'Bowling' Them Over cont...

Mr. Bowling earned his diploma second out at Delaware Park Aug. 22, and had no trouble stretching out when he annexed the Dover S. back at that oval Oct. 8 by a facile 7 1/4-length margin. That effort helped the homebred garner 7-5 favoritism in Churchill's GIII Iroquois S. Oct. 30, but Mr. Bowling could do no better than a non-threatening third. He had been working bullets here since that race, including one in company with Believe You Can (Proud Citizen) (see p6) going five furlongs in :58 4/5 Jan. 9, and was backed down to 7-2 despite a morning line quote of 8-1.

Hugging the fence in mid-pack behind a half in :47.22, Mr. Bowling moved up and out several paths entering the far turn to take closer order. He seemed to spin his wheels briefly at the head of the lane after looming ominously, but responded to left-handed encouragement from Robby Albarado and kicked it into high gear as he sliced in between horses and to the lead. He took several strides to level off, but was traveling well inside the furlong marker and was able to contain Z Dager's resolute rally. Shared Property, who made his run farther outside than the top two, looked like a winner in mid-stretch, but ran out of real estate to fall a half-length short of the runner-up.

"I had a great trip, unbelievable trip," said winning pilot Robby Albarado. "I just wanted to give him a chance turning for home. I worked him in the morning--I saw a lot of fight in him. So I figured if I can get him clear turning for home, give him a chance to run, he would. When that horse ran to him late, he gave him some second effort."

Mr. Bowling, who will return here in the GII Risen Star S. Feb. 25, is the first graded stakes winner for sophomore sire Istan (Gone West), who currently stands at Jones's Airdrie Stud for \$3,500.

Steve Asmussen, trainer of the runner-up, said of his charge, "He's a little bit 'on again, off again,' but that's just who he is. I think the winner ran about a head better than we did...I think it was huge for his third race, coming out of a maiden race, to run as well as he did."

Frumious strung together a trio of wins in 2008 before a winless streak that would stretch all the way to Dec. 9, with just eight races in between (including just one start in 2009), when he annexed a \$40K Hollywood claimer at 8-1 by 3 1/4 lengths with a 99 Beyer. The Cal-bred was 14-1 last time in an open \$62K optional claimer--wisely not entered for the tag--over track and trip Dec. 31, and belied those odds to score by 1 1/4 lengths and earn a 104 Beyer. He was again dismissed at a generous price here, but for the second time in his career, Frumious put together back-to-back-to-back victories.

Zippering through fractions of :21.06 and :42.77 over the lightning-quick Santa Anita strip, Frumious entered the stretch in isolation and built on his advantage from there to score in a head-turner. "You could see that the speed of the races was fast today," said winning rider Antonio Castanon. "This race was going to be one of the fastest races today, so I just let my horse run his own race because I know he has a lot of speed. I didn't expect to be on the lead so soon, and when I ended up there I just let my horse run." **Cont. p5**

Mersad Metanovic, bloodstock consultant to trainer Jeff Bonde, added, "I'm ecstatic for everybody who works with this horse... It is a credit to Jeff and George Schmitt for giving the horse time to come back to the races. They gelded him, they brought him back--he had a few little issues--but Jeff and his assistant, Miguel Carranza, did a phenomenal job in bringing this horse back." Metanovic continued, "There's nobody that can run with him [early]. Maybe they can catch him late, but they're not going to go with him. That's a fact."

Metanovic said Frumious could travel to Meydan for the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen Mar. 31. Trainer Jeff Bonde was forced to miss the race with a cold, while owners George and Mary Clare Schmitt of Pleasanton, CA were in Germany.

Amazombie Scratched...

As anticipated, recently crowned champion sprinter **Amazombie** (Northern Afleet) was scratched out of the Palos Verdes, which would have been his first race since annexing the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint Nov. 5, because of rain Friday night. Darryl Rader, assistant to trainer Bill Spawr, said the 6-year-old could resurface in either the Sensational Star S. down the hill next Saturday or the seven-furlong GIII San Carlos S. Feb. 25.

Mr. Vegas, a smart debut winner at Saratoga in 2009, had bounced back and forth between New York and the Midwest over the last few seasons, and rejoined Richard Sherer's barn last August after spending some time with Christophe Clement. He finished close-up seconds three times from four tries in Illinois from August to September, and scored by a head over this course and distance in a \$40K optional claimer Nov. 26. The chestnut paired that victory with one against \$62K optional sellers (not in for the tag either time) Dec. 31, and was looking to remain unbeaten over the grass here in his graded stakes bow.

Mr. Vegas controlled the pace through six furlongs in 1:13.84, and dug in to hold off veteran Dubious Miss in the stretch, bumping with his pursuer around the sixteenth pole. The stewards launched an inquiry into the incident between the first- and second- place finishers, but made no change. "He did come out a touch, but I wasn't sure if it was enough to change the outcome," commented Sherer. "I'm glad the stewards saw it my way."

These connections went on to take the GIII LeComte S. later on the Fair Grounds card.

'TIZ' A TOUGHER TEST IN LA CANADA

Pamela Ziebarth's undefeated **Tiz Flirtatious** will face the sternest test of her career in today's GII La Canada S. for 4-year-old fillies at Santa Anita. The homebred arrived late on the scene to graduate going six furlongs against Cal-breds here Oct. 2, and cleared her first-level allowance condition Oct. 29 before having no trouble with Hollywood's synthetic surface and an increase to 7 1/2 furlongs in the Dec. 11 Cat Cradle H. She earned an 89 Beyer Speed Figure for that effort. The dark bay will be making her first start beyond a mile in this graded stakes bow. "Any time you go two turns for the first time, it's a challenge, especially raising in class, too," trainer Marty Jones told *Daily Racing Form*. While saying he thought Tiz Flirtatious preferred conventional dirt, Jones admitted, "I wasn't real happy with the draw. I would have preferred not to be on the far outside." **Great Hot (Brz)** gets the narrow nod on the morning line off some solid performances against slightly tougher foes. Third in the GI Lady's Secret S. over track and trip Oct. 1, the Coudelaria Jessica homebred annexed Keeneland's GII Raven Run S. Oct. 22. She failed to contend when 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Sprint Nov. 4, but was third in the GI La Brea S.--again at seven panels--here last time Dec. 31. "She's versatile," said Great Hot's trainer A.C. Avila. "She can go, she can sit, she can do whatever she wants."
