an upset chance. A \$320,000 KEESEP yearling from Lane's End's draft, the gray, purchased by North Hills Management, has 11 wins from 30 starts in Japan and over \$3.6 million in earnings. Seventh, beaten four lengths in last year's renewal of the Cup, La Verita has won a trio of minor local stakes this season and enters this off a strong second in the JBC Ladies Classic at Ohi Nov. 3. She was defeated by **Miracle Legend (Jpn)**, and along with that miss is one of two fillies in the Cup. La Verita goes from the four hole. Directly to her outside is Testa Matta. Bred by Waterford Farm and sold to Narvick International for a modest \$60,000 at the Barretts March Sale in 2008, Testa Matta has been a solid sort over the years. The 5-year-old won the Japan Dirt Derby in 2009, ran second in the G1 February S. last season, and this term added the G3 March S. over this strip in April. He returned from a four-month break to be seventh, beaten 3 1/2 lengths, in the Tokyo Chunichi Sports Hai Masashino S. Nov. 13, and will have to take a big step forward to figure in the outcome here. Testa Matta has six wins in 20 starts and nearly \$2.8 million in earnings. One local who could belie his 25-1 morning-line price is **Tosho Freak (Jpn)**. A late-developing 4-year-old, he was carrying a five-race winning skin into his first group test, the nine-furlong G3 Miyako S. at Kyoto Nov. 6, and could be a gate-to-wire threat if left along up front.

NORTH AMERICAN RIDERS RULE THE DAY

Apprentice Irad Ortiz Jr. also got his picture taken following the day's seventh race and posted a pair of runner-up finishes and a trio of thirds.

YOSHIHARA IN COMMAND IN JOCKEY SERIES

It was all about the local jockeys as the World Super Jockeys Series kicked off yesterday at Hanshin Racecourse in Japan. Hiroto Yoshihara built up a near-insurmountable lead during two-day, four-race competition after winning the first two legs. In the opener, the grassy 1400-meter Golden Saddle Trophy, Yoshihara booted home the 9-1 **Auxerrois** (Awesome Again) to win by 3/4 lengths over France's Ioritz Mendizabal and 11-1 **Kyoei Asura (Jpn)** (Swept Overboard) and his countryman Norihiro Yokoyama and 3-1 **Shiny Hawk (Jpn)** (Fuji Kiseki {Jpn}). In the second leg, Yoshihara was on the 3-2 choice Laser Bullet (Jpn) (Brian's Time), who romped by four lengths over the U.S.'s John Velazquez and the 36-1 **Jo Meteor (Jpn)** (Neo Universe {Jpn}) and Ireland's Johnny Murtagh and 126-1 **La Luce (Jpn)** (Kurofune). Japan's Yasunari Iwata finished fifth in both heats, and is in second place with 20 points, just ahead of Murtagh's 18. Velazquez sits in a tie for fourth with 16 points.
