Triple Threats

Union Rags Drills for Fountain of Youth...

Phyllis Wyeth's **Union Rags** (Dixie Union), the flashy winner of last season's GII Saratoga Special S. and GI Champagne S. before falling by a head to Hansen (Tapit) after a troubled trip in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Nov. 5, worked an easy five furlongs at Palm Meadows Monday as he prepares for the GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Feb. 26. In company with Peruvian Group 1 winner Rihanna (Per) (Apprentice), the homebred

covered five furlongs in 1:03.08. It was the 21st fastest of 26 drills at the distance. Rihanna went in 1:03.43. "He just did whatever we asked him to do," said Matz of the work. "He worked with Rihanna--they worked to the wire together and that was it." New pilot Julien Leparoux was aboard Union Rags for the spin--it was announced Sunday that the bay's regular rider Javier Castellano would instead opt to ride Starlight Racing's GIII Holy Bull S. romper Algorithms (Bernardini) for trainer Todd Pletcher in the Fountain of Youth. Union Rags will have one more work before his sophomore debut. "He'll come out of the gate on Sunday and that's it," said Matz.

ROYAL DELTA TO RETURN IN SABIN

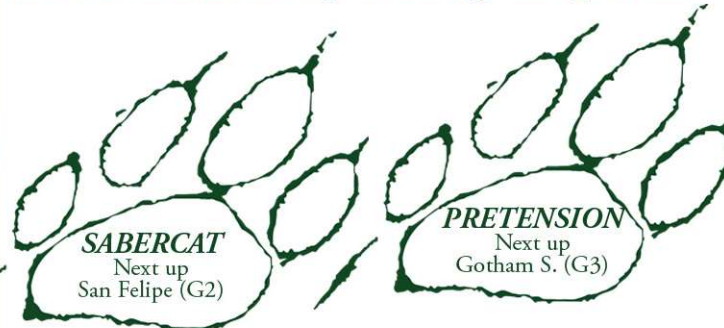
Eclipse-winning trainer Bill Mott announced yesterday that Besilu Stable's **Royal Delta** (Empire Maker) will most likely prep for the Mar. 31 G1 Dubai World Cup in Gulfstream's upcoming 1 1/16-mile GIII Sabin S. Feb. 25. "She's doing well," Mott told *Daily Racing Form* of the 2011 champion 3-year-old filly, who has been training at Payson Park since re-joining Mott's stable after Ben Leon went to \$8.5 million for her at KEENOV. "I've nominated her to the Sabin. It's the only spot I see for her if we want to run around here. The distance is a little short for her, but the timing might work. I'd like to get her started here, get a race into her, and then go to Dubai. I toyed with the idea of not running her and training her up to the World Cup, but that would mean she'd be going five months without a race."

Also scheduled to resurface in the Sabin is Robsham Stables' **Awesome Maria** (Maria's Mon), who hasn't been seen since annexing the GI Ogden Phipps H. by three lengths at Belmont in June. "She's been ready to run for a month, but we couldn't get an allowance race to go, so we'll probably be taking all the worst of it going into the Sabin off a June layoff, especially going up against a very talented filly like Royal Delta," trainer Todd Pletcher told *DRF*. The 5-year-old bred five panels in 1:00.23 at Palm Meadows yesterday.

El Padrino Breezes For Risen Star...

Let's Go Stable's **El Padrino** (Pulpit) breezed four furlongs in :48.28 under jockey Javier Castellano yesterday at Palm Meadows as he prepares for a return to stakes company in the GII Risen Star S. at Fair

Grounds Feb. 25. The Todd Pletcher-trained 3-year-old is coming off an impressive allowance score over an off track at Gulfstream Jan. 29 ([video](#)). "I thought it was a very rhythmic work with a super gallop-out," said Bryan

Sullivan, who manages Let's Go along with Kevin Scatuorchio, and was on hand for the work. "Todd and Javier were both pleased, so it seemed to go very well. He'll have one more work next week in preparation for the Risen Star."

El Padrino has become one of the early talking horses on the GI Kentucky Derby trail despite not having won a stakes. At 16-1, he was the fourth betting choice in Pool 1 of the Derby future wager that closed Sunday, behind "All Others" (3-2), Union Rags (Dixie Union) (7-1) and Algorithms (Bernardini) (12-1). A big 12 3/4-length winner in his second start in the mud at Belmont Oct. 29, he then was beaten 3/4 lengths when third to O'Prado Again (El Prado {Ire}) in the GII Remsen S. Nov. 26. In his first start of 2012, El Padrino unleashed a strong late run to beat Take Charge Indy (A.P. Indy) by two lengths in a 1 1/16-mile optional claimer in his latest. That effort earned him a 100 Beyer (currently co-fourth best in the nation among sophomores), and plenty of respect from a betting public that seems to be gauging El Padrino as a true two-turn horse. "At the end of the day, we always thought the farther the better with this horse, so we're all excited about his future," added Sullivan. Castellano, who last weekend said he would ride Algorithms over Union Rags in the GII Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream a day after the Risen Star, will make the trip to Louisiana to ride El Padrino. -LM

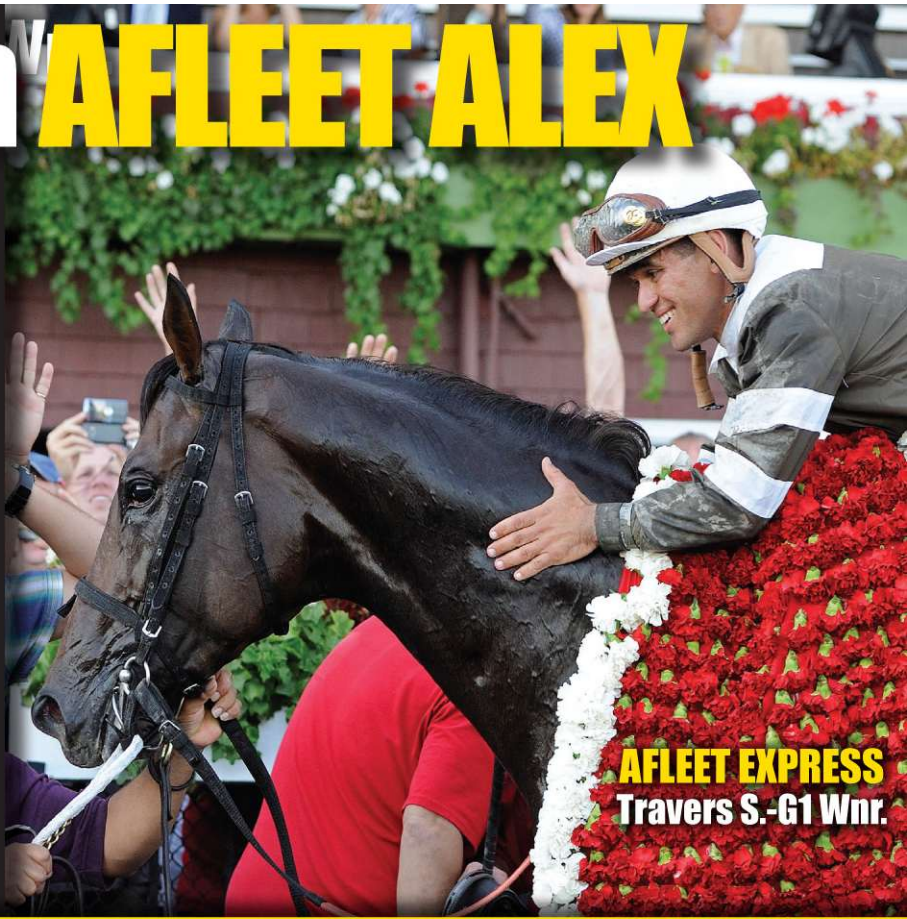

Pletcher Pleased with Fountain Hopefuls...

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent a pair of contenders for the Feb. 26 GII Fountain of Youth S. to work yesterday at Palm Meadows. Starlight Racing's unbeaten **Algorithms** (Bernardini), coming off a five-length victory in the Jan. 29 GIII Holy Bull S., went four furlongs in :49.20. Stablemate **Discreet Dancer** (Discreet Cat), a ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆, went five furlongs in company in 1:00.90.

"Algorithms just had a nice, steady maintenance kind of work and galloped out strong," Pletcher told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's very fit, we don't need to do much more with him."

Discreet Dancer, a perfect two-for-two in his career, has been off since a sparkling 5 1/2-length allowance victory over one mile at Gulfstream Jan. 7 ([video](#)). The Robsham homebred missed training time last week due to an elevated temperature, but proved to his trainer he was back on track yesterday.

"I thought Discreet Dancer worked extra good this morning," Pletcher said. "He looked full of run and galloped out strong. We made up some ground from what we lost last week and I'm very happy where we are with him at the moment."

Baffert Pair to Oaklawn...

The Bob Baffert-trained duo of ☆ **"TDN Rising Star"** ☆ **Secret Circle** (Eddington) and **Castaway** (Street Sense) both worked six panels at Santa Anita Monday, and will both contest Oaklawn's

GIII Southwest S. Feb. 20, according to a tweet by the Hall of Fame conditioner. Secret Circle, who finished off a three-for-three 2-year-old campaign with a score in the Nov. 4 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Sprint, is coming off a runner-up finish to Out of Bounds (Discreet Cat) in the GIII Sham S. in Arcadia Jan. 7. Surprisingly absent from the first round of Kentucky Derby future wagers, the Pegram, Watson and Weitman representative covered the six furlongs yesterday in a bullet 1:11.60. Tabor, Magnier and Smith's Castaway, a \$435,000 KEESEP yearling who broke his maiden last out Jan. 21, was timed in 1:12.40--third fastest at the distance.

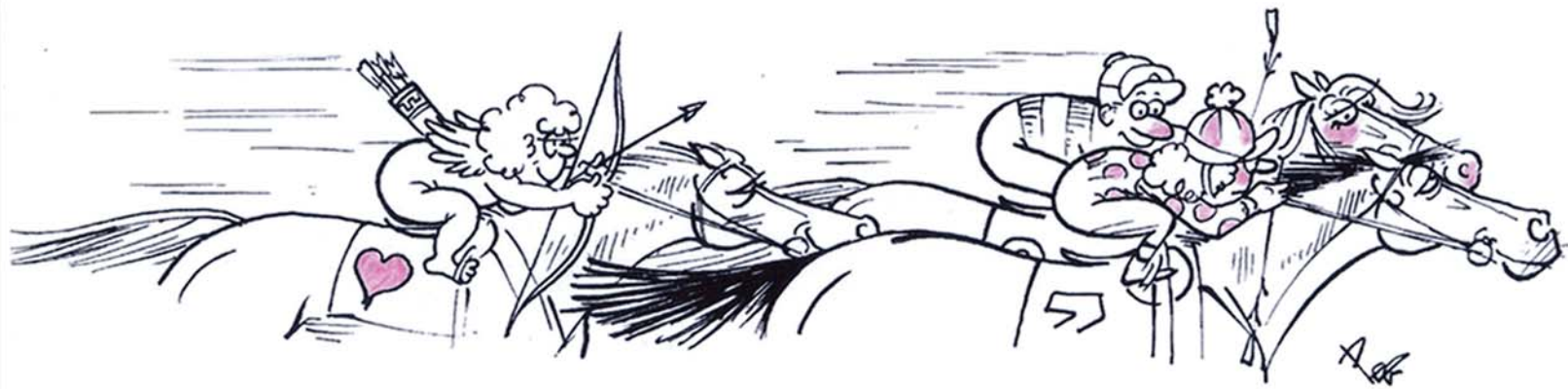

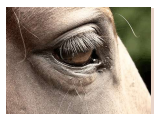

It's a measure of how much things have changed that Habitat--a leading Irish stallion whose book was sometimes a little higher than the norm during the 1970s--is credited with 695 foals during a career which lasted until he was 20. Sadler's Wells, on the other hand, notched up 2,295 foals, while Storm Cat bowed out with 1,412, Mr. Prospector with 1,178 and Danzig with 1,075.

Plenty of today's established stallions already have four-figure totals to their credit. Using the *Blood-Horse's* AEI table, Smart Strike has 1,024 named foals of racing age; Dynaformer 1,211; Unbridled's Song 1,088, Giant's Causeway 1,168; Tale of the Cat 1,178; Stormy Atlantic 1,088; Holy Bull 1,046; Grand Slam 1,227; and Thunder Gulch 1,158. Of course several of these stallions also have Southern Hemisphere stock to their credit.

Sadly, one stallion whose total will never reach four figures is Kingmambo. Because health problems reduced his ability to cover towards the end of his career, Kingmambo has just under 900 named foals to his credit, his final foal being a 2-year-old of 2012. He was retired after failing to impregnate his single mate in 2010, at the age of 20.

Kingmambo has only 11 3-year-olds in his 2009 crop but one of them, Kinglet, added to his substantial total of stakes winners when he finished well to take last week's G3 UAE 2,000 Guineas. The question now is whether this Godolphin colt can progress to become Kingmambo's first Group 1 winner since his excellent 2005 crop, which featured Henrythenavigator, Thewayyouare, Campanologist and the Australian Group 1 winner (My) Kingdom of Fife (GB). **Cont. p7**

Of course the Lane's End stallion's highly impressive worldwide tally of Grade I/Group 1 winners features such notable sons as Lemon Drop Kid, King's Best, Alkaased, Student Council, El Condor Pasa and King Kamehameha, as well as such outstanding fillies as Russian Rhythm and Divine Proportions. King Kamehameha has been Japan's champion sire for the last two years, while King's Best has sired Derby winners in Britain and Japan, so Kinglet should have a future as a stallion if he can build on his Meydan group success.

Kingmambo sired that tough and talented filly Voodoo Dancer from a Danzig mare and Kinglet is out of a grand-daughter, by the GI Breeders' Cup Mile winner War Chant.

War Chant's record as a stallion has to be considered disappointing in view of the opportunities he originally received. He has only two winners at the highest level on the flat to his credit in the major racing countries, one being last year's GI Santa Anita Derby winner Midnight Interlude, the other being the G1 National S. winner Kingsfort. However, Kinglet's dam Karen's Capar very nearly became a third Grade I winner for him in the years she carried the colors of Stonerside Stable. Having won the G3 Nell Gwyn S., one of the main trials for the G1 1,000 Guineas, Karen's Capar finished a respectable fourth of 20 in the Classic. She then lost the G1 Coronation S. by the narrowest margin and later suffered a similar fate on her American debut, when she just failed to catch Sweet Talker in the GI Queen Elizabeth II S. Karen's Capar went on to add a couple of Grade III successes as a 4-year-old, at up to 1 1/16 miles, and this consistent filly has to be considered unlucky not to have won something better.

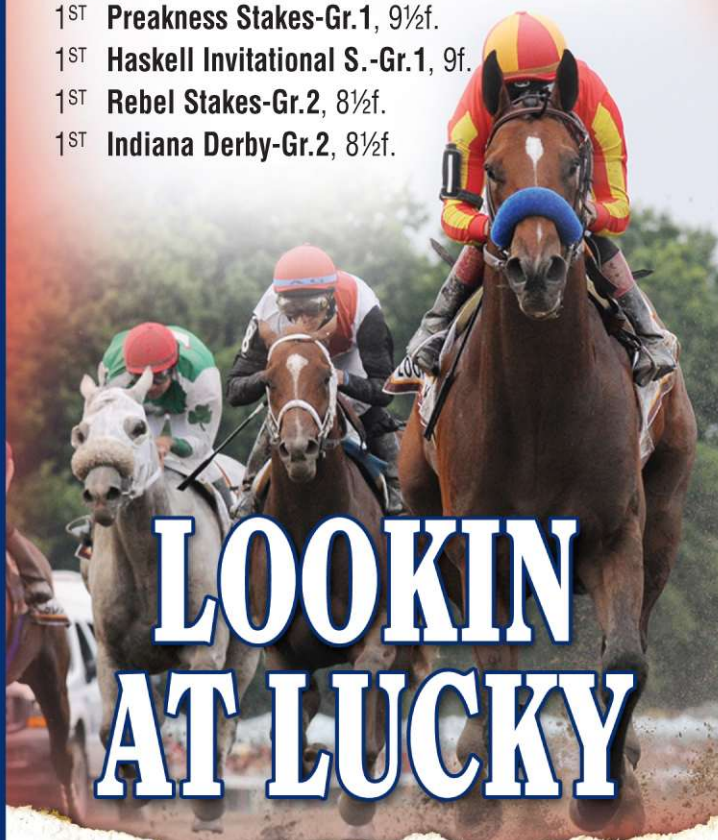

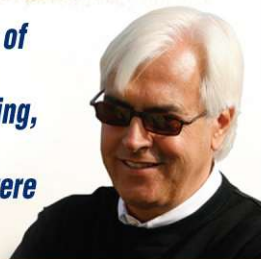

Kinglet's victory came a day after Godolphin had announced the retirement of that grand filly Blue Bunting. Coincidentally, both of these Godolphin performers come from the same female line, each of them having the French filly Miss Satin as their fourth dam.

I am glad to have the opportunity to write about this female line, as Blue Bunting's achievements of winning last year's G1 1,000 Guineas, G1 Irish Oaks and G1 Yorkshire Oaks marked her out as something special. At the time I opted to write about other horses, as I had already written about two other members of Dynaformer's 2008 crop.

Miss Skyscraper, the fifth dam of Kinglet and Blue Bunting, was one of the foundation mares of the late Jean-Luc Lagardere's highly successful racing and breeding operation. Even though this tough filly had won the Kempton 1,000 Guineas Trial and earned a Timeform rating of 110, she was bought for as little as 7,600gns. She rewarded her buyer with the Group 2 winner Mister Ski and with Miss Satin, who produced the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois winner Miss Satamixa to Linamix, who also sired Blue Bunting's dam Miarixa. Miss Satin's daughters also included Mrs Annie, who produced group winners to three different stallions, plus a Group 1 performer to a fourth. The Group 1 performer, Mrs Arkada, is the second dam of Blue Bunting.

Miss Skyscraper's family continues to flourish. Bonfire, the highly regarded English colt who featured in a *TDN* 'In Sharper Focus' piece Jan. 26 ([click here](#)), is out of a granddaughter of Miss Satin. Bonfire's second dam Miss d'Ouille is the third dam of Kinglet.

Kinglet's family arrived in the U.S. with the purchase of his second dam, Miss Caerleona. Only a listed-placed winner in France, this daughter of Caerleon did well in her new home, notably winning the GIII Cardinal H., and she was also runner-up in a Grade II over a mile and a half.

Miss Caerleona continued the good work after she joined the Stonerside broodmare band, producing the Grade II winner Miss Coronado in addition to Karen's Caper.

Kinglet has yet to tackle more than a mile, but there's good reason to think that he will stay a mile and a quarter. WONDER ACUTE AIMS FOR FEBRUARY UPSET

The first Group 1 on the Japanese racing calendar is set for this Sunday, and while **Transcend (Jpn)** (Wild Rush) will be a short price to repeat in the G1 February S. at Tokyo, there are a few outsiders worthy of a look. They include **Wonder Acute (Jpn)** (Charismatic), a horse with an American dirt pedigree top and bottom, being a son of the dual Classic winner Charismatic out of the Pleasant Tap mare Wonder Heritage. As a 5-year-old last year, Wonder Acute hit his best stride, winning the G2 Tokai T. V. Tokai S. at Kyoto in May. After a six-month absence, he ran a non-threatening fourth in the G3 Miyako S. at Kyoto Nov. 6, then ran a strong second to Transcend in the G1 Japan Cup Dirt Dec. 4. He came back to nearly register the win in the 2000-meter Tokyo Daishoten Dec. 29--a local Group 1 that he missed by a nose to Smart Falcon (Jpn) (Smart Falcon {Jpn}). Wonder Acute now scales back to 1600 meters for the February, one of the most prestigious dirt races in Japan and, with a purse of roughly \$2.45 million, worth nearly \$1.18 million to the winner. A maximum field of 16 is expected; entries are taken Thursday.

ADVANCES AT ARQANA FEBRUARY MIXED

Buoyed by its largest catalogue ever, Arqana's February Mixed Sale concluded its one-session run at Deauville yesterday, with 204 head grossing €1,627,500. It was the sale's largest aggregate since the 2007 renewal, which was bolstered by a €2.2-million yield from the dispersal of Haras de Saint-Pair-du-Mont's stock. The dispersal of the bloodstock of Mme Sylvia Wildenstein dominated this year's auction, aiding in significant increases in both median and average figures. The dispersal also included six of the day's top 10 lots.

Opening the sale with a bang, all of the dispersal's 11 offerings were sold for a total €413,500, at an average of €37,591 and a median of €34,000.

Top of the pile from the dispersal, and of the day's overall trade, was [hip 4s](#), the stakes winner and group placed **Nickelle (Fr)** (Sagamix {Fr}), who sold to the YES agency for €85,000. The 8-year-old mare, consigned by Haras de Victot, is a daughter of the Group I-winning hurdler **N'Avoue Jamais (Fr)** (Marignan), who got proceedings under way as [hip 1s](#) when selling to Eclipse Bloodstock for €48,000.

Benefitting from an international presence--which included representatives from Europe, North Africa and Asia--the much-improved clearance rate forced the average up almost 40% to €7,978, and the median up nearly 30% to €4,500.

"The good National Hunt families, such as

that of [Mme Sylvia Wildenstein's] Neomenie, always draw the interest of breeders passionate about jumps, be they French, English or Irish," expressed a satisfied Arqana president Eric Hoyeau. "Mme Wildenstein's dispersal added momentum to the sale, for which the percentage sold was 78.16, up almost 11% on 2011. These factors all point towards the February sale meeting its targets."
