## REFUSE TO BEND DIES

The Darley stallion **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells--Market Slide, by Gulch) died of a heart attack at Haras du Logis Friday. The 12-year-old was due to stand his first season at the Normandy stud after previously standing at Kildangan Stud and Whitsbury Manor Stud.

Refuse to Bend made a bright start to his career and bagged a first Group 1 success in the 2002 G1 National S. at The Curragh to close an unbeaten juvenile campaign for owner-breeder Moyglare Stud and

trainer Dermot Weld. Refuse to Bend achieved Classic glory in the following term's G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket, but suffered his first defeat in the G1 Epsom Derby.

Purchased privately by Sheikh Mohammed and transferred to Godolphin's trainer Saeed bin Suroor after his sophomore season, Refuse to Bend added Royal Ascot's G1 Queen Anne S. and Sandown's G1 Eclipse S. to his portfolio. He is the sire of three-time Group 1-winning champion Sarafina (Fr) and last term's G1 Prix Saint-Alary victress Wavering (Ire).

"Refuse to Bend was a very good horse," former trainer Dermot Weld told *Racing Post*. "[He was] a lovely horse to train, a lovely made horse and a proper gentleman to deal with. He was very honest and true. He was a horse close to my heart, having won an English 2000 Guineas when he got a brilliant ride from Pat Smullen and had the race won a long way out. I have many happy memories of him."

Darley's director of stallions, Sam Bullard, added, "Refuse to Bend's death will be a significant loss for breeders, Haras du Logis and to Darley. He was a superb racehorse and he had it all ahead of him as a stallion. Refuse to Bend's progeny had a wonderful 2010 and 2011, and as a result he was proving very popular in France this year."

## HYMN BOOK FINE AFTER DONN VICTORY

**Hymn Book** (Arch) exited his dramatic victory in Saturday's G1 Donn H. in fine shape, according to trainer Shug McGaughey. McGaughey confirmed the Apr. 14 GII Oaklawn Park H. could be next for the 6-year-old gelding. Hymn Book was winning his first graded stakes in the Donn, but the victory didn't surprise his trainer. "It was surprising how deep the race was, but it didn't surprise me that he ran as well as he did," McGaughey said. "He's just one of those hard-trying horses that tries every time. He's trained really well this winter at Payson Park. I knew if he ran his race, he'd be a horse to reckon with."

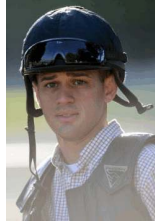

**Creative Cause Works Bullet (cont. from p1)**

Jockey Joel Rosario rode Creative Cause to victory in the GI Norfolk S. last October and to his third-place finish in the Breeders' Cup. He is looking forward to getting the colt's sophomore campaign started in next week's seven-furlong GII San Vicente. "It looks like he could be a little fresh coming off a layoff, but he's a great horse and I love to ride him," Rosario said. "His Breeders' Cup race was a good one. I was impressed with it. Maybe he's the right horse for the Derby, who knows?"

Creative Cause also worked a bullet six furlongs at Hollywood Park Jan. 28, when he covered the distance in a best-of-20 1:11.60.

Also Sunday, GI Del Mar Futurity winner **Drill** (Lawyer Ron) worked five furlongs at Santa Anita in 1:02.00, but trainer Bob Baffert was non-committal on a start in the San Vicente. The dark bay colt was second behind Creative Cause in the Norfolk and 10th in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Off the board in the GIII Delta Downs Jackpot and GI CashCall Futurity, he was fifth in his sophomore debut in the Jan. 22 San Pedro S.



**Castellano Chooses Algorithms Over Union Rags**

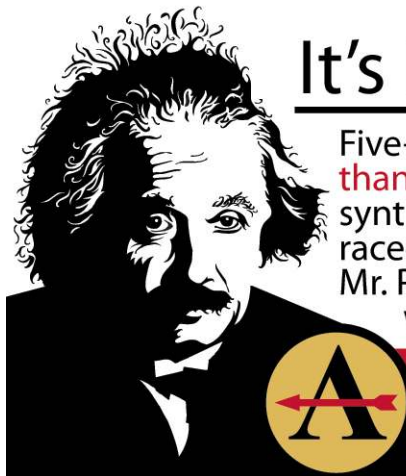
Javier Castellano, who had been the regular rider on GI Champagne S. winner **Union Rags** (Dixie Union), has opted to ride GIII Holy Bull S. winner **Algorithms** (Bernardini) in the Feb. 26 GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Park, according to *Daily Racing Form*. Jockey Julien Leparoux has been tabbed to ride the Michael Matz-trained Union Rags in the Fountain of Youth. In addition to Union Rags and the Todd Pletcher-trained Algorithms, Castellano has regularly ridden Kentucky Derby prospects **El Padrino** (Pulpit), **Discreet Dancer** (Discreet Cat) and **Gemologist** (Tiznow)--all trained by Pletcher.

"Javier rides five top Derby prospects, four of which are with one trainer," Castellano's agent Matt Muzikar told *DRF*. "This was a very tough decision, but Javier and I thought it was the right decision. Both of us have the utmost respect for both Michael Matz and Mrs. [Phyllis] Wyeth. They are both very classy people, and we wish all the connections of Union Rags the best."

## FORCE FREEZE READY FOR COMEBACK

Saeed Naser al Romalhi's **Force Freeze** (Forest Camp), who missed by just a neck when second to Amazombie (Northern Afleet) in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, worked a half-mile from the gate at Gulfstream Park Sunday in :47 2/5. The 7-year-old gelding is expected to make his 2012 debut in next Saturday's GII Gulfstream Park Sprint

Championship. "That put the finishing touches on him and we just have to keep him happy up to the race," trainer Peter Walder said of the work. "My only concern is the distance, particularly coming off the layoff. Seven furlongs is a tricky distance. I think he can run with any horse in the country at six furlongs. [Jockey] Paco [Lopez] is confident that the distance will be no problem. I'm excited to get him started back." Force Freeze was also second in last year's GI Vosburgh Invitational S.

## THE USUAL Q.T. ON THE MEND

**The Usual Q.T.** (Unusual Heat) was forced to miss Saturday's GII San Marcos S. with a quarter crack, but trainer Jim Cassidy is looking forward to the veteran's next start. "I had to put a bandage on him," Cassidy explained. "It will take a couple weeks to get him straightened out and we'll look for the next one."

## SUGGESTIVE BOY TO U.S.

Four-time Argentine Group 1 winner **Suggestive Boy (Arg)** (Easing Along) has arrived in the U.S., where he will continue his racing career. Owned by Jose Cerrillo's Haras Pozo de Luna, the 4-year-old colt will be trained in California by veteran Ron McAnally, joining the 2009 Argentine Horse of the Year Interaction (Arg) (Easing Along).

Suggestive Boy is the heavy favorite to be honored as 2011 Horse of the Year in Argentina after breaking his maiden in the G1 Gran Premio Raul y Raul E. Beautiful But Blue struggled a bit early in her career to harness her ample speed, but lost the blinkers for her fourth maiden try in the slop here Nov. 23, and scored from off the pace. She cruised by 4 3/4 lengths in a first-level allowance Dec. 28, and was stretching out for the first time in this spot. Quickly in front from her rail draw here, the homebred traveled well within herself through splits of :24.52, :49.57 and 1:15.05 over a track that had been kind to speed all day. She took a clear lead into the stretch and, despite shying from the whip as she had in previous efforts, was impossible to catch in the run to the wire. "After each race, she's been a totally different filly," said Jose Calderon, assistant to trainer Tom Bush. "She's growing into herself, and mentally she's learning. I said [to rider Junior Alvarado], 'If she takes the lead, just go ahead.' We didn't want her to get rank and uncomfortable." Alvarado added, "I went to the lead and tried to relax her, and she did everything else by herself. She's a big filly, and when I rode her [in sprints] after she would keep bounding around the turn, so I knew she'd be good going a longer distance."
