SWEET HOME SANTA MONICA

Craig Stables's **Home Sweet Aspen** (Candy Ride {Arg}), fourth behind **Teddy's Promise** (Salt Lake) and **Sugarinthemorning** (Candy Ride {Arg}) in the GI La Brea S. Dec. 31, turned the tables with a game neck victory in yesterday's GI Santa Monica S. The chestnut shot out to the front, raced under pressure throughout, and wanted it a little bit more in the stretch than Sugarinthemorning, getting her neck on the line first. "I think this is a good sprinting filly, a good quality filly," trainer John Sadler said. "It's pretty exciting to have her win a Grade I. I felt she's capable and we got a good trip today. had a length to spare over Consortium in a salty \$75,000 optional tagger at Gulfstream Dec. 16 ([video](#)). Consortium, beaten as the 4-5 chalk that day, previously debuted with a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ performance at the Big A Nov. 12. Consortium adds Lasix here. "He's not a bad bleeder, but he did show signs of bleeding mixing in with the mucus," trainer Kiaran McLaughlin revealed. "I think we might have been second best on the day, but being that he had a little blood and mucus, I think the Lasix will help." McLaughlin continued, "But Algorithms is a nice horse. We won't take anything away from him, but we should improve. And Hansen, the 2-year-old champion, obviously, is in there, so it's going to be a good race."

Awesome Feather continues to impress since missing nearly all of her sophomore campaign. The bay completed a championship season with a win in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Churchill Downs, then finally made it back to the races with a two-length tally in Belmont's \$58,000 Le Slew S. the following October. She put forth a dominating performance in Aqueduct's GI Gazelle S. most recently Nov. 26, and lined up as the heavy chalk to remain

unbeaten here. Pressing the early pace through fractions of :23.46 and :46.69, Awesome Feather gained command on the turn for home and took off impressively when asked to win for fun. "She trained great for the race, but you just don't know until you run them," trainer Chad Brown said. "She's just a real pro. I was a little concerned when I saw the fast fractions, but Jeffrey [Sanchez] is part of the team and executed perfectly. She just hit another gear and it was over. I'm not sure we've ever seen every gear she's got. I thought we got a glimpse with her run in the Gazelle. We don't have anything in particular in mind for her. The biggest thing with her is to see how she comes back. We'll talk to the Stronachs and see where we go. With her it's one race at a time." Sanchez has been aboard in all nine of Awesome Feather's career starts. "She's the best horse I've ever ridden," he said. "She's the best filly in the world."

California-bred Willa B Awesome, heroine of the Barretts Debutante S. in September, hit the board in her next three attempts against stakes company, including a third-place finish behind Charm the Maker (Empire Maker) in the Sharp Cat S. Nov. 13 and a runner-up effort in the California Breeders Champion S. on the opening day program Dec. 26. Let go as the longest shot on the board in this five-horse affair, the chestnut was hustled to the front, clicked off fractions of :23.23 and :46.80, took off as they straightened for home and showed them her heels in the stretch. "It's pretty nice seeing her break like the way she did today," trainer Walther Solis

commented. "I was thinking about coming from third or fourth, but with them scratching the speed, I told Martin [Pedroza], 'Let's go to the lead and have them catch us.'" "It was just the way I planned it. I took advantage of her speed. I put her where she wanted to be, and then I said, 'Come and get me.'" Favored Charm the Maker, last seen finishing second to Killer Graces in the GI Hollywood Startlet S. Dec. 10, trailed for most of the way and failed to fire in the stretch.

wins in the Presque Isle Debutante S., the Inaugural S. at Presque Isle, and the Robert M. O'Malley S. at Suffolk, and most recently captured Tampa's Minaret S. by 8 1/4 lengths Dec. 31. Seeking her fourth straight tally here, It's Me Mom was gunned from her inside post, rattled off

fractions of :22.25 and :44.41, and kept finding more in the stretch to win with authority.

"I think the biggest difference between then and now is that she just grew up and matured," trainer Lynne Scace reflected of her charge. "She also likes her races spaced out. We'll take her back to Tampa now. I haven't really thought much about what might be next."

Champion Musical Romance (Concorde's Tune) failed to land a blow in fourth while making her first race since capturing the GI Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint Nov. 4. "[Jockey] Juan [Leyva] said she popped up leaving the gate," trainer Bill Kaplan said. "She broke a little bad so he did the right thing once that happened, he let her do her own thing. It's the first time something like this happened in her last nine starts. You don't want to go chasing this early in the year when you give up five, six lengths like that. She pulled up great and everything was fine."

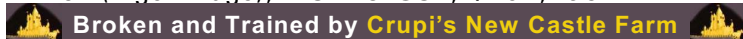

"He's a better horse this year than he was last coming back from the injury," trainer Dale Romans revealed. "He had a cracked shin. I've always thought he could get the mile and an eighth because even though he runs on the front he relaxes. I haven't got anything in particular picked out for him at this point. We'll start talking about it tomorrow."

Igugu hadn't faced the starter since winning the G2 Ipi Tombe Challenge at Turffontein Dec. 4, and missed her intended prep with a slight respiratory infection earlier this month. But she took her spot in the Met despite her isolation in the Kenilworth quarantine center, and came through for her connections. Generally in the thick of things, Igugu had been expected to show the way if there wasn't a pace, and the signs were ominous when she strolled out of the stalls. She raced in fifth while not traveling very comfortably, and taking home the trophy seemed unlikely as they turned into the straight. Bravura had the lead and was moving very well when Gimmethgreenlight came to deliver his run. Jockey Anthony Delpech switched the filly out, but he didn't get an immediate response. The crowd came alive, and it was only in the final 100 meters that Igugu finally got going en route to another big trophy. De Kock had freely stated that he thought his filly would be making the running. "Well, I thought that if there was a slow pace, we'd be in front, so I was concerned," her trainer said after registering an 87th success at the top level and third renewal of this showpiece. "With a quarter mile to run, I thought we might be third. You could see she was making an effort."

De Kock added, "The month she has had, she had no right to win, and I don't think she had the easiest passage in the race. I think she was probably at 90% today, so for her to dig deep and still win humbles me. She has been locked up in a quarantine from dawn to dusk and it hasn't been easy. These champions seem to get over these problems and she wasn't the Igugu that was in the July today--she didn't have that early-gate speed and was a little sluggish, which is not what we know of her at all." Igugu will now head back to her Johannesburg home, and a decision on whether she remains in South Africa will be made in the coming months. "We'll see how things go in May," said de Kock. "If she can leave the country, then we'll probably ship her in June or July. If not, then maybe the Durban July."

He stepped up to nine panels for the Listed Politician S. at Kenilworth Jan. 7, and handled the added ground here with aplomb.

FIRST-CLASS FIELD LINES UP FOR CUP

A slew of accomplished and familiar rivals line up in today's 1600-meter Stewards' Cup at Sha Tin in Hong Kong, led by **Ambitious Dragon (NZ)** (Pins {Aus}), **California Memory** (Highest Honor {GB}) and **Able One (NZ)** (Cape Cross {Ire}). Such is the quality of the field that nine of the 14 runners feature in the recently published 2011 World Thoroughbred Rankings, with reigning Hong Kong Horse of the Year Ambitious Dragon rated 122. That one, winner of last season's Mercedes-Benz HK Derby, is looking for redemption after suffering defeat in his last two, most recently when fourth behind California Memory in the 2000-meter G1 Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup Dec. 11. The Tony Millard-trained gelding tuned up for this with a "victory" in a 1000-meter barrier trial Jan. 17. "His barrier trial was nice, and we've just freshened him up," said Millard. "We haven't done much since his race in December. The main thing was to make him happy and enjoy racing, and that's how we've approached his preparation. Everybody's there in the race, they've all come out to play, so it will be interesting to see how it pans out. Our only concern is that we want to see a genuinely run race. He's pretty versatile, so the drop back to a mile is not a problem." Douglas Whyte partners the 5-year-old. "Ambitious Dragon trialed with purpose," said the champion rider. "He came through and did his job, and he's in great order. He looks like he's thriving in the morning."

TRF Unveils NY Retraining Program:

Edited Press Release

The Thoroughbred Retirement Foundation has launched a new program, created to develop second careers for horses racing at New York Racing Association tracks. The program, initiated with a \$225,000 start-up grant from the Harriet E. Pflieger Foundation, will provide rehabilitation and retraining for as many as 100 horses a year. Among other groups that have committed to fund the initiative are New York Racing Association, the New York Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, The Jockey Club, the New York Thoroughbred Breeders, Inc. and The Jockeys' Guild. "With the spark created by a large donation from a private foundation, we were able to put together a consortium of racing partners to fund and oversee this valuable new program," TRF Director of External Affairs Diana Pikulski said. "We have a model here in New York that embodies what everyone is trying to accomplish in the industry nationwide. We are excited that this has become a reality."







In the initial phase of the program, the TRF plans to redevelop its retirement farm at the Walkkill Correctional Facility in Walkkill, New York. Walkkill, which is home to hundreds of Thoroughbred retirees cared for by Walkkill Correctional Facility inmates, has been expanded to include the capability for short- and middle-term rehabilitation. According to Pikulski, horses will be sent from NYRA tracks to Walkkill for an evaluation that will determine if they are sound enough for the program, and whether they need short- or long-term rest before they begin the retraining process prior to adoption. The TRF is also exploring potential sites to be used as the retraining centers, which will showcase the horses for those looking to adopt. The first horses are expected to be accepted into the program early this spring. "Walkkill has the facilities now for basic retirement, with the inmates grooming the horses and keeping them happy and healthy, but this is a genuine effort to repurpose the horses that are sound enough to have a future in other equine disciplines," said NYTHA President Rick Violette, Jr. "That's a significant challenge, for sure, but it's a challenge that can be met, and it coincides with other initiatives that NYTHA and NYRA are developing to find second careers for racehorses. Horses that are physically able don't need to be turned out--they really are much happier if they have jobs to do. Everyone recognizes that, ultimately, this is all about the horses."

NYRA and NYTHA have partnered to commit a total of \$185,000 to the initiative; The Jockey Club will contribute \$50,000, and an additional \$135,000 has been collected from fundraisers and private donations. A committee comprised of representatives from NYTHA, NYRA, TRF, NYTB, the Jockey's Guild and the public will provide oversight for the program. "I think it is significant that all of these industry stakeholders are rallying with substantial financial support around an expansion of the TRF's signature and award-winning project," said NYTB Executive Director Jeffrey Cannizzo. "We are also grateful for the very substantial generosity of the Harriet Pflieger Foundation. This is an initiative that has a documented success in the rehabilitation of criminal offenders while at the same time advancing the TRF's horse rescue mission. It's a tribute to all involved."

Mike Tammaro Dead at 57: *Edited Press Release*

Longtime Kentucky trainer Michael A. Tammaro died of a heart attack at St. Elizabeth Hospital in Edgewood, Kentucky, Friday night following a long illness. He was 57. One of his five sisters, Cathy Tammaro, had been his assistant until recent years. The jockey Dean Sarvis is a nephew, while another nephew, John Tammaro IV, is a blacksmith. Mike Tammaro earned his first win as a trainer in 1975 with Bid For Me at Laurel. According to Equibase, Tammaro trained 8,380 starters and compiled a record of 930 wins, 1,006 seconds, and 998 thirds and purse earnings of more than \$17 million. Among Tammaro's stakes winners were Amerigirl, Claire's Honor, Three Fanfares, Golden Choice, Wonchindordor, Steady Zephyr, and Dynamic Asset. First South African Stakes Winner for Trippi...

Yesterday, two horses helped illustrate that, when it comes to the End Sweep stallion Trippi, America's loss is South Africa's gain. At Gulfstream, the now-expatriated sire was represented by his newest stakes winner, the lightly raced 4-year-old colt Soaring Stocks, who sprang a slight upset in the \$150,000 Florida Sunshine Millions Sprint S. for trainer Todd Pletcher. It was only hours earlier, but halfway around the world, that Trippi's 2-year-old daughter **Agra (SAf)** began a Saturday advertising campaign for her sire's prepotency. Racing in the colors of Barry Irwin's Team Valor International, Agra easily defeated males in her second career start in the Summer Juvenile S. at Kenilworth. She is Trippi's first stakes winner in South Africa. Formerly a leading sire in Florida, Trippi was purchased by Johann and Gaynor Rupert's L'Ormarins Stud in 2008. Trippi stands at Drakenstein Stud, situated amongst the vineyards at L'Ormarins, and has his first runners this season in South Africa. **Cont. p8**

Agra, purchased by Irwin for R700,000 (about \$100,000) at the Cape Premier Yearling Sale, has a ways to go before equaling the feat of another Team Valor stakes winner on the Kenilworth card yesterday--G1 Majorca S. heroine **Ebony Flyer (SAf)** (Jet Master {SAf})--but Irwin likes what he's seen thus far.

"The guy that trains her, Justin Snaith, told us she was his best 2-year-old," said Irwin. "The first time she ran she won, but she was green and kind of edgy, and even though she won. This time they brought a pony with her to the post, just to calm her down. She broke on top and must have been 1 1/2 lengths clear in the first 50 yards, but the jock got her to come back to him, and she relaxed. And he never even asked her to run. It was a matter of him letting

her out a notch every once in a while, and she spurted away and won by four. It was very impressive."

Irwin said the filly would likely have two more starts in her 2-year-old year (she'll turn three Aug. 1), with South Africa's version of the G1 Golden Slipper in July a possible target.

Irwin said that Team Valor had campaigned a few horses by Trippi before, but that he felt particularly confident buying Agra given the surface on which she'd be running.

"I loved her physically, but also, to me, Trippis always move up a little bit on the turf," he said. "I felt comfortable knowing that, and it gave me the courage to buy one."

Irwin, meanwhile, had the courage to buy Ebony Flyer and her dam Sunshine Lover (SAf) (Badger Land) as a package as he already own her sister, Captain's Lover (SAf) (Captain Al {SAf}). Team Valor had privately purchased Captain's Lover, whose wins included the G1 Cape Fillies Guineas.

"Right before Captain's Lover got good, we bought the mother, and Ebony Flyer was at her side," said Irwin. "I put [Ebony Flyer] through the yearling sale, and I bought her for myself. I got a lot of calls asking about offering her, so I formed a new partnership to race her."

Ebony Flyer matched her sister's feat of winning the Cape Fillies Guineas, and like Captain's Lover, might come to U.S. shores eventually. Captain's Lover, also a group winner in France, won the Taylor Made Matchmaker S. at Monmouth in 2009.

"If she's good enough, we'll bring her here, and it looks like she's good enough," Irwin said. "But you never know." -LM
