## THE FACTOR GOES AN EASY HALF-MILE

As 2011 reaches its close, it has been a season of ups and downs for Fog City Stable and George Bolton's **The Factor** (War Front), but the grey colt has a chance to put a permanent positive spin on the campaign in Monday's GI Malibu S. After firing a six-furlong bullet in 1:11 4/5 over Hollywood's Cushion Track Dec. 17, the \$250,000 Barretts May topper from 2010 was put through his paces yesterday with a much easier half-mile in :48 3/5. "He went very nicely, and [trainer] Bob

[Baffert] worked him at a nice pace and he has lots of options," Bolton commented. Whereas The Factor drew inside and was used up on the pace when fourth in the GI Ancient Title S. and when eighth in the GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile in his last two starts, Bolton sees

Monday's wide draw as an asset. "Hopefully with an outside post he doesn't have to commit to the front," he explained. "Bob has always said he doesn't have to be on the lead, and my hope is he can rate a little bit." With wins in the GII San Vicente S. and in the GII Rebel S. early this year, Bolton admits things haven't worked out as planned. "It certainly has been a season of extreme elation and some disappointment," he offered. "But he'll stay in training in 2012 and he's in good shape right now." Bolton foresees The Factor remaining in California to compete in the sprint series at Santa Anita before considering the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at the end of March. And then? "I wouldn't be surprised to see him in the GI Met Mile," Bolton stated. In other Wednesday works at Hollywood, **El Pocho (Chi)** (The Mighty Tiger) went three-eighths of a mile from the gate in a bullet :35.60; and **Centralintelligence** (Smarty Jones) breezed a half in :47.60.

## CREAM OF THE CROP GATHER AT NAKAYAMA

Sunday's G1 Arima Kinen at Nakayama is to Japan what the Kentucky Derby is to the U.S., the Melbourne Cup to Australia, the Arc de Triomphe to France. The racing fan is asked to contribute to the composition of the field, and eight of the 10 top votegetters will face the starter on Christmas Day, including the last two winners of the G1 Japan Cup, the reigning G1 Dubai World Cup hero and a Japanese Triple Crown victor. **Buena Vista (Jpn)** (Special Week {Jpn}), who made amends for a disqualification in the 2010 Japan Cup by taking this year's renewal, could go off a slender favorite in a race which attracted the better part of a half-billion (yes, billion) dollars in turnover last year. **Rose Kingdom (Jpn)** (King Kamehameha {Jpn}), promoted to the win, reopposes here. Buena Vista, who makes her final career start, drew the inside gate. Alongside her is **Victoire Pisa (Jpn)** (Neo Universe {Jpn}), who led home a one-two finish for the island nation in the World Cup this past March. **Orfevre (Jpn)** (Stay Gold {Jpn}) swept the G1 Satsuki Sho, G1 Tokyo Yushun and G1 Kikuka Sho to complete the Triple Crown. The Arima Kinen marks his first start against older rivals. **Field p2**

## RACETRACK ROUND-UP

### Europeans Join Mott Roster...

Juddmonte's Group 1 winners **Mutual Trust (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}) and **Announce (GB)** (Selkirk) have been transferred from Andre Fabre to Bill Mott, according to *Racing Post*. Mutual Trust, who bagged the June 12 G3 Prix Paul de Moussac and July 3 G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly, shipped Stateside in September after running 10th in the Aug. 15 G1 Prix Jacques Le Marois at Deauville. Twice a winner at the Group 3 level, Announce registered a career high when annexing the Aug. 21 G1 Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville, and was denied by a pixel when runner-up in the Oct. 2 G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp. She was scratched from the Breeders' Cup meet after colliding with an equine ambulance. Other ex-Europeans to bolster Mott's Payson Park winter team include four-time listed winner **Principal Role** (Empire Maker), recent GI Hollywood Derby fourth **Slumber (GB)** (Cacique {Ire}) and MSP **Imperial Pippin** (Empire Maker). "They're great horses to get," Mott told the trade daily. "They're not used up, they are usually sent with some gas left in the tank, and you know they are already graded-stakes quality. The challenge is to get a Grade I win over here, particularly with some of those who just missed out over there." The Hall of Fame horseman added, "Mutual Trust came over in September and we were hoping to run him in the fall, but he got a little virus. We didn't run him, but he's doing well now. We might try to give him a run at the current Gulfstream meeting and then look at the [GI] Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita. Announce might run later on at Gulfstream, but I think the other fillies will need time to acclimate, so they won't run probably until April."

**Meydan Masters Heads First Two DIRC Programs...**

The Dubai Racing Club has extended invitations to a dozen of the world's top jockeys to compete in the Meydan Masters International Jockeys' Challenge over the course of the first two days of the Dubai International Racing Carnival Thursday, Jan. 5 and Friday, Jan. 6. They will compete in a points-based competition conducted over four races. Points are accumulated based on the riders' finishes in the race, and the winner is determined by the highest point total secured in those races. Great Britain's Richard Hills won the inaugural event in 2010 and Calvin Borel of the United States was champion in 2011. The 12 confirmed riders are; Mickael Barzalona, Maxime Guyon and Christophe Lemaire from France; William Buick, Ryan Moore, Colm O'Donoghue and Tom Queally from Great Britain and Ireland; Italy's Mirco Demuro and Frankie Dettori; Kenichi Ikezoe from Japan; Andrasch Starke from Germany and Australia's Craig Williams. The jockeys have combined to win a total of 61 Grade/Group 1 races around the world in 2011, including the Dubai World Cup (Demuro), Caulfield Cup (Williams), W.S. Cox Plate (Williams), Melbourne Cup (Lemaire), King George VI & Queen Elizabeth S. (Buick) and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe (Starke).

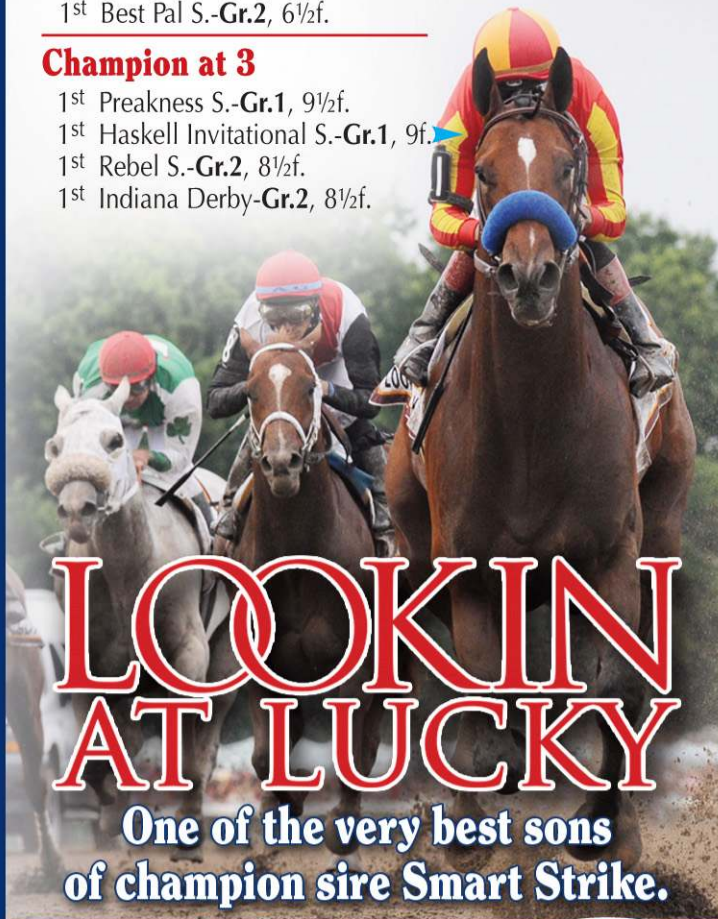

**Gural, NJSEA Reach Meadowlands Deal:**

New York-based real estate developer Jeffrey Gural has signed a 30-year lease with the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority (NJSEA) for the Meadowlands. According to *Daily Racing Form*, the agreement will allow for a six-day Thoroughbred meeting in the spring, as well as 15 days of all-turf racing in the fall. The Thoroughbred horsemen will be required to cover "incremental costs" such as a starting gate crew. Earlier this week, the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association and the NJSEA reached an agreement to run 141 days at Monmouth Park in 2012.

## Capt. Candyman Can Gearing Up for Return:

Grade I winner **Capt. Candyman Can** (Candy Ride {Arg}) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 2/5 Tuesday morning at Palm Meadows as he prepares for the GIII Mr. Prospector S. at Gulfstream Park Dec. 31. The soon-to-be 6-year-old will be having his first run since a third-place effort to Noble's Promise (Cuvee) in the GIII Aristides S. at Churchill Downs June 4. "He had some minor [physical] issues and we had to stop on him," trainer Ian Wilkes said. "He's doing well and we know he likes the track at Gulfstream. We're going to take his campaign one race at a time and see where he takes us." Calvin Borel has the call aboard Capt. Candyman Can, who was promoted to the victory in the GI King's Bishop S. in 2009. Earlier that season he captured the GII Hutcheson S. in Hallandale.

Little Mike enjoyed a stand-out campaign over the Gulfstream turf last winter, scoring front-running victories in the Jan. 9 GIII Ft. Lauderdale S., Feb. 27 GIII Canadian Turf S., and Apr. 3 GIII Appleton S. Making his first start since, the bay gelding set a measured pace through fractions of :24.13, :47.90 and 1:10.76 and held on to a fast-diminishing advantage over Yankee Fortune to take his Gulfstream turf record to four wins in five starts. "It's like sitting in a Ferrari, just sit back," said winning rider Joe Bravo. "Honestly, this is a special horse. I haven't been on too many horses like this. He's half-human. He knows horses when they come to him, and he picks it up again. If they went around again, they weren't going to get by him. No disrespect to [Yankee Fortune], he's a very nice horse. It'll tell you that this was a stakes-caliber race. For him to come off a layoff, and not quite be 100% and run a race like that, I can't wait to see the rest of the year." Trainer Dale Romans indicated Little Mike could make his next start in either the Jan. 14 GIII Ft. ### Paddock Proposal Has Happy Ending:


Just after she rode in Wednesday's ninth race at the Fair Grounds, history was made by jockey Anna Roberts when the Louisiana-bred jockey said 'yes' to a marriage proposal from her boyfriend Will Werner, son of trainer Ronny Werner. "Will was standing in the middle of the paddock watching the replay of the race and called me over to him as I was walking back to the jockeys' room," recalled the 23-year-old Roberts Thursday while en route to Texas to meet members of her upcoming extended family. "I asked him, 'What are you doing?' and he said, 'I'm about to propose to you,' and I said, 'But I'm all dirty now.' I was very surprised, but I think I said, 'Yes' right away."
