## AROUND THE CAPE

Trainer Mike de Kock will saddle a pair of Australian-bred Galileo (Ire) fillies for Sheikh Mohammed bin Khalifa Al Maktoum in today's feature at Meydan, the G2 Cape Verdi S. **Mahbooba (Aus)**, a Group 1 winner in South Africa and a solid performer at the Carnival last year, kicked off 2012 with a confident conditions score going a furlong further over this course Jan. 5. "The drop in trip is the query, but she won over 1600 meters last year and should cope," said de Kock. "She won well last time and has come out of that in great shape, and should be very competitive."

"Reem has been a bit disappointing since the 2011 Carnival, but she would have needed her run last week," admitted de Kock. "Hopefully, the extra distance and return to grass will help her. **First City** looks the one we have to beat, with her English form looking very solid." That mare ran third in the G1 Falmouth S. at Newmarket before finishing fourth behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville. She has not faced the starter since running fifth in a listed race at Haydock Sept. 3.

### IGUGU ROLLS SEVEN FOR J&B MET

South African sensation **Igugu (Aus)** (Galileo {Ire}) drew post seven for next Saturday's J&B Met at Kenilworth in Cape Town. She was one of 16 runners declared for the R2.5-million event, along with recent G1 L'Ormarins Queens Plate hero **Gimmethelight (Aus)** (More Than Ready). Named South Africa's Horse of the Year after a season that included wins in the G1 Durban July and two other top-level trophies, Igugu has not raced since capturing the G2 Ipi Tombe Challenge at Turffontein Dec. 4. The bay filly missed her intended tune-up in the Jan. 7 G1 Paddock S. due to a less-than-ideal scope, but has been given a clean bill of health following her recent gallops for trainer Mike de Kock. **Cont. p5**

**HRTV FILM FESTIVAL AT SANTA ANITA**

Santa Anita and HRTV are hosting a non-fiction documentary competition. The "A Day at the Races" competition will be open to filmmakers who create a Santa Anita-based film of five minutes or less. The films will be judged by a panel of racing and entertainment professionals and will offer first place prize money of \$10,000, second prize of \$5,000 and third prize of \$3,000. An additional \$10,000 first prize will be awarded to the winner of an on-line poll. Applications must be made in person from Jan. 20, with the first day of shooting Feb. 9. Submissions must be made by Mar. 28 and the winners will be announced Apr. 22. "We are very excited to be partnering with Santa Anita to initiate this project," said HRTV President Scott Daruty. ## CHICHICASTENANGO DIES AFTER COLIC

**SURGERY** Multiple Group 1 winner **Chichicastenango (Fr)** (Smadoun {Fr}--Smala {Fr}, by Antheus) died last week after undergoing colic surgery in Japan, according to *Racing Post*. He was 14. Winner of the G1 Grand Prix de Paris and G1 Prix Lupin in 2001, the grey colt entered stud at Haras de Victot. His best offspring to date was Vision d'Etat (Fr), who captured the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club in 2008, and added the G1 Prince of Wales's S., G1 Prix Ganay and G1 Hong Kong Cup as a 4-year-old. Chichicastenango, who has been represented by two other Group 3 winners, was sold to Shadai Stallion Station in time for the 2009 breeding season. "Chichicastenango showed signs of colic around the end of last year and then was sent to Shadai Horse Clinic for a laparotomy Jan. 5," Shadai Farm spokesman Naohiro Hosoda told *Racing Post*. "He remained in the clinic and seemed to be recovering. But suddenly his condition changed for the worst, and he died Jan. 13 despite our vets struggling to do their best. We deeply regret losing him and there are high expectations for his remaining offspring."
