FAIRY TALE OR FOLLY?

Today's GIII Lecomte S. at Fair Grounds has drawn a competitive group of 13 sophomores, including a

Cinderella story in the form Oklahoma shipper **Ted's Folly** (Wild Tale). It's hard to imagine that a 3-year-old sporting a six-race winning streak could be 10-1 on the morning line, but there you have it. Carrying the colors of Steve Martin--not the actor--the \$1,200 juvenile purchase stepped out of Sooner State

company to put in a strong rally when taking the \$300,000 Springboard Mile S. at Remington Dec. 10. That marked his first try at two turns, and Ted's Folly should appreciate the long Fair Grounds stretch. "It's a question how good he is every time we run him," trainer Wilson Brown told *Courier-Journal*. "We'll see how it works out for us. If it doesn't, he's been a lot of fun so far for \$1,200." Brown acknowledged that his stable star is slightly made. "When you look at him, he's kind of a gazelle-looking little rascal," he said. "As somebody commented after the Springboard, he's not much to look at until he runs by you." **Cont. p4**

WEATHER MAY DELAY 'ZOMBIE' RETURN

Newly crowned sprint champion **Amazombie** (Northern Afleet) is scheduled to kick off his 2012

campaign this afternoon in the GII Palos Verdes S. at Santa Anita. However, if forecasted rain materializes, the bay gelding will remain in his stall. "I have no Plan B if he doesn't run," said trainer and co-owner Bill Spawr. "I'll just enjoy last year. He's really ready to run, but we want to make it through the year. If they don't seal the track, he'll run." There is currently a 70% chance of rain in

Arcadia. Defending champion **Euroears** (Langfuhr) will attempt to end his career on a high note. Ninth behind Amazombie in the Breeders' Cup, the swift chestnut most recently ran fourth in the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. at Hollywood Nov. 26, after which it was announced that he would enter stud at Oklahoma's JEH Stallion Station 2012. "He's been wiped out in a couple races, so we'll see what happens," said trainer Bob Baffert. "He likes this track. There's a lot of speed in the race, but he's pretty speedy himself. It's a big plus being on the outside as opposed to leaving from the rail." **Field p5**

First City had strong form claims for this, having finished third in the G1 Falmouth S. for the David Simcock yard last term, but faced a champion in Mahbooba, and had questions to answer after an absence having finished fifth in the Listed Superior Mile at Haydock in September. Held up with only two behind as her chief rival set off in front, the bay swung wide into the stretch and cut her down with a withering run to win the bobber by a nose. "We were hoping for a big run as she was going nicely at home in the mornings and her form in Europe was very good," jockey Royston Ffrench said. "She has finished very strongly to get there in the last strides and I was not sure we had won when we flashed past. It is great that we did and I assume we will probably come back for the Balanchine S. and take it from there." First City, having her first start for the Ali Al Raihe stable here, was winning her first pattern race after thirds in last year's G2 Windsor Forest S. at Royal Ascot and Newmarket's Falmouth, and seconds in the 2010 G3 Supreme S. at Goodwood and G3 Princess Elizabeth S. at Epsom in June. She was also fourth behind Goldikova (Ire) (Anabaa) in the G1 Prix Rothschild at Deauville on her penultimate start. Al Raihe added, "We will look at the Dubai Duty Free on World Cup night long term, perhaps after the Balanchine and Super Saturday."

The tepid 4-1 favorite on the morning line is **Shared Property** (Scat Daddy), who came from off the pace to win each of his first two starts, including the GIII Arlington-Washington Futurity Sept. 10. The dark bay ran sixth as the choice in the GI Dixiana Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland the following month, however, and was freshened up afterwards. He tuned up for the Lecomte by breezing six furlongs in a bullet 1:15 4/5 last Saturday at Fair Grounds.

"He still has not won going two turns, and that's one of the things we're anxiously looking for at this time," said trainer Tom Amoss. "The Lecomte should be a good starting point for us, but the screws may not be completely tight just yet on this horse. I expect him to run very well, but we're also thinking about the rest of the year."

Owned by George Strawbridge and James Wigan, the stakes-winning mare is boarded at Derry Meeting Farm. She is the dam of Group 3 winner Fantastic View (Distant View) and Group 2-placed Weald Park (Cozzene).

RACETRACK ROUND-UP

The Factor To Dubai and...Royal Ascot?

Owner George Bolton said yesterday that his explosive star 4-year-old **The Factor** (War Front) is on track for a probable tilt in the \$2-million G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen on the Dubai World Cup card at Meydan in late March, and said the Bob Baffert-trained colt could well extend his international travels. Bolton said the ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ had received an invitation for the G1 Golden Jubilee S. on closing day at Royal Ascot in June. "I'm

seriously considering it," said Bolton. "It's a straight six furlongs, and it's worth \$700,000. I figure between those two races, they'd be worth about 12 California [graded] sprints. He's run well on the Poly, so I'm not worried about [the switch to the turf]." The Factor has never run on grass, though many of his sire's offspring have excelled on it. The gray won the GI Pat O'Brien S. at Del Mar last August as a sophomore. In his latest, he doubled his Grade I tally in the Malibu S. at Santa Anita Dec. 27. Bolton owns The Factor with Fog City Stable.

Bolton also provided an upbeat bulletin on **My Miss Aurelia** (Smart Strike), who on Monday was crowned champion juvenile filly at the Eclipse Awards. Owned by Bolton and Barbara Banke's Stonestreet Stables, My Miss Aurelia hasn't raced since her win in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies S. at Churchill in November. She was given some time off because of sore shins, and is scheduled to return to trainer Steve Asmussen's barn in the coming weeks. Bolton said the time off has done his filly good.

"She grew I think about three inches," he said. "She's taller and longer, and she's really blossomed. It's nice to take them out of training for a little bit and let them grow up. She got a saddle on her in what, September [of 2010]? And she went straight through to the following November. So the break's nice. She'll resume training soon at Vinery very shortly and should be ready by late spring."

A return in late spring would put a start in the GI Kentucky Oaks May 4 in question, and Bolton said that while he'd like to make the race, connections wouldn't push the filly to make it.

"When a horse is growing the way she is, you have to give them time to let that take place," he said. "We're going to get her right, and *then* we're going to find a race. We'd love to make the Oaks, but we'd love to make all of them. When she's ready, she'll run."

Bolton hinted that My Miss Aurelia would be aggressively campaigned in 2012.

"The thing about my partner Barbara is that she's gutsy," he said about Banke, wife of the late Stonestreet founder Jess Jackson. "She'll throw them in the big races. You know she will, after what she and Jess did with Curlin, with Rachel [Alexandra]. My hunch is that she'll have an exciting schedule." -LM

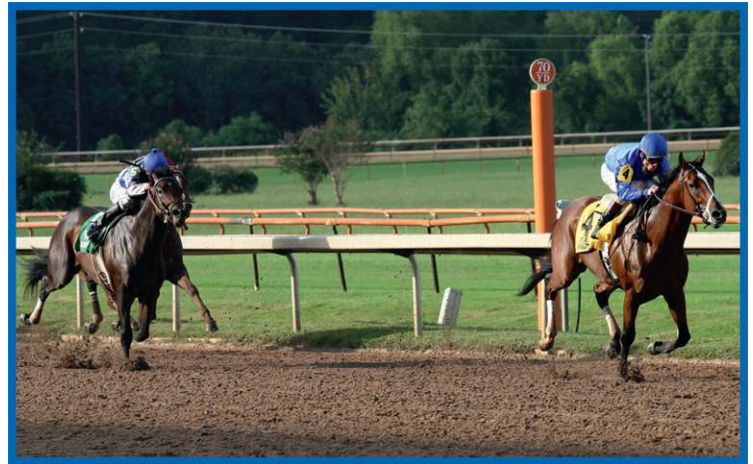



Two months ago, prominent owner George Bolton was in a restaurant, taking part in a fundraiser, when he got a call from bloodstock agent John Moynihan. Moynihan was in the thick of the action at the Keeneland November Sale, and was focusing on an unraced Smart Strike 2-year-old colt in the ring that the men had looked at, liked, and hoped to buy. "He's at twenty-two five," said Moynihan, awaiting further instructions.

"Well all right, bid \$250,000," Bolton responded. Moynihan clarified. "No, no--the bid's \$22,500. Would you like to bid 23,000...American dollars?"

Needless to say, Bolton did, and while it took a bit more to secure the colt--\$60,000 eventually got the job done--the price was hardly stratospheric.

And when the colt, named **Spring Hill Farm**, made his debut for Todd Pletcher at Gulfstream last Saturday, he already looked worth many multiples of what Bolton paid for him. Hammered down to 3-5 favoritism under John Velazquez, Spring Hill Farm was put on the front and set sensible :23 2/5, :47 3/5 and 1:12 2/5 splits before exploding the final furlong to win by a widening 6 1/4-length margin.

"They got away with fairly ordinary early fractions, but he came home in :12 flat when he was asked to run," Bolton said yesterday. "Todd really likes him."

The San Francisco-based investor said Spring Hill Farm came out of the race great and is now being pointed to a first-level allowance going a mile at Gulfstream Feb. 11. "We don't want to throw him to the wolves yet," said Bolton. "It's a long year. He's by Smart Strike, so you can take your time--you know the deal."

It shouldn't be a surprise to see a nice Smart Strike hailing from Bolton's stable. This is, after all, the man who co-owned (for a time, at least) Smart Strike's two-time Horse of the Year Curlin, and just this past Monday accepted an Eclipse Award with Barbara Banke on behalf of the Lane's End stallion's champion juvenile daughter My Miss Aurelia. Bolton also co-owns Dominus, the Smart Strike colt who won last year's GII Dwyer S. at Belmont.

Smart Strike's been so good to George Bolton that his friends chide him by calling his operation Smart Strike Stables.

Given Smart Strike's success, Spring Hill Farm's price tag seems especially reasonable. "And he's a gorgeous individual," said Bolton, who said he was a mid-sized horse that reminds him physically of another horse he co-owns, Grade I winner The Factor (War Front).

Another interesting aspect of Spring Hill Farm's modest price is that he hailed from the dispersal of the late Ned Evans's Spring Hill Farm, the same dispersal that saw 170 horses sell for a staggering average of \$328,353. Spring Hill Farm's \$60,000 price was less than half of the \$130,000 median of the Lane's End-handled draft.

So how did Bolton come to land on him? "Well, John Moynihan, who is my very adept agent, called and said that we should sift through some of the unraced juvenile prospects with [then Spring Hill Farm manager] Chris Baker," Bolton explained. "So we called Chris, and he told us the ones Ned loved, told us the ones he loved, and which ones we should look at. This horse had immature knees, but our vet passed him. He'd been in training with Todd Pletcher, so I called Todd, and Todd said that he hadn't set him down yet, so he didn't know if he could really run. He agreed his knees were immature, but that he was 'getting through them.'"

Pletcher suggested that, with the colt's ability still a question mark, he'd nonetheless be worth taking a stab at--so long as the price was right--given his pedigree.

"It's the family of Minstrella, which was one of Ned's most successful lines," said Bolton. "If you look back over his extremely successful 40 years breeding, it was probably that family and the Raging Fever family that were the two biggest arteries."

Minstrella, Spring Hill Farm's second dam, was a champion 2-year-old filly in Ireland with three Group 1s on her card, and is the ancestress of Evans's GII Jim Dandy S. winner A Little Warm (Stormin Fever) and

GSW Pleasant Strike (Smart Strike). This is also the family of Saint Liam, et al. Among Minstrella's daughters were the Grade II winner Colonial Minstrel (Pleasant Colony), Spring Hill Farm's dam. The colt is a half to two stakes winners, Storm Minstrel (Storm Cat) and Grand Minstrel (Grand Slam).

Despite the bloodlines, shoppers at Keeneland November were obviously reluctant to take a shot on an

unraced juvenile that late in the year.

"It's funny--I think Ned's horses sold for about double the estimate," said Bolton. "But those horses of racing age seem liked options expiring in days and not months. The sky's the limit on a broodmare or a yearling, but an unraced 2-year-old in November? People get nervous--*why hasn't he run? What's going on?* Frankly, I was nervous, too."

If Bolton was nervous, he received a reassuring phone call from Pletcher a month after the sale. The conditioner gave a cautious but definite thumbs up. "This horse can run a little bit," he said, trainer-speak for *I don't want to get your hopes up, but you might have a good one on your hands.*

Time will tell if Spring Hill Farm lives up the reputation of the farm he was named after, a name, incidentally, the colt sold with. Bolton initially intended on changing the moniker to Mr. Evans, but a close aide to Evans pointed out that Evans himself named the horse after his farm, and so Bolton figured he would respect his old friend's choice.

"Ned Evans was one of my favorite people--as funny as Ned was, we got along great," said Bolton.

Spring Hill Farm wasn't the only Evans-bred horse Bolton purchased at November. Along with the late Jess Jackson's Stonestreet Stables--now run by Jackson's widow Barbara Banke--he acquired three weanlings. Included were a \$1 million Smart Strike--Raging Fever filly, a \$675,000 Medaglia d'Oro--Fiery Pursuit filly and a \$440,000 Bernardini--Imaginary Cat colt.

"After his death, I sadly talked to his farm manager Chris Baker about getting some of his families into my operation," said Bolton. "At the November Sale, as you can see, I didn't go for the yearlings, I went for the weanlings, because Ned had gone to the stallions I prefer in that crop."

Bolton said one big benefit of owning horses bred by Evans is that he gets to share the experience with many of the former employees who worked at the Virginia-based Spring Hill Farm.

"It's emotional and nice for me that all of Ned's staff called and sent emails congratulated me last week," he said. "We're all like family, and it's been a really fun week. It's fun for me to have a horse in training from his operation, and I think Ned would have been excited, too." -L Marquardt
