INCLUDE ME OUT ON TOP IN LA CANADA

Include Me Out (Include) came into Santa Anita's GII La Canada without a graded placing to her credit, but she remedied that omission with an eye-catching 4 1/4-length victory Sunday afternoon. Let go at 8-1

for Jay Em Ess Stable and trainer Ron Ellis, the dark bay settled off an honest opening pace of :22.64 and :45.86 reeled off by **May Day Rose** (Rockport Harbor). A comfortably placed fourth down the backside, she came off the rail three wide

turning for home and powered on all engines late to win by an emphatic margin over 5-2 chance **Great Hot (Brz)** (Orientate). Favored **Tiz Flirtatious** (Tizbud) tired to third after prompting the early pace, while the pacemaker faded to last. "Going into the first turn, I thought I would be laying second right next to Martin Garcia, but [Joel] Rosario [aboard Tiz Flirtatious] and [Rafael] Bejarano [on fifth-place Capital Plan] made an early move so I just had to ease back," explained winning rider Joe Talamo. "After that she just ran great..She was so fresh and ready today, and full of run." Runner up behind stablemate Teddy's Promise (Salt Lake) in a Santa Anita sprint last October, Include Me Out triumphed over the Santa Anita dirt in November. Facing her stablemate once again in a six-furlong test over Hollywood's CushionTrack Nov. 25, the 4-year-old had to play the bridesmaid once again. Asked to try the highest level last time out in the seven-furlong GI La Brea S., she came home fifth behind Teddy's Promise. "She got in behind horses [in the Grade I La Brea], but I think being by Include, she was dying to go two turns and it's kind of been a process getting her up to it," explained Ellis. "I thought she looked great the whole race. She was very relaxed and with the pace scenario I thought Joe [Talamo] had her in a perfect spot. She just looked very comfortable all the way. She's just been learning coming up to this but pedigree-wise she wanted to go two turns. I felt good about it."

champion juvenile **Hansen** (Tapit) breezed five furlongs at Gulfstream Park Sunday morning. The grey completed the task in :59.81, while working in company with stakes-winning stablemate **Lou Brissie** (Limehouse), who was caught in 1:00 1/5. Hansen's work was the third fastest of 39 recorded at the distance. "It was nothing out of character," said trainer Michael Maker said. "He worked just fine." Hansen has

never been headed in three starts, including a pair of runaway victories at Turfway Park prior to his head score over previously undefeated Union Rags (Dixie Union) in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Churchill Downs Nov. 5. "We've had no bumps in the road," said Maker. "Hopefully, that trend continues." When asked about the undefeated colt's front-running style, Maker added, "It's no different than a closer, you're dependent on the pace. You just hope no one makes him go quicker earlier than he has to. The one-mile Holy Bull is also expected to also draw Algorithms (Bernardini) and Consortium (Bernardini), the 1-2 finishers in a Dec. 16 allowance at Gulfstream; Fort Loudon (Awesome of Course), who swept the 2011 Florida Stallion Series, and stakes winner My Adonis (Pleasantly Perfect).

Dayatthespa kicked off 2012 the right way with an impressive initial stakes tally here. Runner-up in the GIII Natalma S. at Woodbine Sept. 17, she tired to ninth in the GII Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' Turf at Churchill Nov. 4 and was given a brief freshener. Bet down to 7-5 from her 5-2 morning-line odds, the chestnut was content to rate at the back of the pack after a tardy start and was second to last going into the first turn. She began to cut into a fast pace on the backstretch, made an eye-catching move on the turn and was a loaded gun in upper stretch. Moving

widest of all, she unleashed her rally under Javier Castellano and was going away late to win by three lengths. "I expected to be much closer to the pace, but she broke just a step slow today," said Castellano.

"Fortunately, they went much faster up front than I expected. She settled beautifully and when I asked her, she picked it up really quickly. I had no choice but to go around horses on the turn and to go a little wide. I was really satisfied with how she ran today and I think she's a really nice filly." Trainer Chad Brown added, "She likes the firm ground like it was today. I don't want to make an excuse for her Breeders' Cup, but Ramon [Dominguez] said that it was probably too soft for her and she didn't care for it. The 5-2 shot pressed the pace three-deep through a comfortable half in :48.39 and six furlongs in 1:12.07. He came under an energetic hand ride at the top of the lane, moving in tandem with Self Control (Lemon Drop Kid) with little separating himself from that rival in either direction. E. H. Indy (A.P. Indy), meanwhile, came charging up the rail, and the three runners struck the line almost in sync. Simba's Story got the victory by a head, with the other two in a dead heat for second.
