VASE FIELD SINGING THE BLUES?

The G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Vase annually brings together a melange of some of the world's top middle-distance specialists with a sprinkling of stayers, and this year's renewal is no different. Godolphin's Mastery (GB) (Sulamani {Ire}) rallied in the stretch to defeat Khalid Abdullah's Redwood (GB) (High Chaparral {Ire}) 12 months back, and **Campanologist**

(Kingmambo) gives the boys in blue a strong chance to put them back to back. Runner-up to So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup in May, the 6-year-old went a bit off form over the summer, but hinted that better was to come with a runner-up effort

in the G2 Bosphorous Cup at Veilifendi Sept. 4. His road trip continued with handy scores in the G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne Sept. 25 and the G1 Gran Premio Jockey Club in Milan Oct. 16. "He has been in very good form recently, but since he has arrived here, he looks even better and stronger and his coat looks fantastic," said trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "I think it is a very open race and we just need the luck now." France has won three of the last four runnings of the Vase, and **Dunaden (Fr)** (Nicobar {GB}) will try to follow up on his dramatic victory over **Red Cadeaux (GB)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) in the G1 Emirates Melbourne Cup Nov. 1. The 5-year-old, winner at home of the G3 Prix de Barbeville over 3100 meters in April, showed he could handle this sharper trip with a handy score in the G3 Geelong Cup Oct. 19 and has galloped to rave reviews this week. Redwood's last-out seventh to Sarah Lynx (Ire) (Montjeu {Ire}) in the G1 Canadian International S. Oct. 16 is best forgiven, as he faltered on a rain-affected surface. He should prefer Sunday's underfoot conditions and rates an outside look. Foreign horses occupied the first five spots on the tote in the overnight hours. **Field p4**

'KILLER' MOVE IN HOLLYWOOD STARLET

Most of the G1 Hollywood Starlet S. money was centered on 4-5 **Weemissfrankie** (Sunriver) and 8-5 **Charm the Maker** (Empire Maker), but **Killer Graces** (Congaree) changed the script. The chestnut filly uncorked a bold move on the far turn and finished up determinedly to annex her first Grade I victory. "I think she kind of likes Hollywood Park," said winning trainer and co-owner Jerry Hollendorfer. "She's done very well here." Killer Graces was second by a nose when unveiled by trainer Rafael DeLeon in a May 1 dash over this surface. Acquired privately afterwards, the chestnut paid immediate dividends for her new connections by graduating in the Cinderella S. June 11 and adding the Landaluce S. July 16. "Now we have to get her to carry it over to another track," Hollendorfer added. "Truthfully, I don't have anything in mind for her, we were kind of shooting for this race. I haven't really thought about anything else yet--there will be plenty of races to look at." **Cont. p2**

Killer Graces was unplaced in a pair of Del Mar outings--sixth in the GIII Sorrento S. and fifth in Weemissfrankie's GI Debutante S.--before finishing second in the Soviet Problem S. at Fresno Oct. 9 in her route bow. She had the lead at the stretch call of the Sharp Cat S. over this track and trip Nov. 13, but couldn't resist Charm the Maker and settled for second. Jockey Joe Talamo opted for different tactics this time. Charm the Maker jumped away well, but was reined in by Garrett Gomez and proved reluctant to settle while racing in second behind Lady Pecan. That filly smoothly showed the way through splits of :23.52, :47.30 and 1:12.29, with Killer Graces tucked in on the rail a few lengths back, and Weemissfrankie far and away the caboose. Talamo gave Killer Graces her cue approaching the far turn and the juvenile responded smartly, forging to the lead in midstretch and fending off a resurgent Charm the Maker in the final yards. Weemissfrankie swung wide into lane, but her belated rally could only get her the bottom of the superfecta. Killer Graces is co-owned by trainer Jerry Hollendorfer, London-based Gillian Campbell and California resident Steve Melen. The Starlet winner has a yearling half-brother by Candy Ride (Arg) that sold for \$260,000 at KEESEP to Mark Casse as agent.

Pomeroy's Pistol, winner of the GII Forward Gal S. in January over this surface, was runner-up in both the GI Prioress S. at Belmont July 4 and GI Test S. at Saratoga Aug. 6. She punched her ticket to the Breeders' Cup with a four-length score in the GII Gallant Bloom H. at Belmont Sept. 24, and was an honorable fourth in the GI BC F/M Sprint at Churchill Nov. 4. She had posted just one breeze in the interim, but that didn't faze her here. Utilizing her rail post to secure a ground-saving trip, the even-money chalk came off the fence in the lane, and quickened past Pica Slew for her third graded trophy. "My only concern going into the race was the one post," said winning owner/breeder/trainer Amy Tarrant. "I wasn't worried that she's only had one workout since the Breeders' Cup--I know her and what she needs. She had three quality weeks turned out on the farm, but pretty much kept herself fit running around her paddock." Tarrant added, "We'll look at the [GIII] Hurricane Bertie [Feb. 19] and the [GII Inside Information S. Mar. 17] after that. She'll run in one, or maybe both."

CUP SERIOUS BUSINESS FOR CIRRUS

Connections hope that it will be third-time lucky for **Cirrus des Aigles (Fr)** (Even Top {Ire}), who makes his third appearance at the International meeting in as many years in today's G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup. After finishing down the field in the 2009 renewal, the bay could not overcome a wide alley and was seventh to Snow Fairy (Ire) (Intikhab) in this last December. But it's been a different story in 2011 for Cirrus des Aigles, who faces the starter for 11th time today. Winner of a trio of Group 3s in France in the late spring and summer, he missed by a neck to **Byword (GB)** (Peintre Celebre) in Longchamp's G2 Prix Dollar on Arc weekend, but bounced back with a 12-1 upset over So You Think (NZ) (High Chaparral {Ire}) in the G1 Qipco Champions S. at Ascot Oct. 15. Always a source of world-class caliber horses at this 2000-meter distance, Hong Kong has not been represented by a Cup winner since Vengeance of Rain (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) registered a popular victory back in 2005. The home team has gone excruciatingly close in three of the last four renewals, with runner-up efforts from Viva Pataca (GB) (2007) and Collection (Ire) (2009).

But in the form of Horse of the Year **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}); **Irian (Ger)** (Tertullian), who just missed last year; and **California Memory** (Highest Honor), there is significant cause for hope. Victorious in the Hong Kong Derby and G1 QE II Cup last spring, Ambitious Dragon enters this off a luckless second in the G2 Jockey Club Mile Nov. 20, where he travelled three wide without cover and was tagged on the money. He should get a softer trip from a reasonably low draw and should be flying late. California Memory was runner-up to Ambitious Dragon in the QE II Cup and comes into this off a trouble-filled fourth in the G2 Jockey Club Cup Nov. 20, while Irian finished willingly in that same event to be third, with a final quarter mile in :22.39. He could pick up the pieces late.

MILE FITS THE ‘CHOUX’

So versatile is Kiwi raider **Jimmy Choux (NZ)** (Thorn Park {Aus}) that the case could have been made for him in any one of three of the International Races. As a 3-year-old, the bay validated favoritism in the G1 New Zealand Derby going 2400 meters before traveling across the Tasman Sea for a half-length victory in the

G1 Rosehill Guineas over 10 furlongs just three weeks later. "He copped the Derby distance on class alone," trainer John Bary told South China *Morning Post*. "I know he has won Group 1s over 2000 meters, but he has also won two over a mile." That

includes a defeat of the top-class Mufhasa (NZ) (Pentire {GB}) in the G1 Windsor Park Plate in New Zealand Sept. 17, and it is the G1 Hong Kong Mile that lures John Bary's trainee. The former professional polo player said that a conversation with Trevor McKee, trainer of 2000 Mile victress Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) led him to this race. "Trevor said it is a big track with a big long straight and the mile here for us is like an 1800-meter race," Bary told *SCMP*.

"And, because you're travelling so far, if something is not quite right--then it's 400 meters less than the Cup." Hong Kong's **Xtension (Ire)** (Xaar {GB}) is another to have toyed with slightly longer journeys, but has now become a specialist at the mile. Beaten 3/4 of a length when runner-up to Ambitious Dragon in the Derby, he turned back to win the G1 Champions Mile in May. He hasn't won in three starts this year, but should prove a factor in the end from a cozy stall.

With some of the chief protagonists drawn in the double digits for today's G1 Hong Kong Sprint, the race seems there for the taking for something with an inside alley, and **Little Bridge (NZ)** (Faltaat) can continue his progressive form here. Only eighth in last year's Sprint, the 5-year-old was a dull ninth to Entrapment (Aus) (Halo Homewrecker) in a domestic Group 3 Oct. 1, but showed dramatic improvement when just missing to Rich Unicorn (Aus) (Daneshill Dancer {Ire}) in a local Group 2 Oct. 30. He came full circle with a defeat of Entrapment in the G2 Jockey Club Sprint Nov. 20, and jockey Gerald Mosse believes there's even better to come. "He's very well," the Frenchman stated. "We gave him an open [gallop] Thursday, and the horse could not be better. I haven't had a lot of experience with him, but I think he's improved a lot and our relationship is coming good at the right time. He's got the good draw and anything is possible. He will run very well but it is a strong field." The chances of **Rocket Man (Aus)** (Viscount {Aus}) were certainly done no favors when he drew the 13 hole in an attempt to improve on his narrow defeat last year. However, he was likely to be ridden forward no matter where he landed in the starting gate, and he should show enough foot to get a good spot off the expected pacesetters **Pas de Trois (Jpn)** (Swept Overboard) and G1 Sprinters' S. heroine **Curren Chan (Jpn)** (Kurofune).

Lucky Nine (Ire) (Dubawi {Ire}), runner-up to Mile favorite Xtension in the Champions Mile last May, had a pair of woefully unlucky runs in Japan, missing by a head in the G2 Centaur S. in September while giving weight all around, then encountering trouble caused by Pas de Trois before finishing fifth in the Sprinters S. **Bated Breath (GB)** (Dansili {GB}) missed by less than one length combined when runner-up in the G1 July Cup, G1 Haydock Sprint Cup and to subsequent GII Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint hero Regally Ready (More Than Ready) in the GI Nearctic S.

AN OPEN LETTER FROM KEN RAMSEY



THE JOY OF MY LIFE

For those of you who know Ken Ramsey, you know that I am a fierce competitor who is passionate and consumed with a love of horses, racing and winning.* I write this letter to tell you and also remind myself that any success I have been so blessed to achieve is due to my wife of 53 years.

Many of you may know the story of Kitten's Joy. It's my honor to tell you 'the story behind the story' which began in 1954 when I first started dating my wife, Sarah Kathern, whom I nicknamed 'Kitten'.

We logically named Sarah Kathern's first horse Kitten's First. After beating the boys first time out, in her second start she broke her hip leaving the starting gate and was so badly injured that the attending veterinarian recommended we put her down. With luck and persistence the mare survived, however three of her foals died during delivery. The mare was so special to me and my wife, I came up with the idea to give it yet another try and deliver a foal via caesarean section. The aptly named Kitten's Joy would go on to be Eclipse Champion Turf Horse, Eclipse Finalist for Horse of the Year and was in large part responsible for our winning an Eclipse Award for Leading Owner in 2004.

In 2011, Ramsey Farm bred 16 Stakes Winners including Breeders' Cup Winner Stephanie's Kitten. When Stephanie's Kitten won the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf – with all my family there – knowing we had bred her stallion, bred her mare and bred the two together, this was perhaps the most satisfying moment in my 40+ years in the horse business.

I write this letter as a tribute to my wonderful wife who continues to inspire me. I hope it will be a reminder and inspiration to all fellow breeders to never give up, to always believe in your dreams and to know those dreams can actually come true.

Thank you Kitten, the joy of my life.

Partnered with Javier Castellano for the first time, he got away in decent order before being shuffled toward the back of the back, where he raced some eight lengths off. For Jacksons, Siblings and Spotlights.

Lael Stables' Gretchen Jackson recently sat in a hushed Lincoln Center Theater in New York City, watching the Tony Award-winning play *War Horse*.

Amid the battle scenes and the near post-apocalyptic puppetry, she was struck by the crowd's reaction. "It was packed, and there was not a whisper or a candy wrapper to be heard throughout the entire production," she said. "People were stunned and crying, and were so embracing of the horse."

Jackson knows

something about the public's embracing of a horse, as she and her husband Roy bred and campaigned Barbaro. The son of Dynaformer captivated the racing world and beyond in 2006 with his stirring win in the GI Kentucky Derby, his breakdown in the GI Preakness S. two weeks later, and his gallant fight for life that finally ended in January of 2007.

The wellspring of support and sympathy that built up around Barbaro didn't just go away when he was euthanized. Instead, fans have kept track of his dam, the 15-year-old La Ville Rouge (Carson City), and of the siblings that followed--the 5-year-old Nicanor, the 4-year-old Lentenor and, now, the juvenile colt Margano--rooting for each one in the hopes that they just might pick up where Barbaro left off.

So far, none of Barbaro's siblings have come close to replicating his feats--talk about tall orders--and it would be understandable if the Jacksons tired of the expectations and the spotlight the family attracts.

But the Jacksons, through the years, have always accepted the attention graciously, and continue to do so to this day.

"People are very polite to us, and I think it's encouraging for racing that so many people are drawn to that family and follow the horses," Gretchen Jackson said yesterday. "I think it's great. We need more people in love with horses."

Time will tell if Margano, who made a favorable impression yesterday, develops into a nice horse, and the Jacksons, who like to keep expectations in check, are just happy that he at least is a youngster heading in the right direction.

"In his first race, he was really green," said Gretchen. "That race taught him a lot, as did the second. Today, when Javier asked him to run, he knew that's what he was supposed to do."

Of the fact that Margano was winning in his third start, she added, "You can't help but compare him to Barbaro, but Barbaro was running against Delaware Park competition [in his first start], and I'm thinking this is harder competition, in New York and down there at Gulfstream."

Jackson said any future plans--including a possible try on dirt--would be left to trainer Barclay Tagg.

"Barclay has been around a long time, like us, and he's great," said Jackson. "Whatever he wants to do is fine with us--he's a good trainer for all surfaces."

Since Barbaro emerged on the scene in 2005, La Ville Rouge hasn't visited another stallion other than Dynaformer, most recently producing a colt to the Three Chimneys stallion in 2011. That will change in 2012, however, as the mare, currently not in foal, is booked to Darley's Bernardini.

As always, the Jacksons will keep their expectations low. "We were lucky enough to have one great horse out of the mare, and if we can have any decent runners out of her, we'd be thrilled," Gretchen said philosophically.

Incidentally, Barbaro, as many know, was named after one of the dogs in a painting of foxhounds the Jacksons own. His subsequent brothers--Lentenor and Nicanor--were named after other dogs in the painting. And while there are six hounds in total, the names Sereno and Calypso have recently been used, and so Margano will be the last of the lot. *Cont. p5*

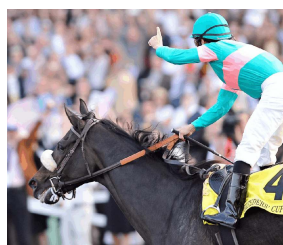
