CAVIAR PUTS ORR FOES ON ICE

As **Black Caviar** (Aus) (Bel Esprit {Aus}) cantered under the wire in Saturday's G1 C. F. Orr S. at Flemington, race commetator Greg Miles called her "The Greatest Show on Earth." Who's to argue, really? The world's top-rated horse was trying 1400 meters for the first time in front of a packed house, and trainer Peter Moody theorized that the 5-year-old could be even better at this slightly longer trip and maybe beyond. She did little to prove him wrong, switching off for the first 4 1/2 furlongs before cruising effortlessly to the pacesetters and streaking clear to the roar of the crowd. **Southern Speed** (Aus) (Southern Image), last year's G1 Caulfield Cup victress, was second best. Black Caviar won the race with a blistering :10.64 sectional from the 400-meter mark to the furlong pole. "What can you say, it's just unbelievable, it's mind-boggling", said Moody. "I know people doubt the opposition, but they're good horses, there's a Caulfield Cup winner who looked outstanding three weeks ago and what she does to good horses is beyond belief, it's unbelievable. You'd hate to disappoint 20,000 to 30,000 thousand people who have turned up, I'm just rapt." **Cont. p4**

Hymn Book, a distant second behind Flat Out (Flatter) in last year's GI Suburban H. at Belmont in July, took the first turn five wide after breaking from post 10 in Gulfstream's centerpiece for older horses. The dark bay was settled in fifth as Trickmeister (Proud Citizen) was hounded by Shackelford (Forestry) through strong early fractions of :23.46 and :47.05. Mission Impazible got first run on the tiring leaders, slipping through an inviting opening along the inside

to hit the front off the turn for home. Hymn Book came with a sustained stretch rally on the outside and made his way past a very game Mission Impazible as that one drifted out several paths down the lane.

"Right after he ran so well in the Cigar Mile I started thinking about this race for him, although I didn't know it would come up this strong," trainer Shug McGaughey said of Belmont's \$60,000 Firethorn S. hero. "This was a good field. We were concerned about the post position and he kind of got caught out there on the first turn, but then got a good position down the backstretch. Johnny [Velazquez] has always had a lot of confidence in him going back to when he was second to Flat Out in the Suburban."

Velazquez added, "It worked out perfect. I wanted to come out running and go onto the first turn and try to get some kind of position and not be too far back. He broke well enough to save some ground into the first turn and I was able to kind of give up a little bit at the quarter pole. When I pulled him out he came running. Get Stormy, who paired up wins in the GI Maker's Mark Mile at Keeneland and GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill last spring, was eased late in his 2012 finale when 12th in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile under the Twin Spires Nov. 5. Brought back for another campaign, the robust bay was sent off as the second choice here despite his distinguished resume. Get Stormy assumed his usual spot on the front end, with all of the recent rain resulting in a :51.07 half and a six-furlong split of 1:16.14. Hollinger took dead aim on him in the lane, but Get Stormy was resolute and hit the wire in time. "I was not concerned about the ground at all," said winning trainer Tom Bush. "He showed from early in his career he handles soft ground." Get Stormy will target the Breeders' Cup once more, despite coming up short in the last two editions of the Mile at Churchill. "The two Breeders' Cup races are still a mystery, except that the course there is different in the fall than it is in the spring," Bush offered. "Maybe we'll get him on that firm turf at Santa Anita later this year, and he'll like that." Favored Silver Medallion (Badge of Silver) spun his wheels over the going. "The turf was a little too soft for him today," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "We'll regroup and come up with a game plan."

Add another top sophomore to Todd Pletcher's already loaded barn. Thunder Moccasin, a smart wire-to-wire victor over impressive next out winners Ender Knievel (Distorted Humor) and Panthro (Discreet Cat) in his Gulfstream unveiling Dec. 24 ([video](#)), stayed perfect with another sharp score here. Heavily favored in this field of five, the bay sat a looming presence in second as II Villano clicked off fractions of :23.34 and :46.89. With John Velazquez aboard, the Starlight Racing colorbearer turned up the heat as they straightened for home and dropped the hammer on his Hutcheson rivals in the stretch. "He's a very talented colt," Pletcher said. "His first race was so impressive with the move he made we thought that we'd take a shot and go right into the Hutcheson. If he comes back all right, the logical spot next would be the [GII] Swale [S. Mar. 10]. Right now, my inclination is that he'll be best staying in one-turn races."

Will the real Slim Shadey please stand up? He did yesterday. The dark bay annexed only one of 13 starts overseas, then kicked things off stateside with a ninth-place finish in a Santa Anita allowance Jan. 2. He put it all together with a 13-1 upset at this distance in a \$40,000 optional tagger Jan. 12, and was overlooked in this much tougher assignment. Sent to the front, Slim Shadey set early fractions of :24.39

and :49.20, kicked for home with a clear advantage and was saved by the wire. "We planned on being on the lead and wanted to get him to relax," trainer Simon Callaghan commented. "David [Flores] gave him an absolutely perfect ride. The horse was training really good. I thought he was in tough today, but when you can go to the front and have tactical speed like him, it's good. There was no real pace in the race, and David just gave him a perfect ride. It's nice when the plans come off."

Not quite as accomplished as her talented half-sister Keertana, Snow Top Mountain took the overland route and was up late for a richly deserved first graded-stakes score. The grey filly burned a bit of money last summer, finishing fourth as the favorite in the GIII Mint Julep H. at Churchill June 11 and in overnight stakes at Indiana Downs June 29 and at Saratoga Aug. 10. She was not the chalk in the Kentucky Cup Distaff Turf at Kentucky Downs Sept. 10, but snapped her three-race skid with a 3/4-length tally. Third by a head in an off-turf allowance at Keeneland Oct. 26, Snow Top Mountain closed to be 3/4 of a length back in third in the GIII My Charmer H. at Calder Nov. 24 and was exiting a near-miss second to Speak Easy Gal (West Acre) in a Tampa allowance test Jan. 8. Wrangled back to race last but one as Speak Easy Gal set a moderate pace over the rain-affected surface, Snow Top Mountain bided her time beneath Jose Lezcano. She still had just one behind as they reached the lane, but the homebred was angled outside of GIII Marshuas River S. winner Heavenly Landing (Pulpit), and rallied in the five path to run down Hit It Rich late. "We've kind of considered her little sister [to Keertana], but after this race we might have to reconsider," said trainer Tom Proctor. "I'm not one to make a lot of plans ahead for the horses. We'll just see what comes along."

Trainer Todd Pletcher saddled his 3,000th career winner in Saturday's third race at Gulfstream when unbeaten Spring Hill Farm (Smart Strike) scored at 4-5. "It's been a great run," Pletcher said in the winner's circle. "We've been very fortunate--a lot of great owners, a lot of great horses, tremendous help, a tremendous staff." The Eclipse Award-winning conditioner added, "It gives you a little time to reflect. There's not many opportunities to reflect in this business, but milestones like this give you a chance to appreciate all of them." When asked what his next goal was, Pletcher replied, "Three thousand and one." He didn't have to wait too long. In the very next race, Majestic Number (Officer)--named in honor of Pletcher's first career winner--came through at 5-2 for the bettors. Was there a favorite moment for Pletcher upon reaching the milestone? "I would have to say the victory by Rags to Riches in the Belmont, Super Saver winning the Derby and two victories in the Travers [Stay Thirsty in 2011 and Flower Alley in 2005] along with the Breeders' Cup wins, stand out," he replied. "I've been fortunate that a lot of those [3,000] victories came in significant races."

Havre de Grace Likely to Return at Fair Grounds...

A day after Horse of the Year Havre de Grace (Saint Liam) recorded her first breeze of the year, trainer Larry Jones suggested that the 5-year-old mare would likely make her seasonal debut at the Fair Grounds. "We would like to get Havre de Grace's first race right here," Jones said, speaking from the Fair Grounds barn area during training hours Saturday morning. "That way we wouldn't have to ship her or anything like that." The local races under consideration are the \$100,000 New Orleans Ladies S. Mar. 17 or a start against males in the GII New Orleans H. Apr. 1. Jones said a title defense in the GIII Azeri S. Mar. 17 is also possible. Despite having recorded just one official workout in 2012, Havre de Grace can easily make those targets, Jones says. "She gets ready pretty quick," the conditioner confirmed. "I found that out last year. This time last year we didn't have her up to anything like a half-mile and the first time we tried to work her at a half-mile she went 53 and four [fifths]. She galloped out in 51 and change yesterday. We're already ahead of last year."

Caleb's Posse Tom Fool Bound...

McNeil Stables and Cheyenne Stables's GI Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile hero **Caleb's Posse** (Posse) will begin his 4-year-old campaign with the GIII Tom Fool H. at the Big A Mar. 3. "Right now our plan is to run in the Tom Fool," trainer Donnie Von Hemel said. "It is a good chance to get him acclimated with Aqueduct and also provides great timing to the [GI] Carter [Apr. 7]. The enhanced purses [at Aqueduct] certainly get everyone's attention and is a factor in any decision that we make." Caleb's Posse, a Eclipse finalist for champion sprinter and champion 3-year-old in 2011, also won last year's GI King's Bishop S. and GII Amsterdam S., both held at Saratoga. Caleb's Posse continues to train smartly at Oaklawn Park, most recently drilling a bullet five furlongs in :59.60 Saturday. "He has been doing great," Von Hemel said. "If everything goes well in his next few starts, the [GI] Met Mile [at Belmont Park May 28] is a goal of ours."

Godolphin's **Alpha** (Bernardini), a decisive winner of Aqueduct's \$150,000 Count Fleet S. Jan. 7 and GIII Withers S. Feb. 4, will train at Palm Meadows for his next start in either the GIII Gotham S. Mar. 3 or the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 7. "He shipped [Friday] and is at Palm Meadows," McLaughlin confirmed. "He'll train here and probably won't work for two weeks. There's a plane going up to New York before the Gotham that we could take, but he'll probably make his next start in the Wood Memorial, with an outside chance of the [GI] Florida Derby [Mar. 31 at Gulfstream] the week before."

Consortium (Bernardini), also owned by Godolphin, has joined McLaughlin's Belmont string following a disappointing sixth in the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Jan. 29. "We sent Consortium on a van to New York [Friday]," McLaughlin said. "We'll look at the Gotham with him. He worked at Palm Meadows Thursday [four furlongs in :50.90], and he probably won't work in New York until [Feb. 18]."

McLaughlin also said that he has two possibles for the GIII Tom Fool H. on the Gotham undercard in Darley Stable's unbeaten **Emcee** (Unbridled's Song) and recent optional claimer winner **Crossbow** (Bernardini). The conditioner added that Shadwell Stable's **Falaah** (Speightstown), an impressive victor of two straight at Aqueduct, has been sidelined with a bone chip.

February 11, 1995...1994 Horse of the Year **Holy Bull** injured his left front leg during the running of the Donn Handicap at Gulfstream Park and subsequently was retired to stud at Jonabell Farm.

February 12, 1981...Julie Krone rode her first career winner, a \$3,500 claimer named Lord Farkle, who was owned and trained by Les St. Leon, in the sixth race at Tampa Bay Downs.

February 14, 1966...Buckpasser suffered the only defeat of his three-year-old season, finishing second in a non-betting race, the Black Caesar Purse, at Hialeah. He went on to win 13 straight races in 1966, 12 of them stakes, but missed the Triple Crown due to injury.

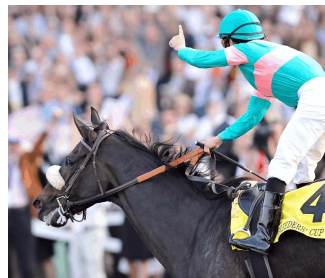

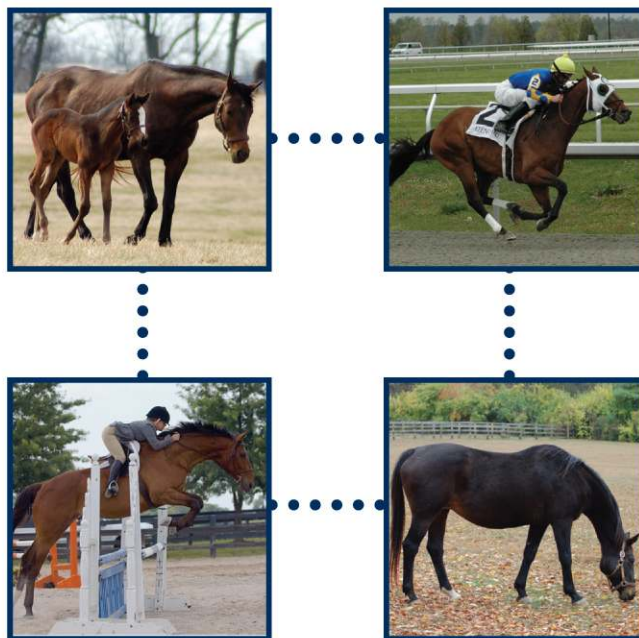
